FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom view thereof;

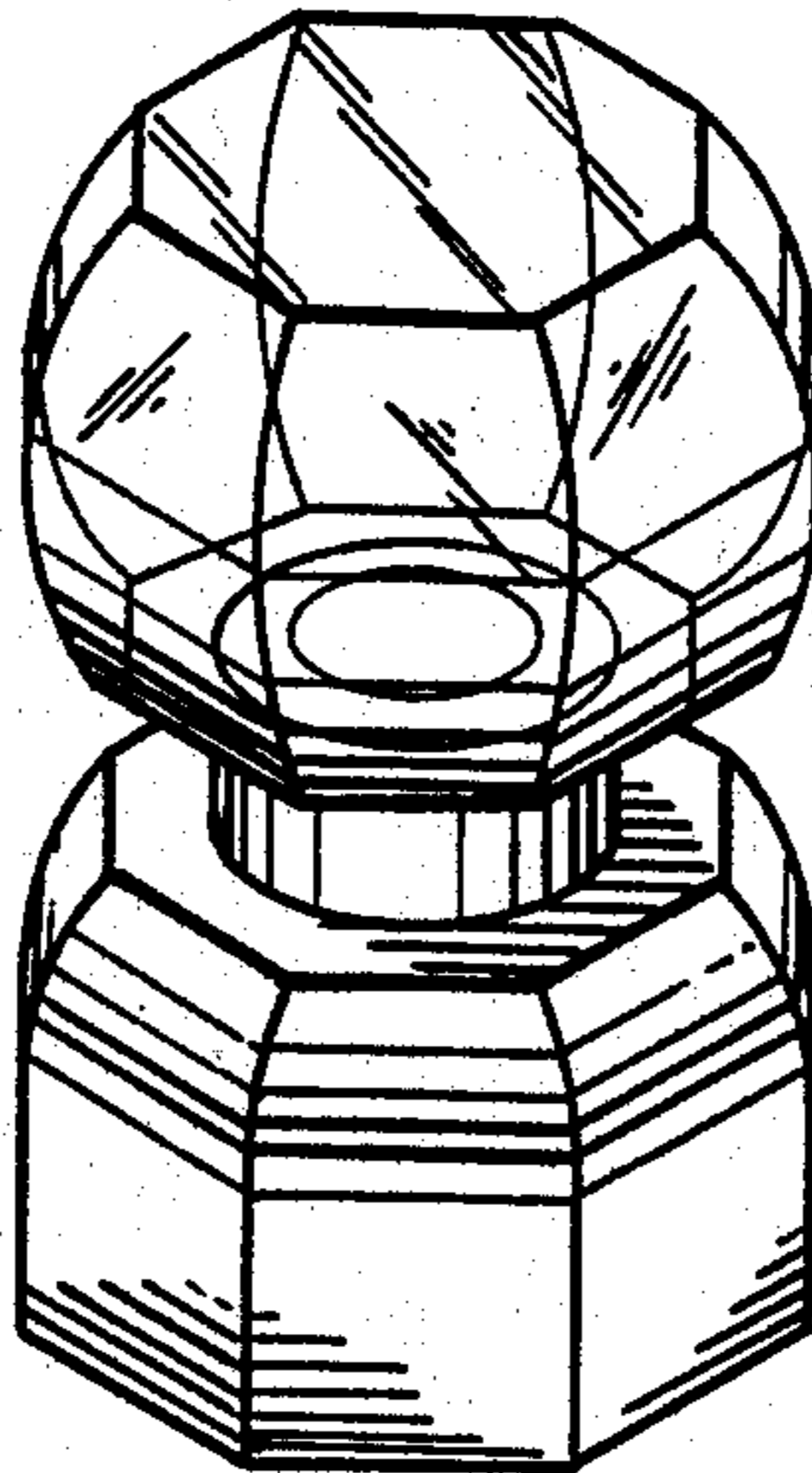

