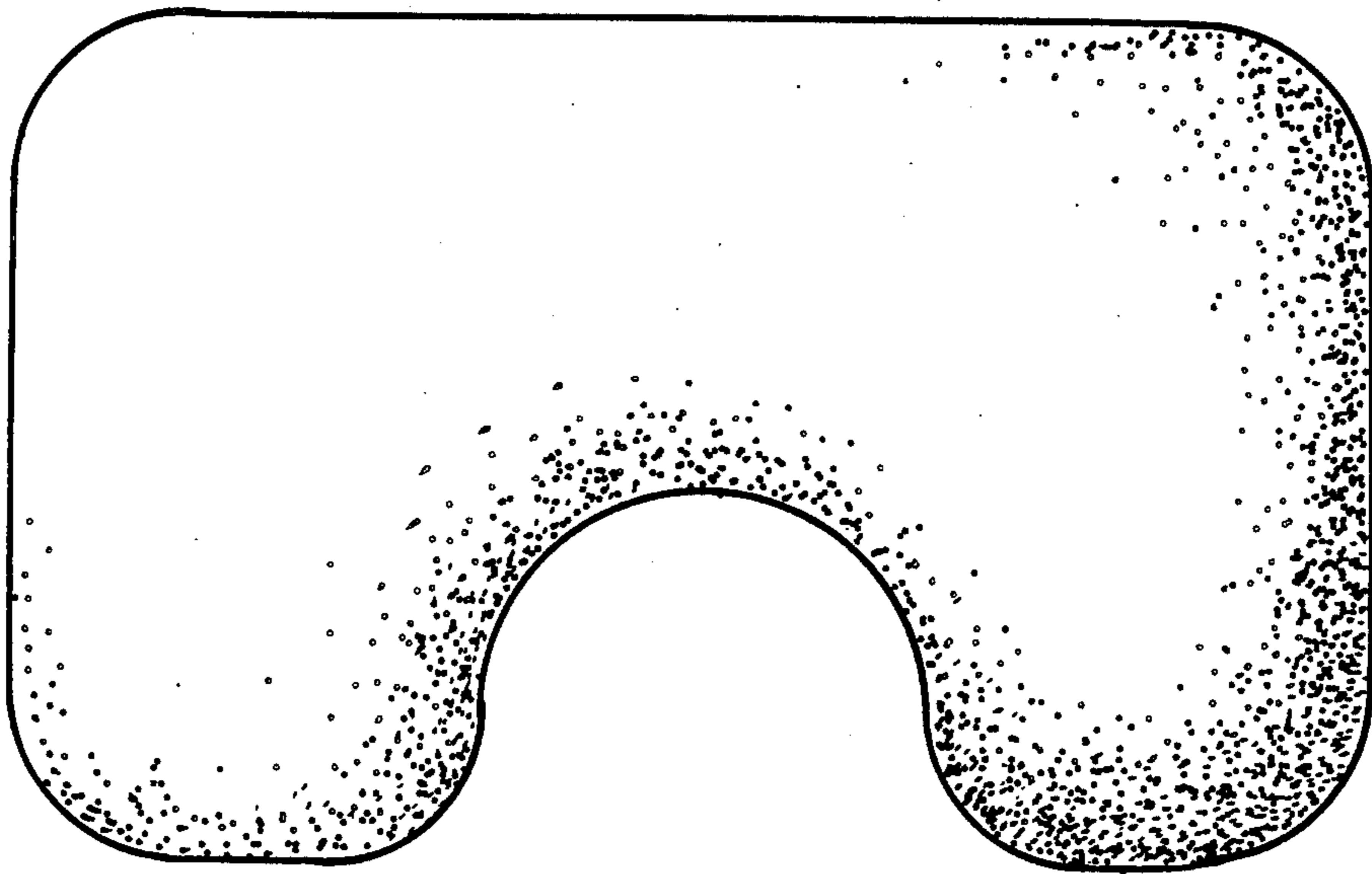

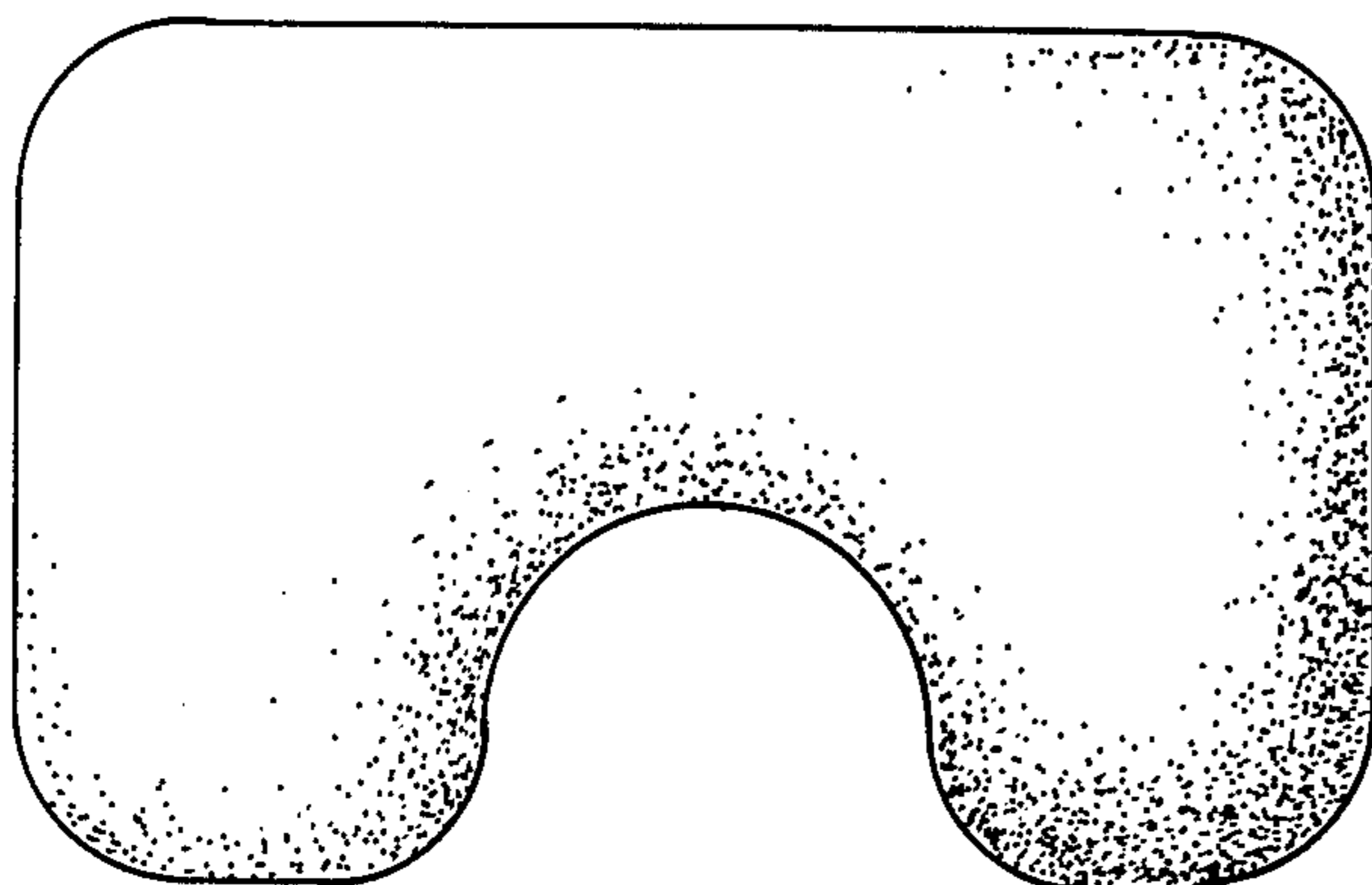
The ornamental design for an obstetric