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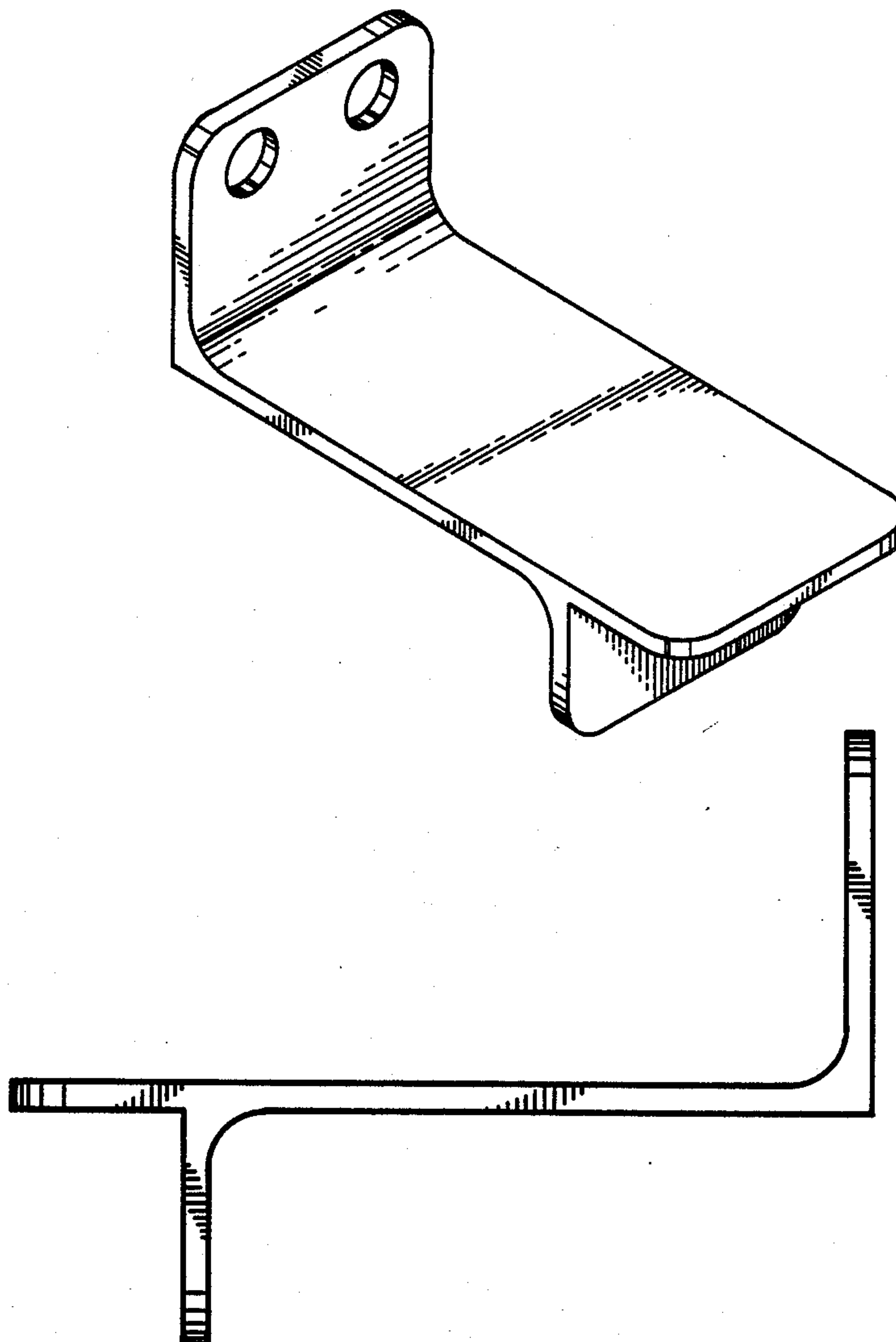

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a workbench support holder for automotive engine members or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side, top and front perspective view of a workbench support holder for automotive engine members or similar article, showing my new design; FIGS. 2 and 3 are respectively front and rear elevational views thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and, FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.



