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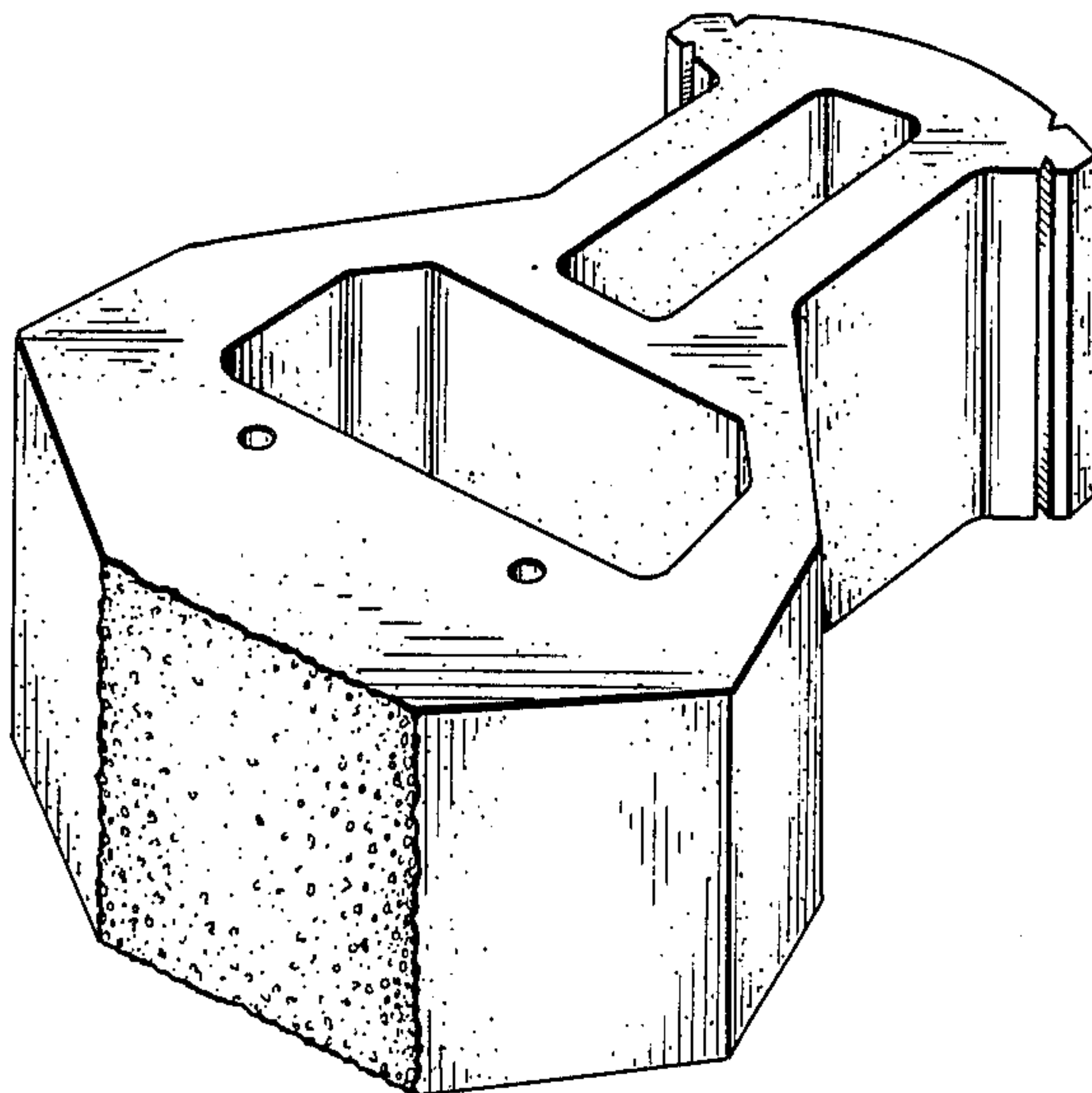

The ornamental design for a retaining wall block, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a retaining wall
block of my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the right side thereof, the oppo-
site side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4—4 of
FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along the line 8—8 of
FIG. 2;
FIG. 9 is a top front perspective view of a first modifi-
cation of the retaining wall block of my new design;
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 9;
FIG. 11 is a side view of right side of FIG. 10, the
opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 12 is a sectional view taken along the line 12—12
of FIG. 10;
FIG. 13 is a bottom view of FIG. 9;
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of FIG. 9;
FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 9; and
FIG. 16 is a sectional view taken along the line 16—16
of FIG. 10.



