FIG. 7 is a bottom plan thereof.

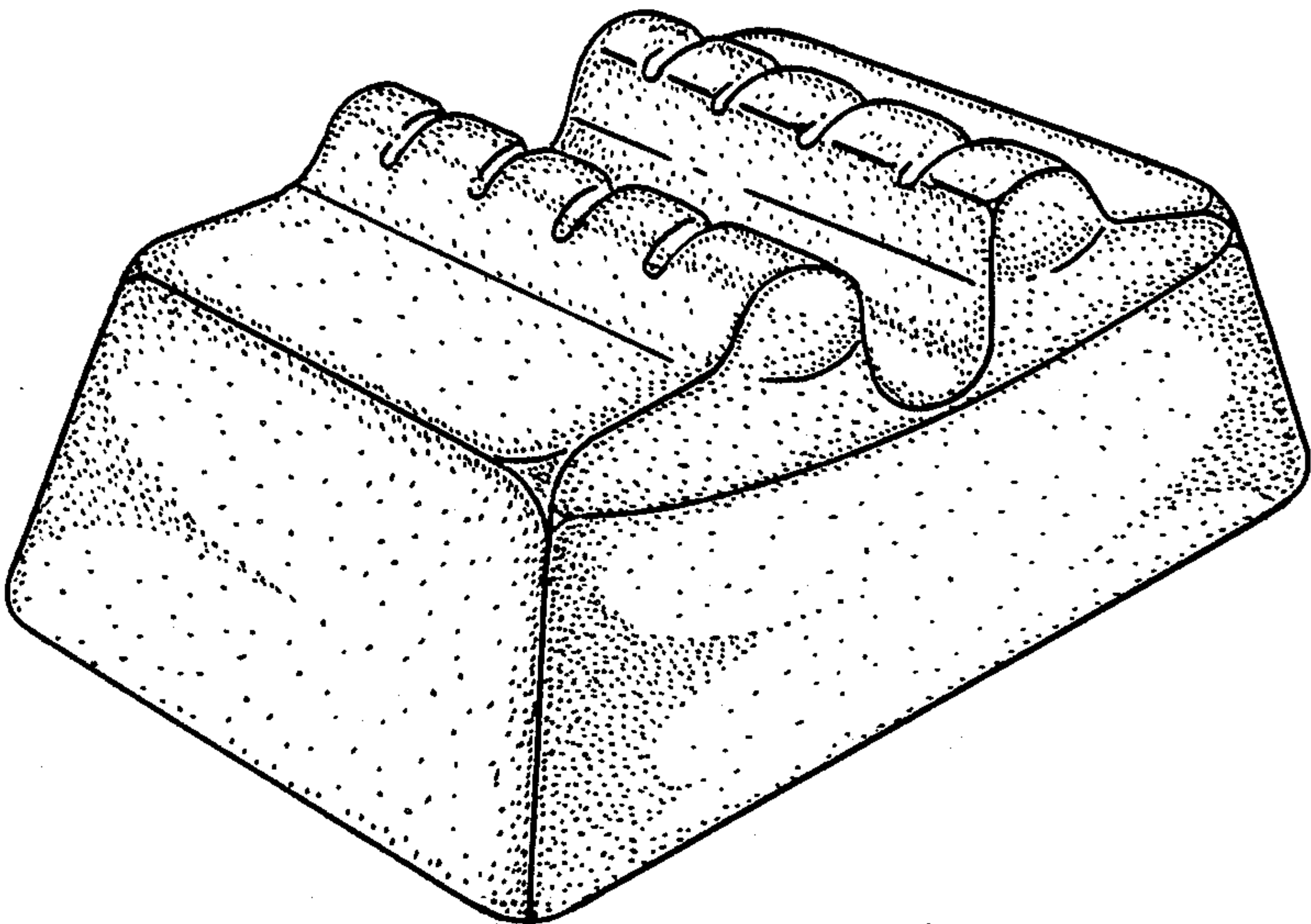

