[57] **CLAIM**

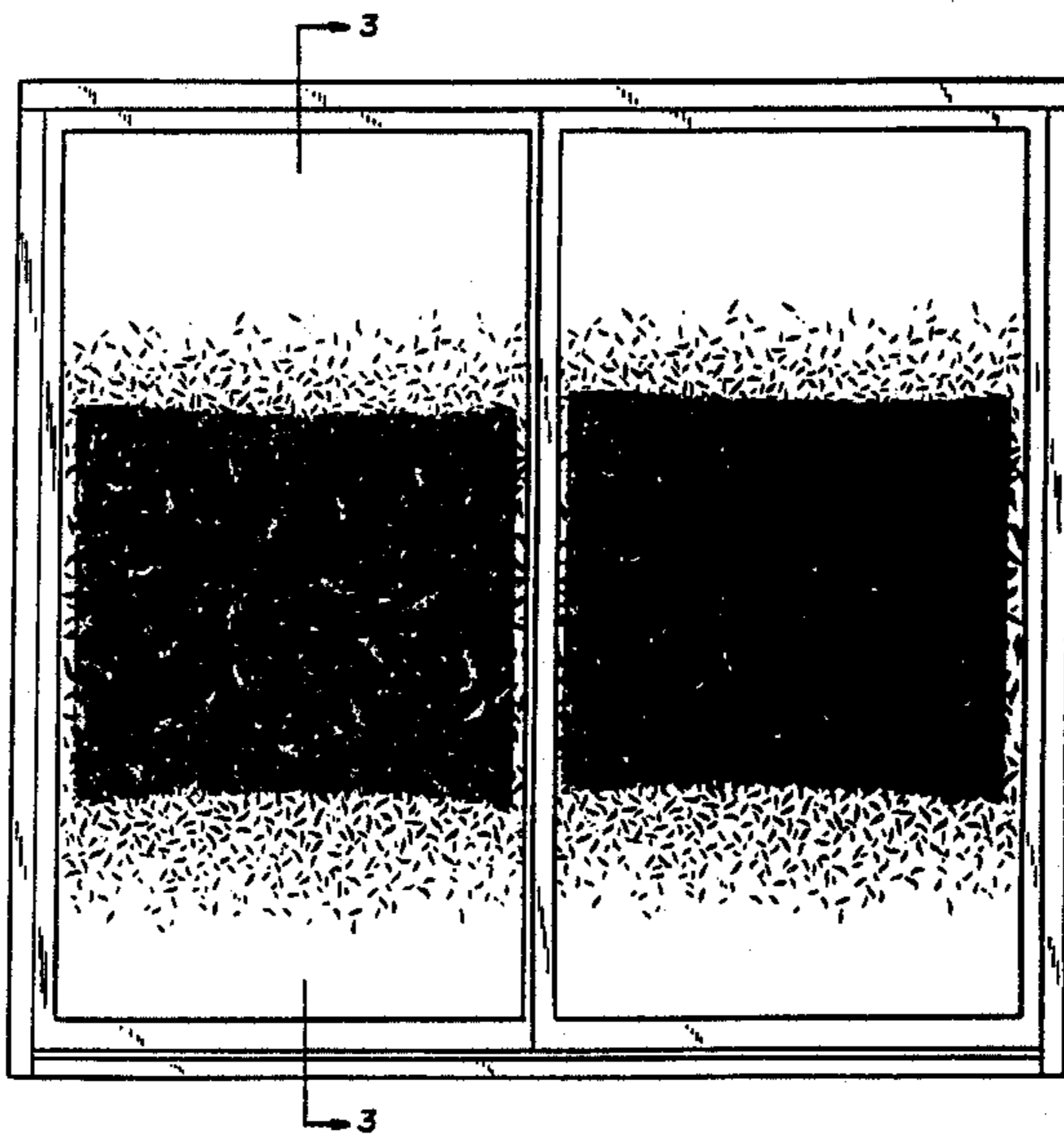
The ornamental design for a decorative sliding door, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1.