delivery seat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

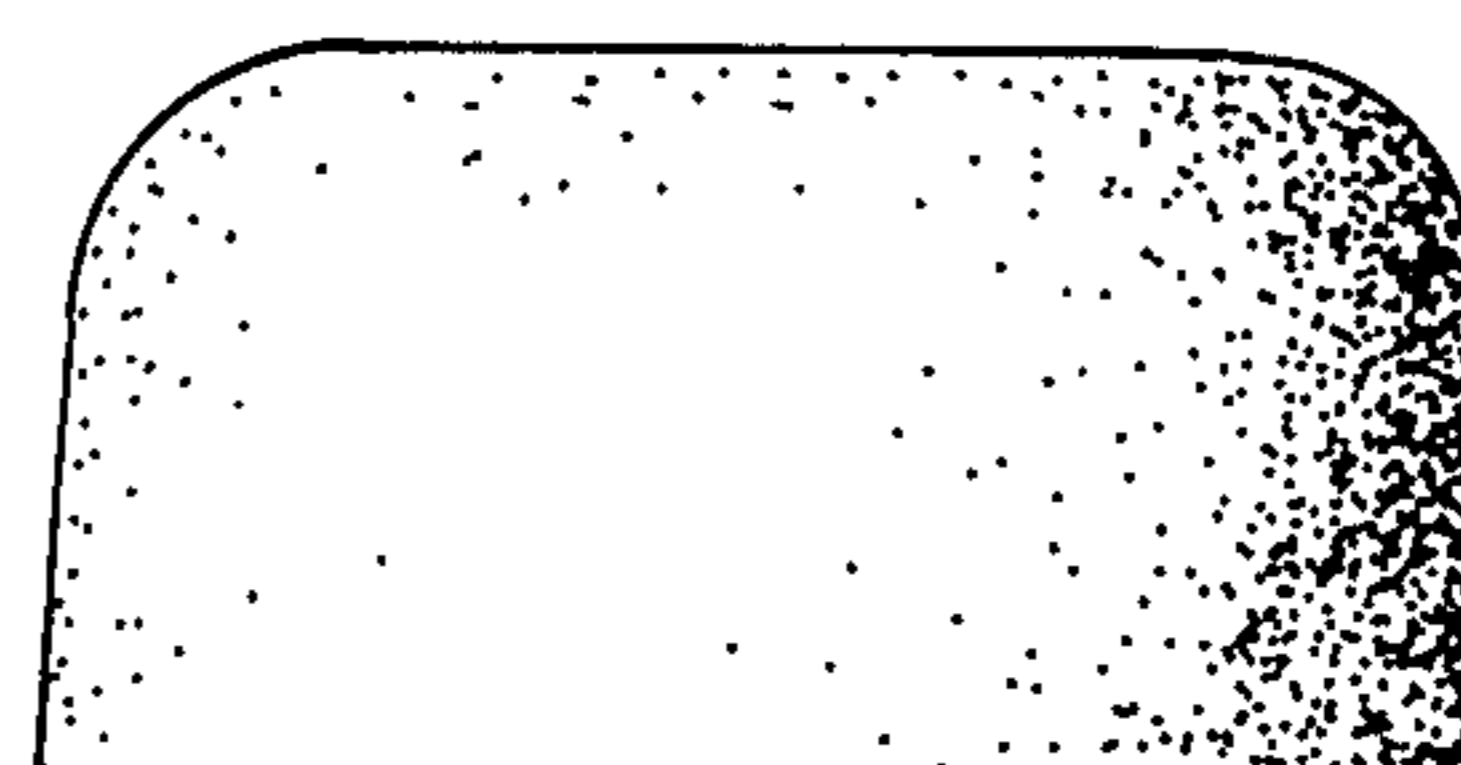
