

The ornamental design for a tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tire showing our new design it being understood that the tread pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumference of the tire and the opposite side is the same as that shown; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof.