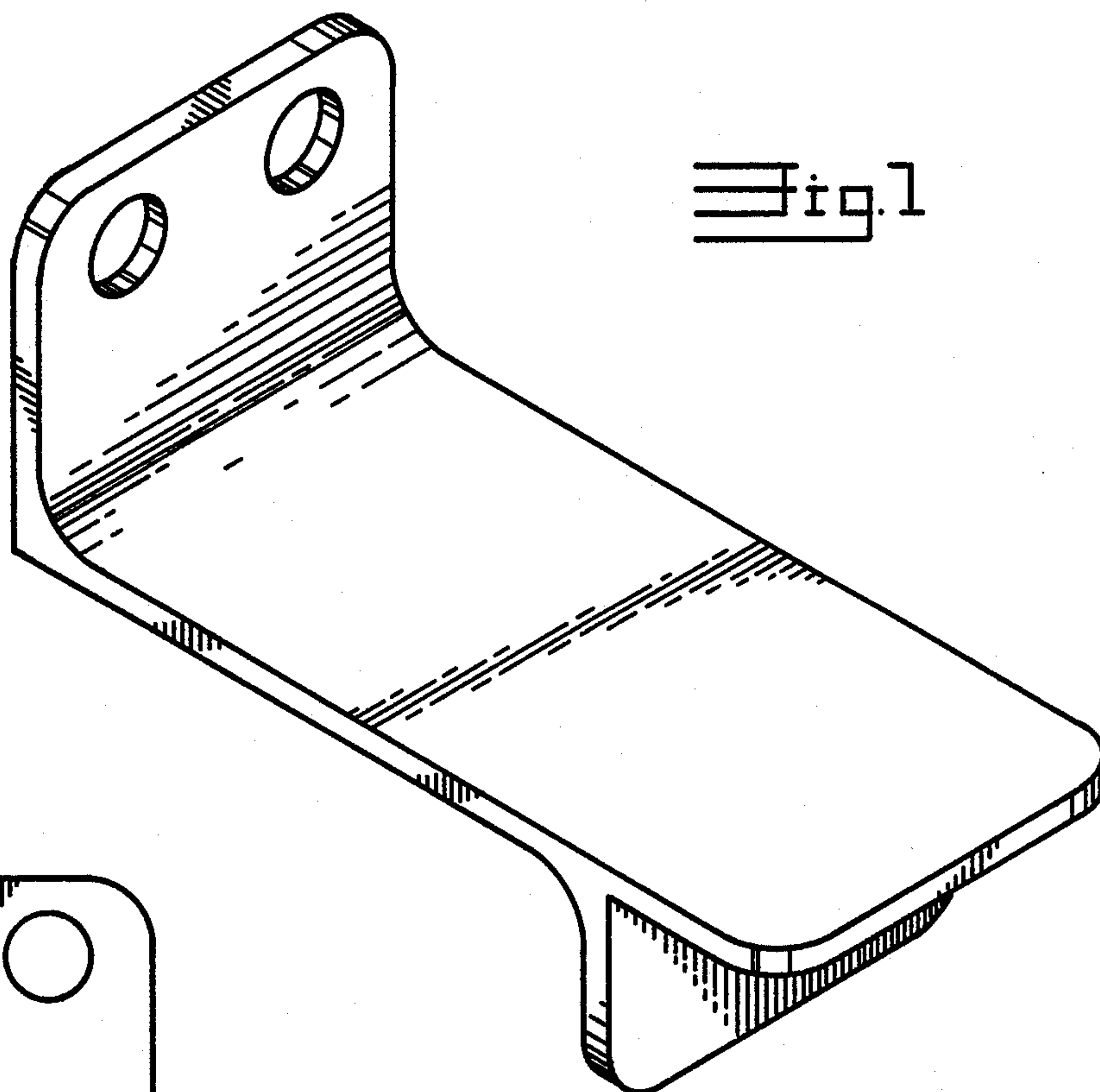

