DESCRIPTION

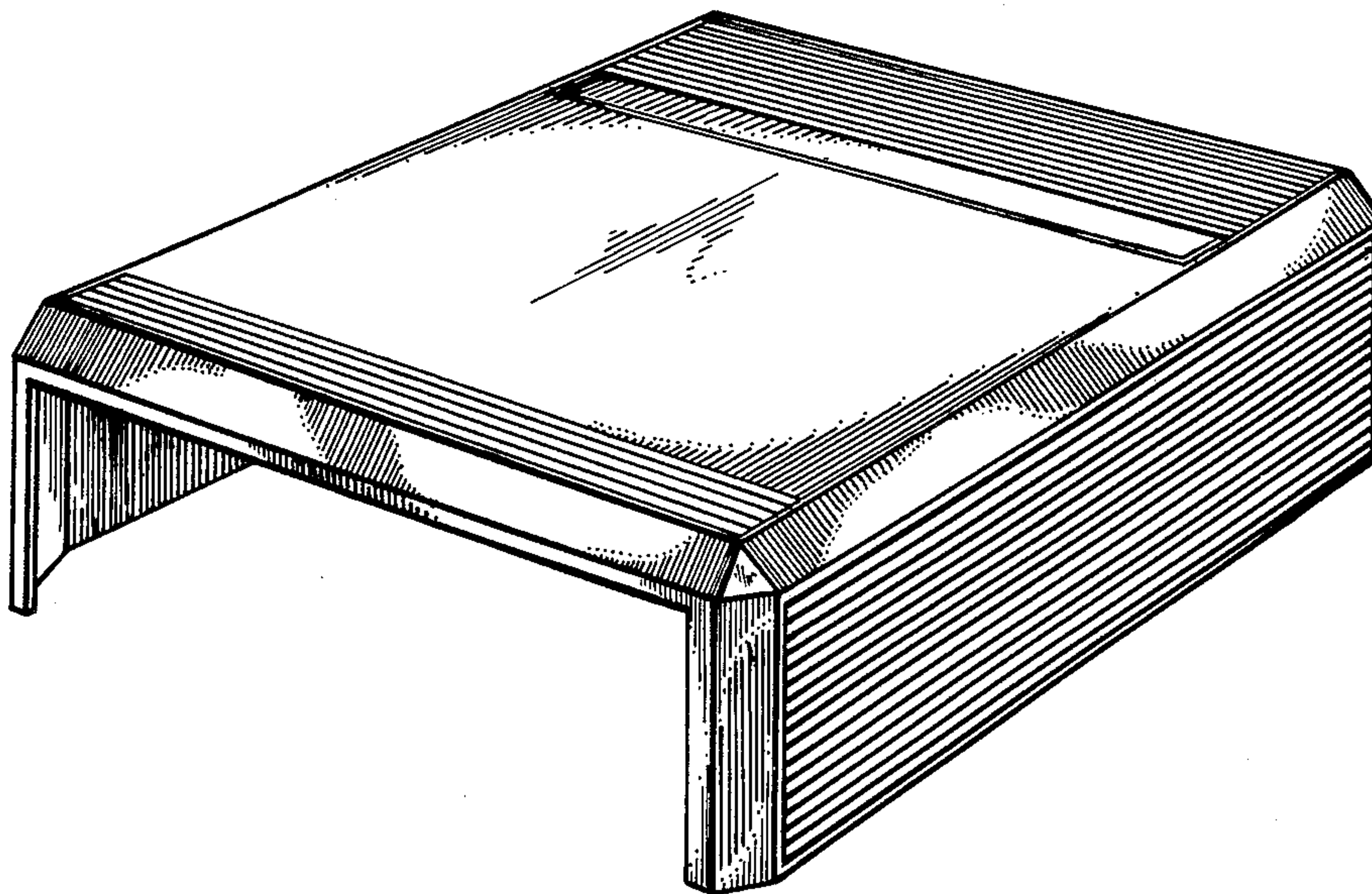
FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of