[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shower enclosure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a shower enclosure showing my new design, a portion being broken away for convenience of illustration.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 2;

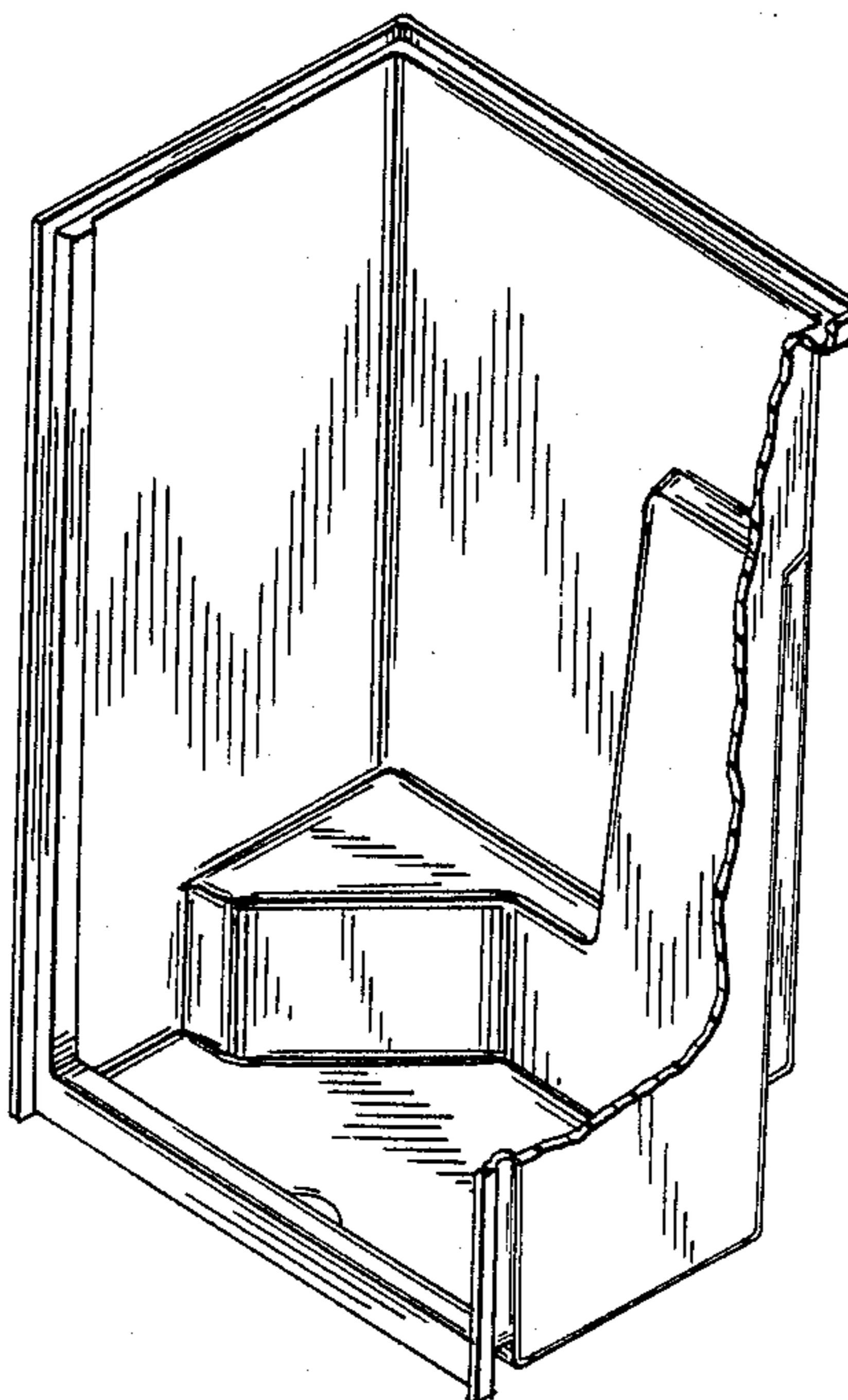
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

