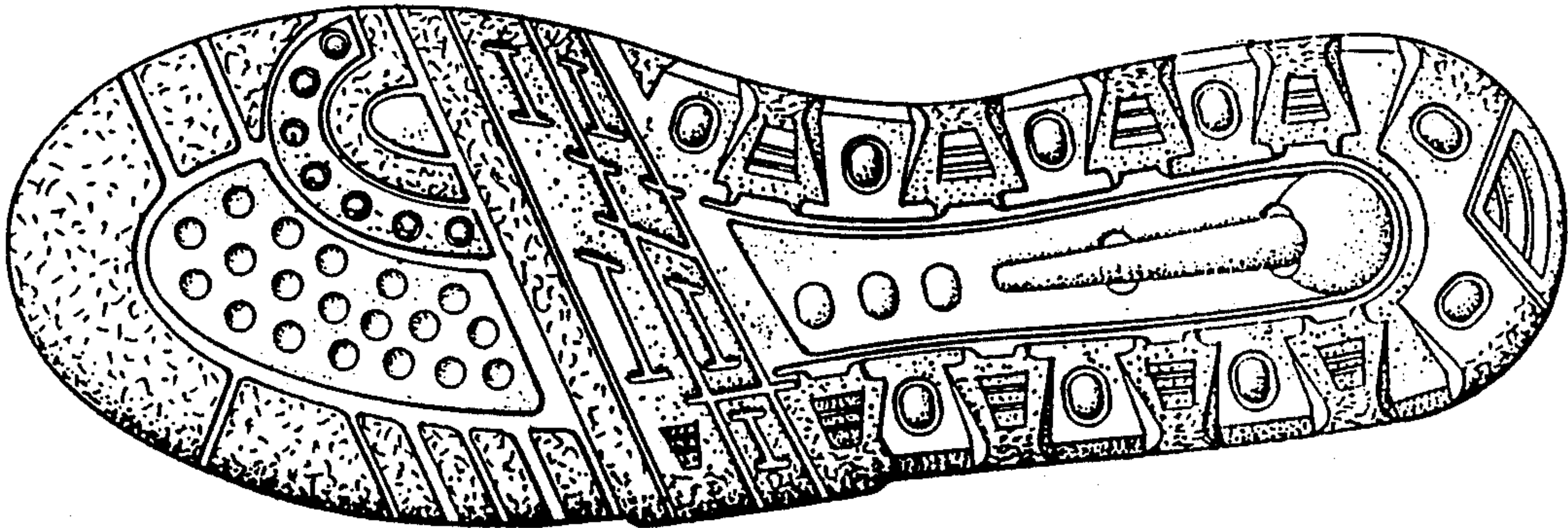
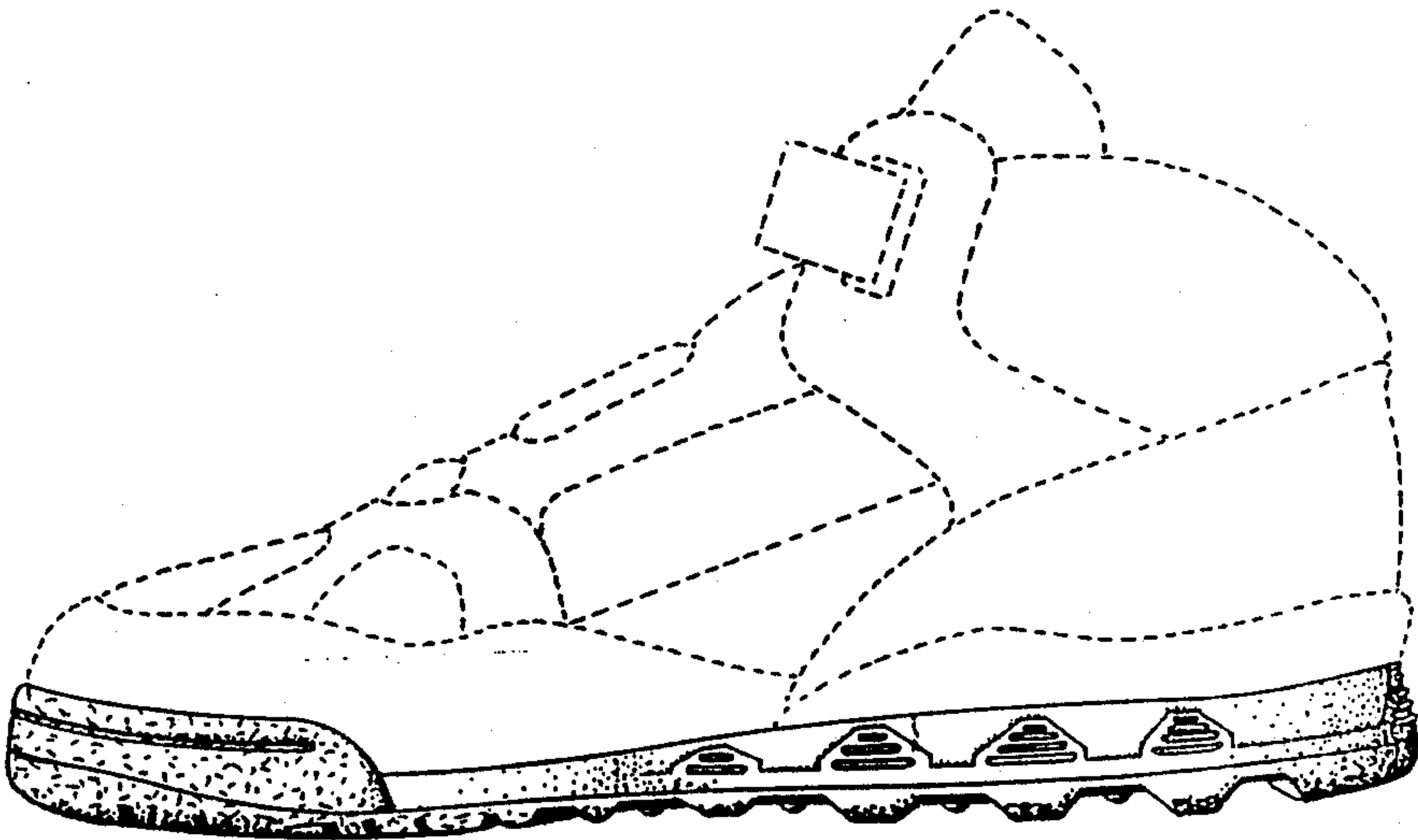

