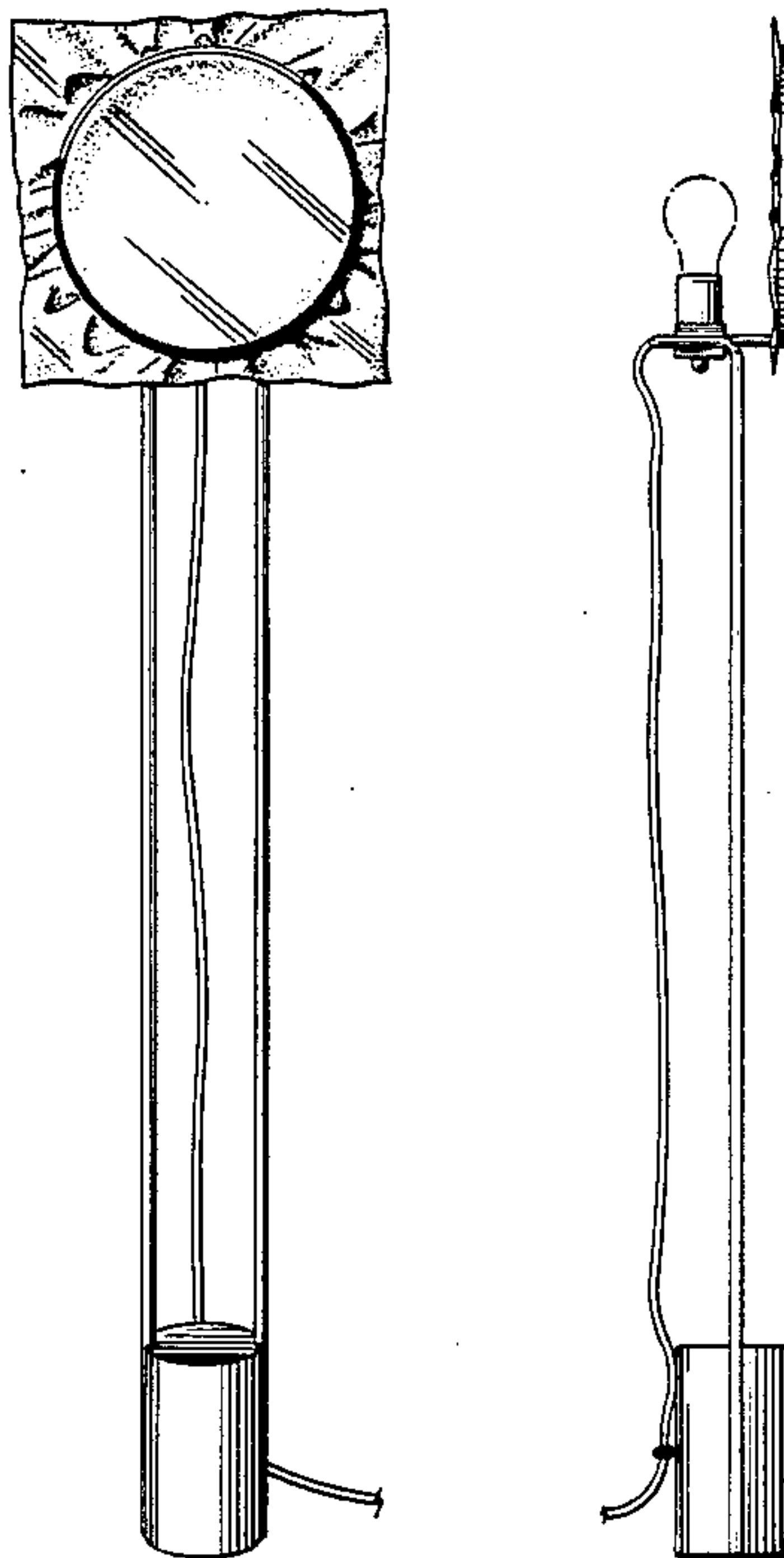

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floor lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a floor lamp showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
The lamp bulb is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



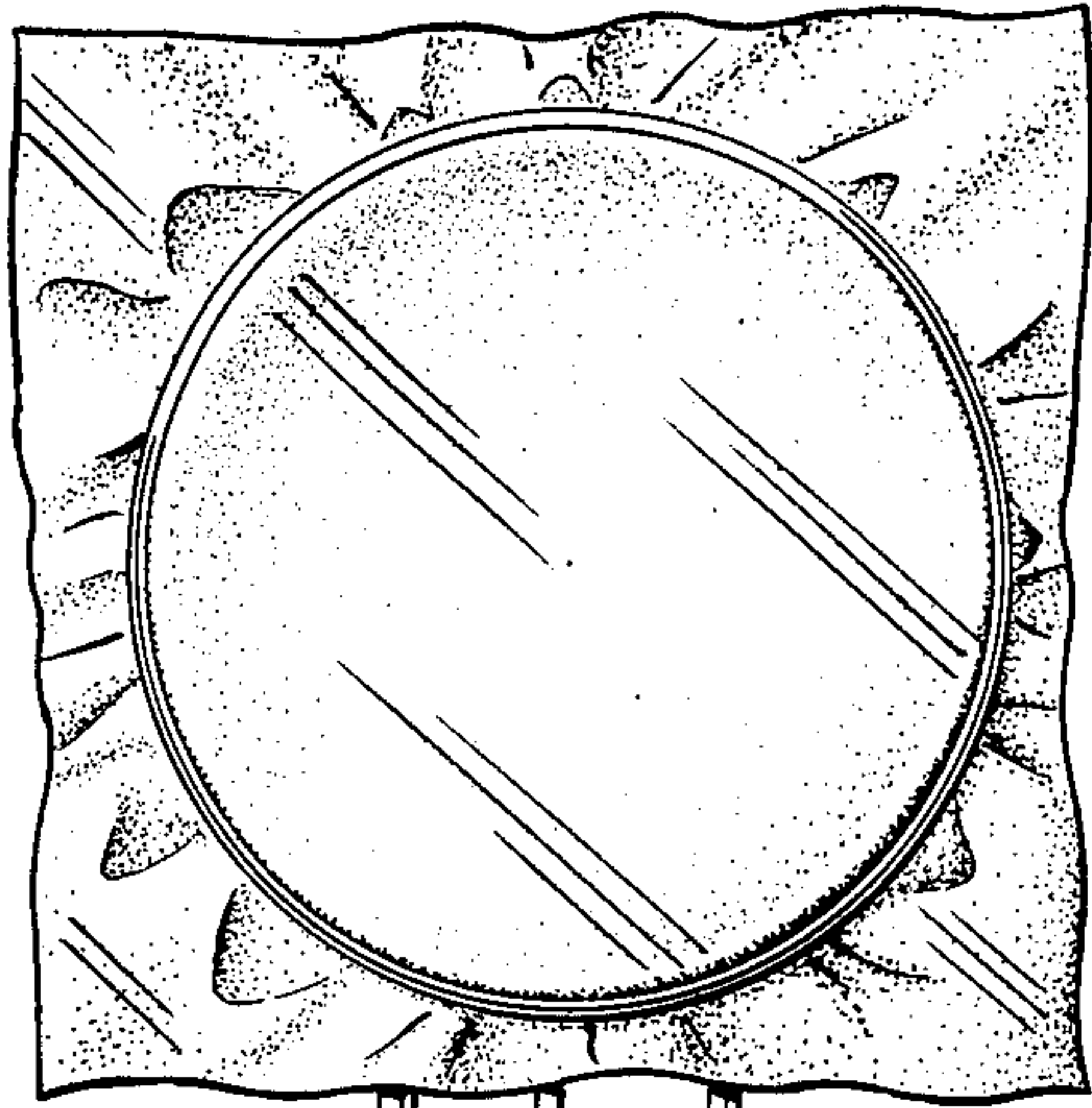

