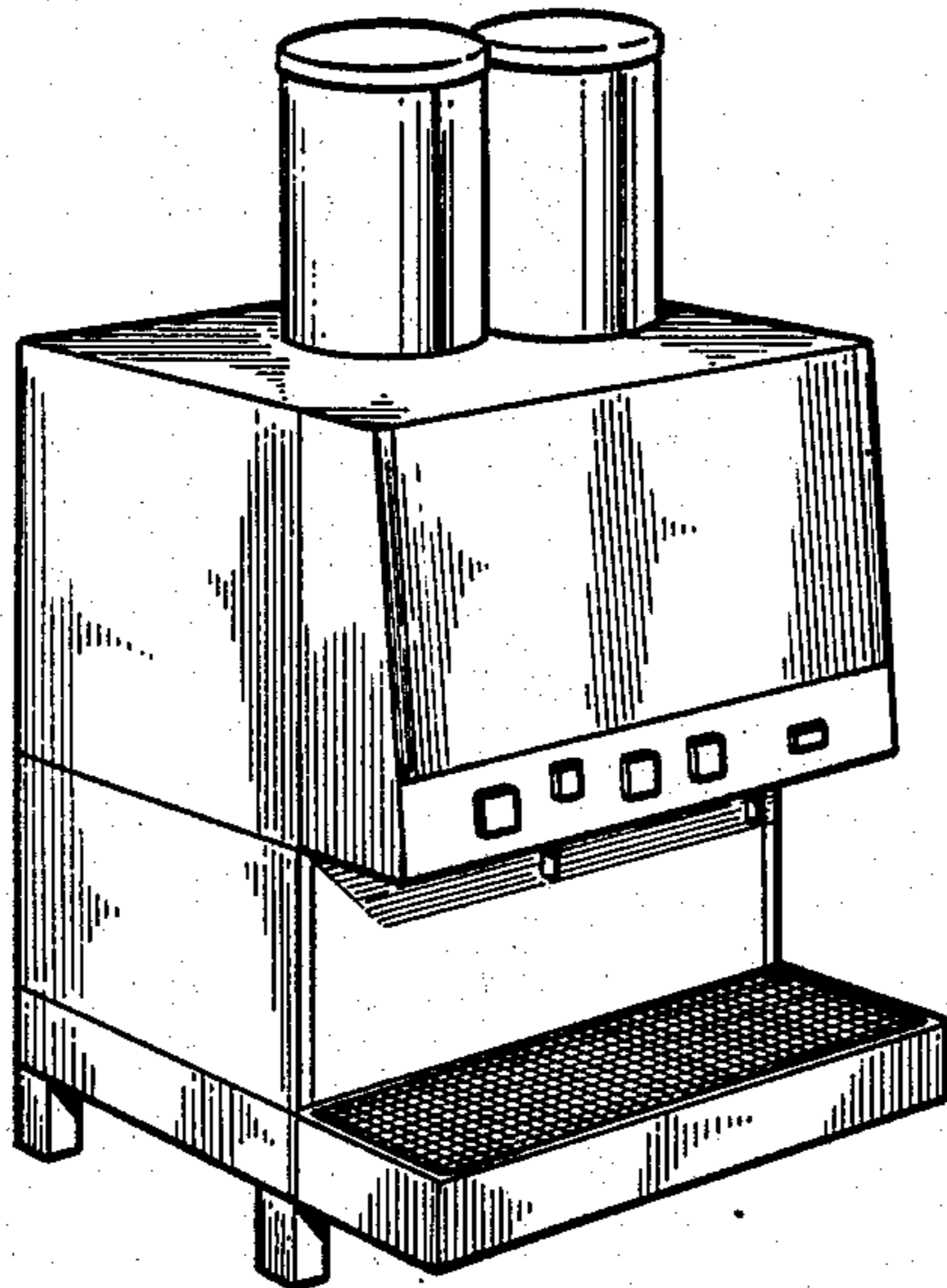

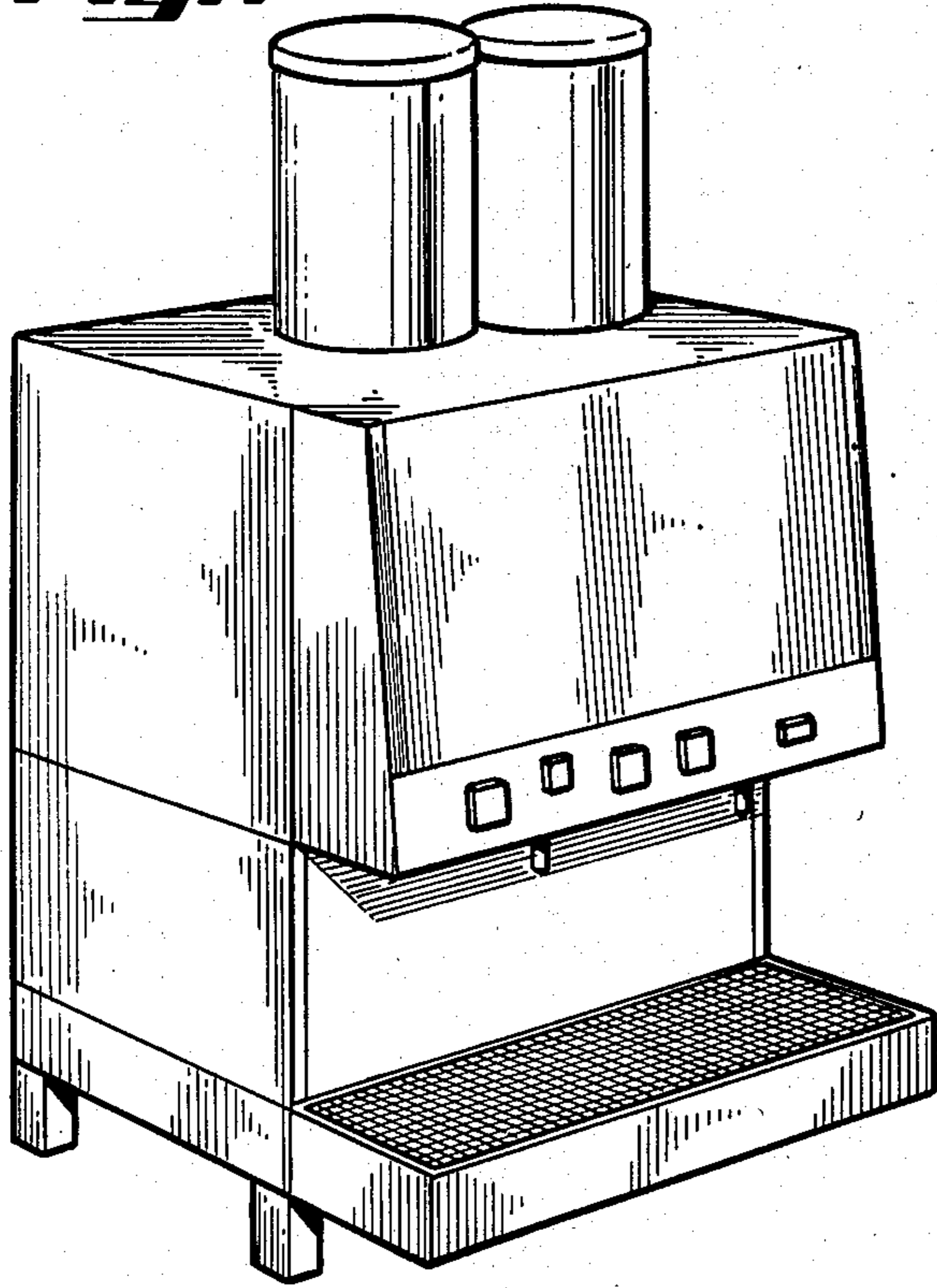
The ornamental design for a coffee