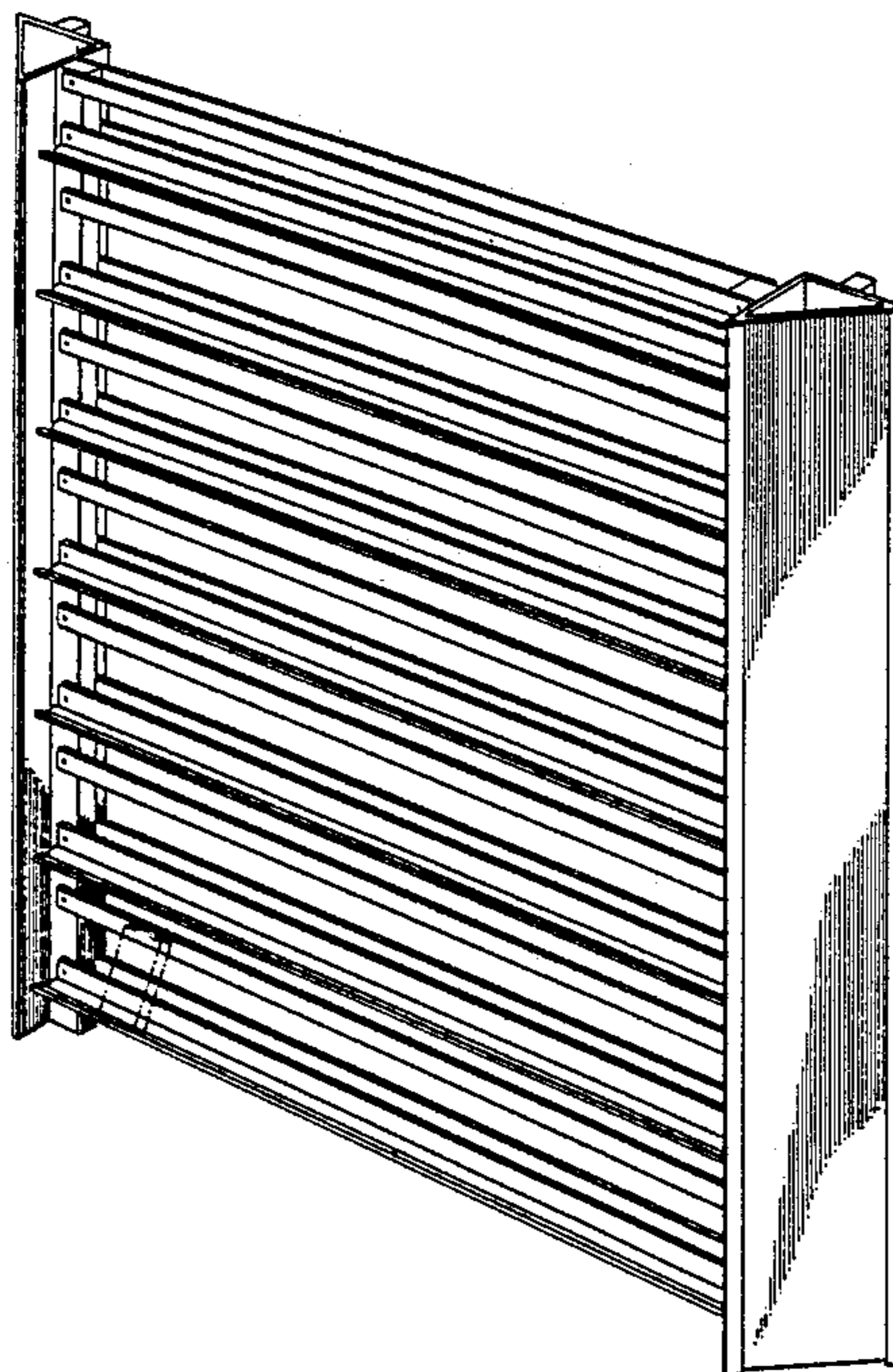
The ornamental design for a modular video cassette display rack, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a modular video cassette display rack showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, with the horizontal shelves shortened for convenience of illustration:

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a fragmentary detailed view of the support shelf.

The broken line showing of a cassette in FIGS. 1, 4, 6 and 8 are for illustrative purposes only.



