[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a retractable animal leash, within a cylindrically-shaped housing for leash attachment as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a retractable animal leash showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The fragmentary broken line showing of a dog and a dog collar in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the elaimed design.

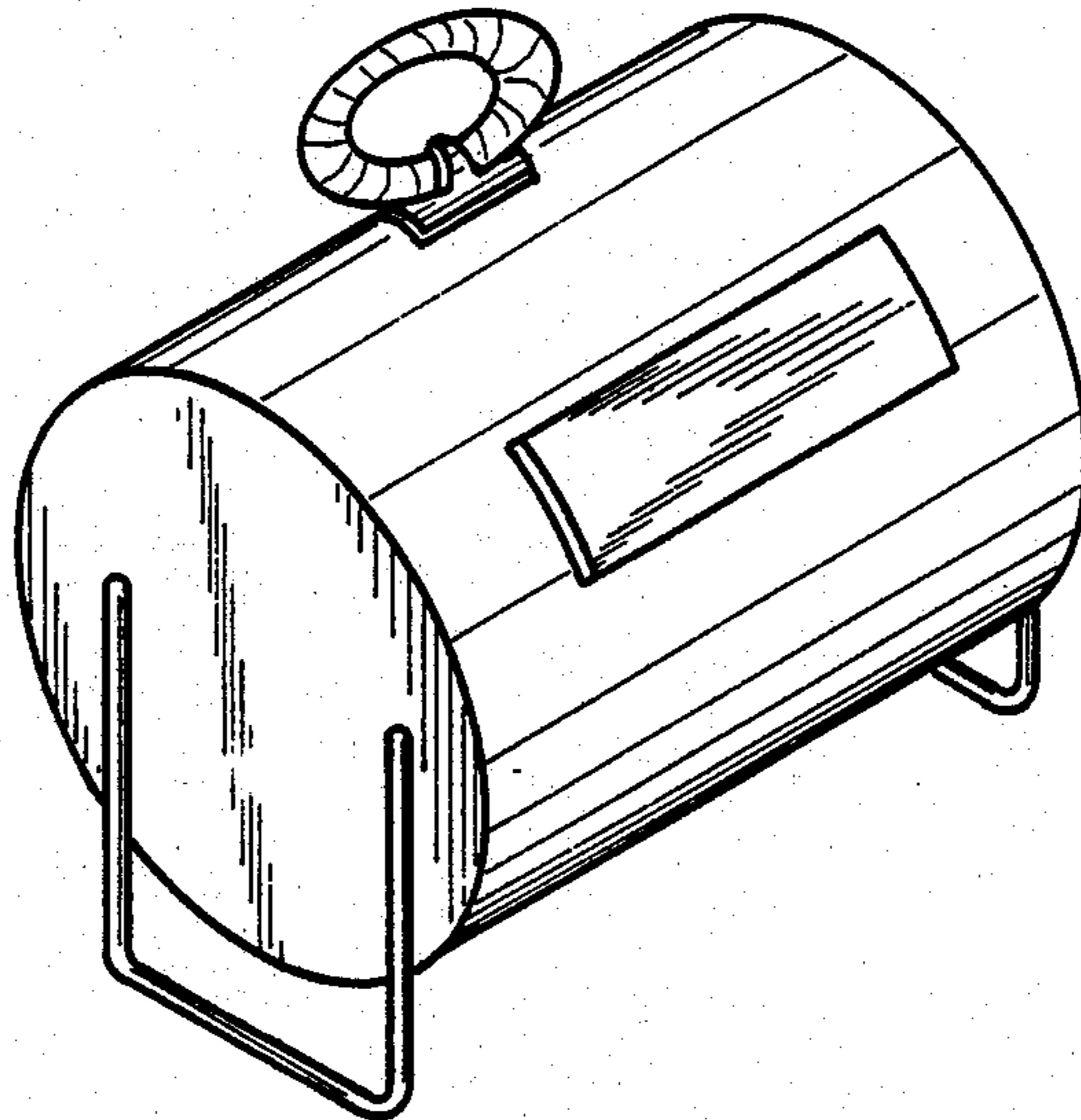