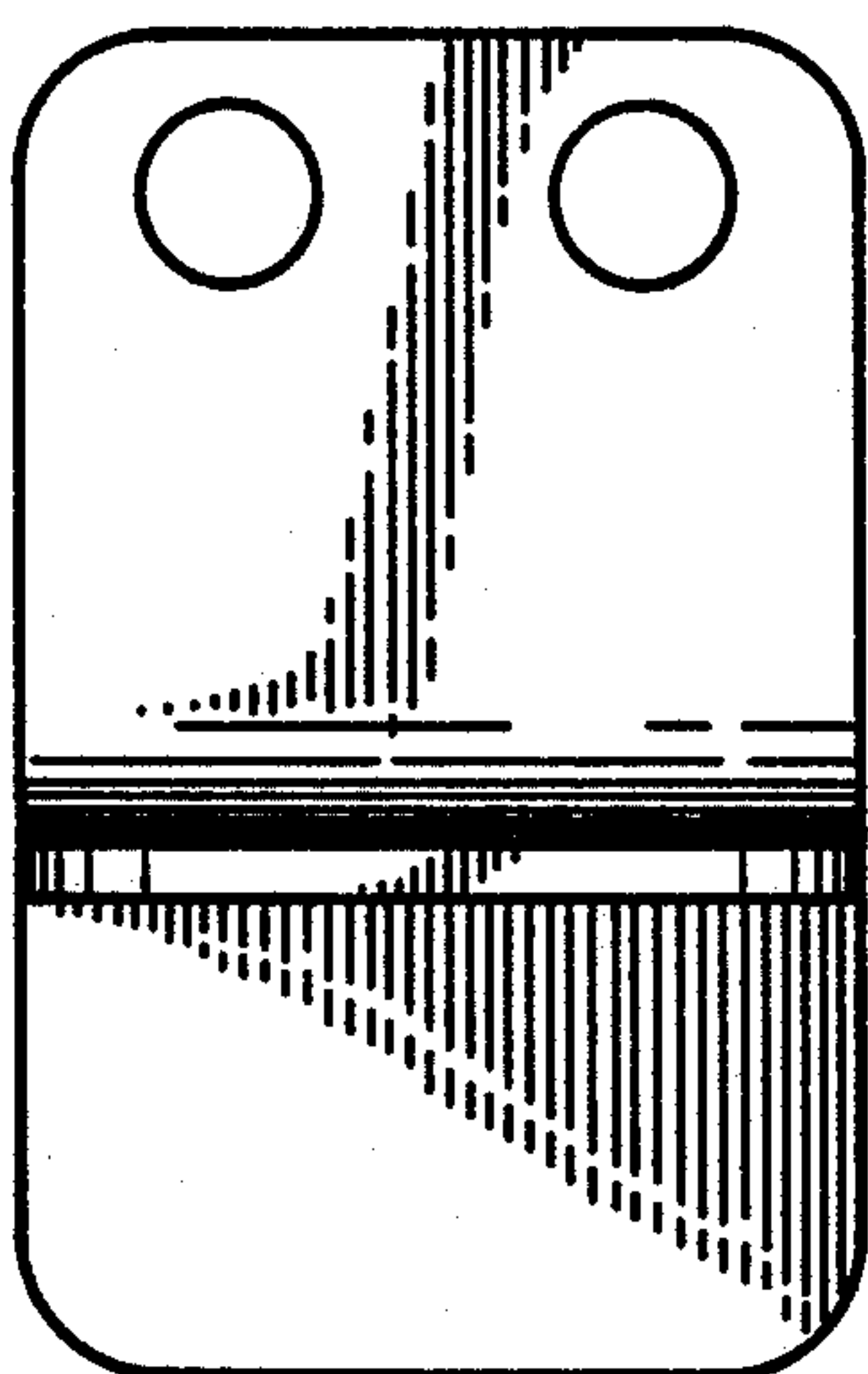

