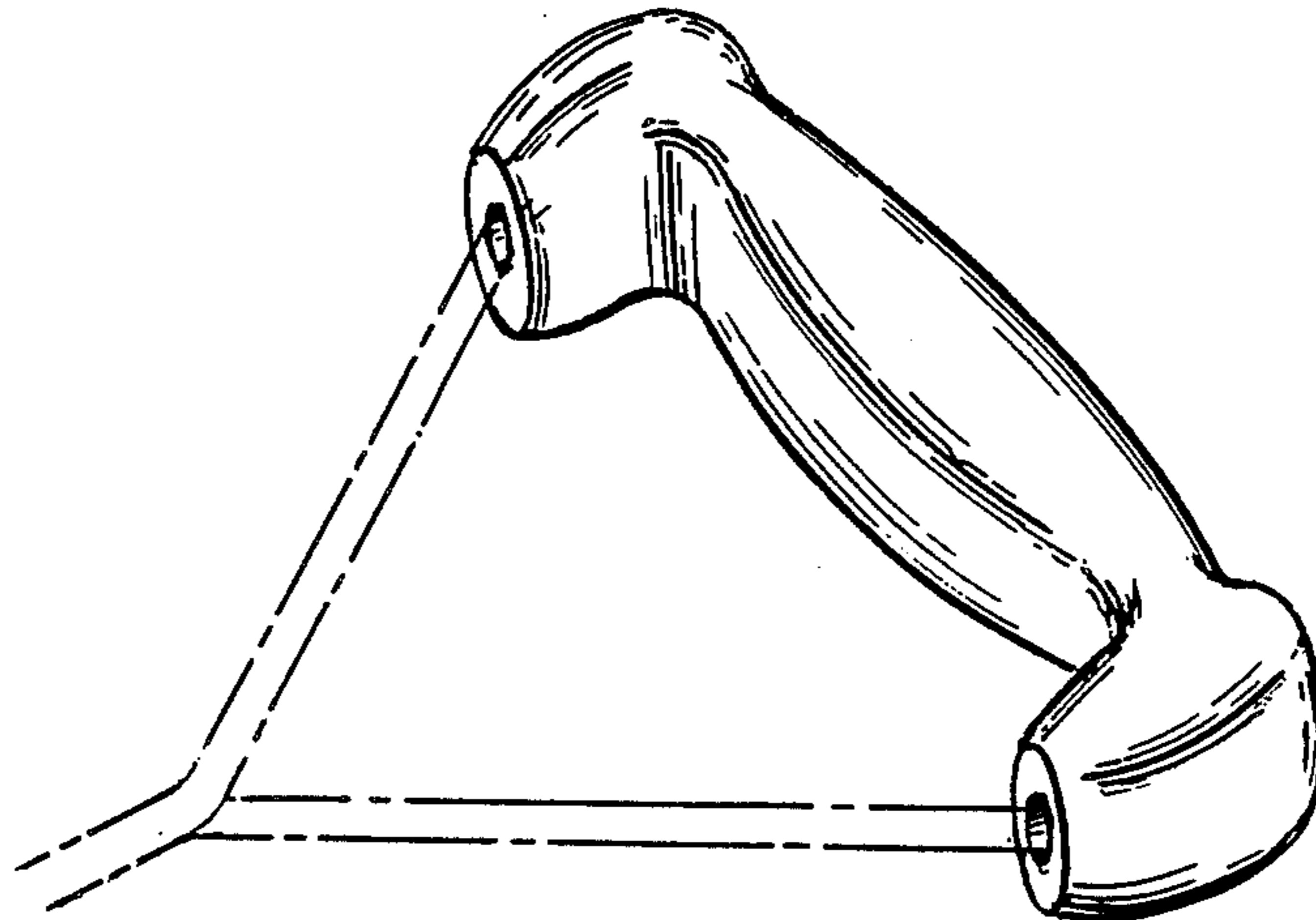

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a leash handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leash handle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of one end thereof, the opposite end being the same as the end shown.
The broken-line showing of a leash in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.