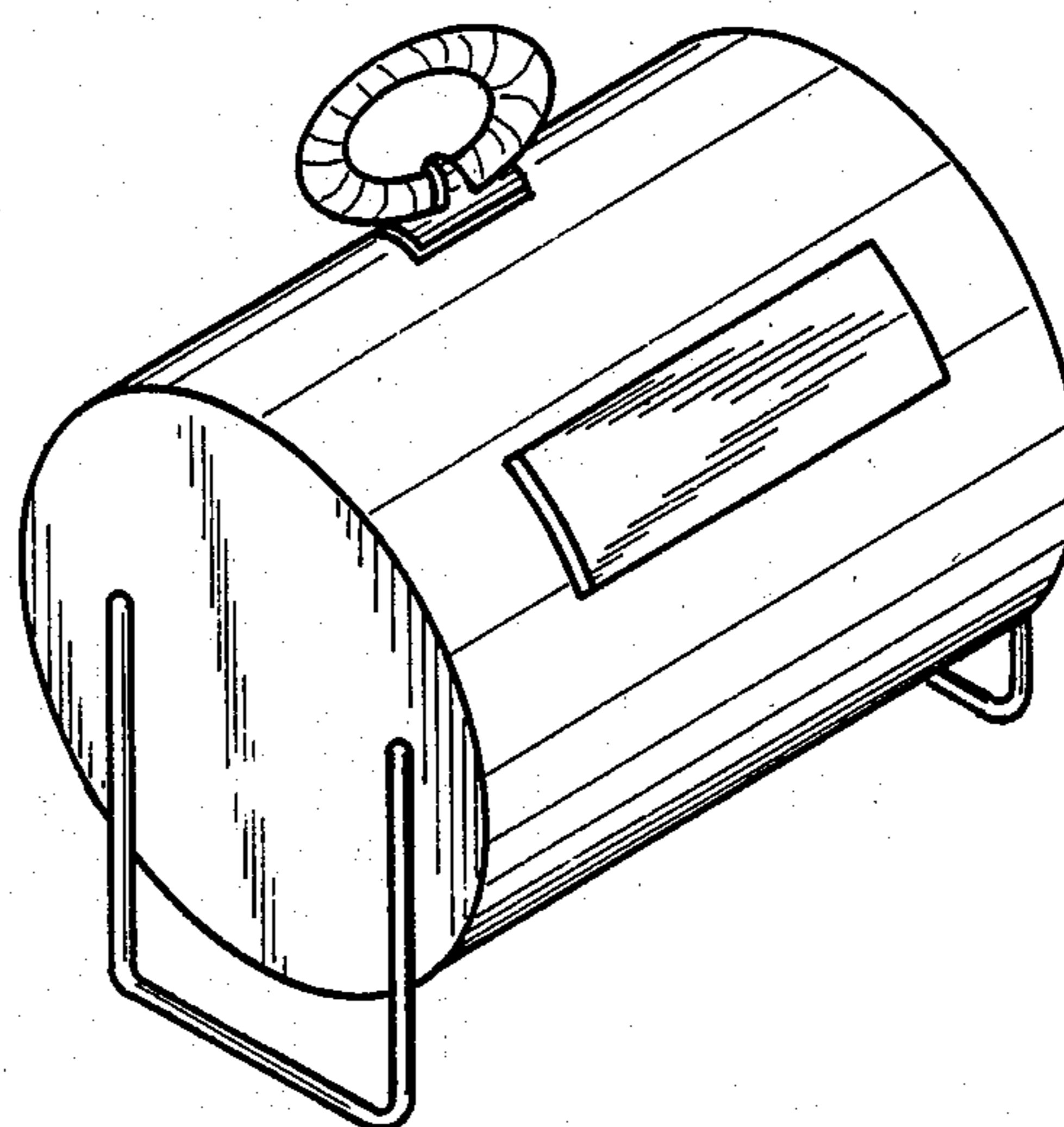
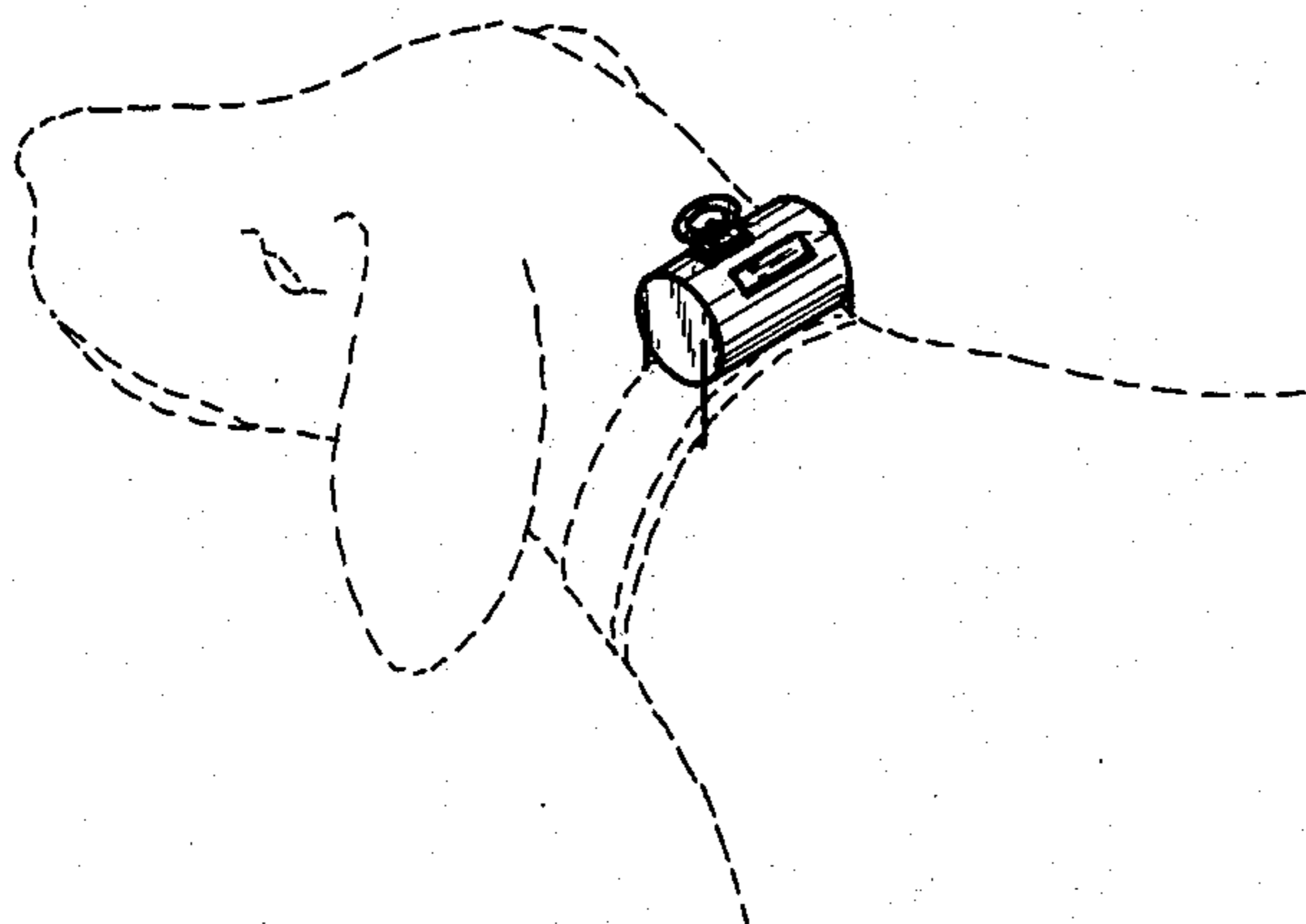