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe sole
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

part of the claimed design.



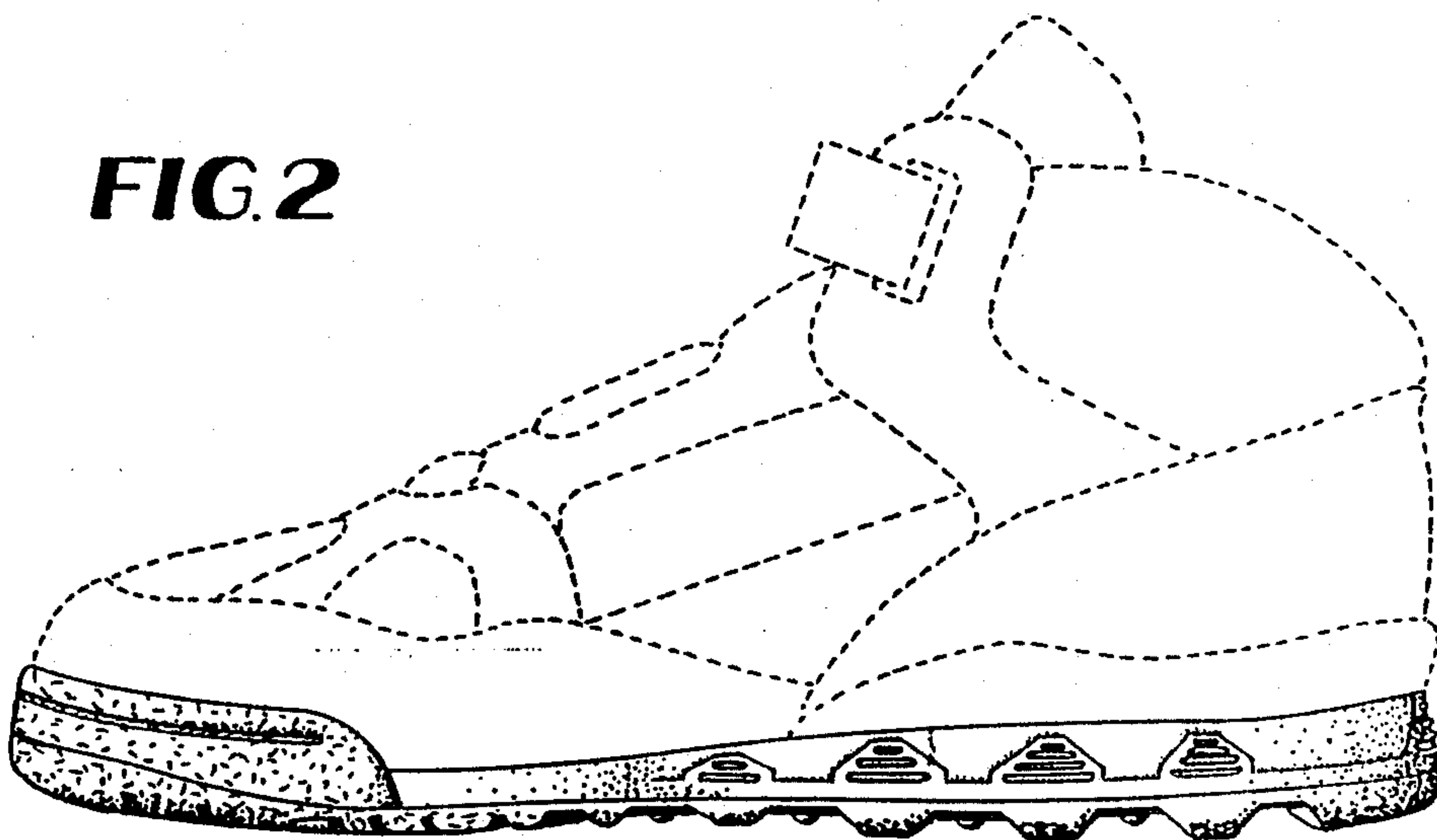
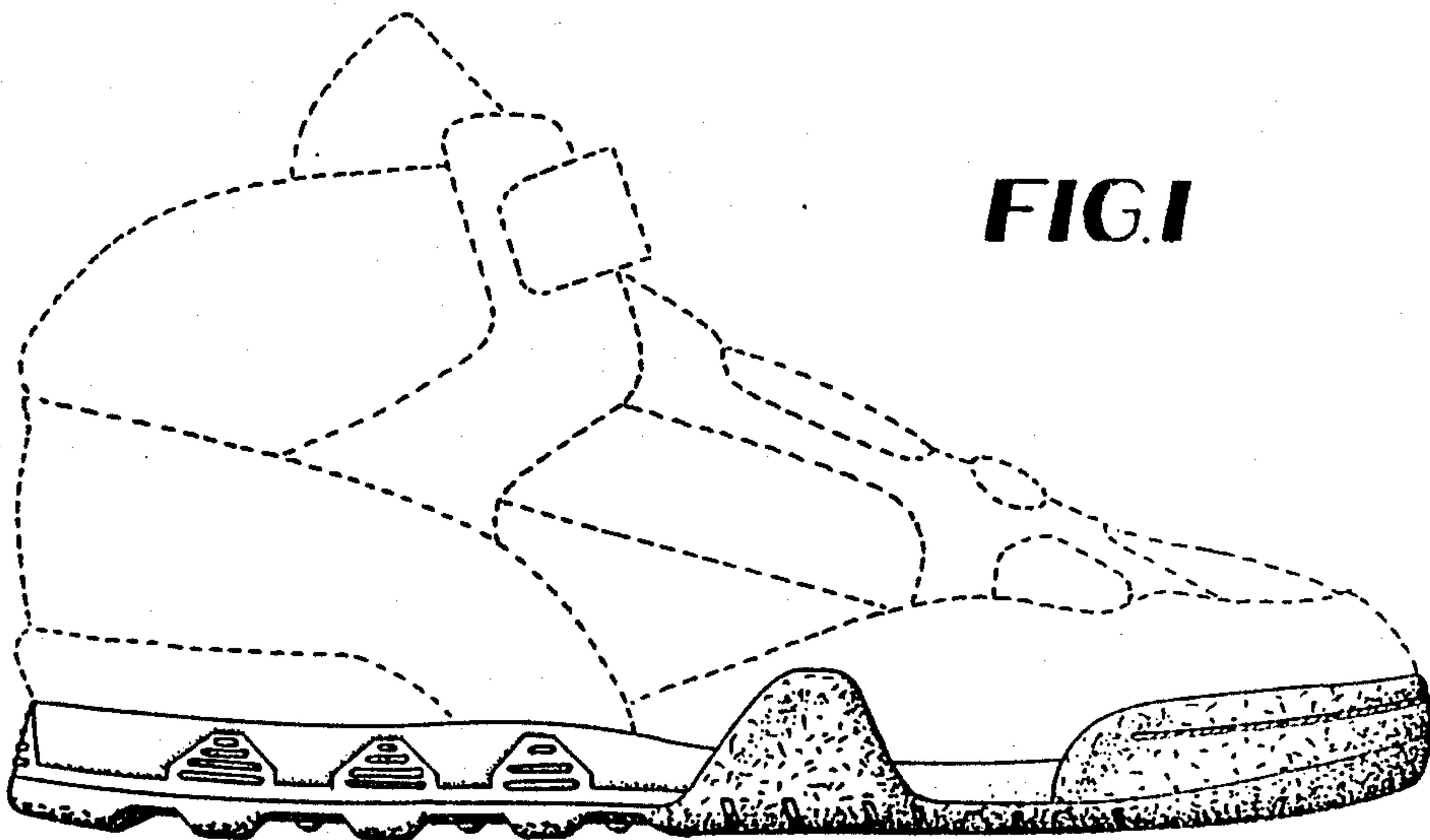

