DESCRIPTION

The card imprinter structure is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

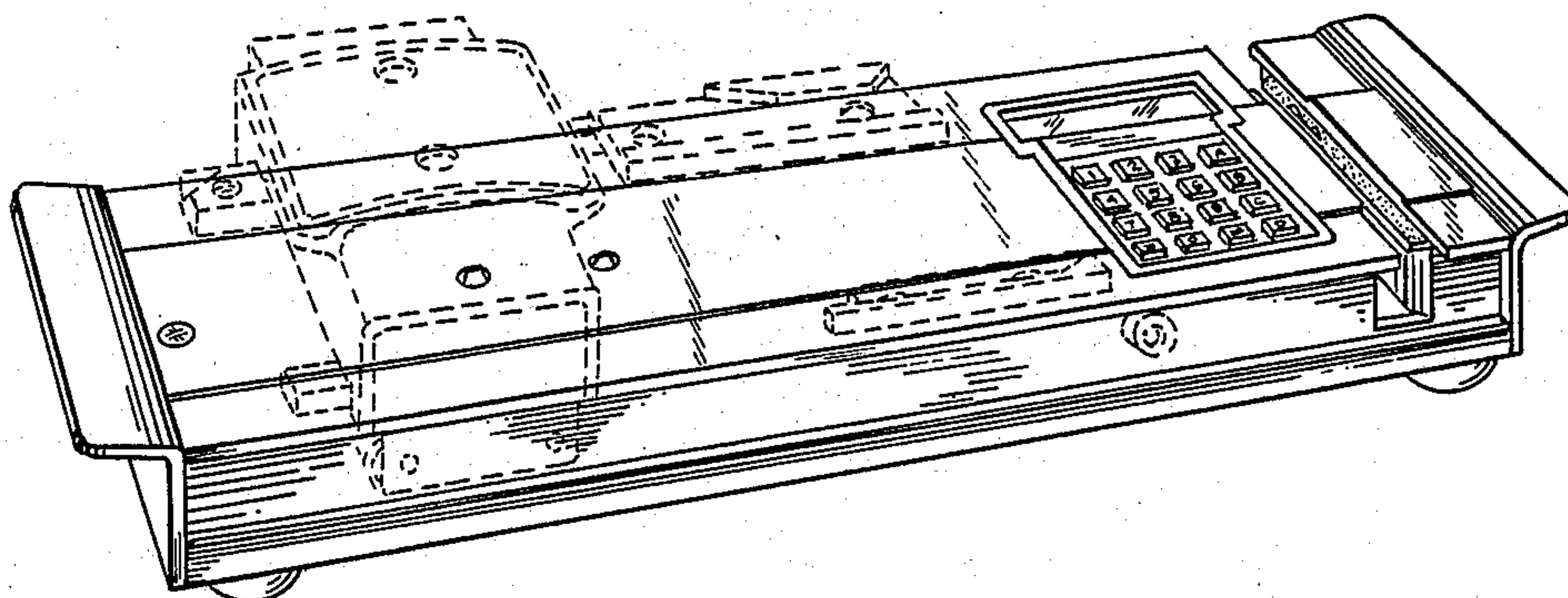

