DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a second embodiment of our new design; and  
 FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the FIG. 1, embodiment.  
 The sides of the chair forms not shown are mirror images of the respective sides shown.

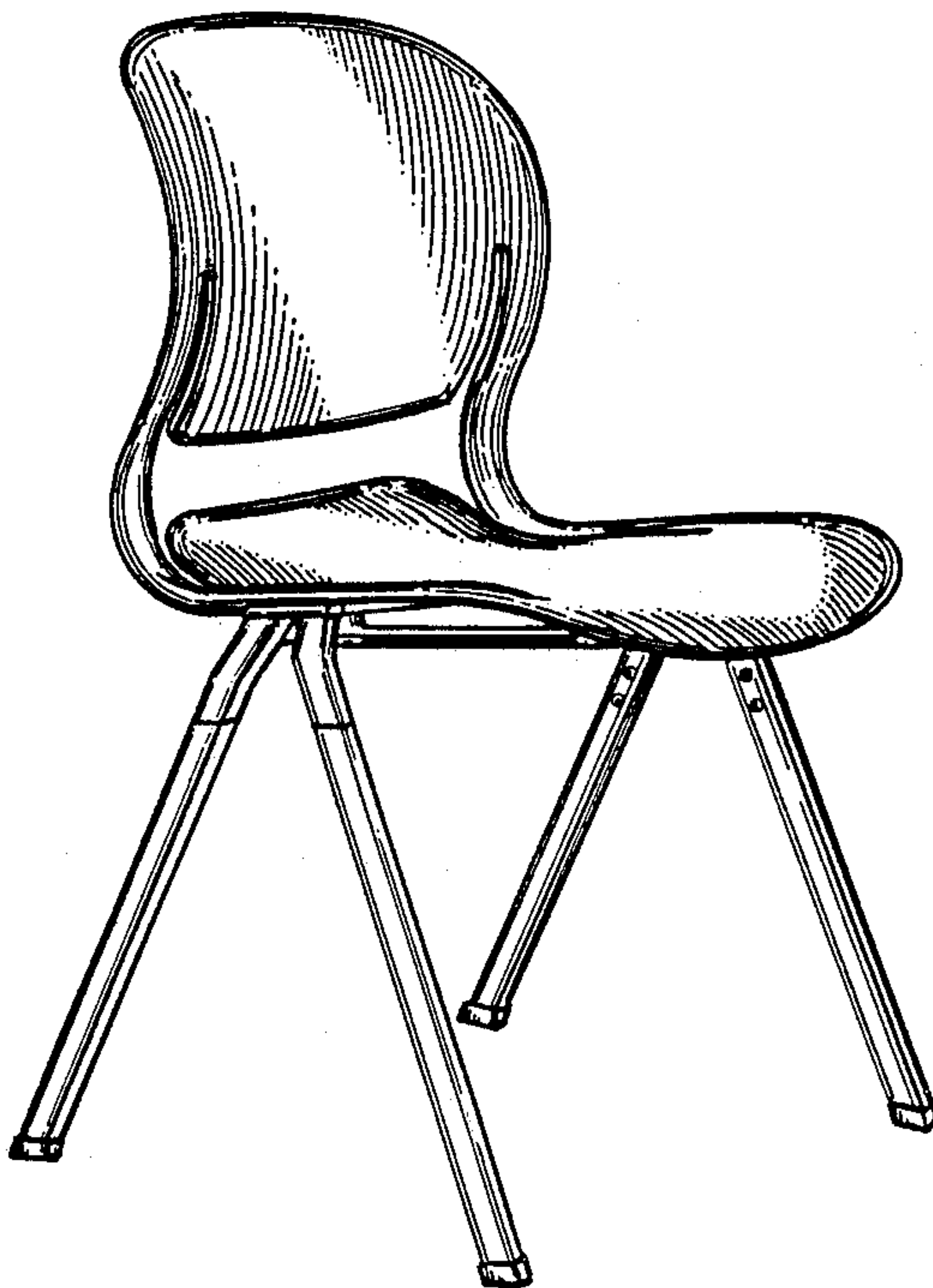

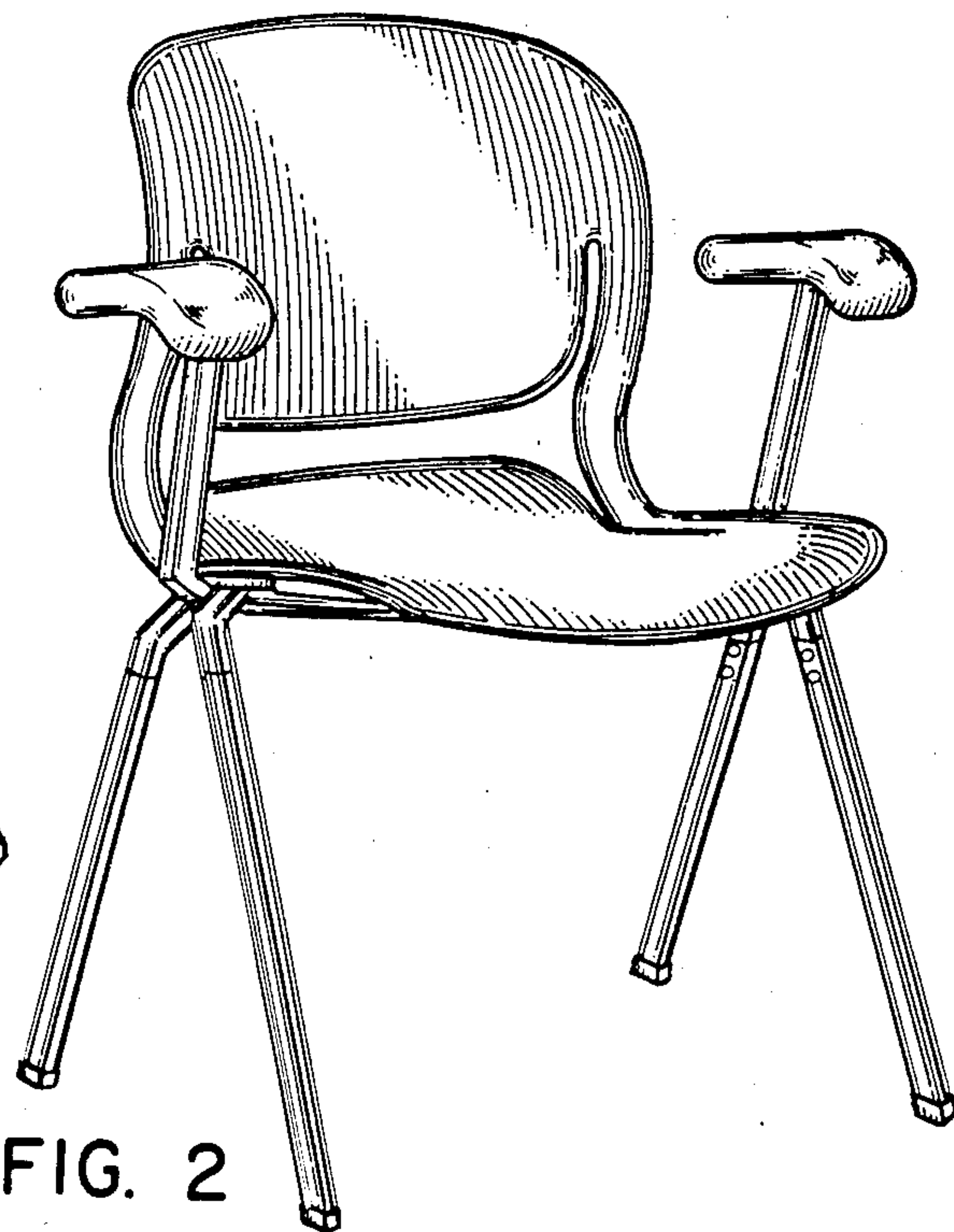

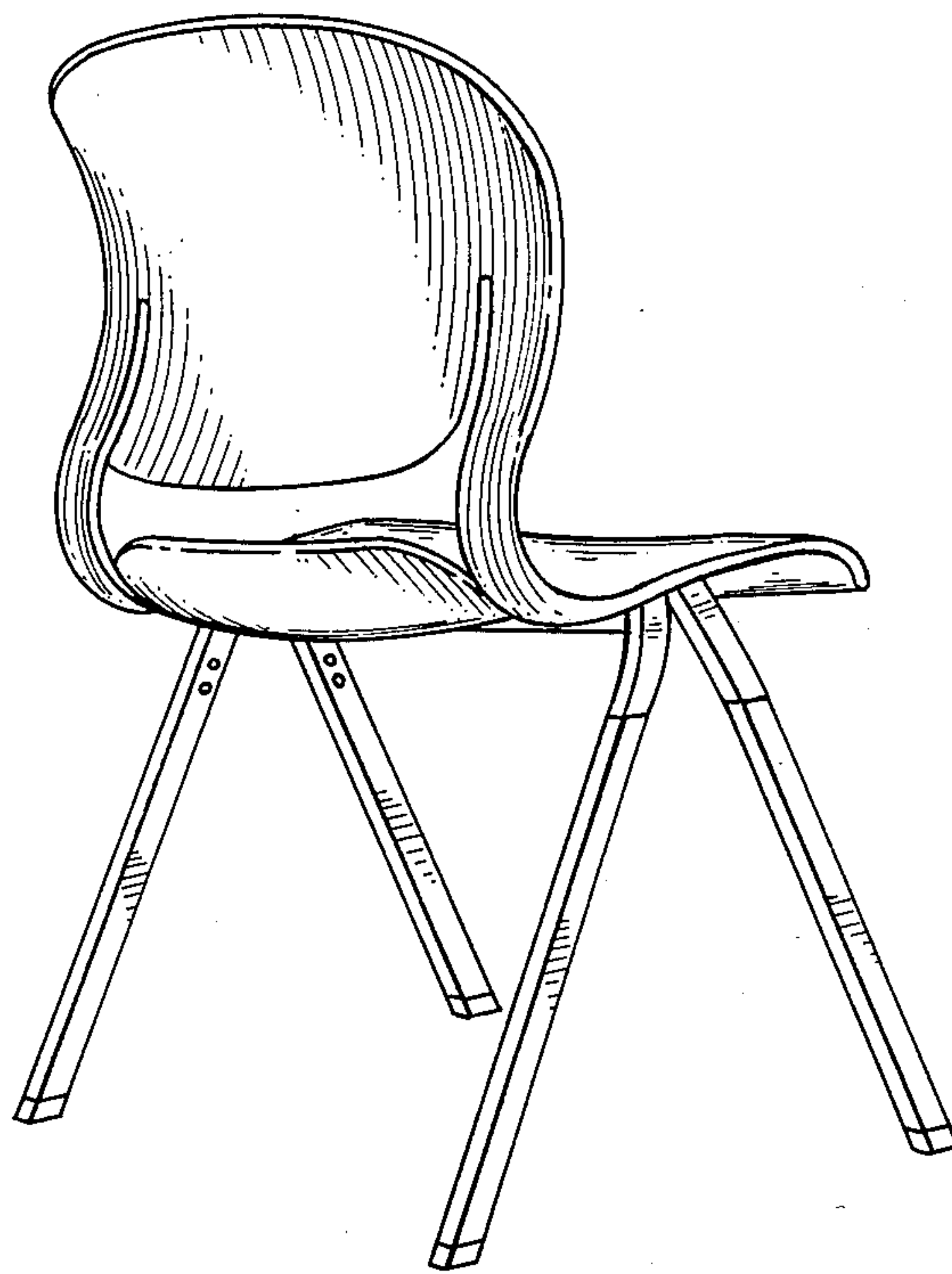