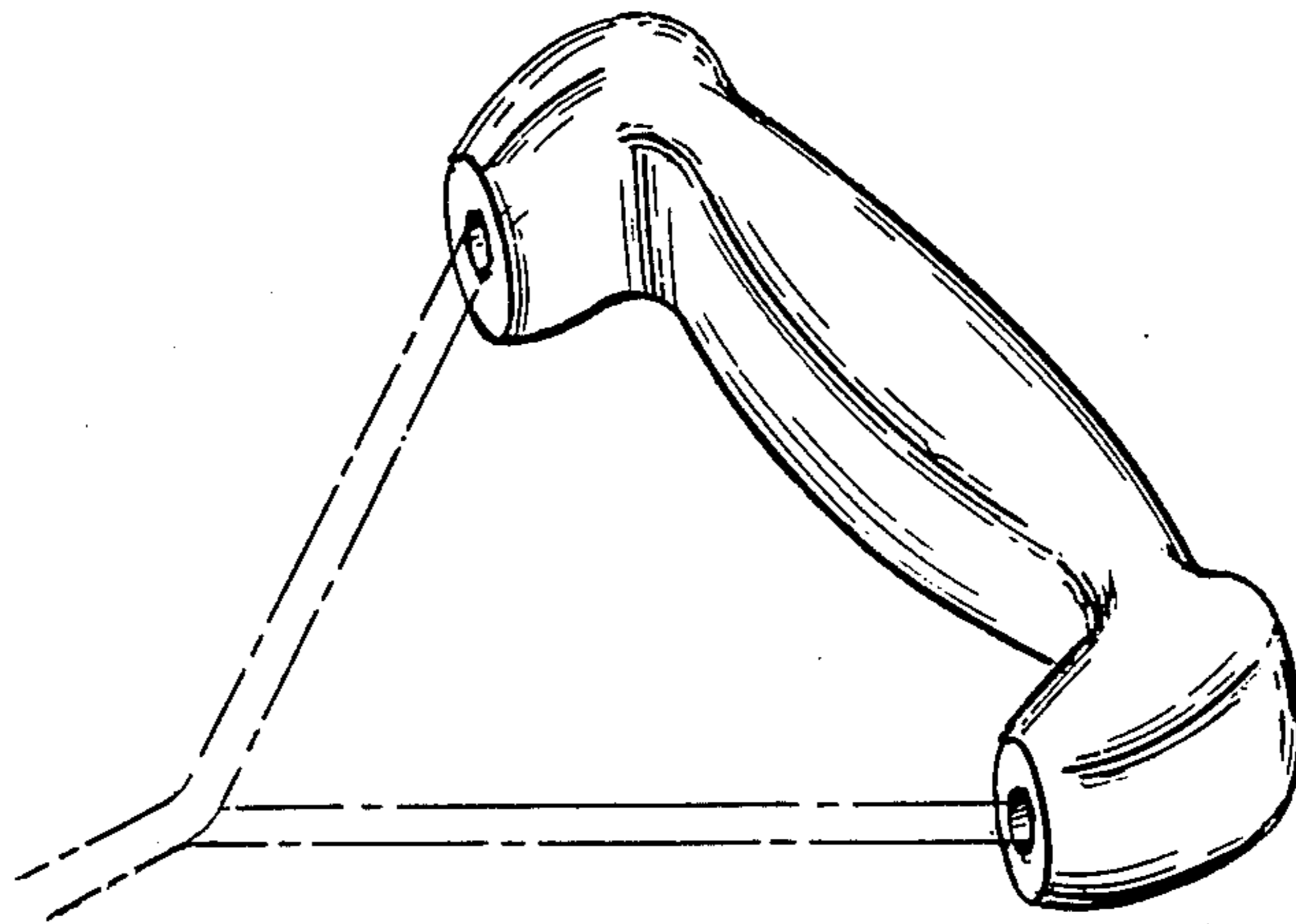

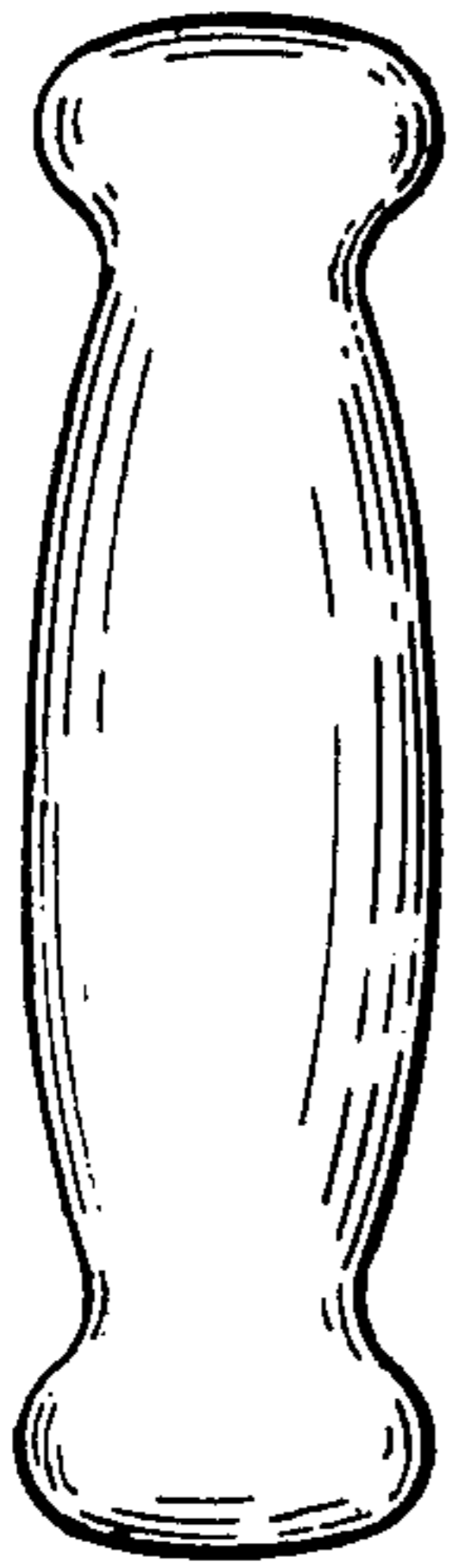

