The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

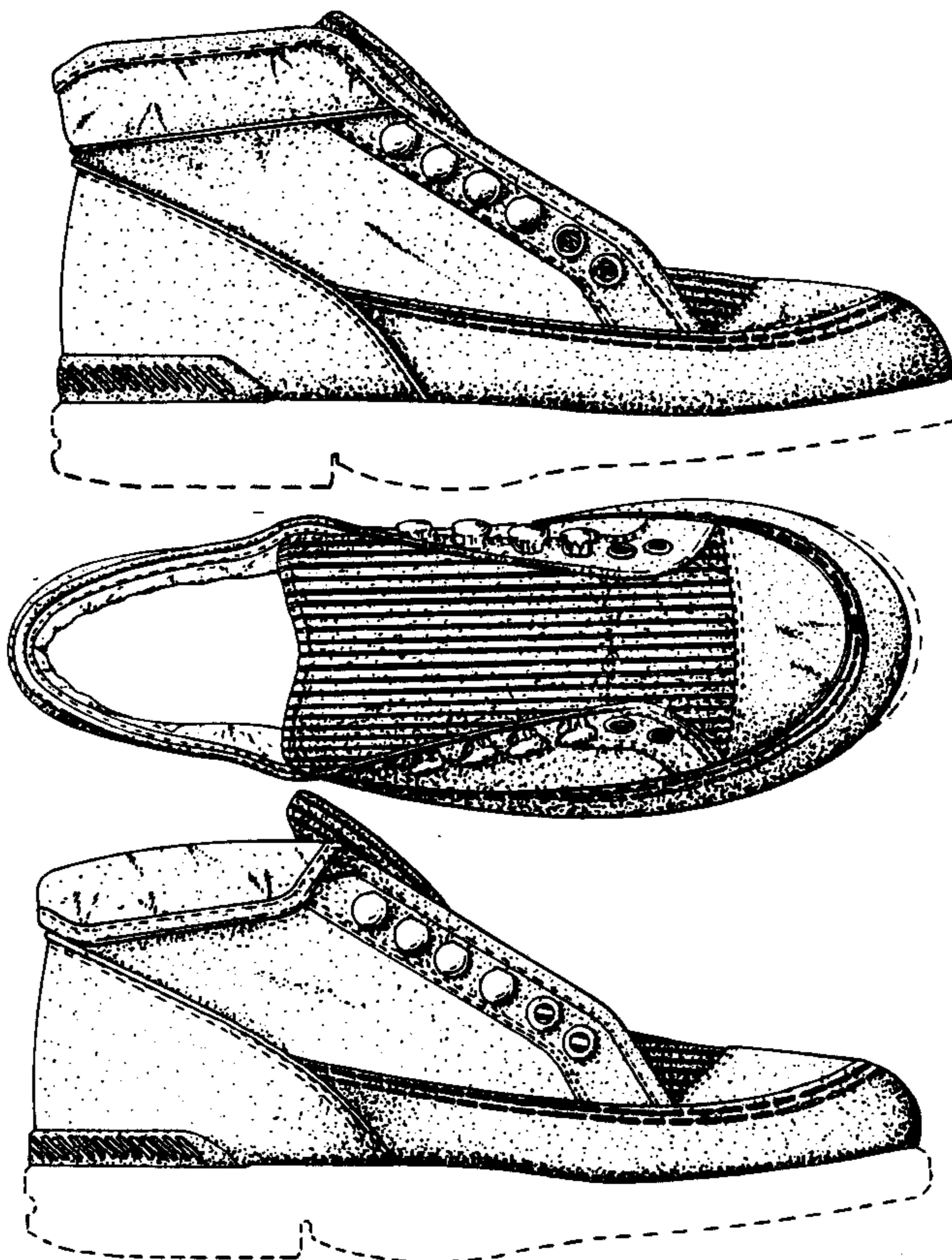
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing my new design having the collar piece turned down; and
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a shoe sole in FIGS. 1-7 and the area within are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.

