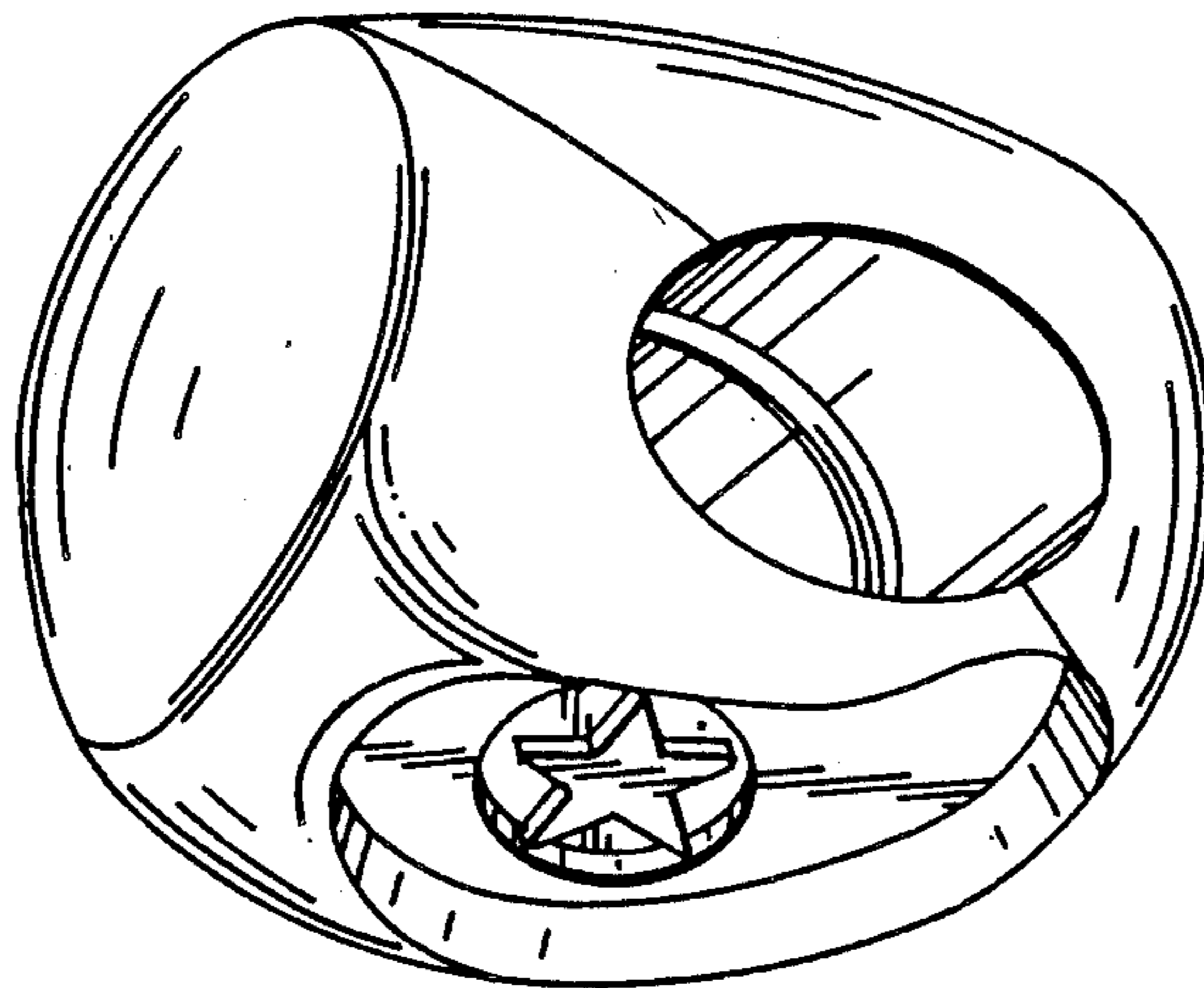

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a