The ornamental design for a wrist mounted holder for pins and other metal objects, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a wrist mounted holder for pins and other metal objects showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

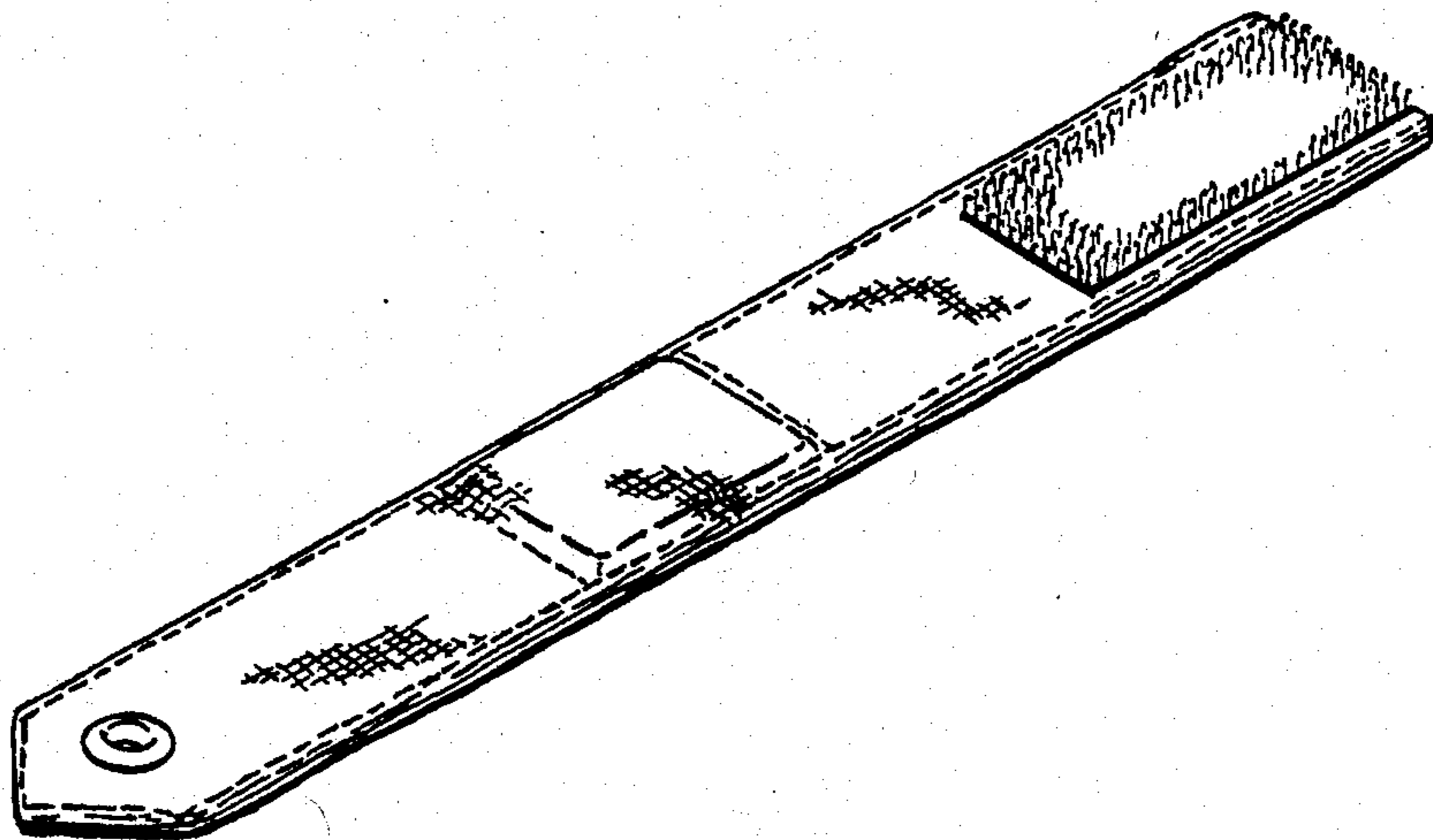

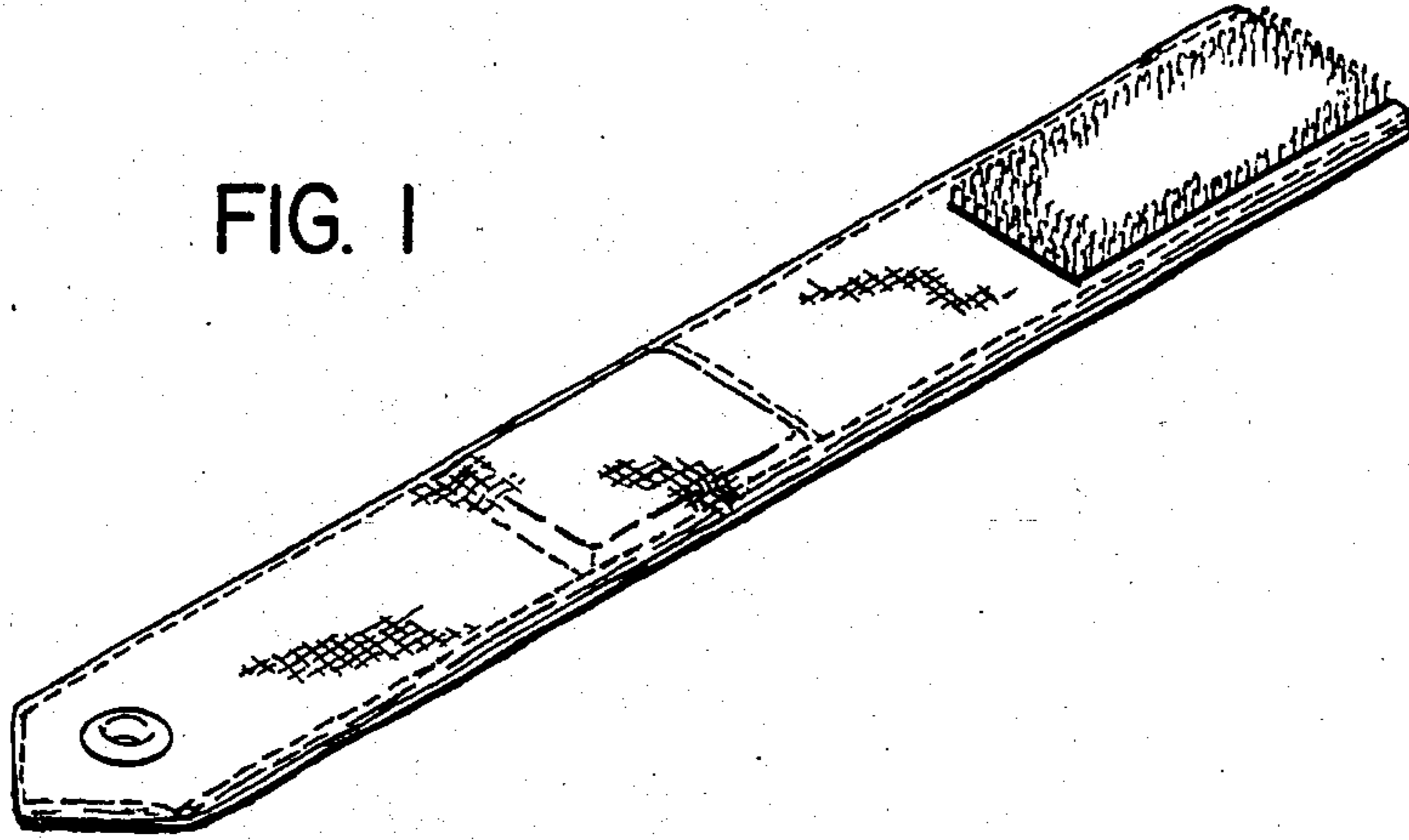

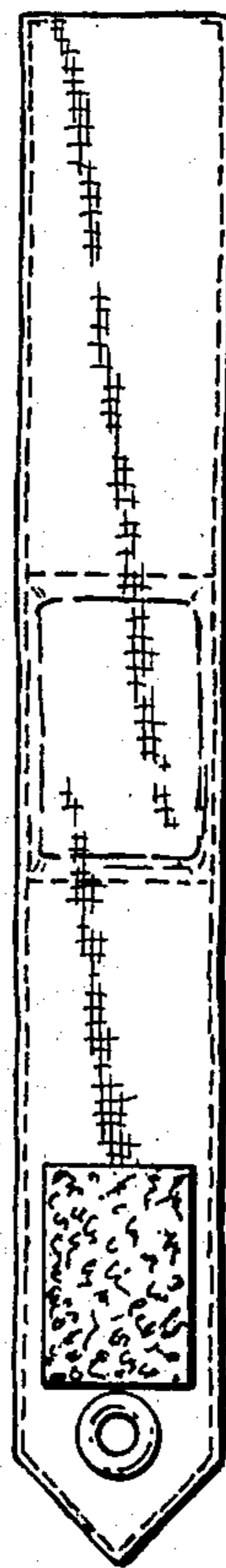