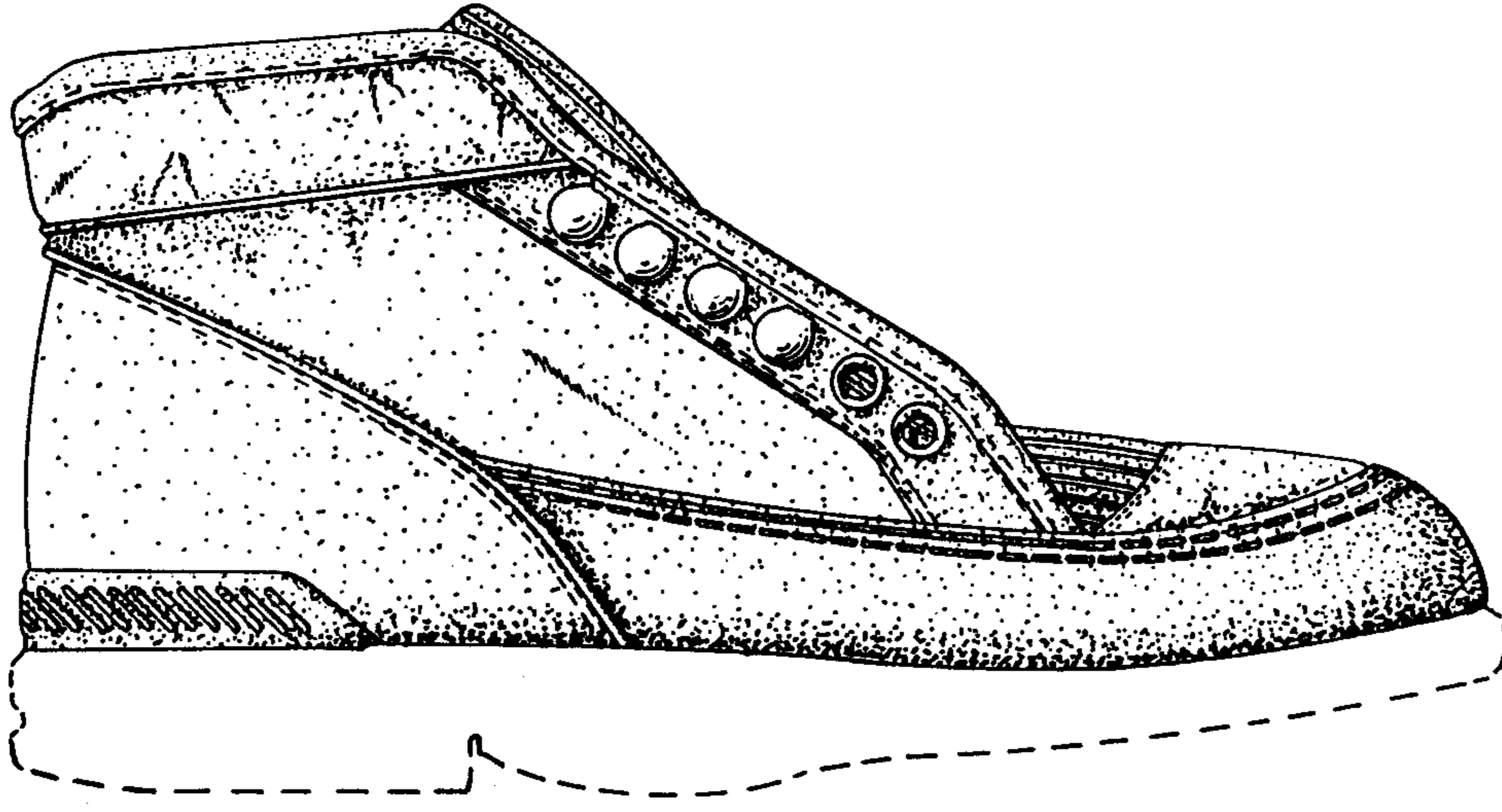

