DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a barbecue grill ash collector, for use with kettle barbecues, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

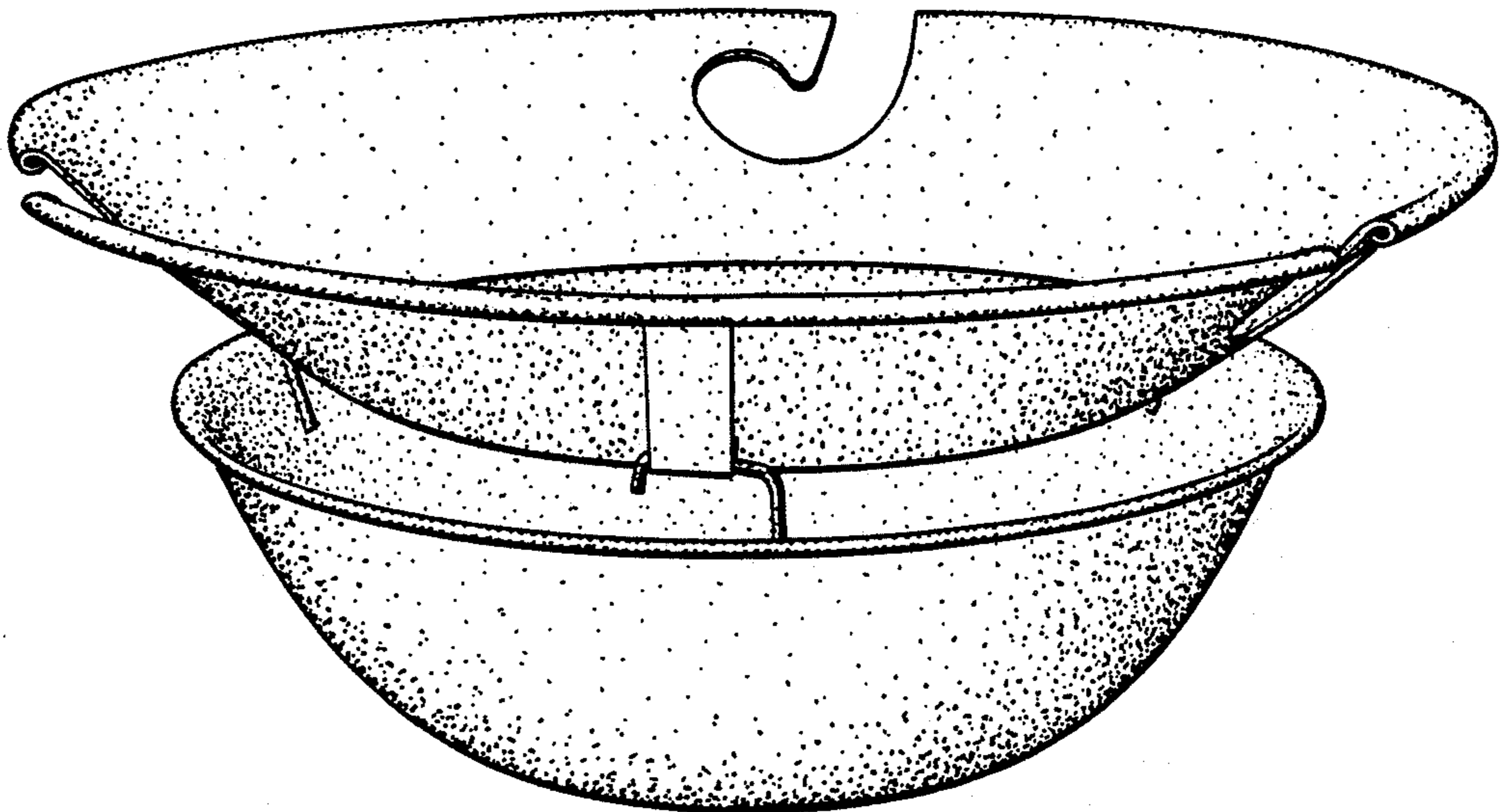
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