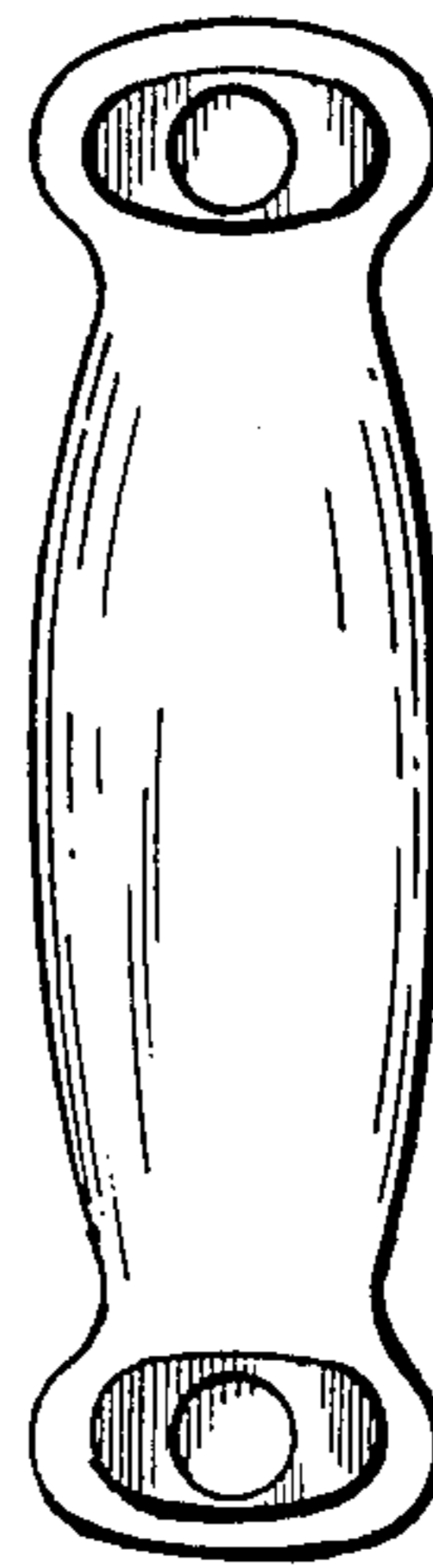

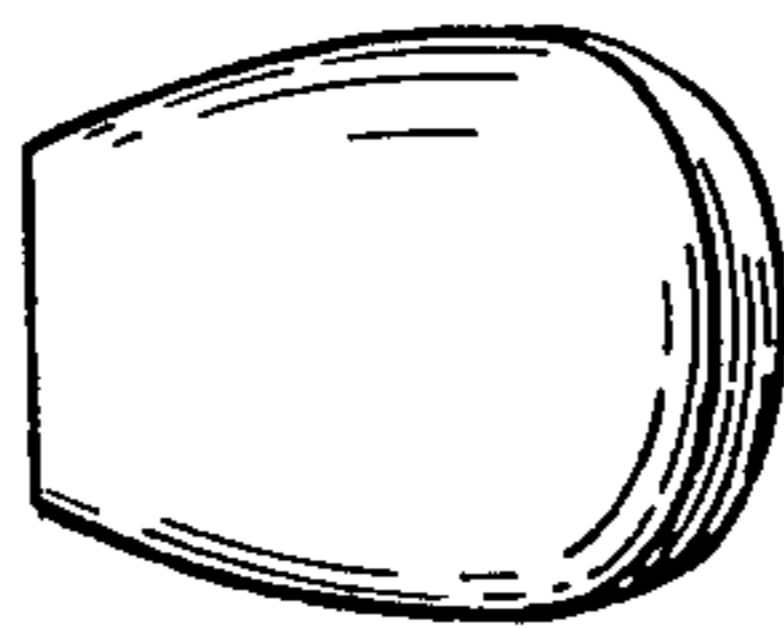