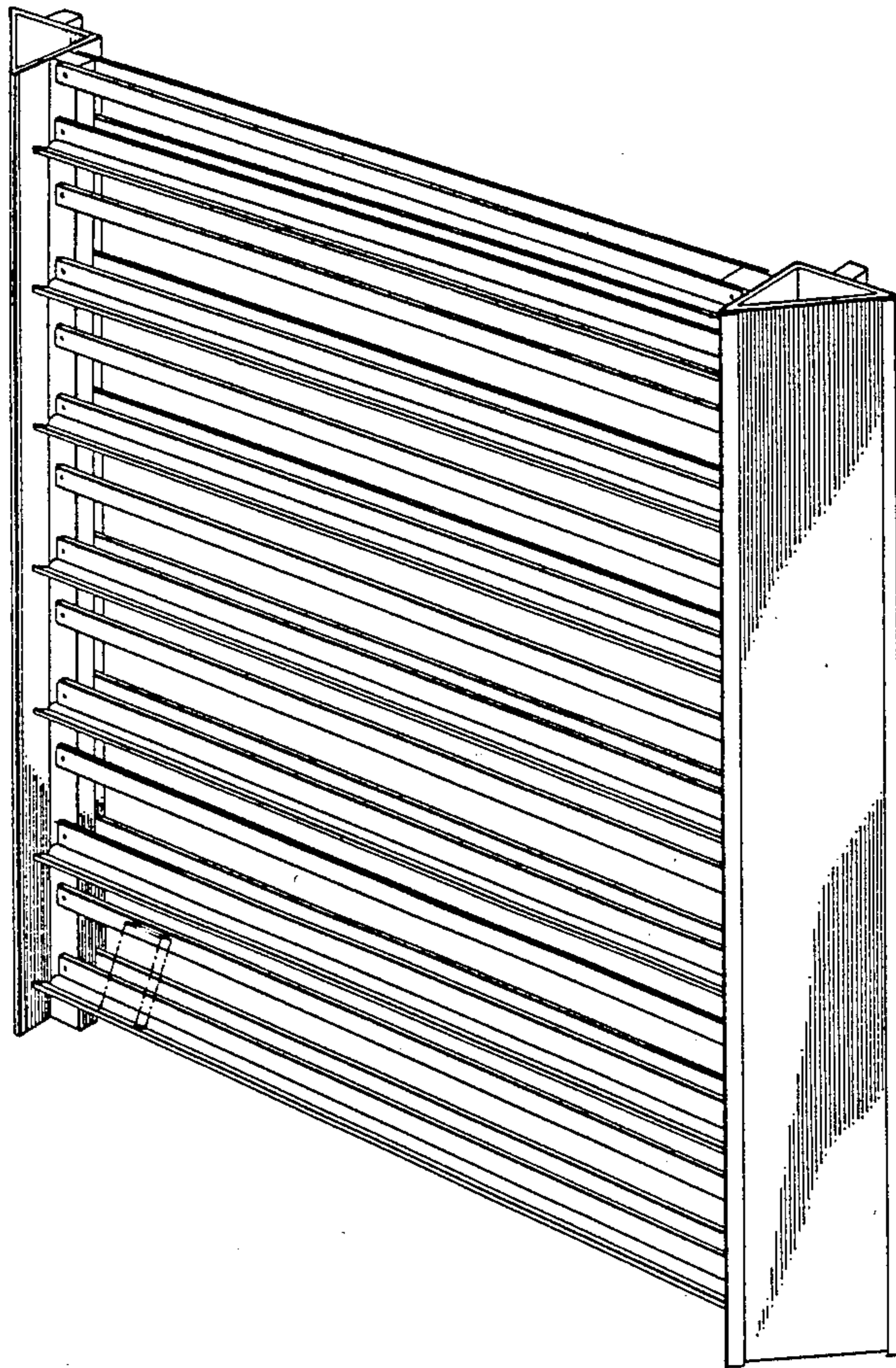

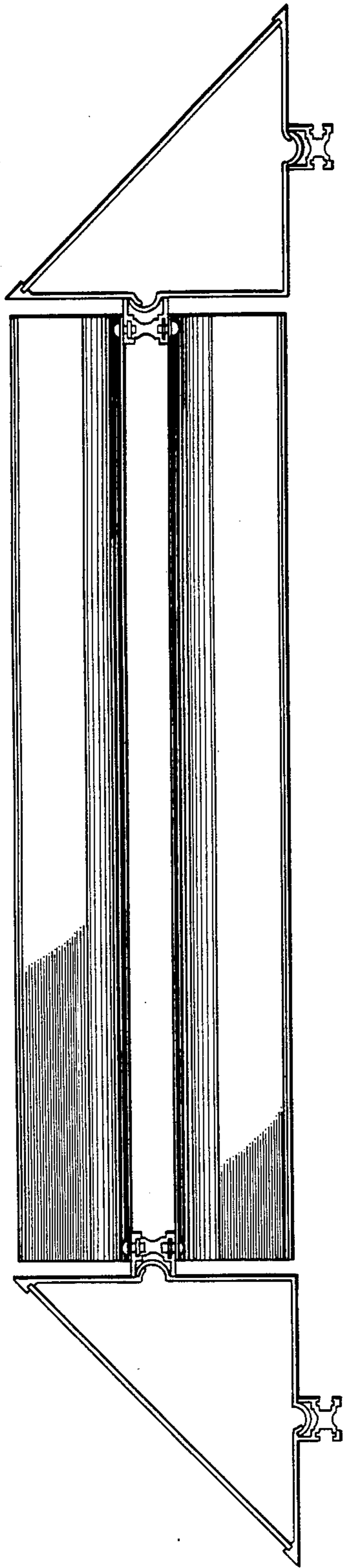