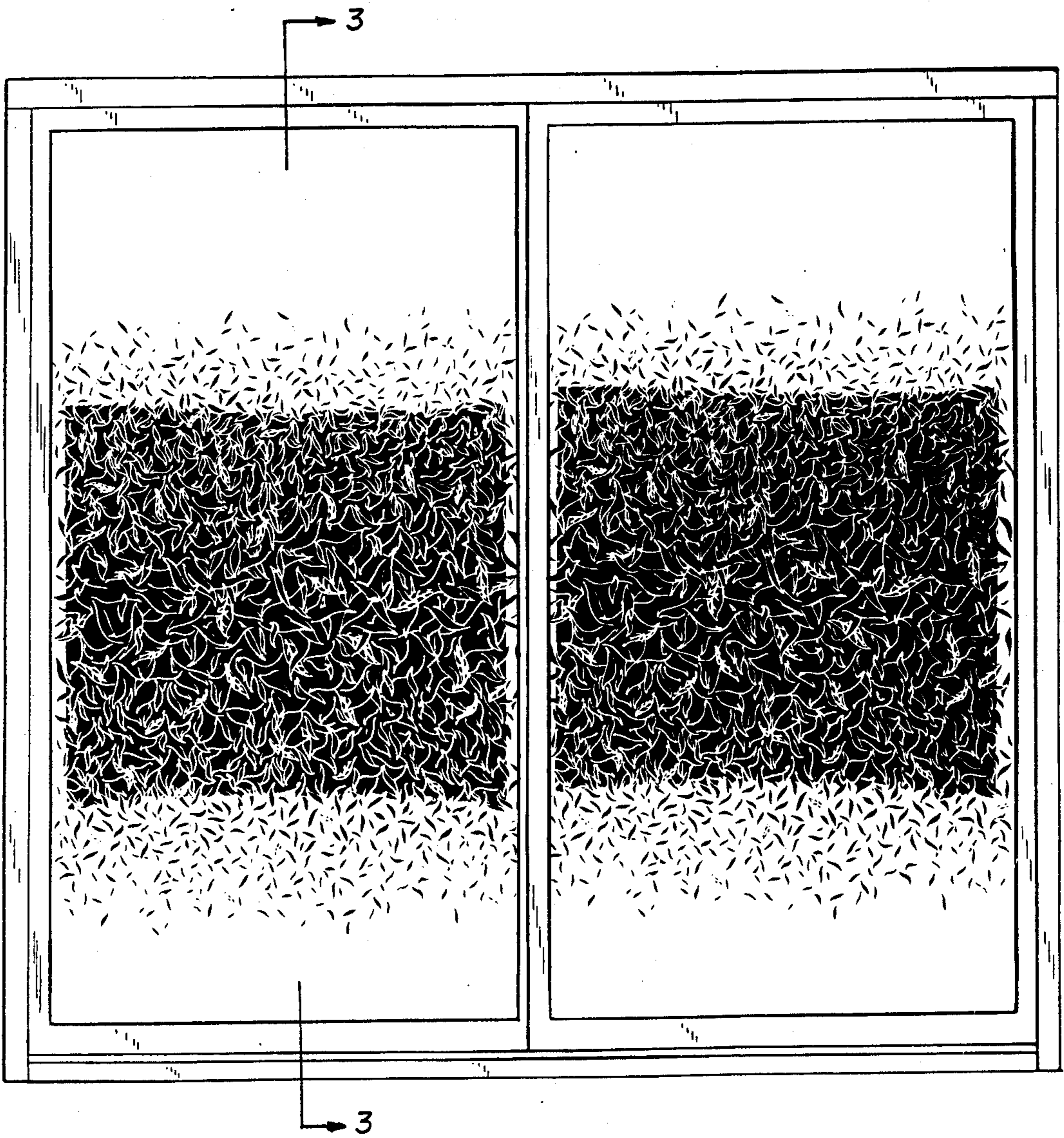

