FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of high-resolution video monitor, showing our new design;

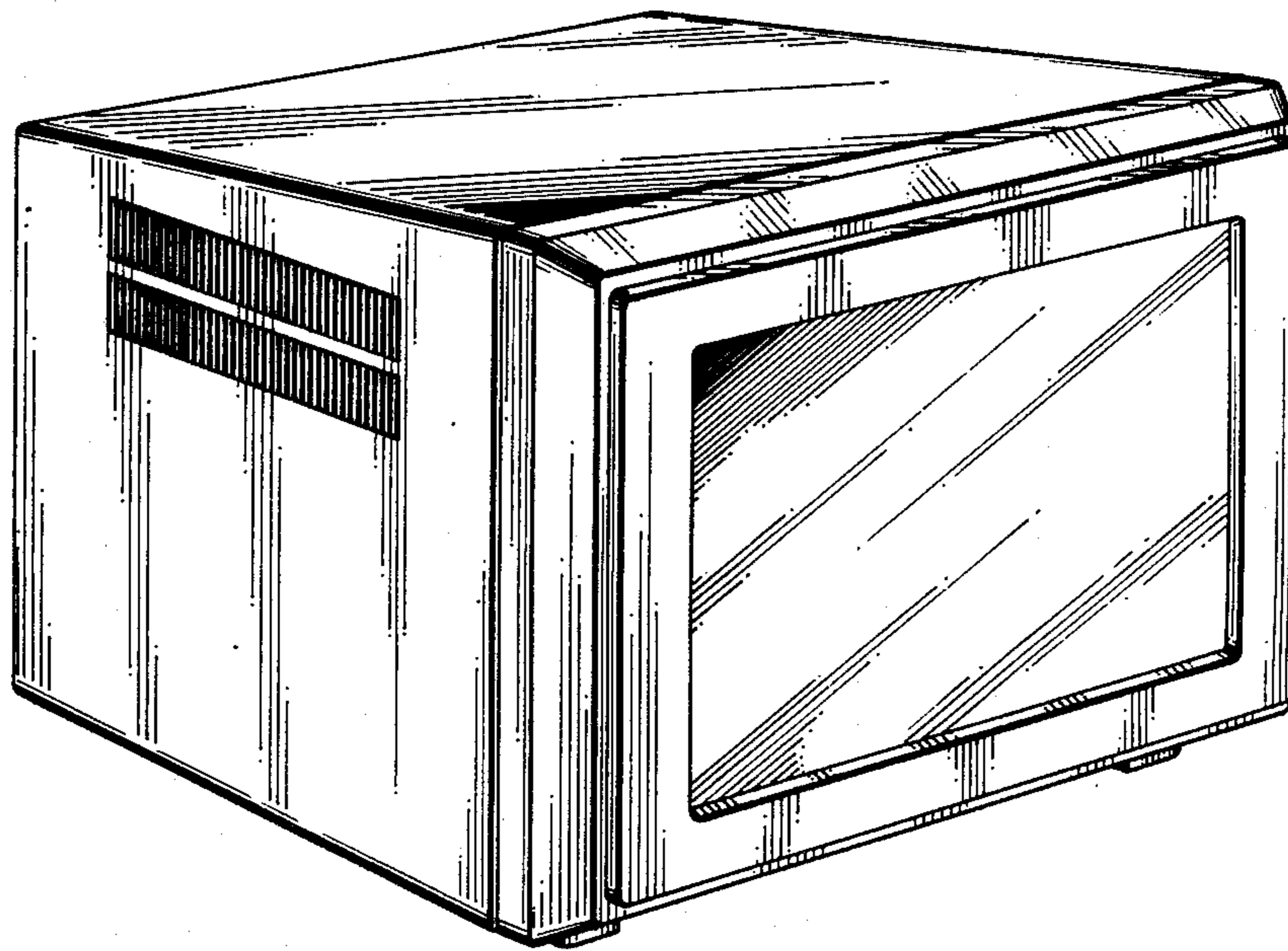
FIG. 2 is a top, rear and right side perspective view thereof;

The bottom view is not seen and constitutes no part of this invention.