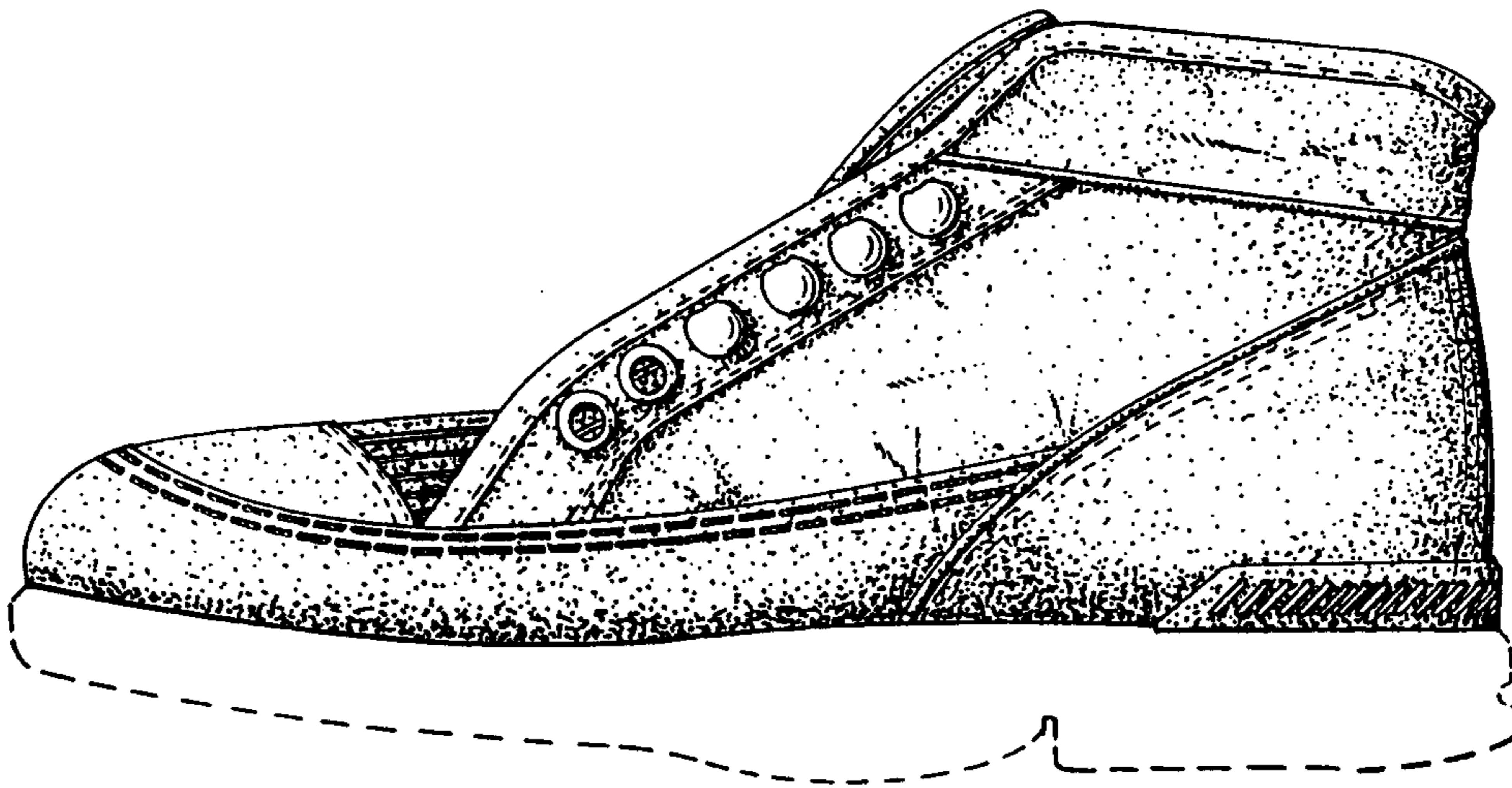