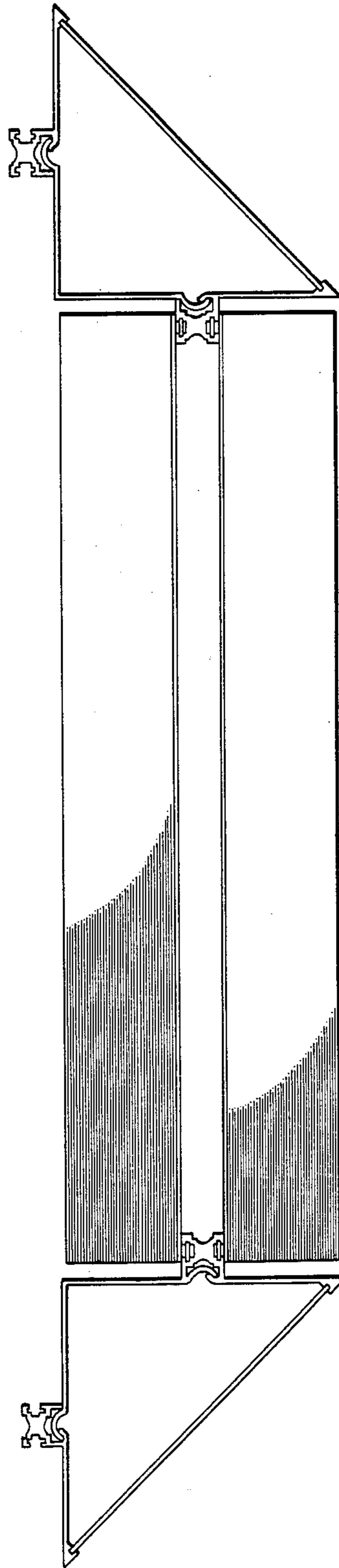

