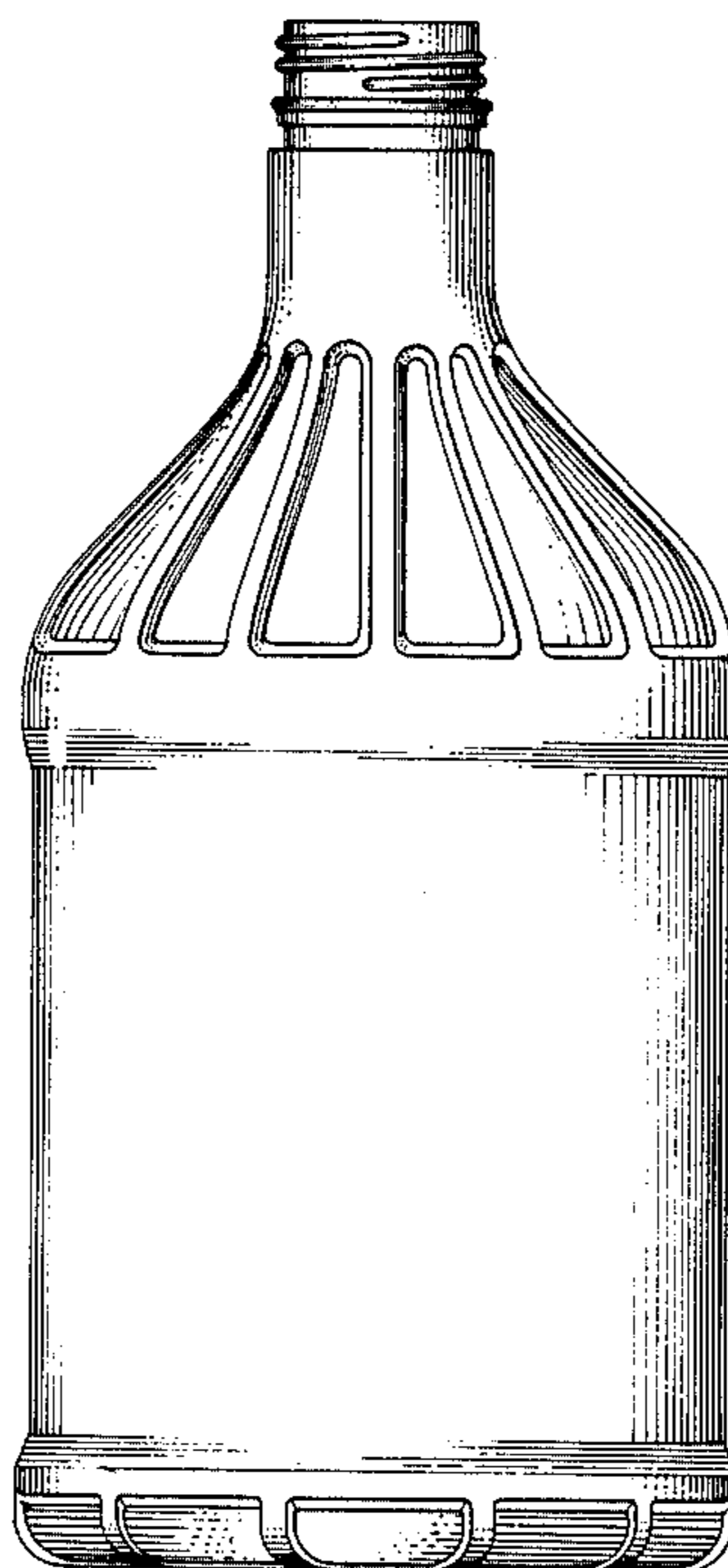

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bottle or similar article showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 4 is an enlarged sectional view showing one of the ribs disclosed in FIG. 2 in greater detail.
The side of the bottle not shown is the same as the side shown in FIG. 1.