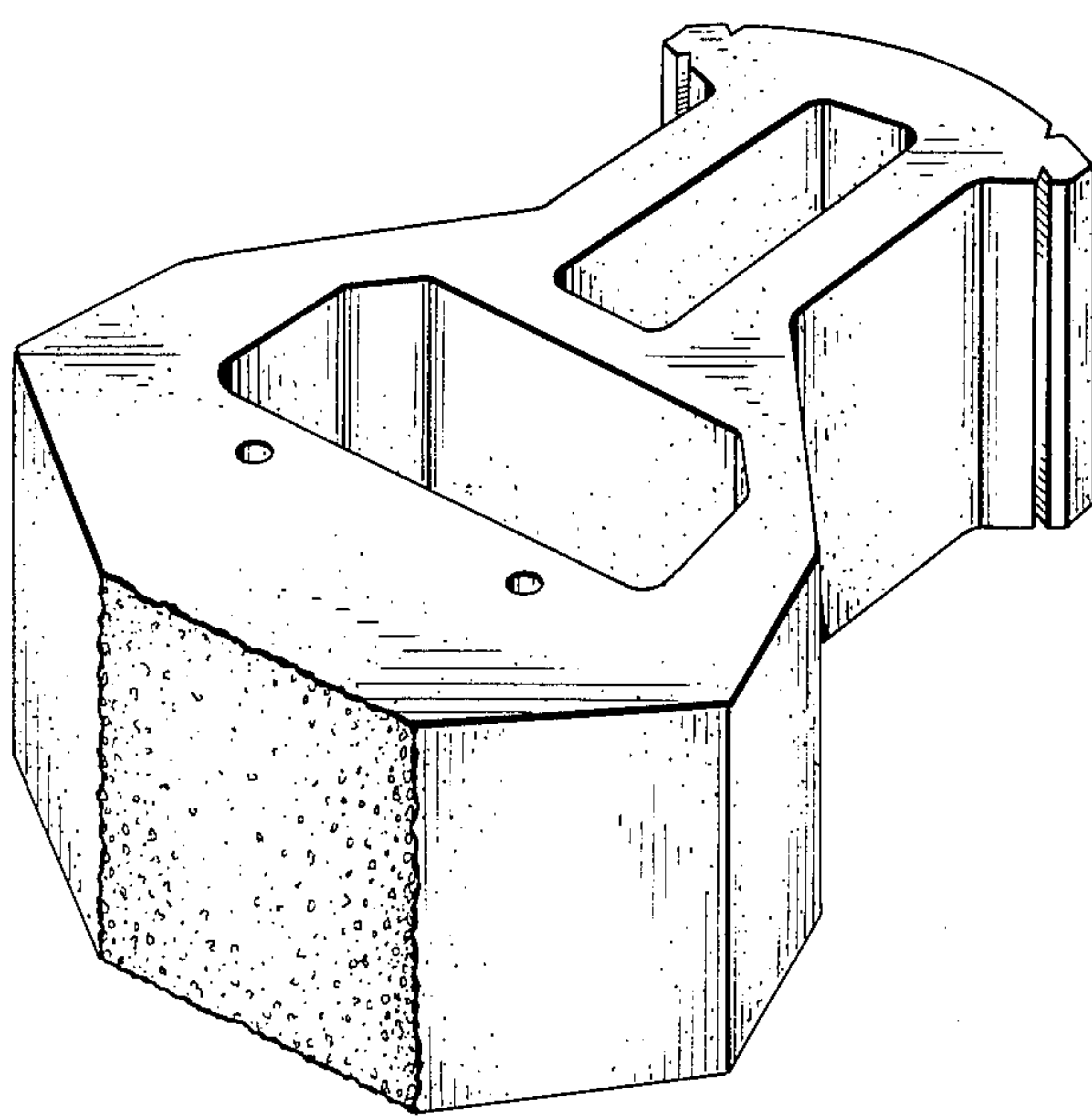

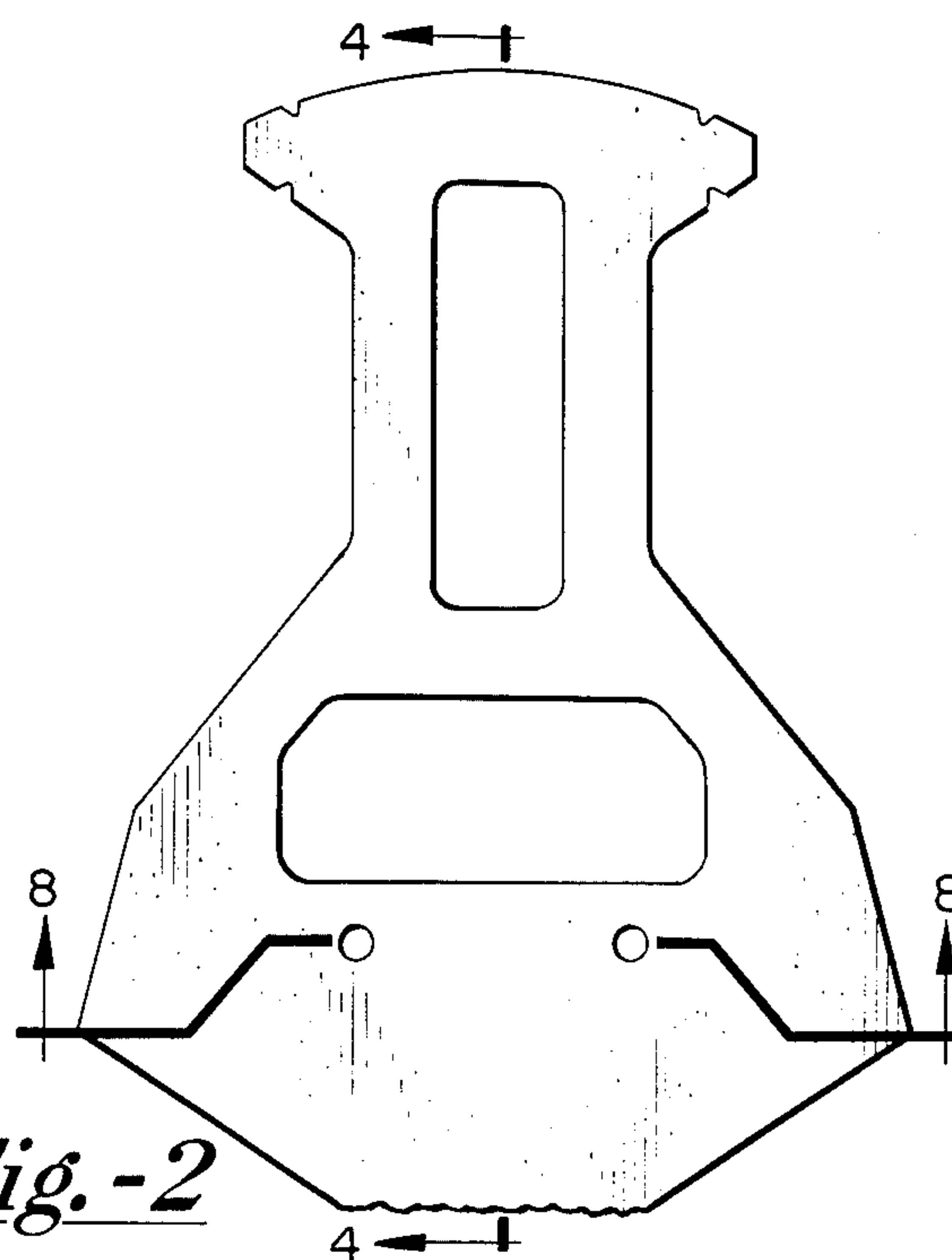