machine, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

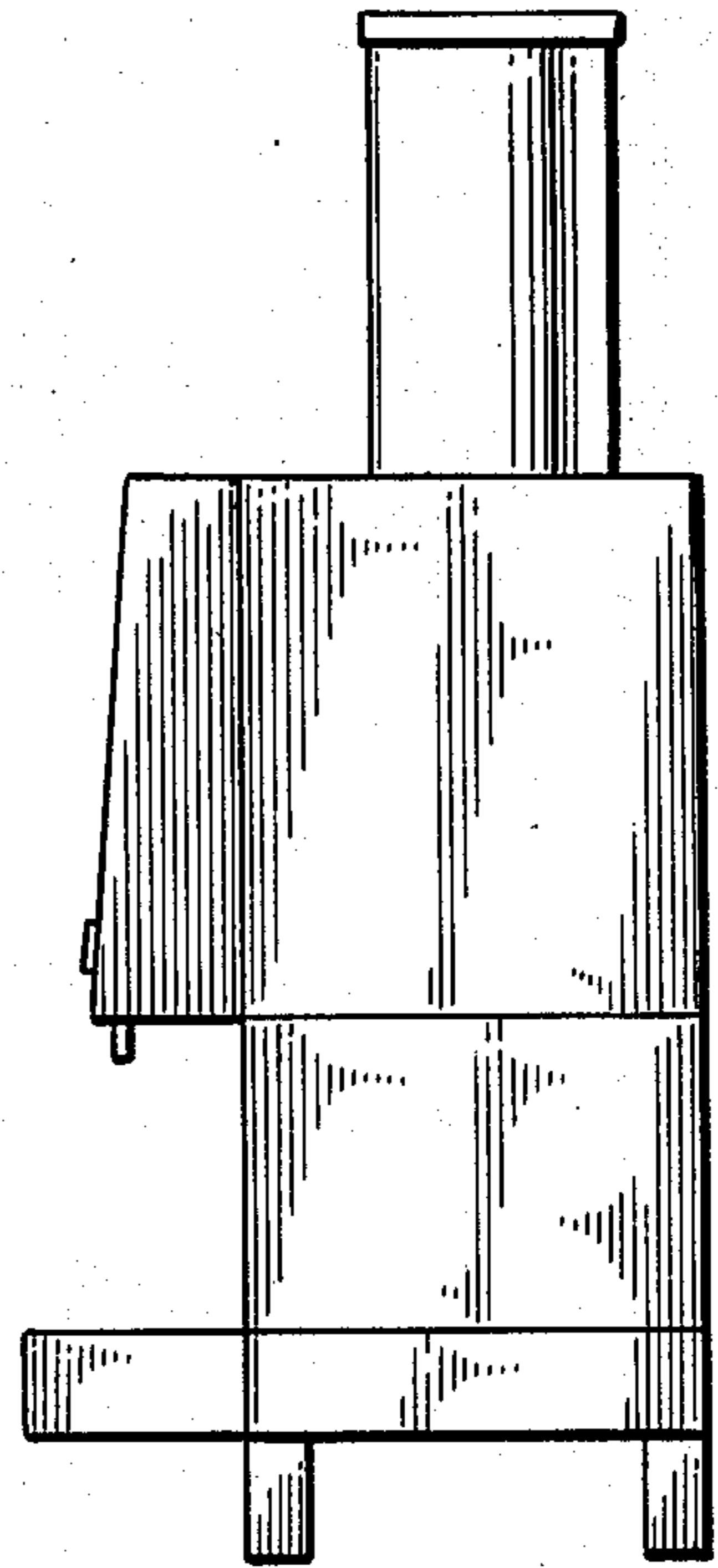
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a coffee machine showing my new design;

The undisclosed rear of the coffee machine is conventional in appearance.



