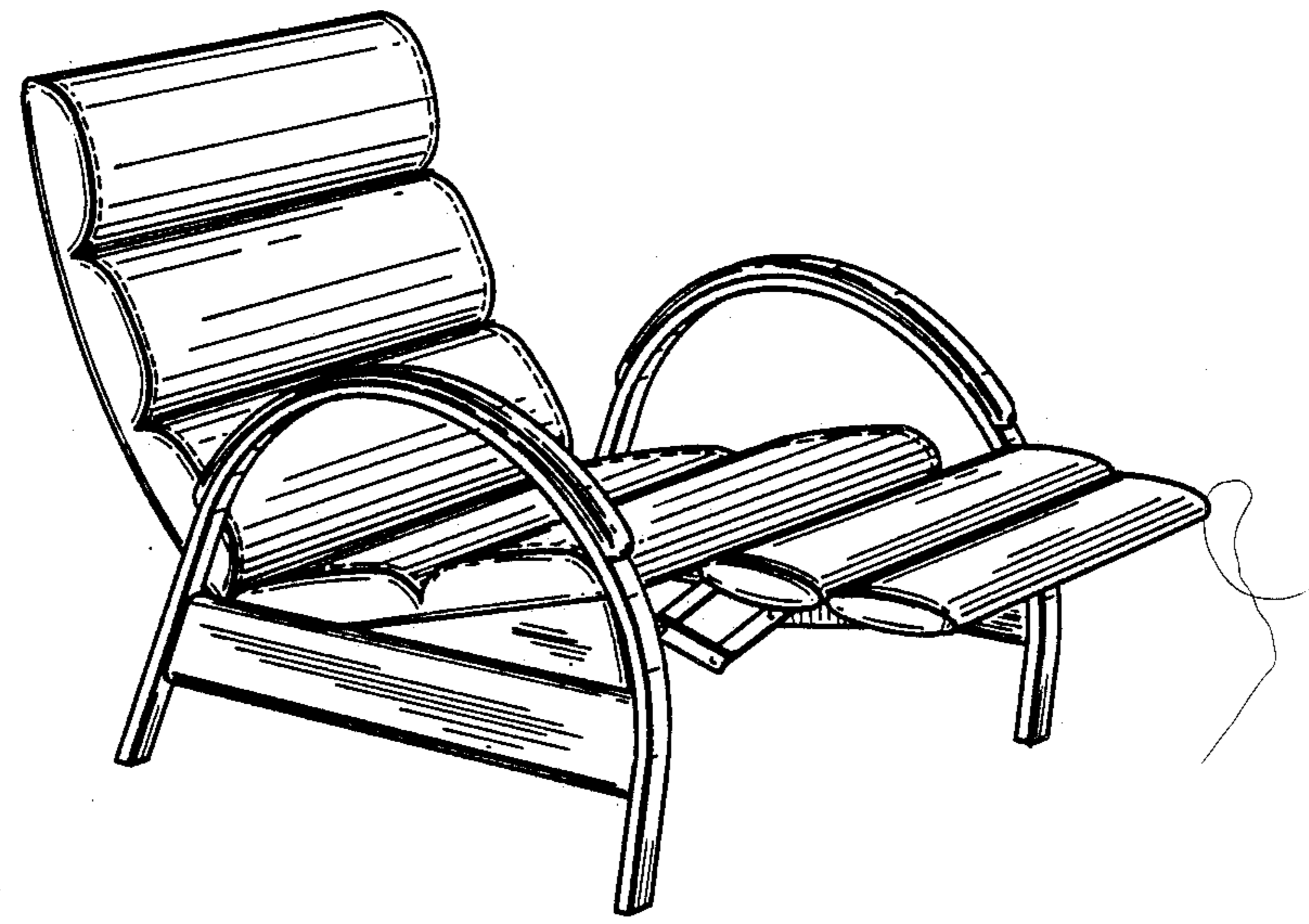

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of an adjustable chair or similar article showing a second embodiment of my new design.