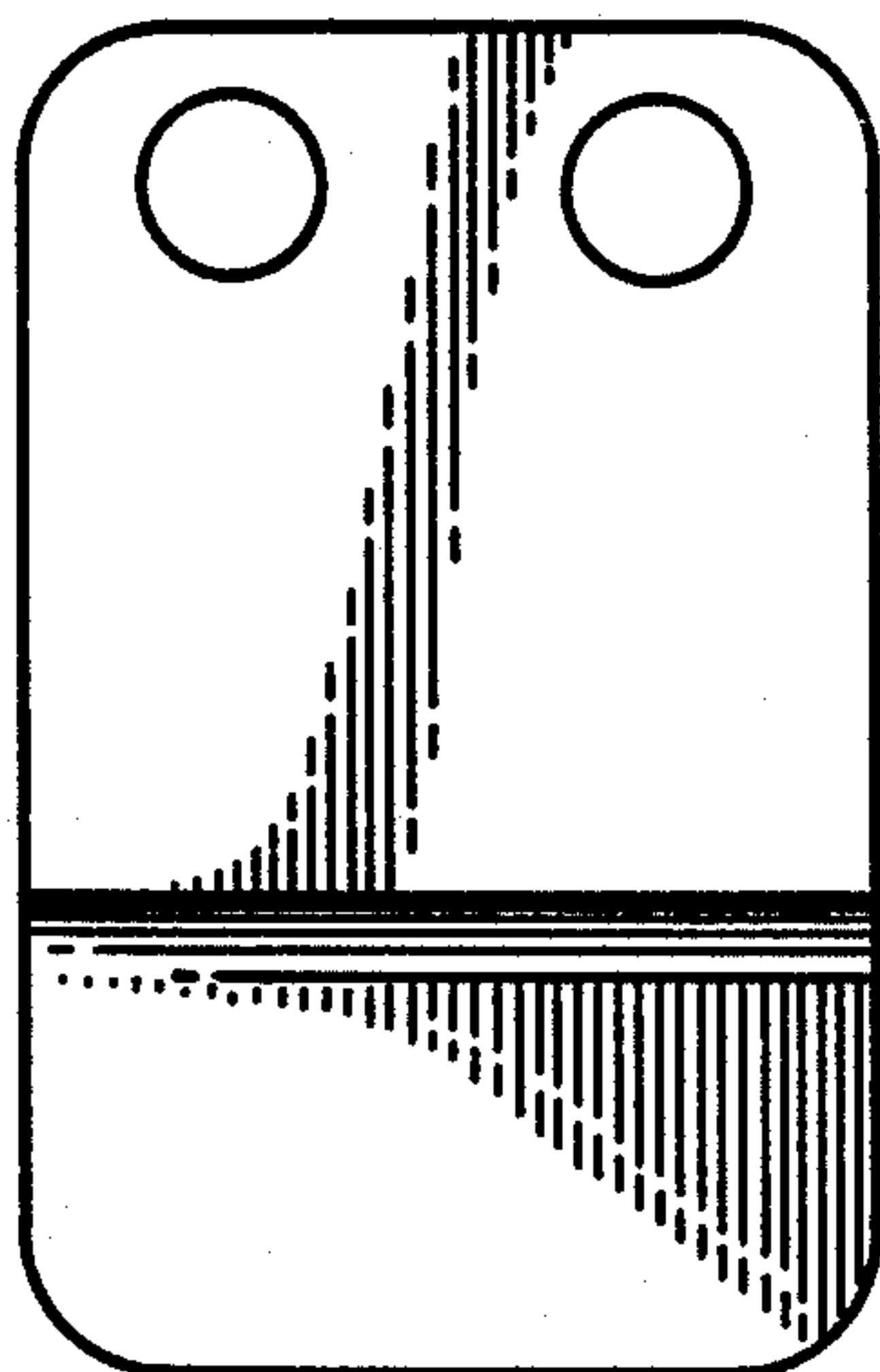