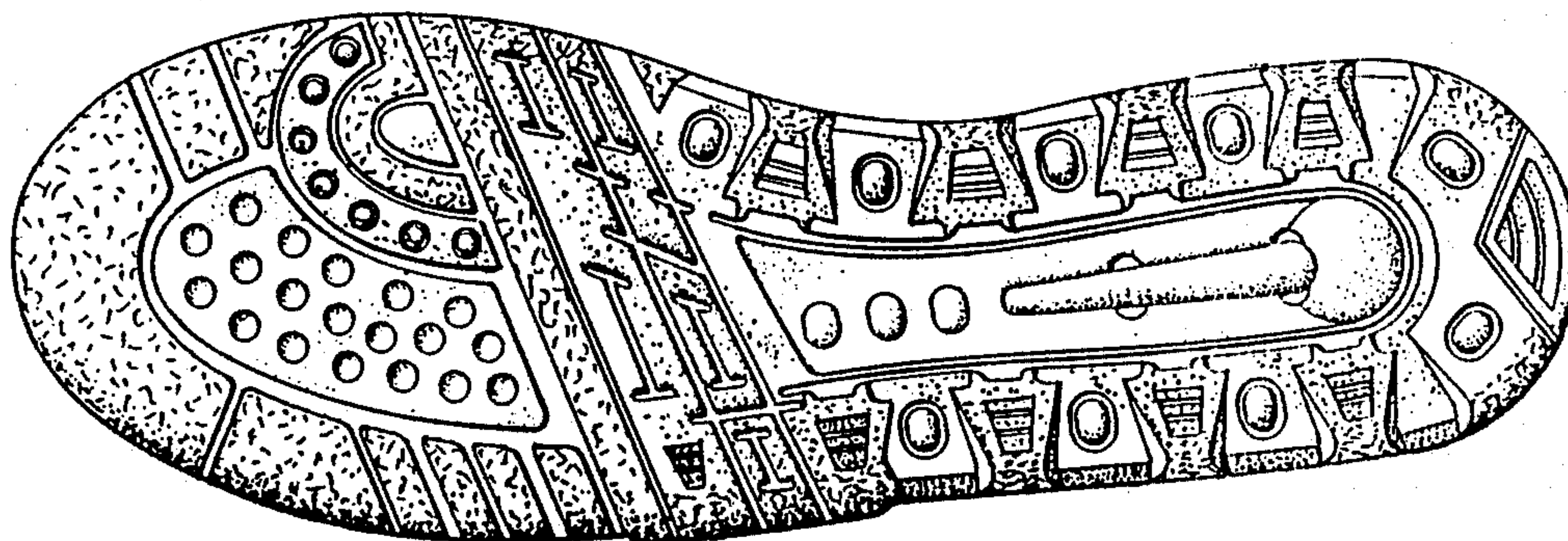

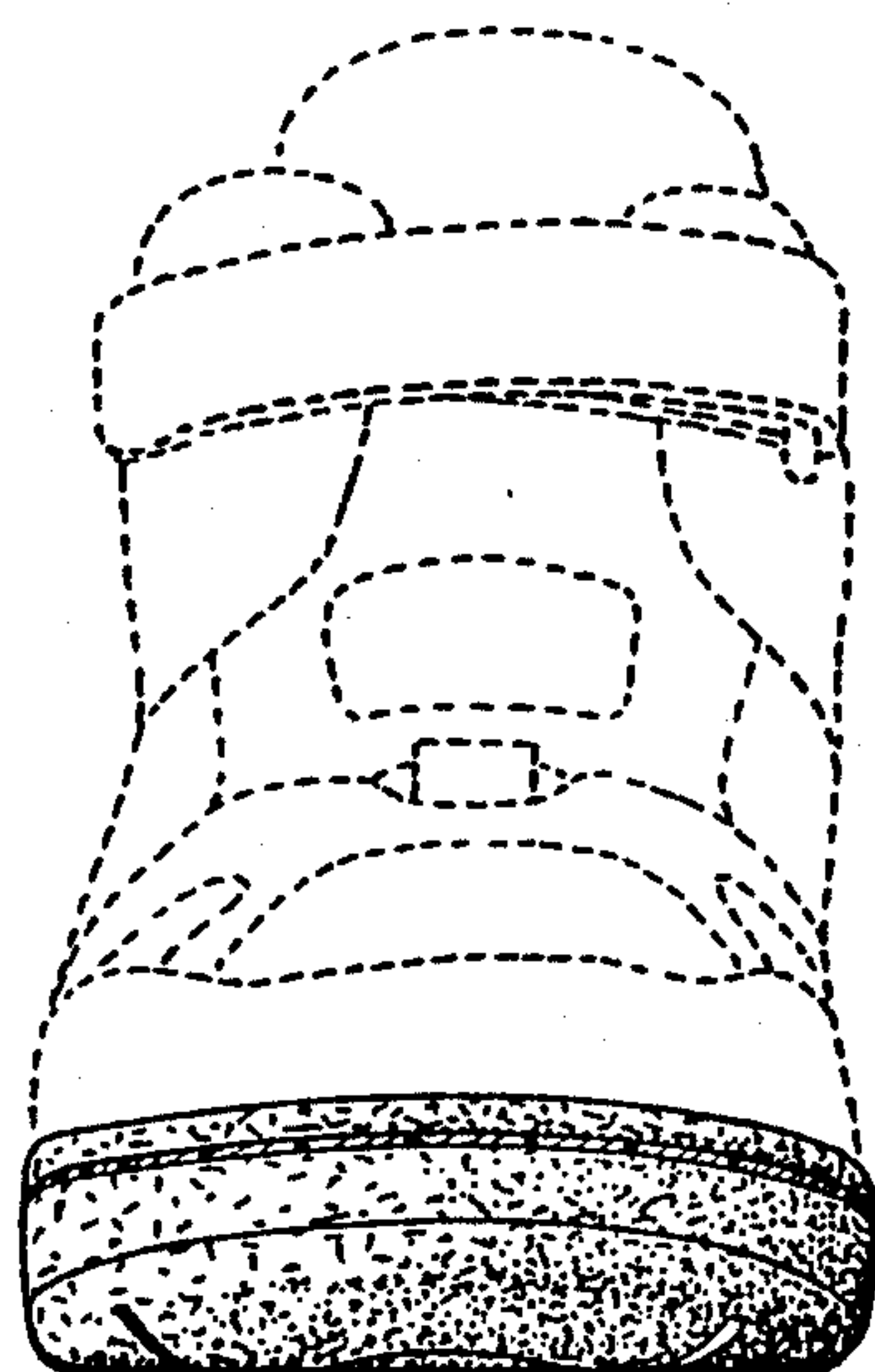