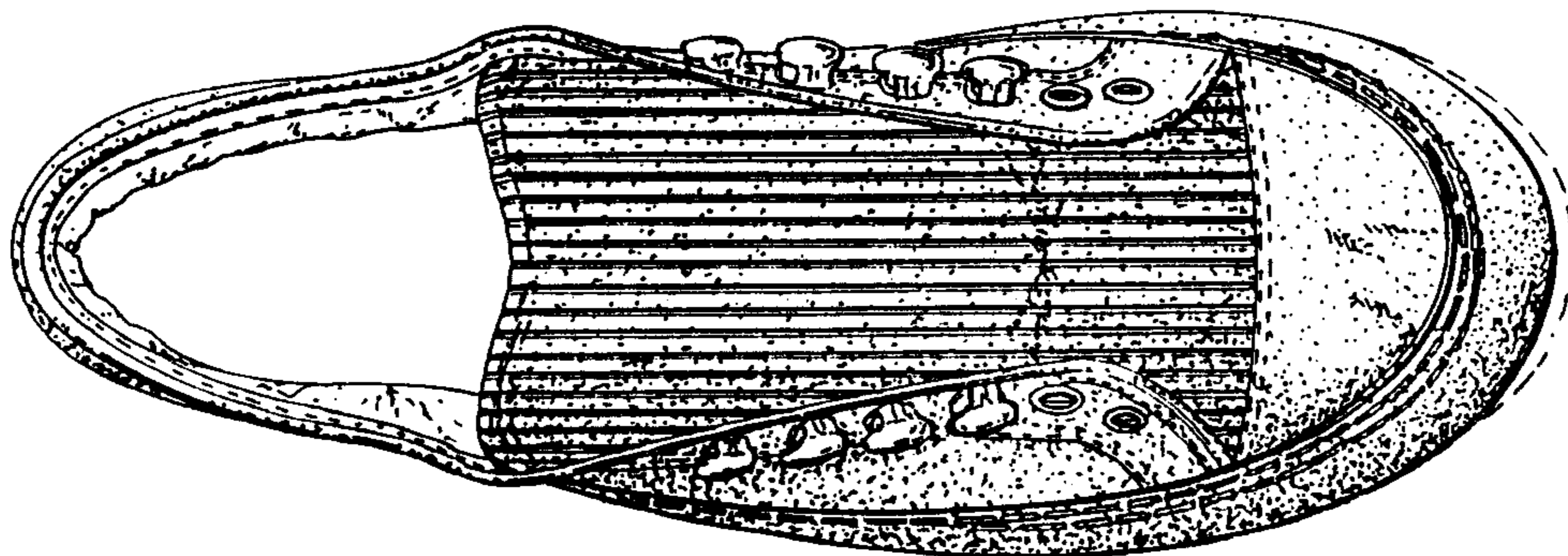

