DESCRIPTION

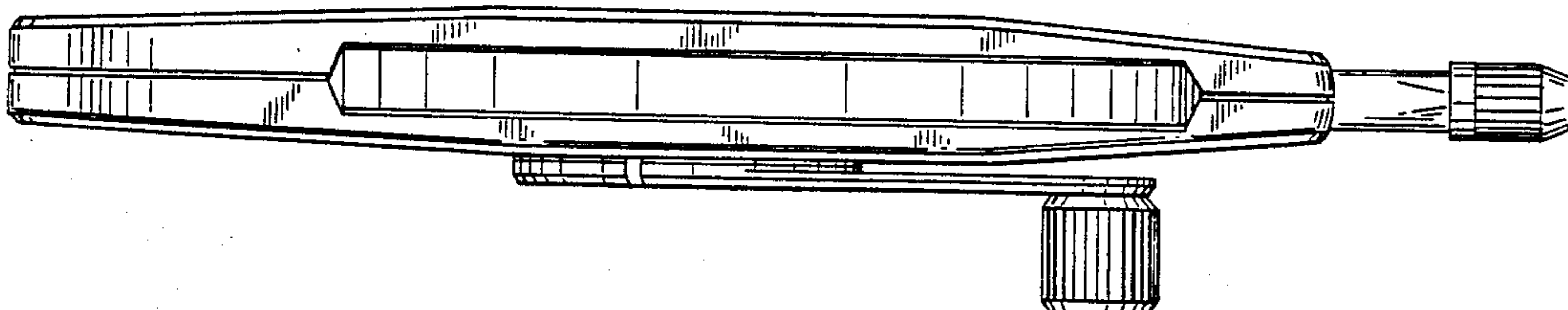
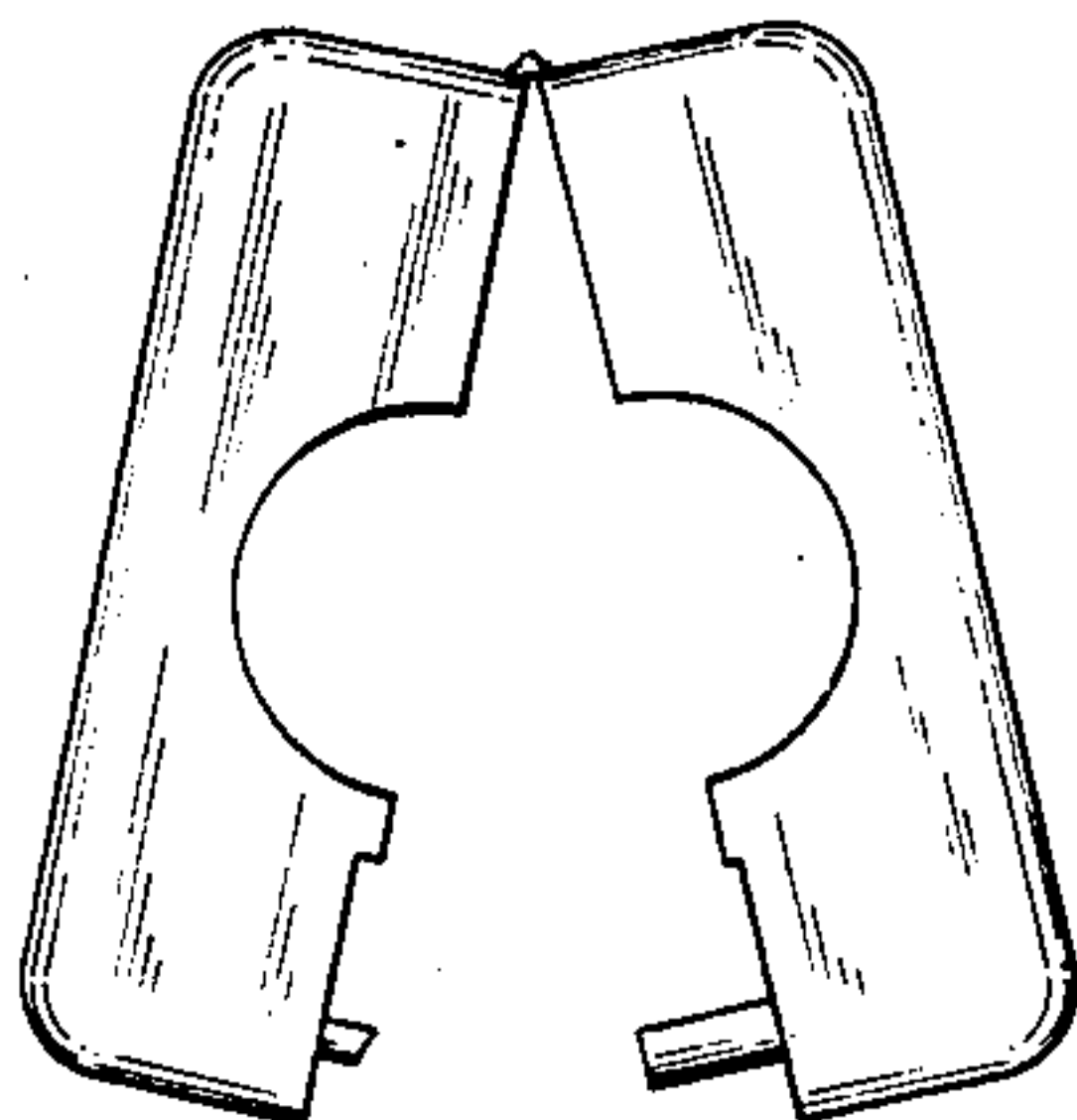