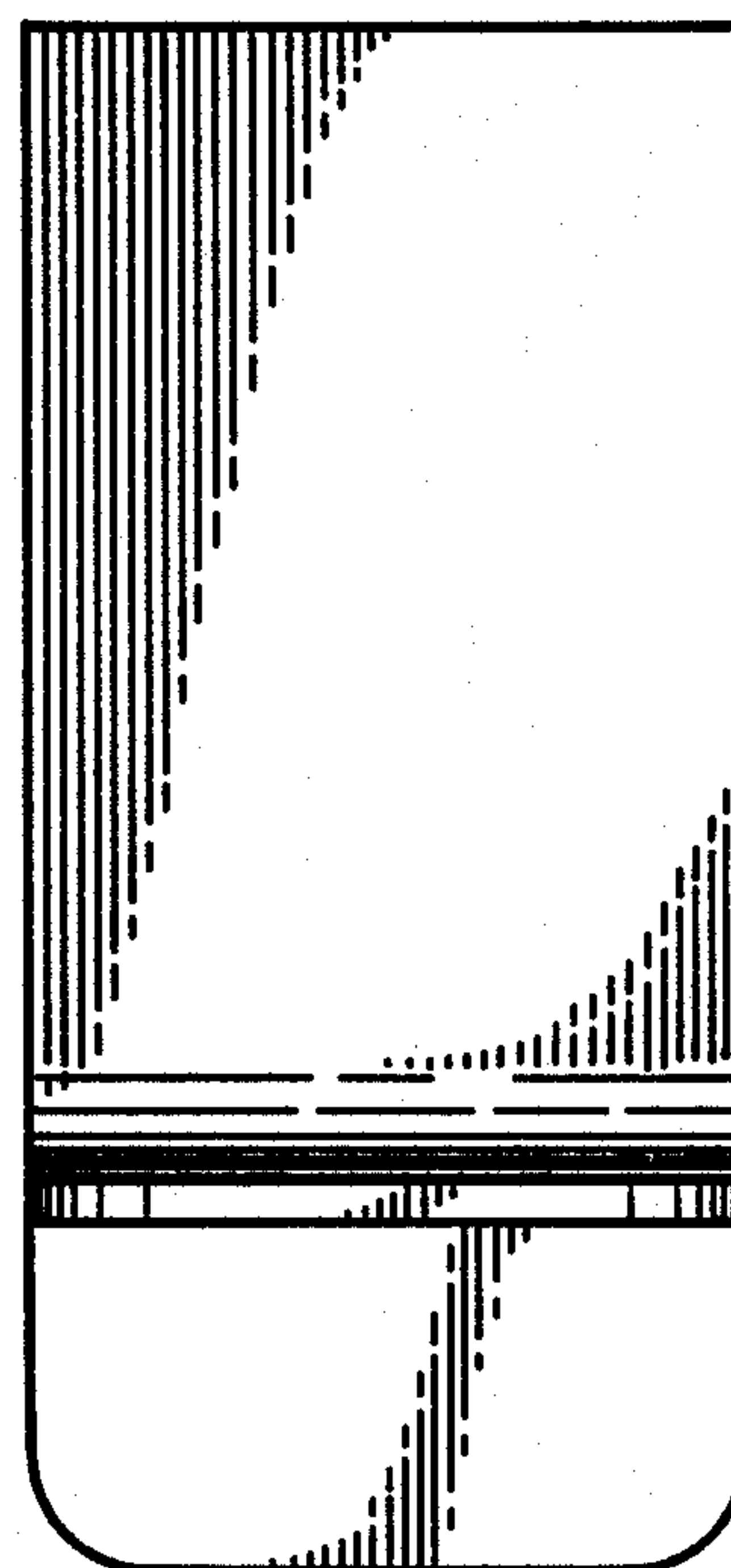

