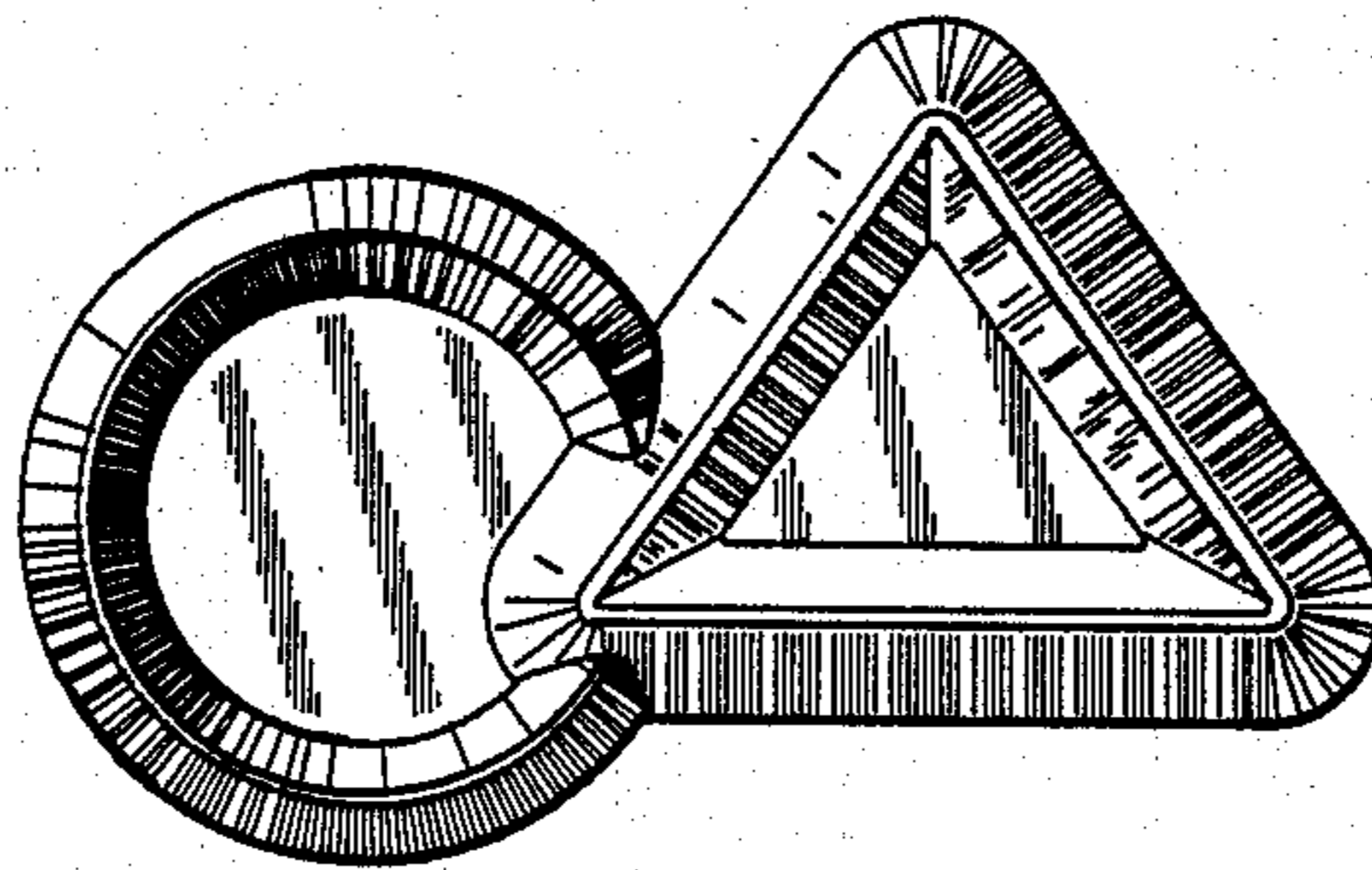
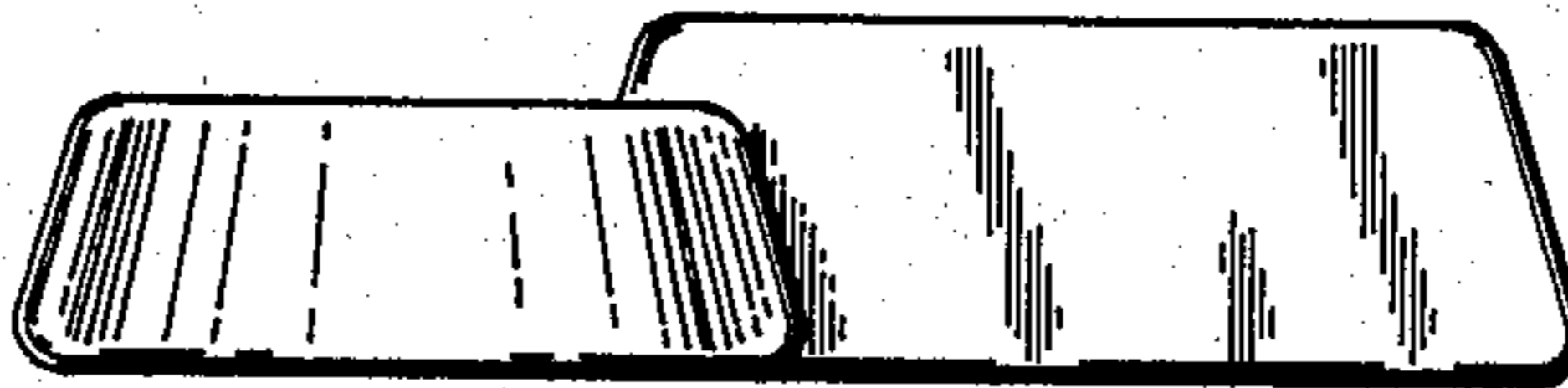