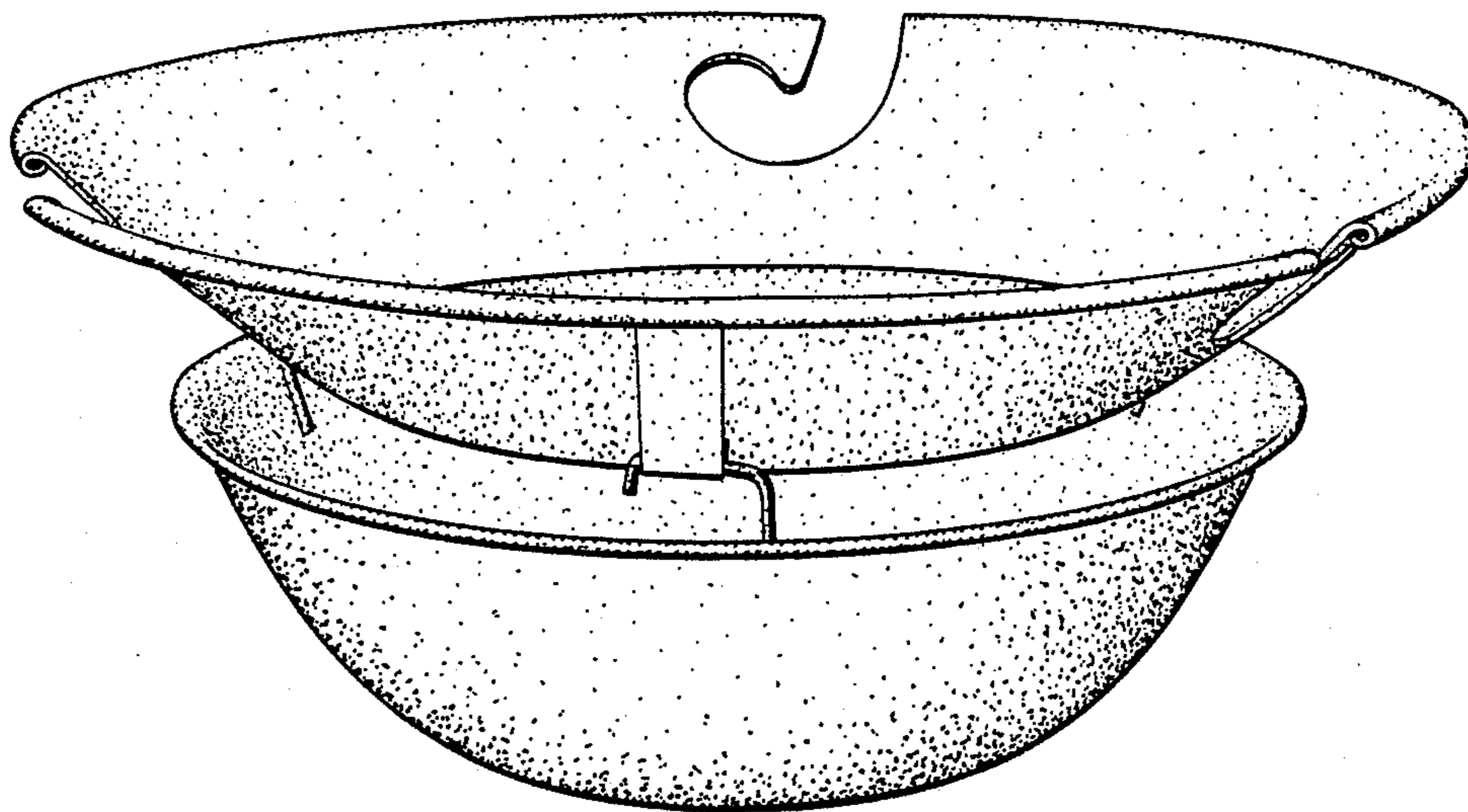