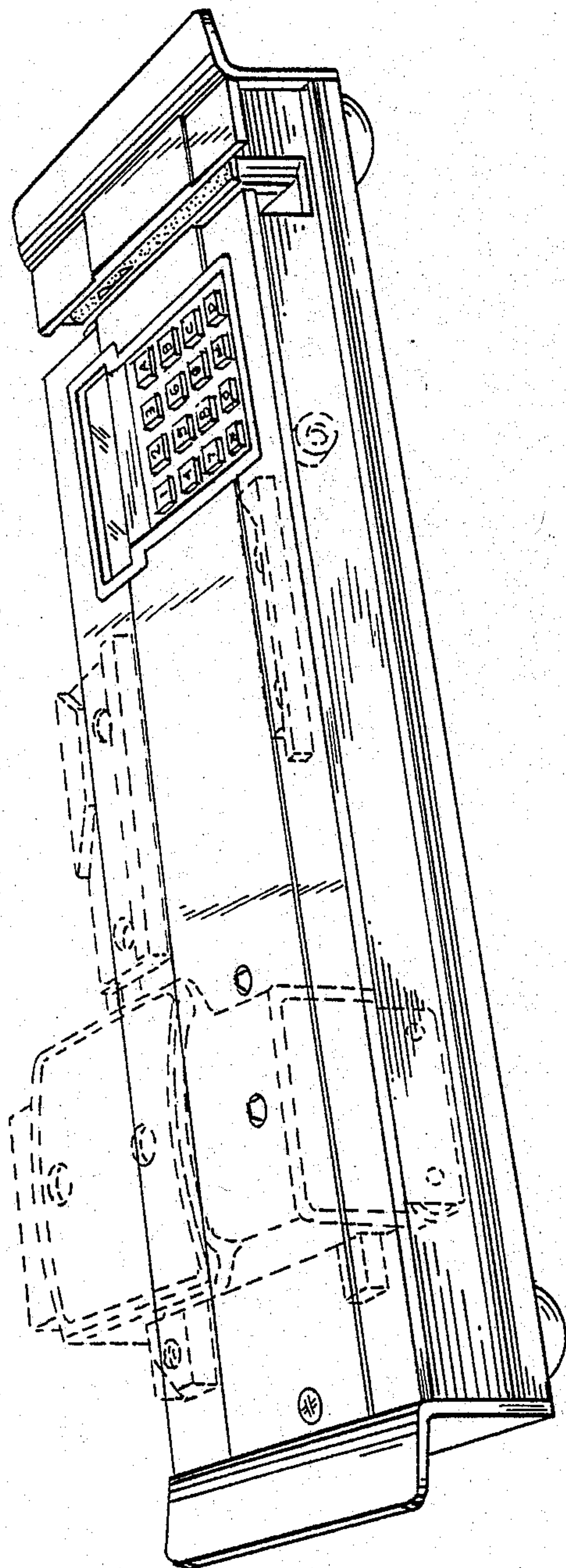

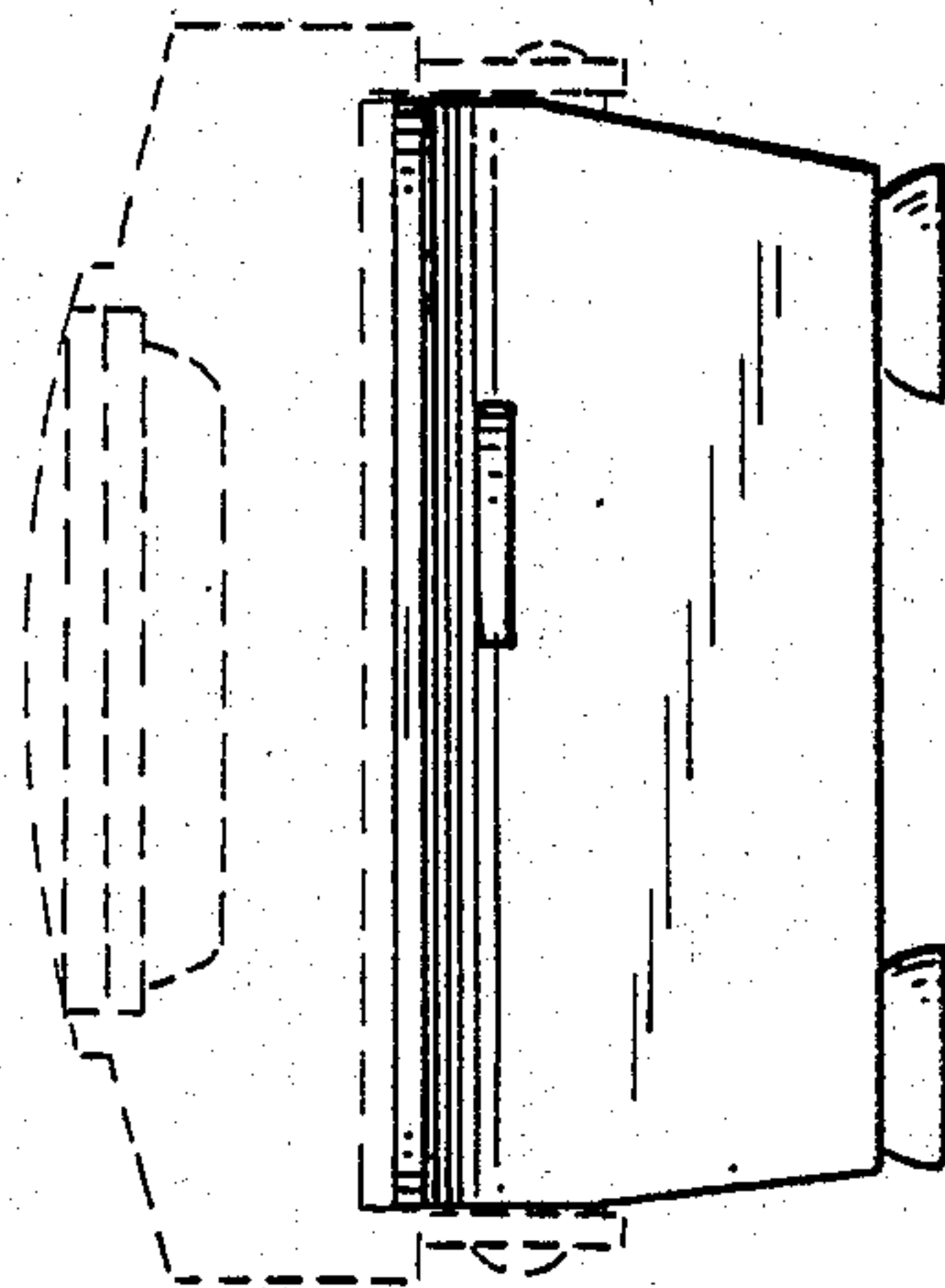

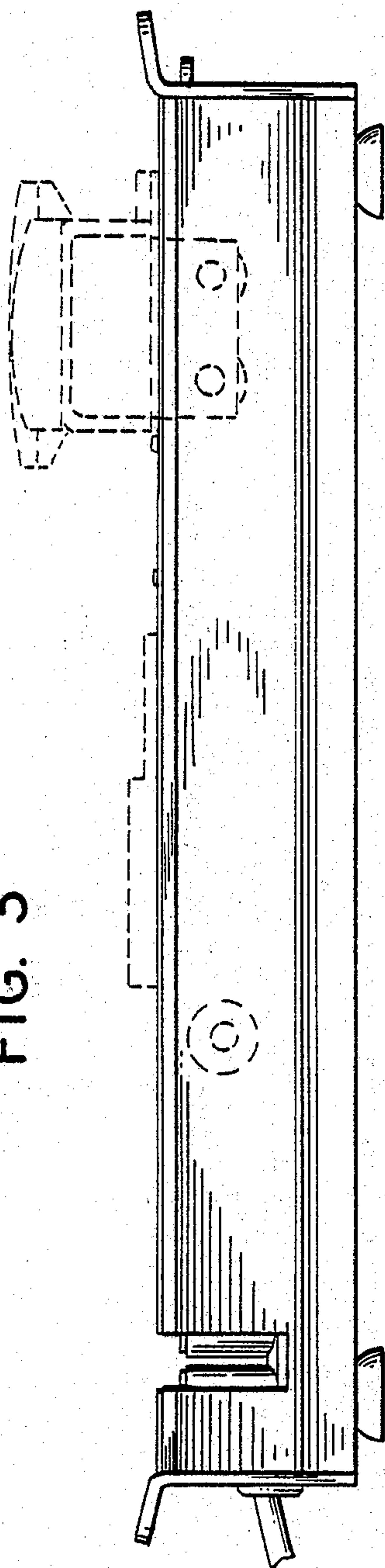

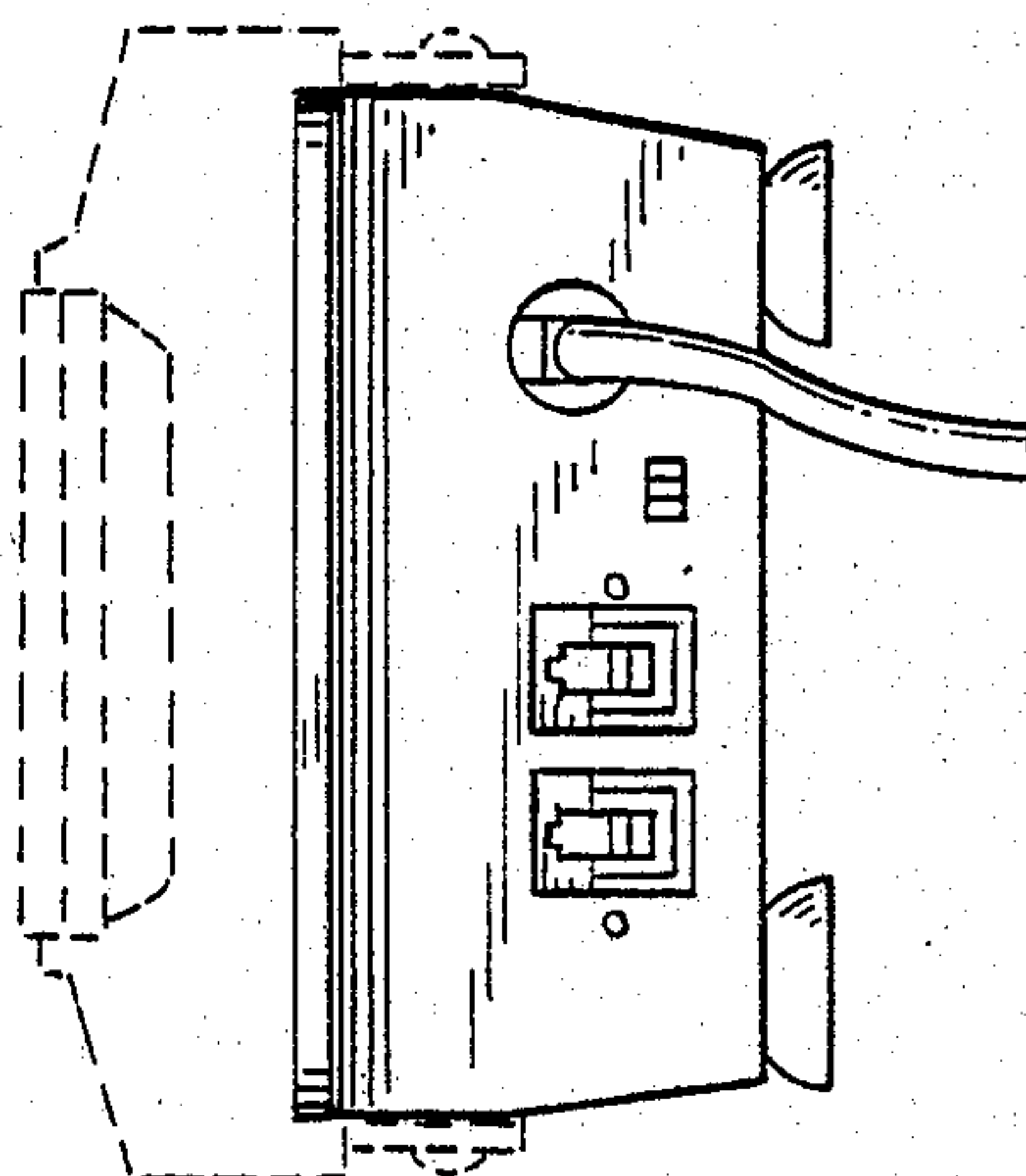