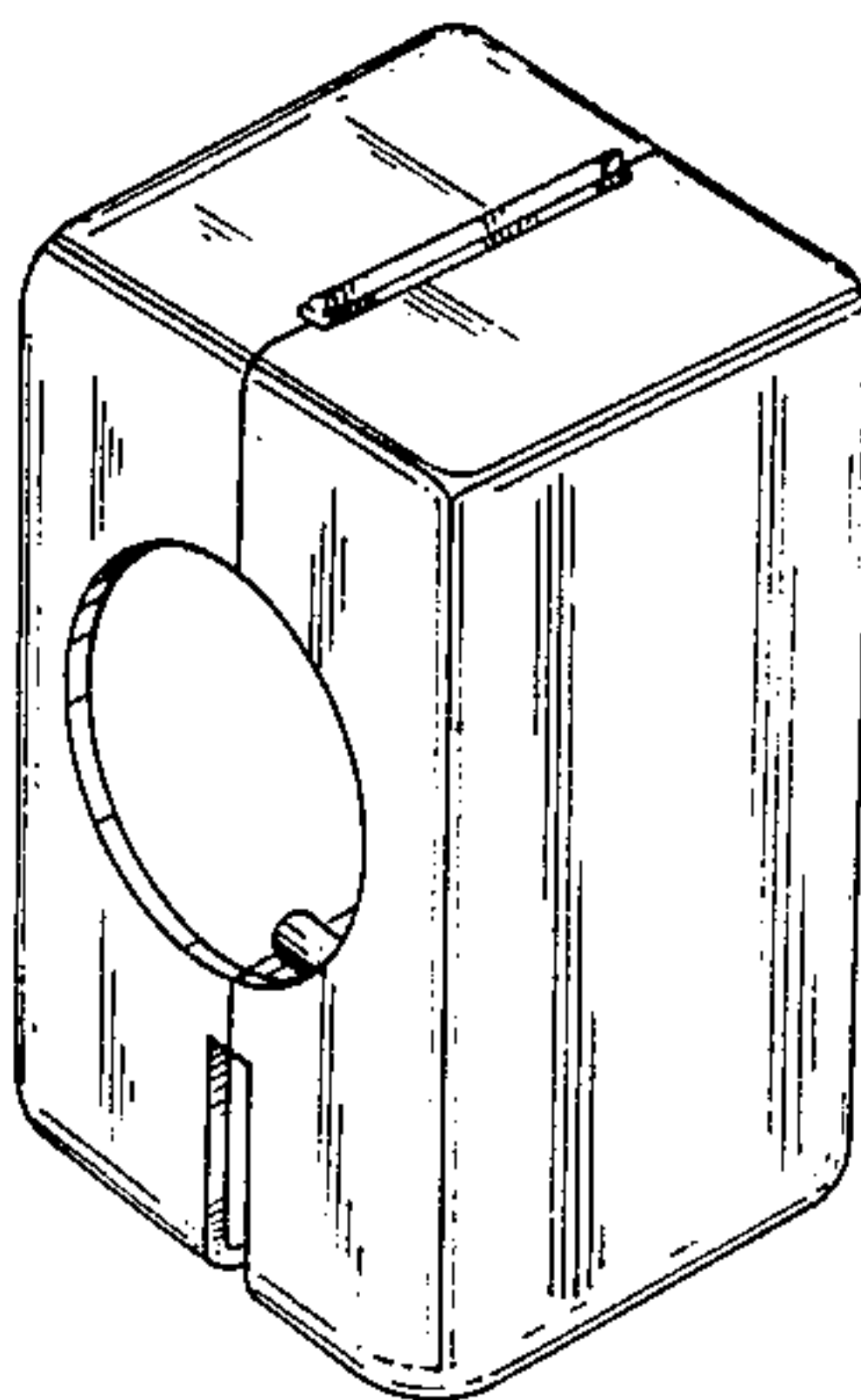
FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a shower curtain holder showing my new design in closed position;

FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively top and bottom plan views thereof.



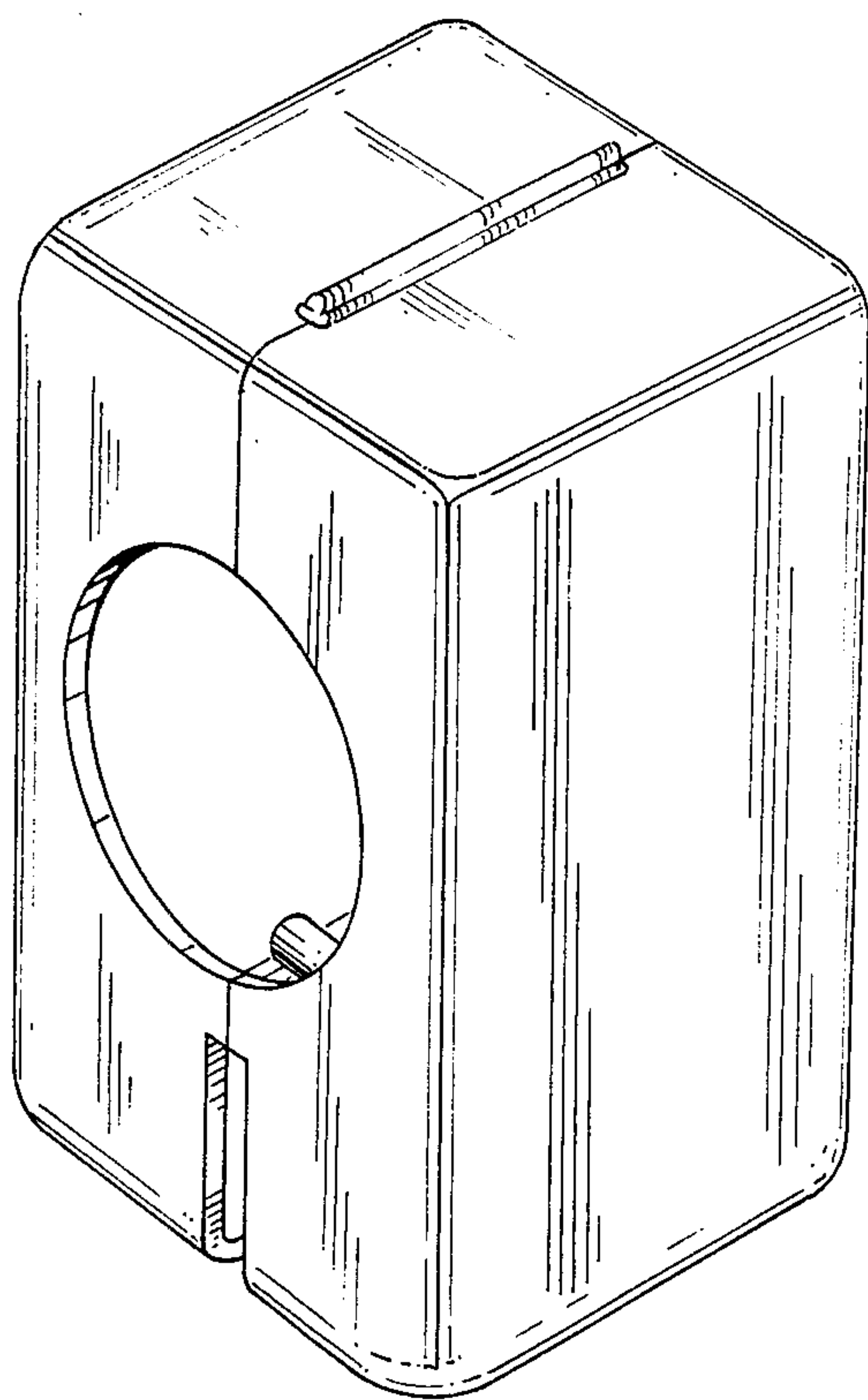

