FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a sixth embodiment of the glove shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9;


FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a seventh embodi-


ment of the glove shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 11. FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of a modified embodiment of FIG. 2.

The broken lines shown throughout the views indicate stitching.
