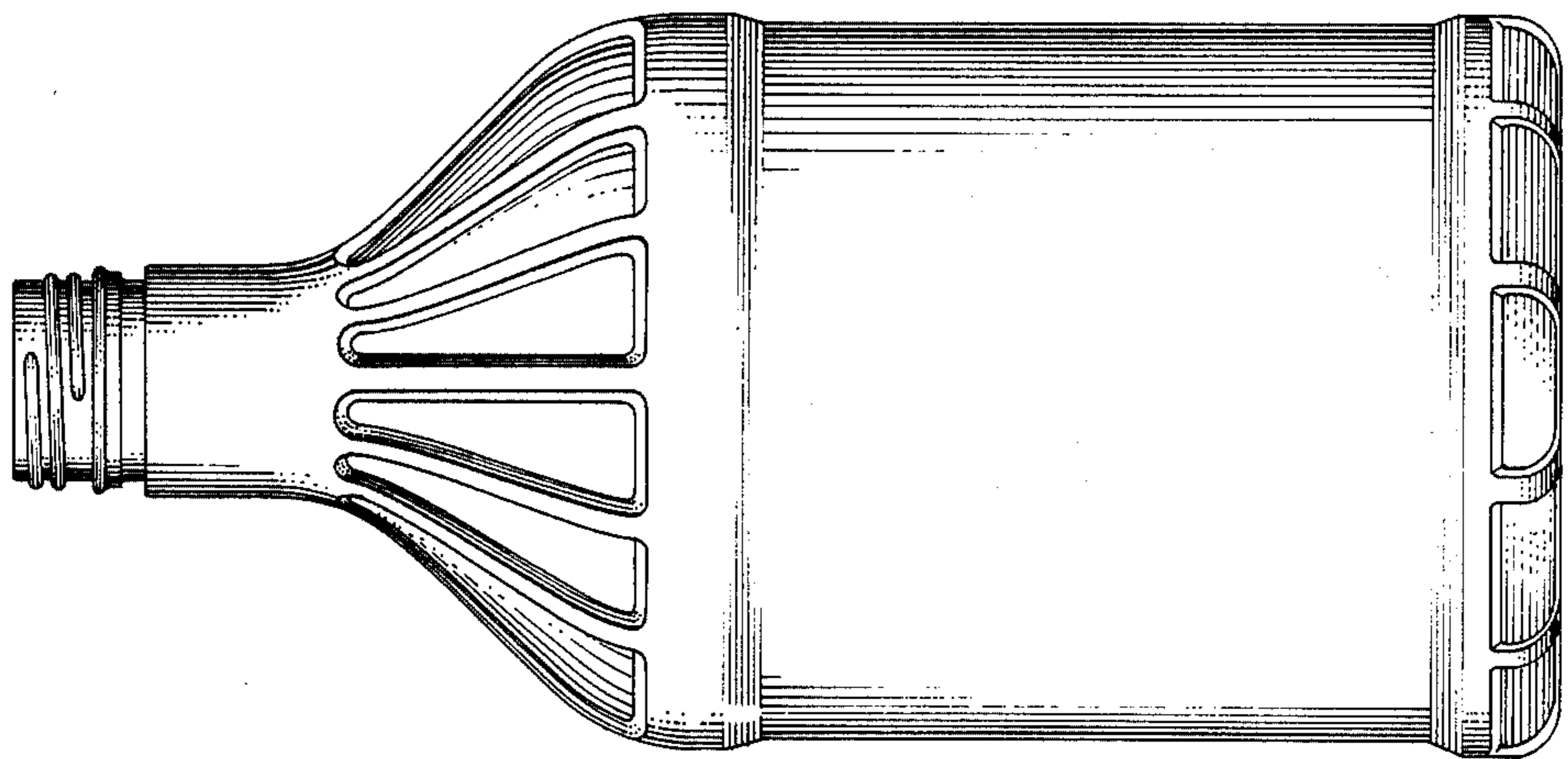