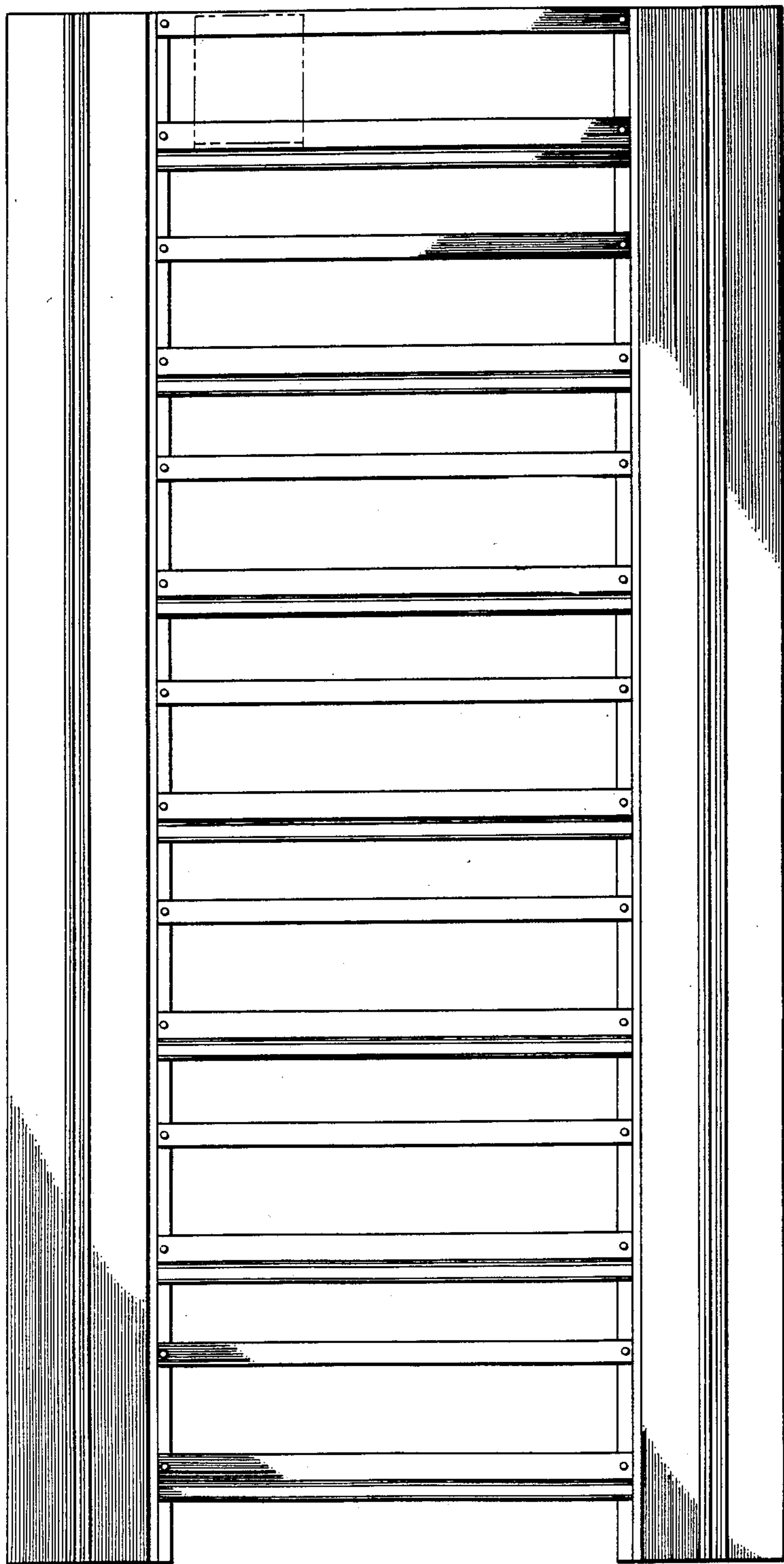

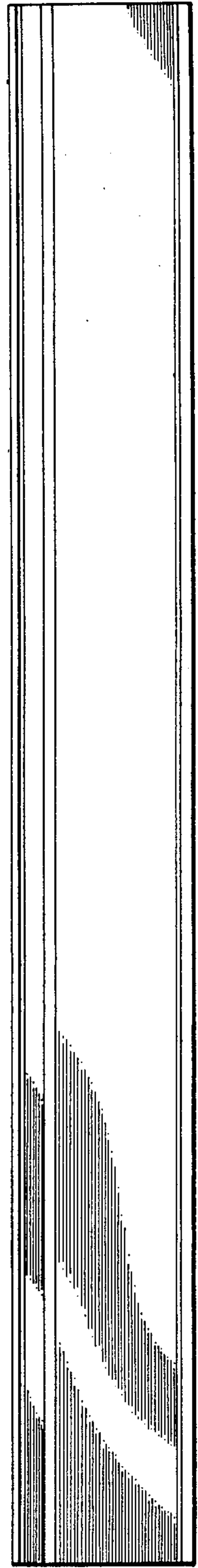

