DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wall shelf showing our
new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof, the
rear being unornamented;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged left side elevational view thereof,
the side opposite being a mirror image;

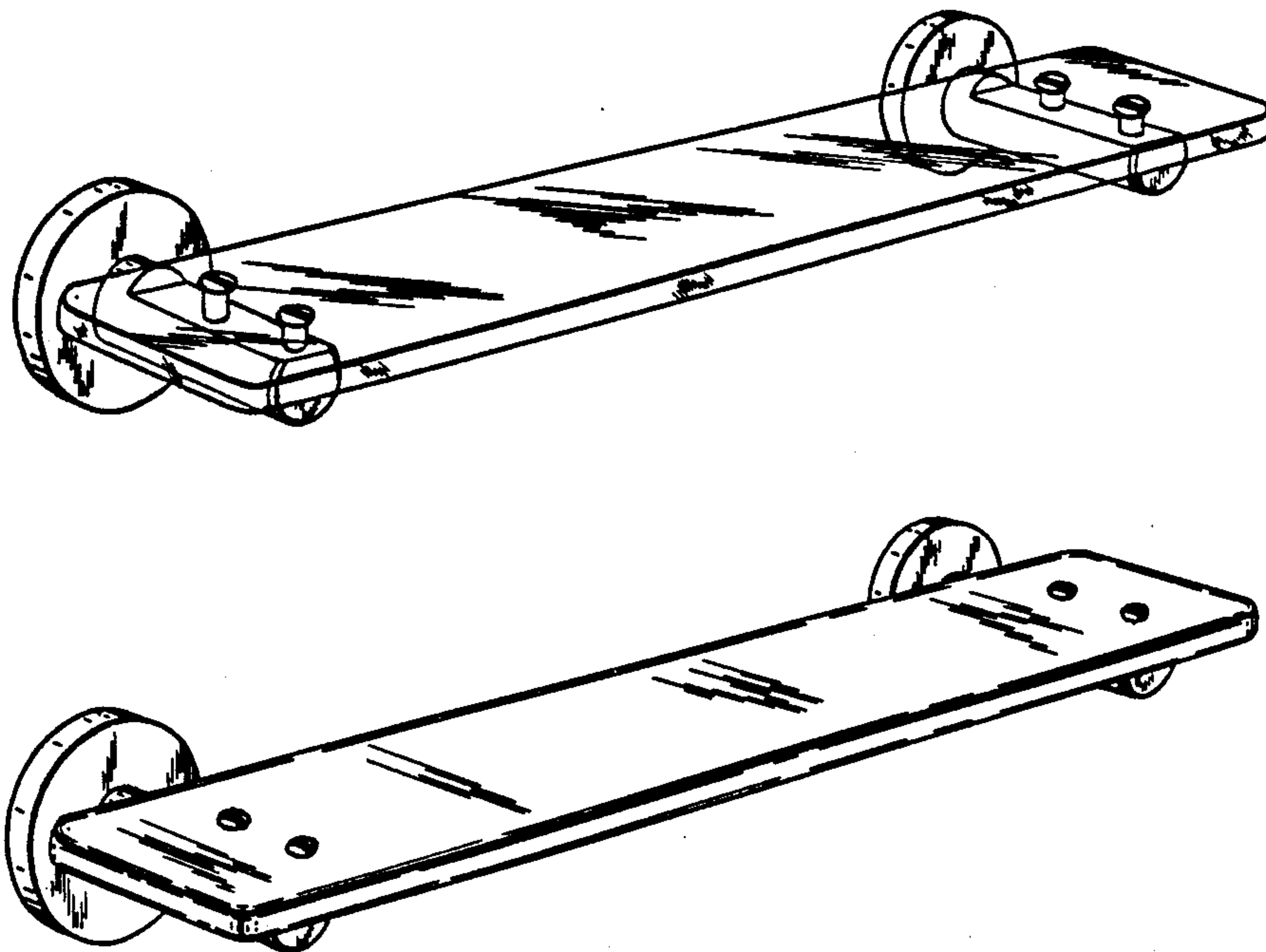
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of

the side opposite being a mirror image.



