The ornamental design for a holder for pens, pencils and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is perspective view of a holder for pencils, pens and the like showing my new design;

FIG. 37 is a front elevational view;


FIG. 38 is bottom plan view, partly broken away;


FIG. 39 is a rear elevational view;


FIG. 40 is top plan view;

FIG. 41 is a right side elevational view, the left side being the mirror image thereof;


FIG. 42 is a view in section taken along lines 42—42 in FIG. 38.






















































