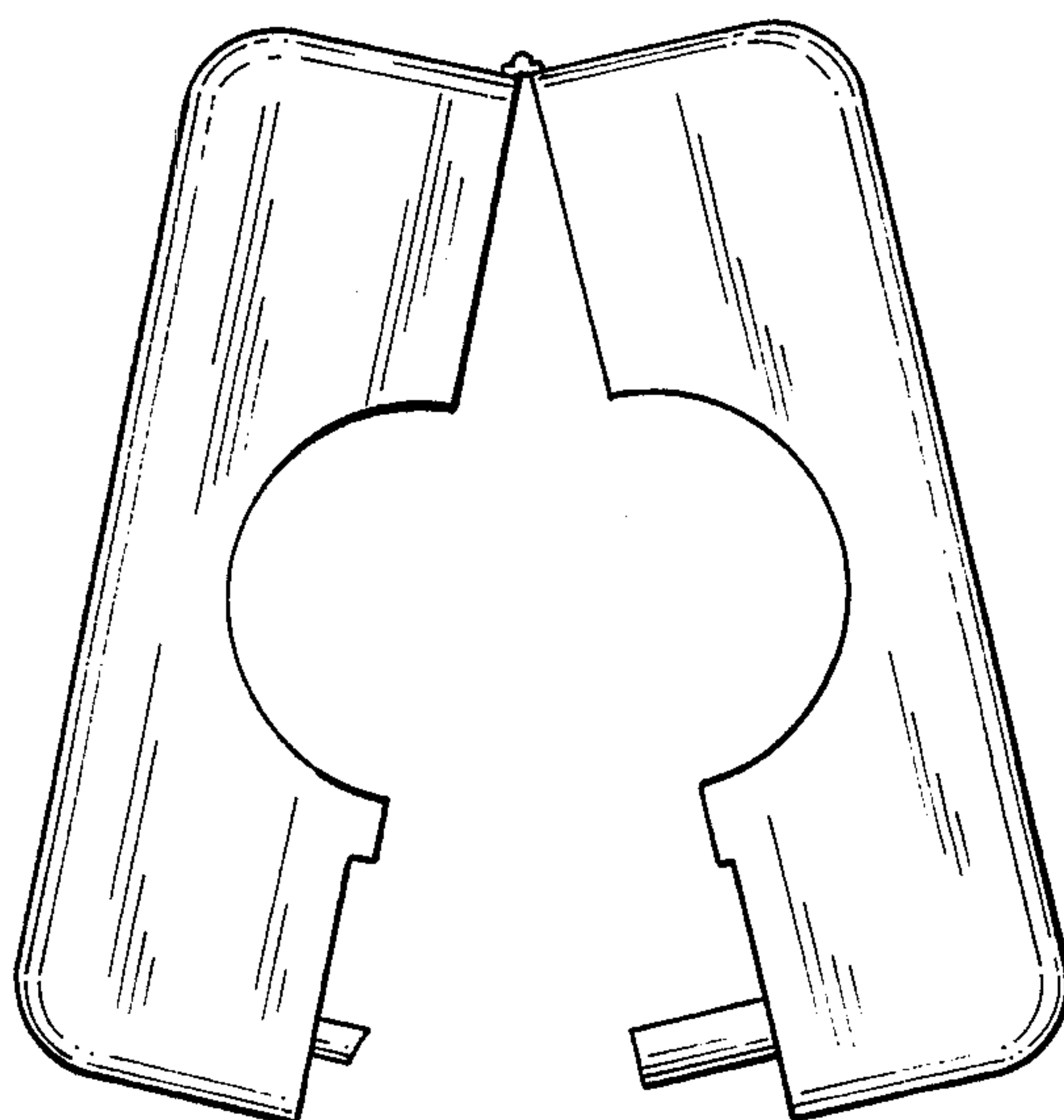