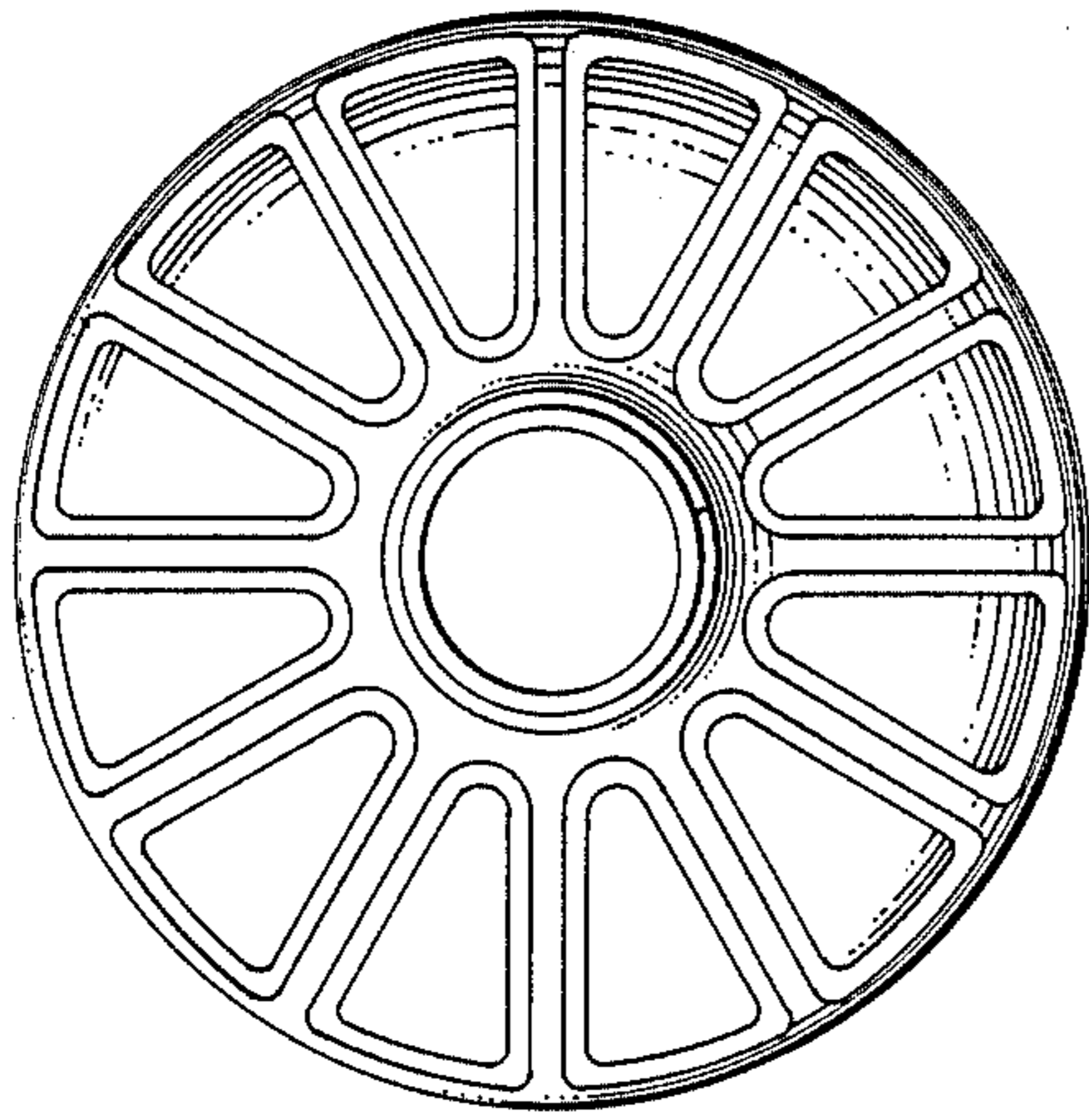

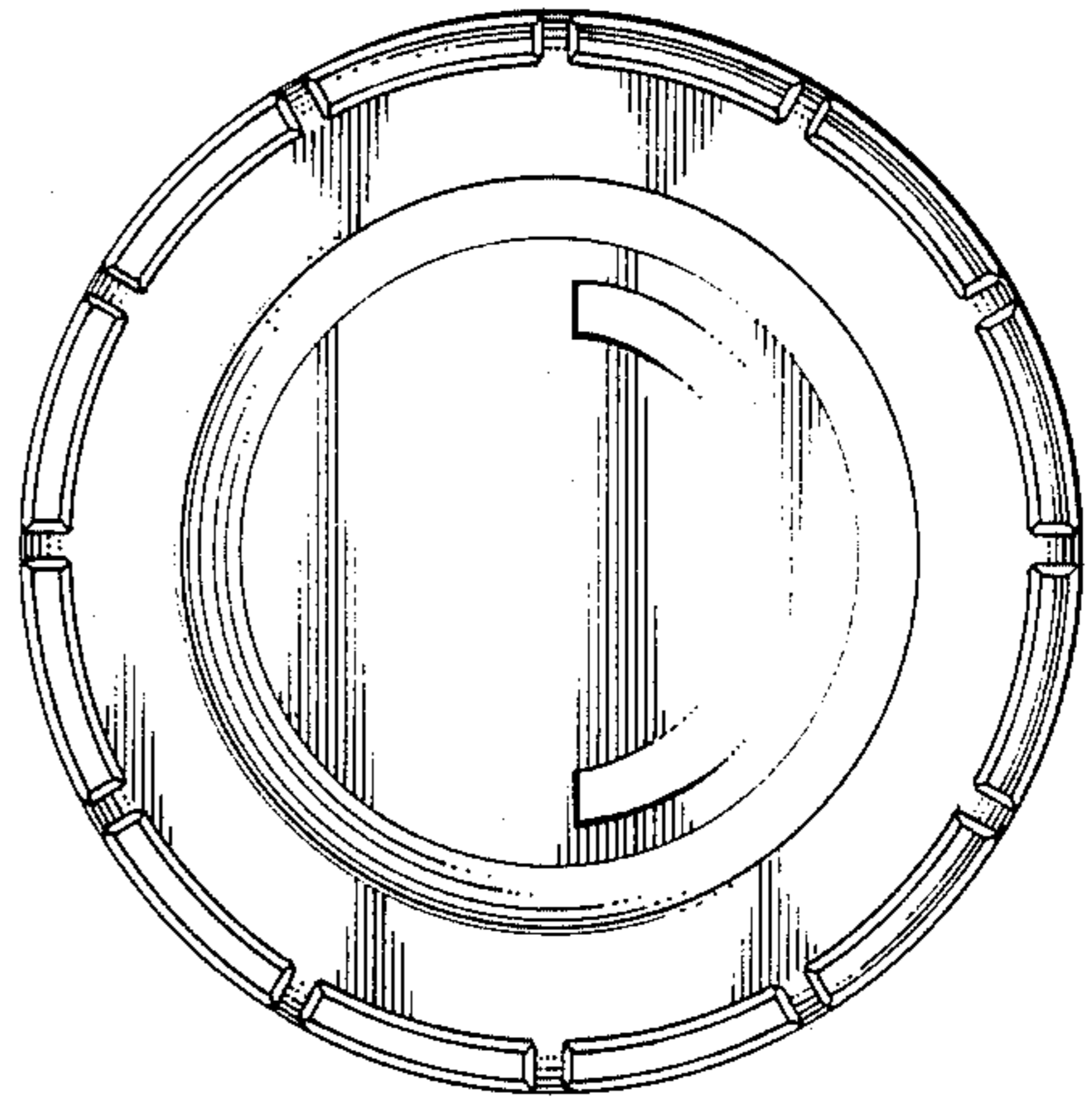