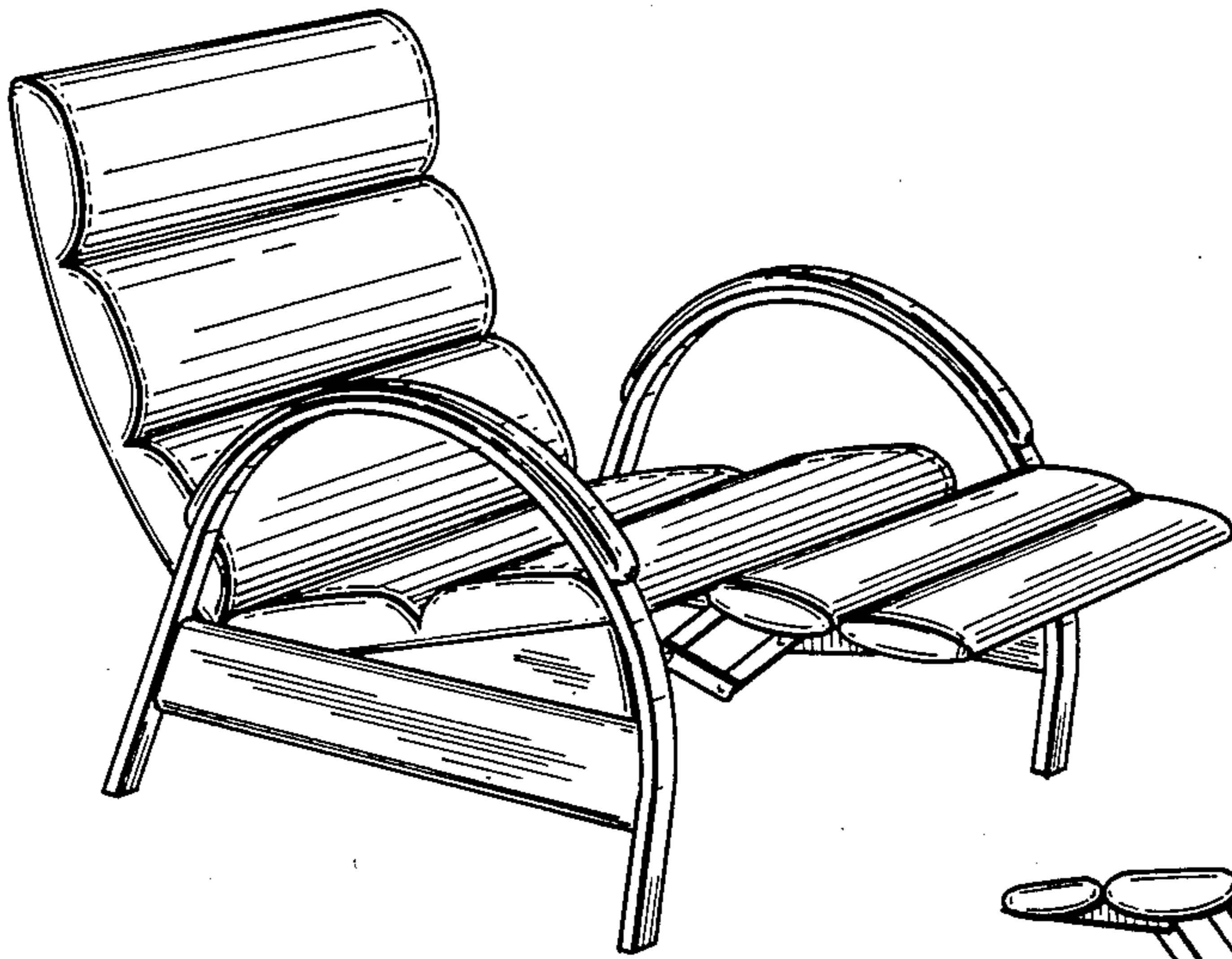