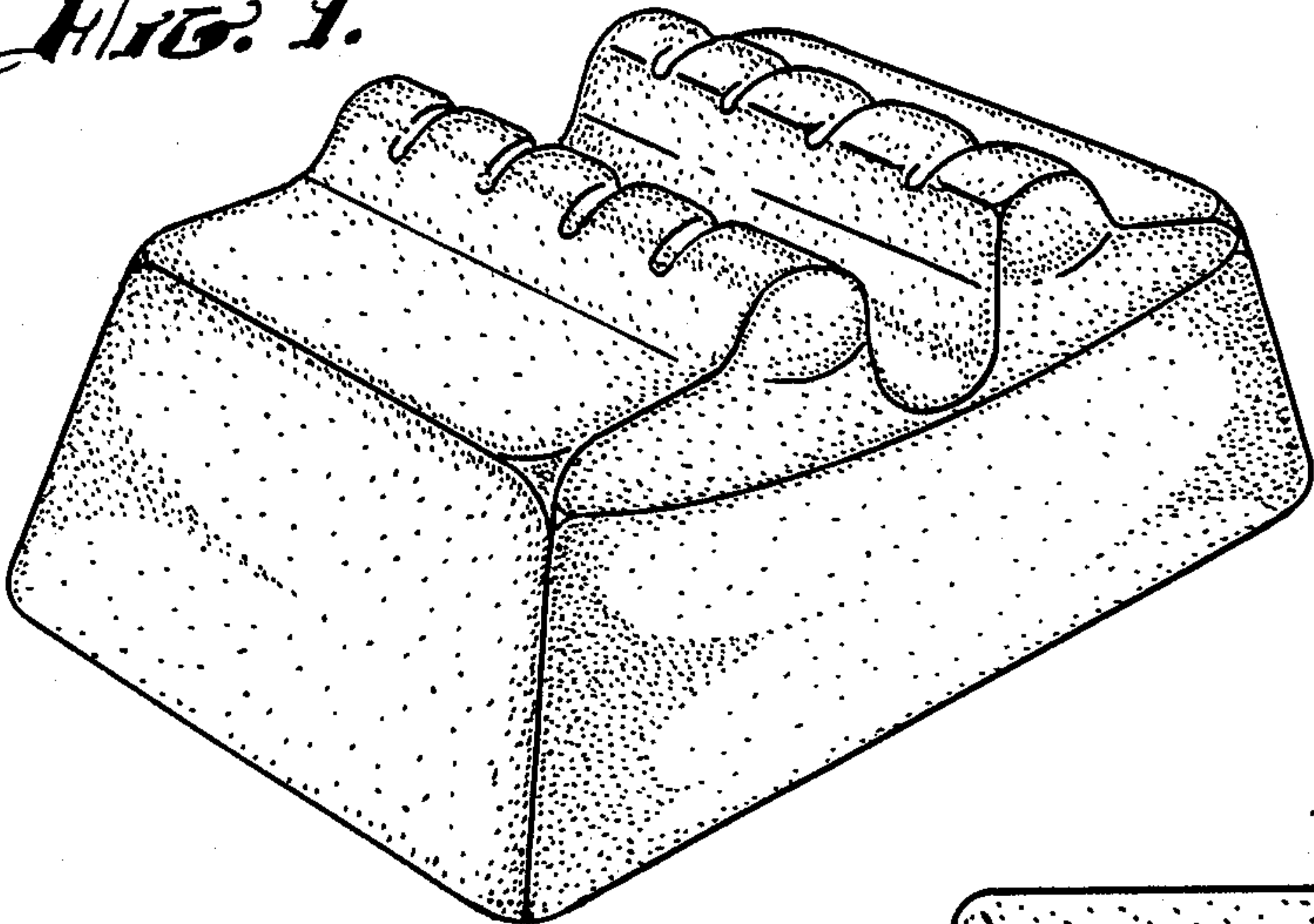

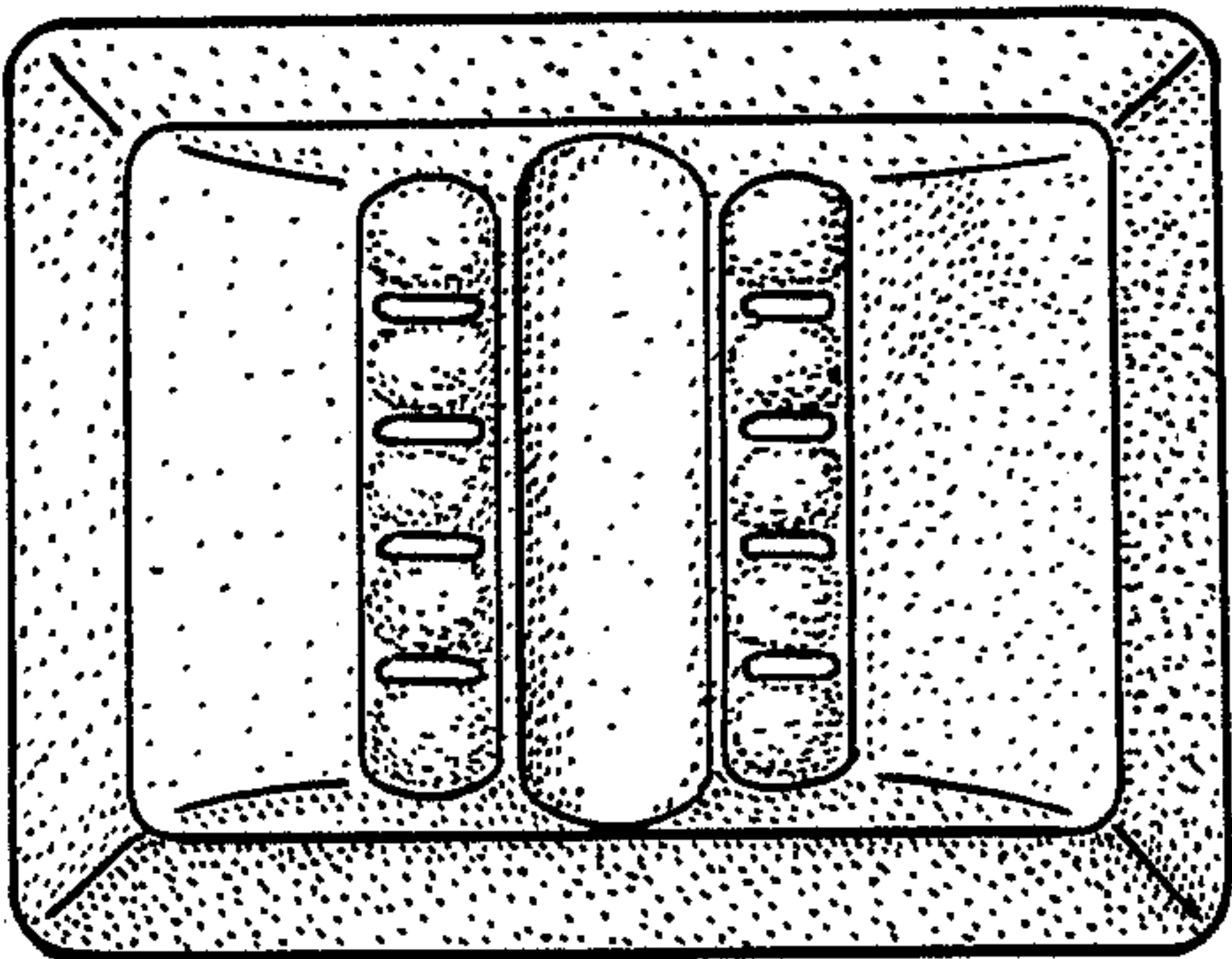