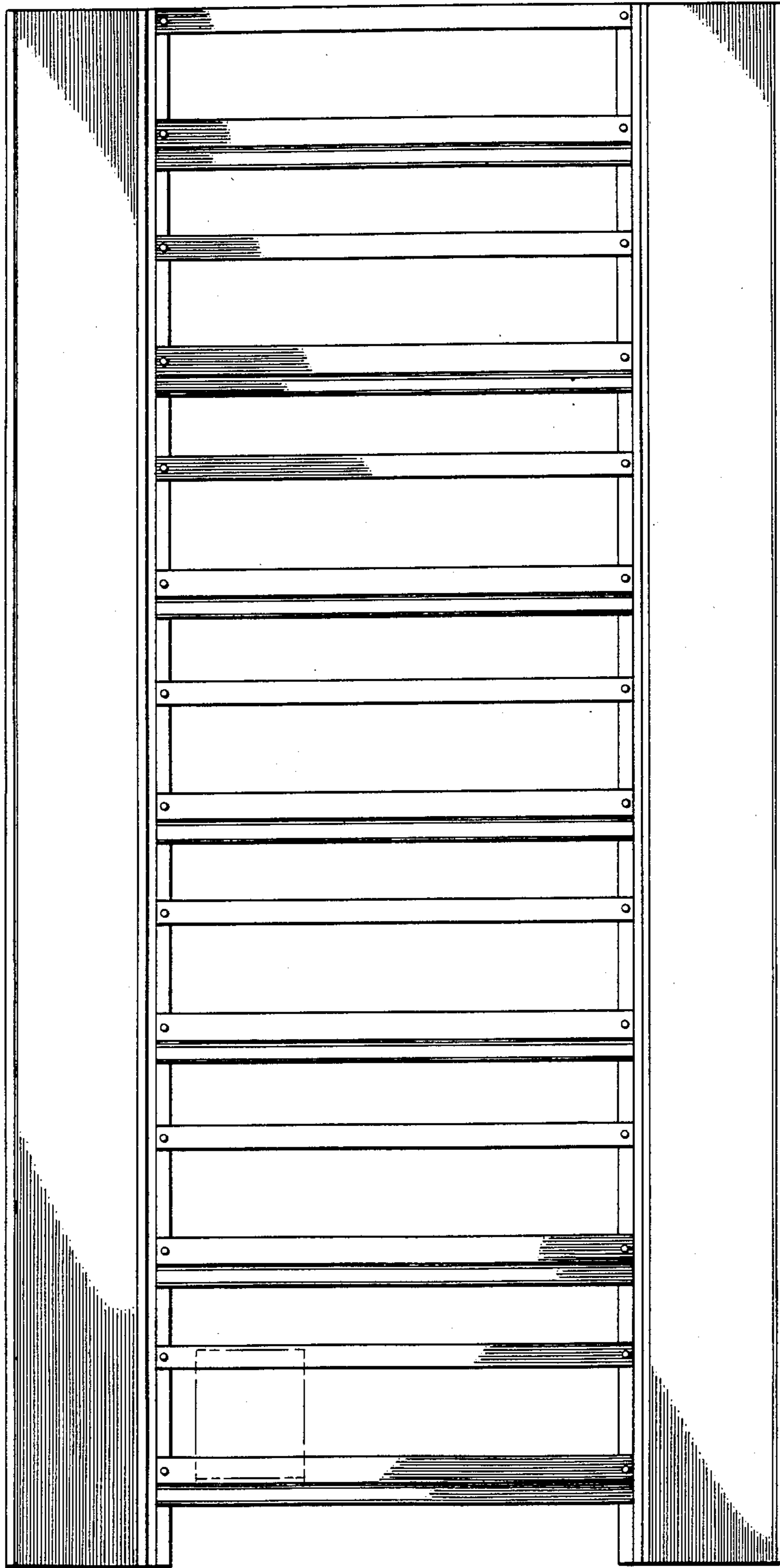