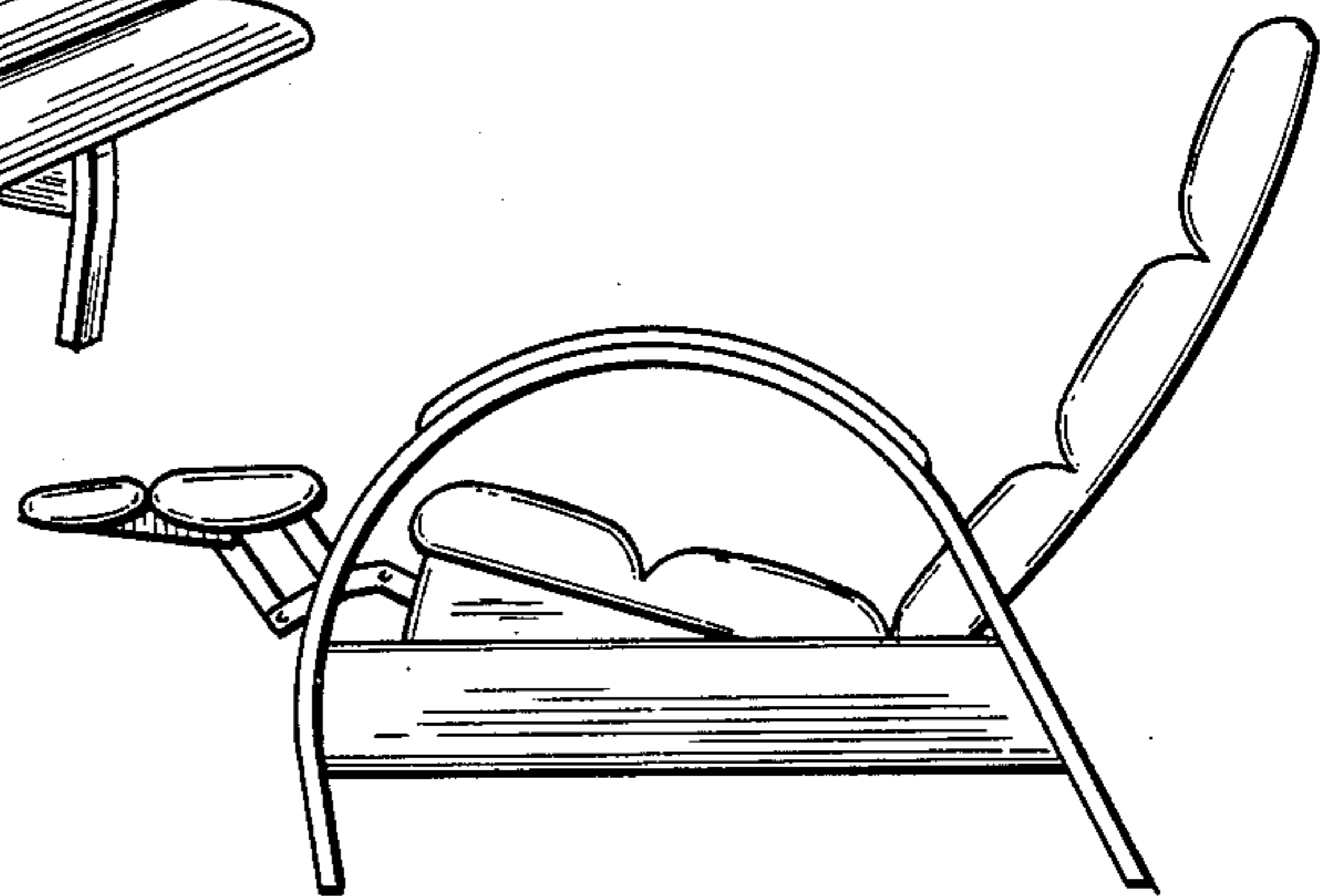