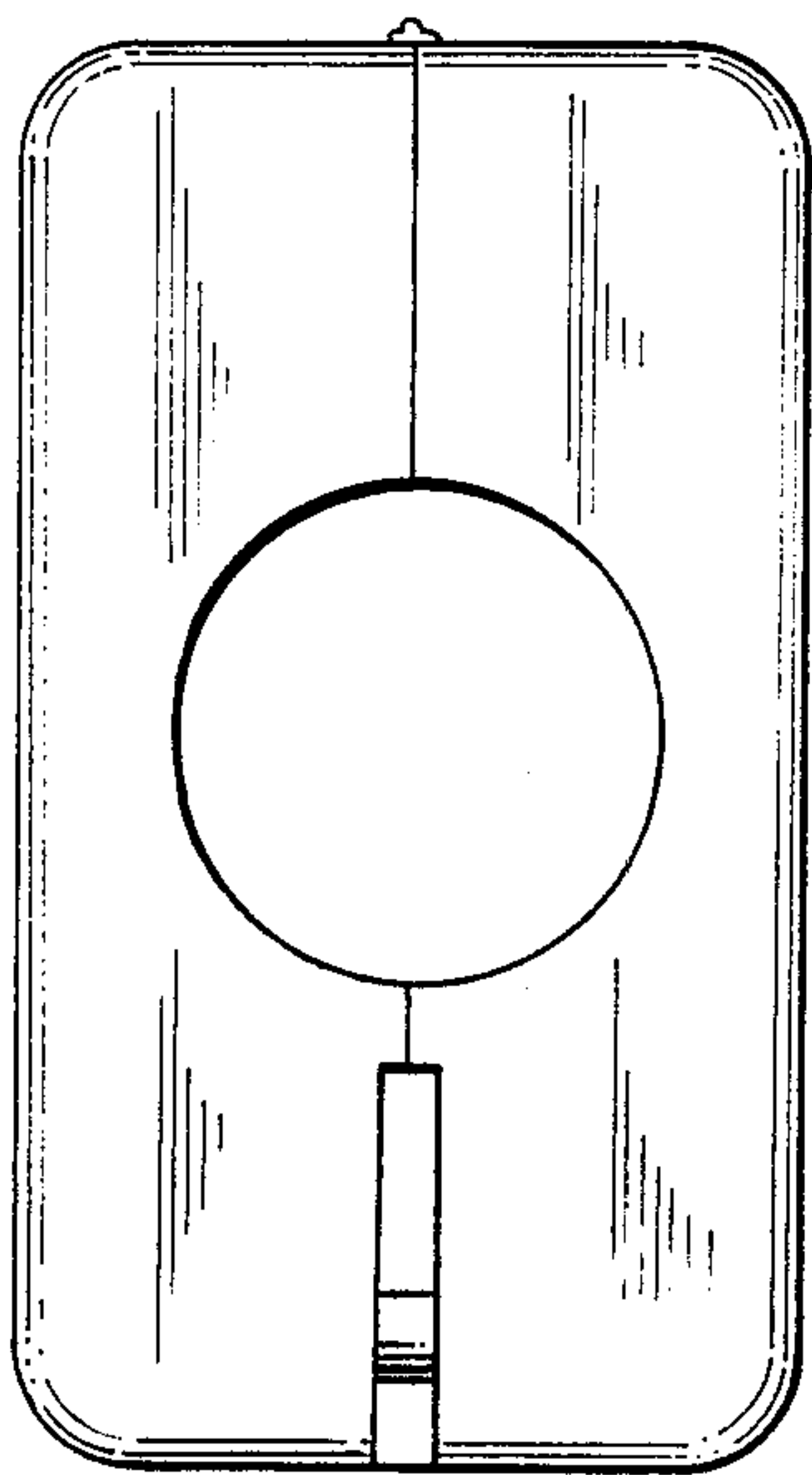

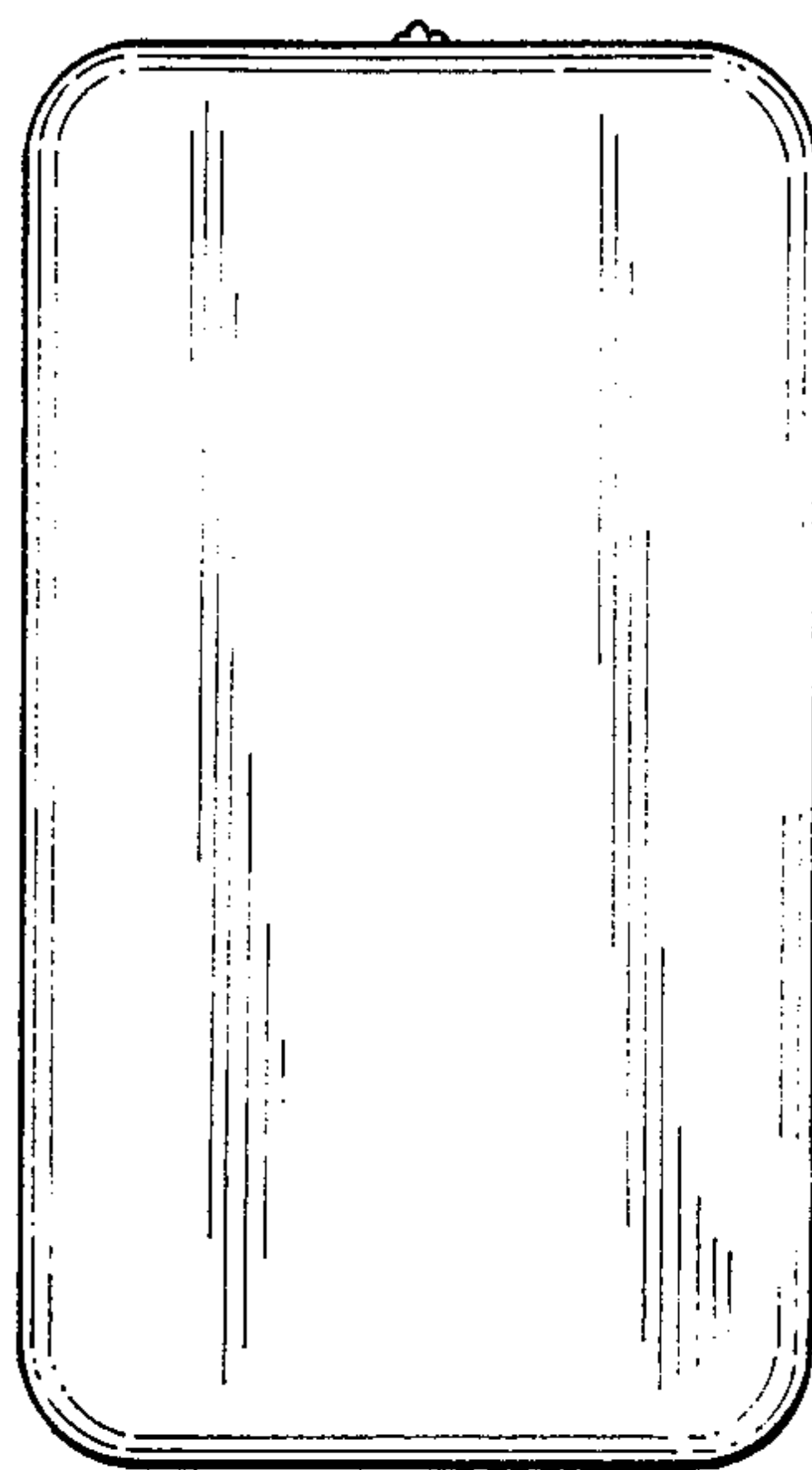

