[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an arrowhead puller, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the arrowhead puller of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is an end view of the device of FIG. 1 taken from the left end of the device;
FIG. 3 is an end view of the device of FIG. 1 taken from the right end of the device;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the device of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view of the device taken substantially along line 6—6 of FIG. 5.
The broken line showing of the ring and arrowhead is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