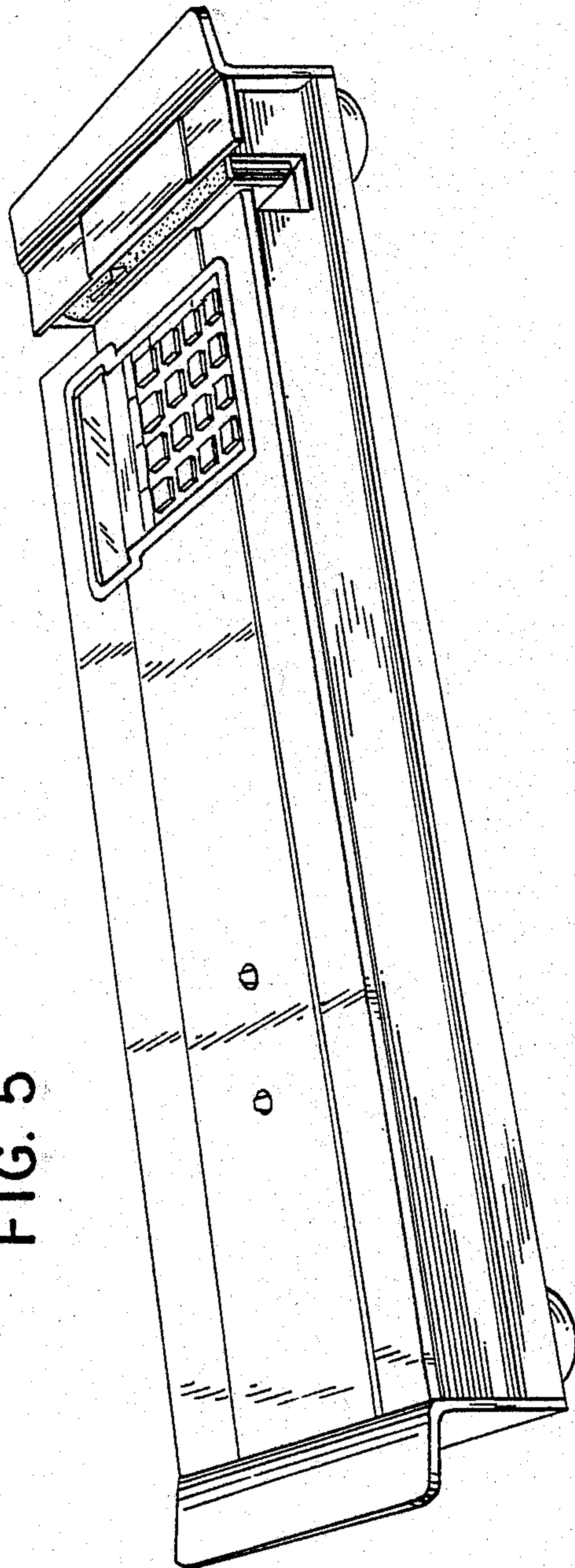

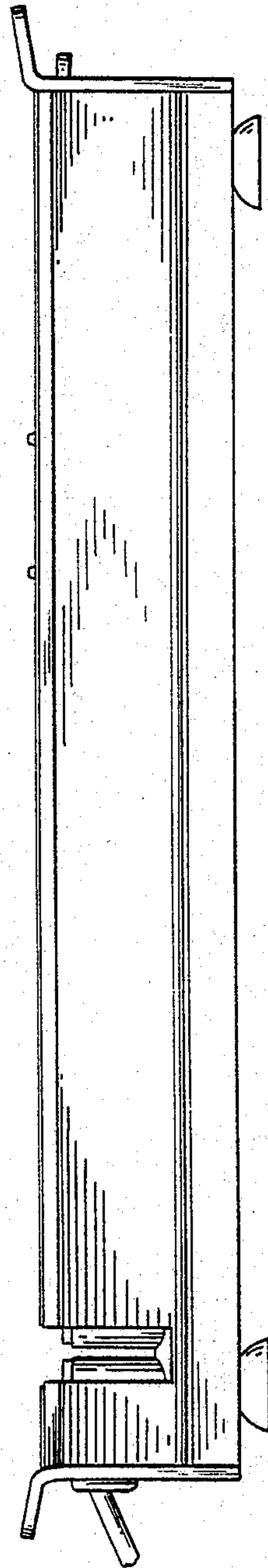

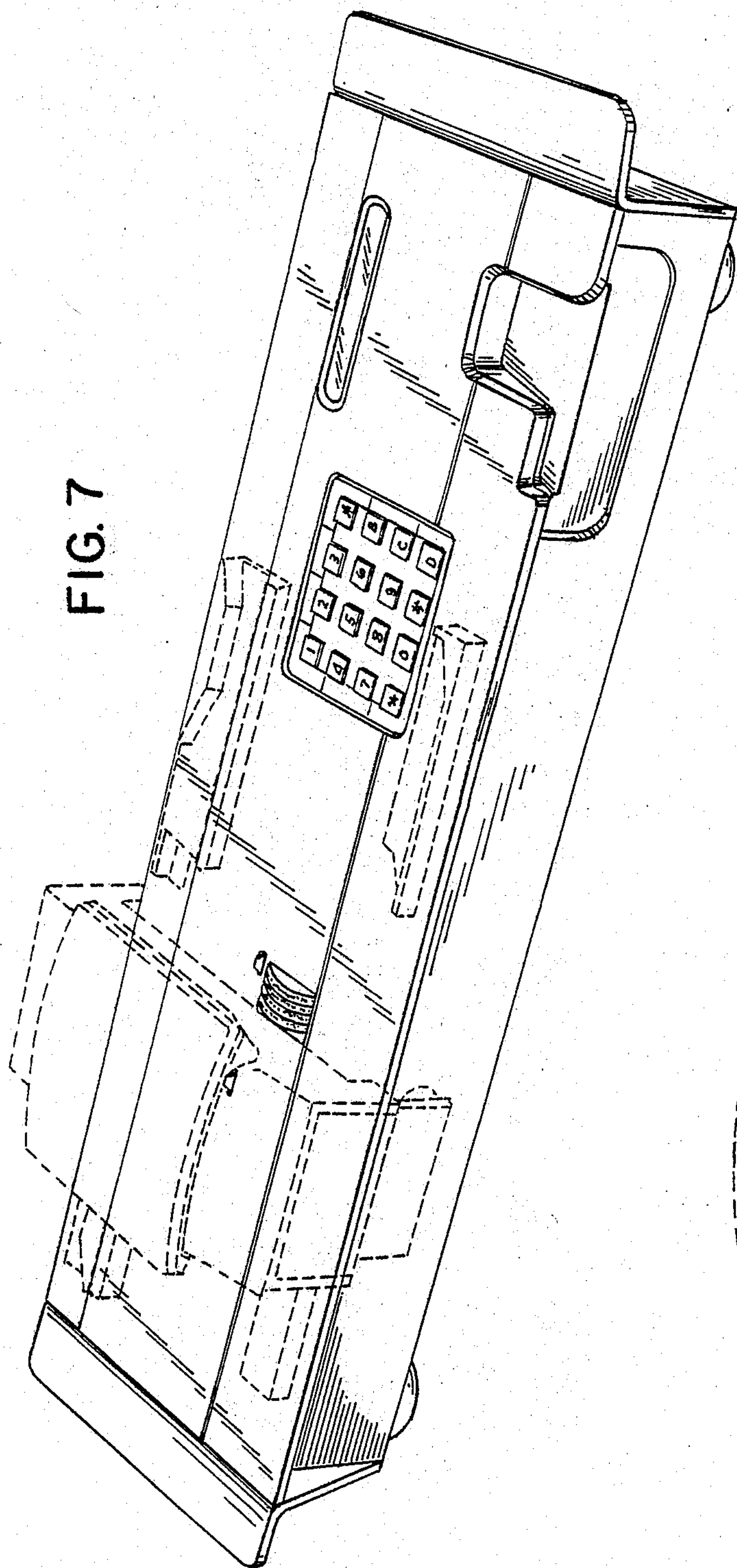