writing aid, or similar article as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a writing aid or similar showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a writing instrument in FIGS. 2 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



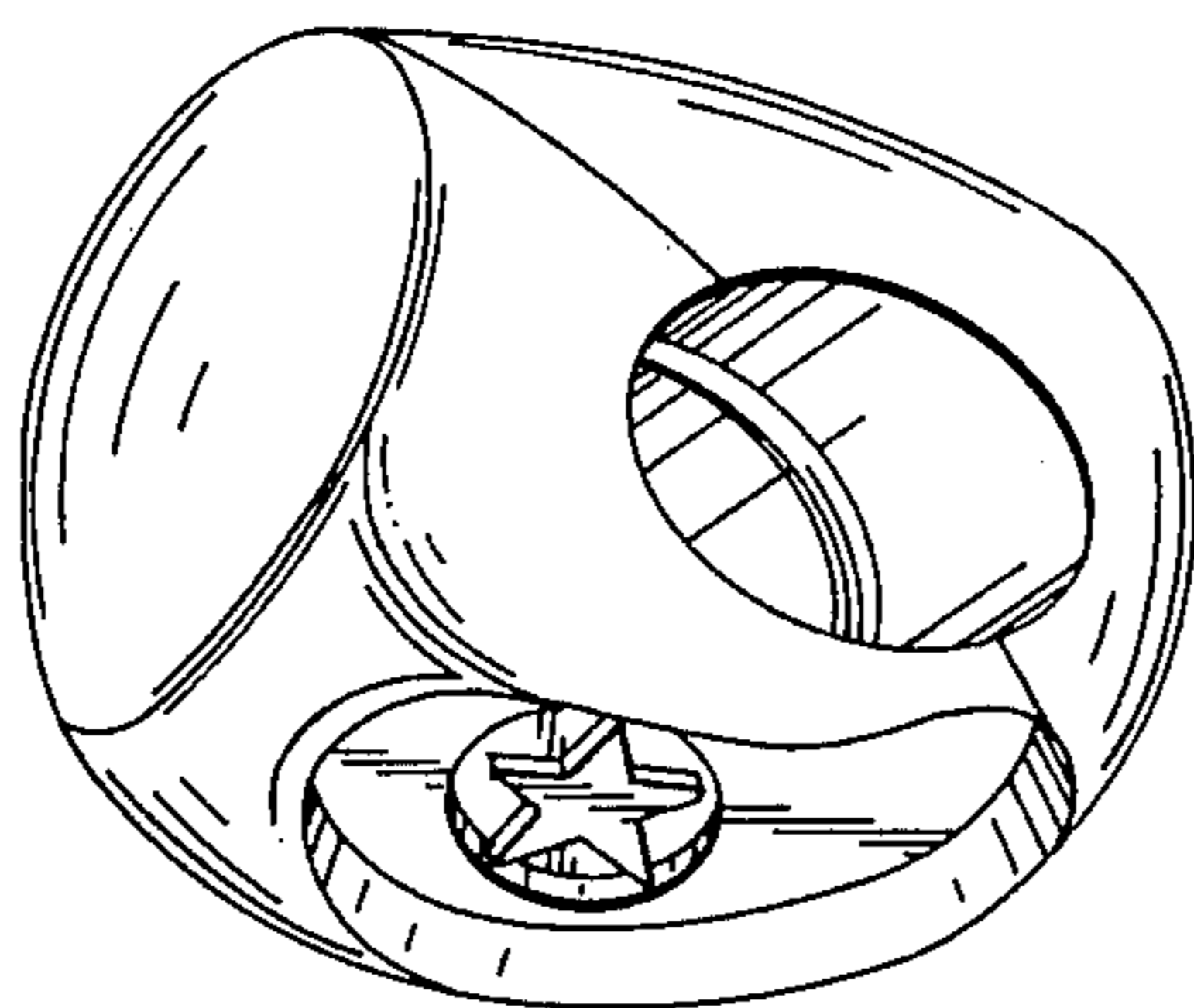

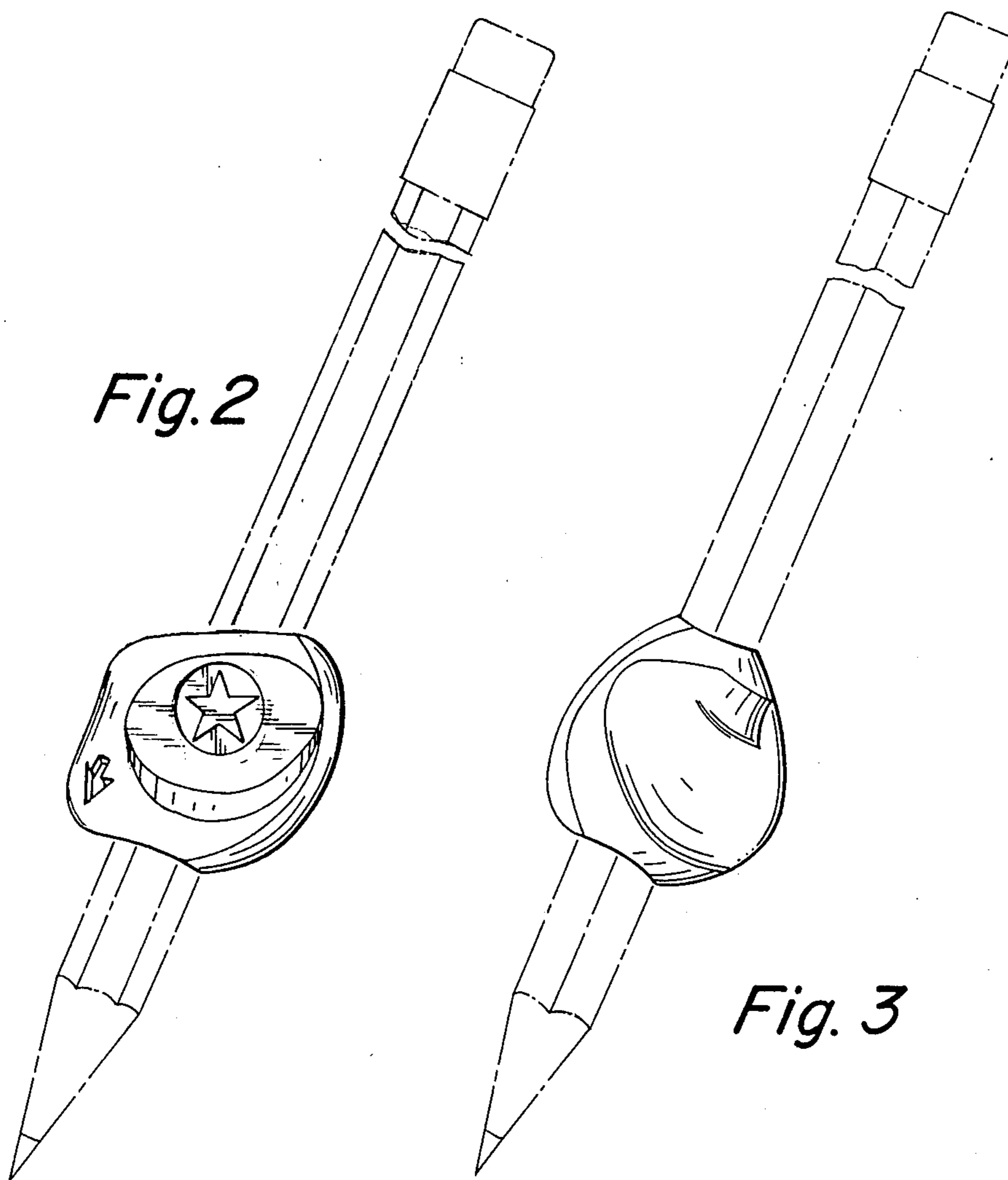

