of FIG. 2.

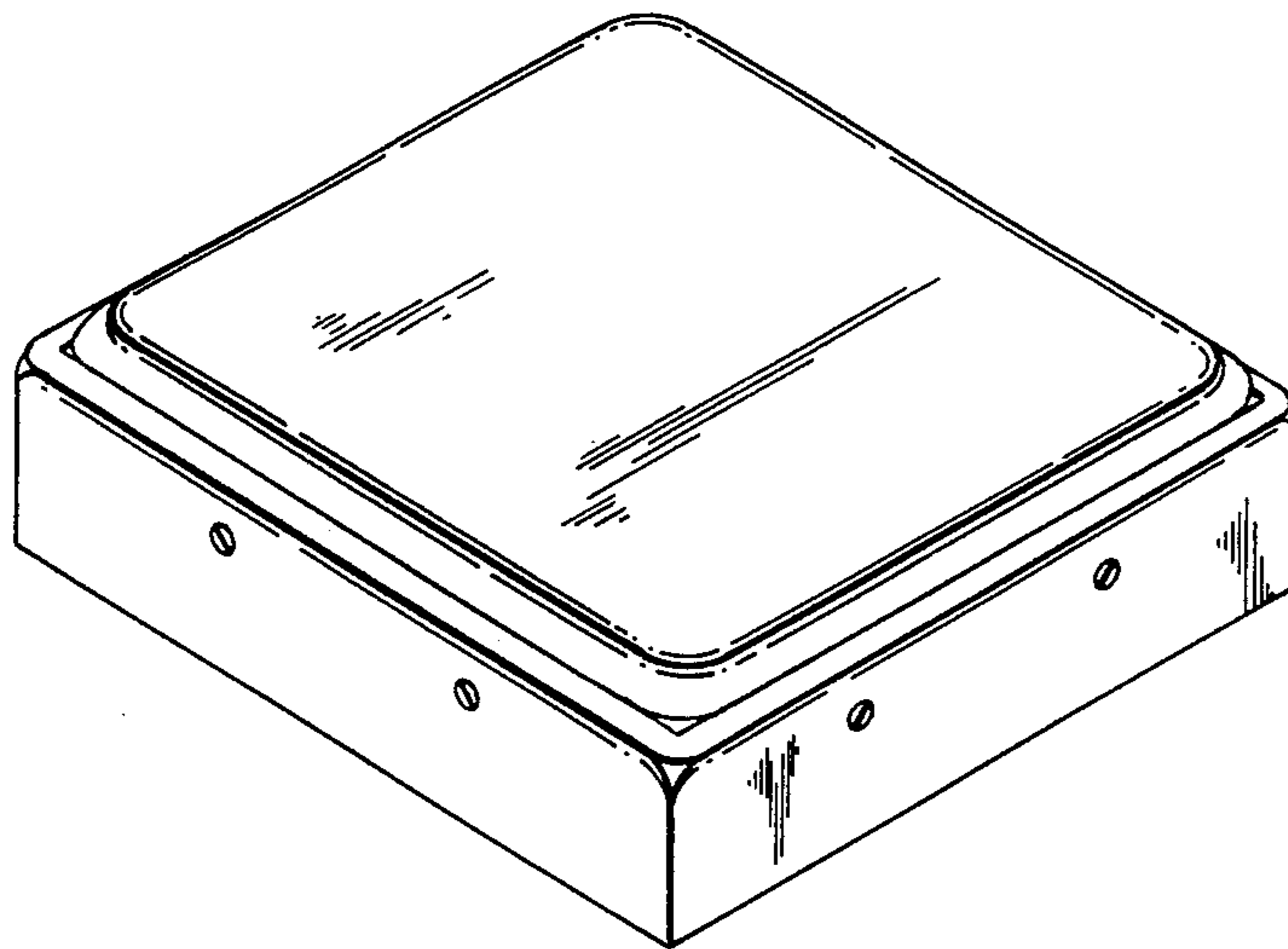