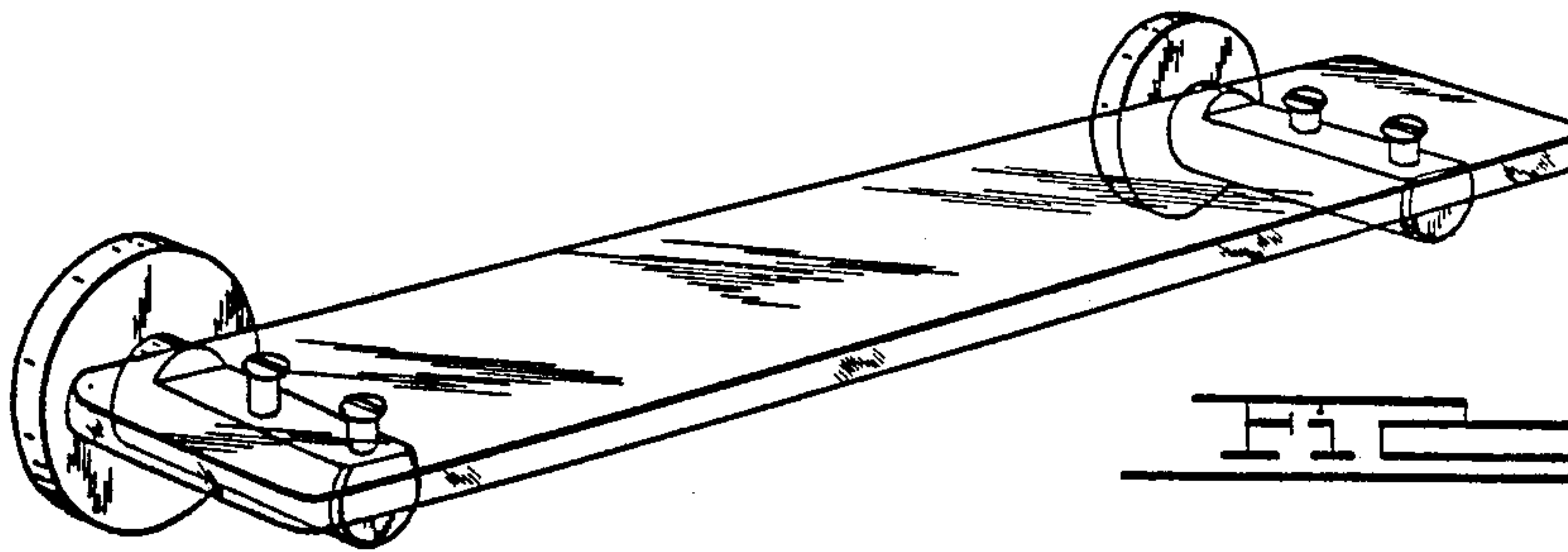

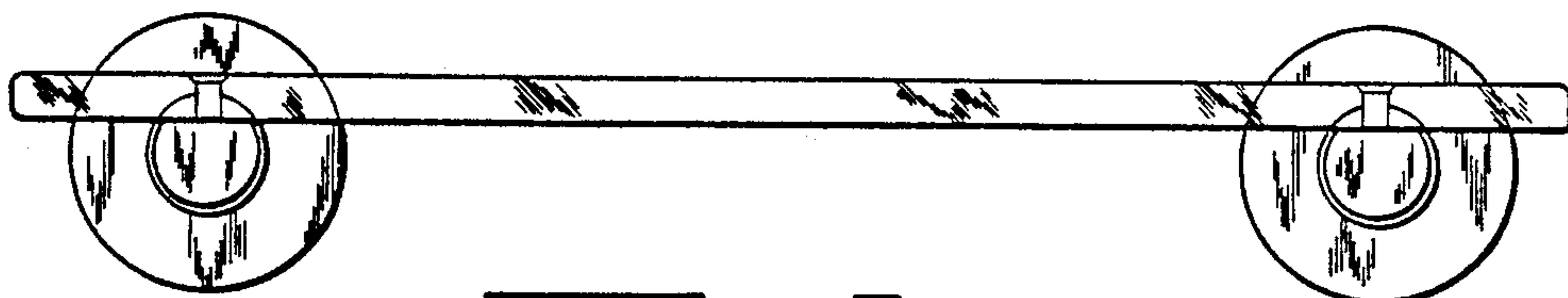