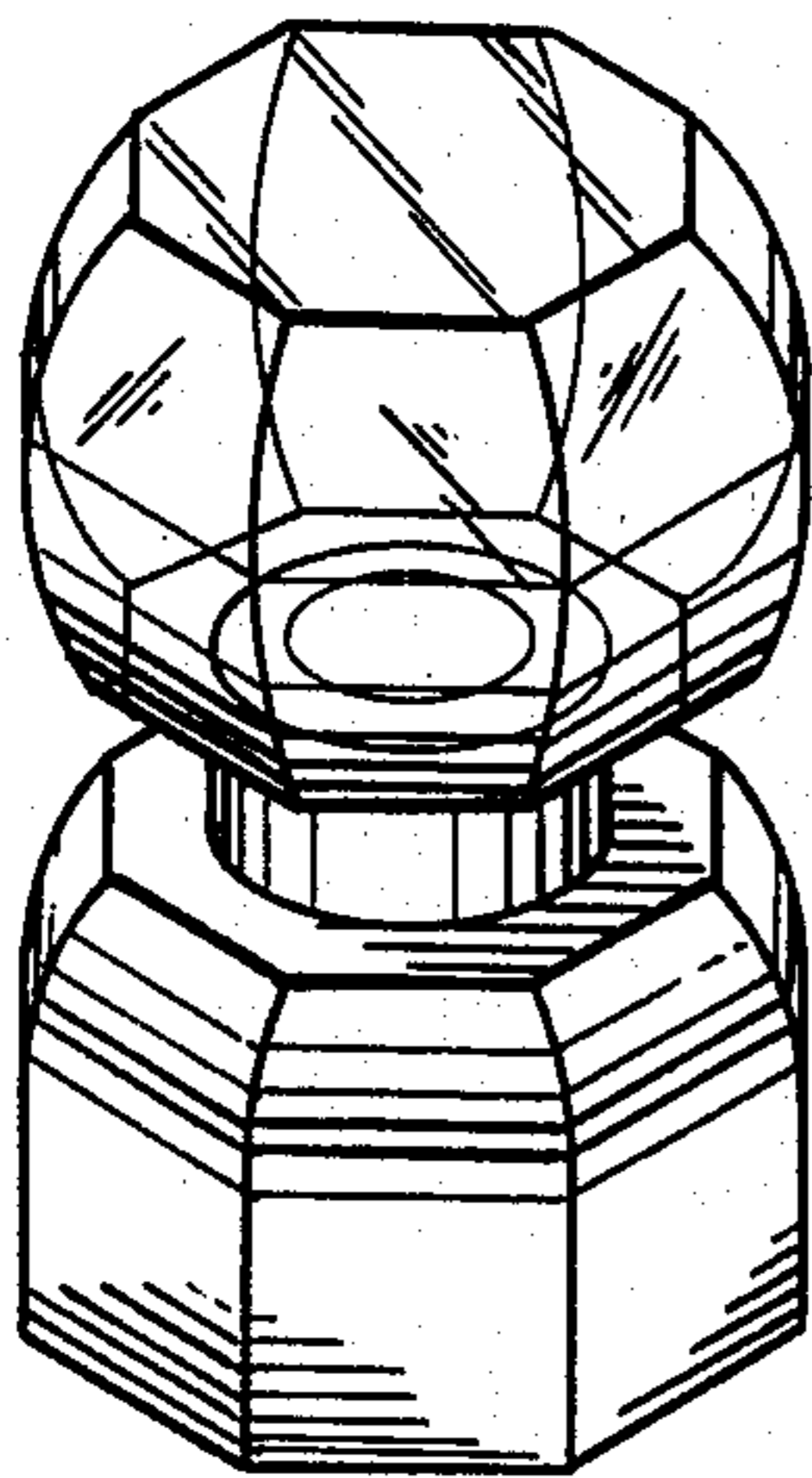

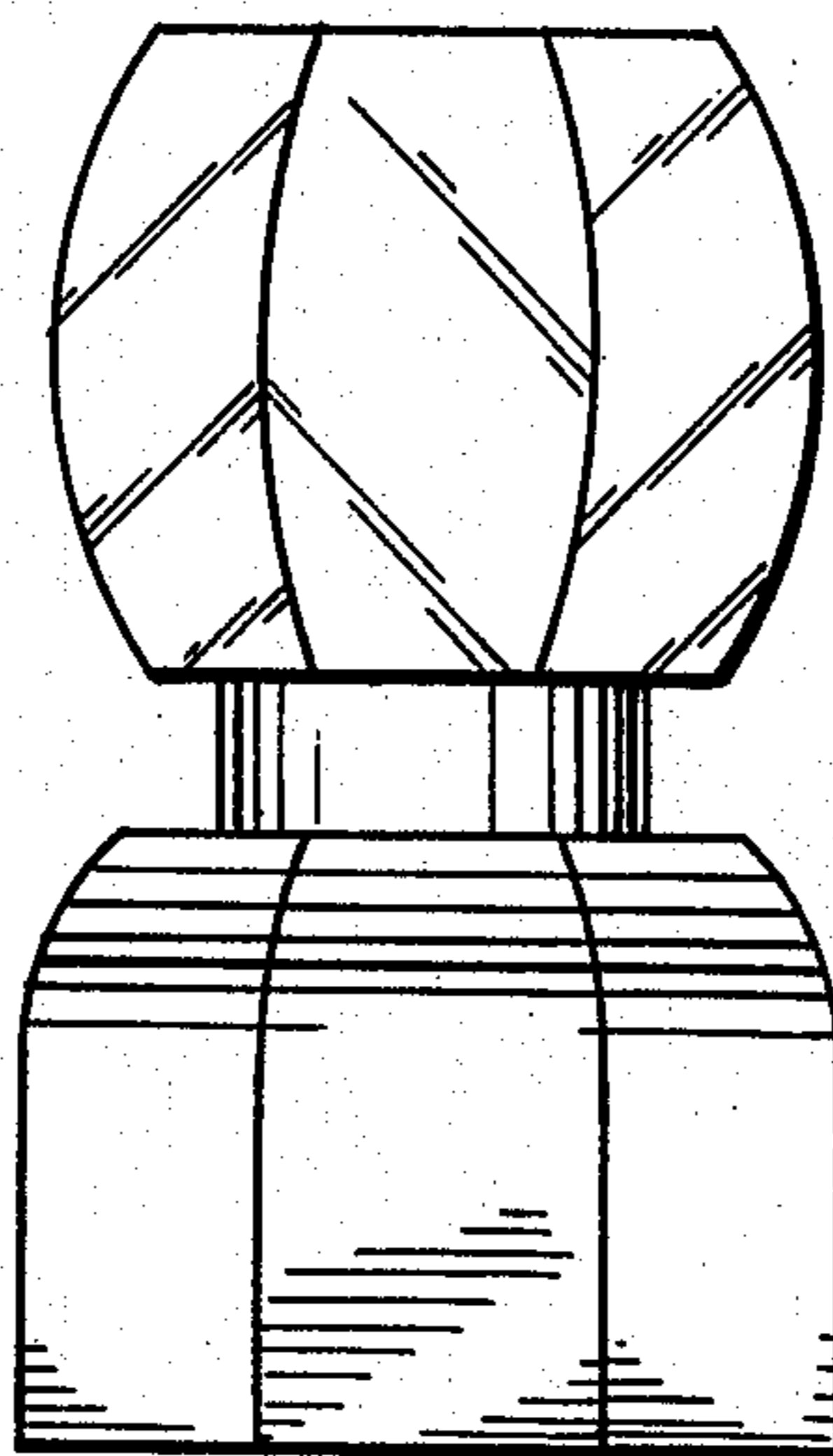