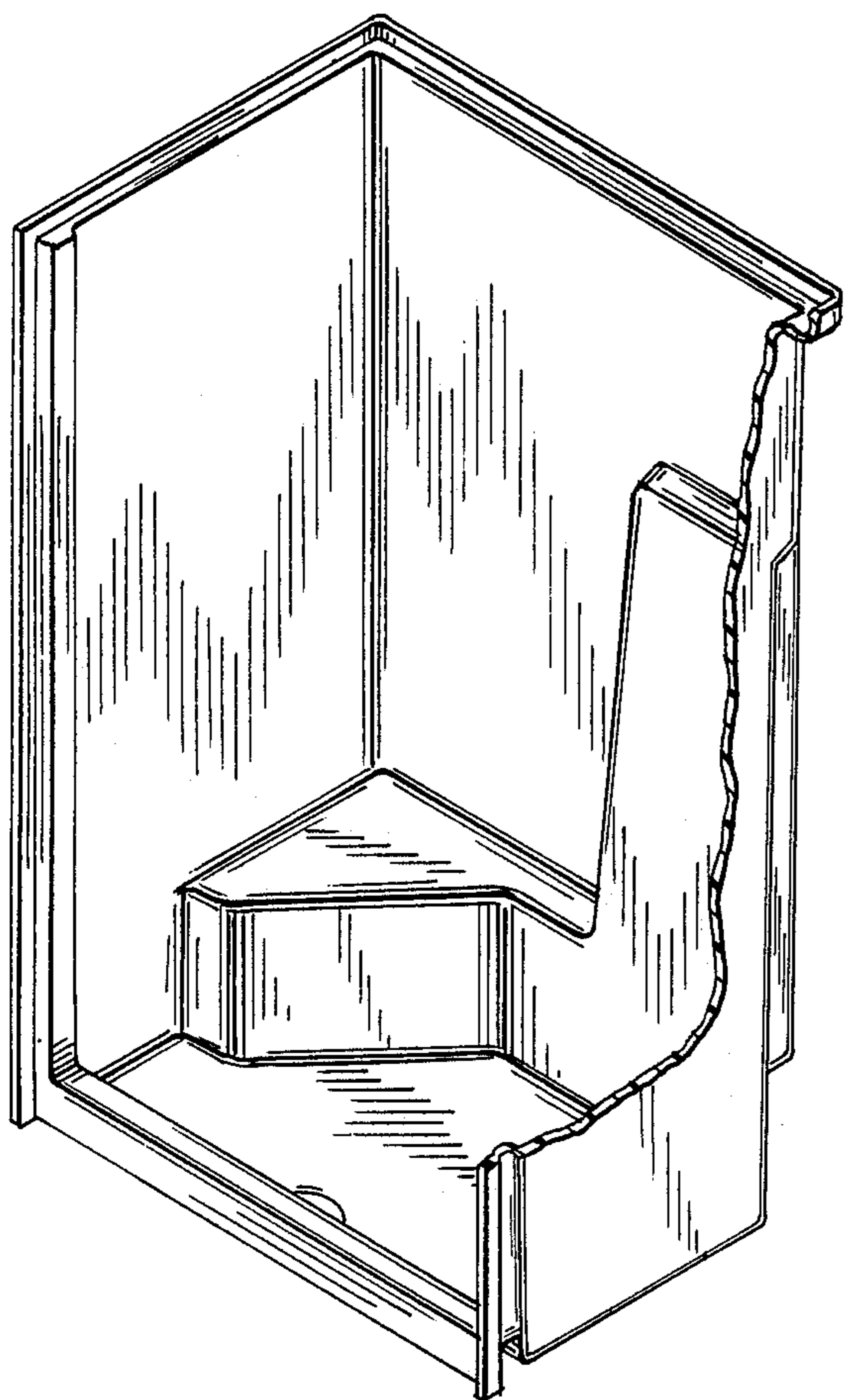

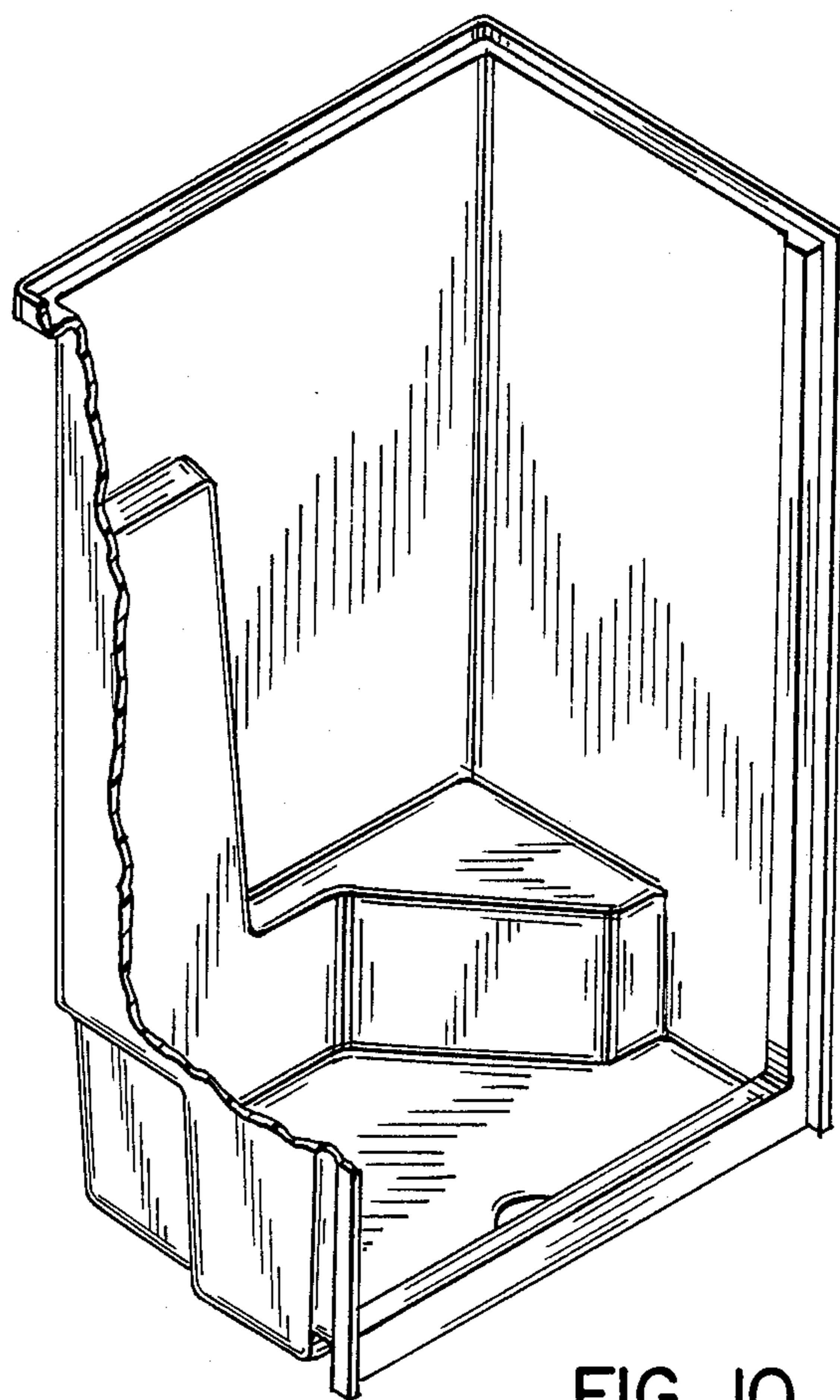

