FIG. 1 is a top and side perspective view of a vacuum jug showing my new design;

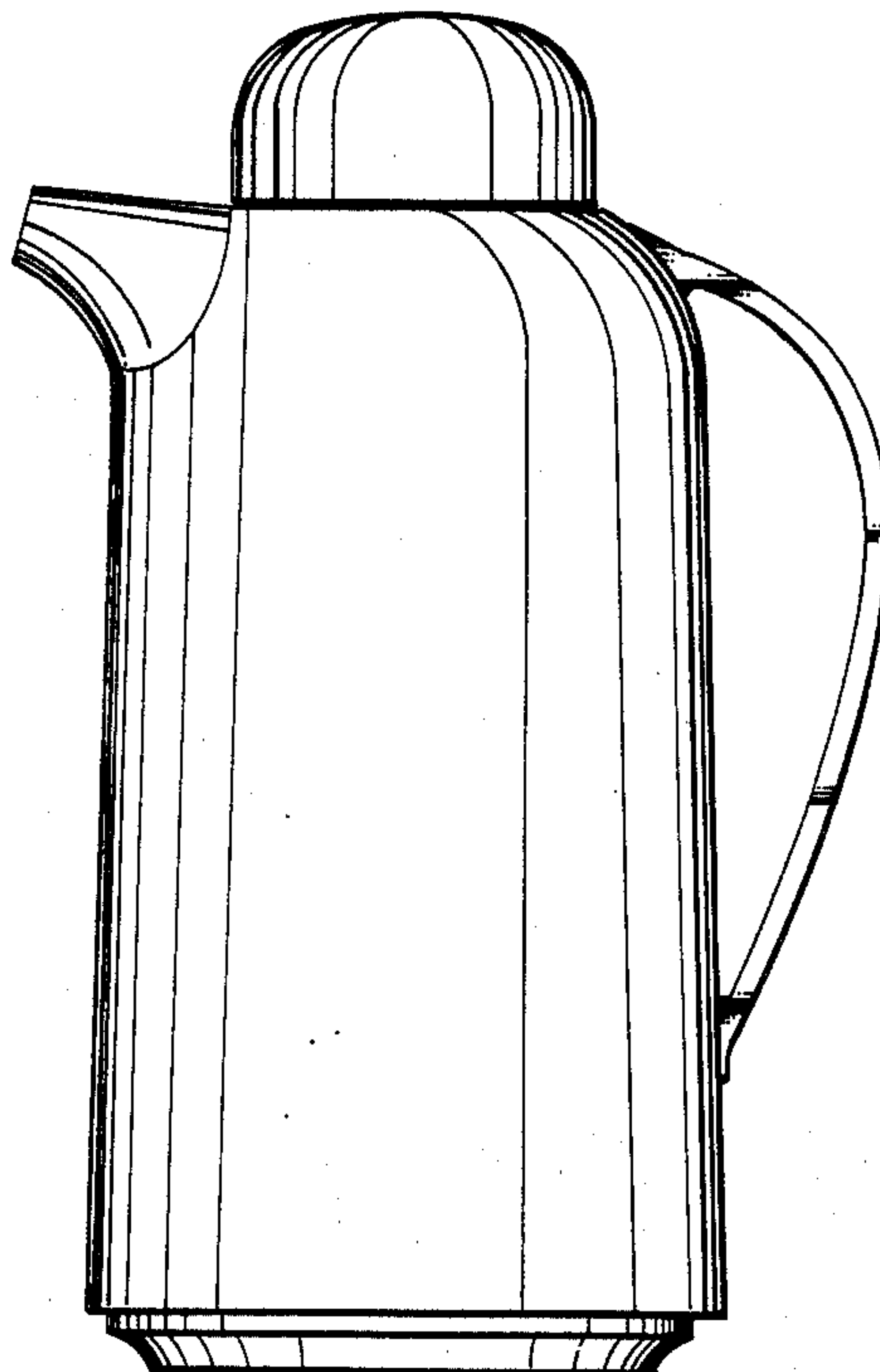
