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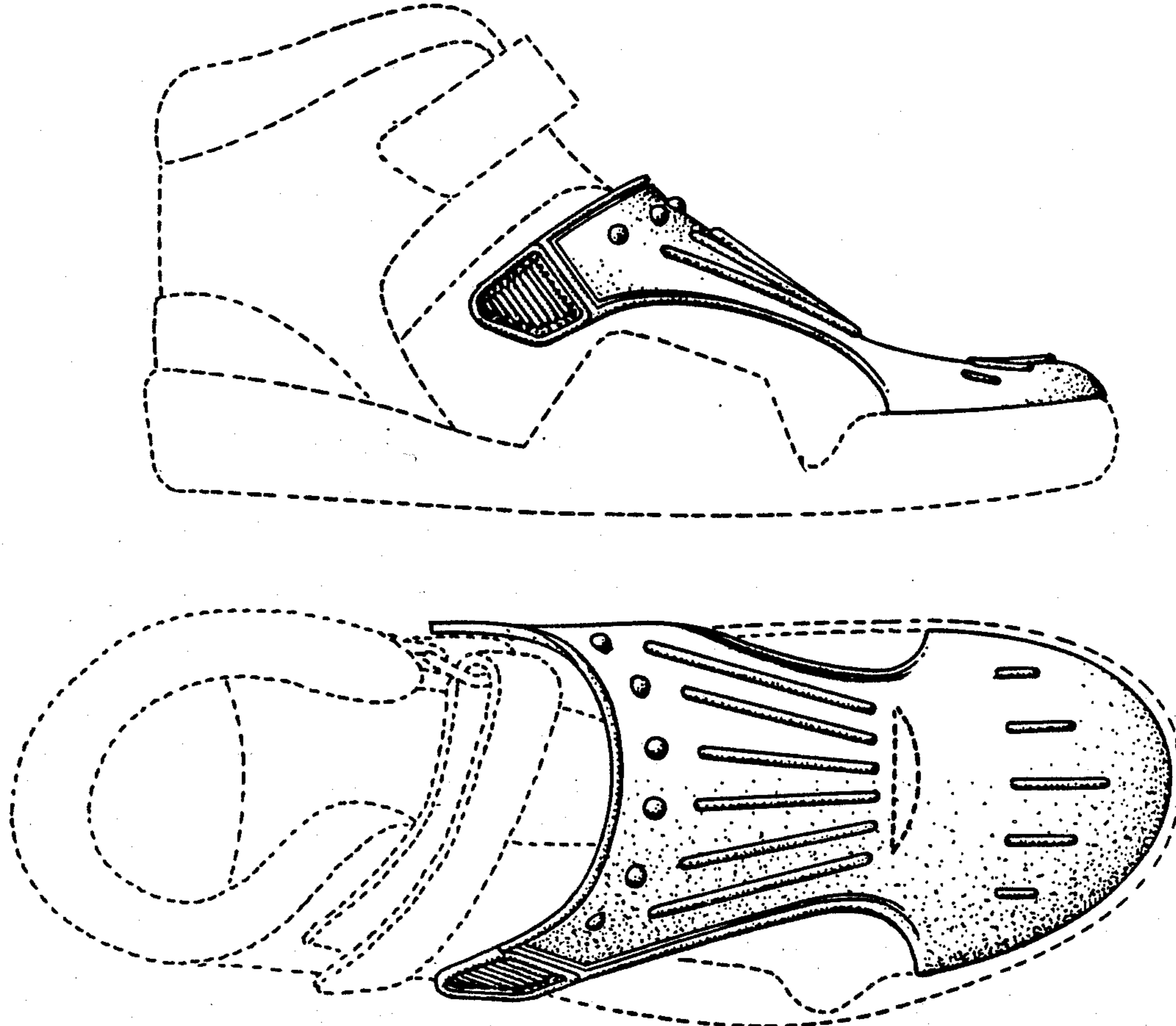

The ornamental design for an element of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