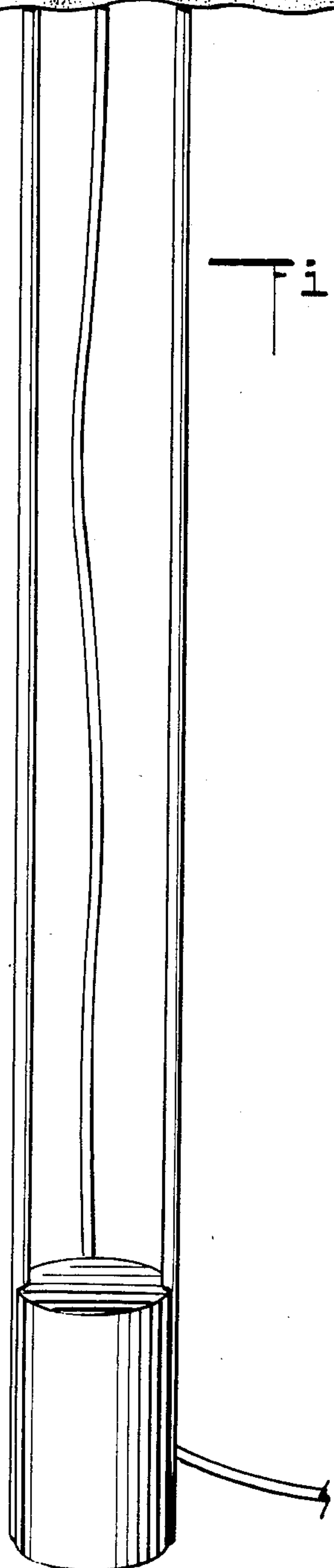
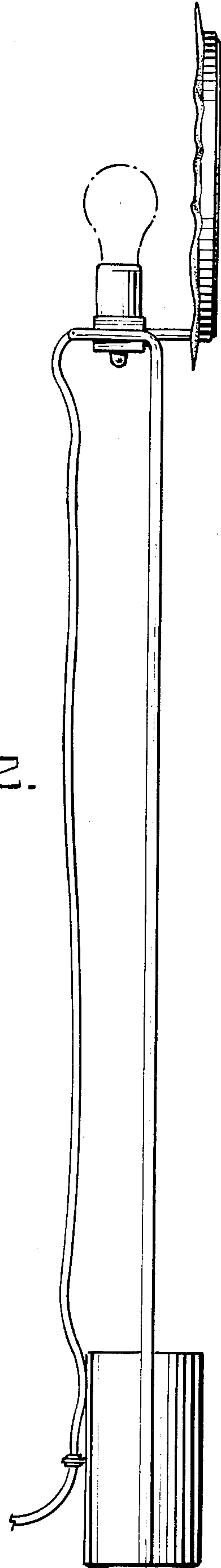

