The ornamental design for a hotel, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a hotel showing our new design and wherein the left two-story guest room building partially shown is identical to the right building shown therein;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the entry building;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the entry building;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the entry building;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the entry building;


FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the two-story guest room building;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the two-story guest room building;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the two-story guest room building; and

The broken line showing of ground lines and environmental structure is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.









