The ornamental design for a handle for a fishing rod, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of one side of a handle for a fishing rod showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of the rod and foregrip is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

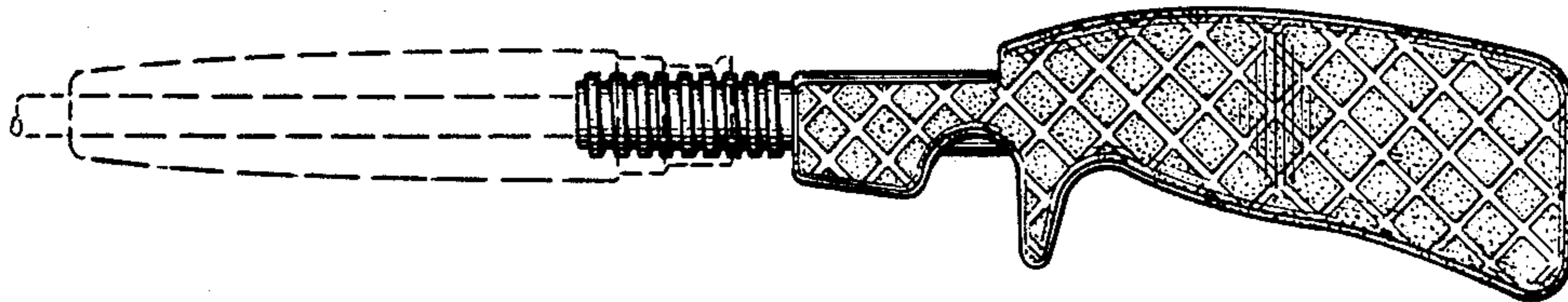

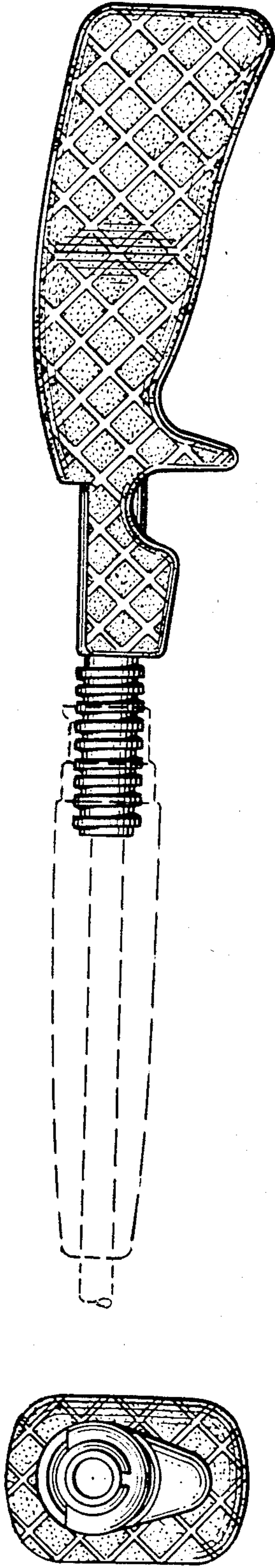

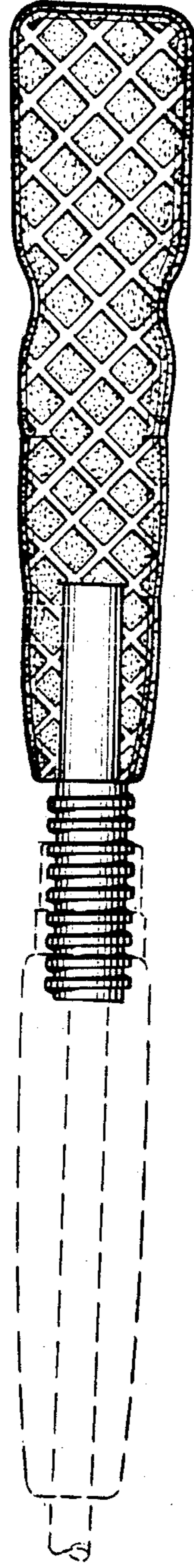

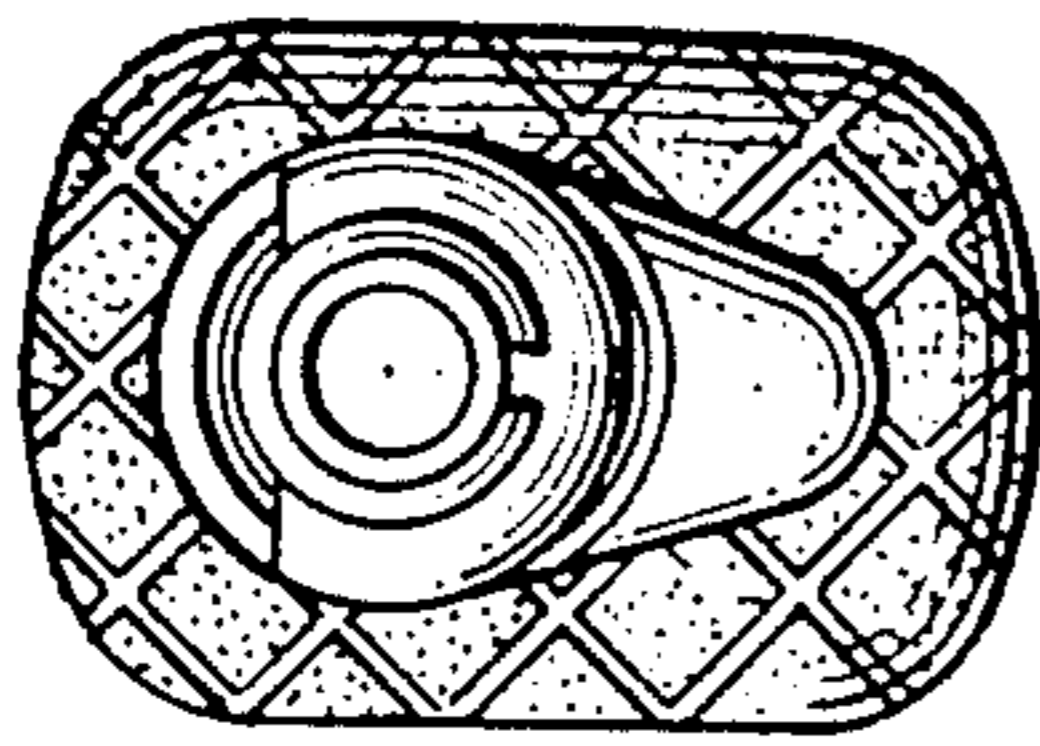

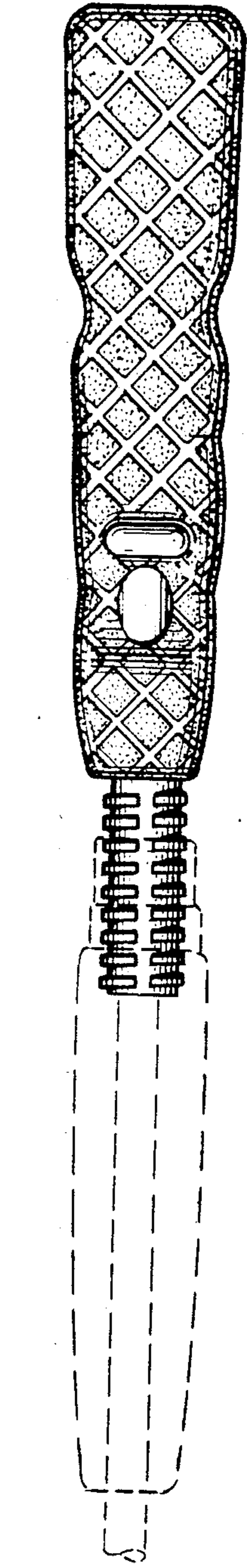