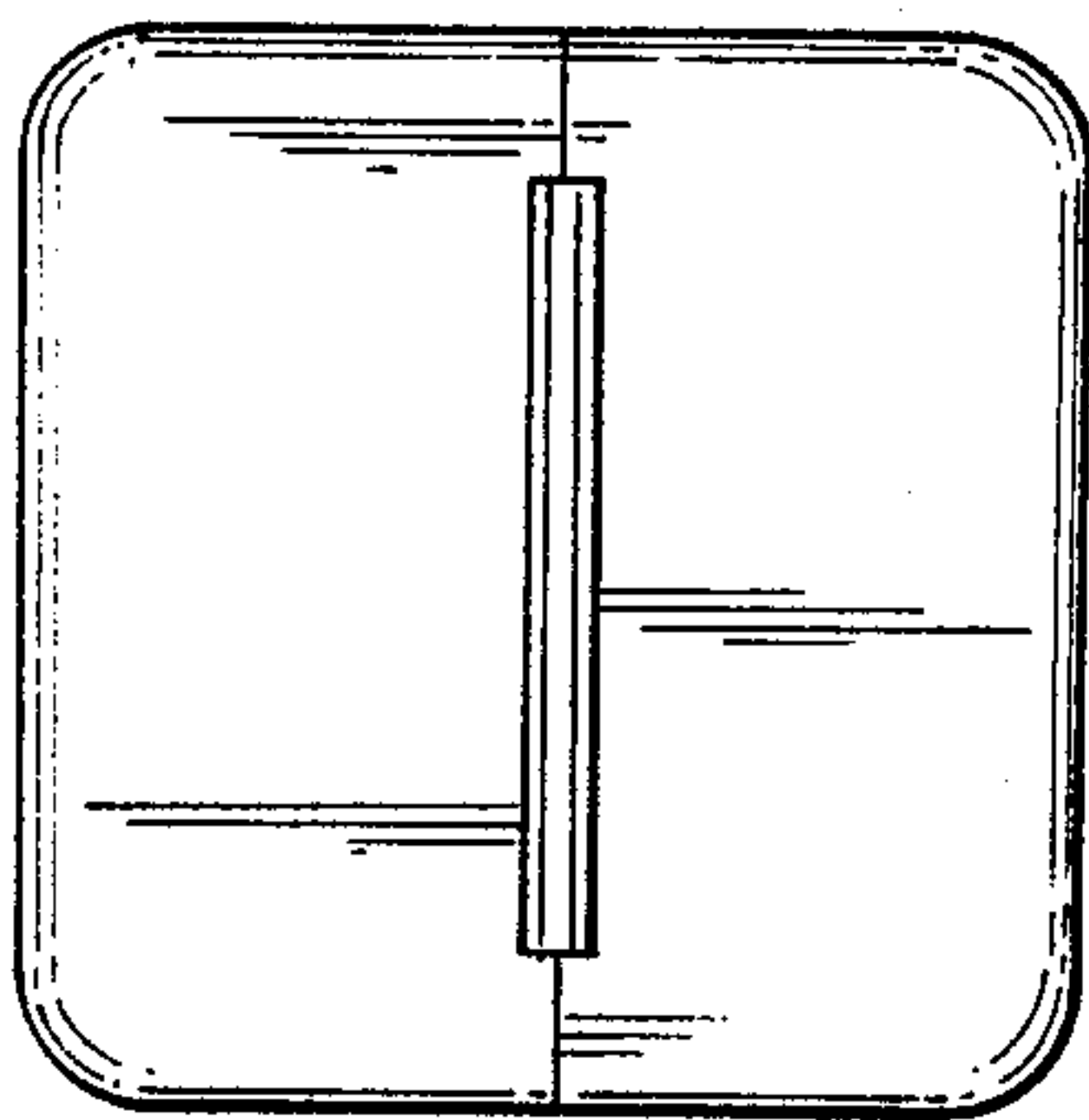

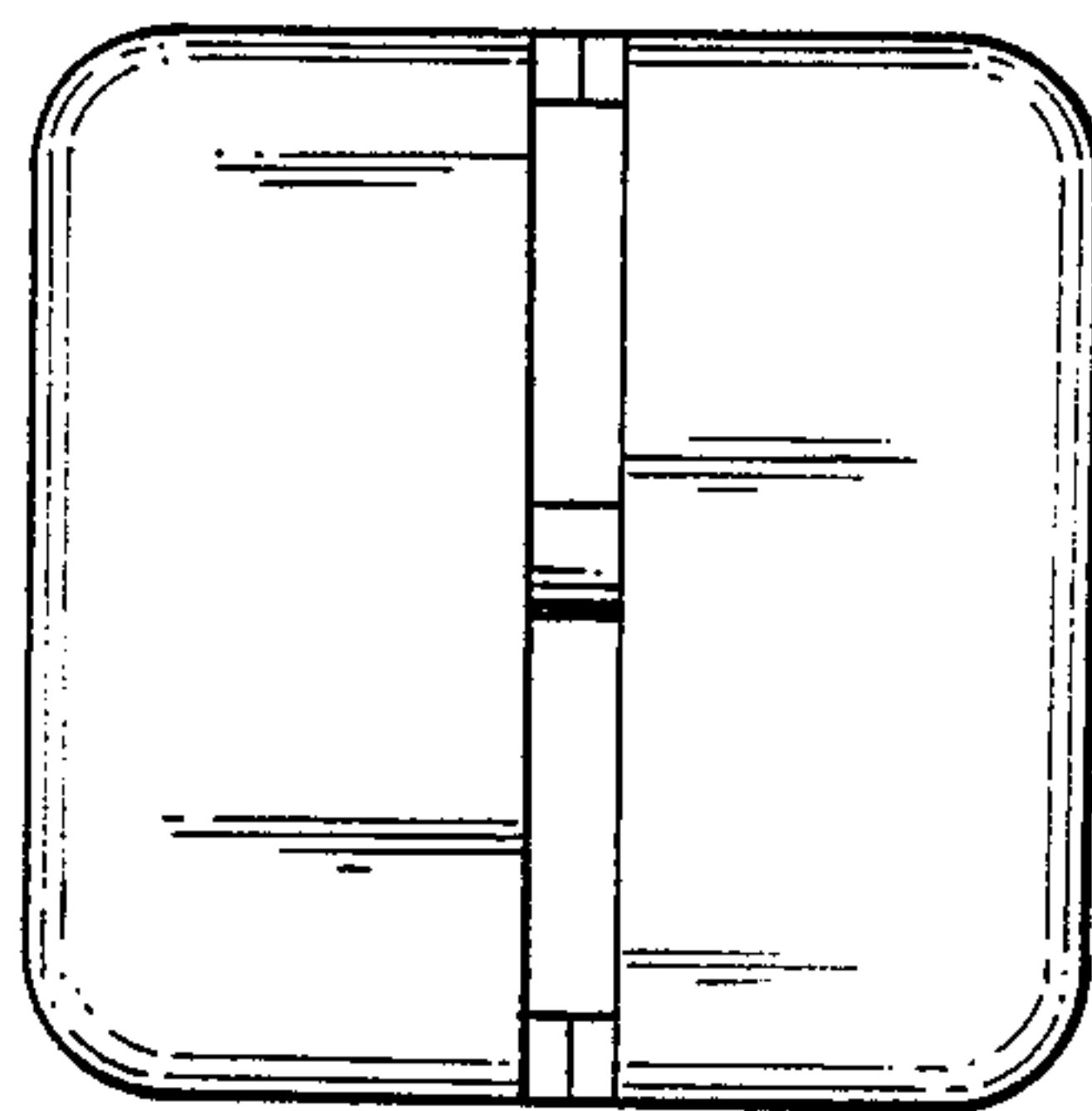