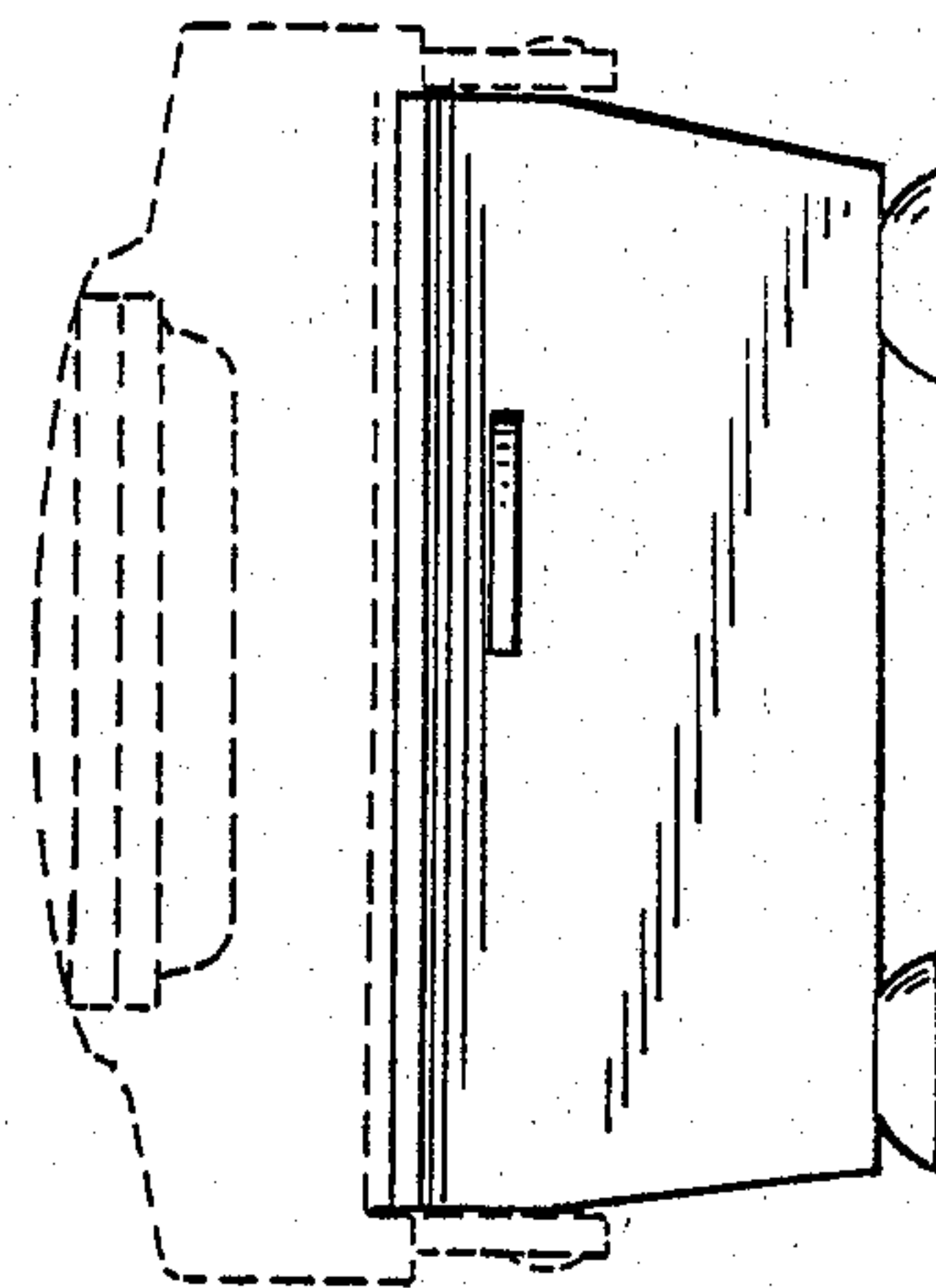

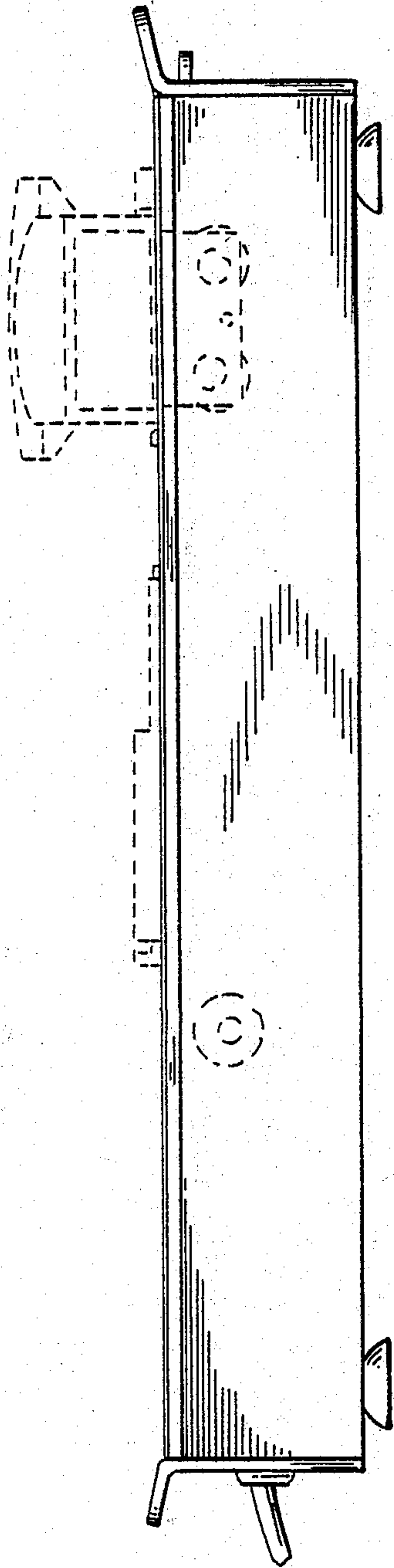

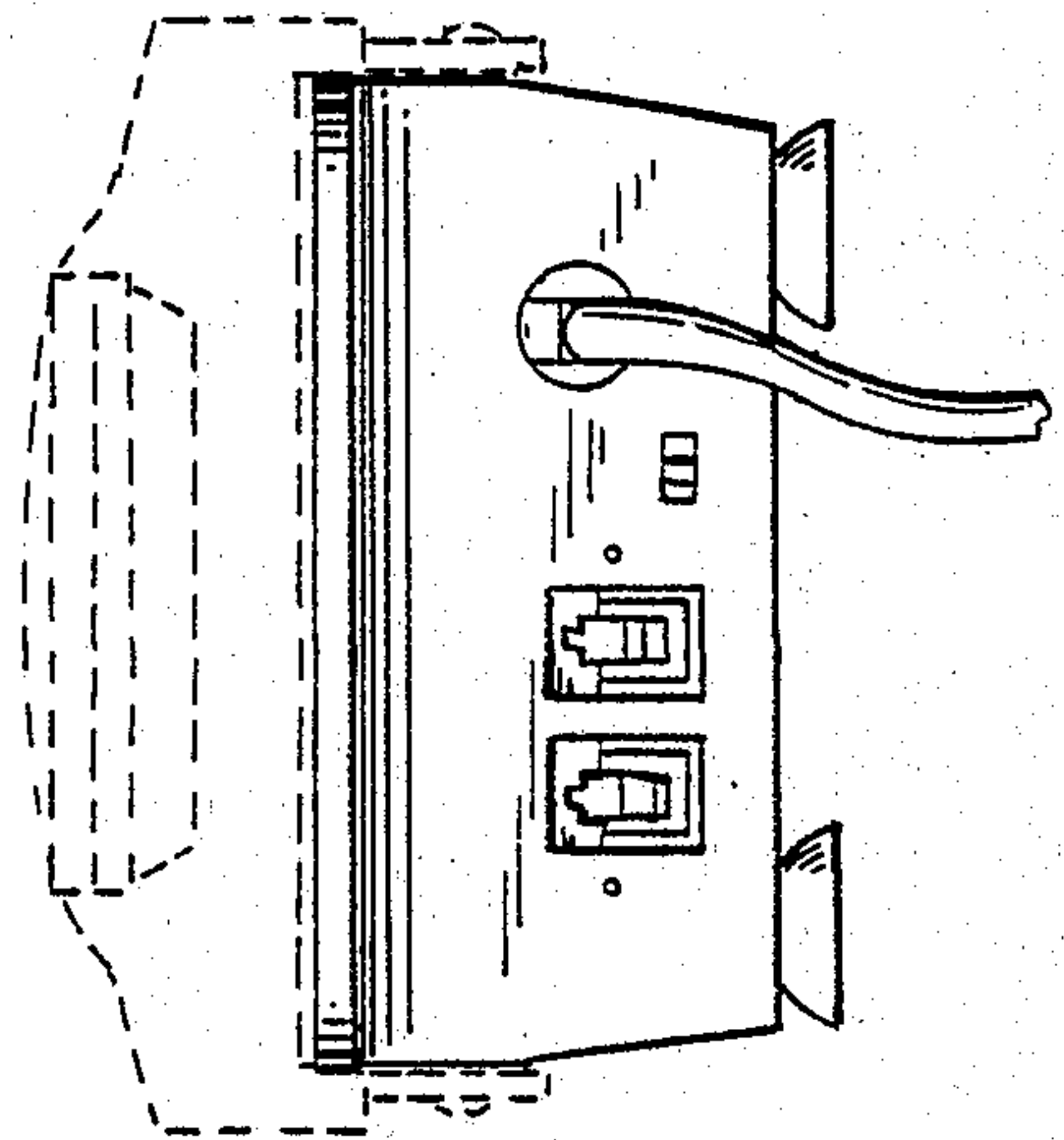

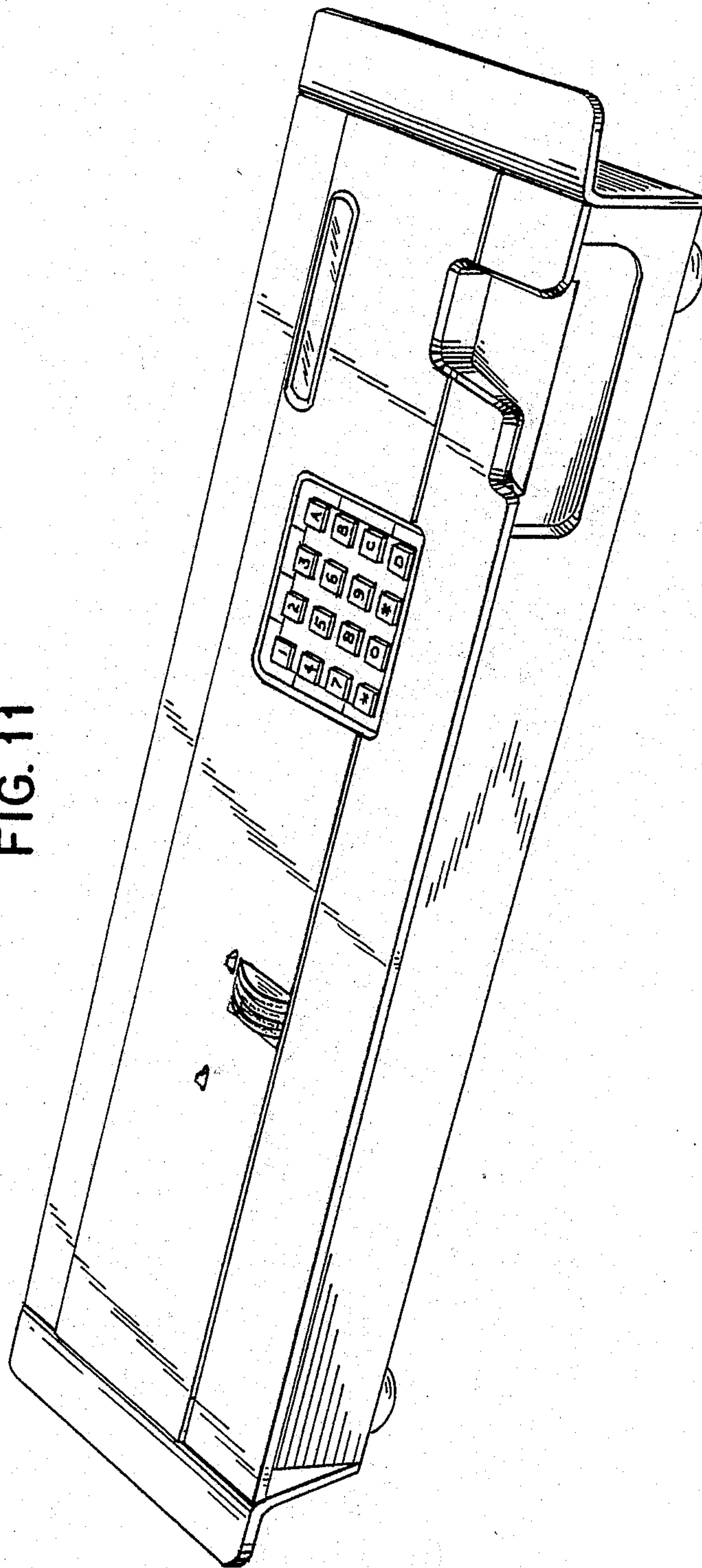