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



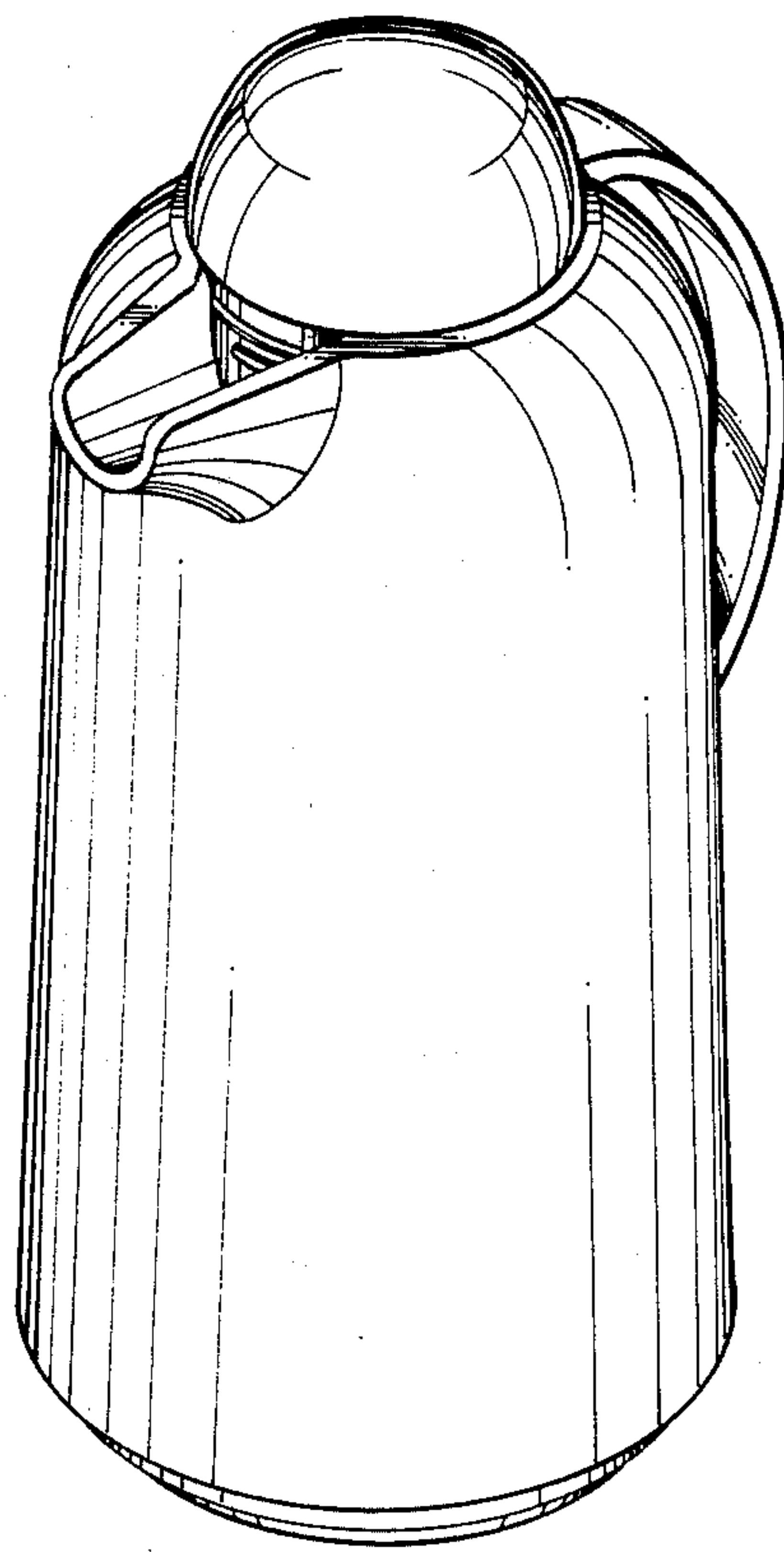

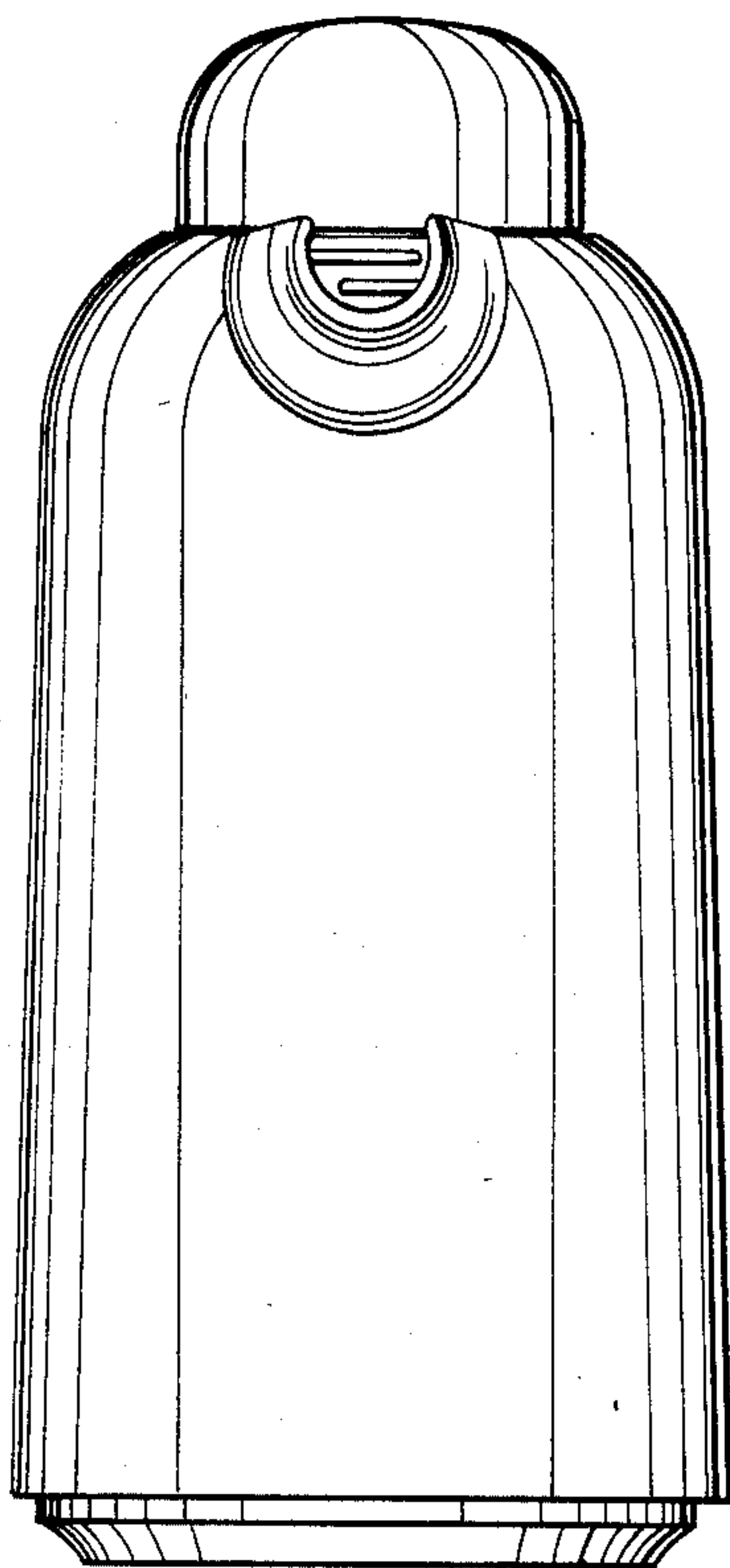