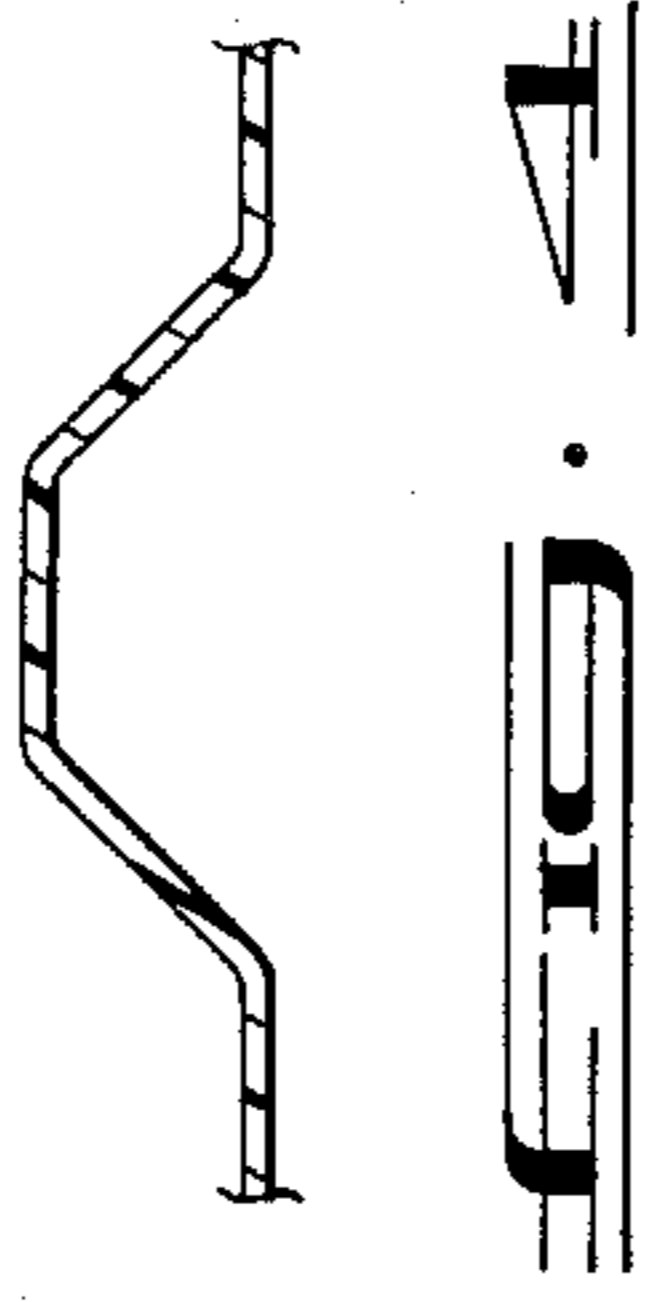