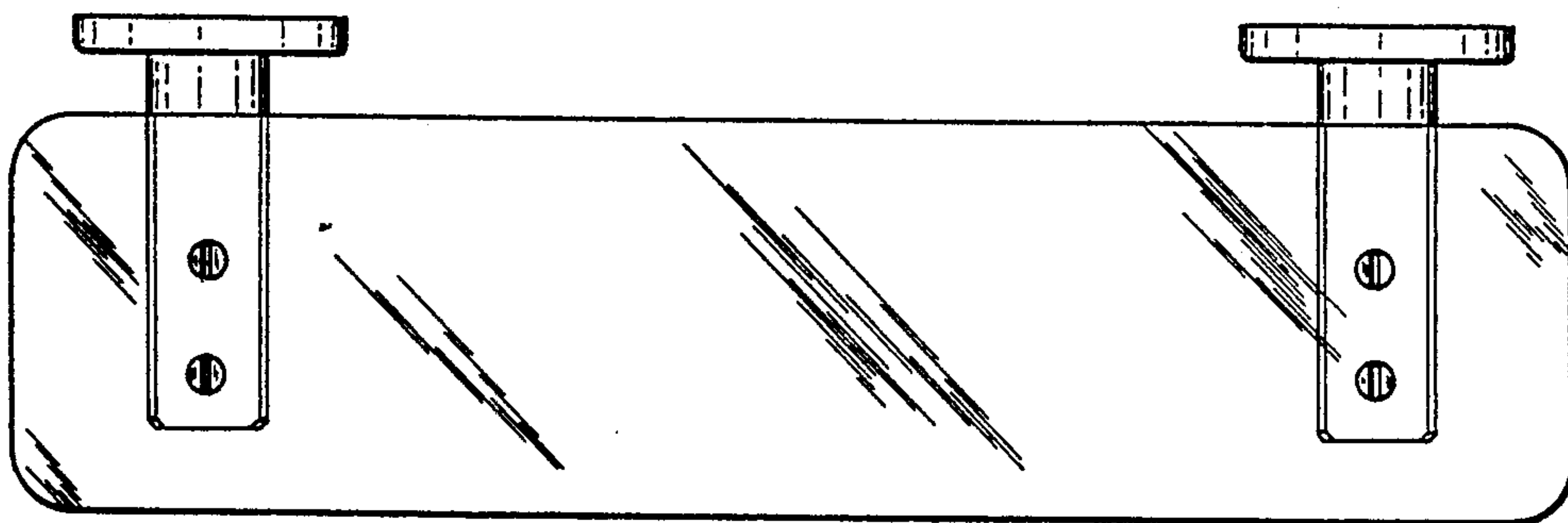

