DESCRIPTION

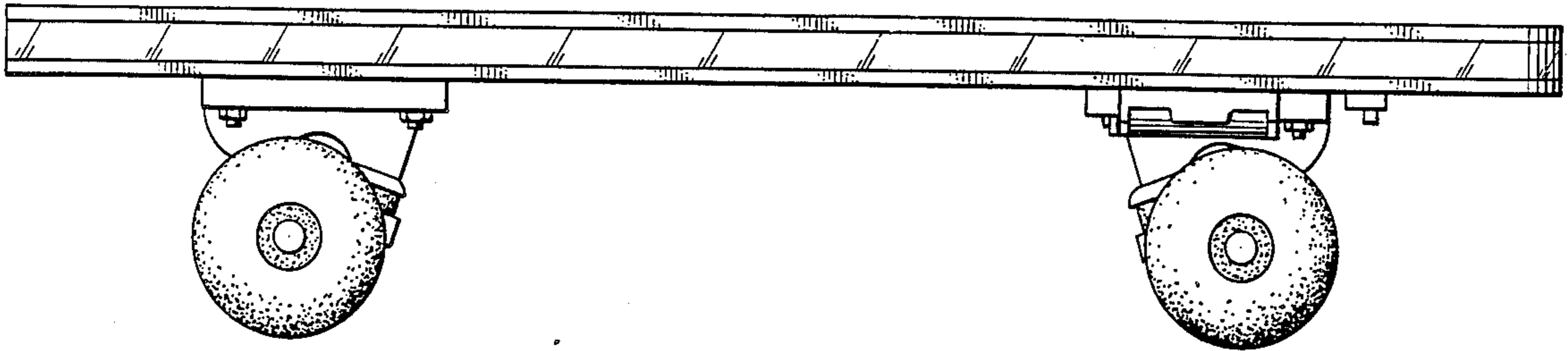
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an illuminable skateboard showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