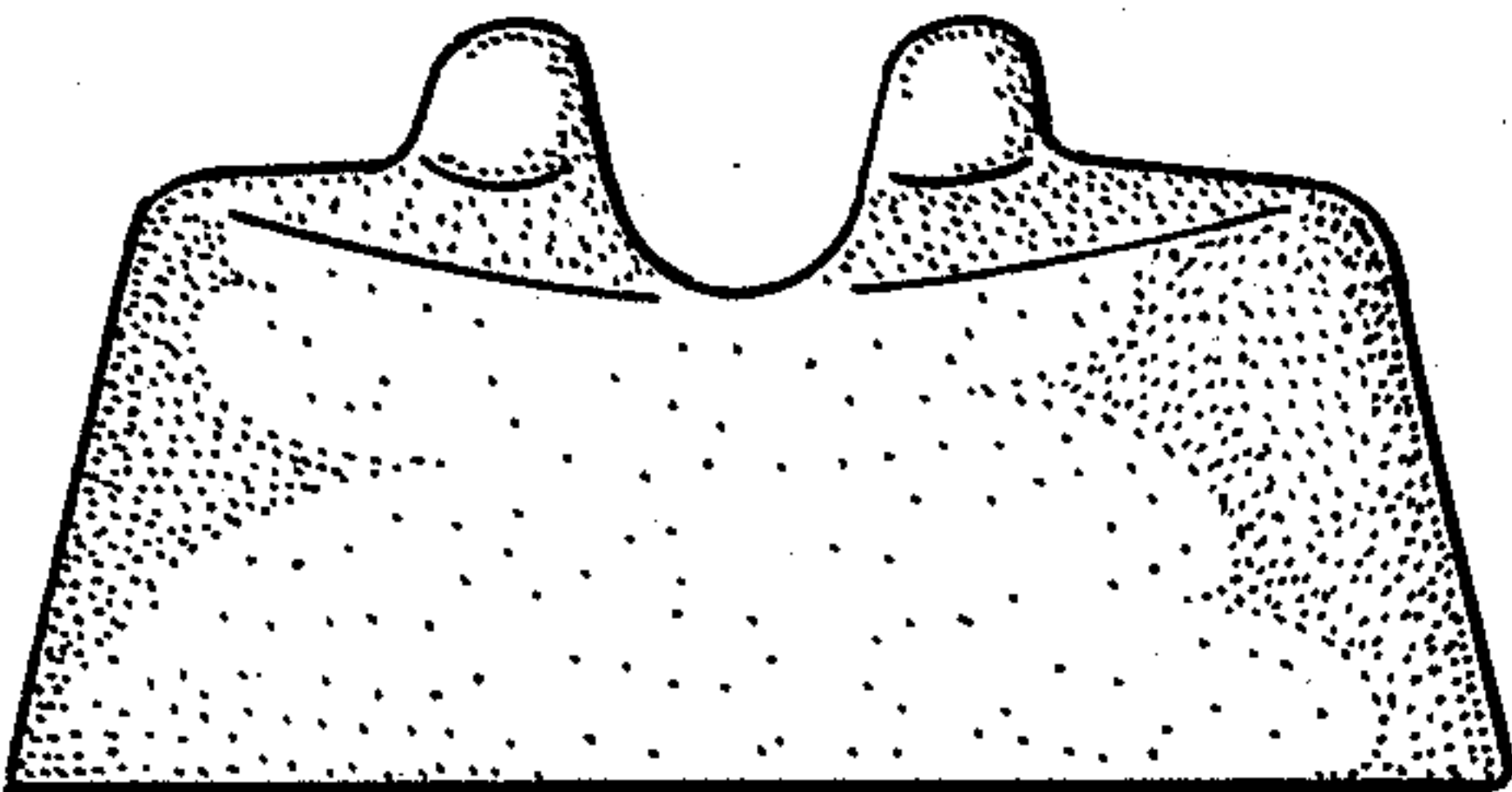