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pet dish, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



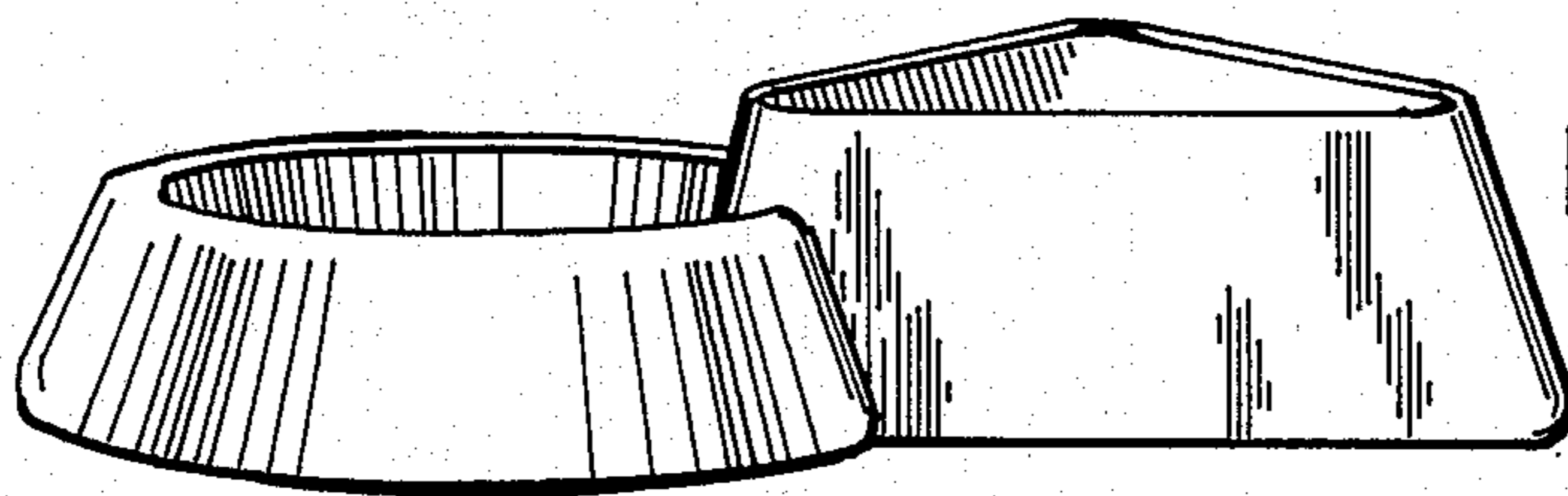