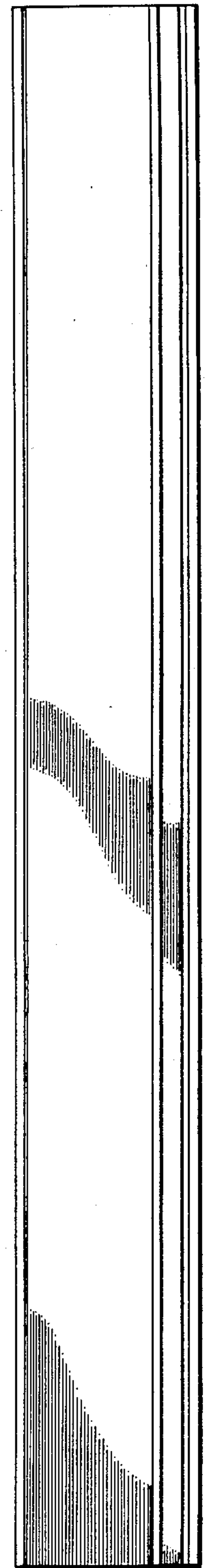

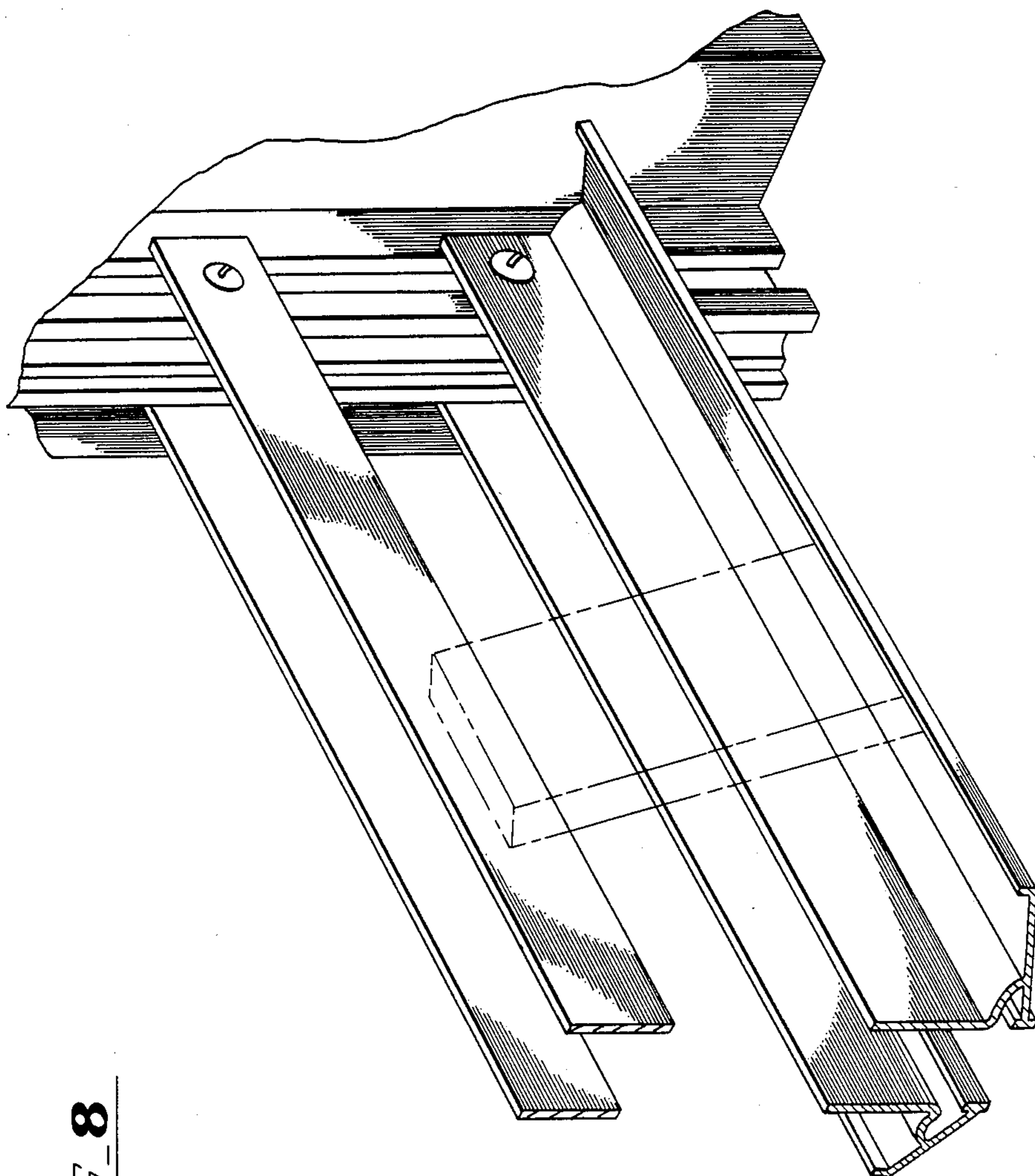