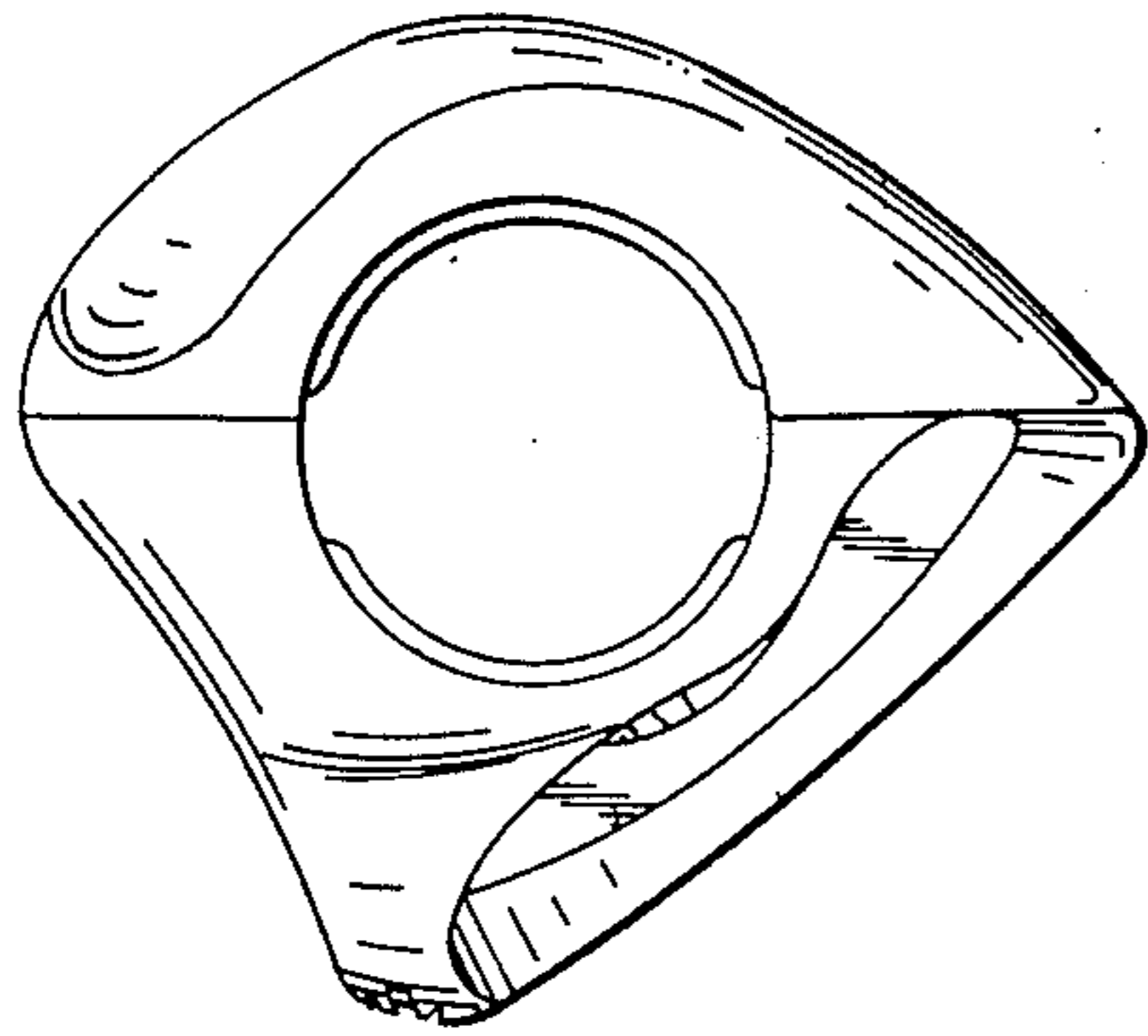

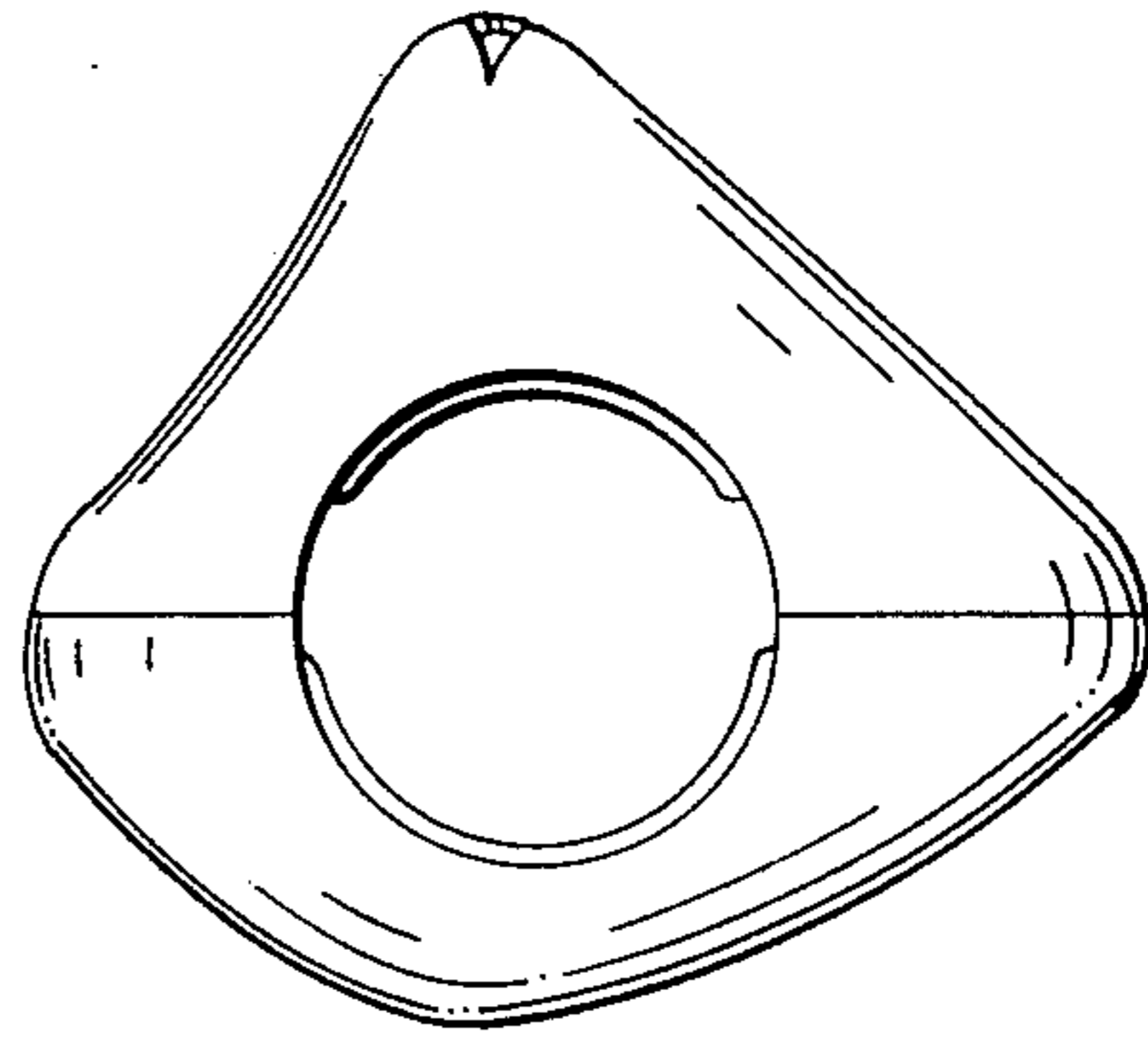