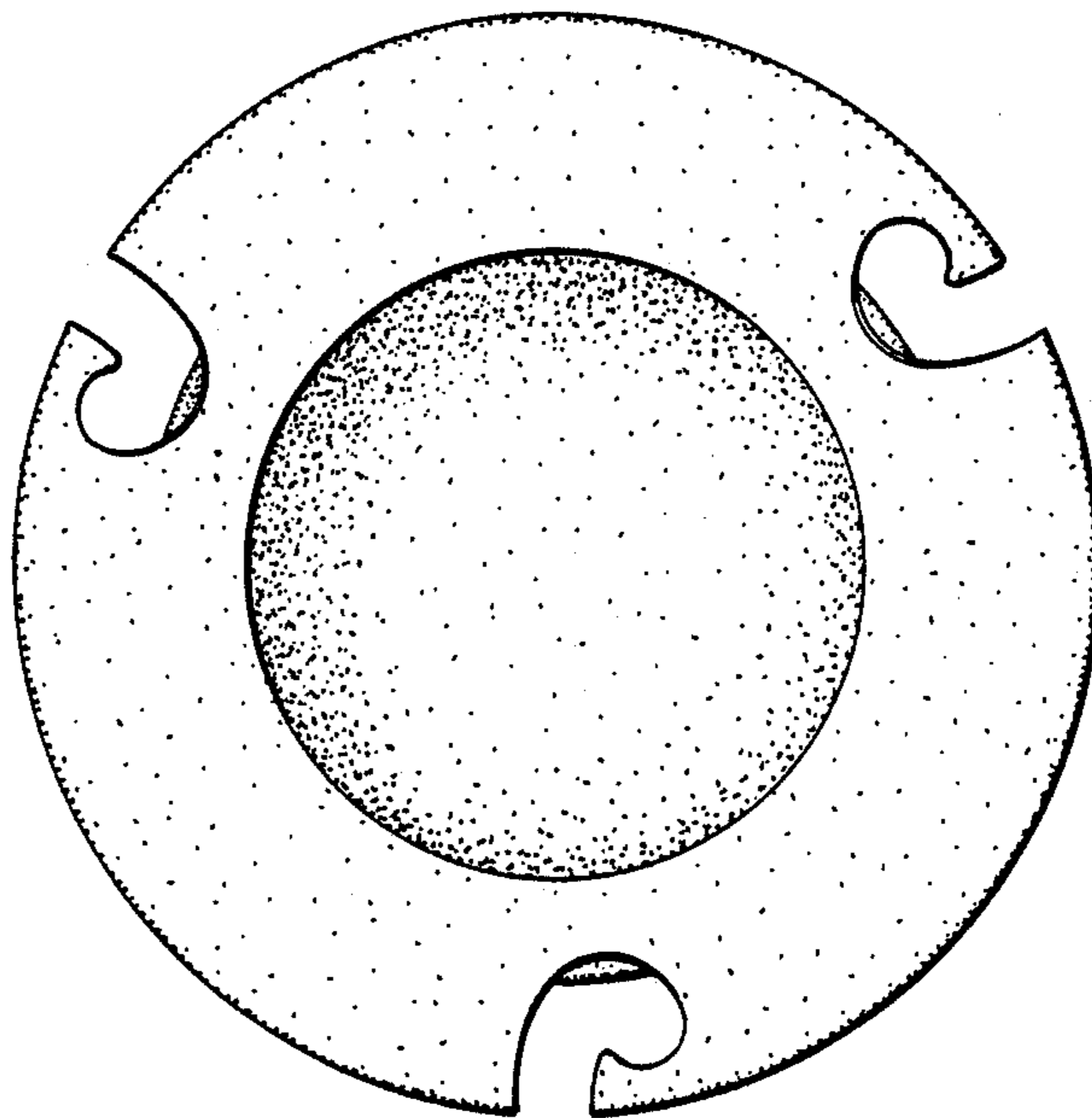

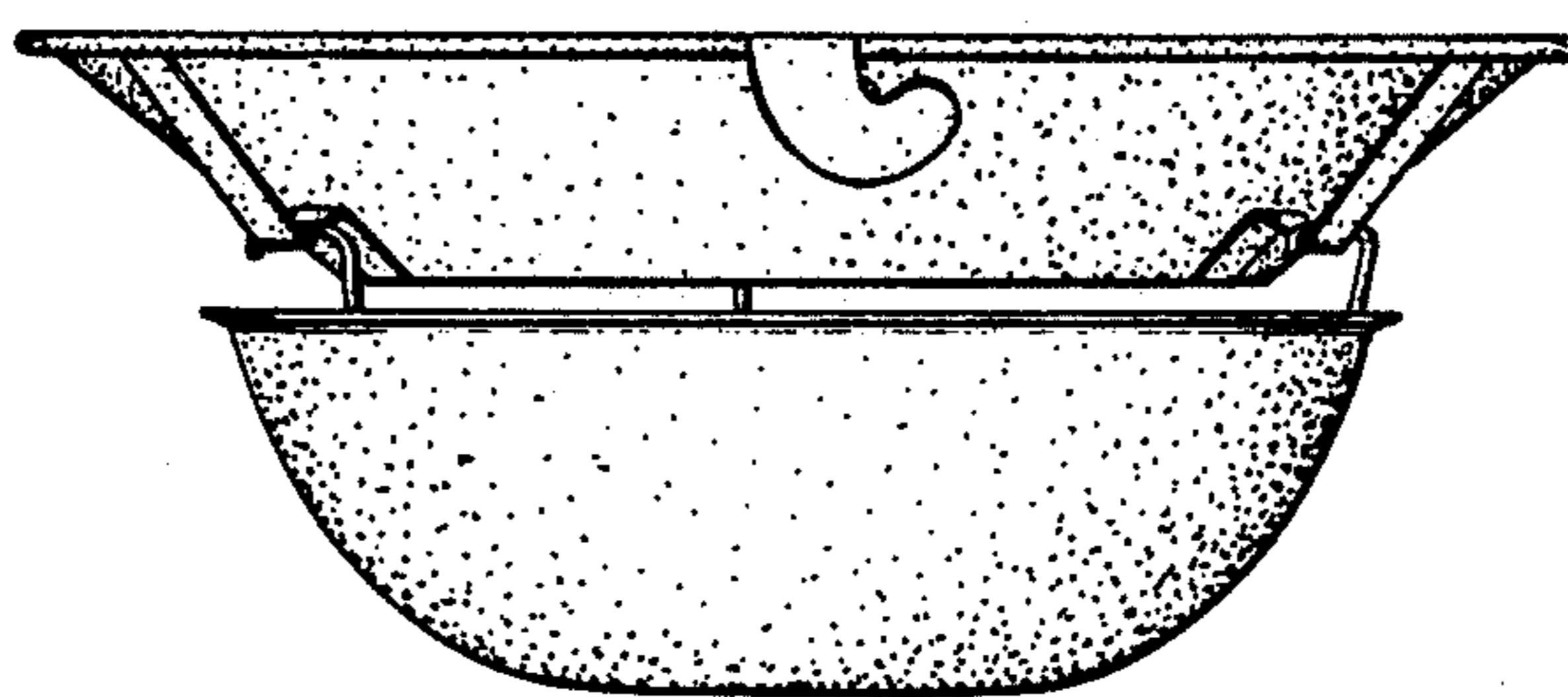