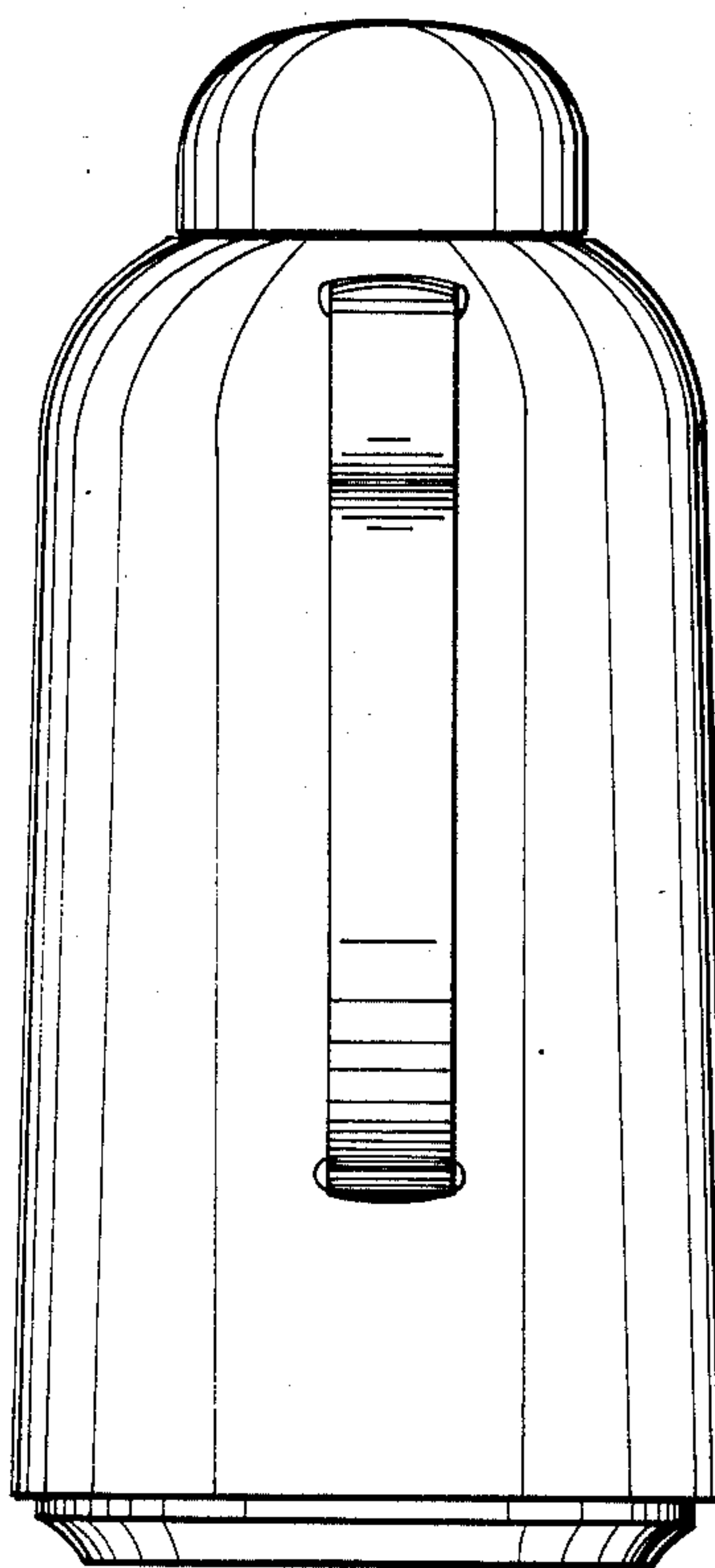