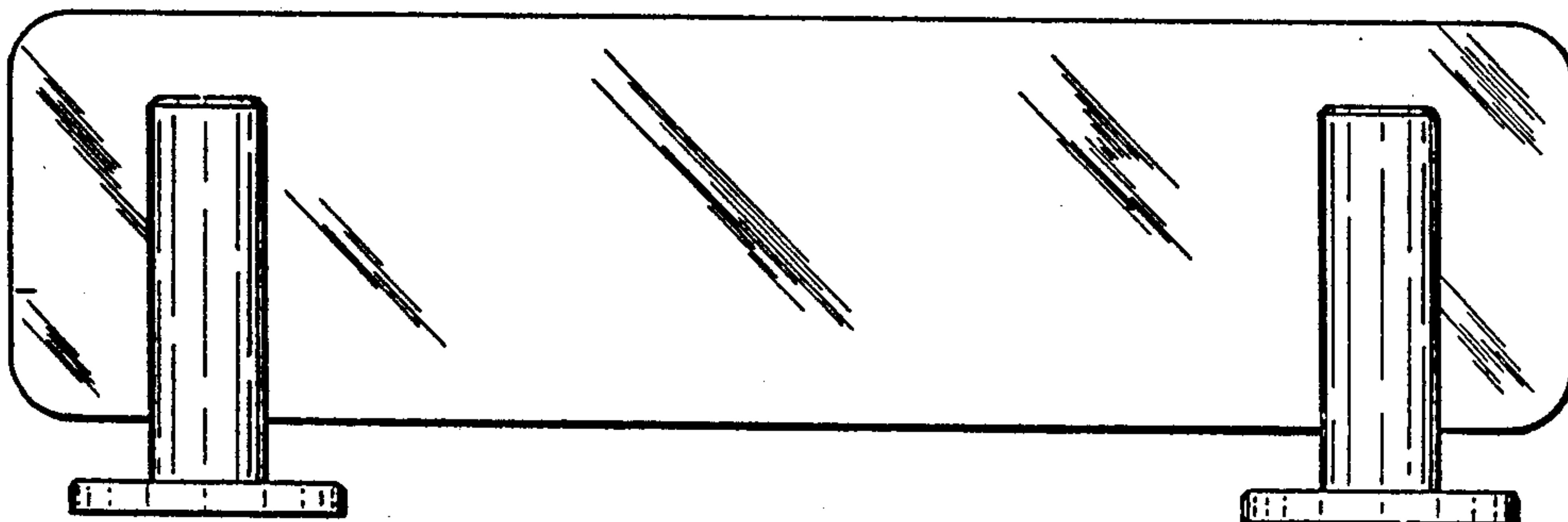

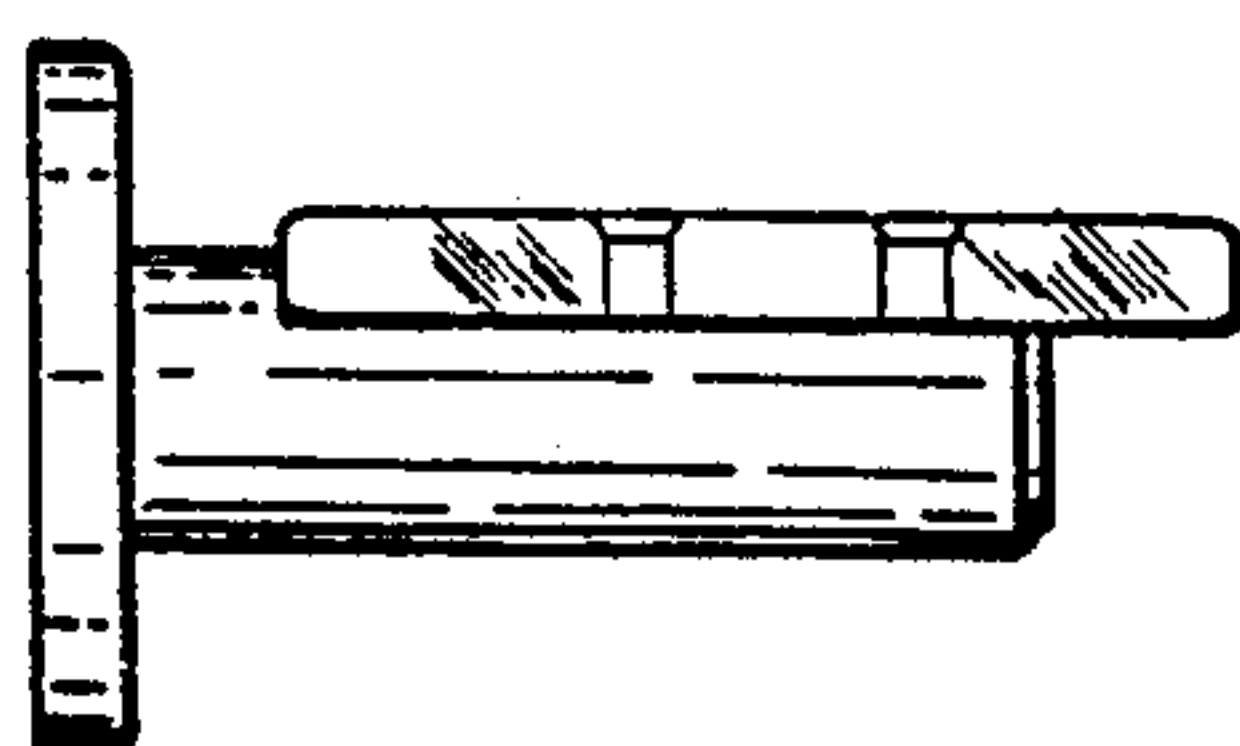