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an obstetric delivery seat showing my new design;

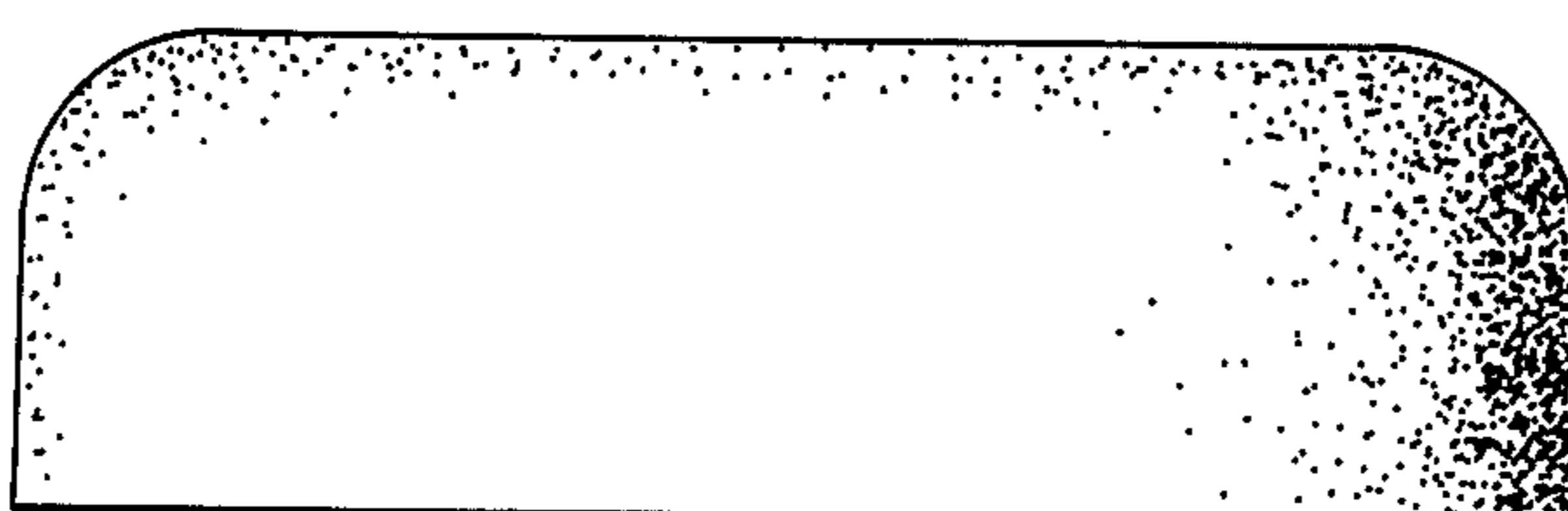