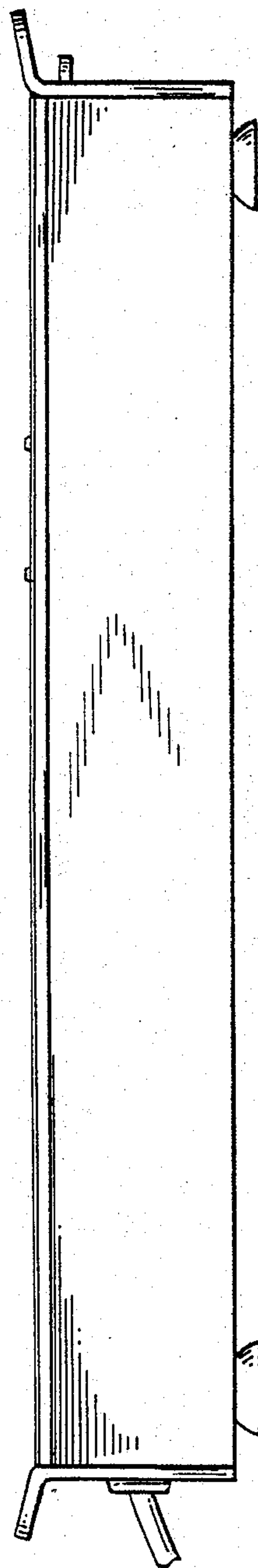

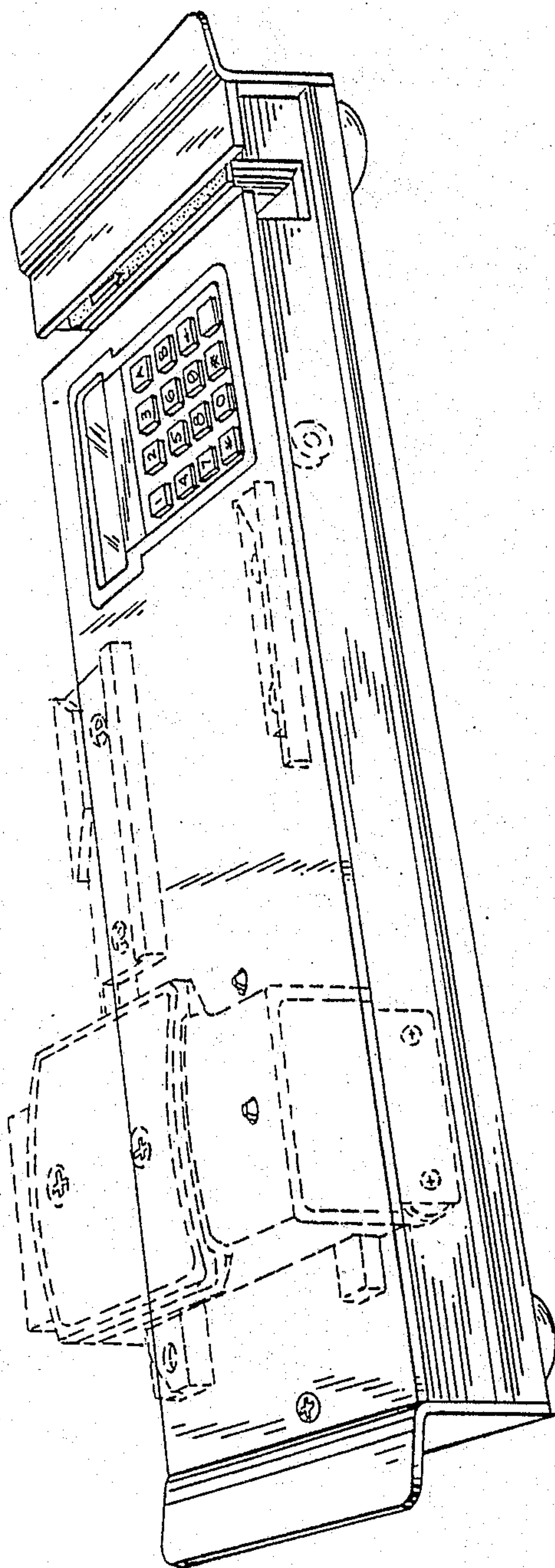

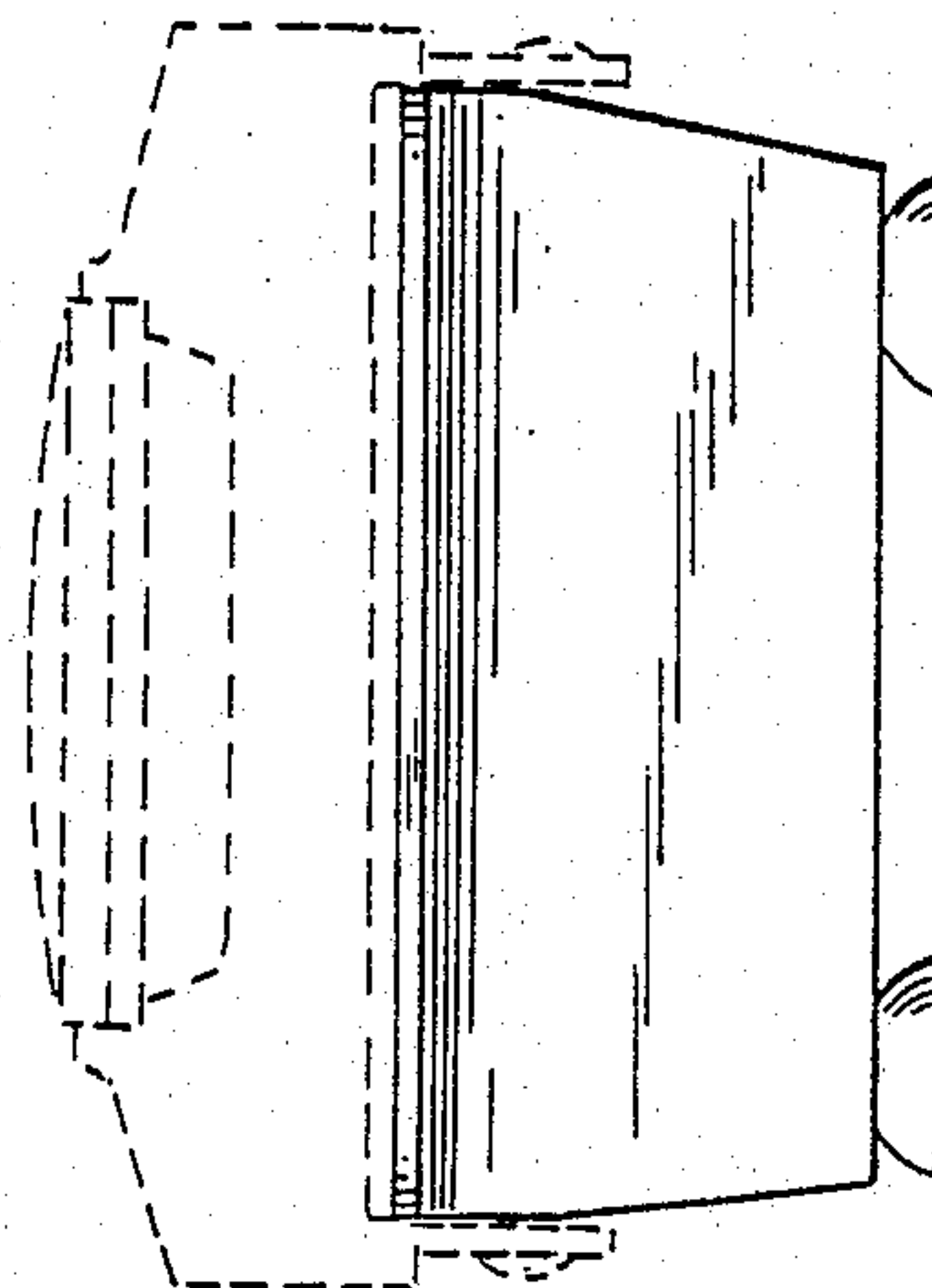