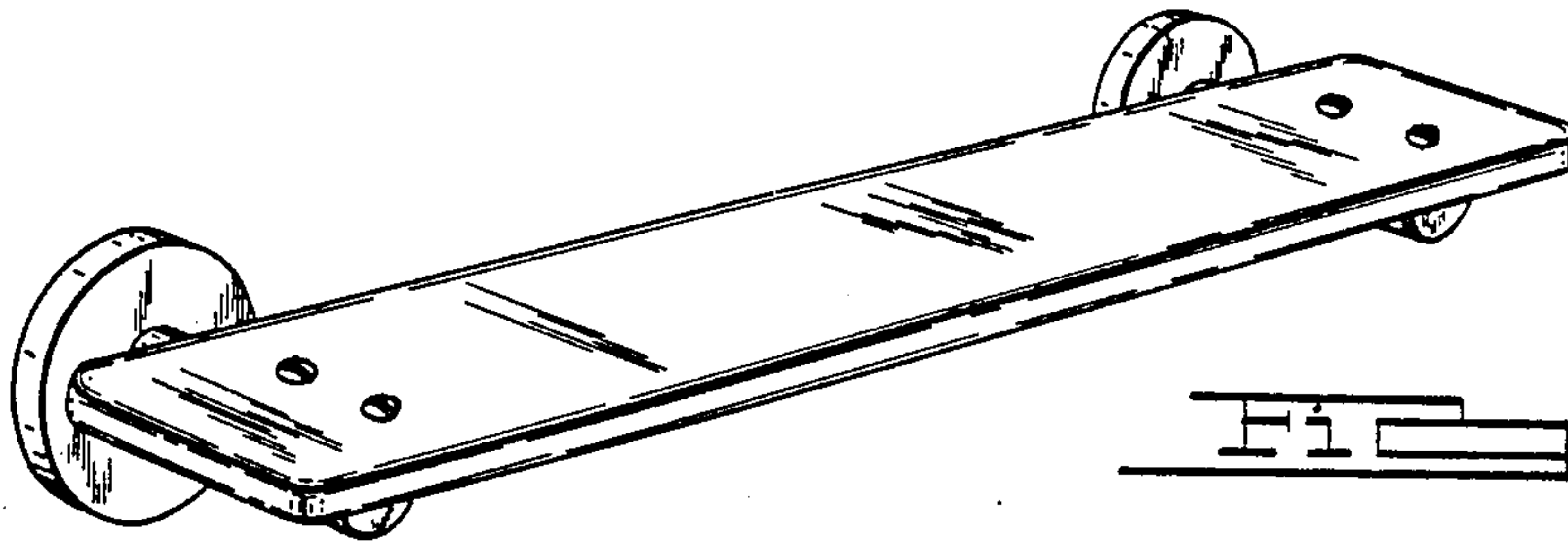

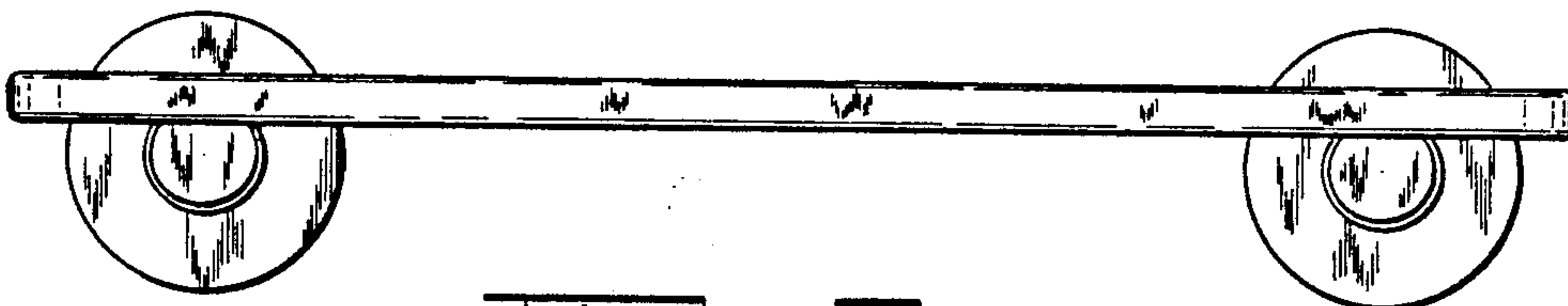