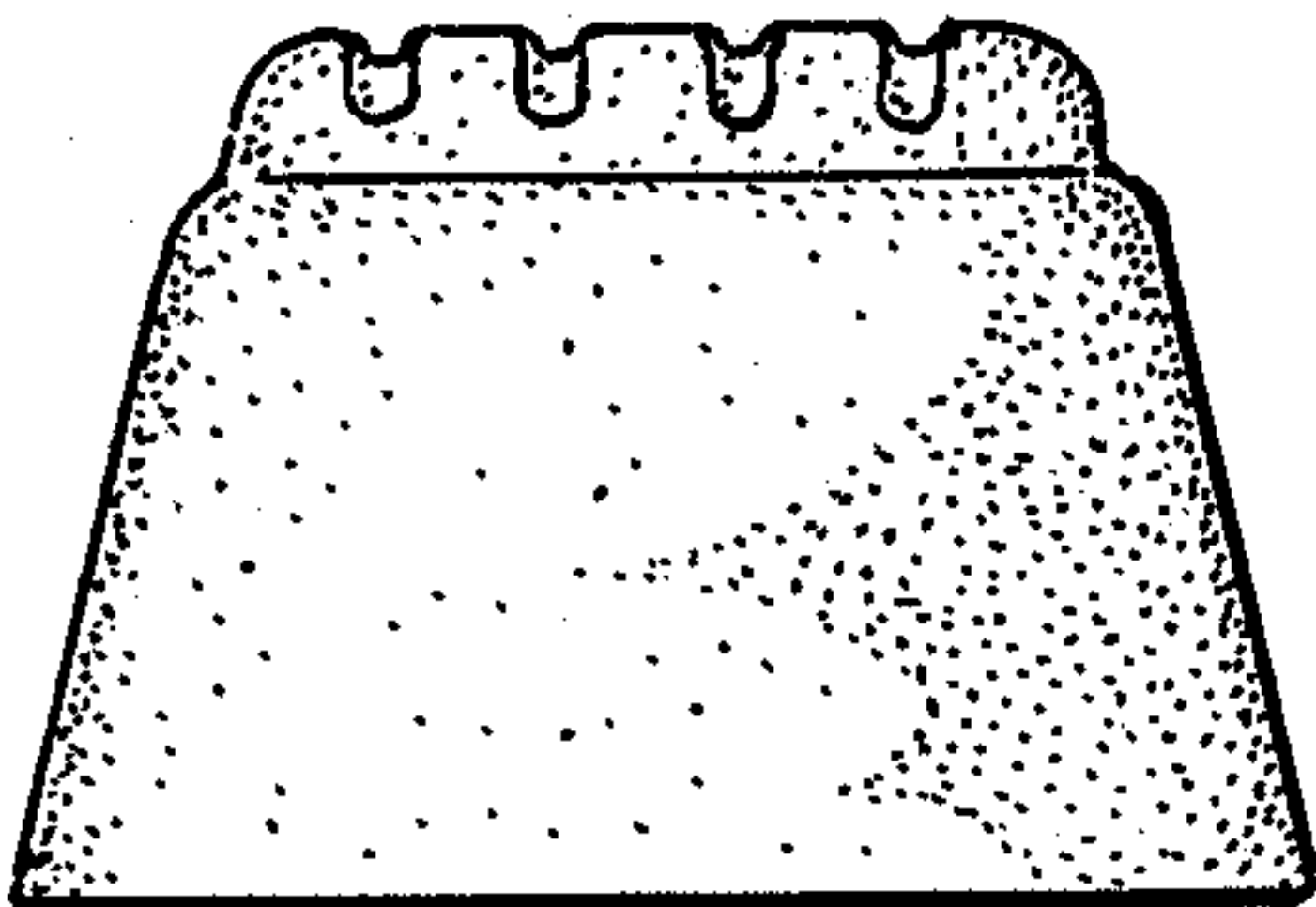