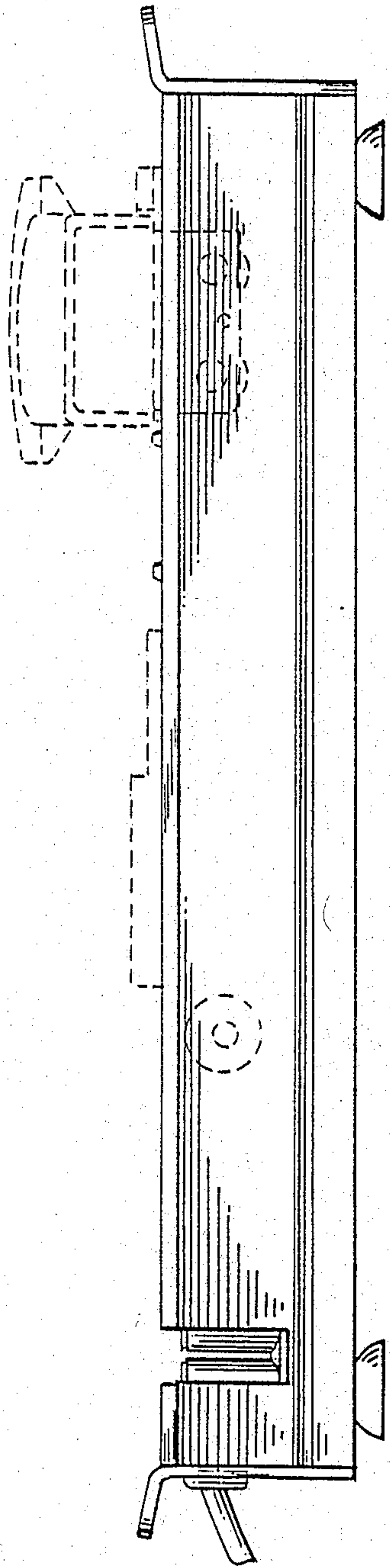
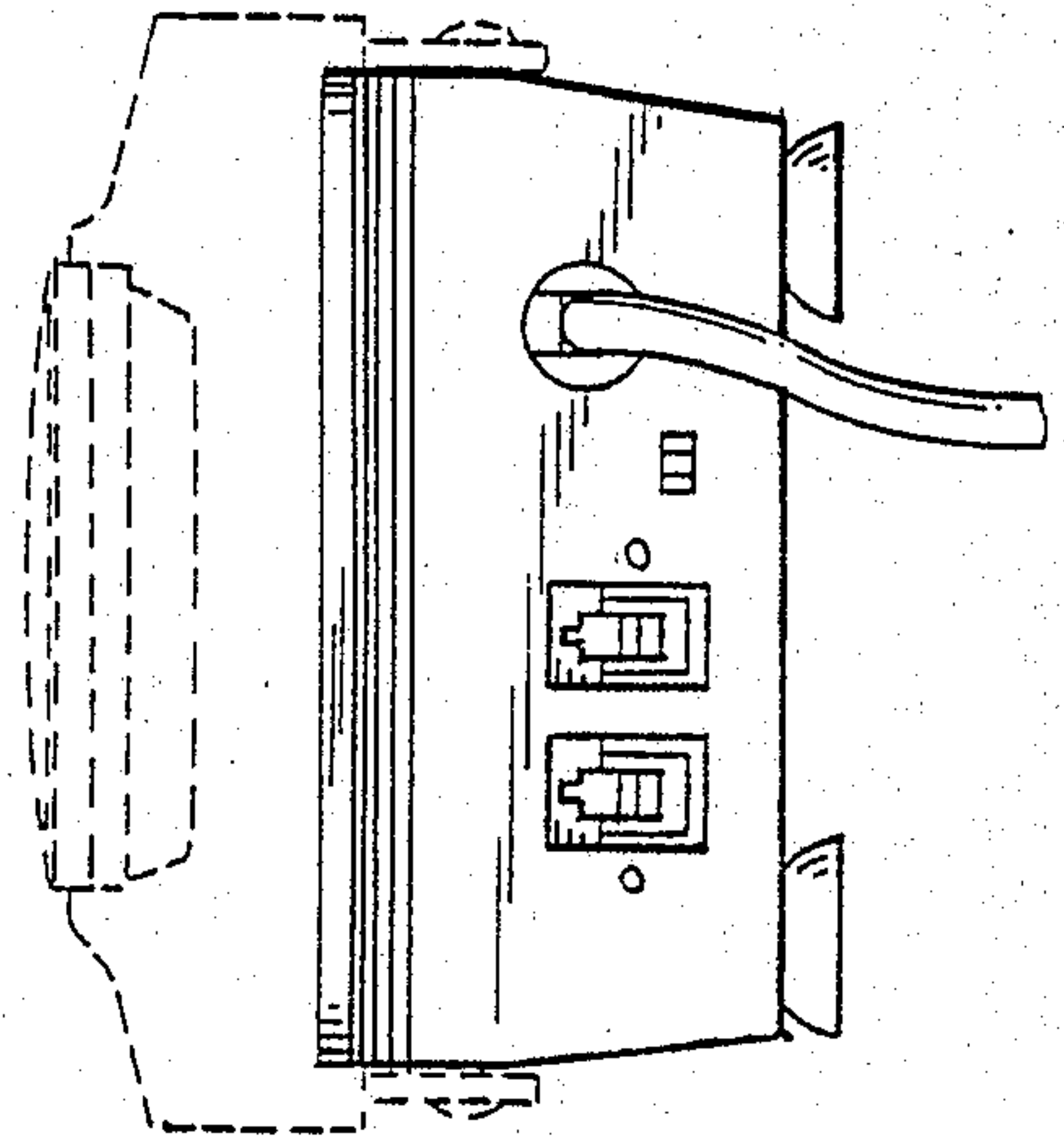

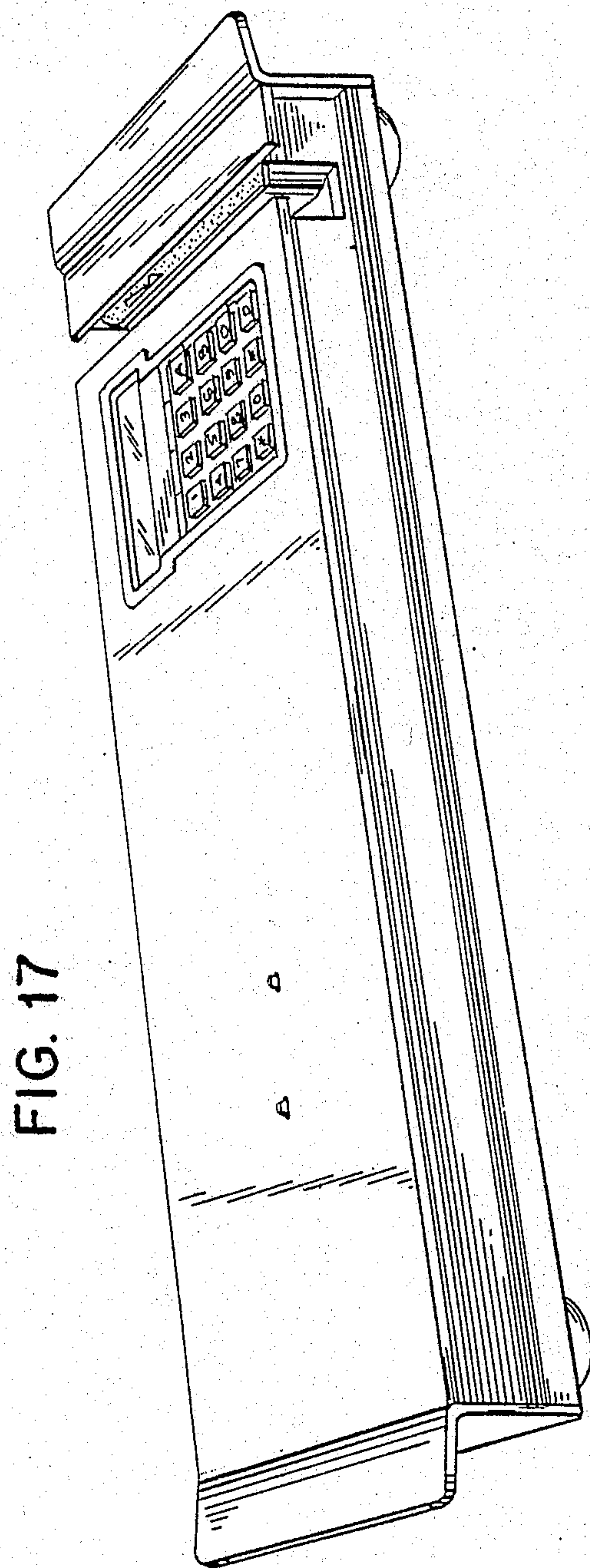
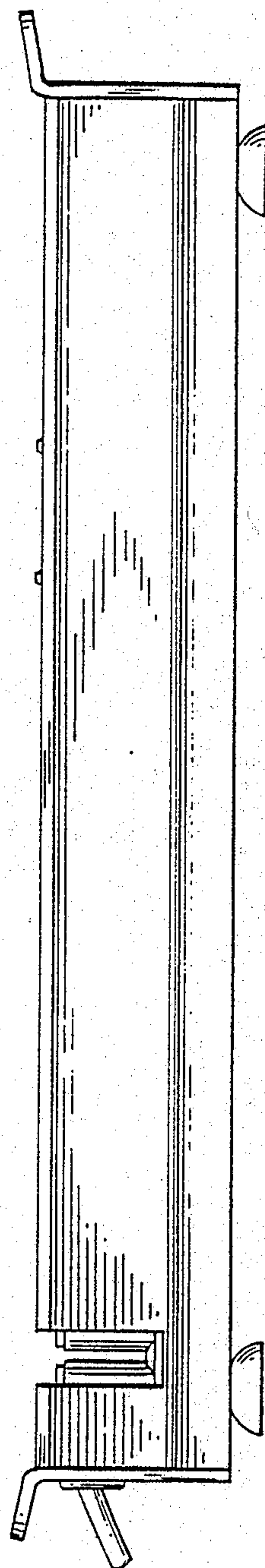