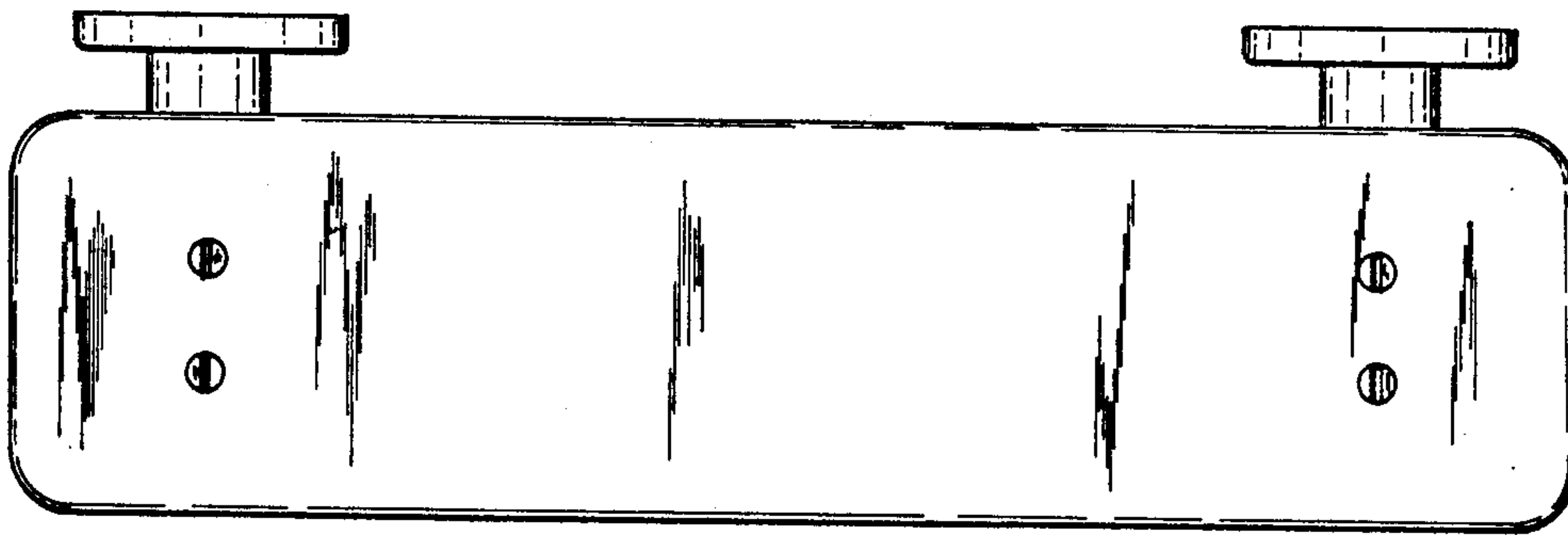