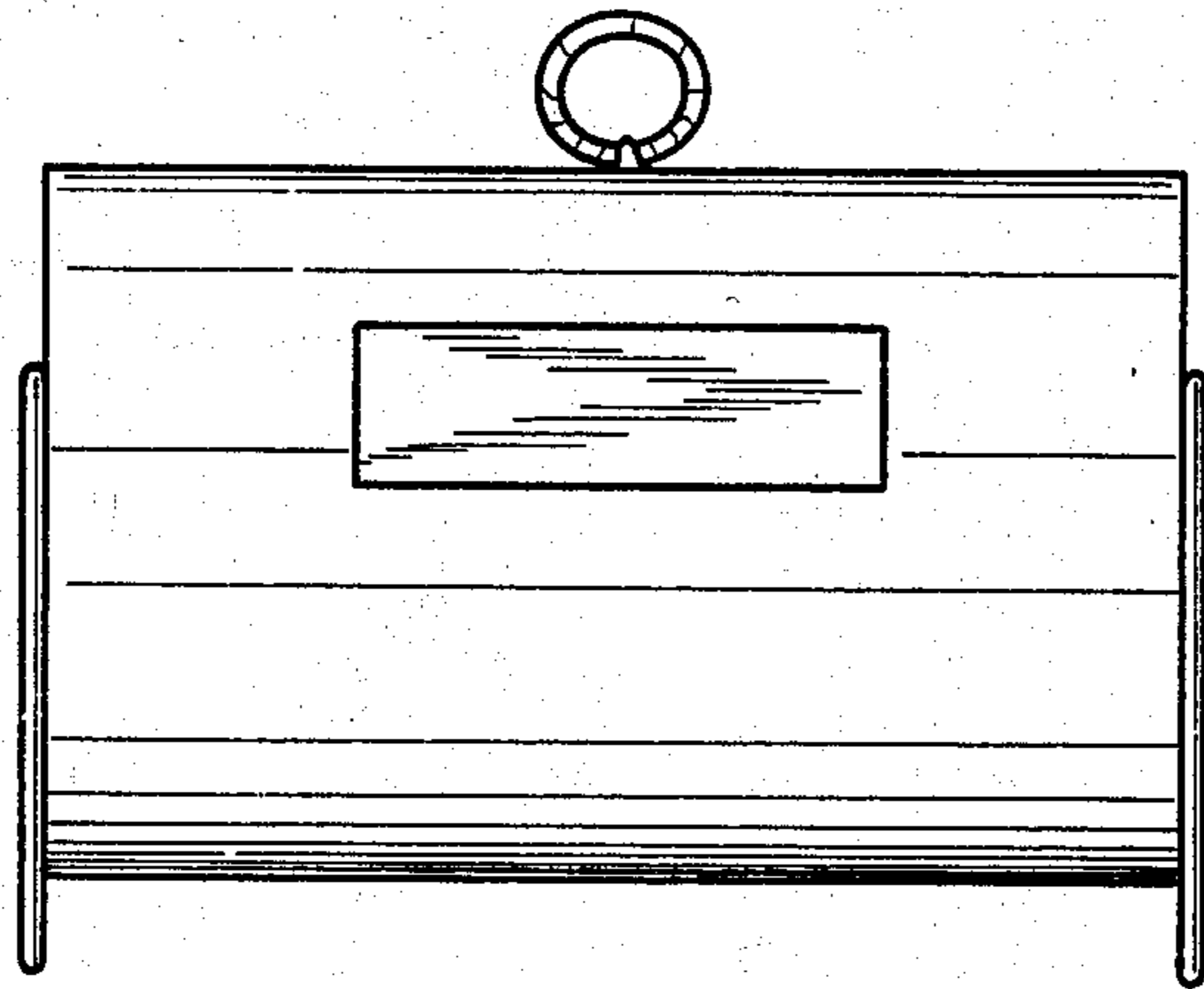

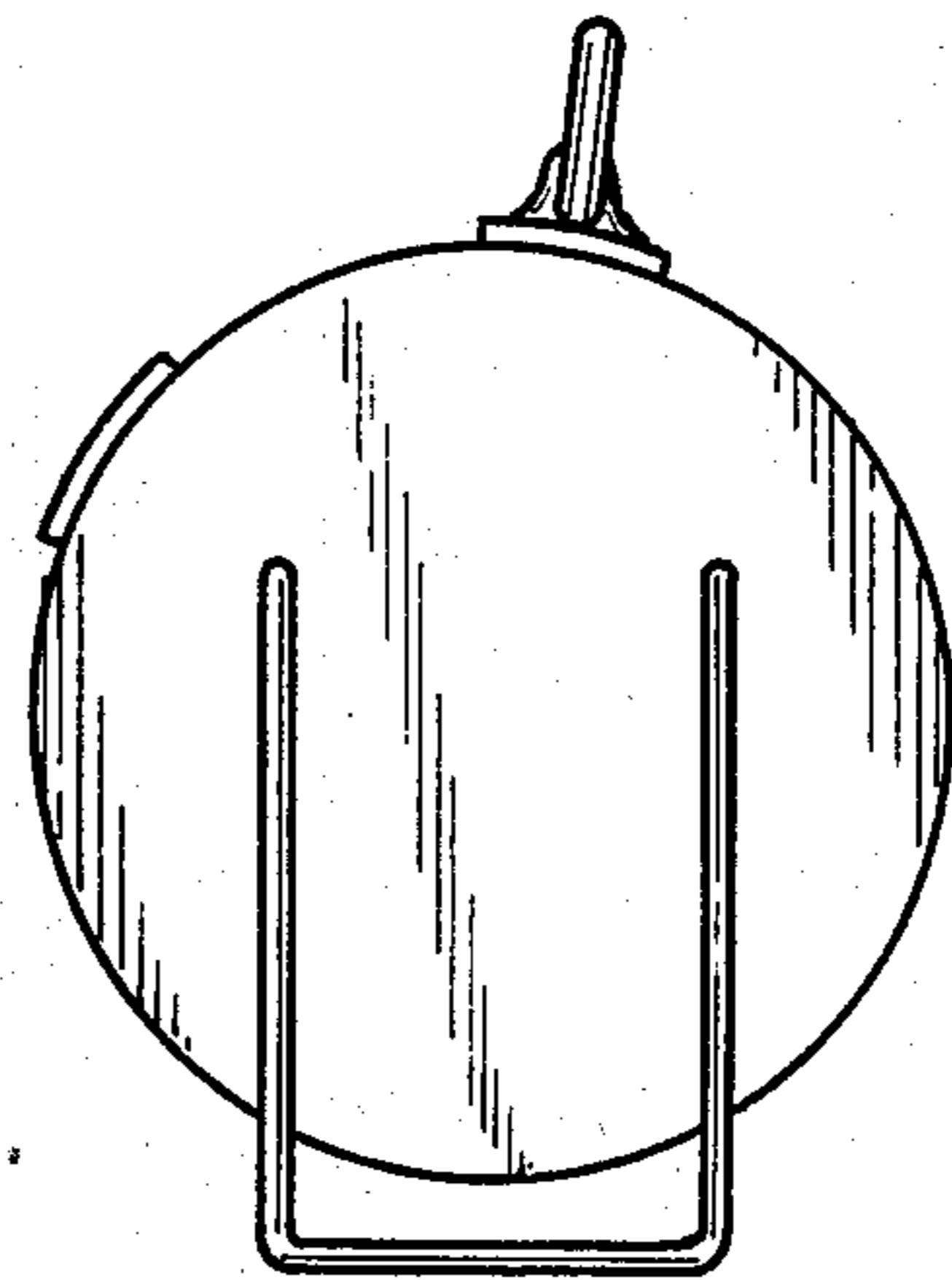

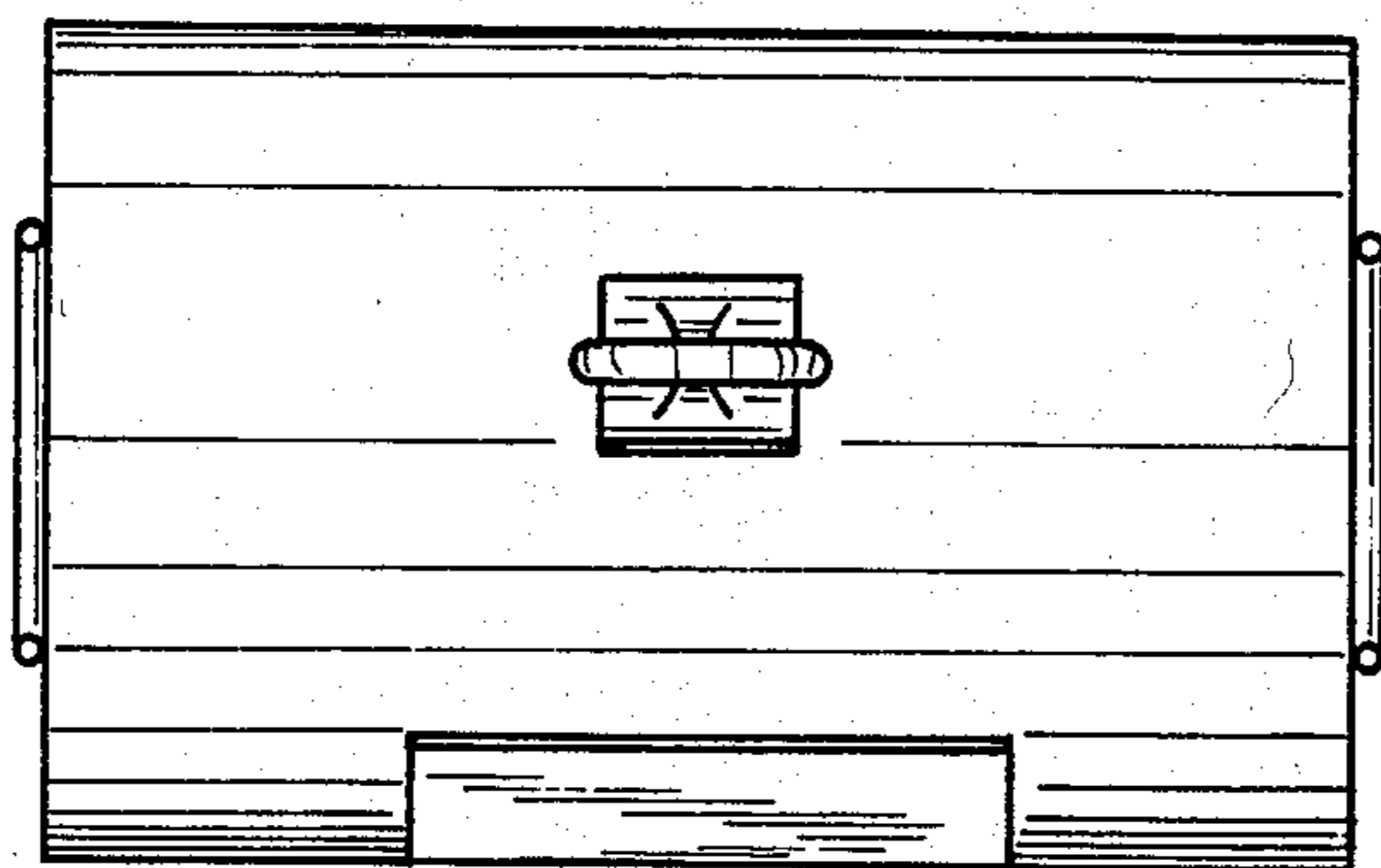