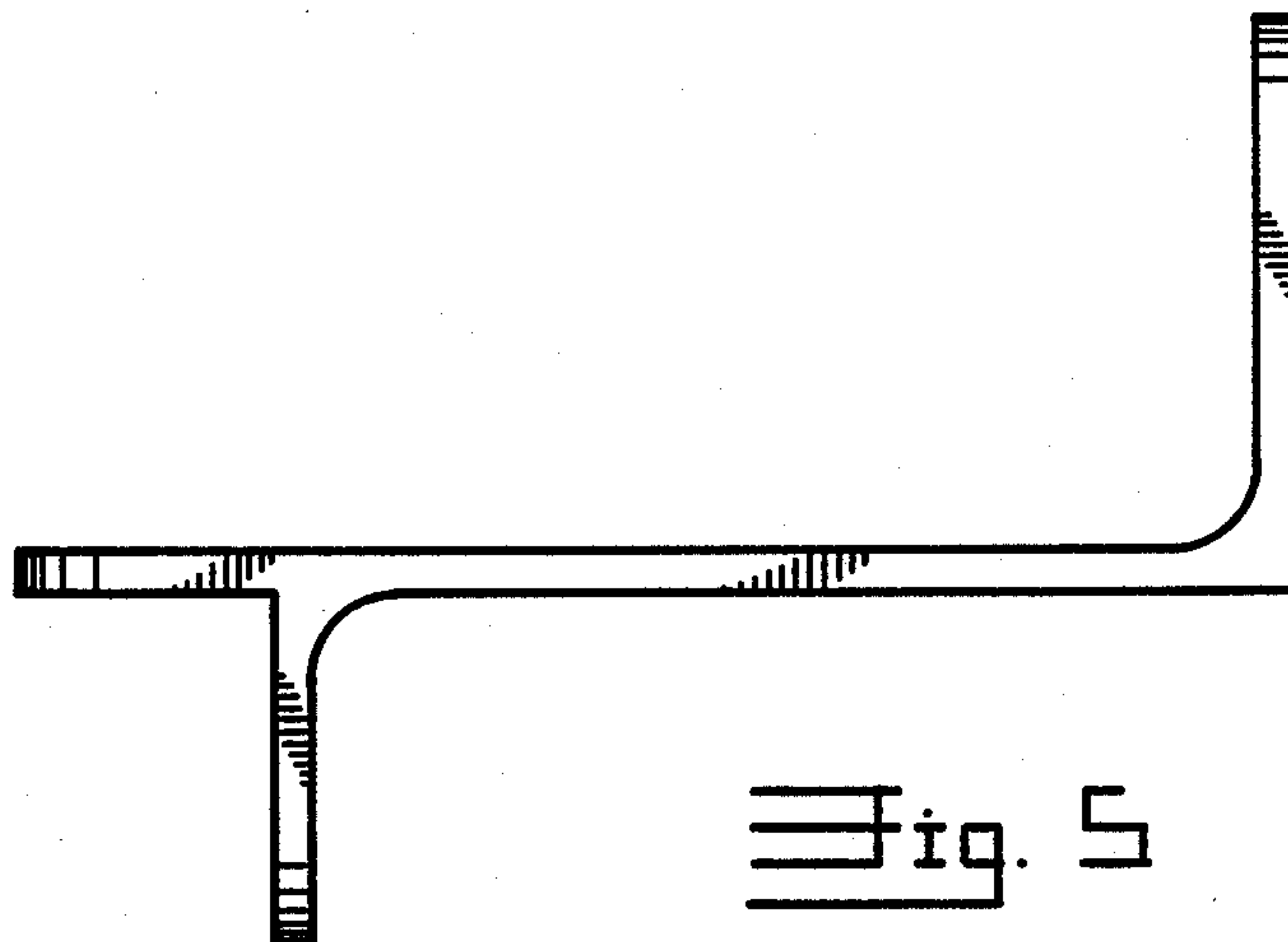