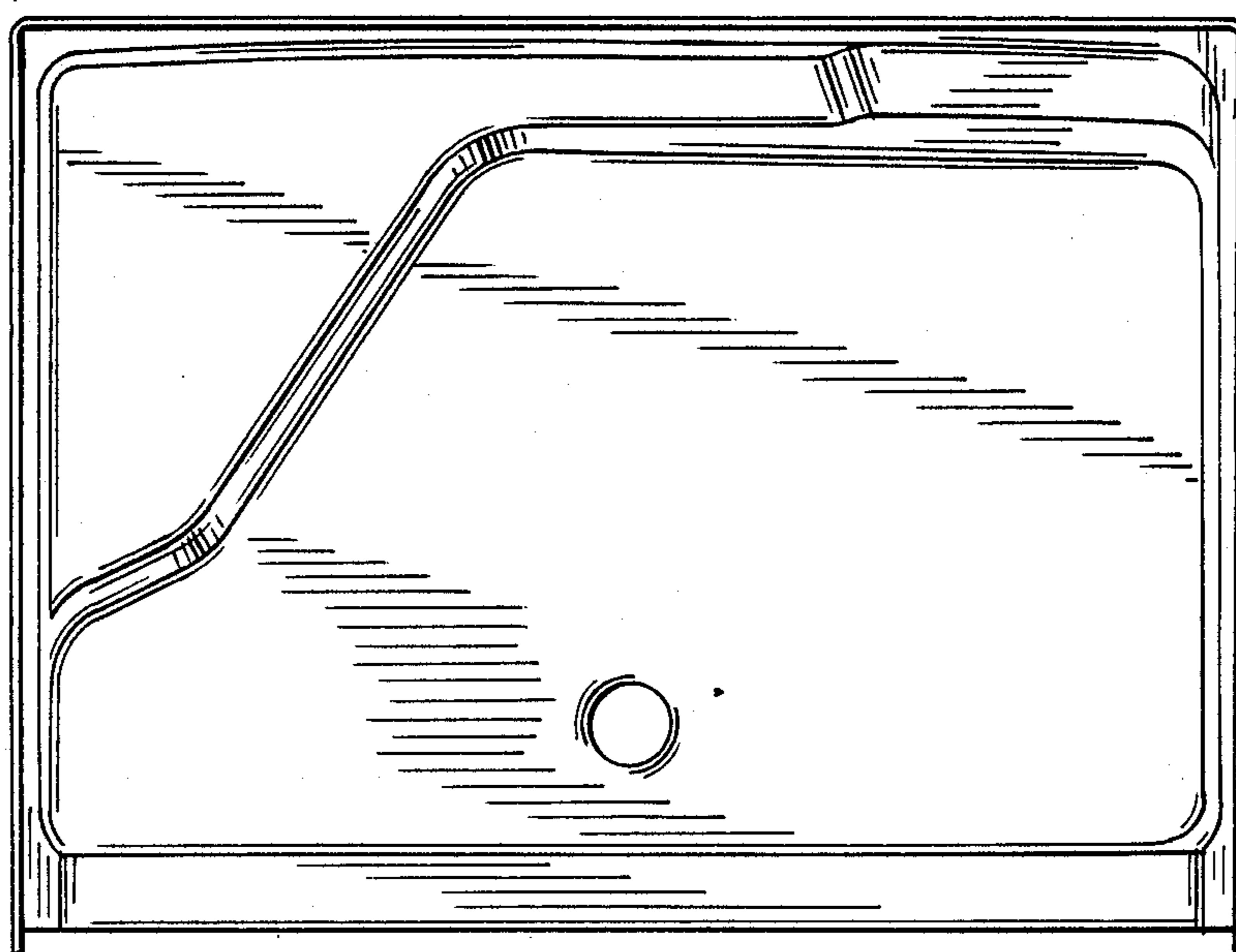

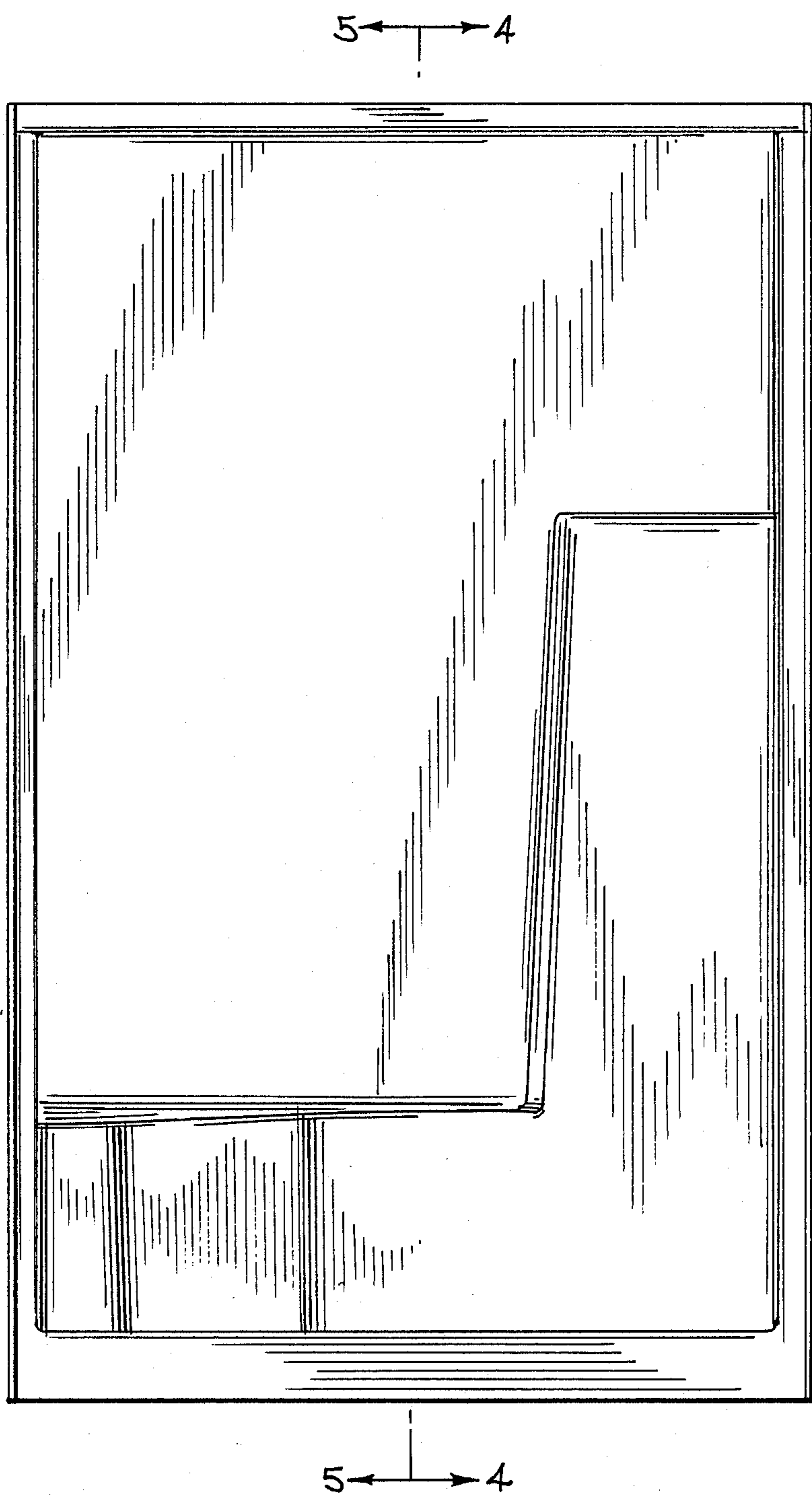

