DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hair weaving machine showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a hair weaving machine showing a second embodiment of my new design which is a mirror image of the first embodiment.

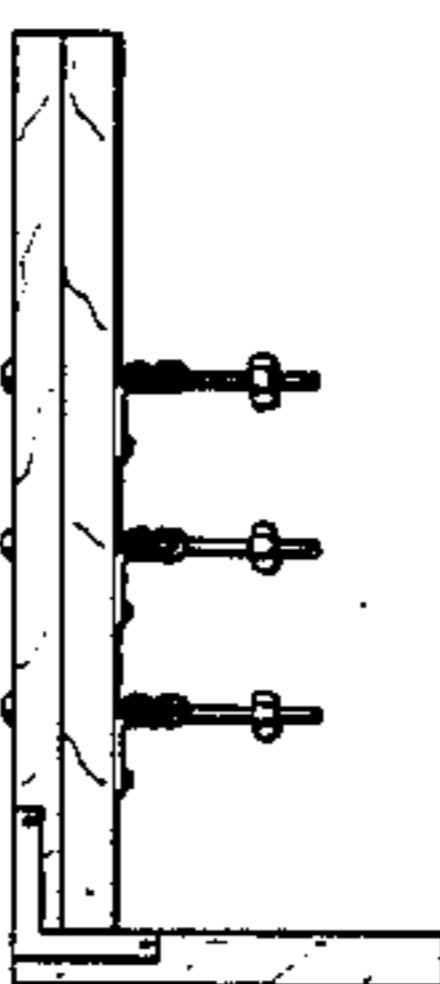
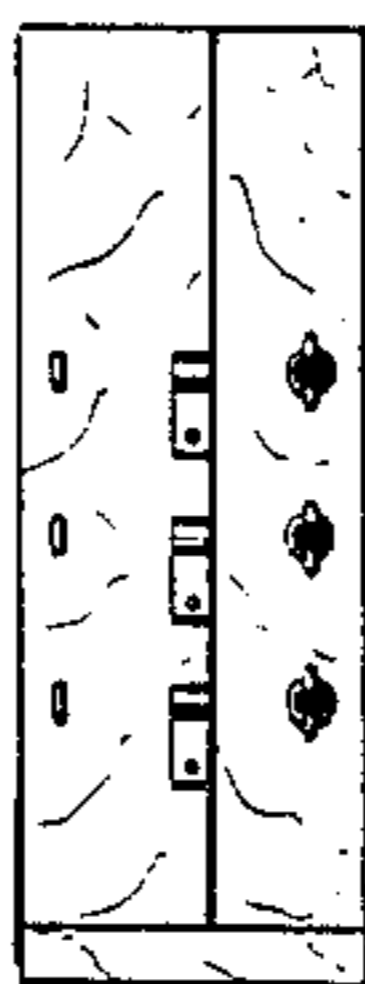