a housing for computer equipment, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being identical;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being identical;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



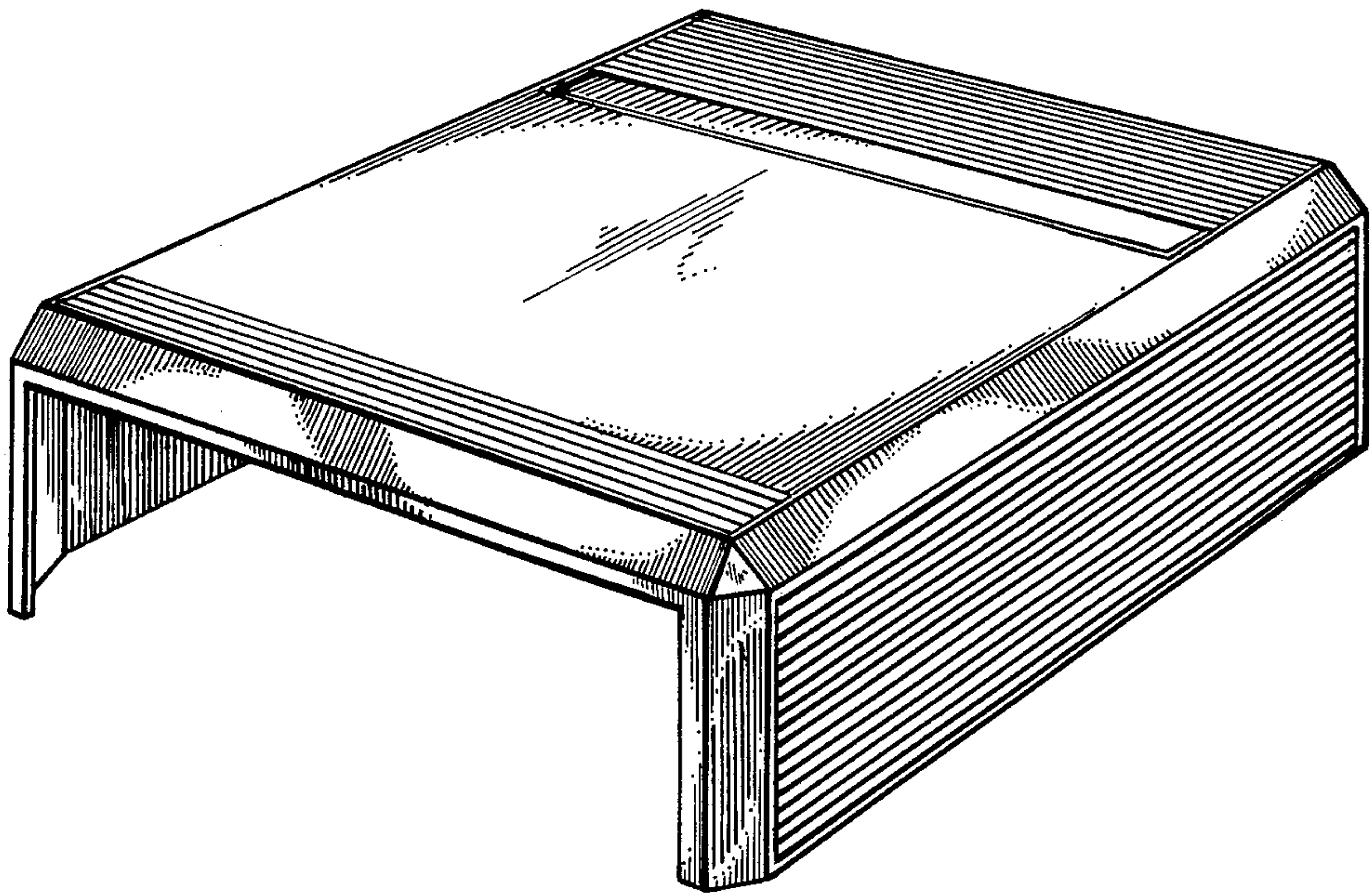

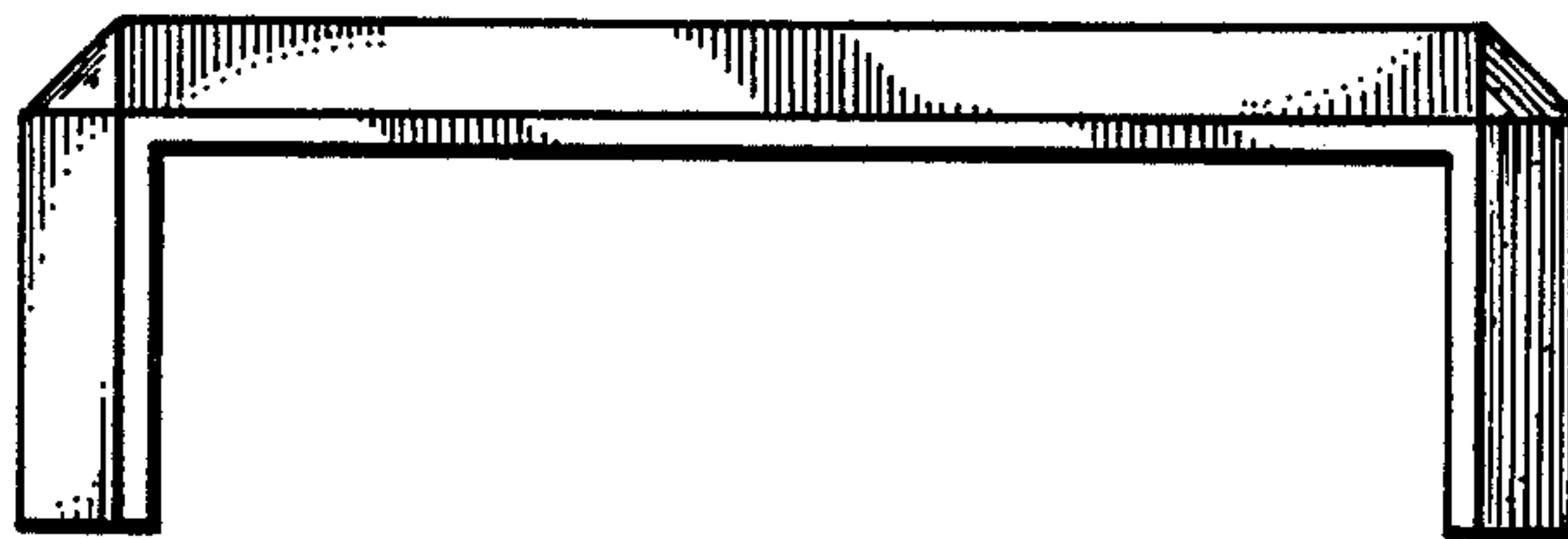