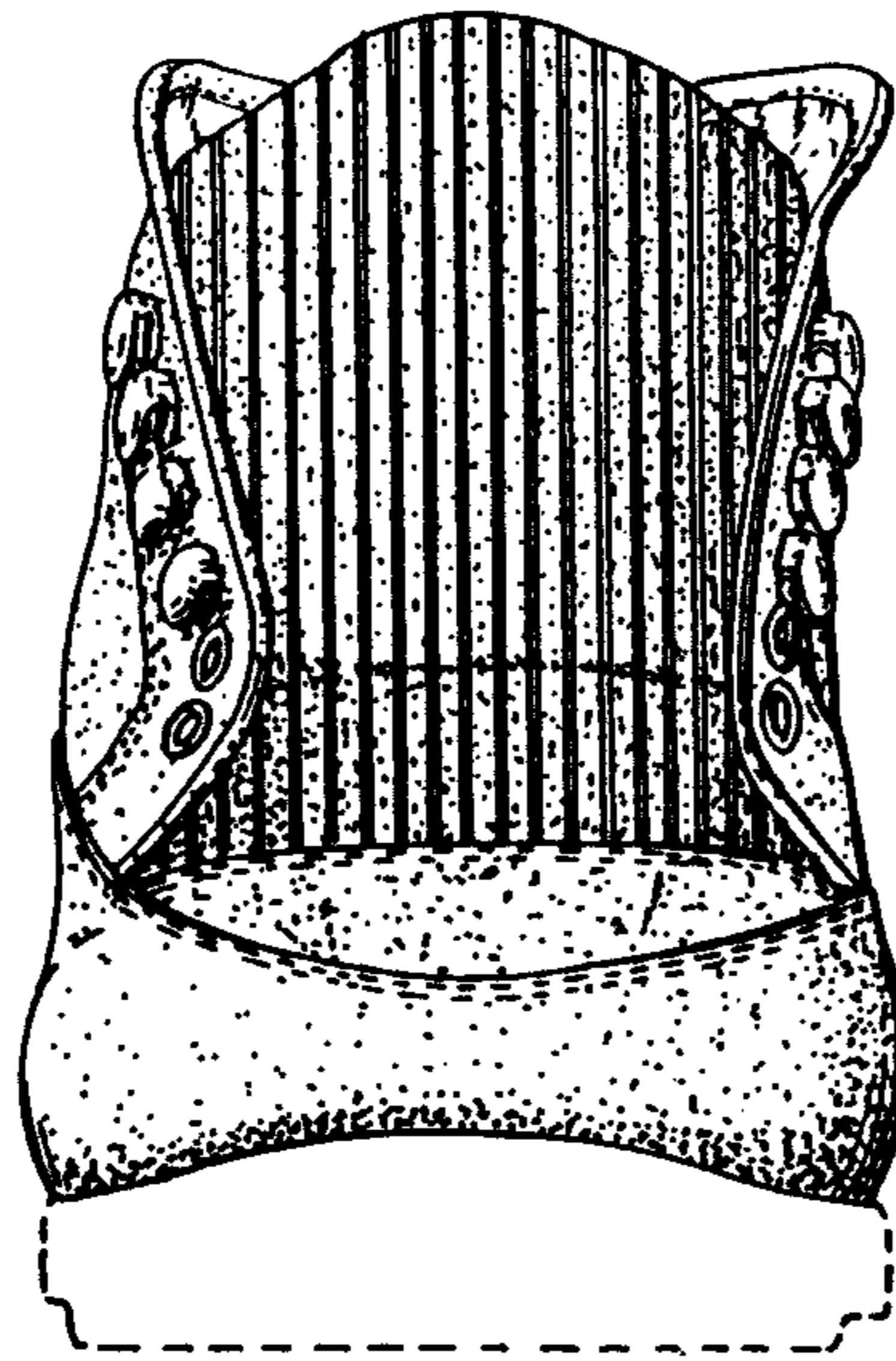

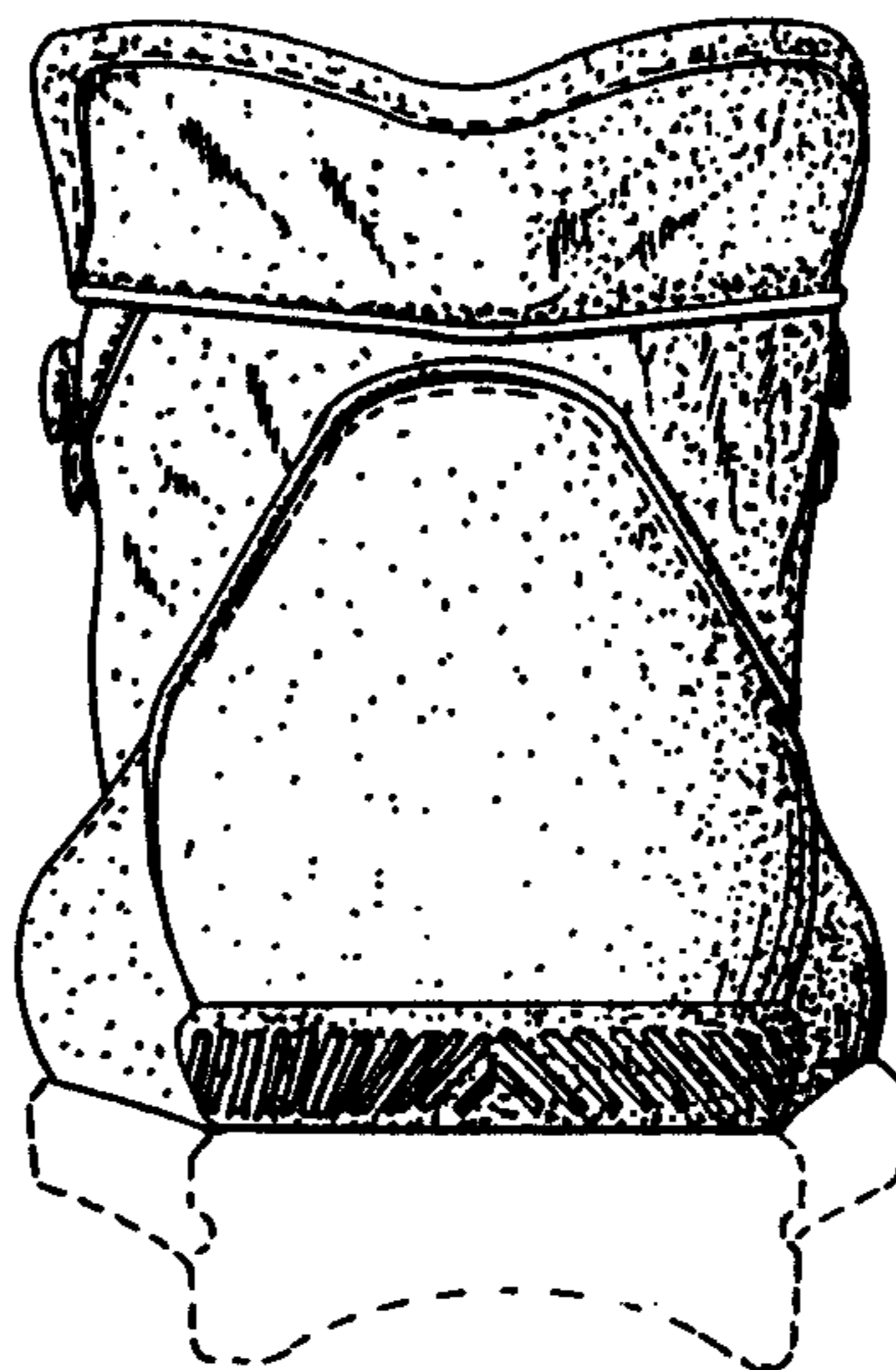