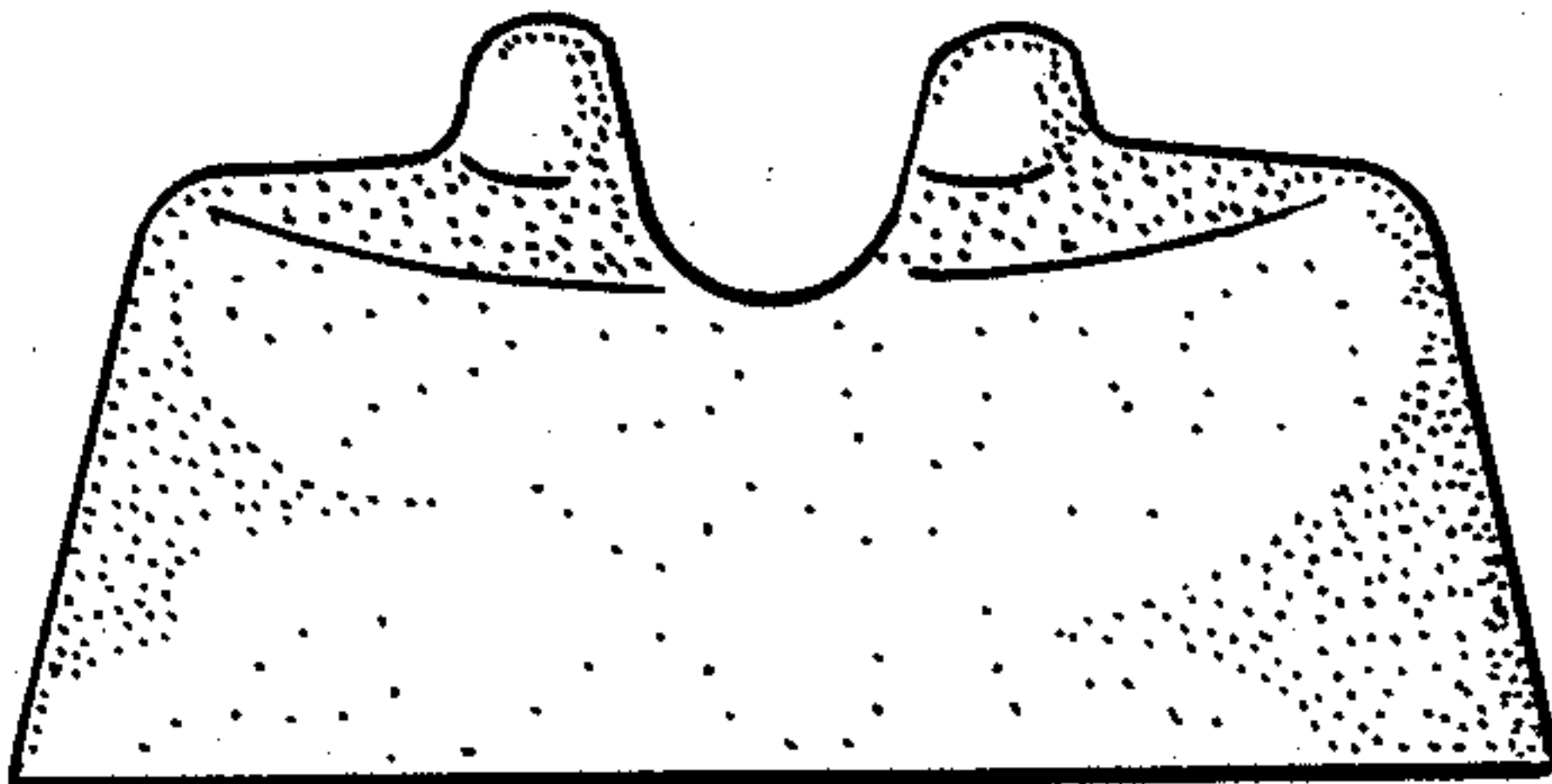