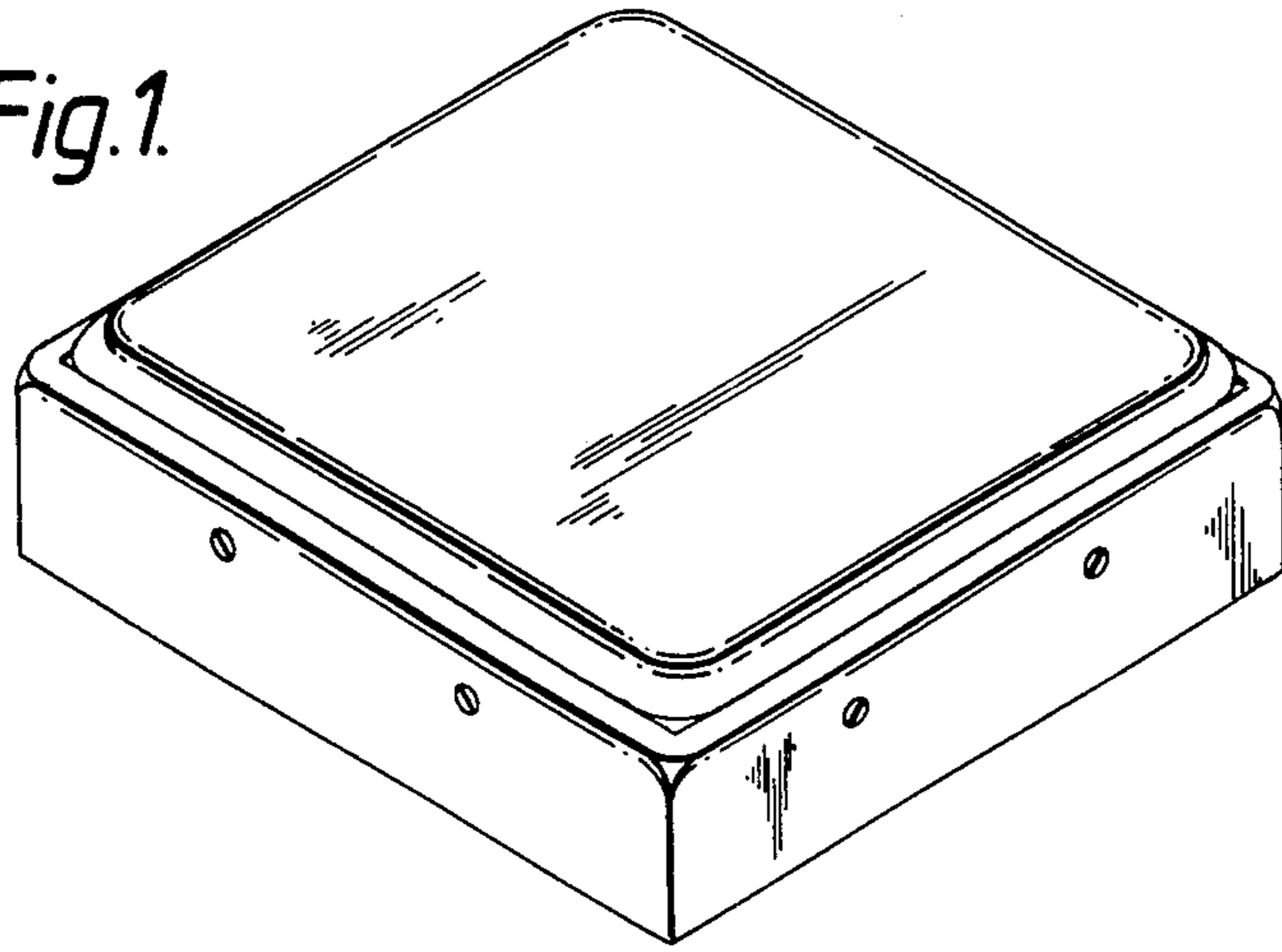