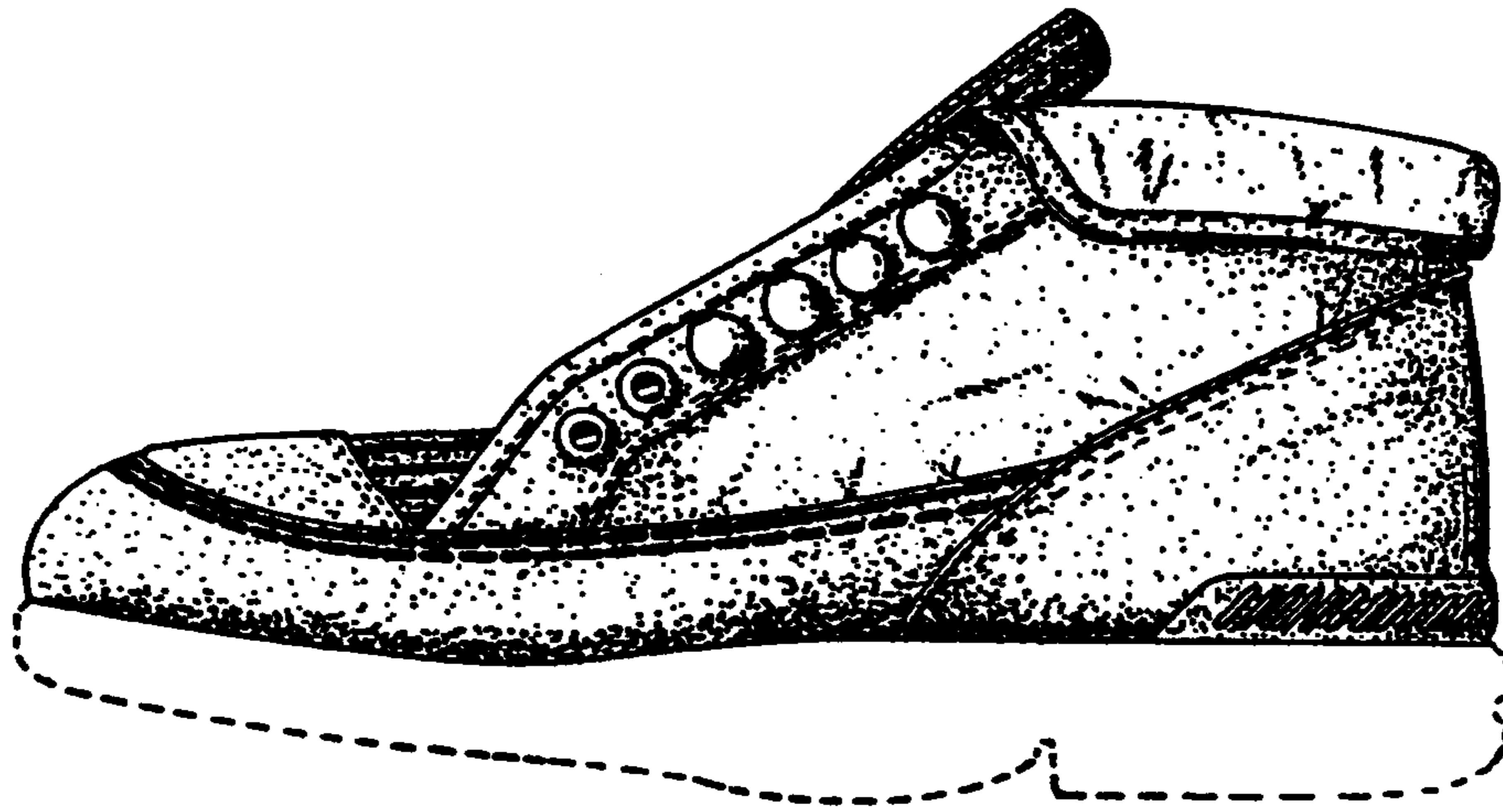