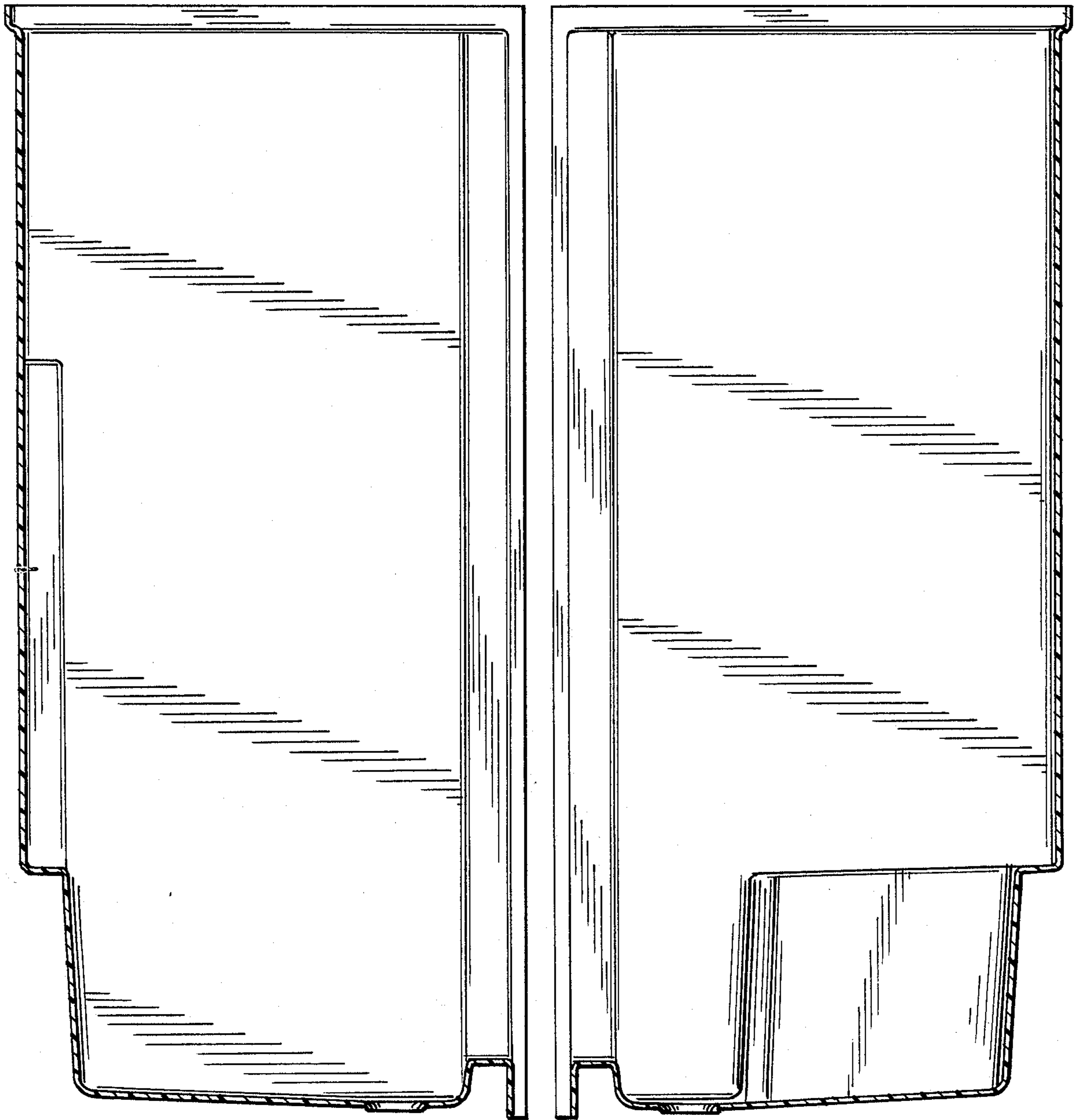

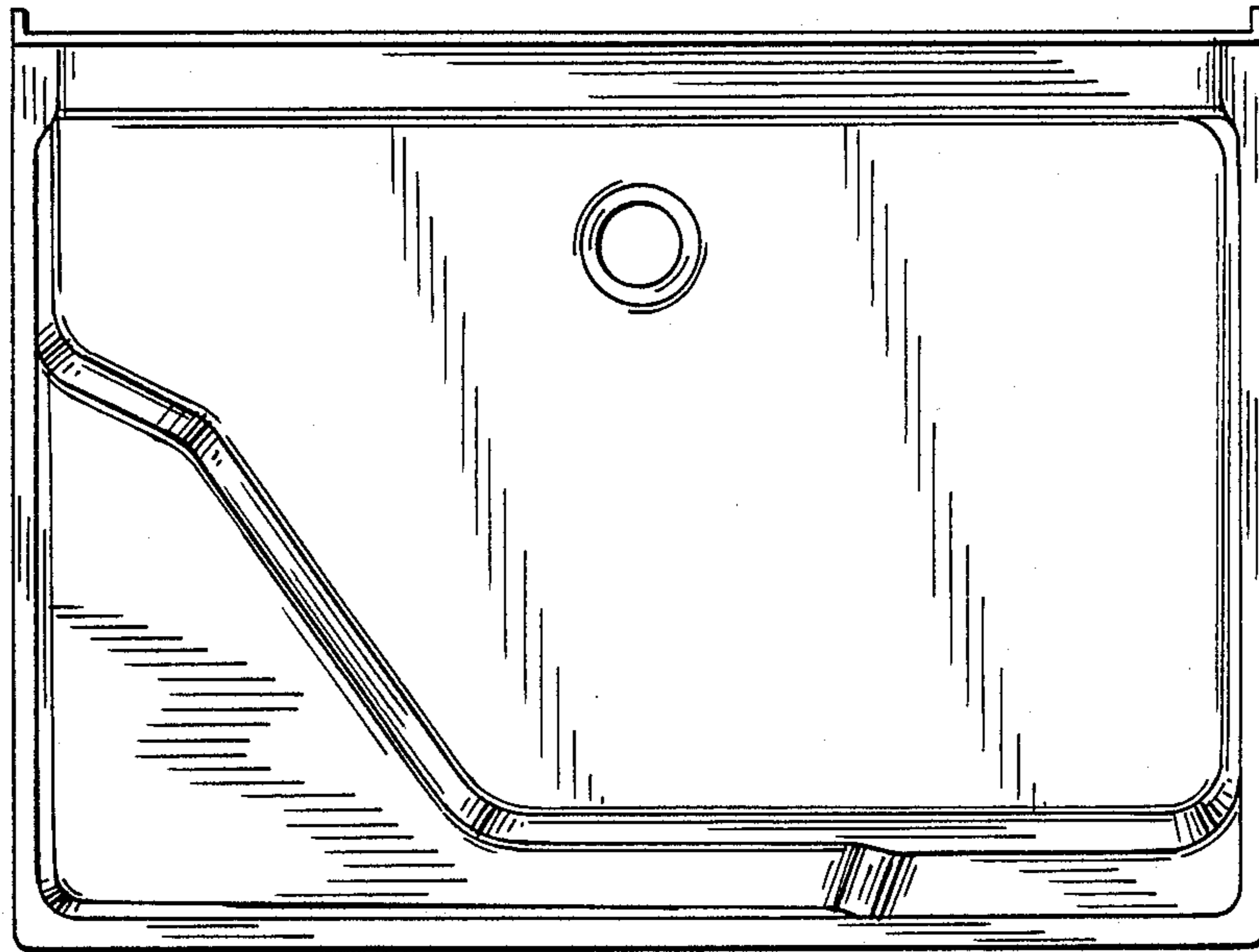

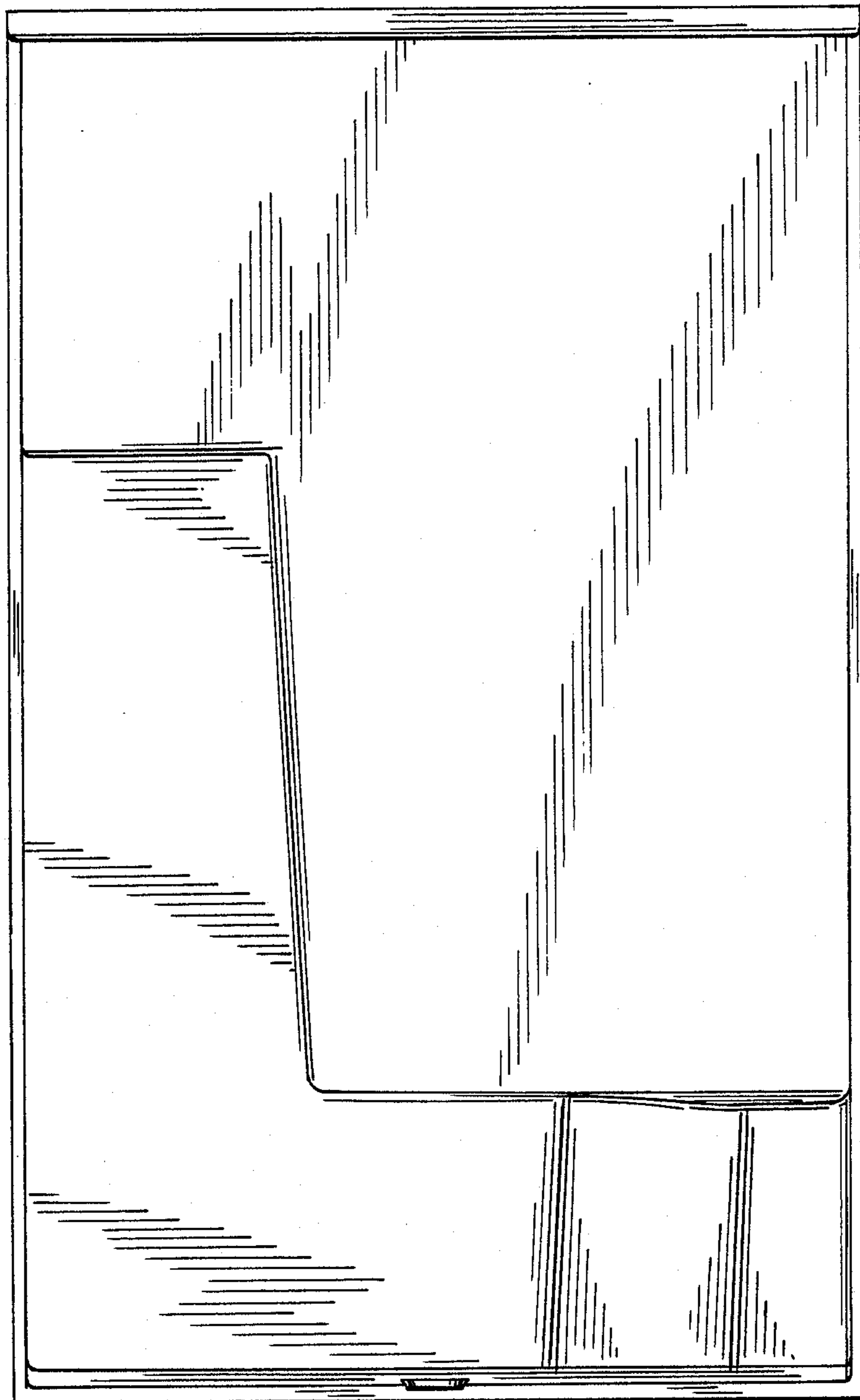