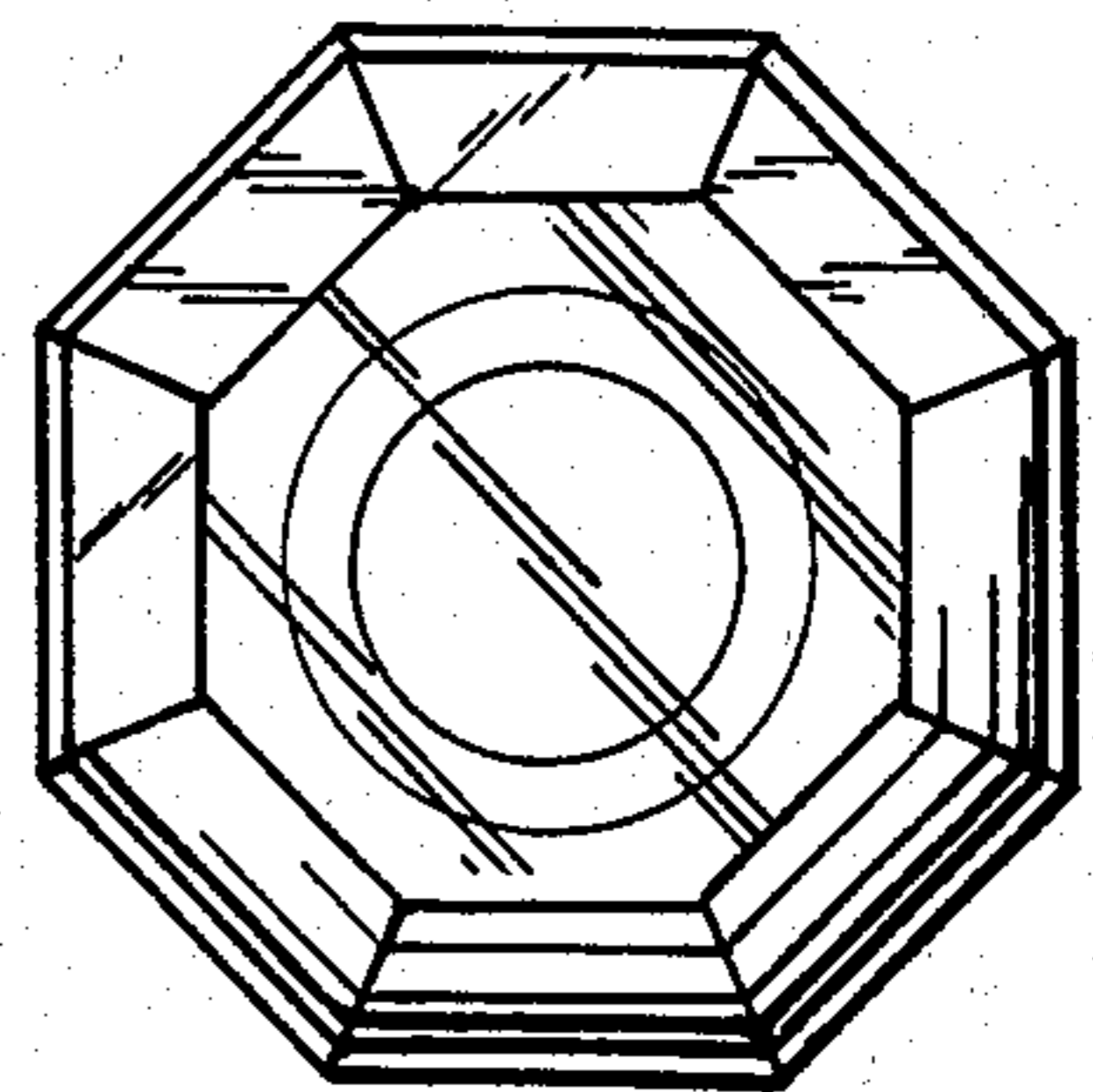