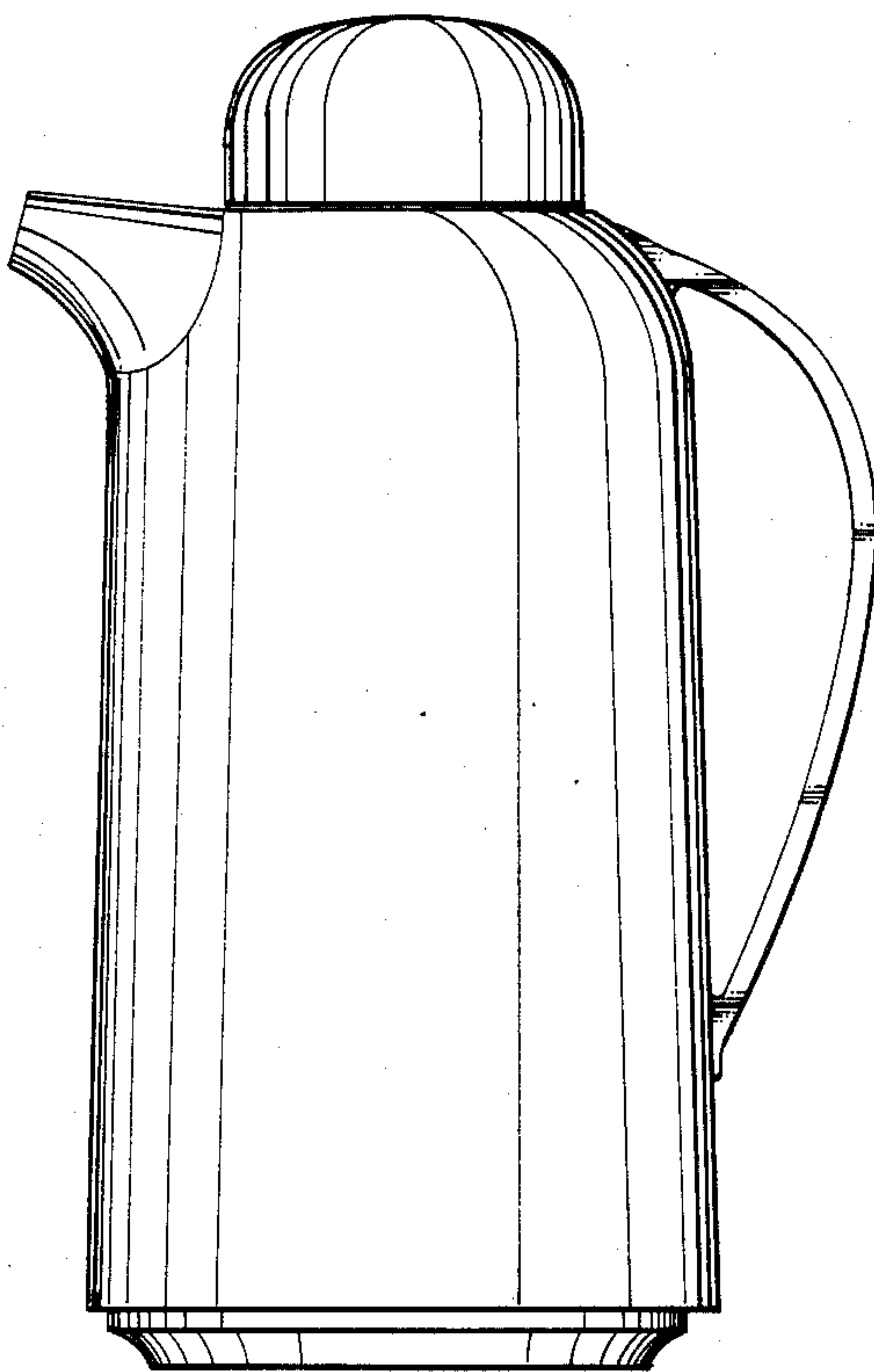

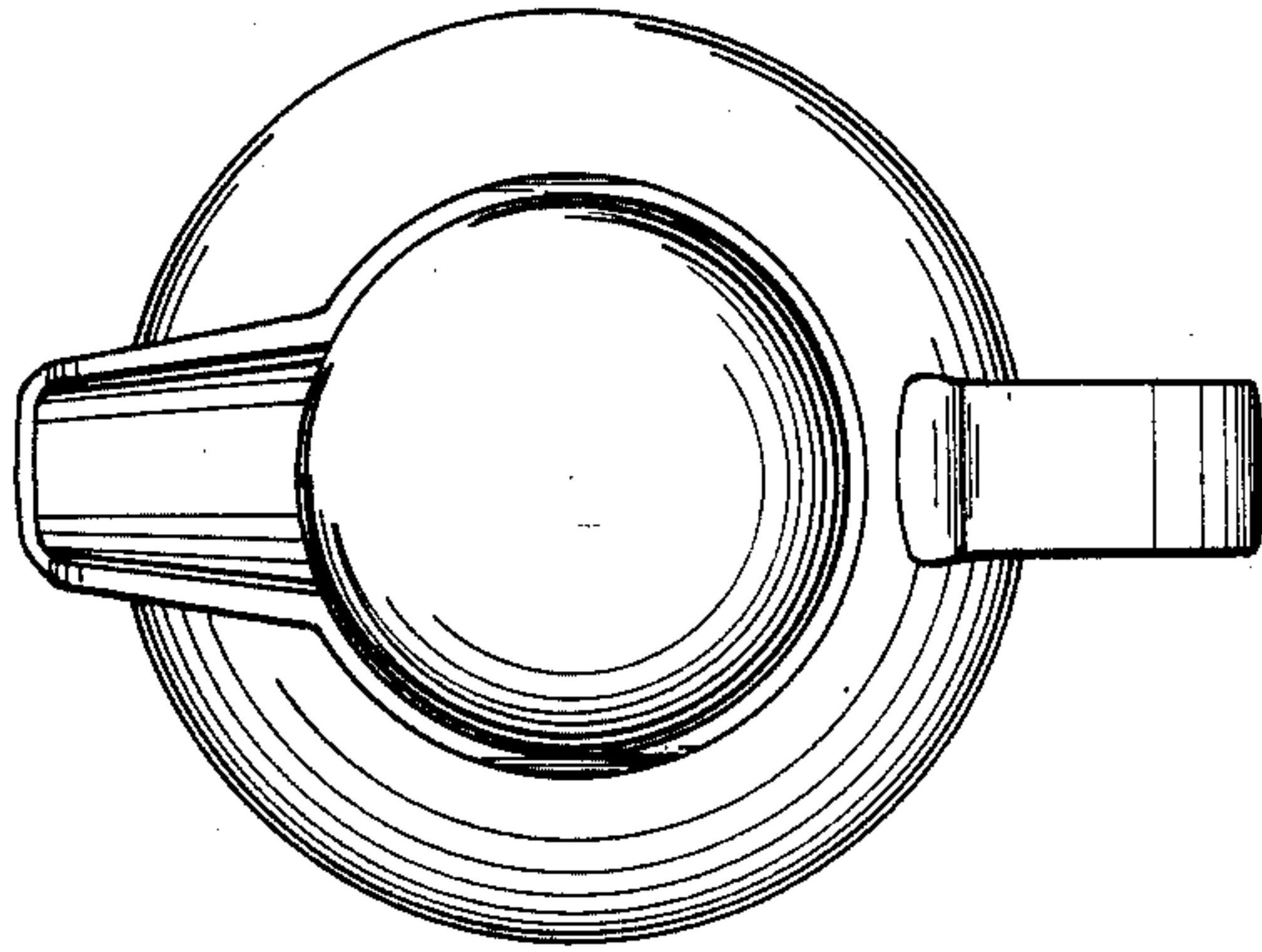