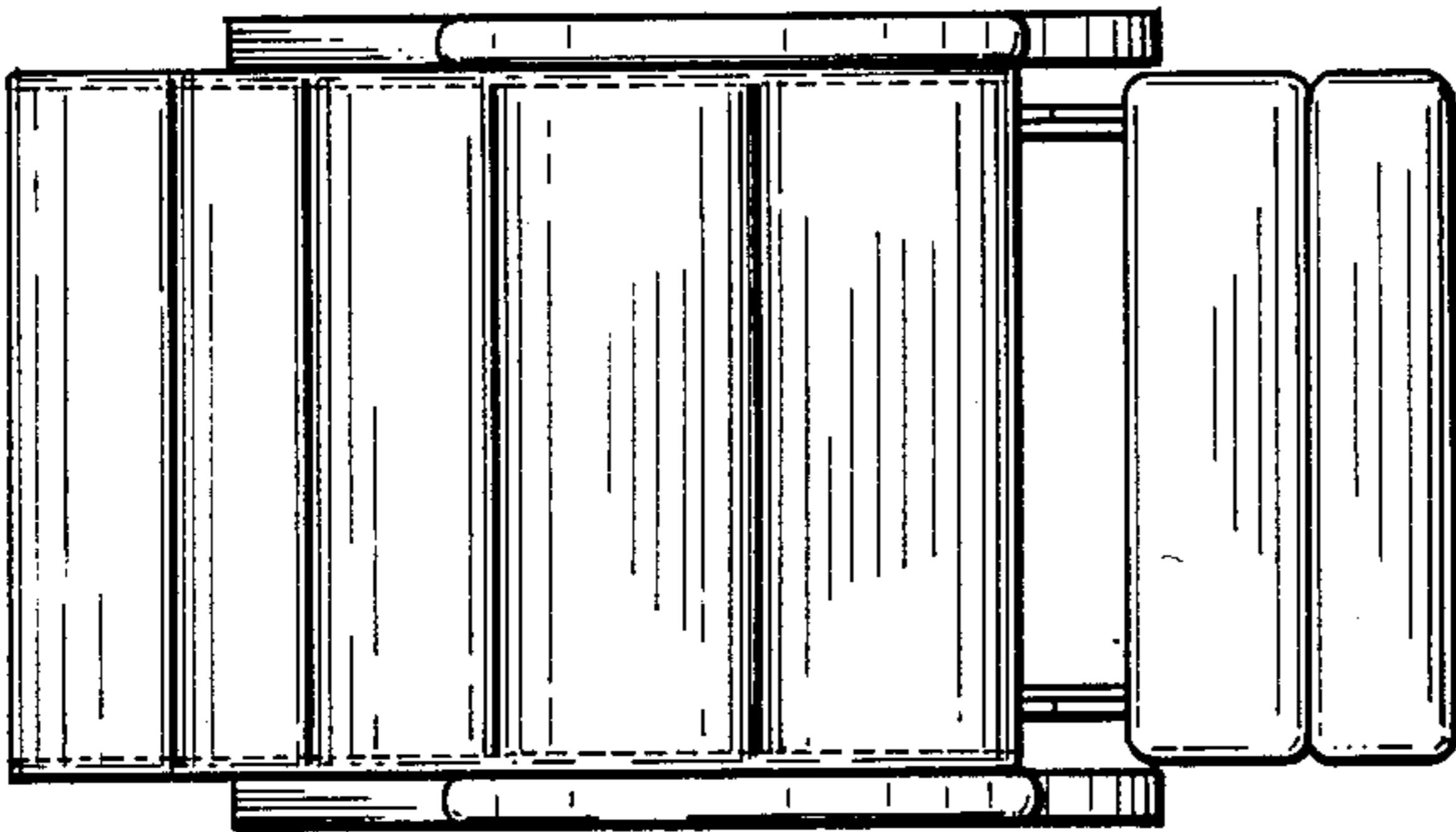