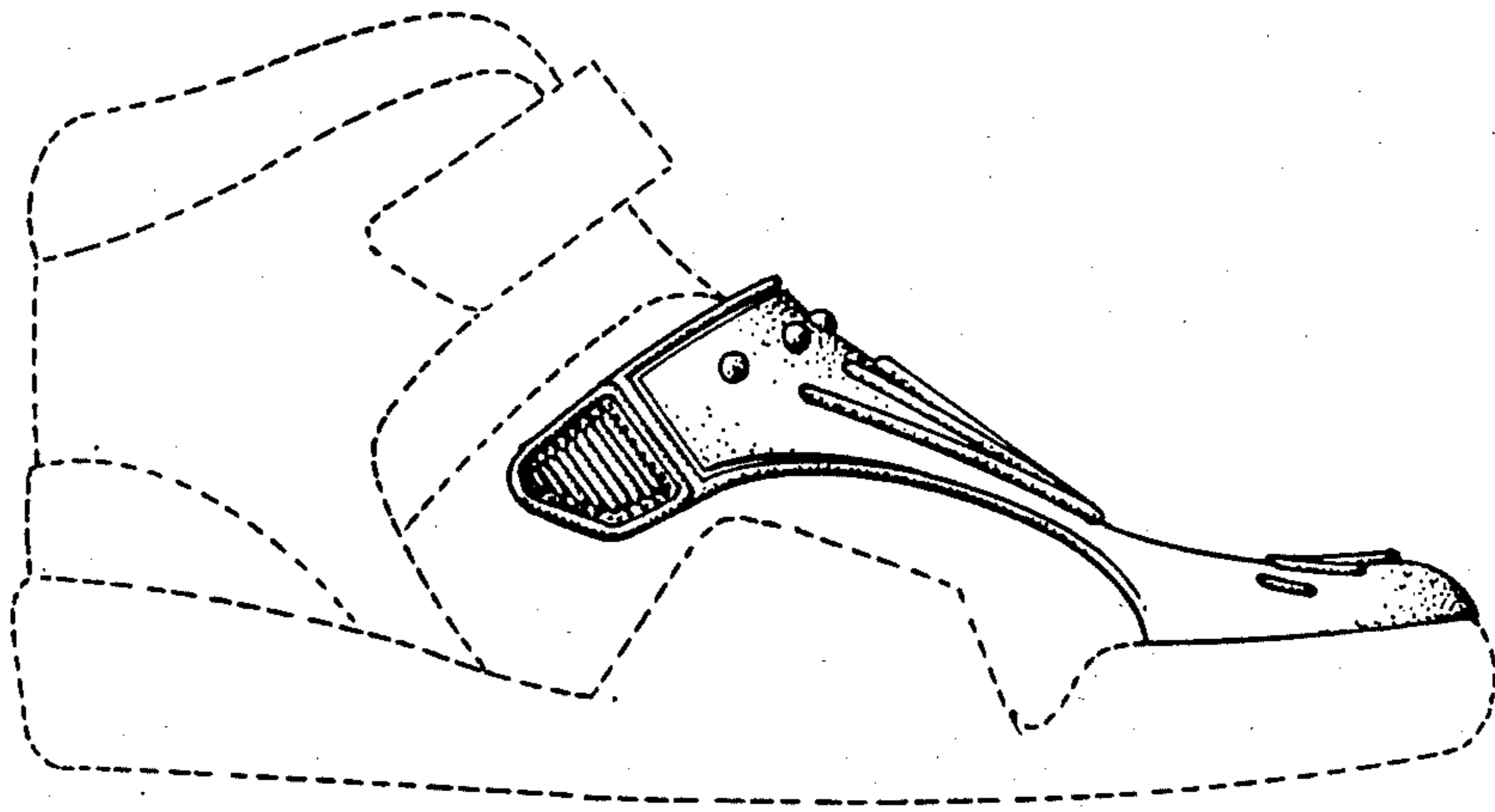
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an element of a shoe upper showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a front elevational view with the element extended.