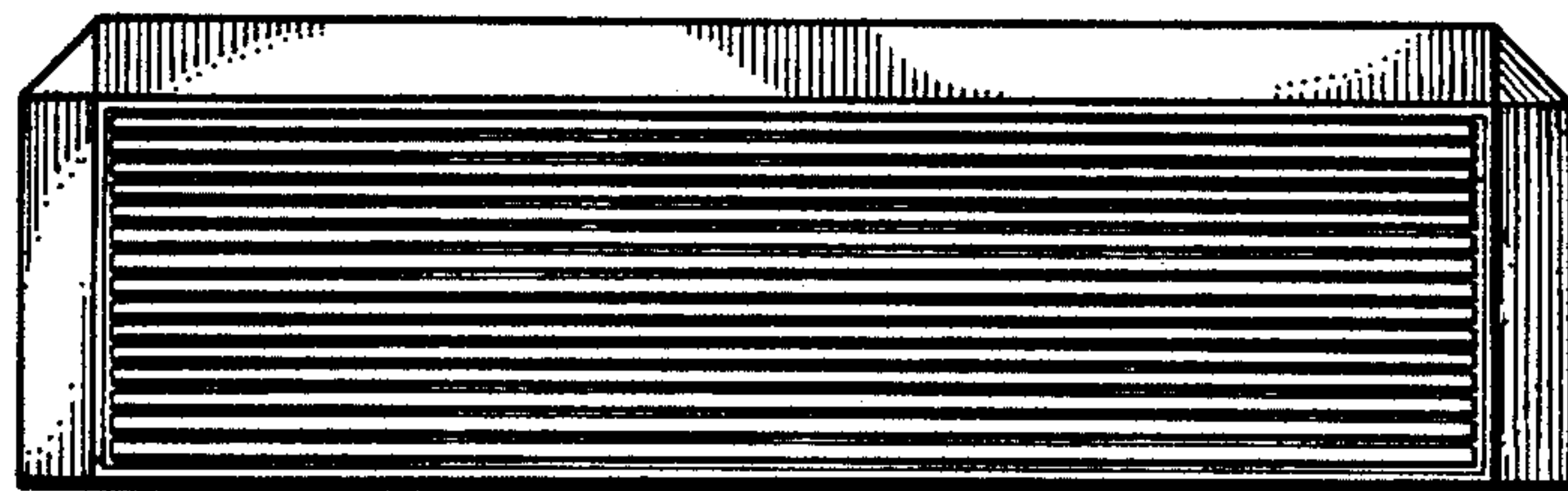

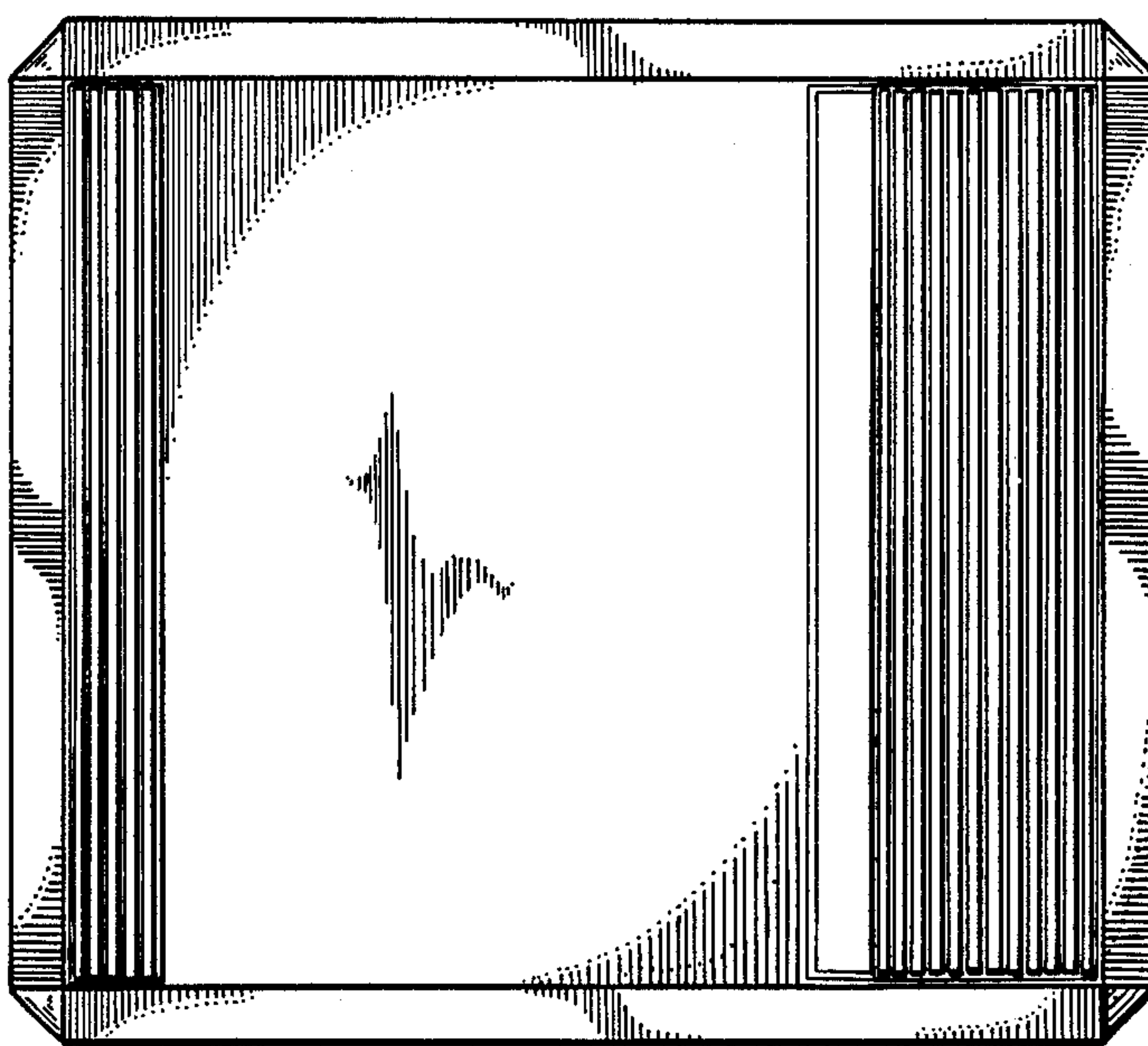

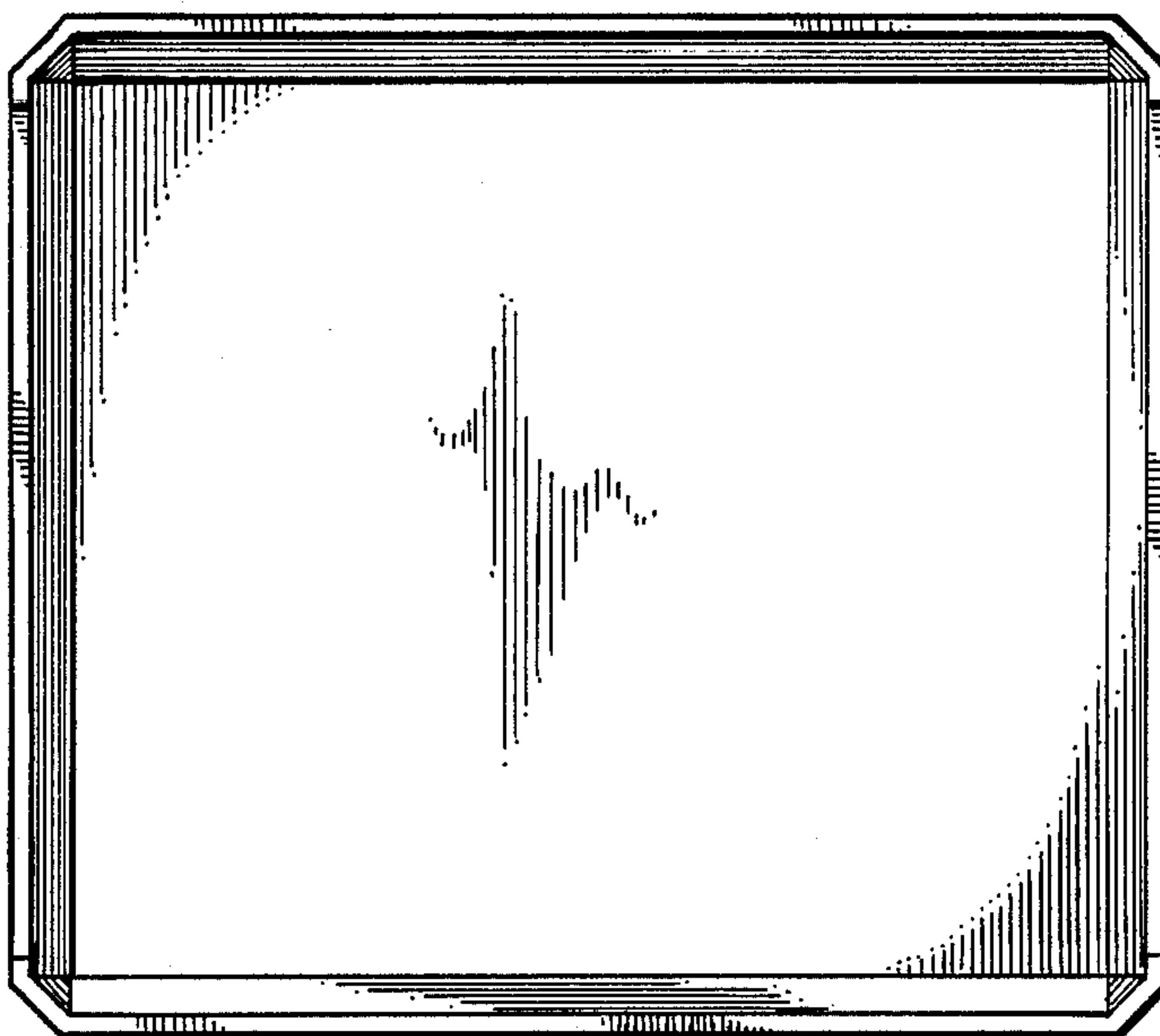