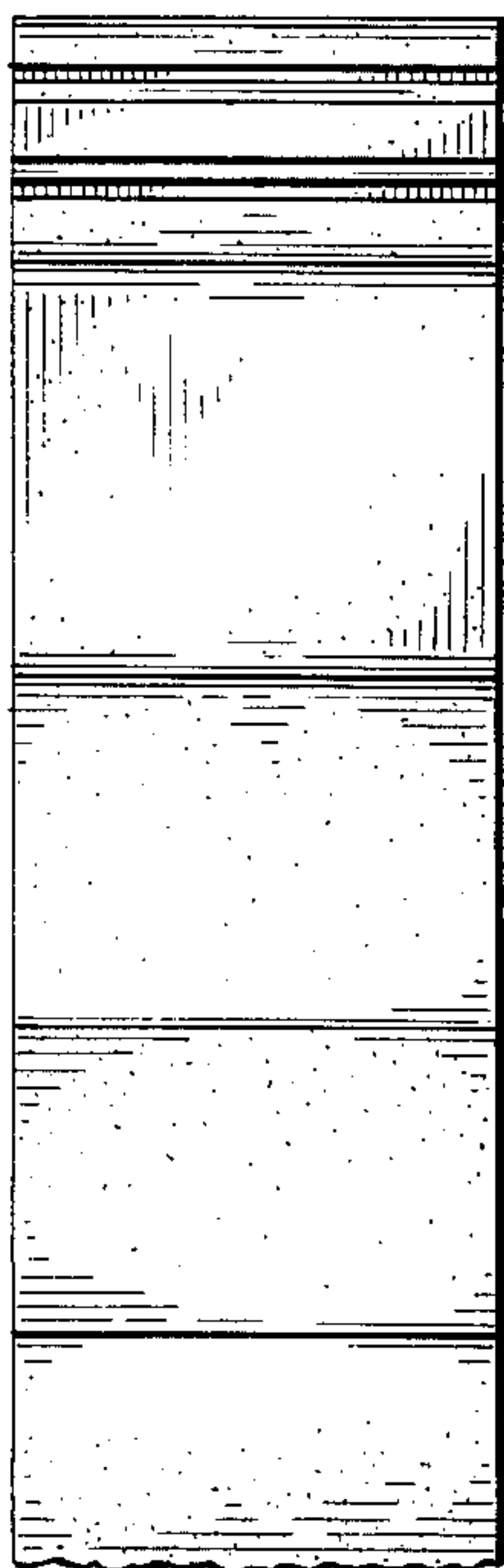

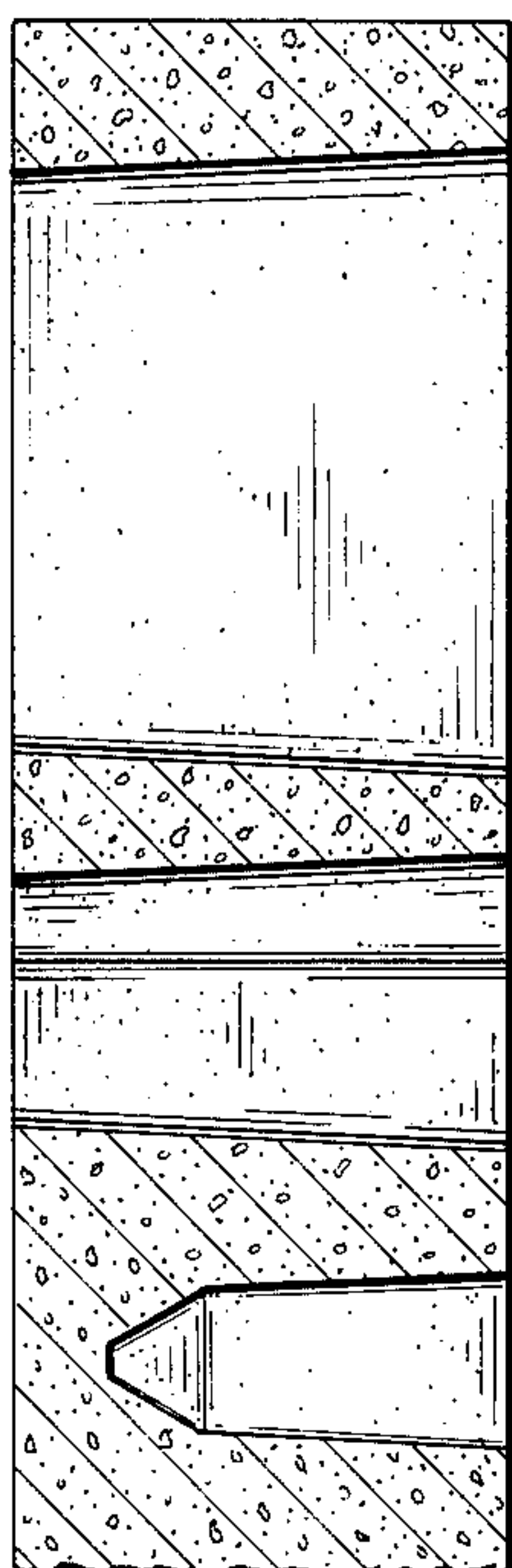

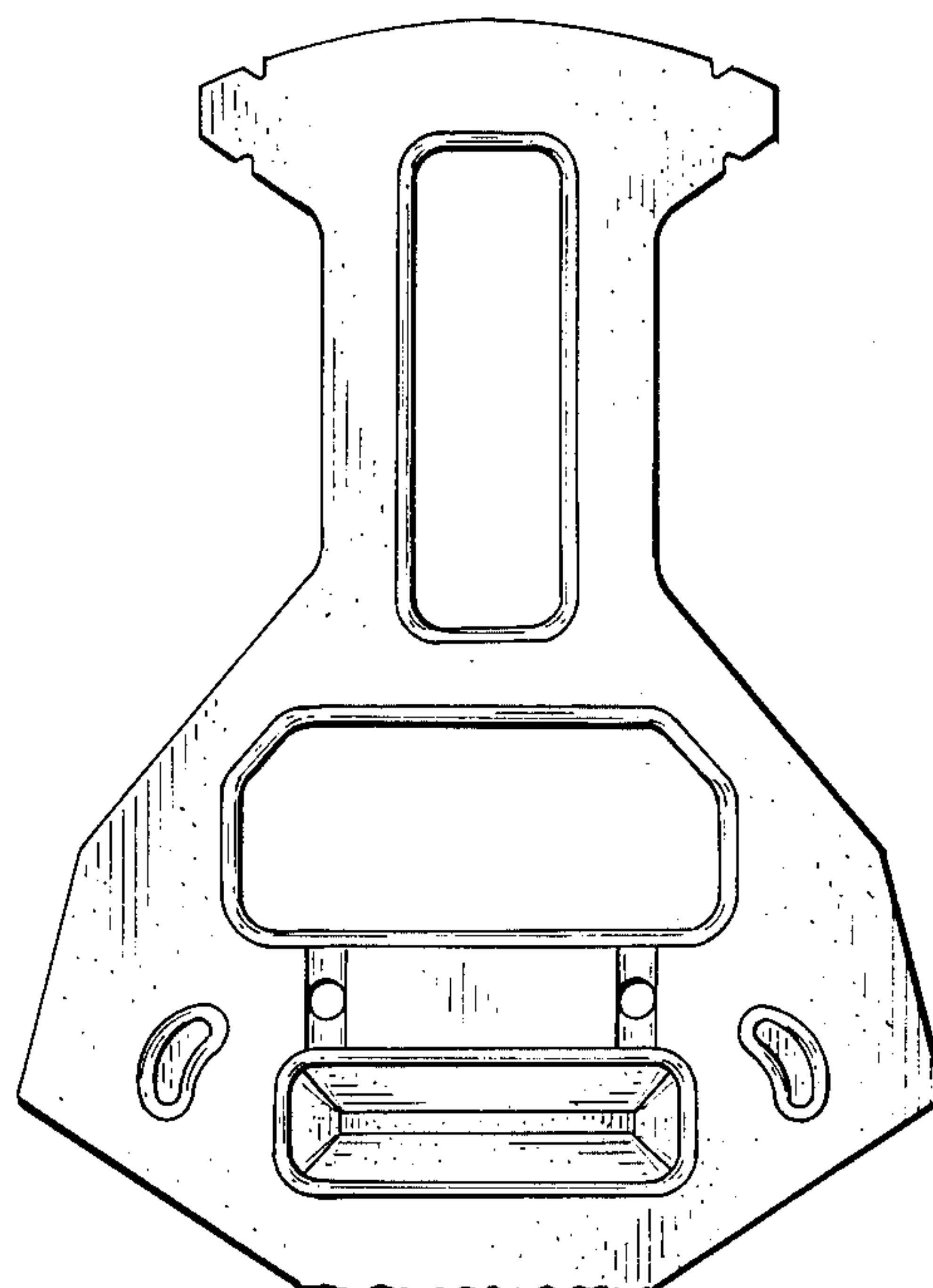