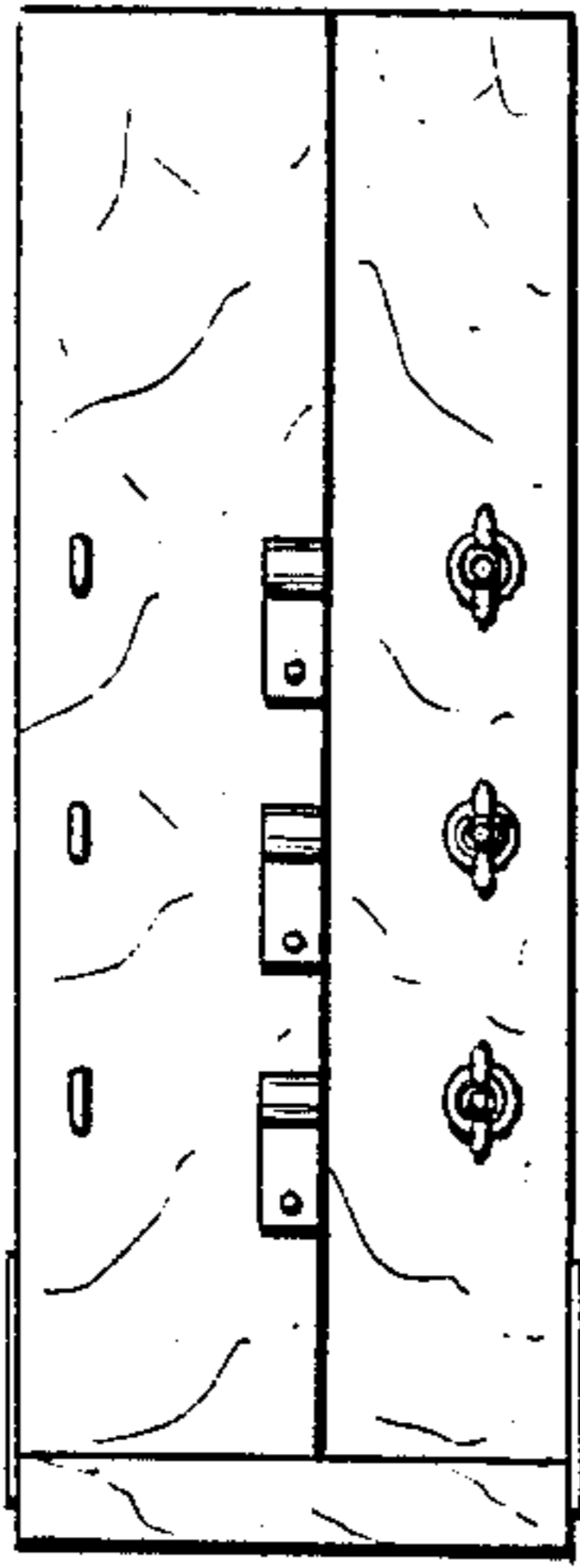

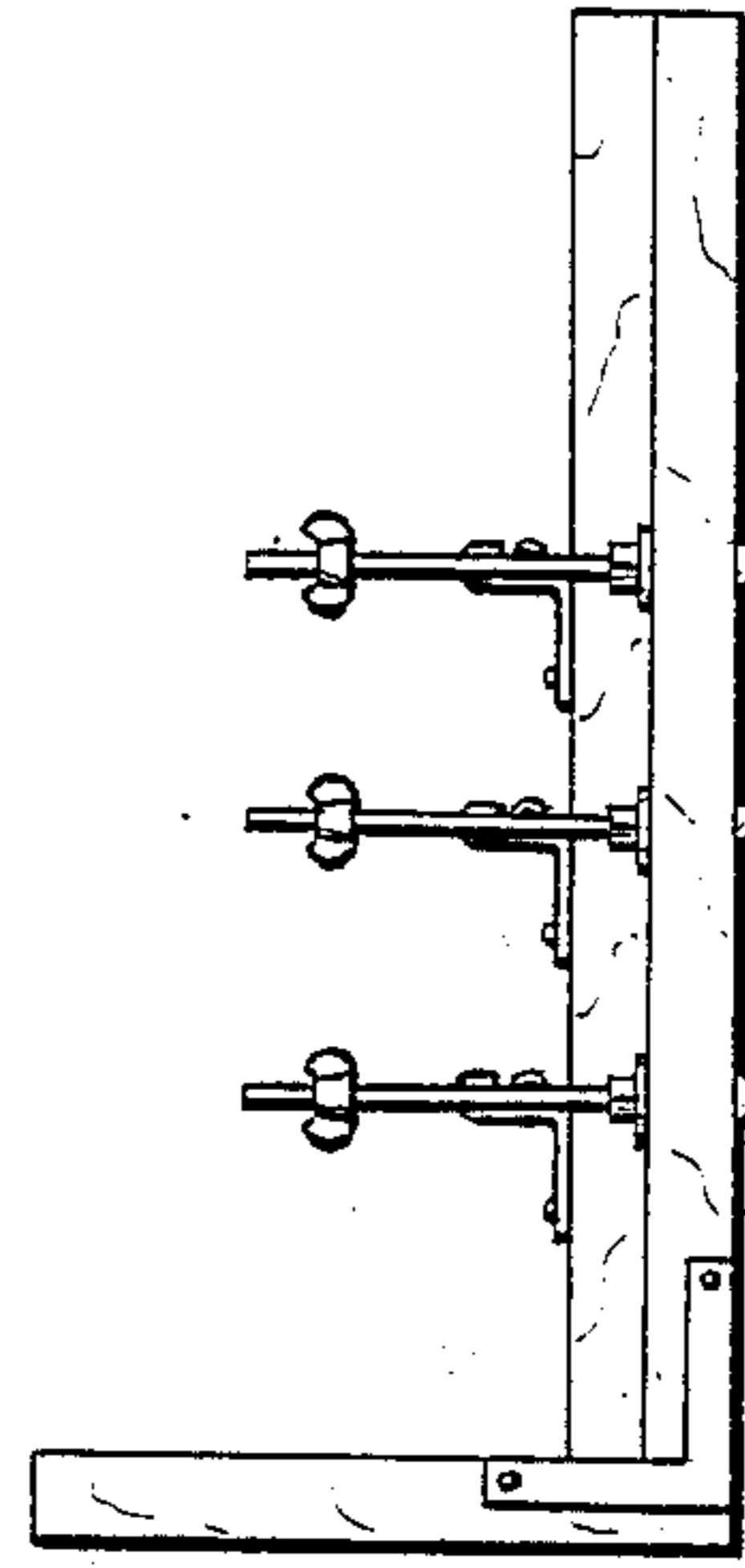

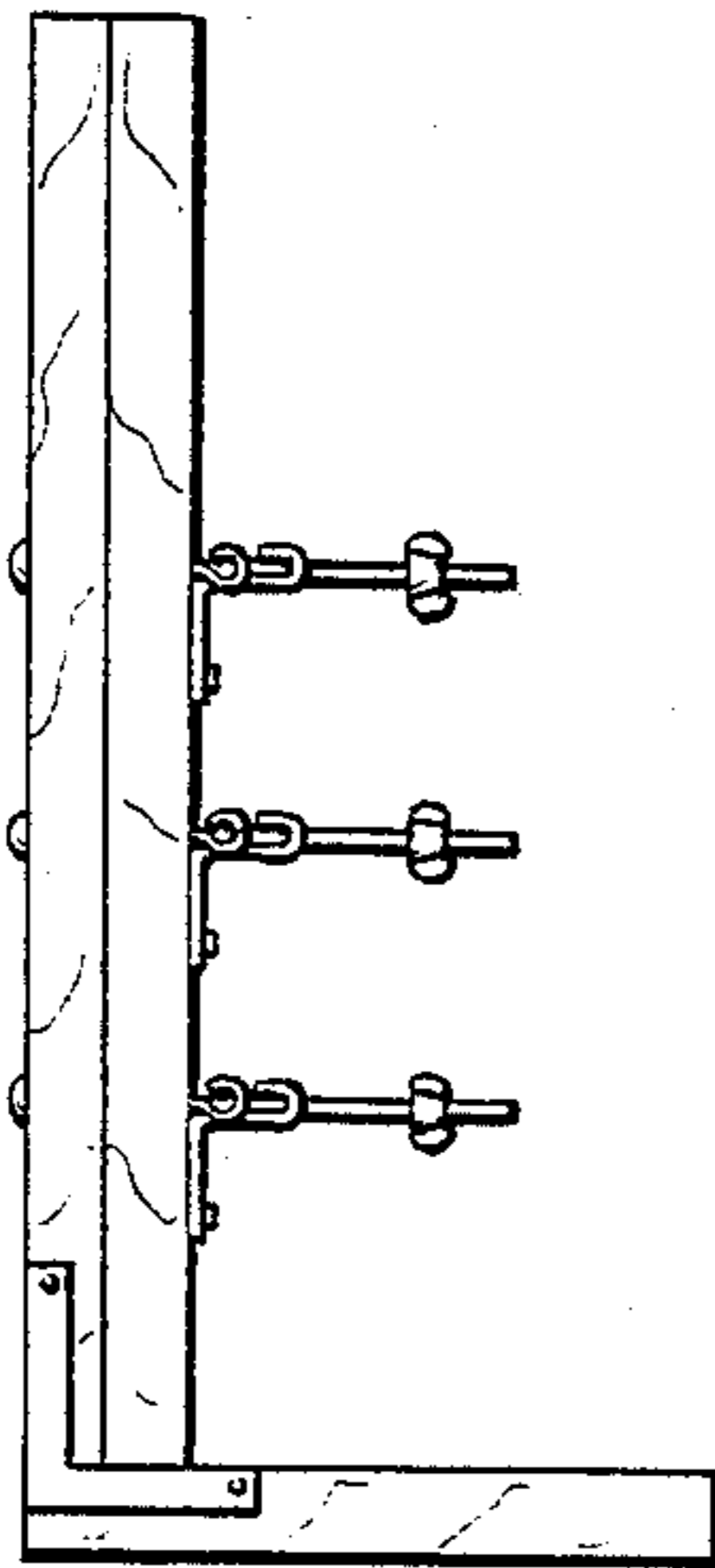