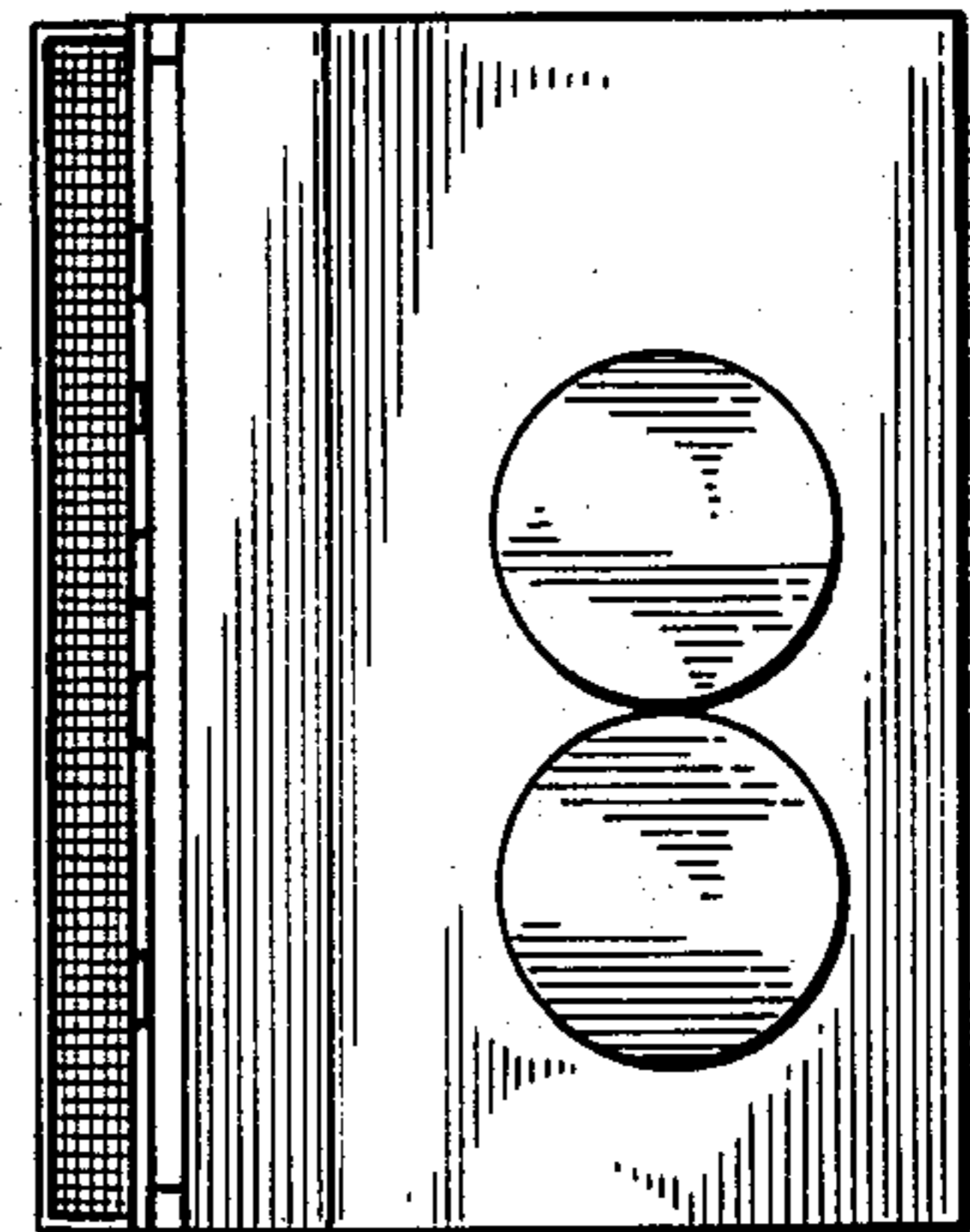