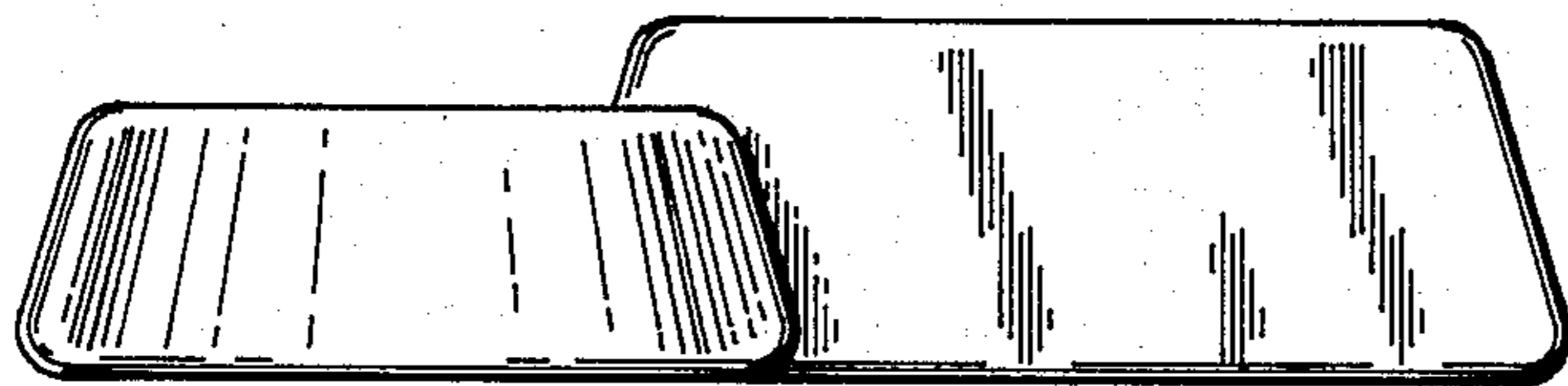

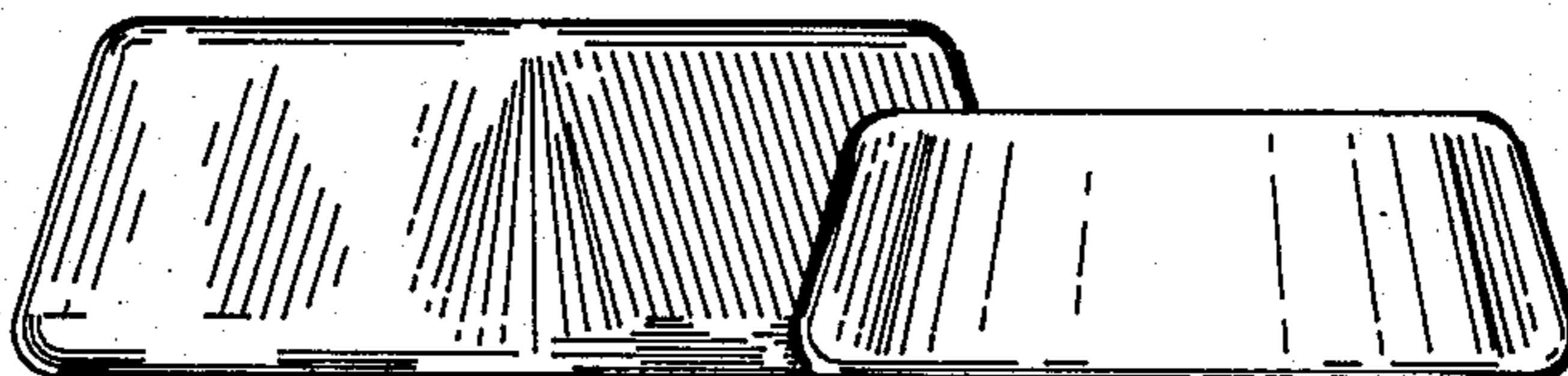