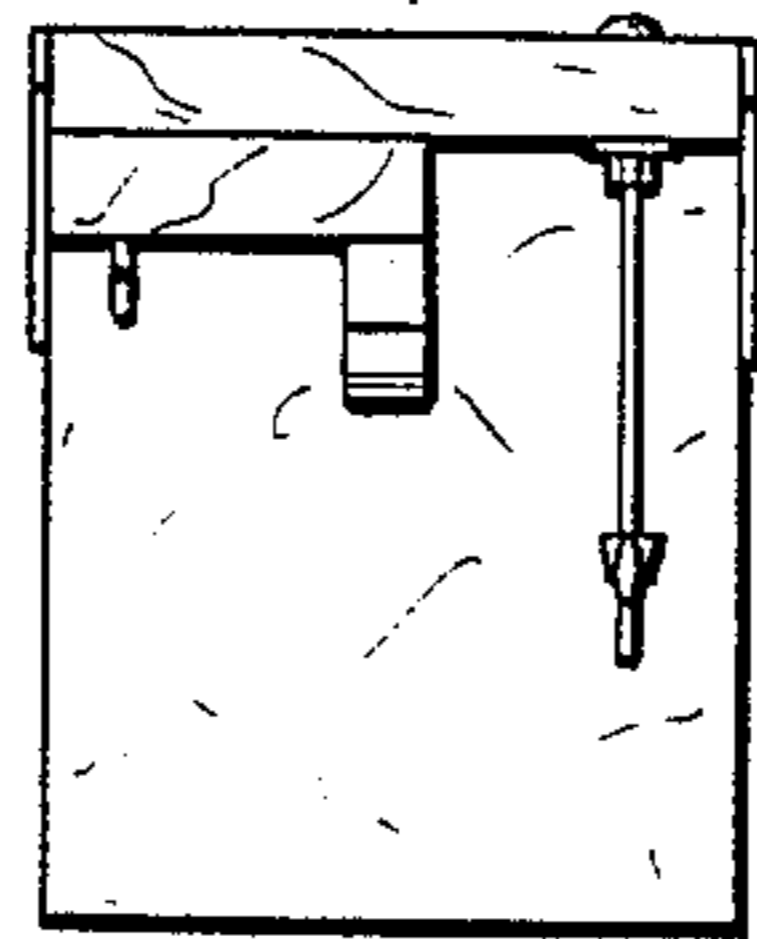

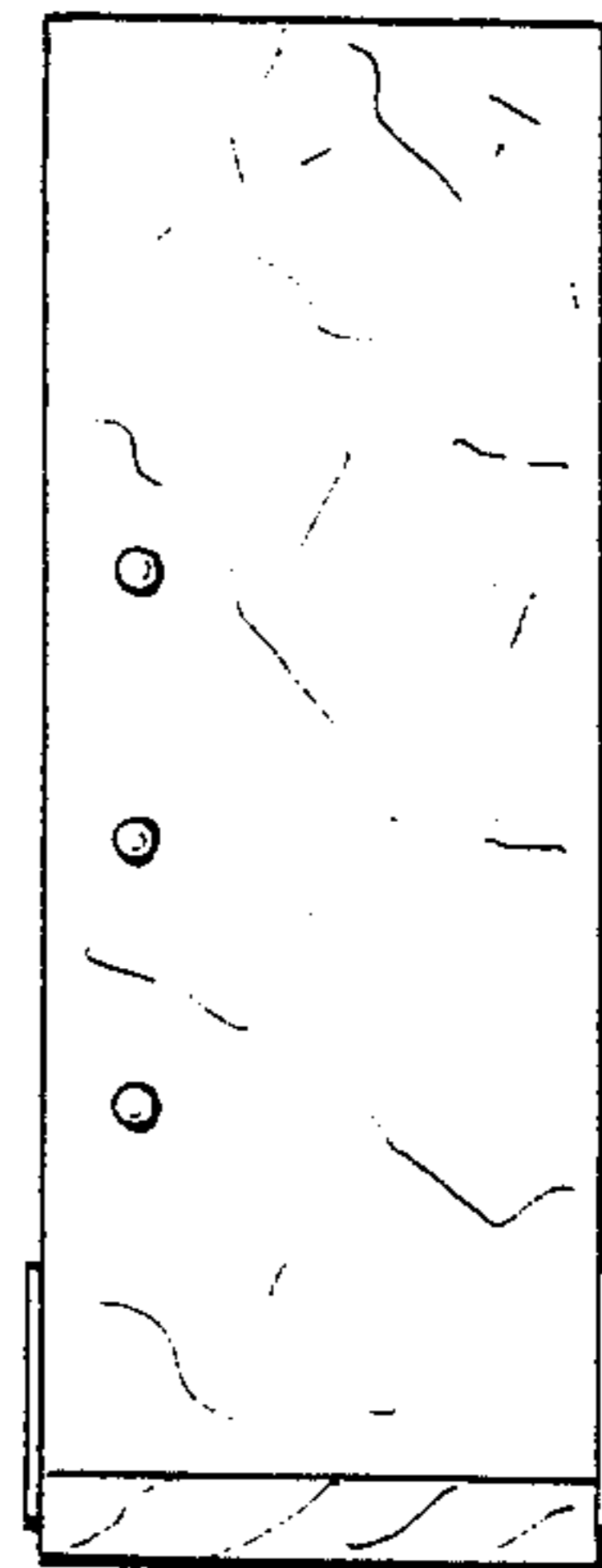

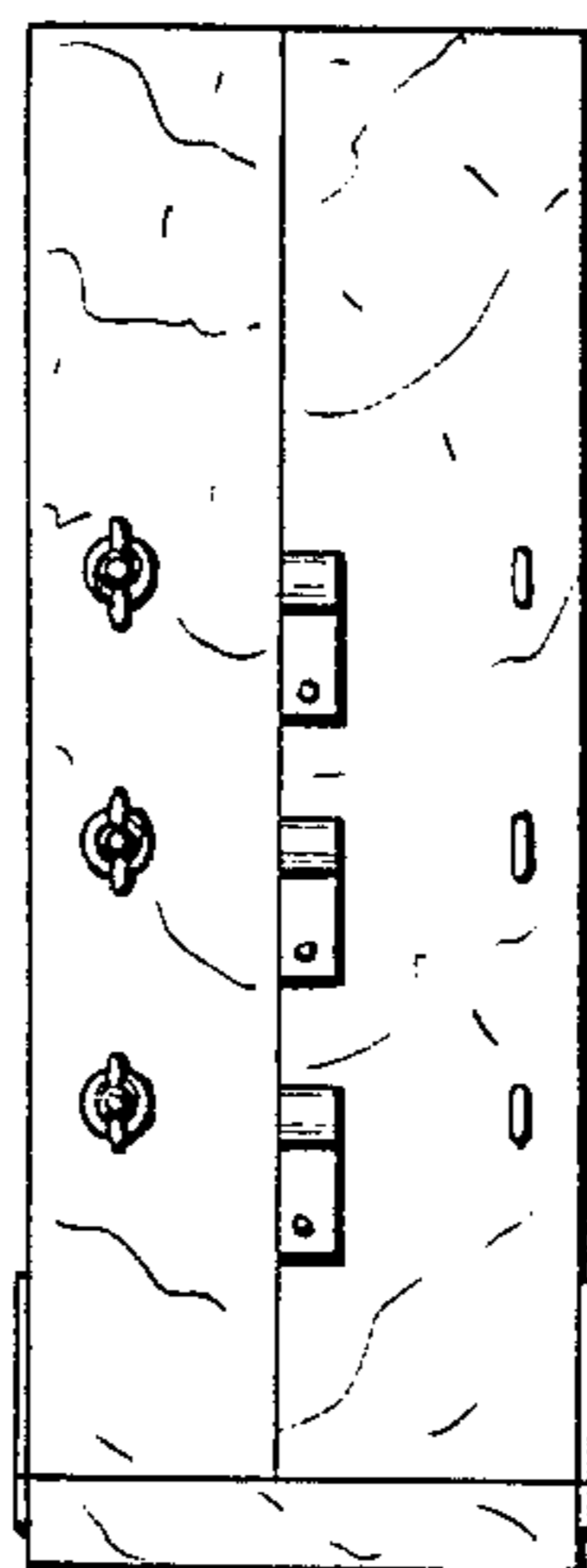