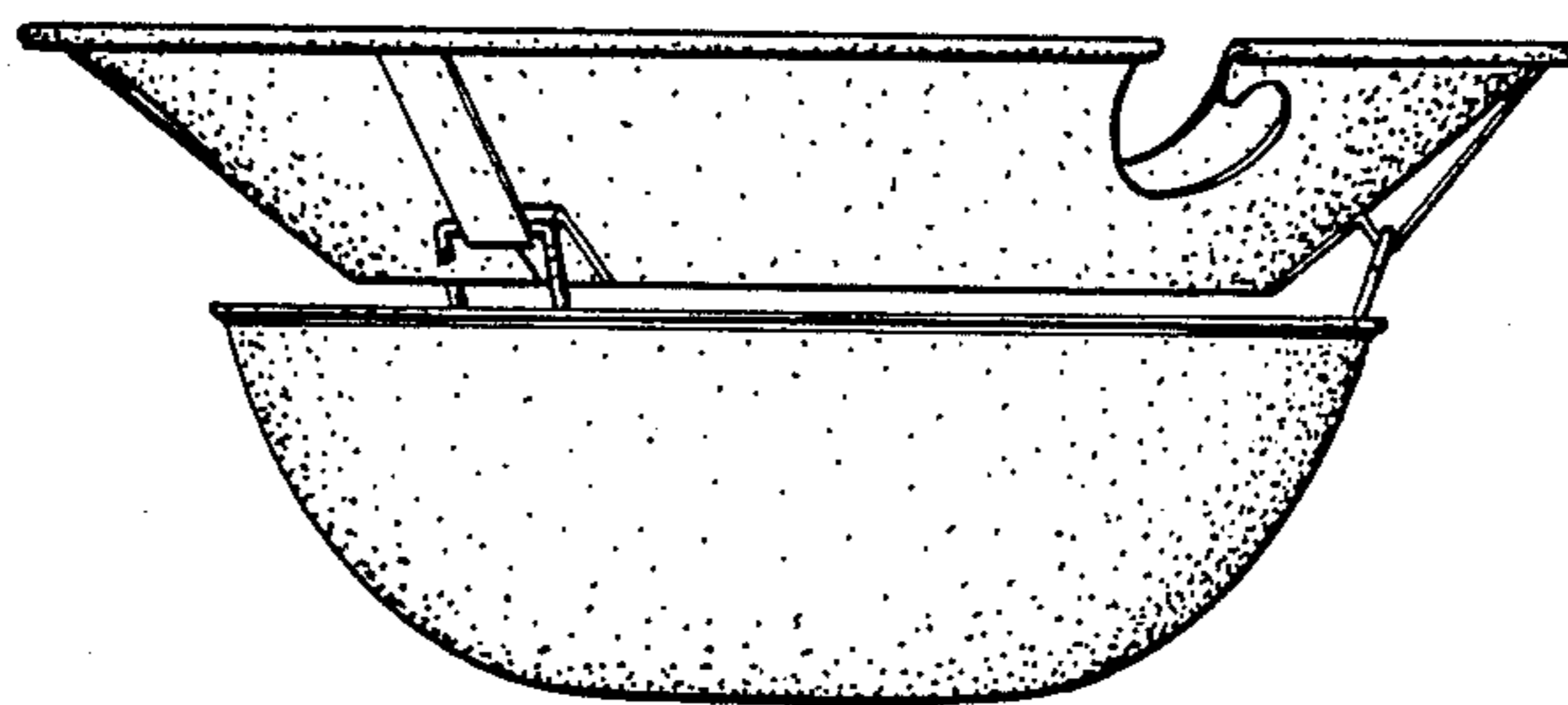

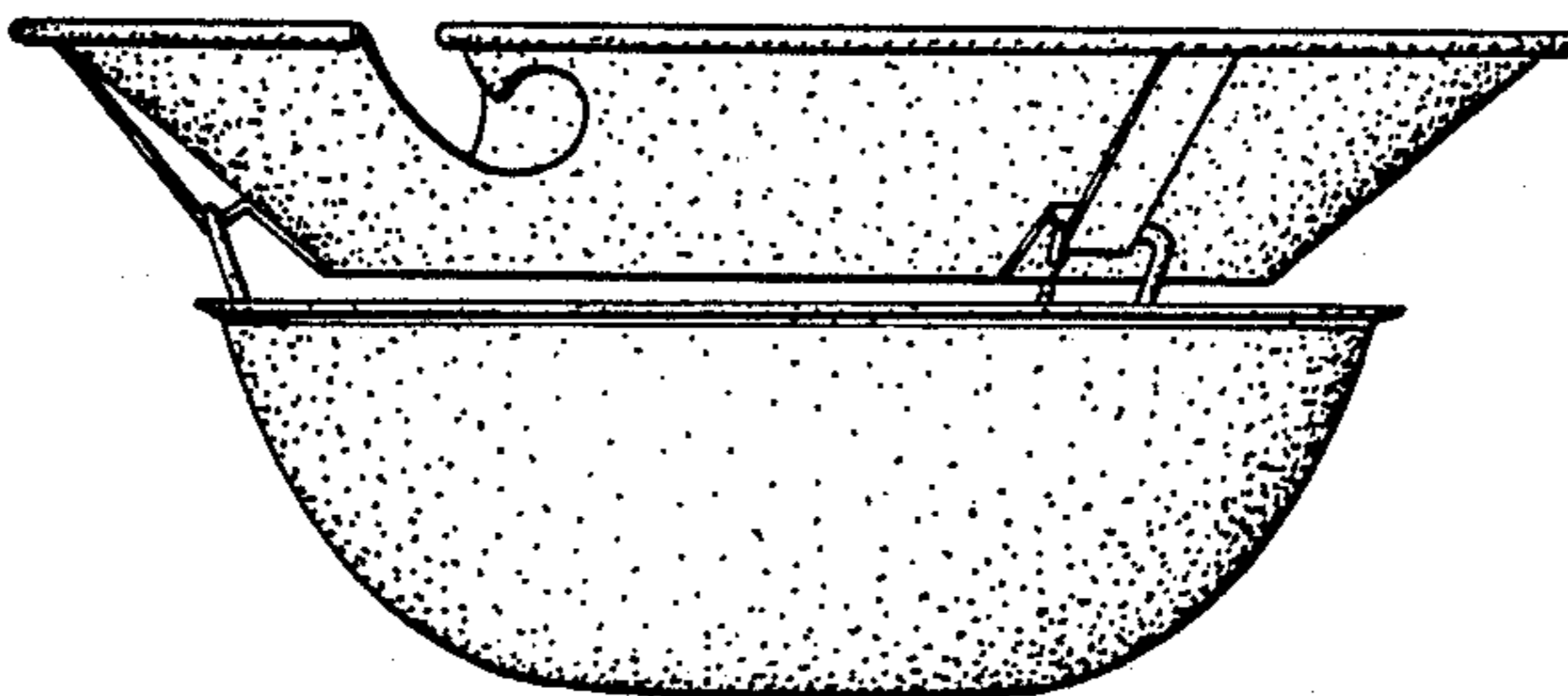