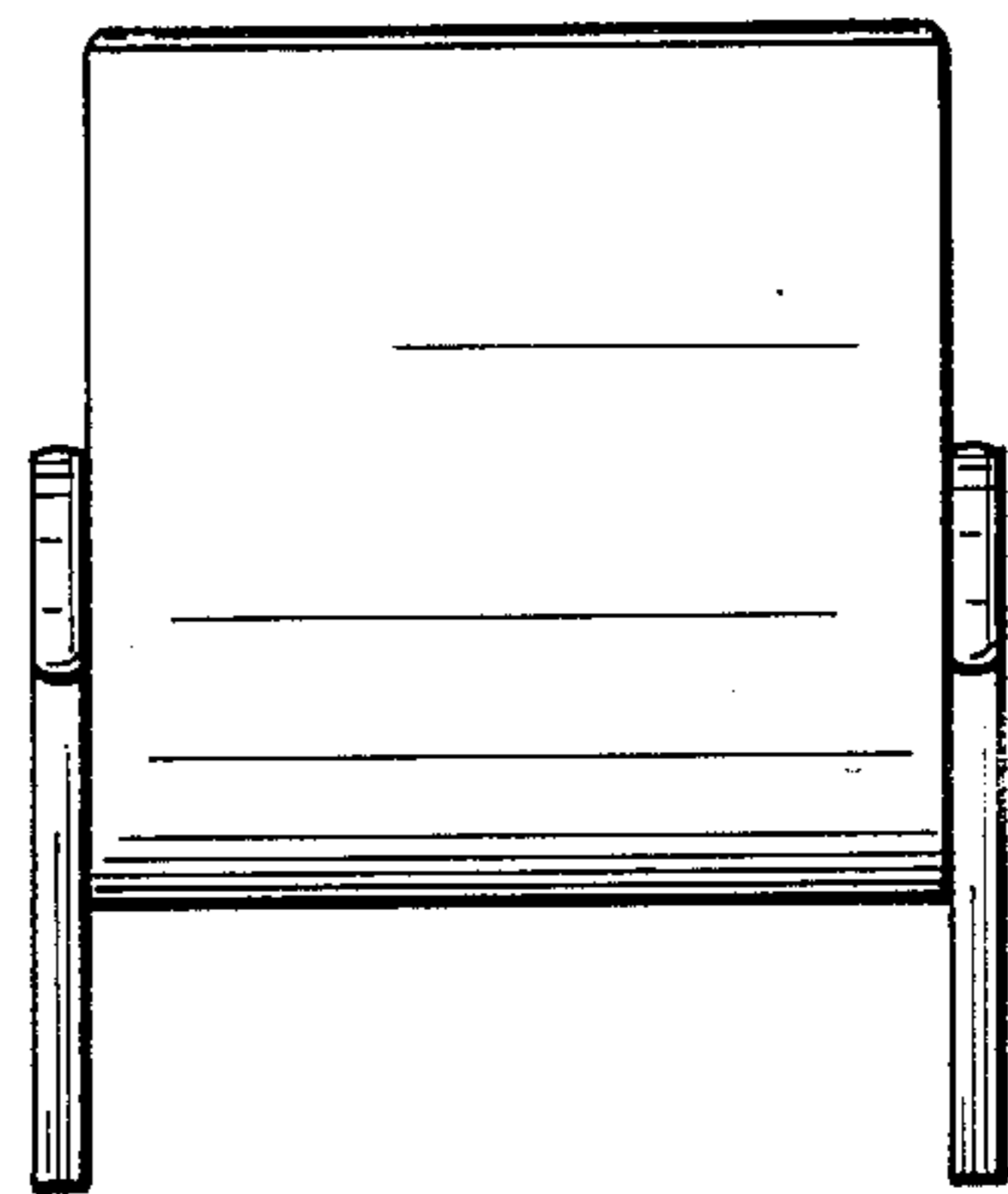