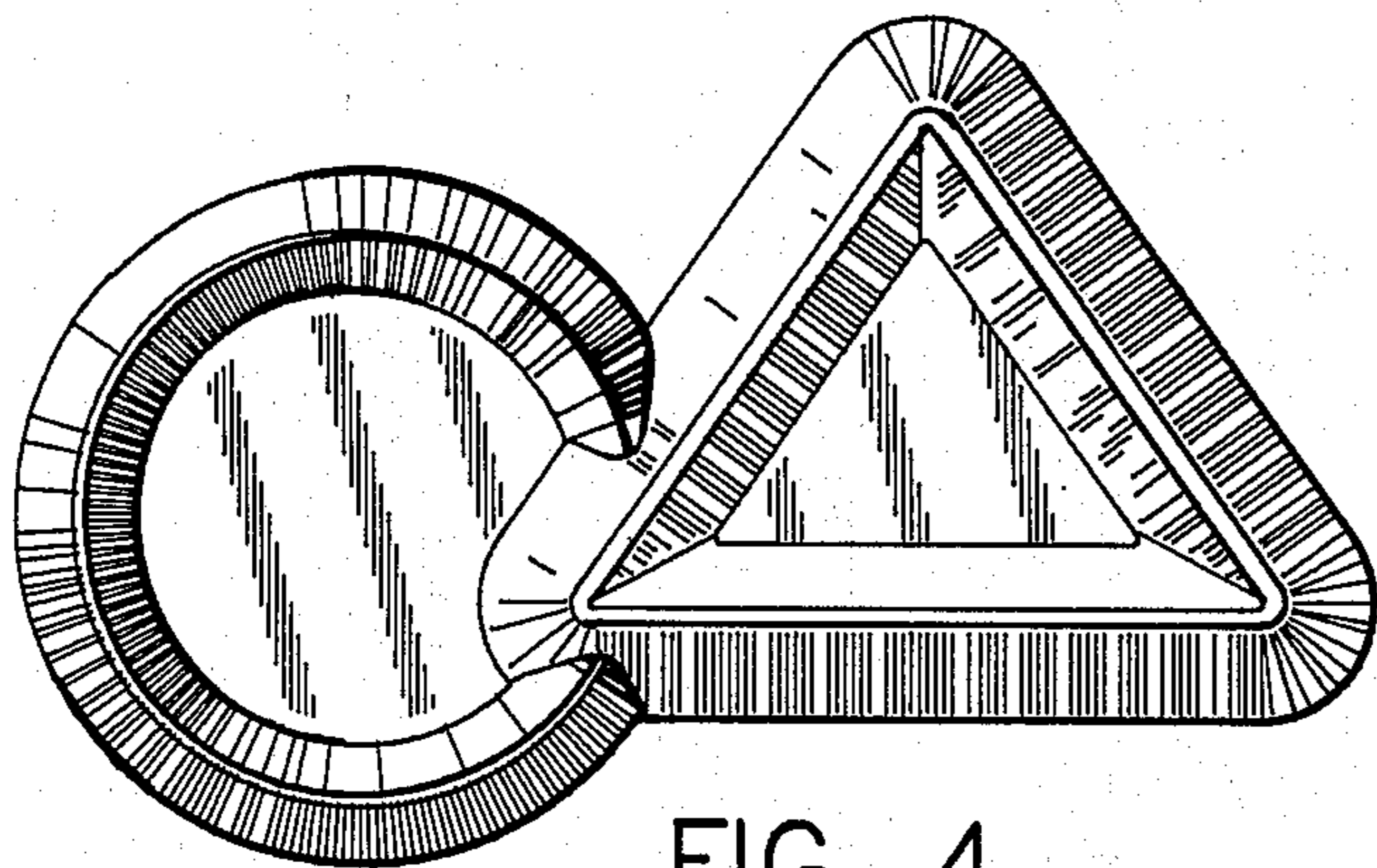

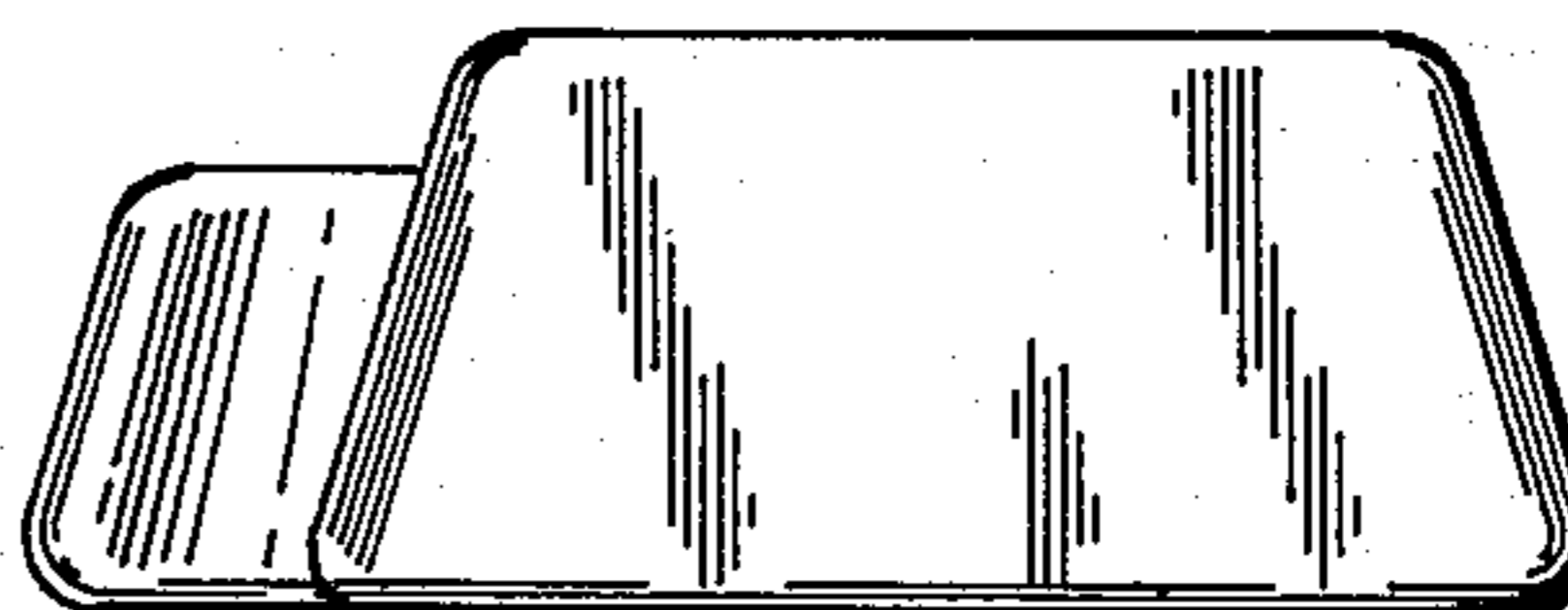