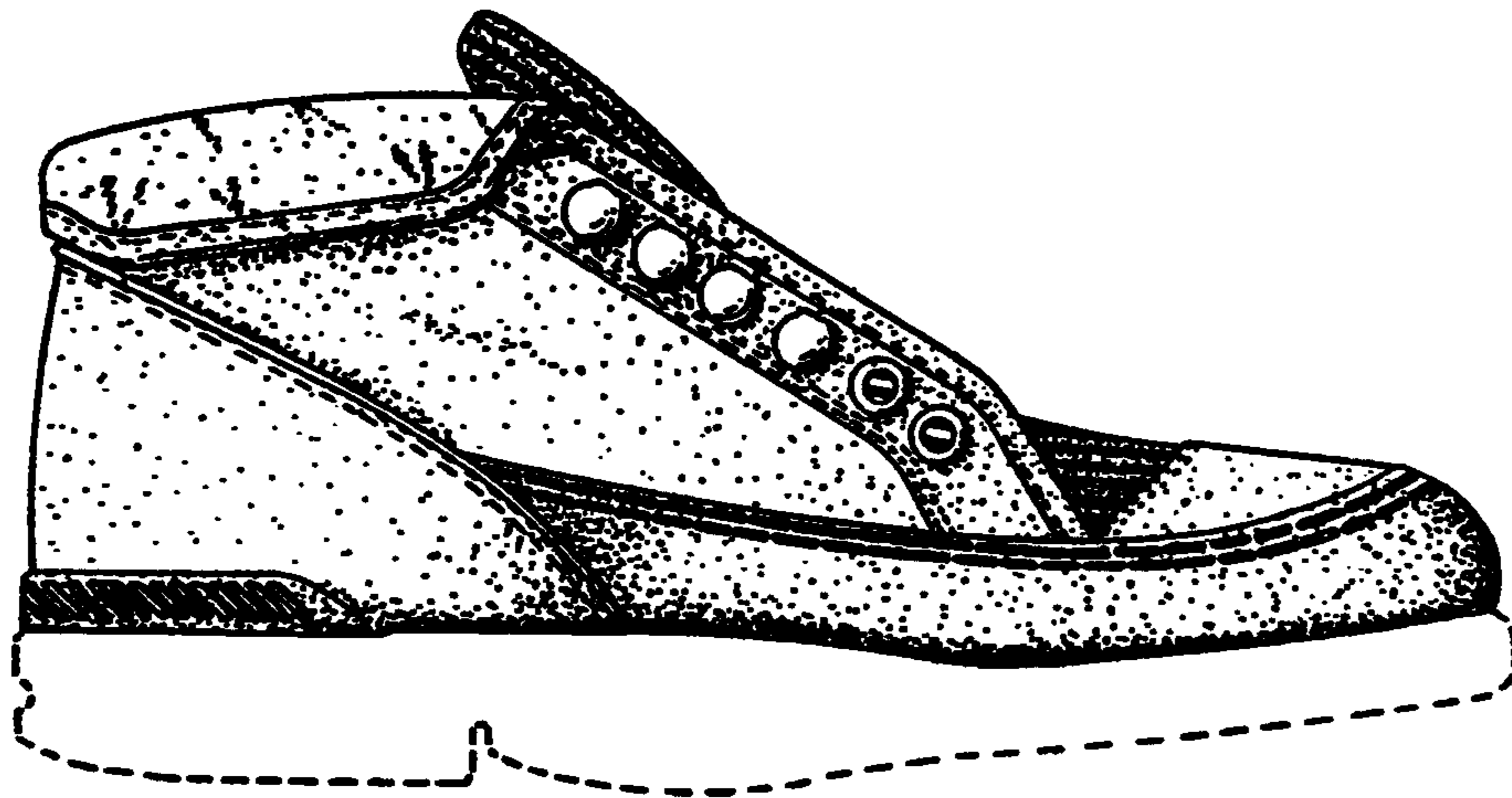