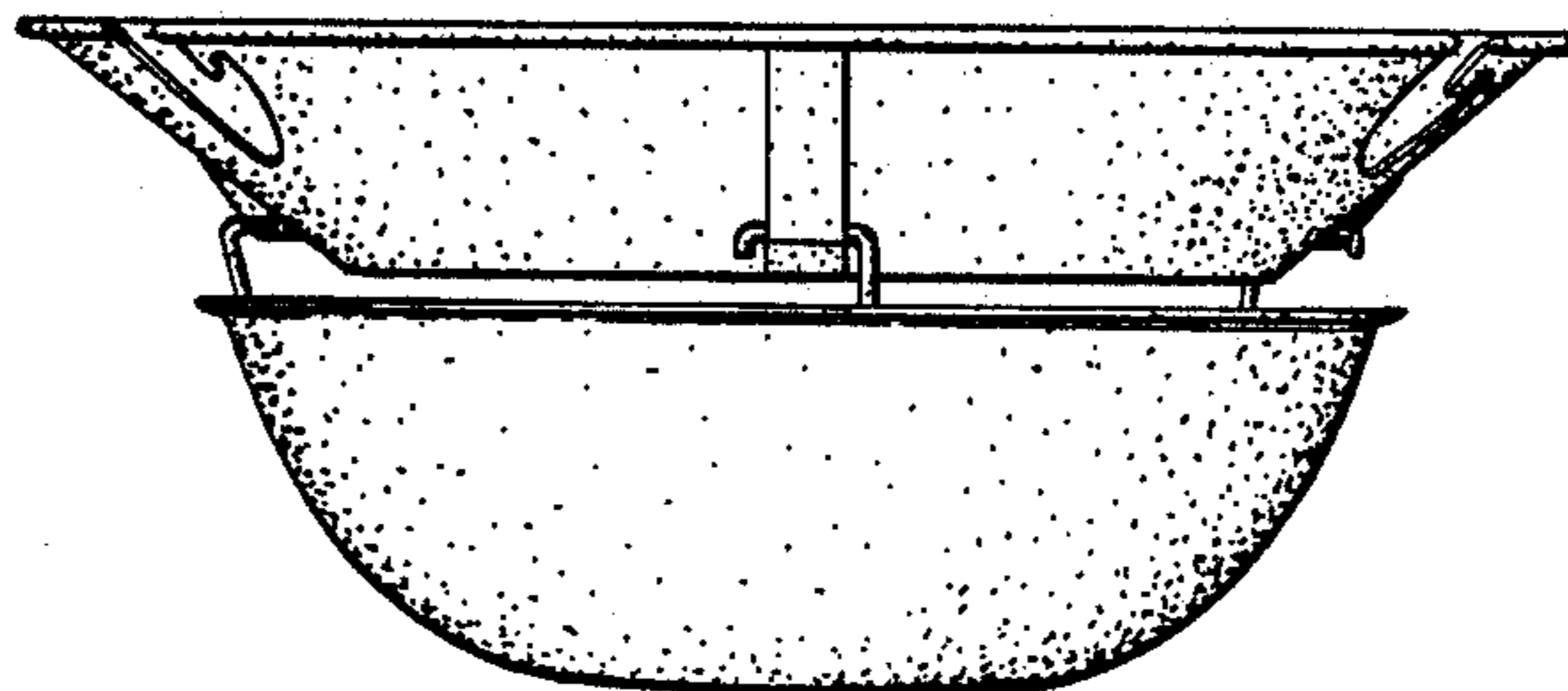

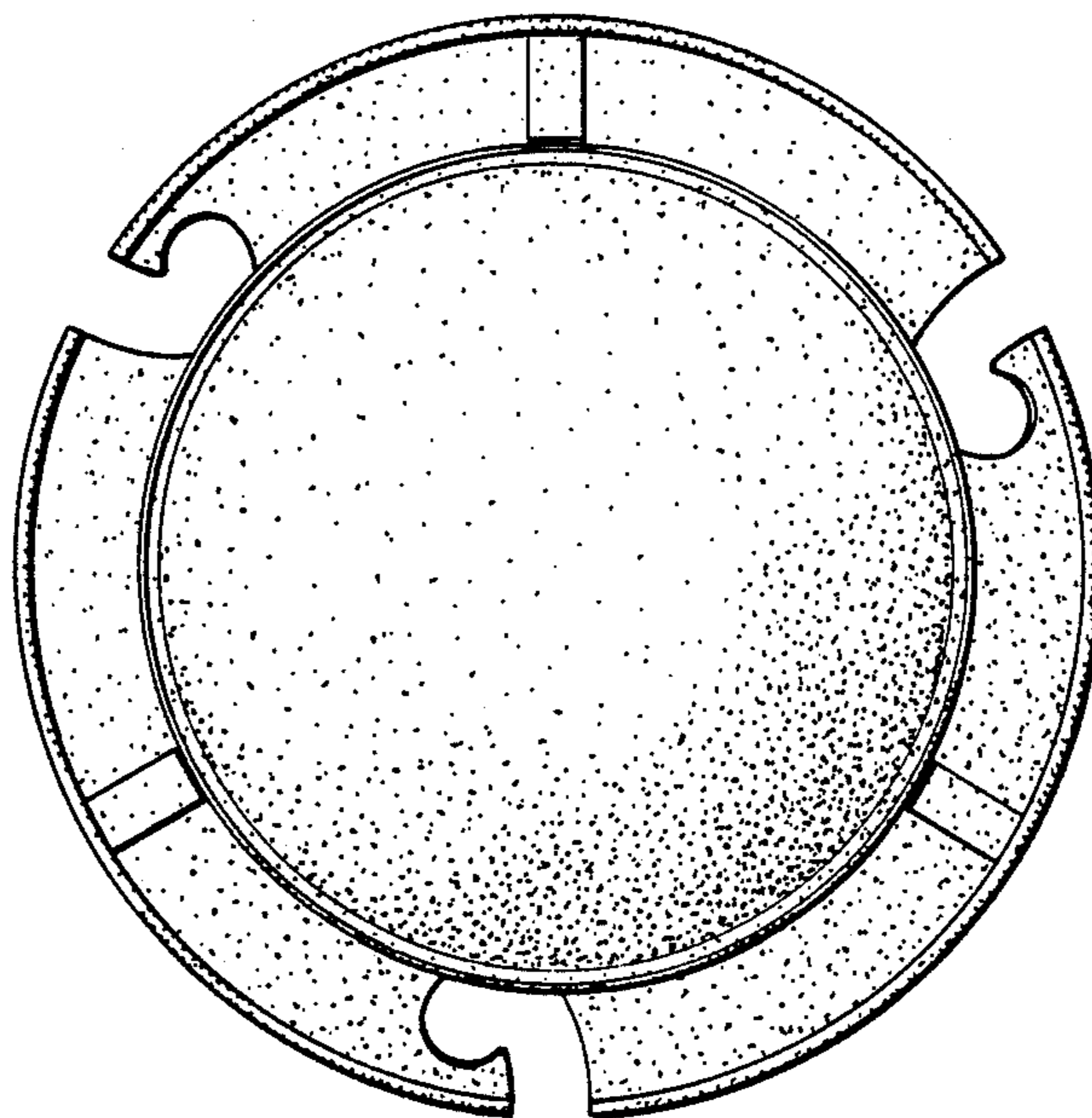