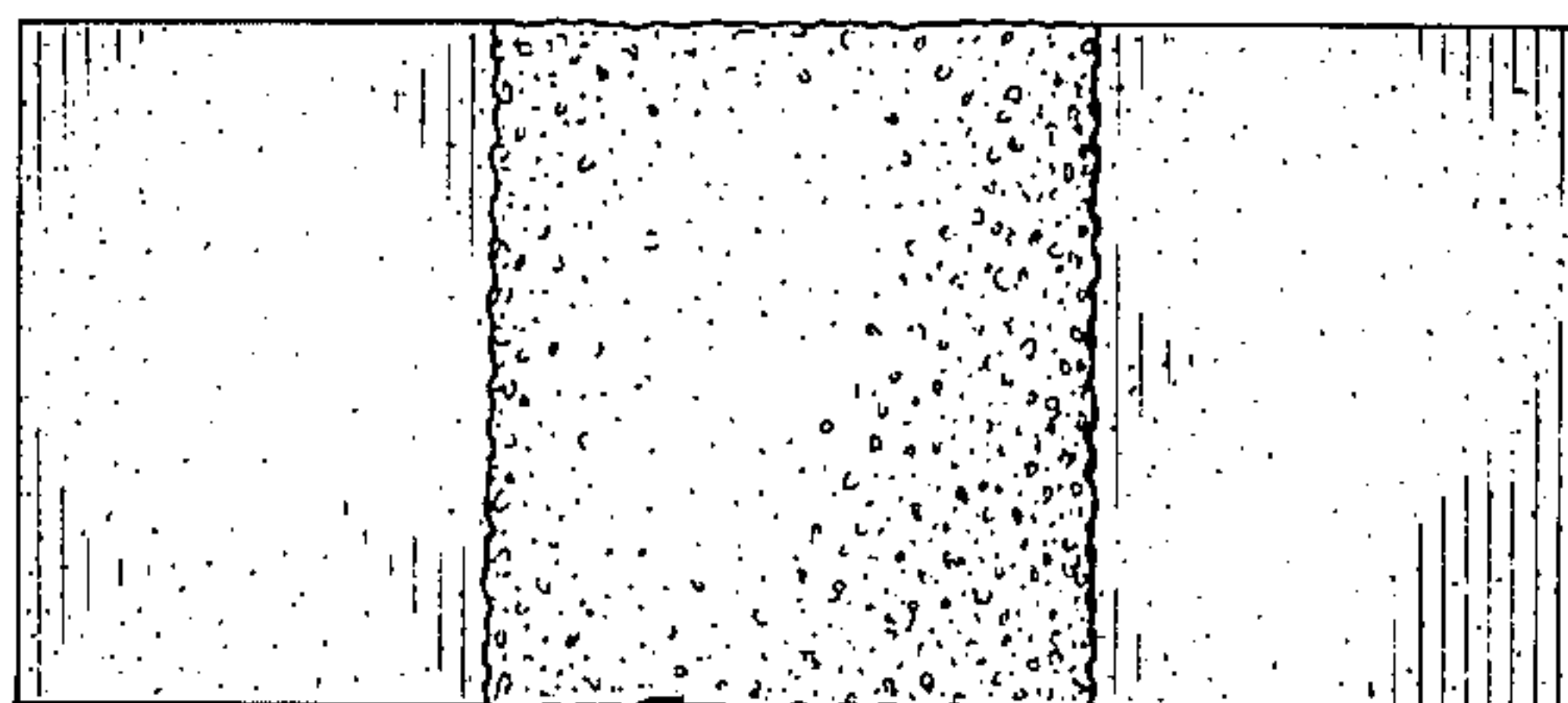

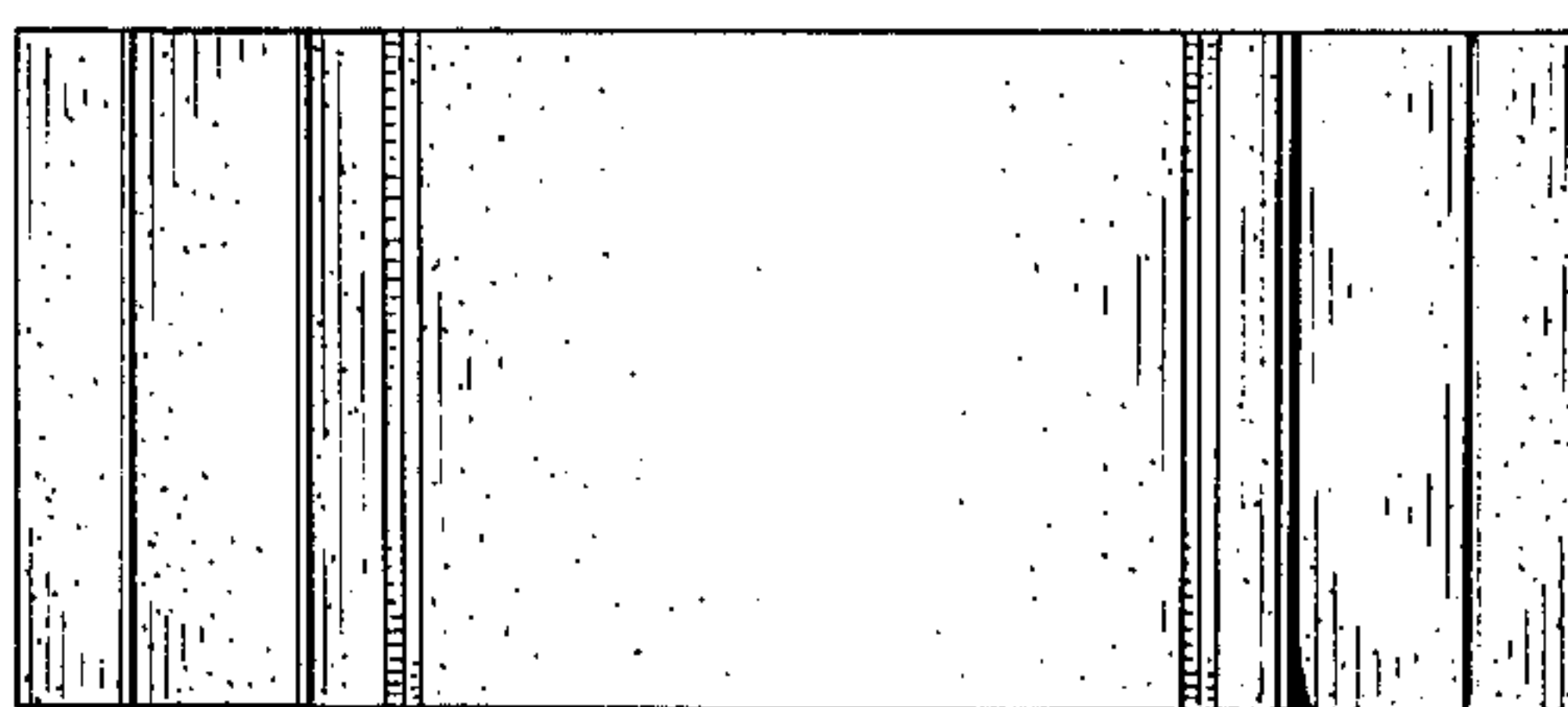

