[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tube for rectal administration of pharmaceutical compositions, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tube for rectal administration of pharmaceutical compositions showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the opposite side, top, and bottom being the same in appearance as the side shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

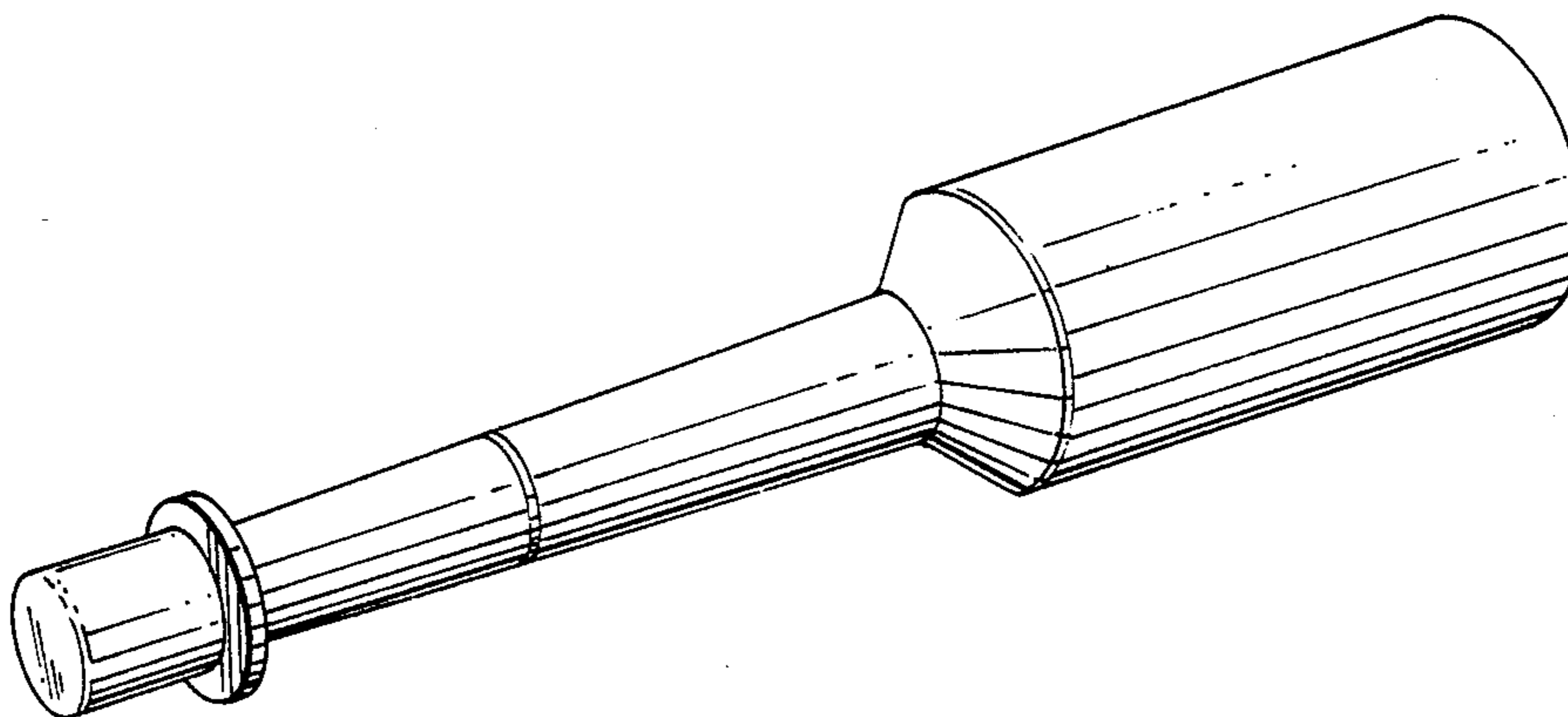

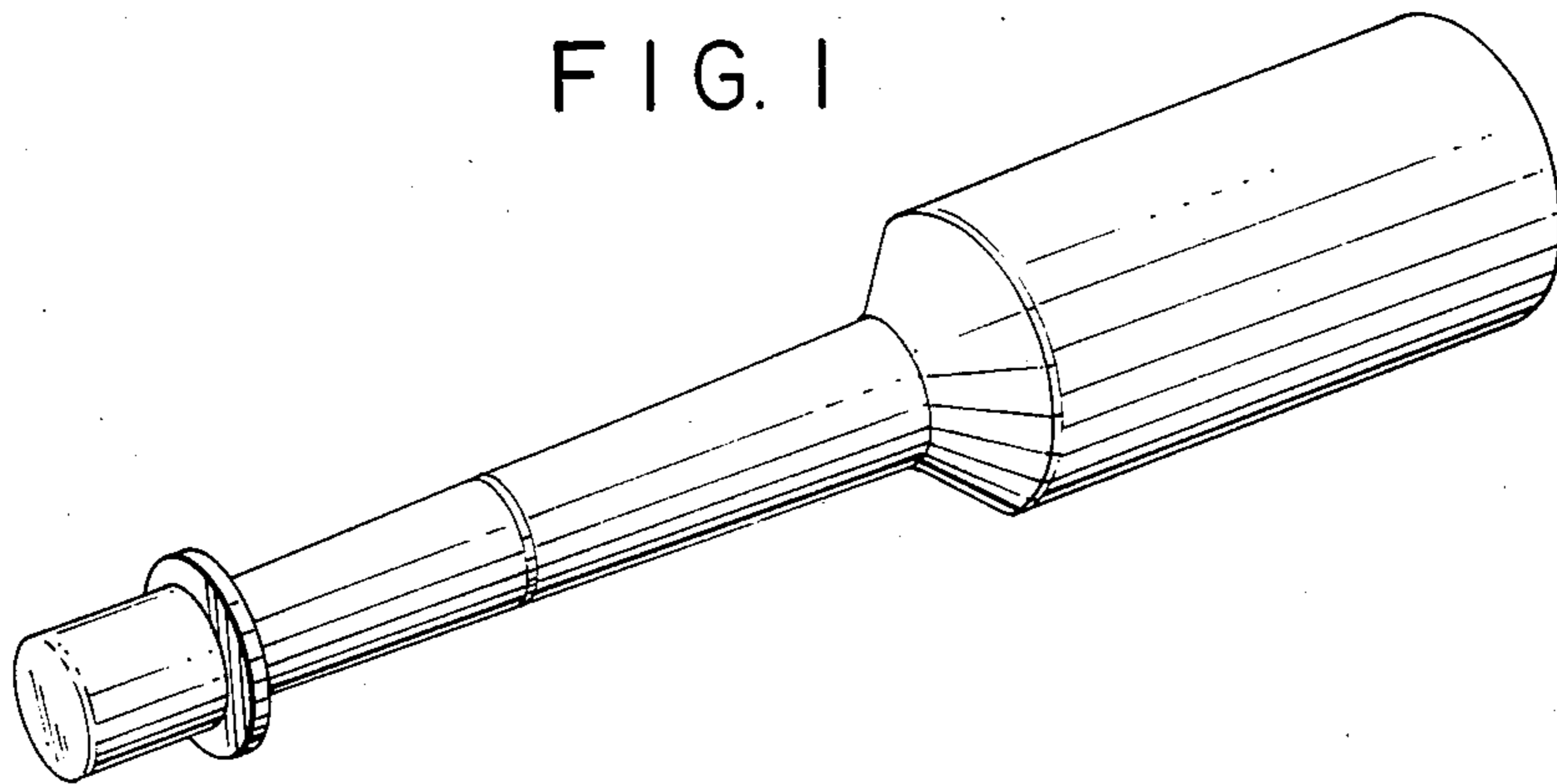

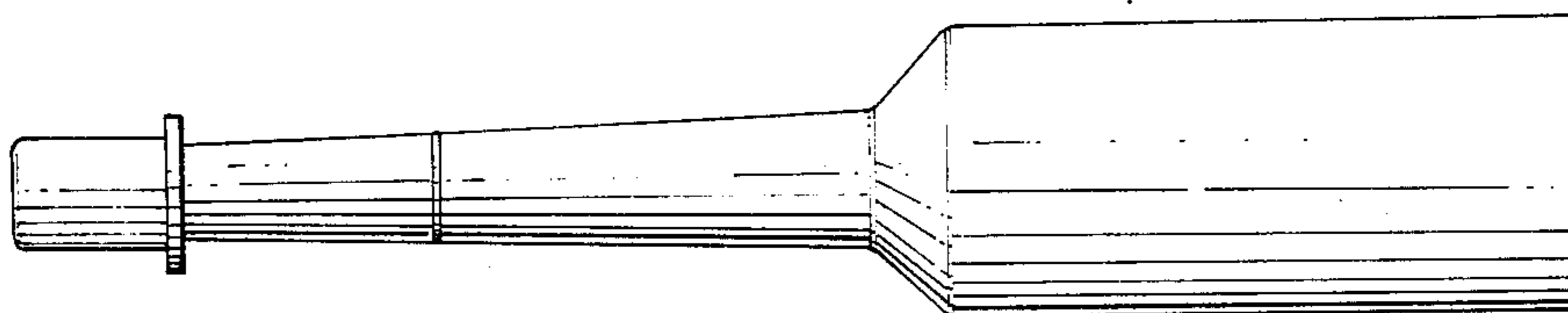

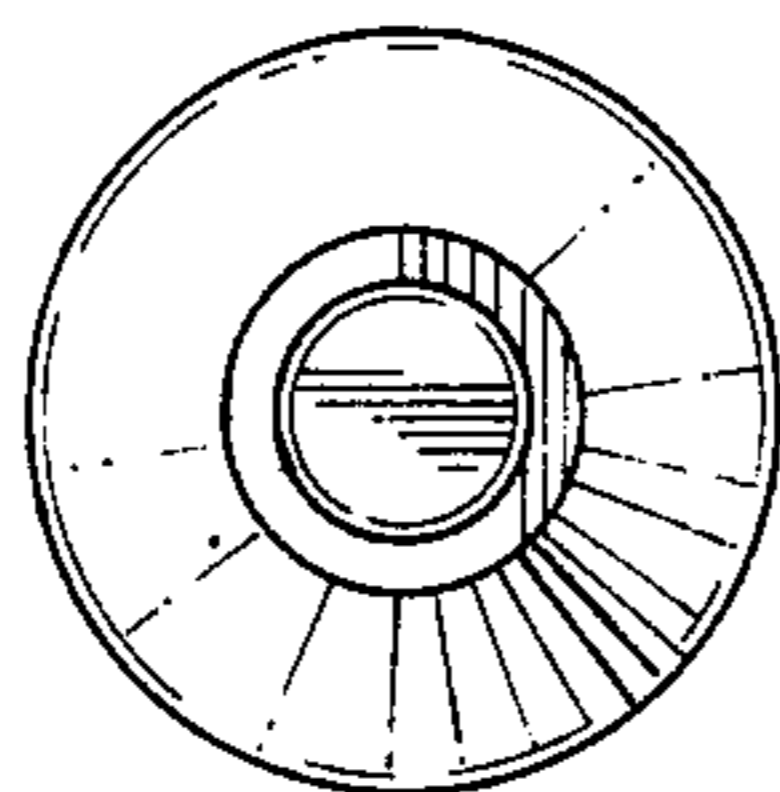