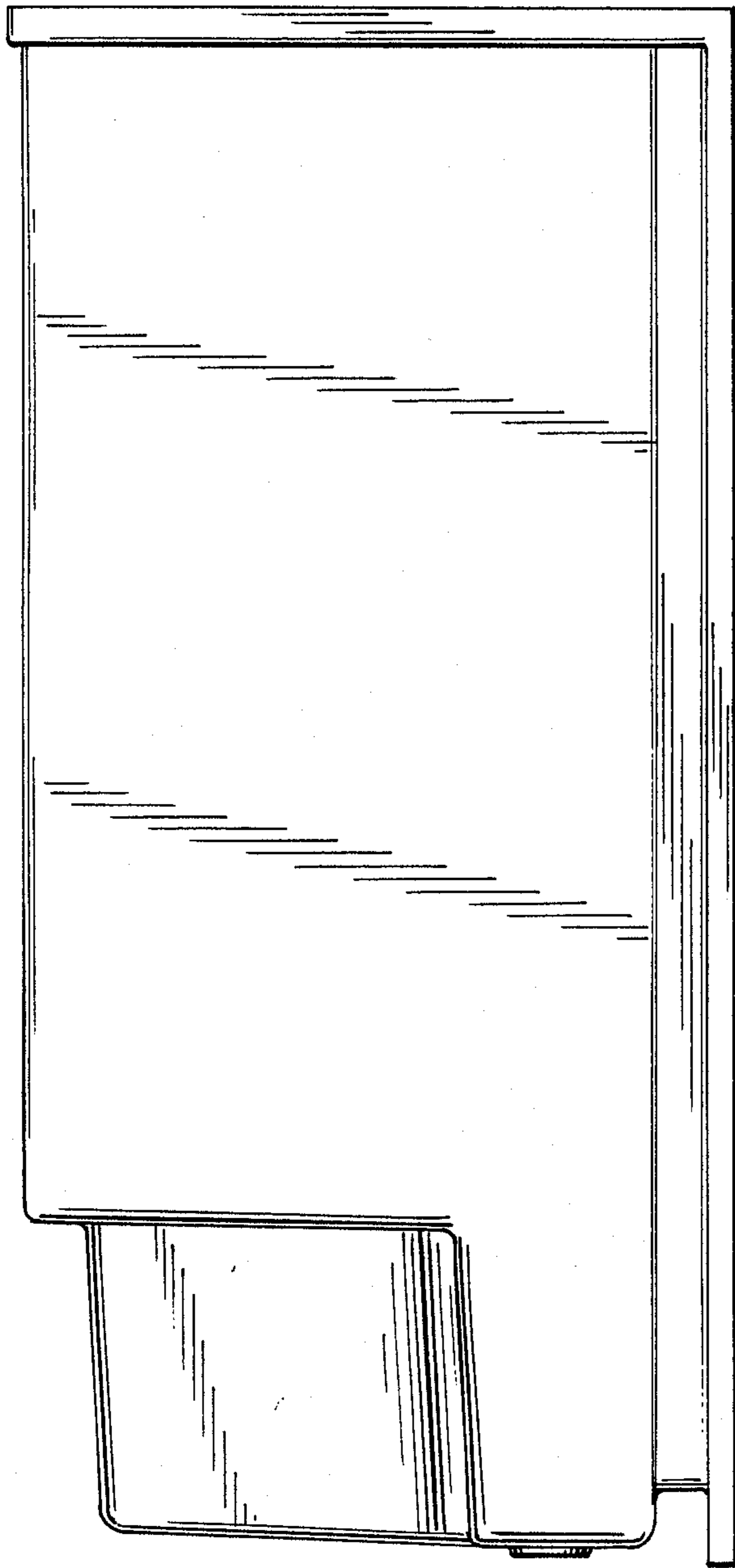

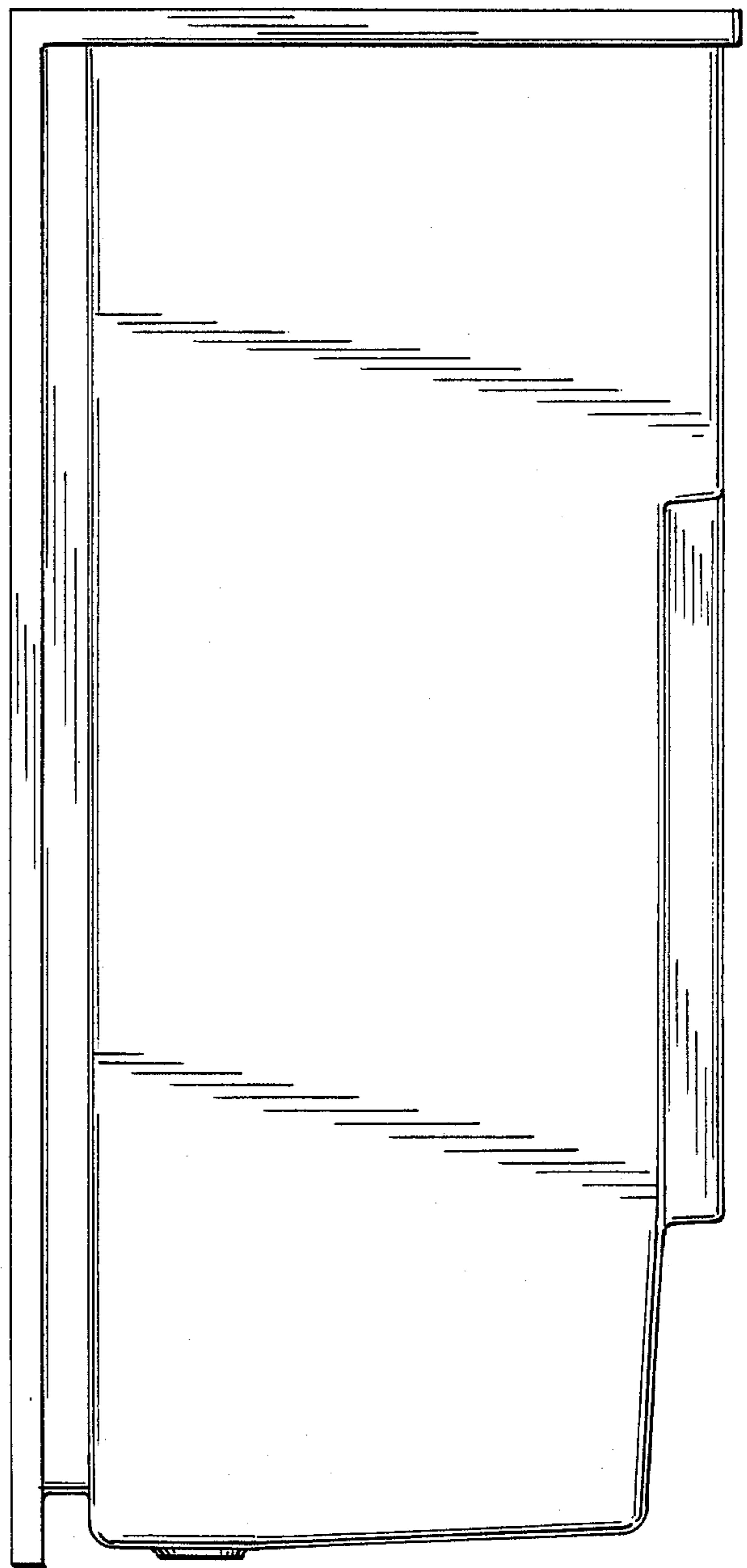