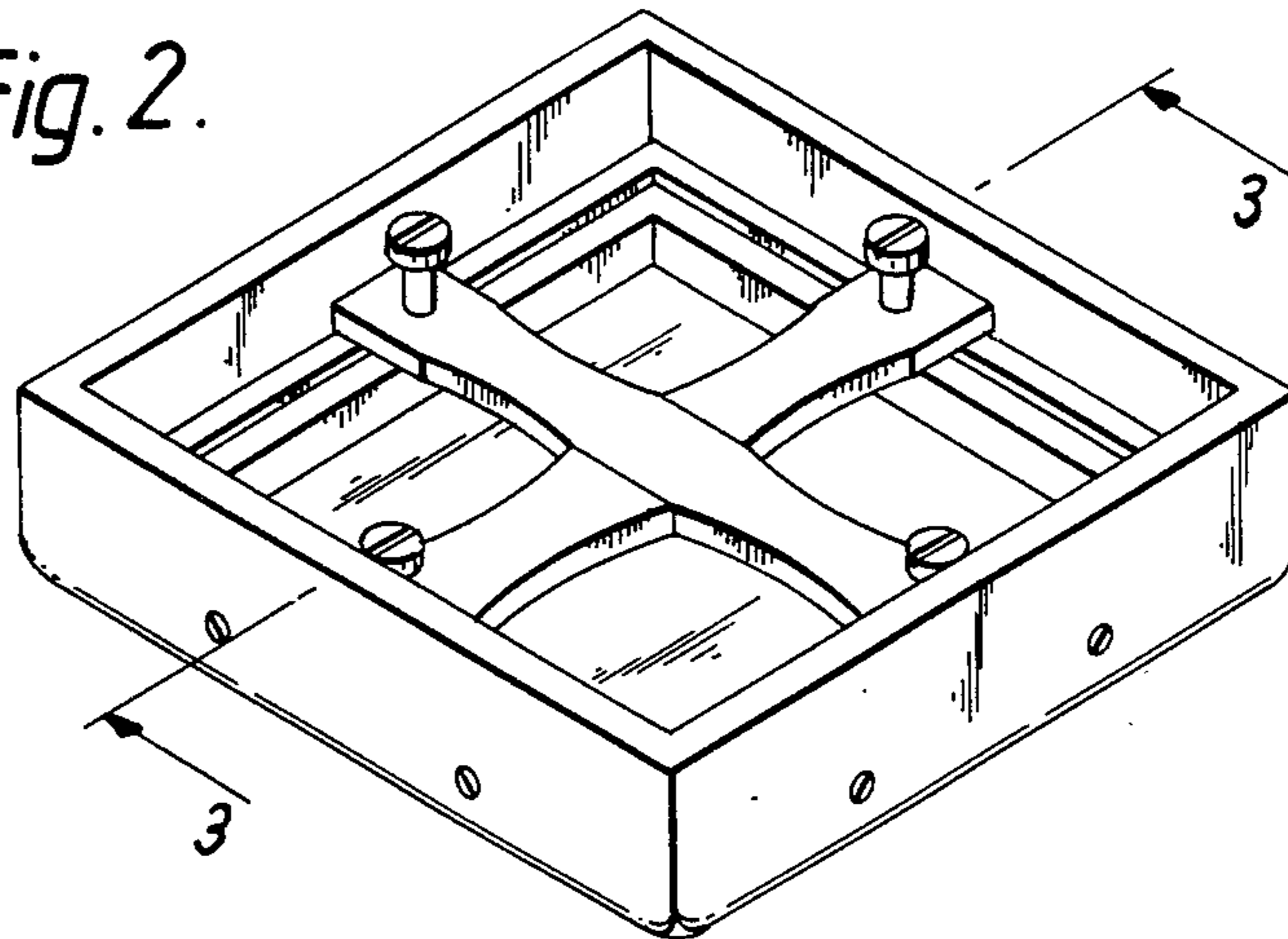