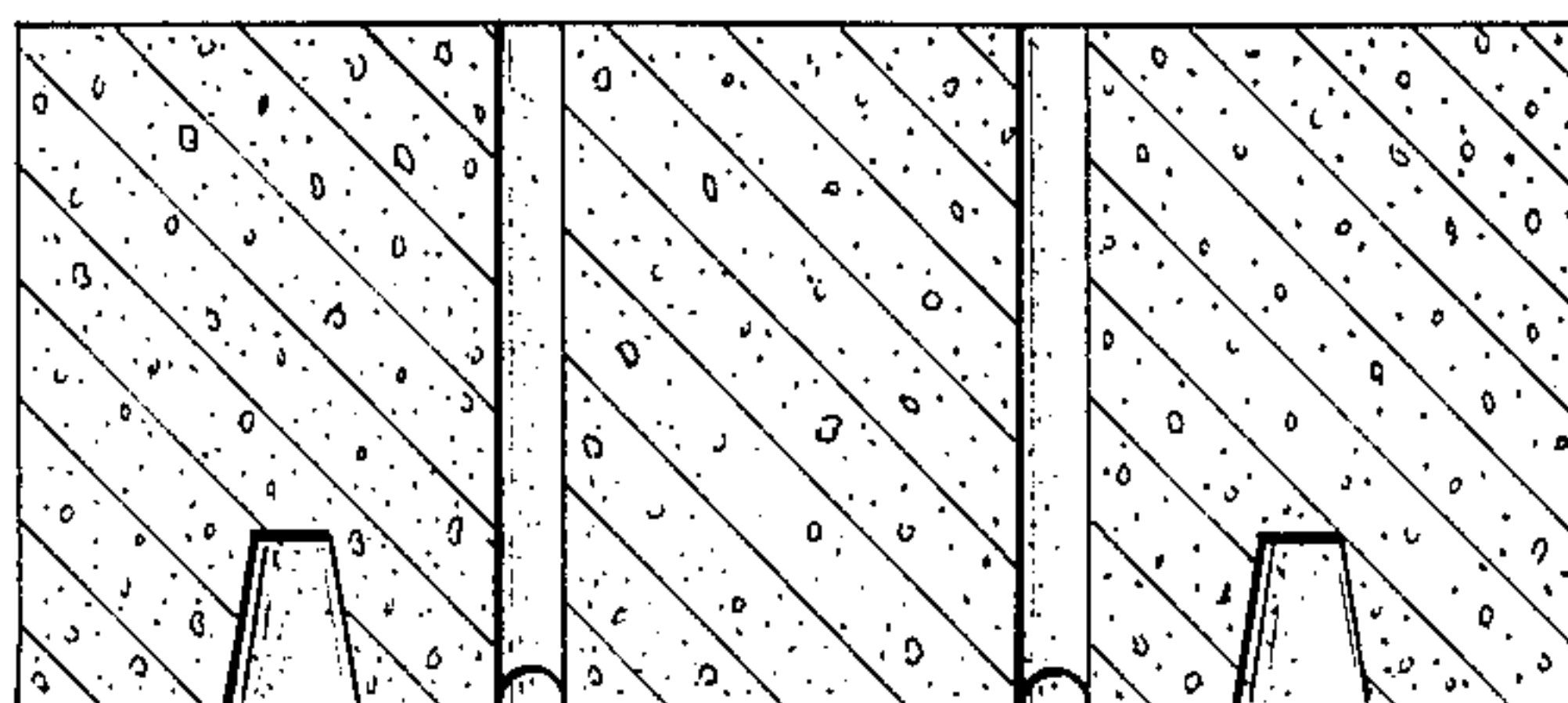

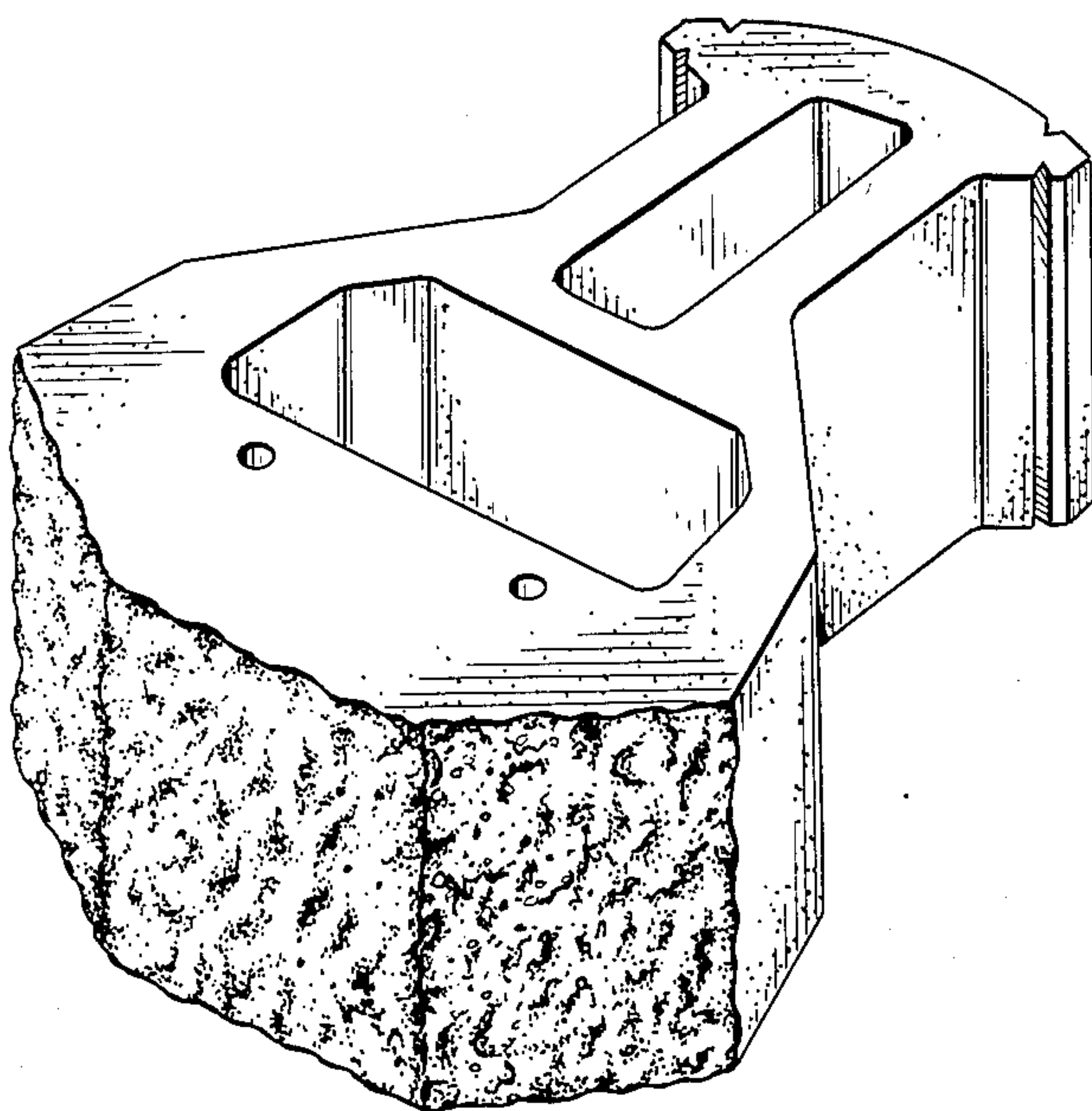

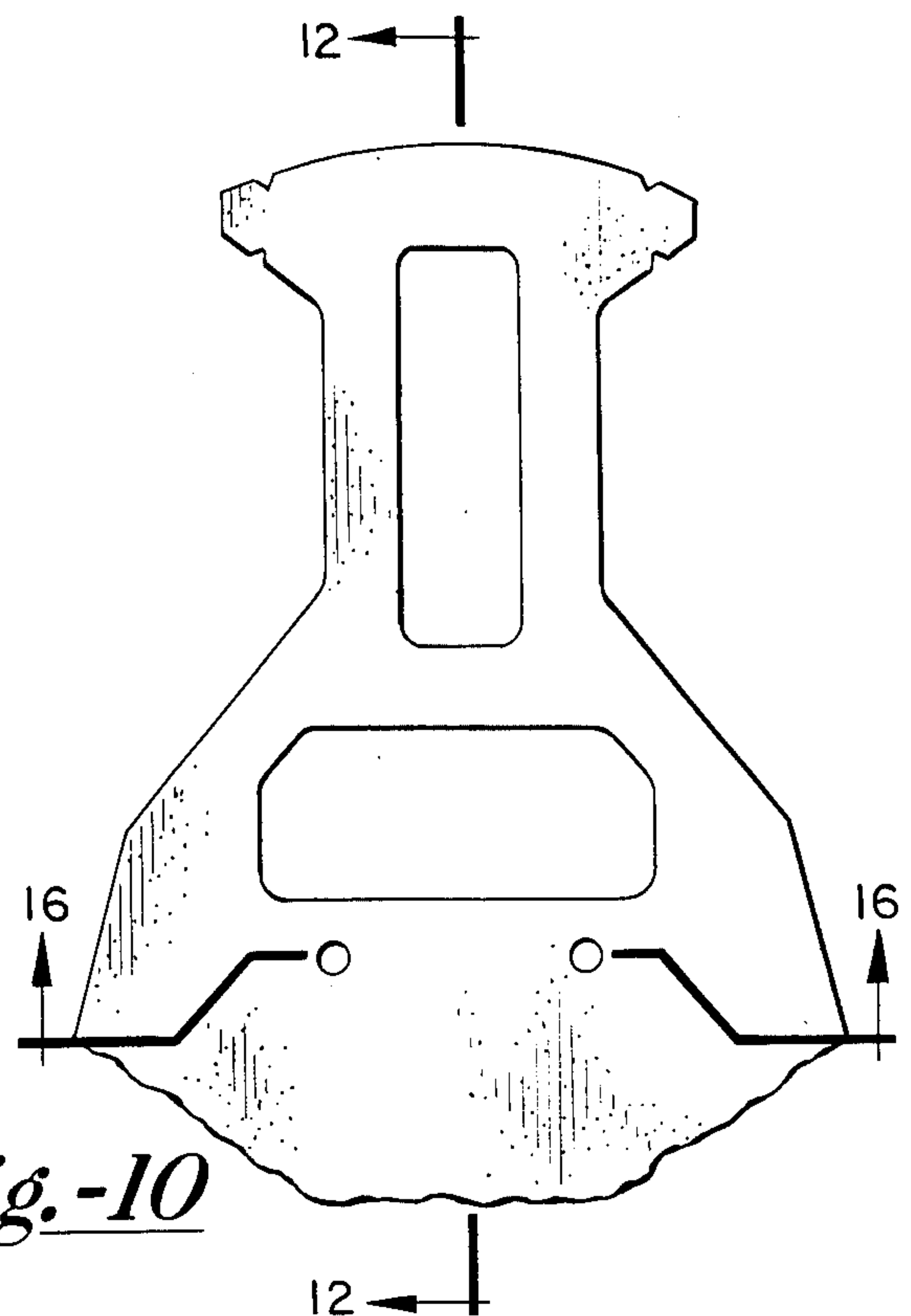