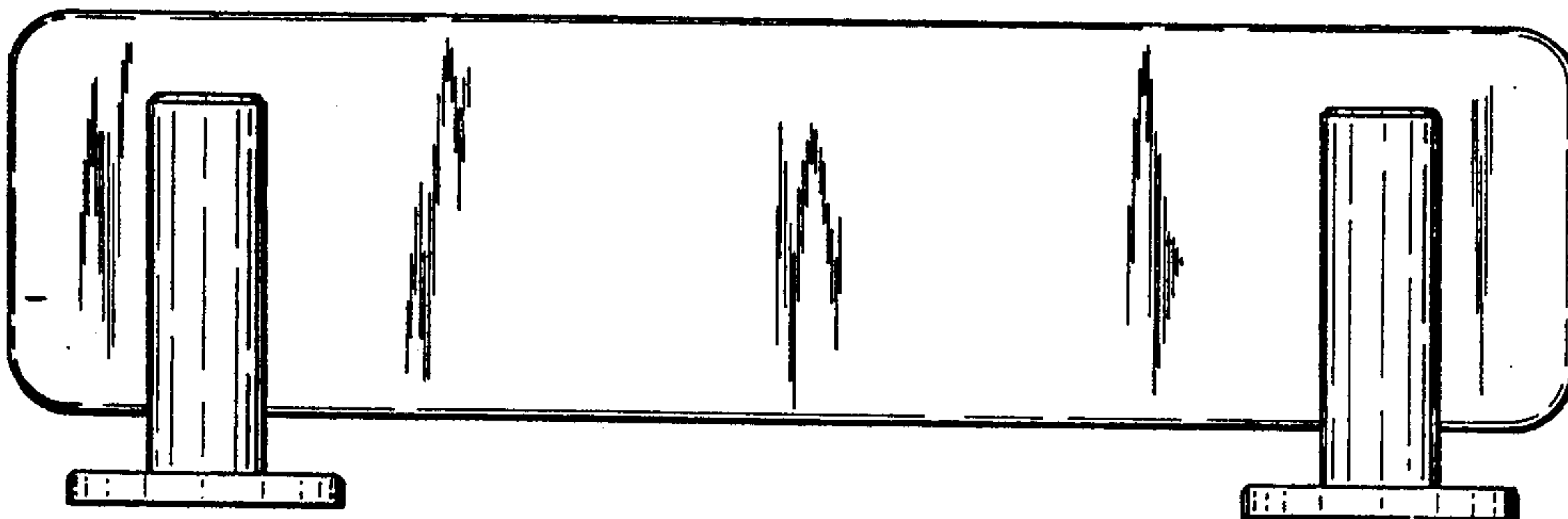

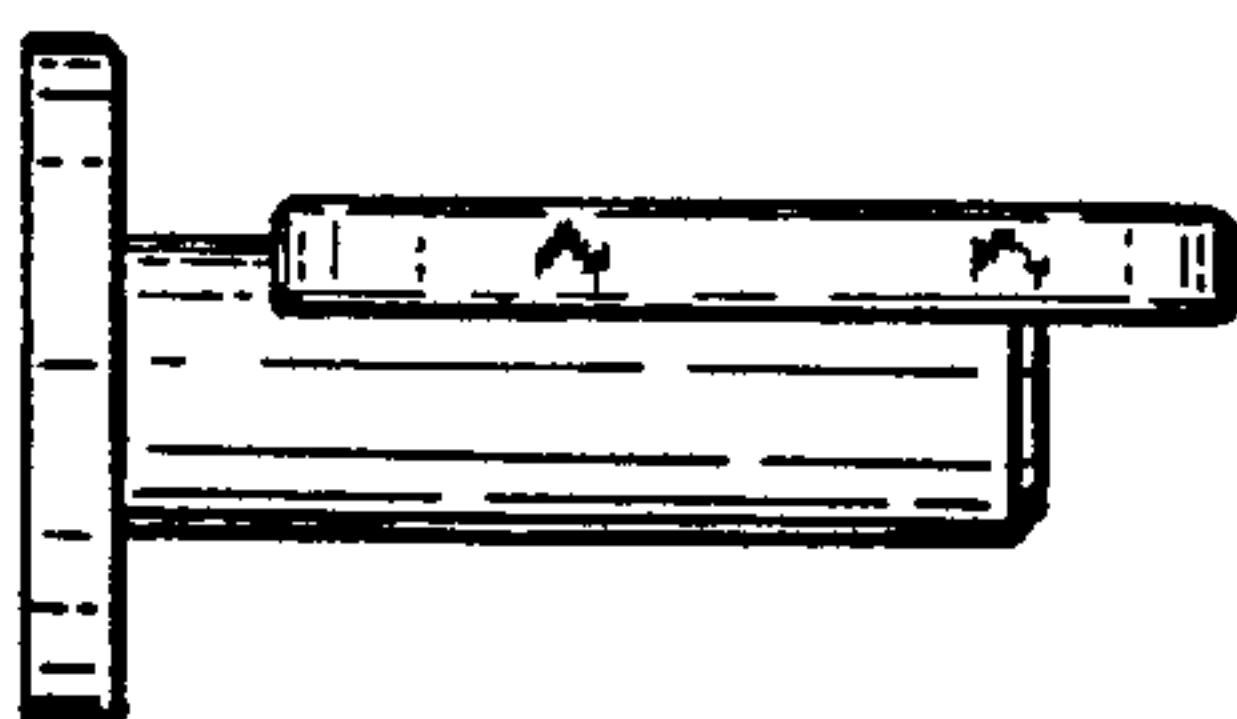