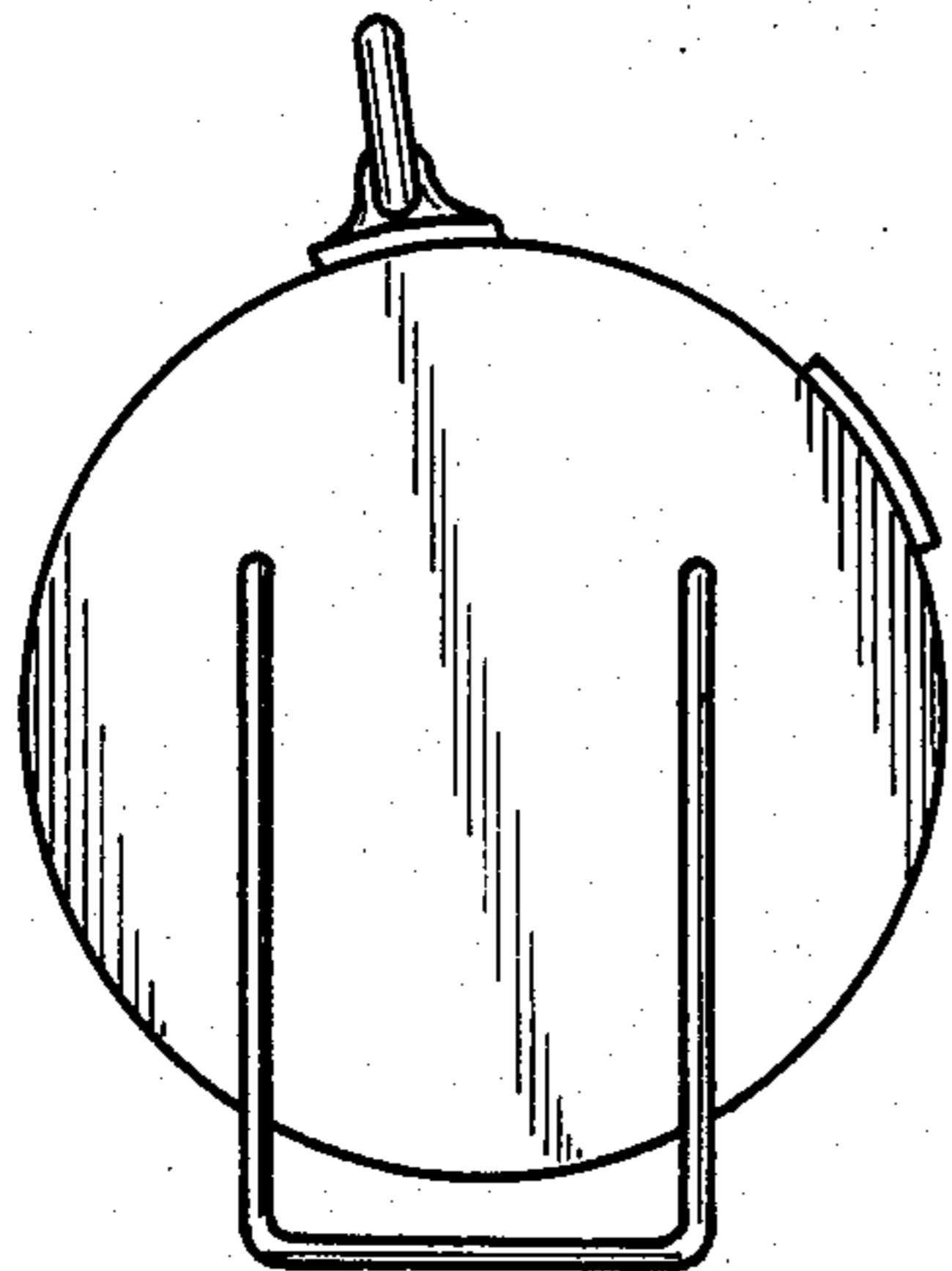
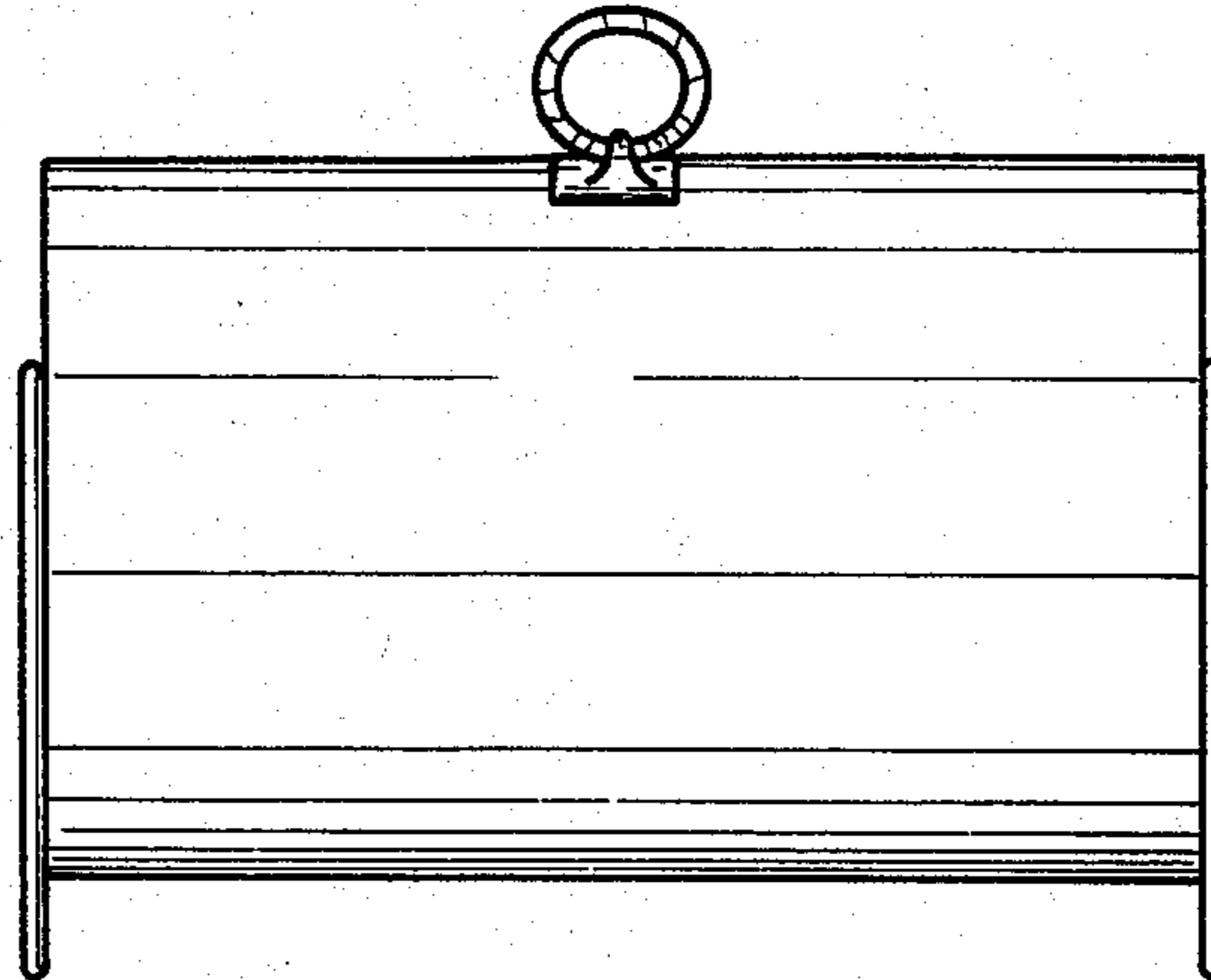