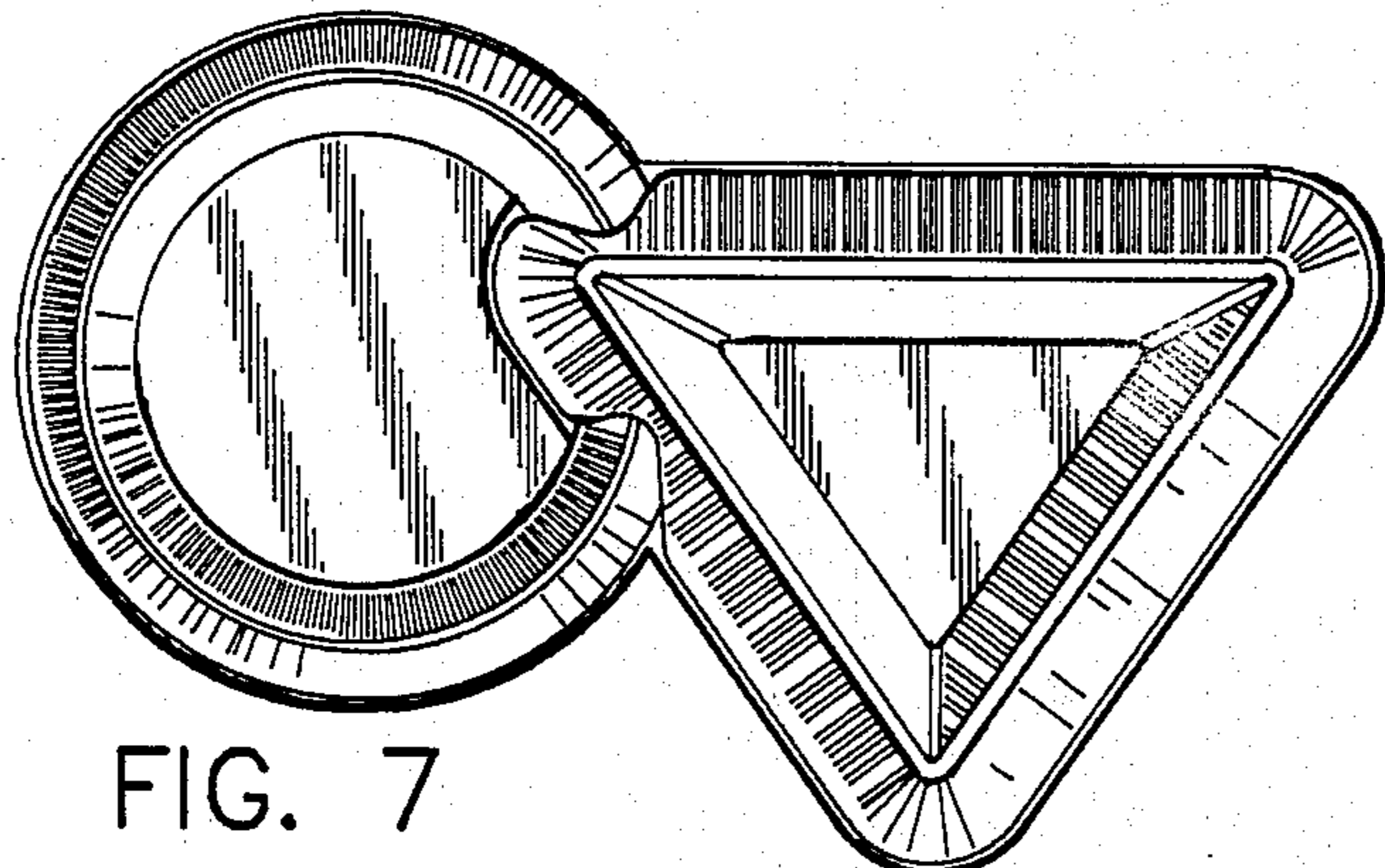

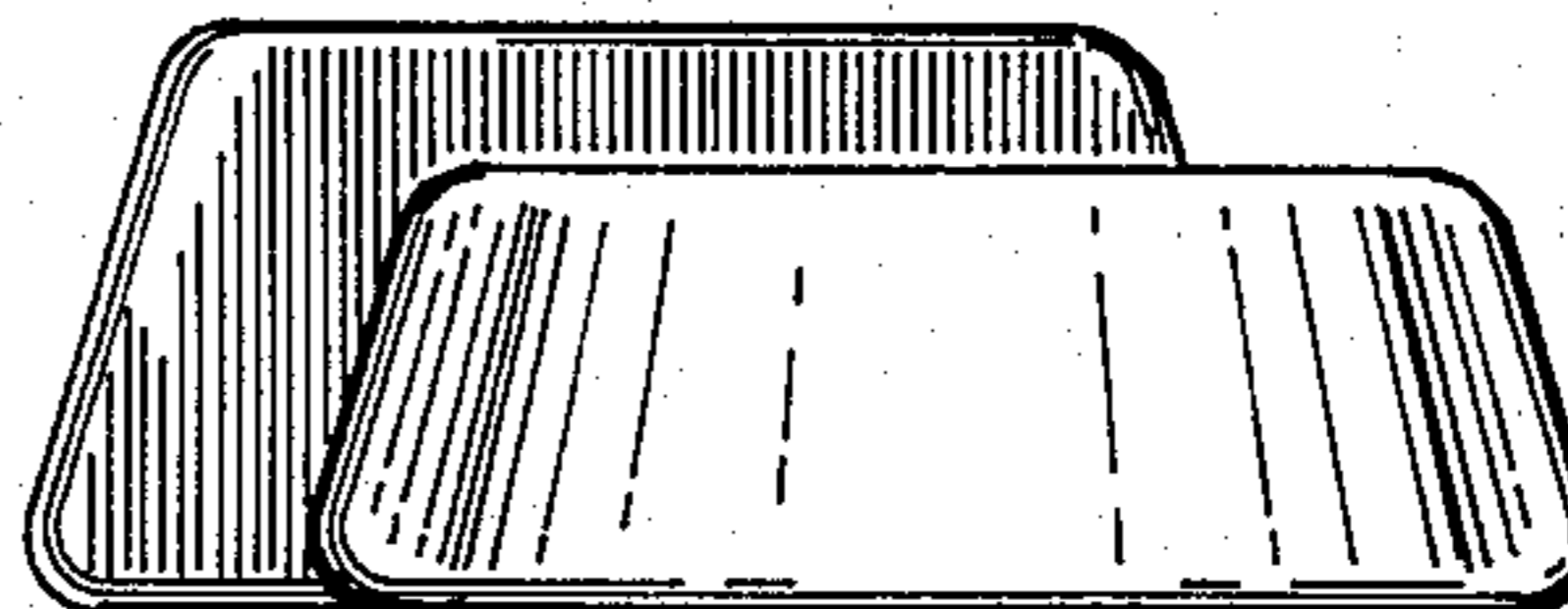