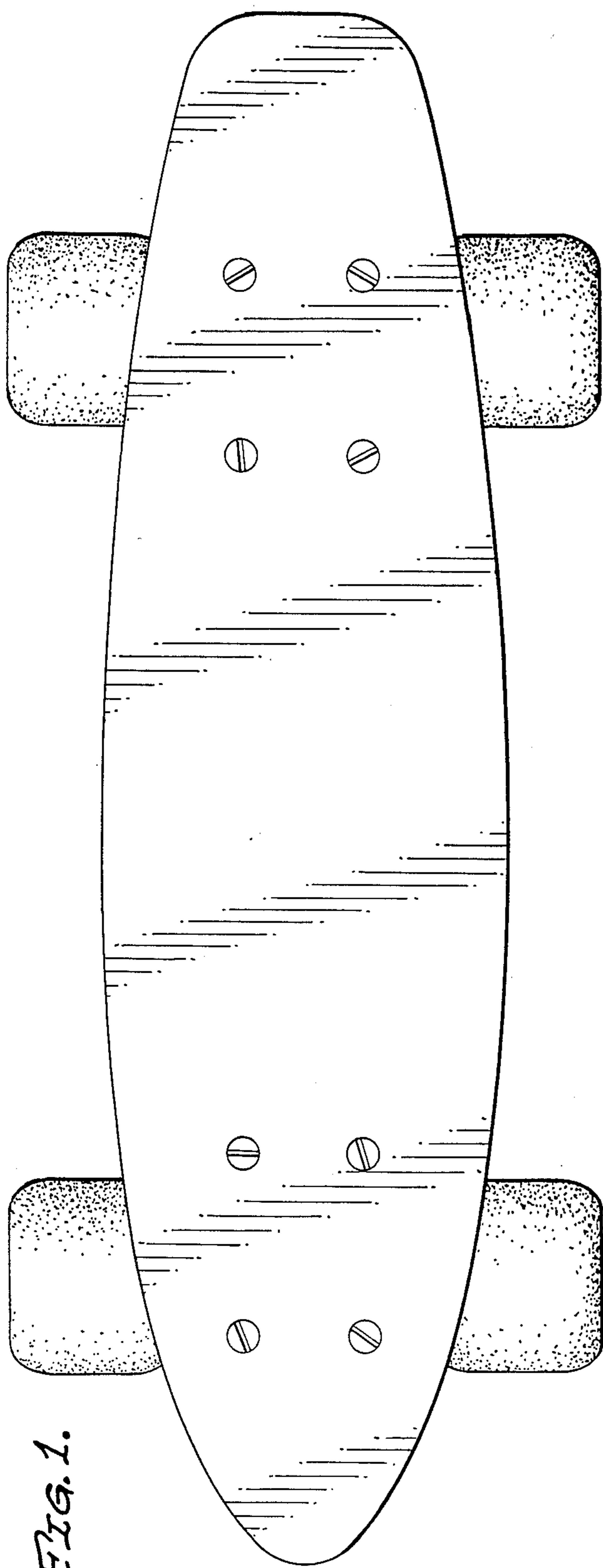

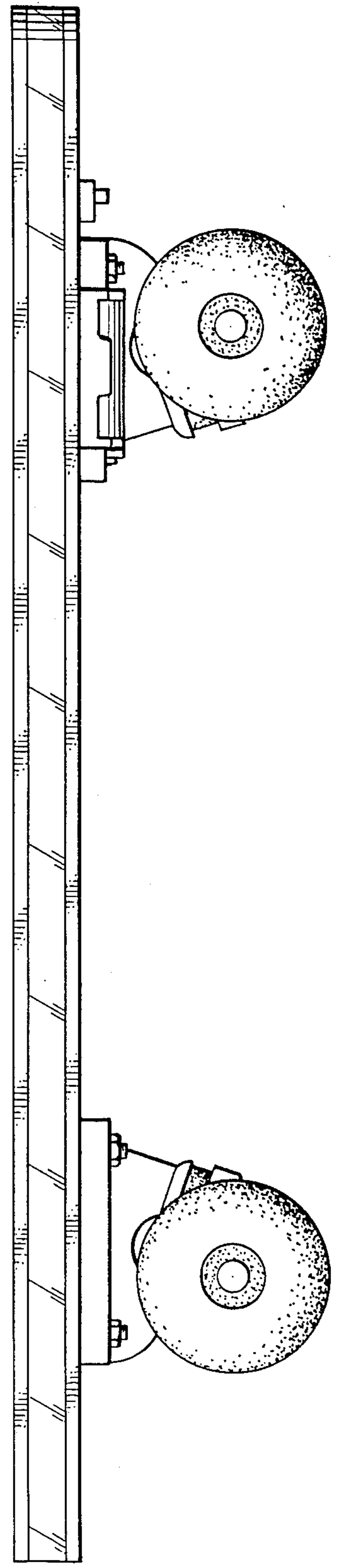