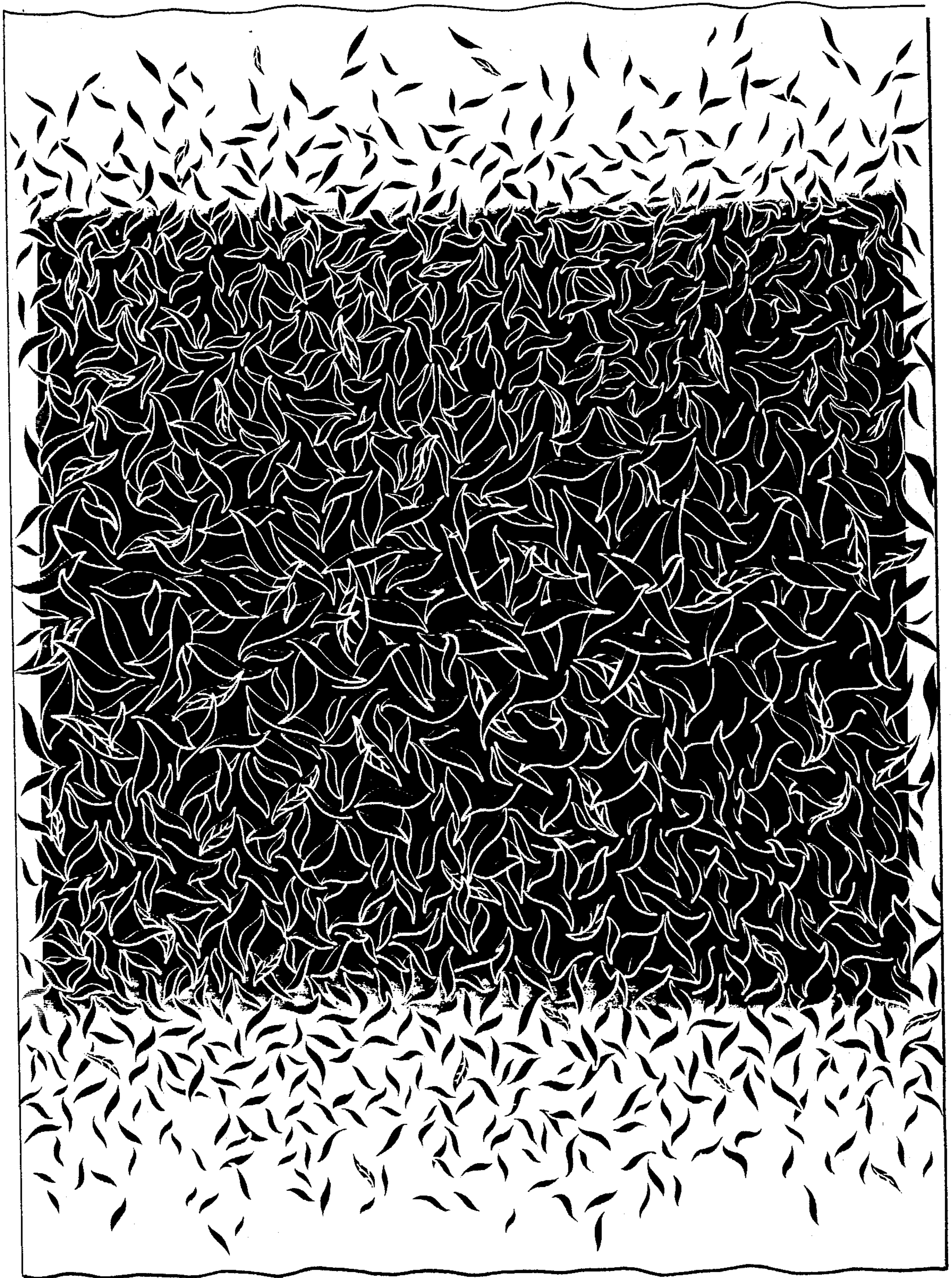

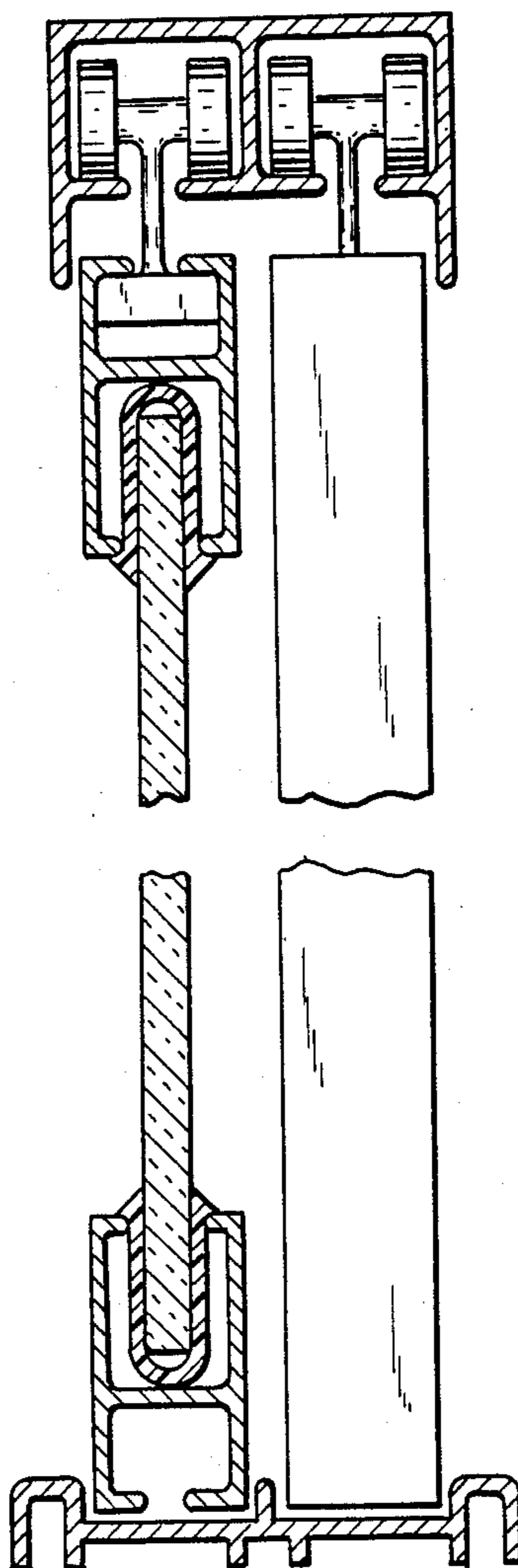