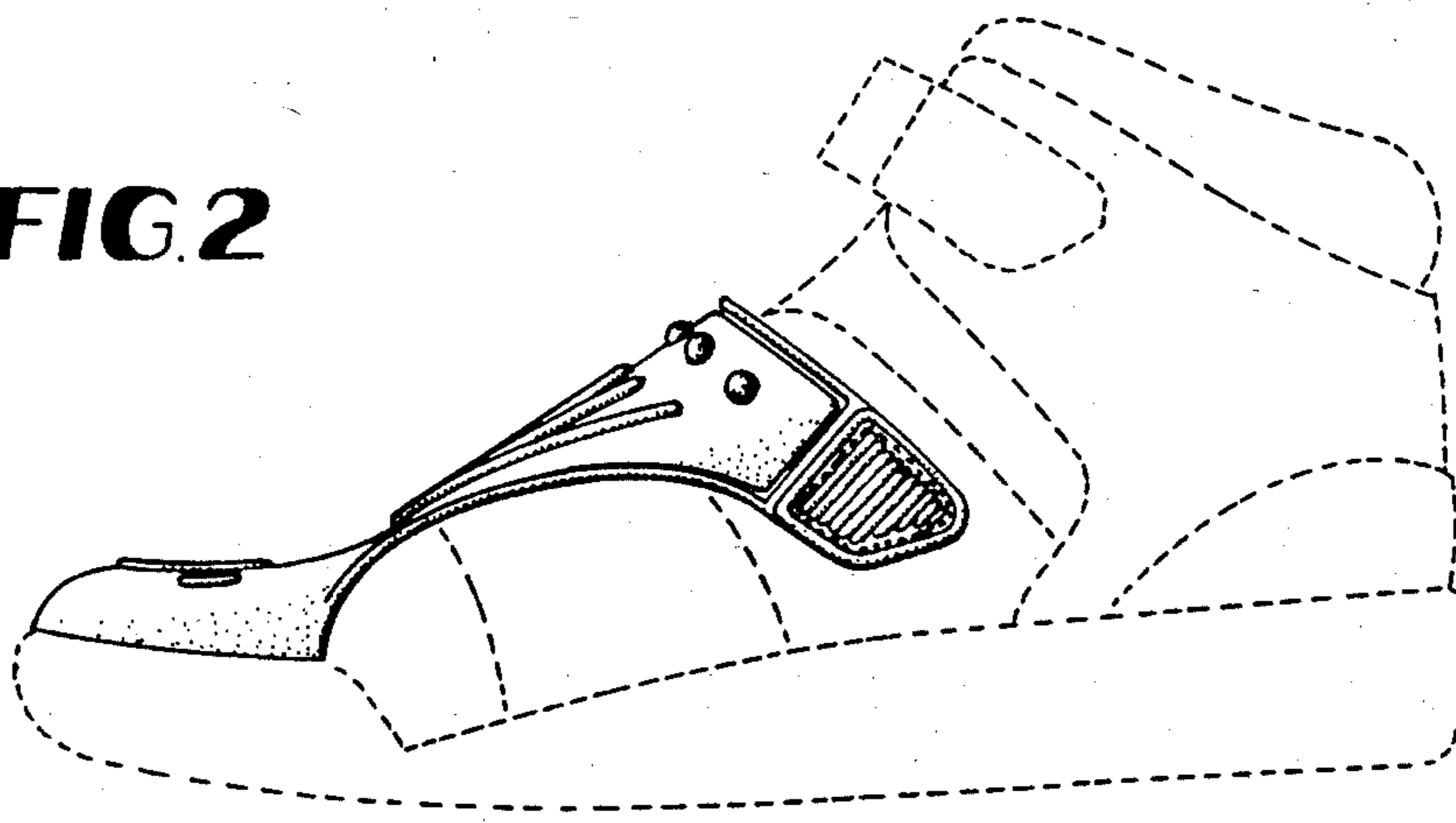
The broken line showing of a shoe in FIGS. 1-6 and the