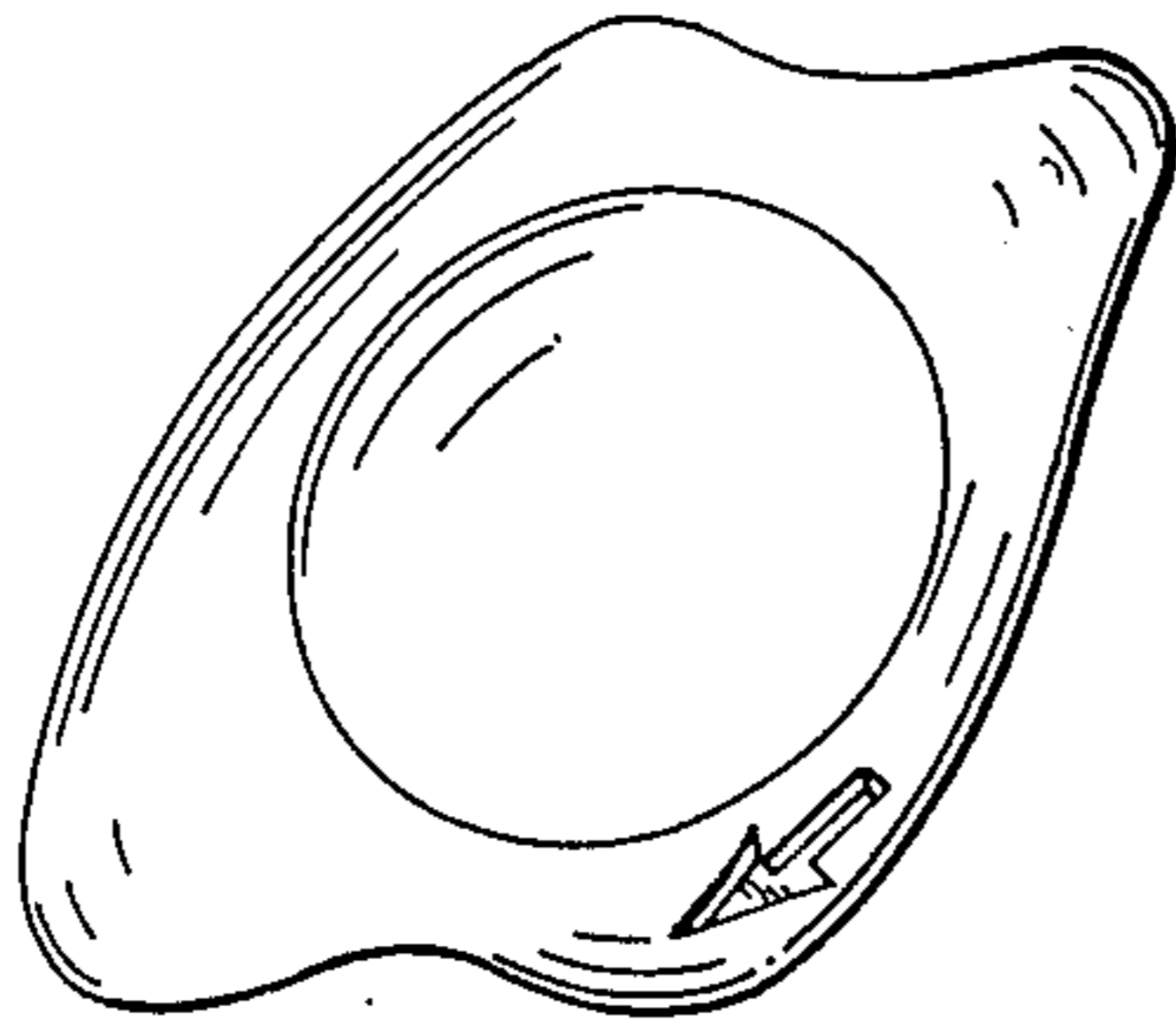

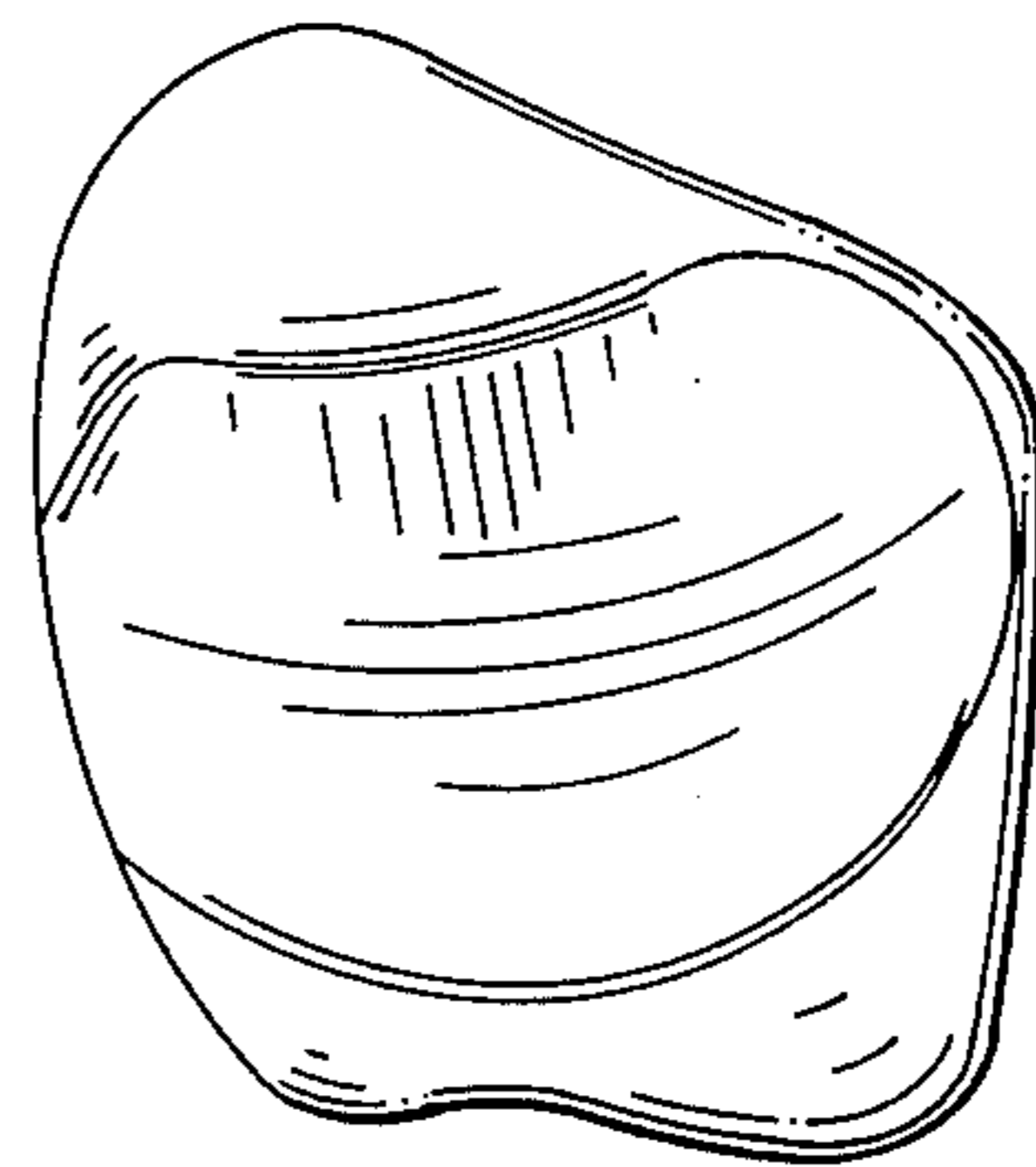