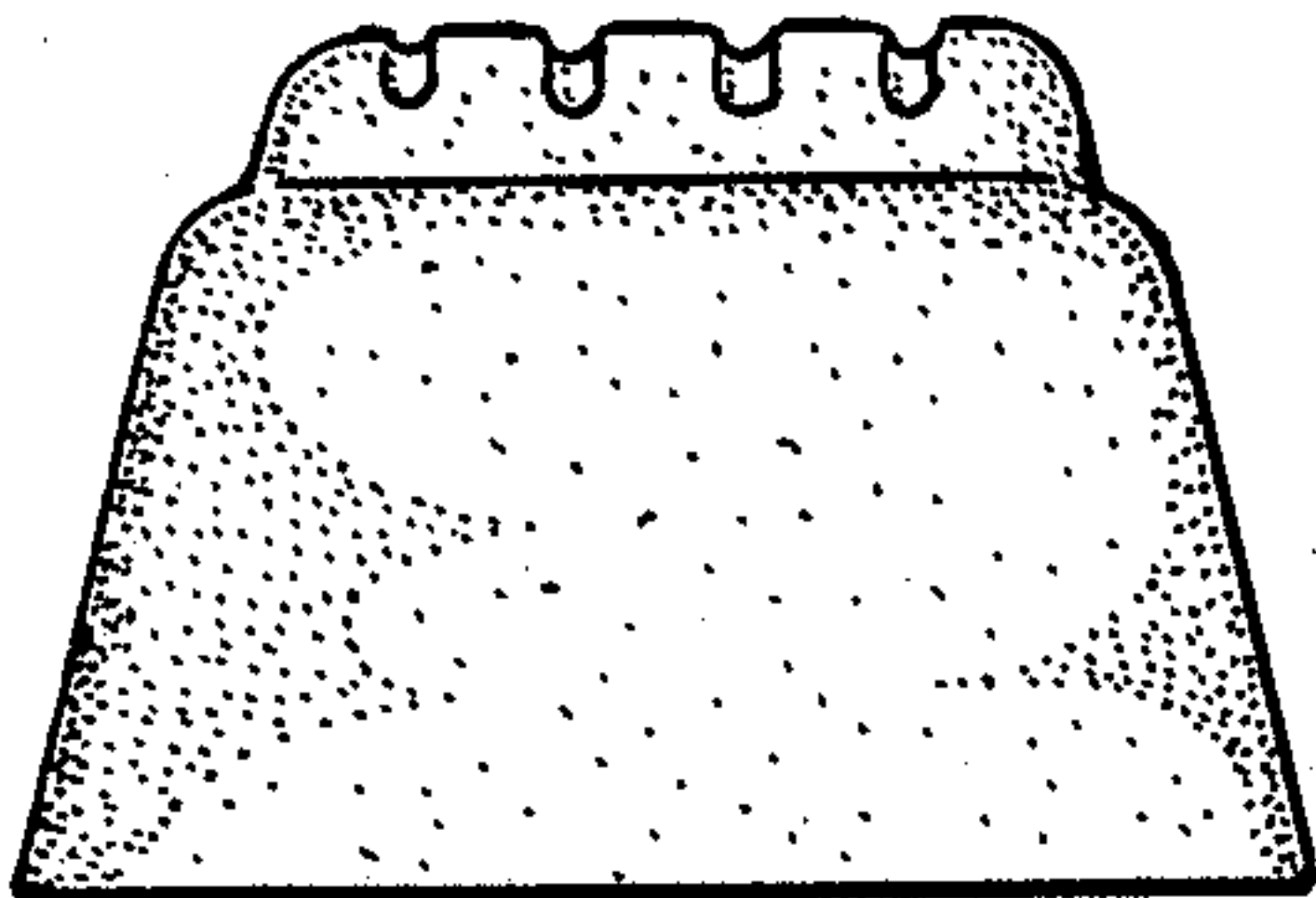