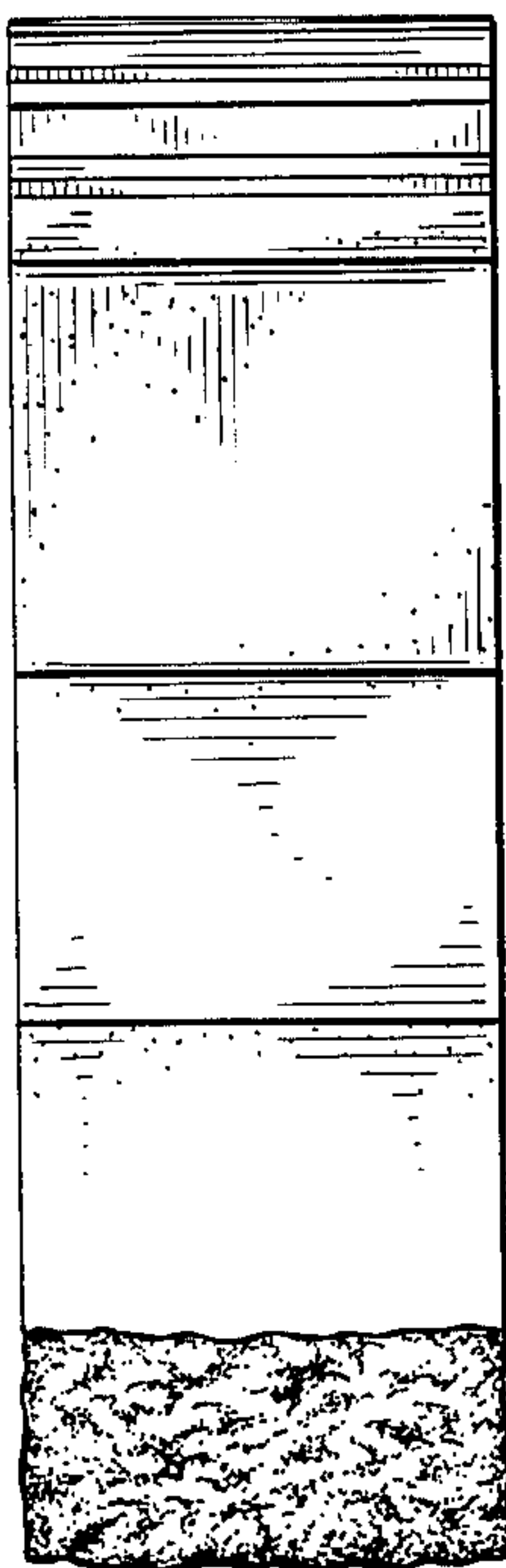

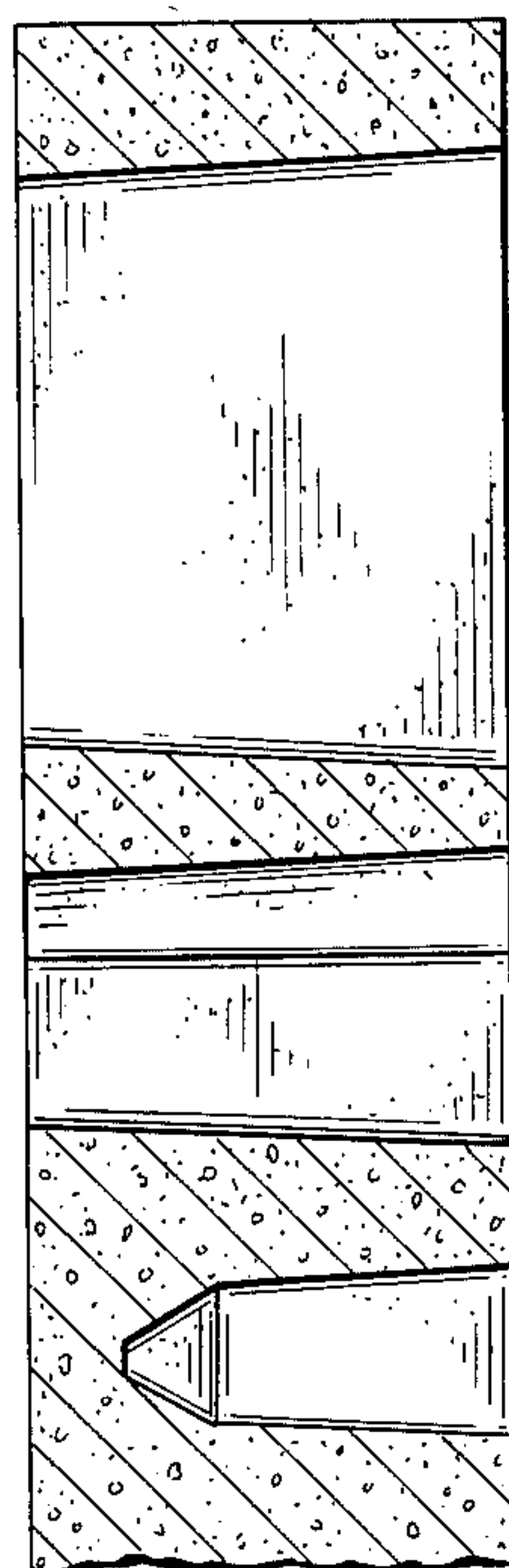