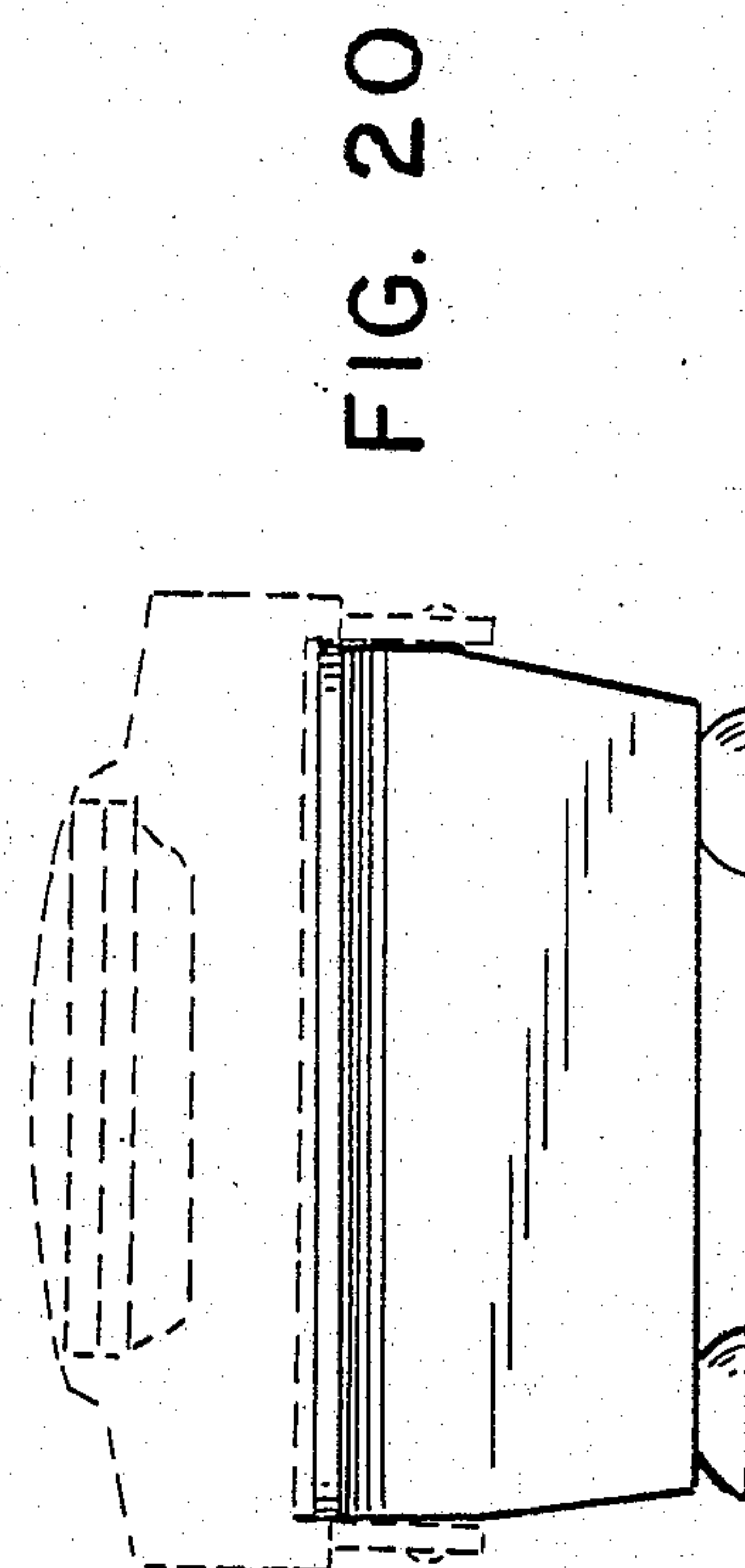
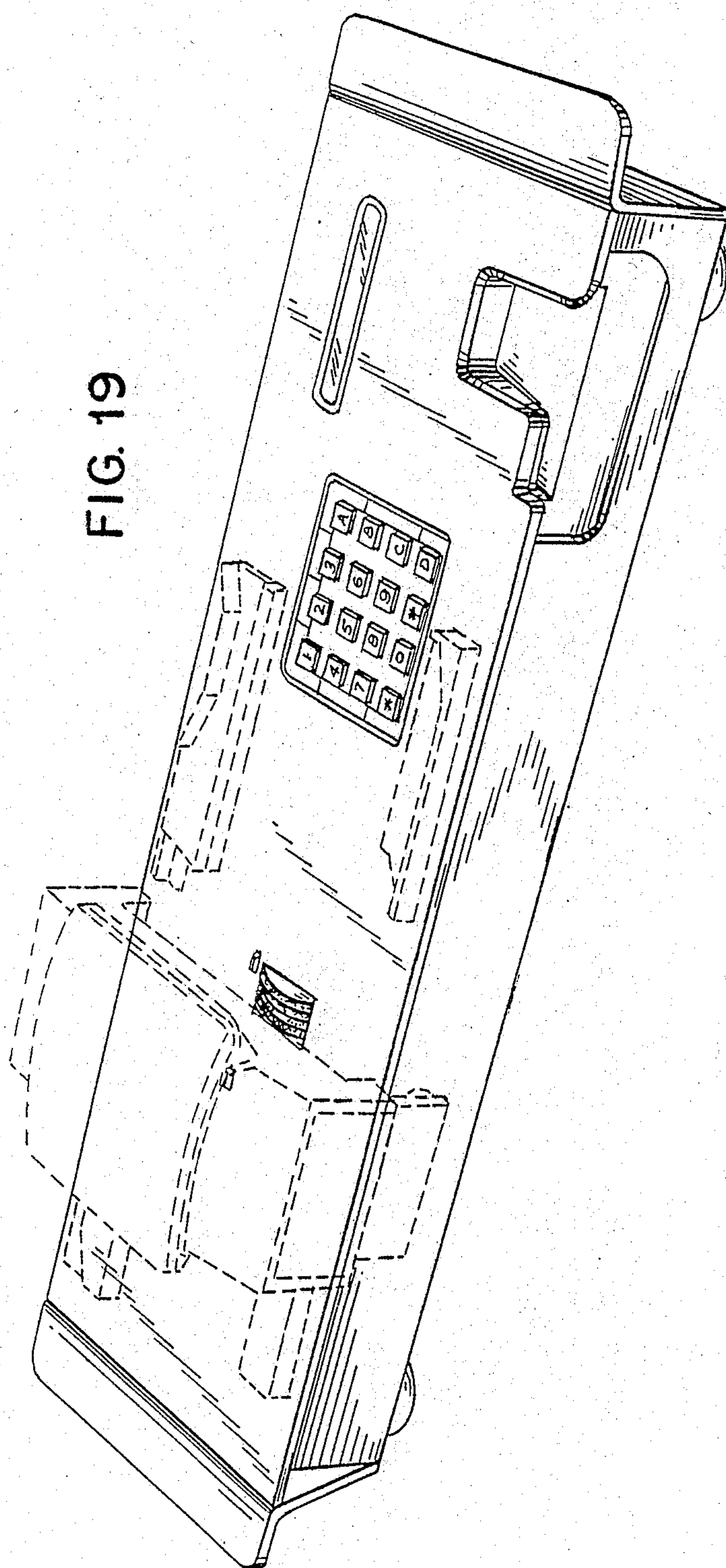