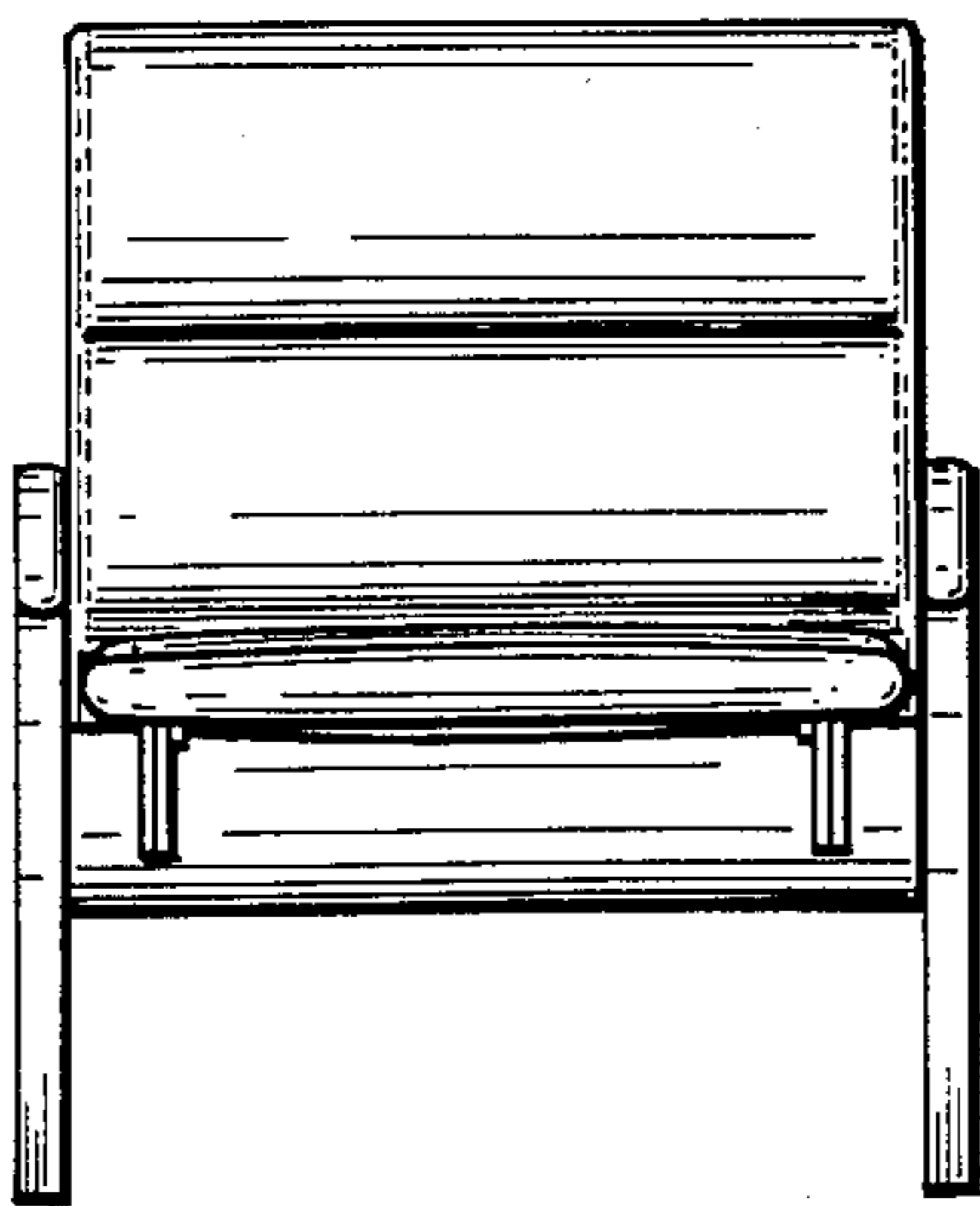