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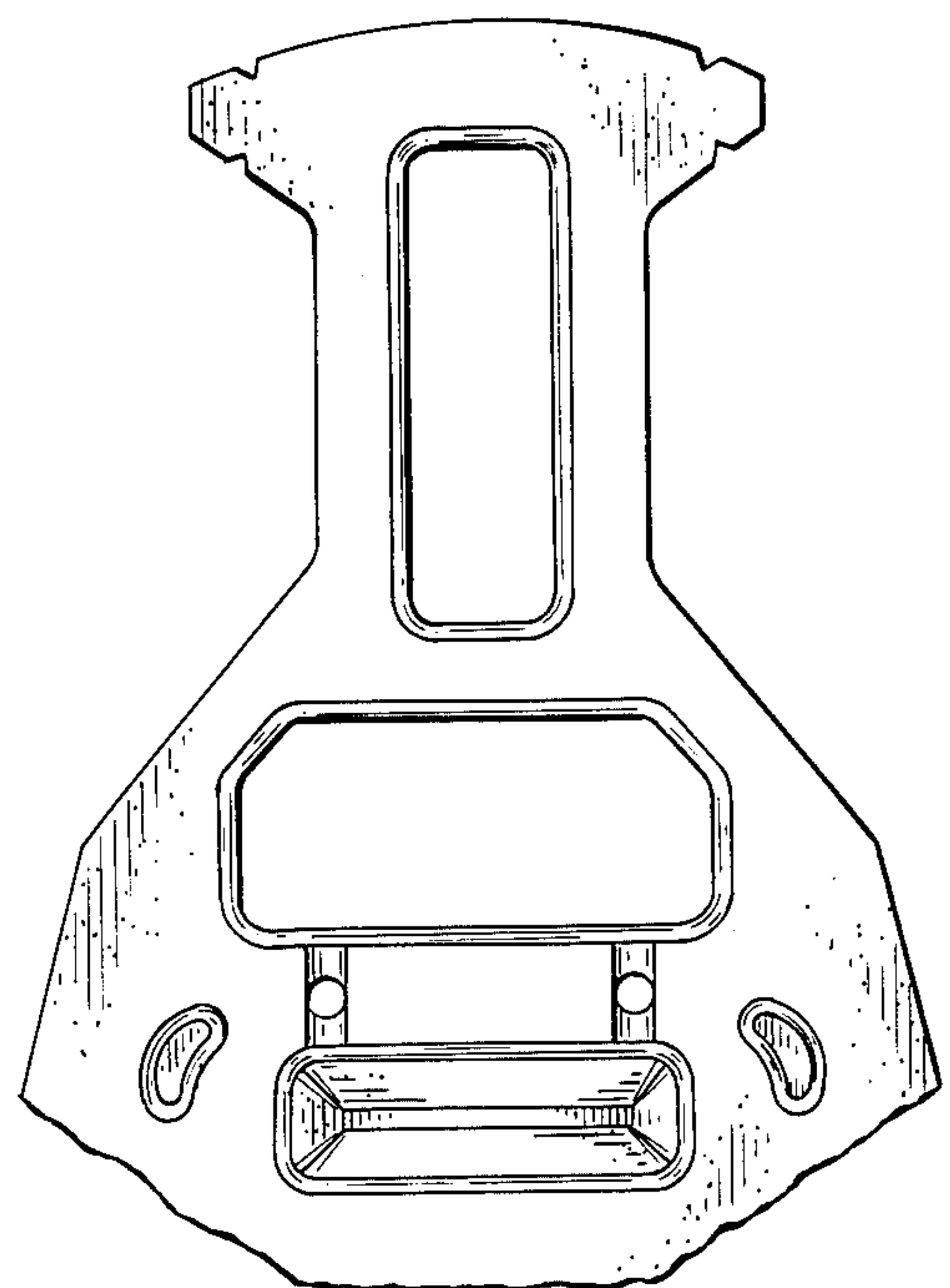