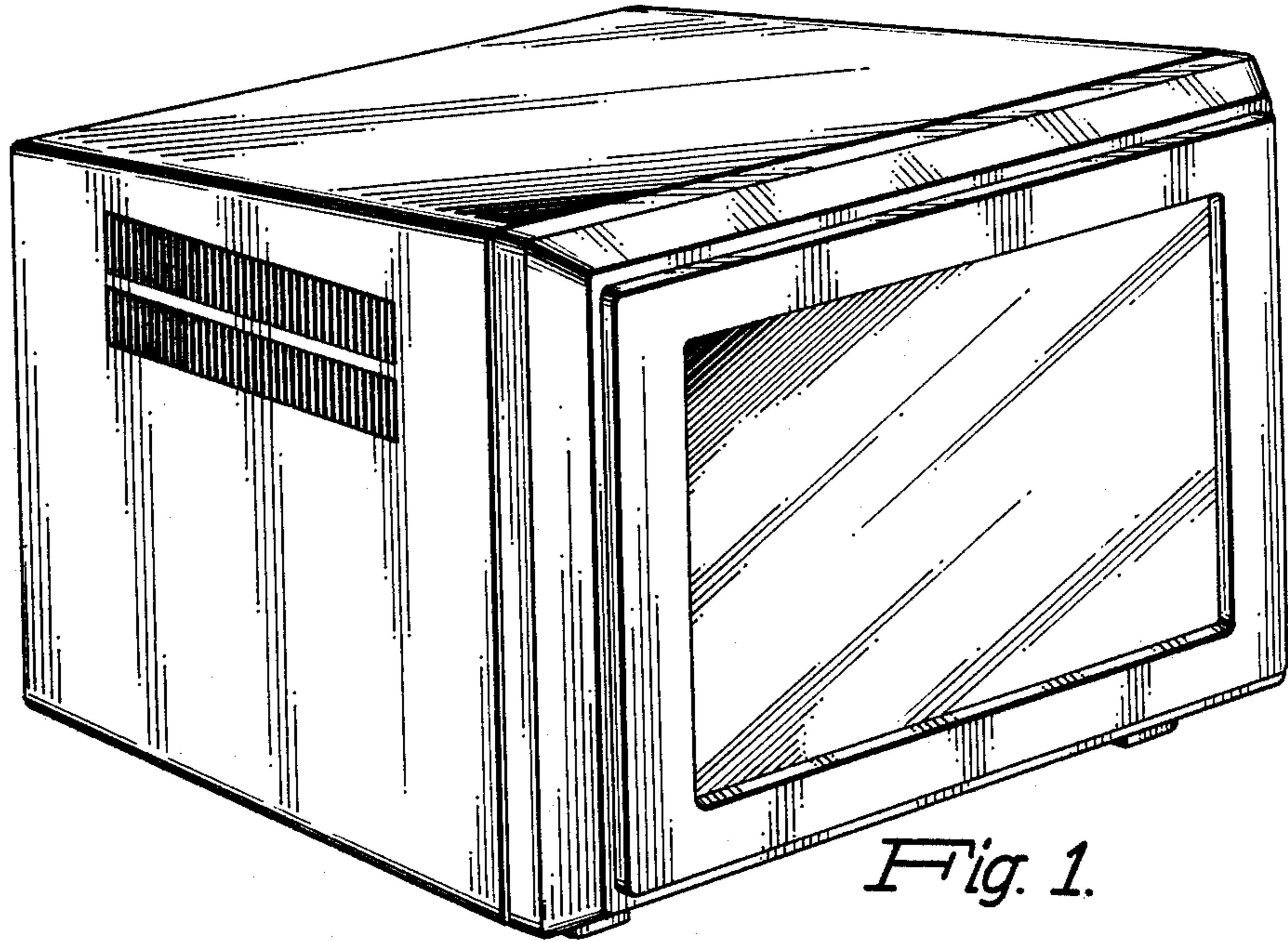