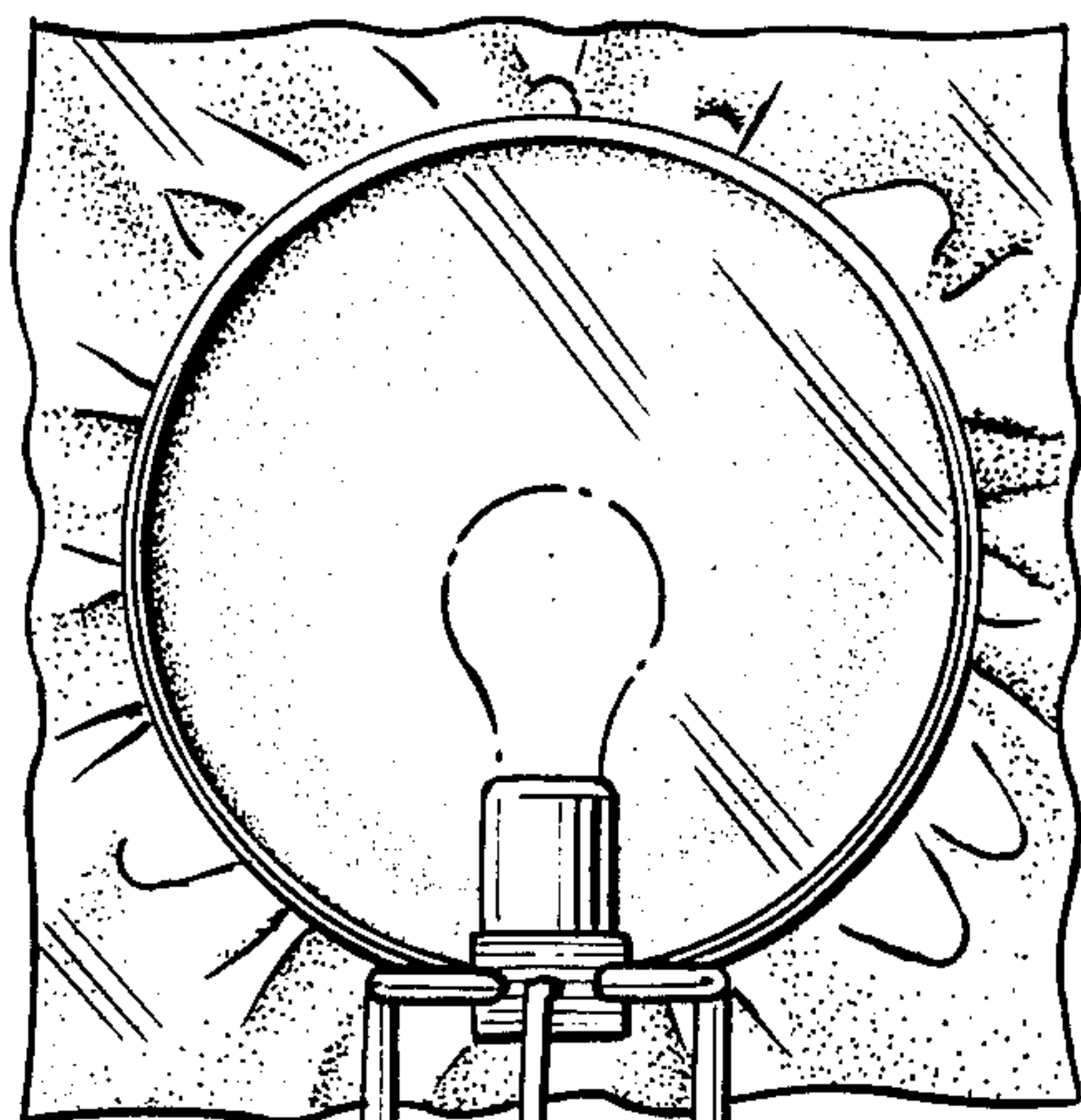

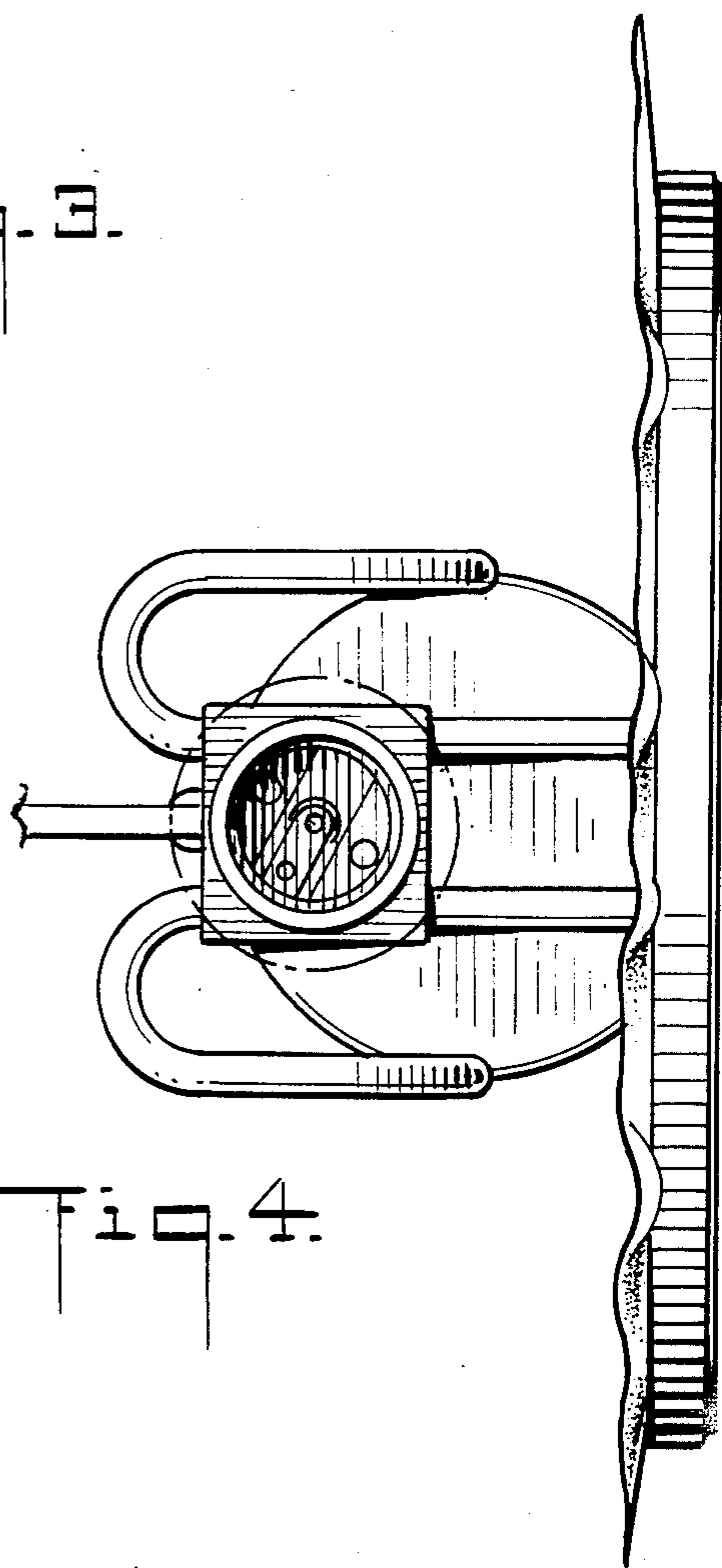
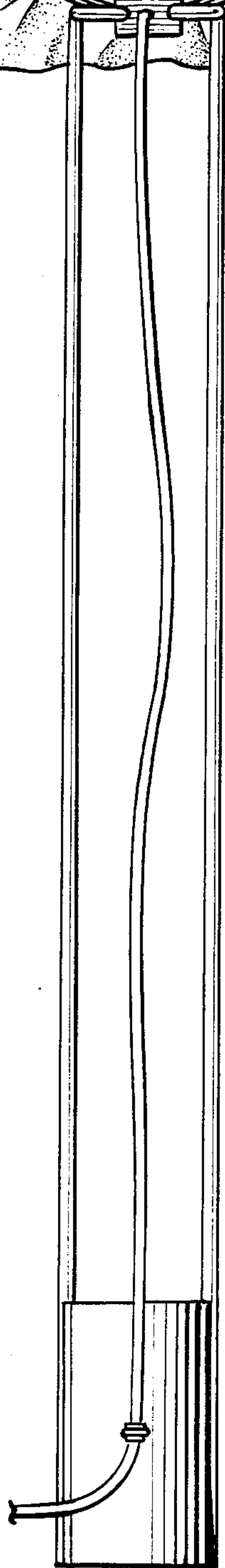