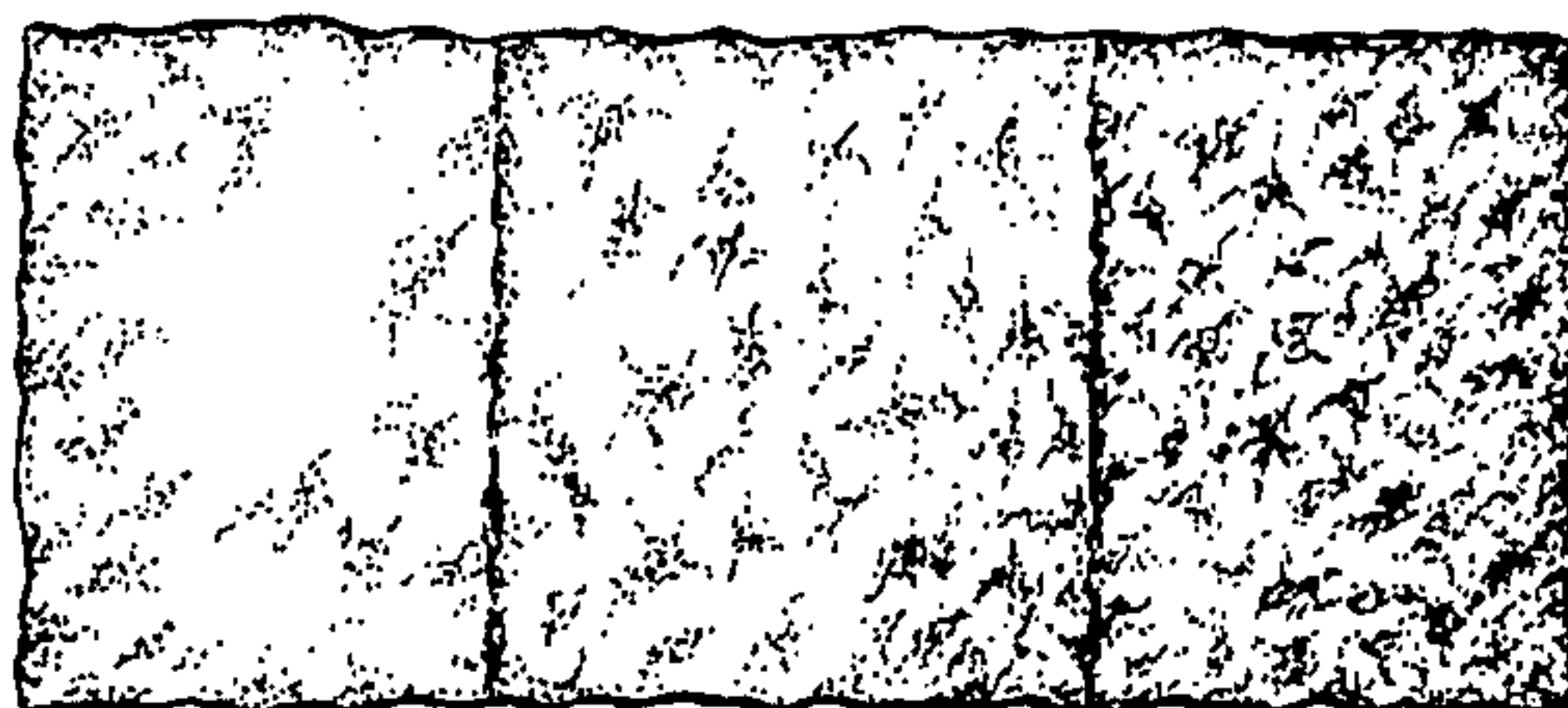

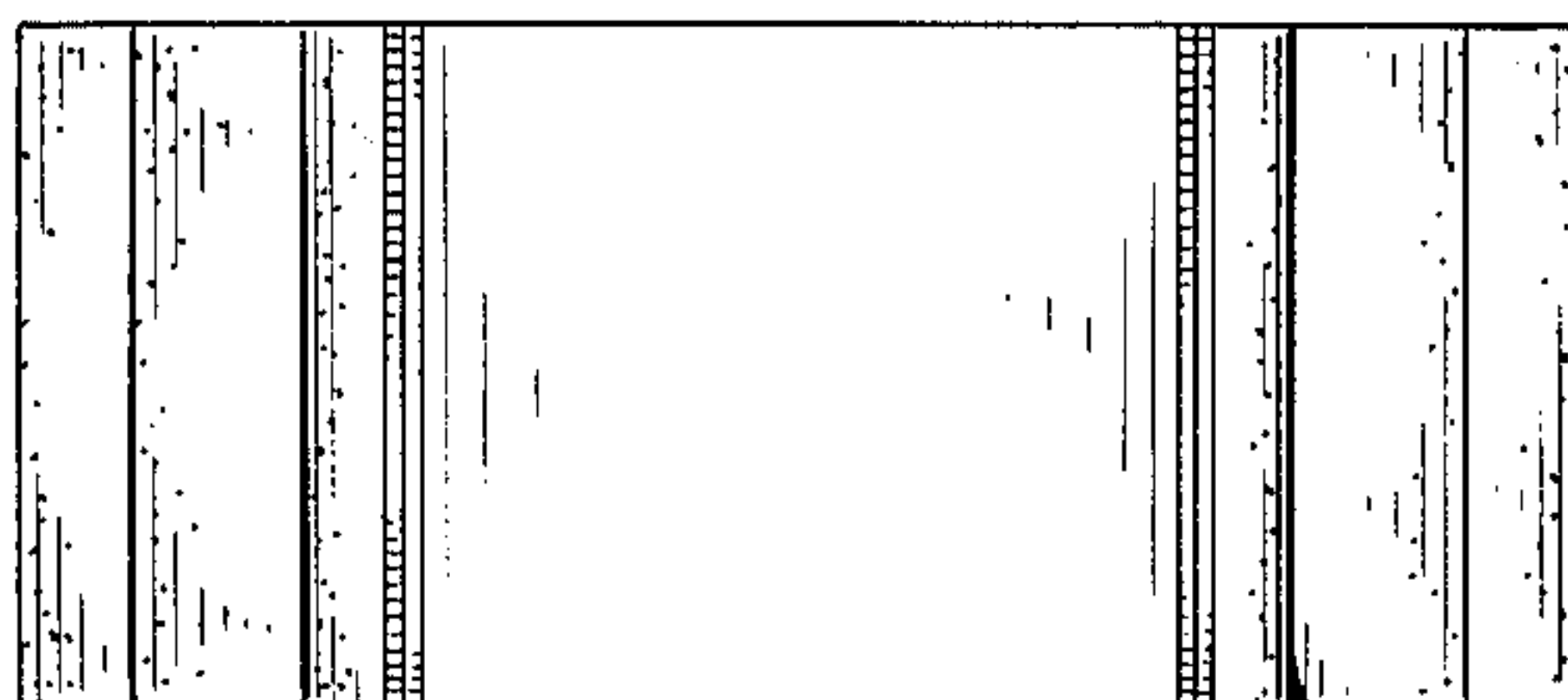

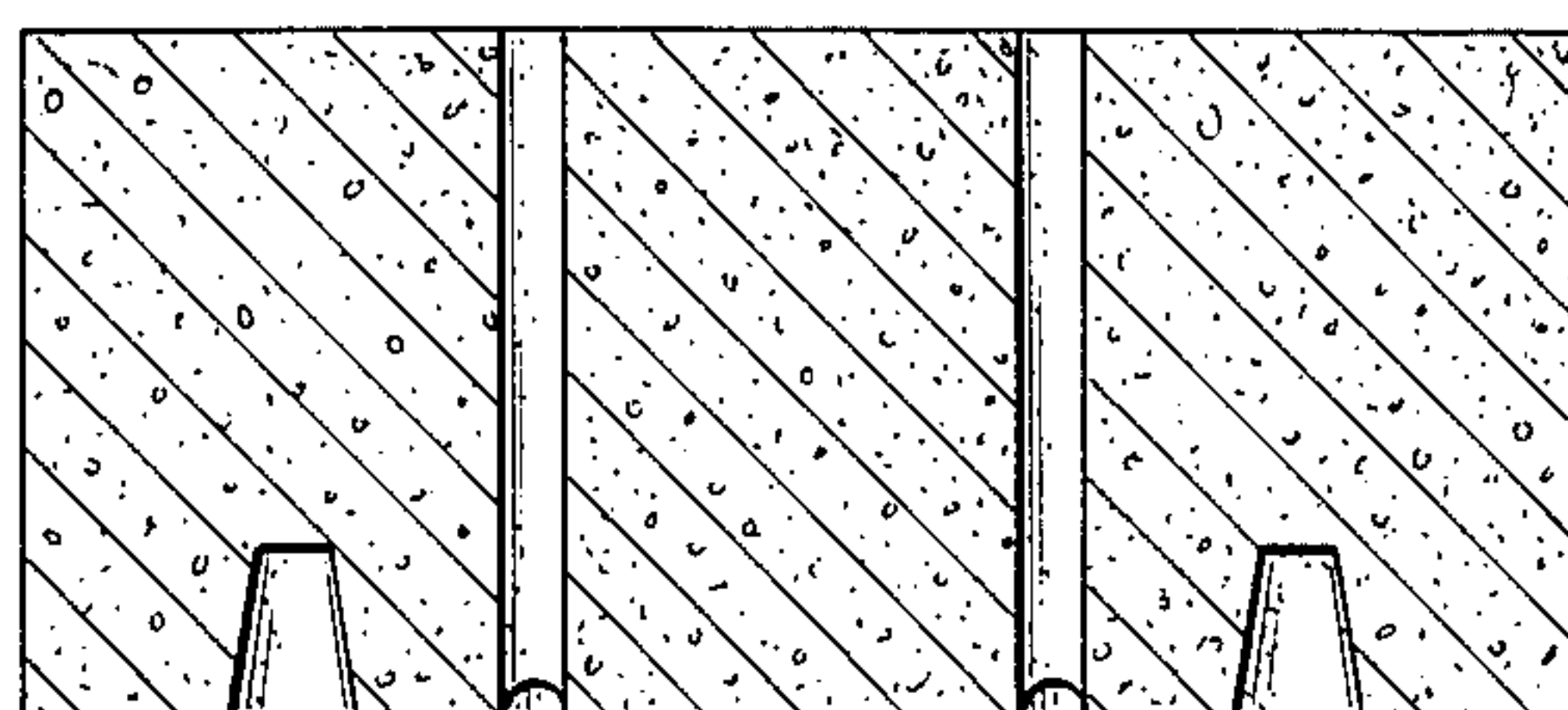
