[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for combination telephone handset and stand with dialing means, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a combination telephone handset and stand with dialing means showing our new design in cradled relationship;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front, top and right side perspective view of the base of the telephone of our new design with the handset removed and a front, right side and bottom perspective view of the handset;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of stand alone;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of the handset;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The structure shown in broken lines is not part of the design sought to be patterned.

The broken line showing of cord in FIGS. 1-4, 7-9 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