area within are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.



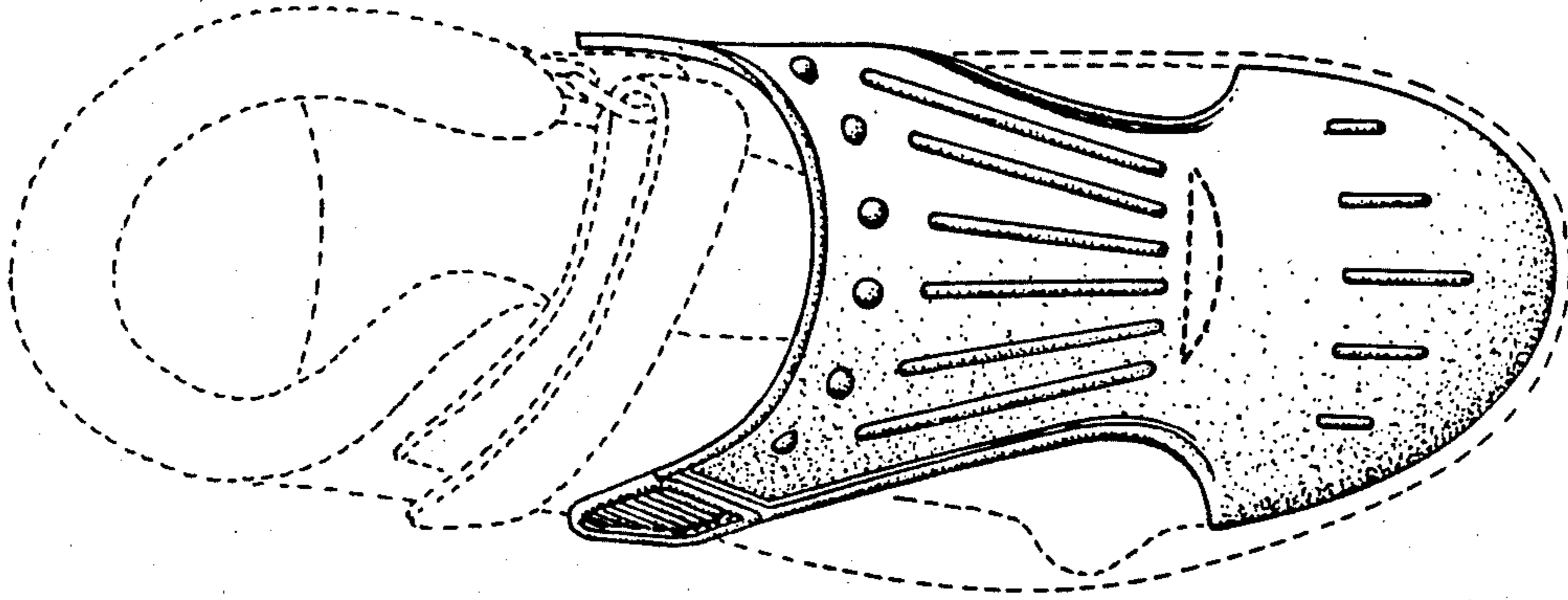