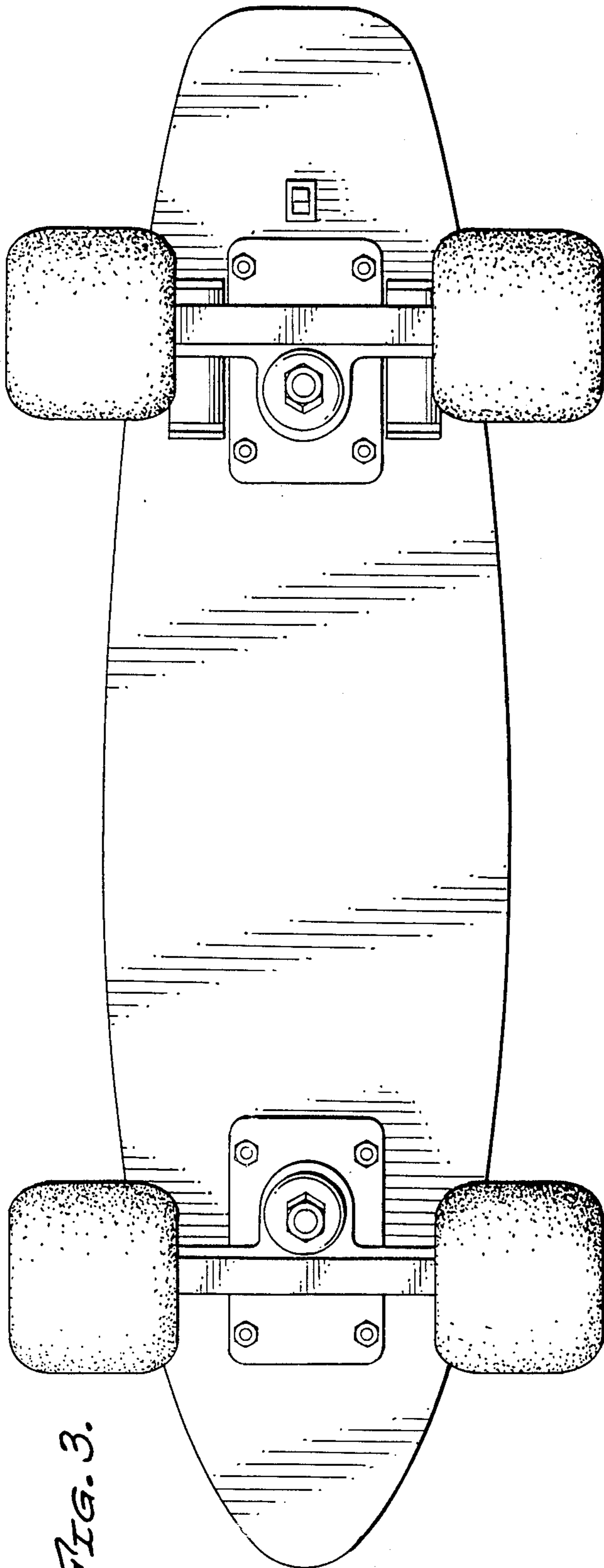

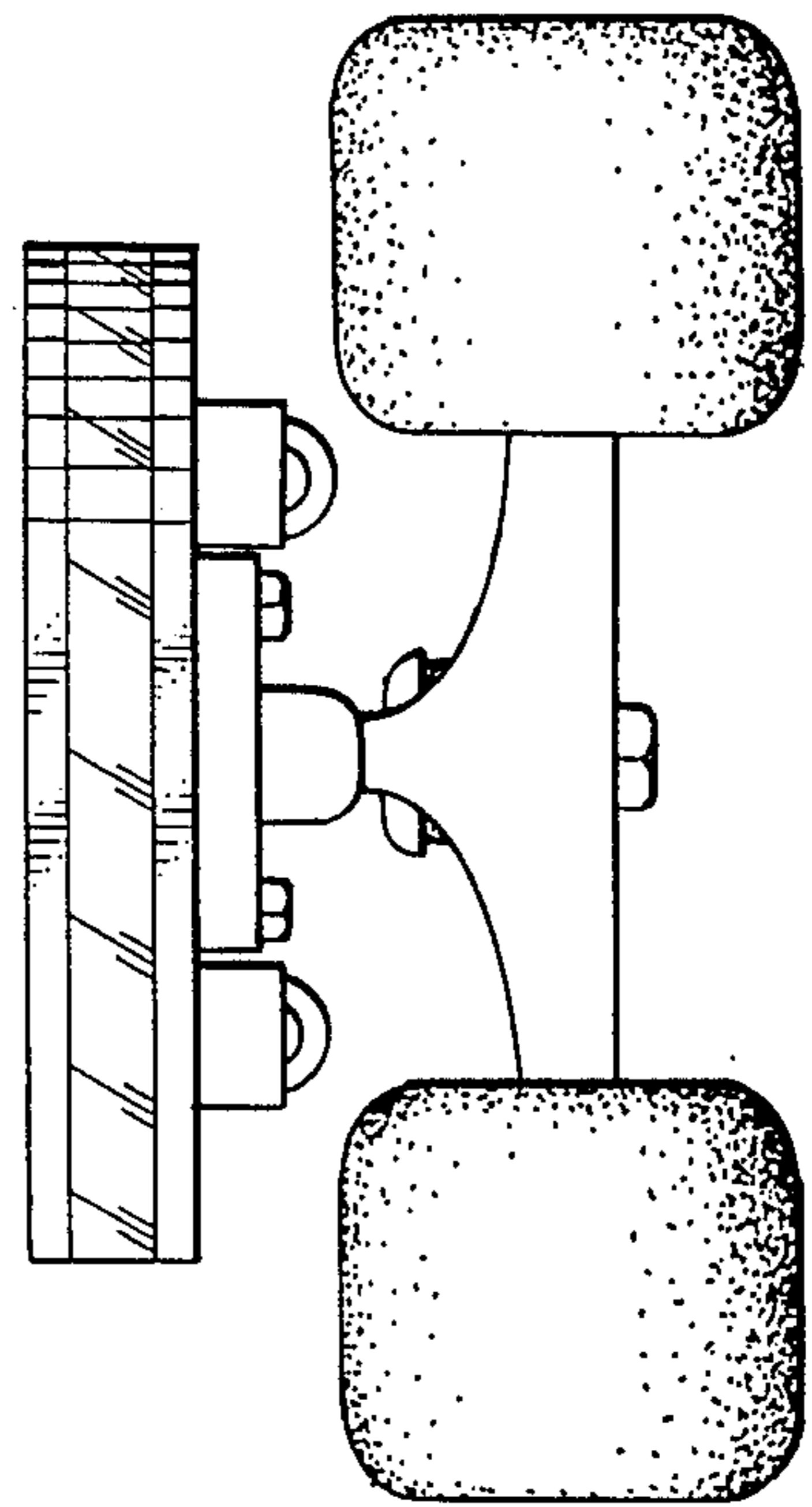