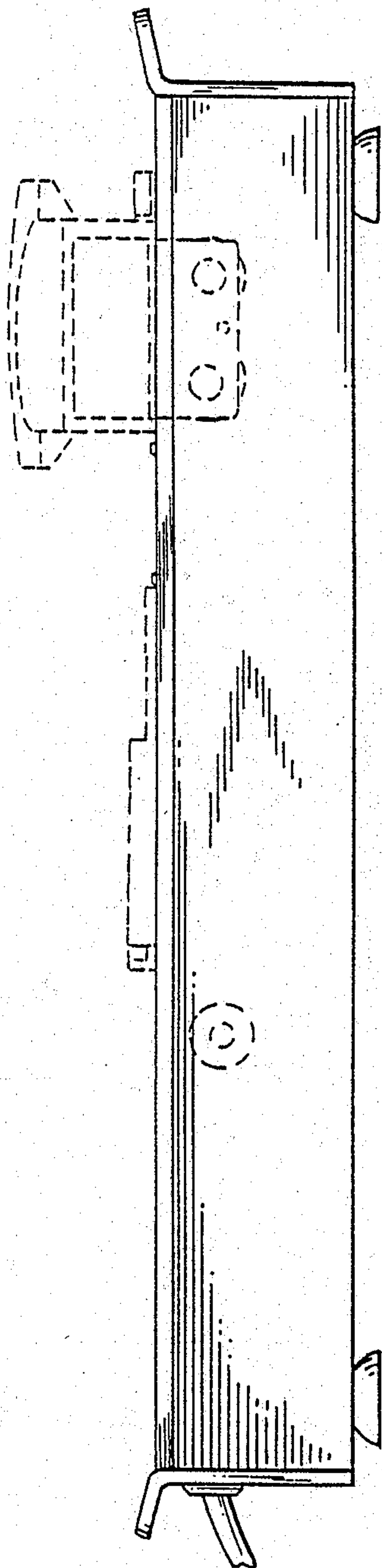
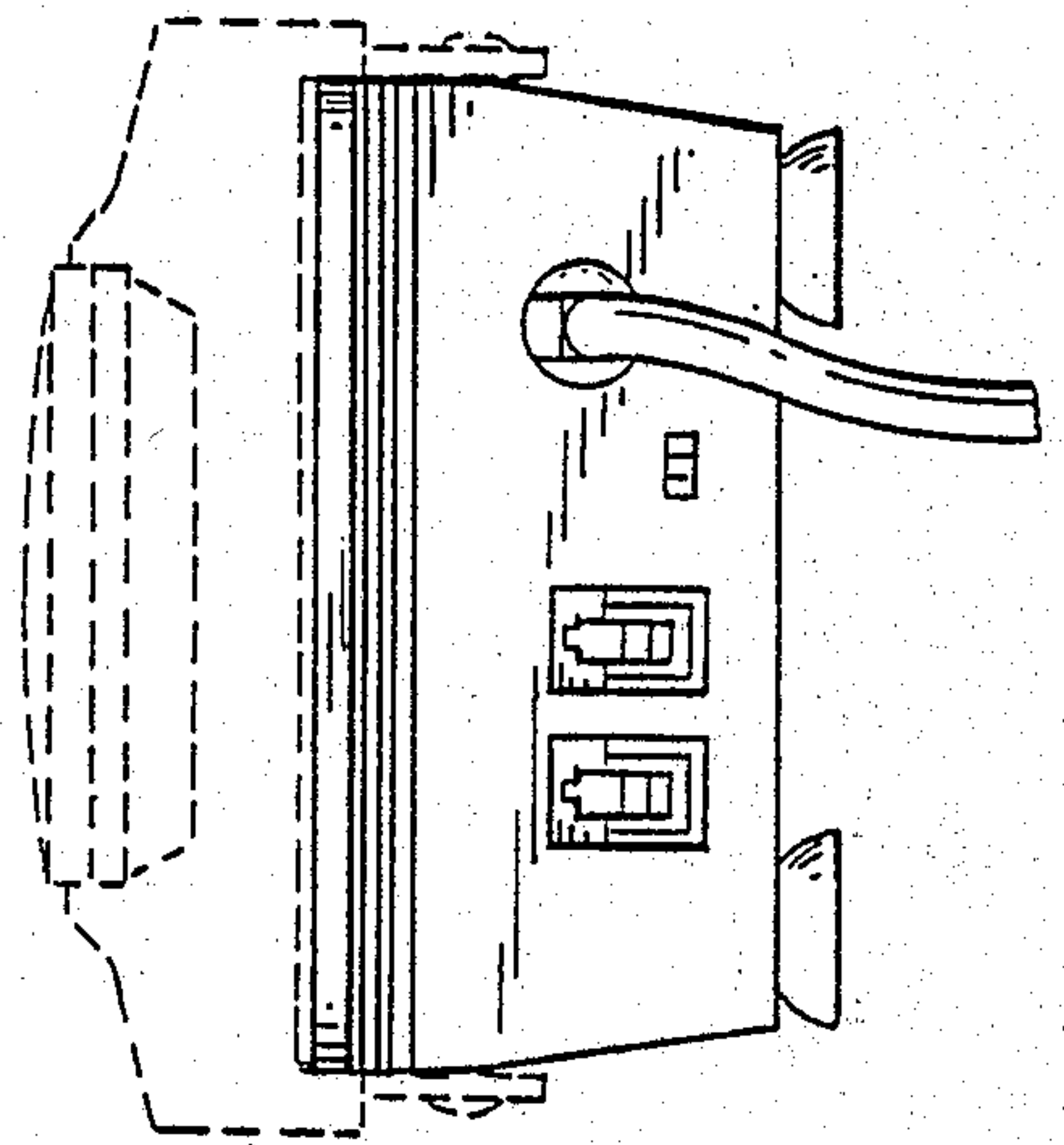

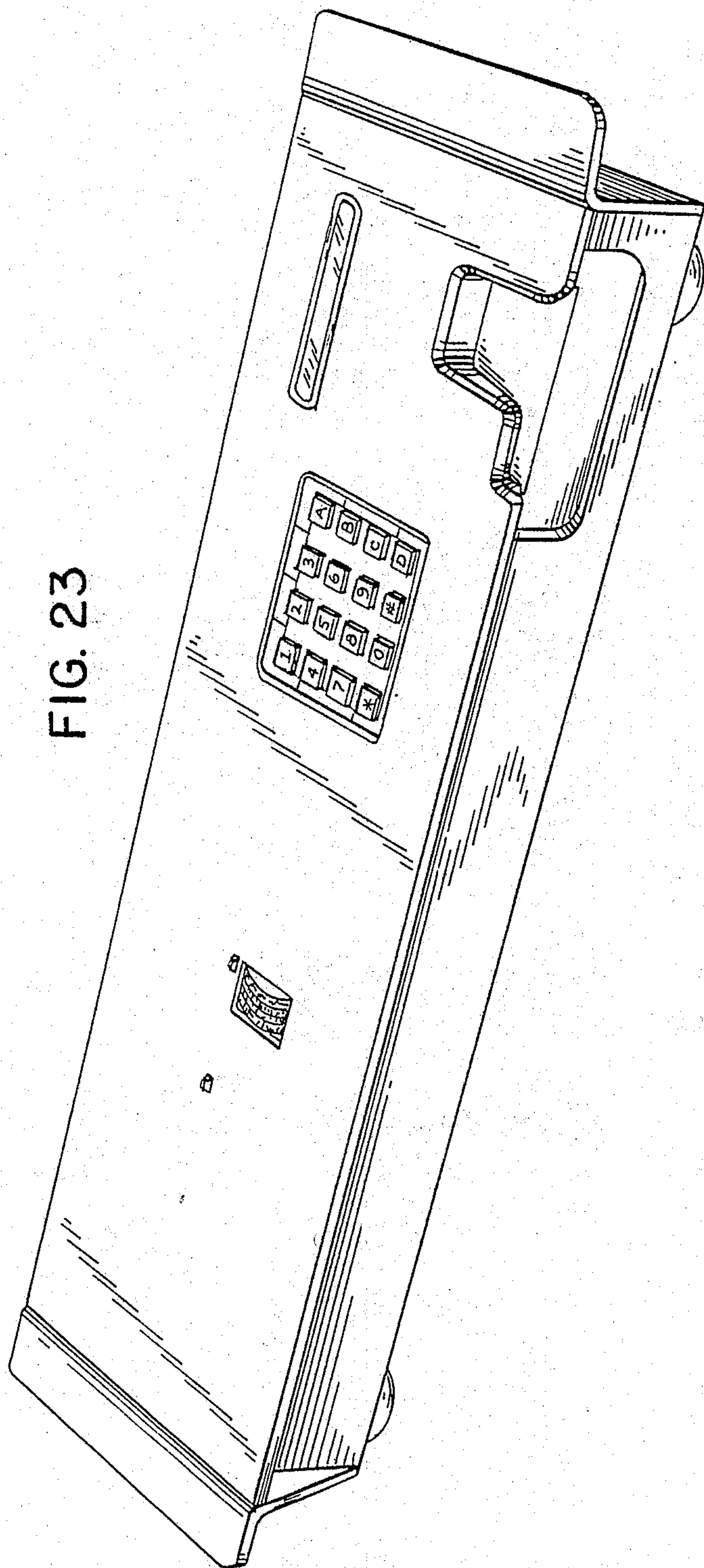