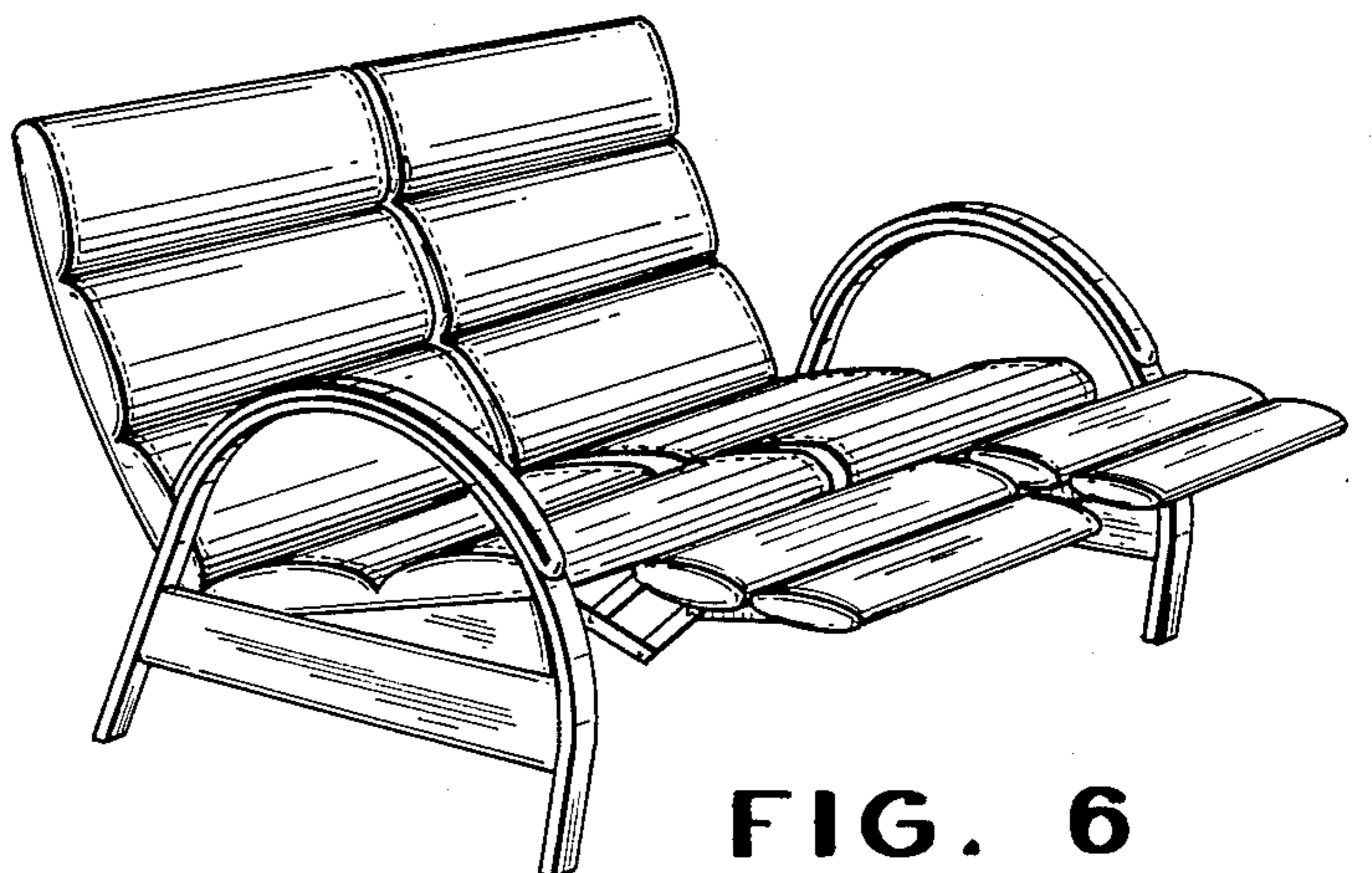