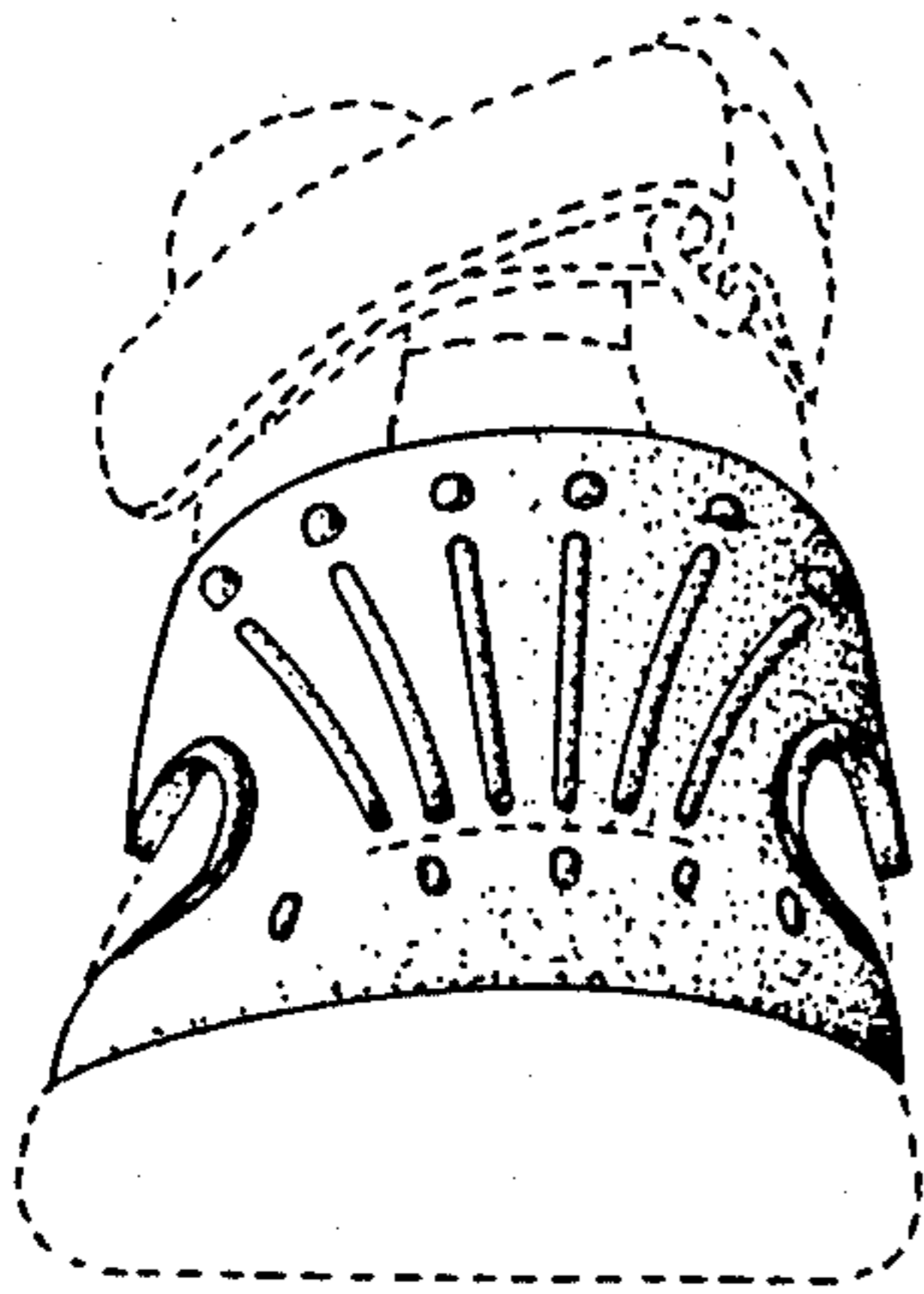

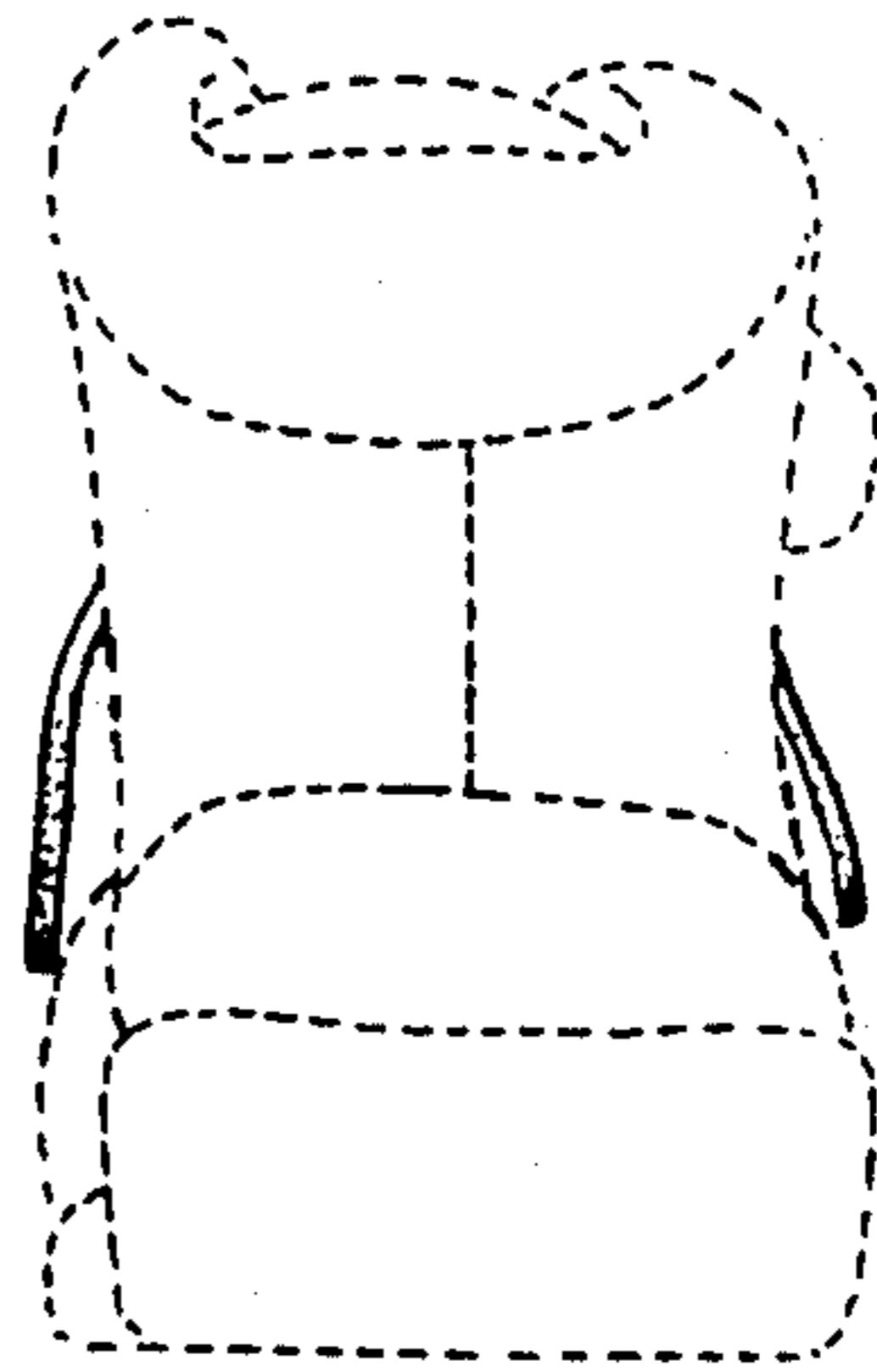