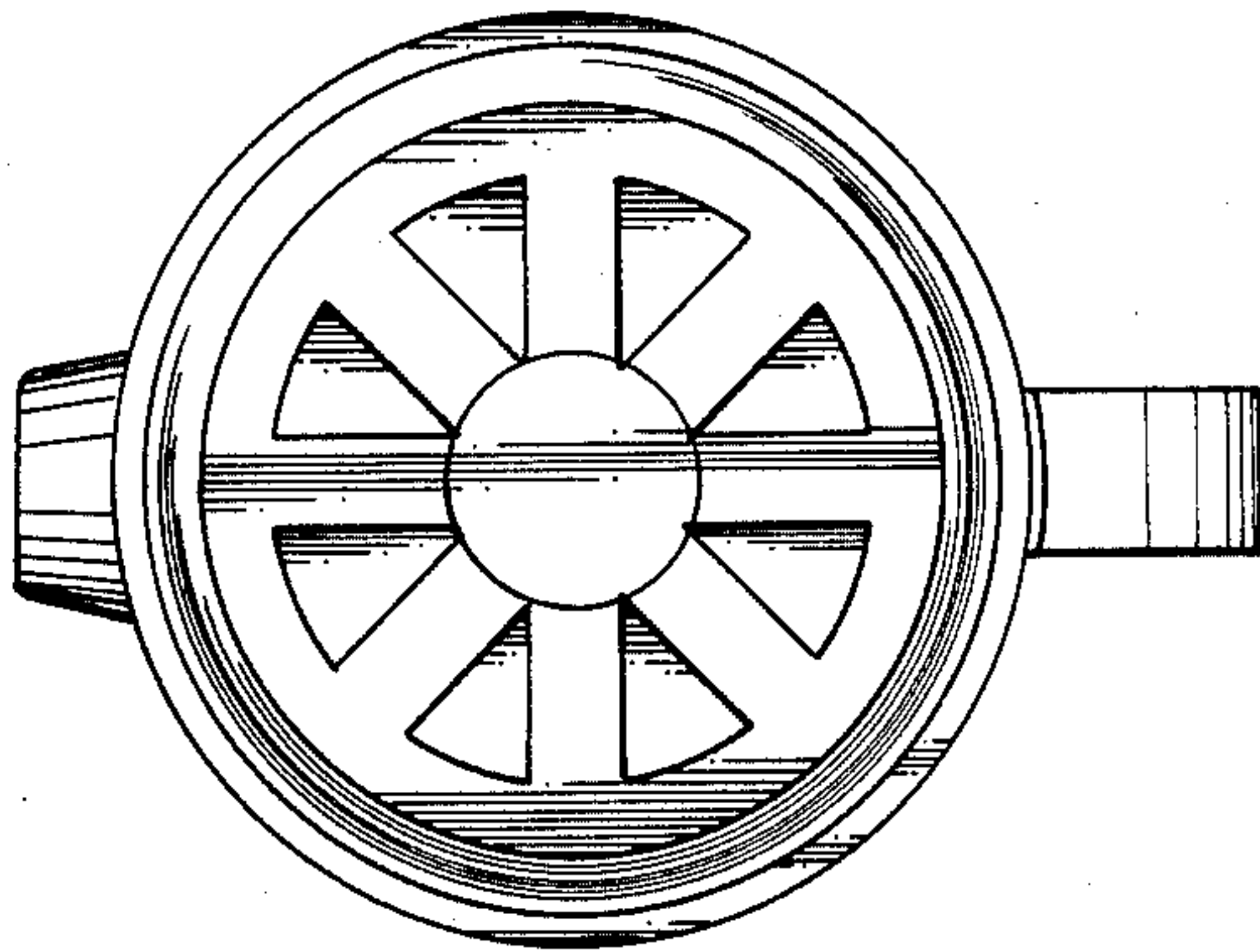
