The ornamental design for a tricycle handle bar, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tricycle handle bar showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