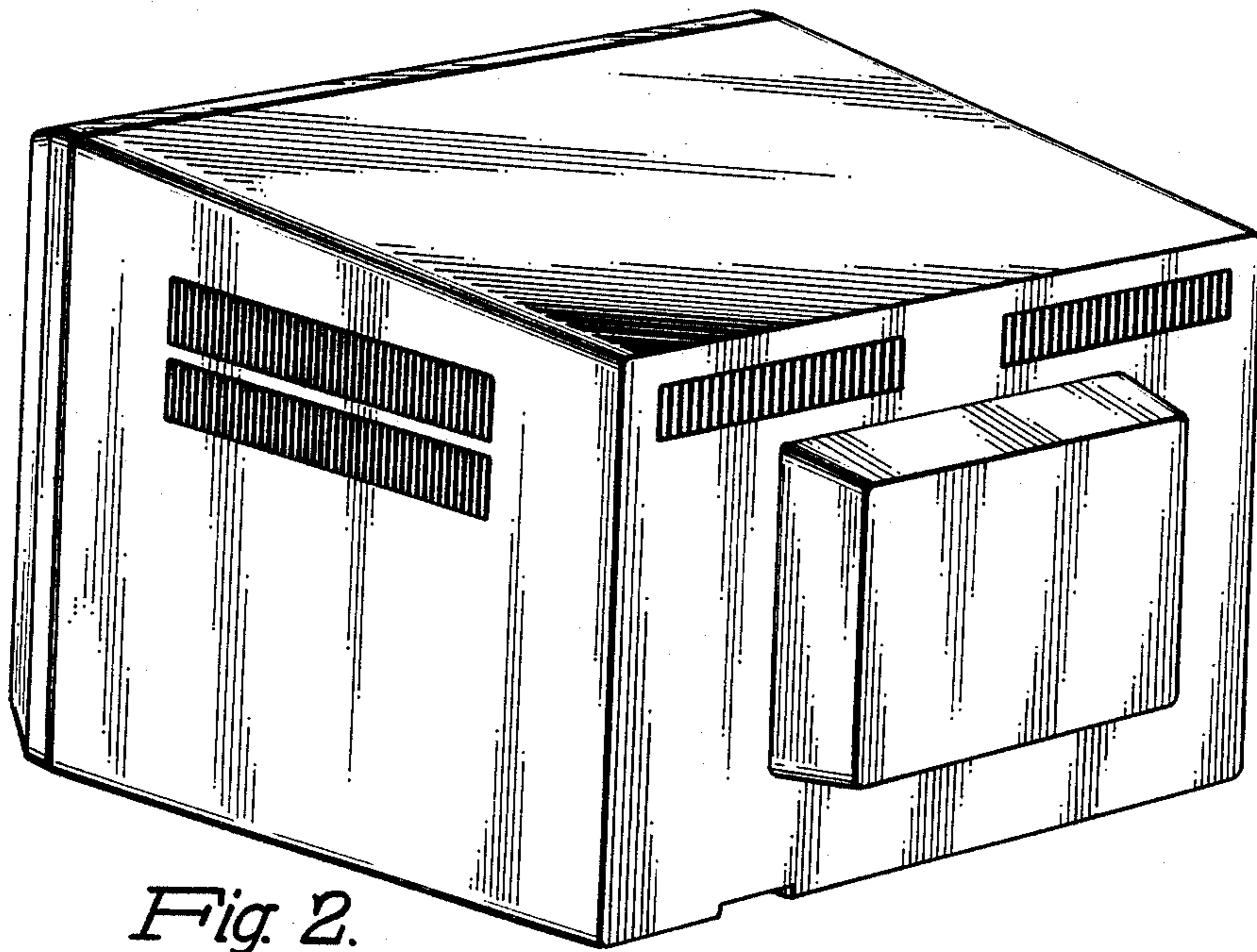

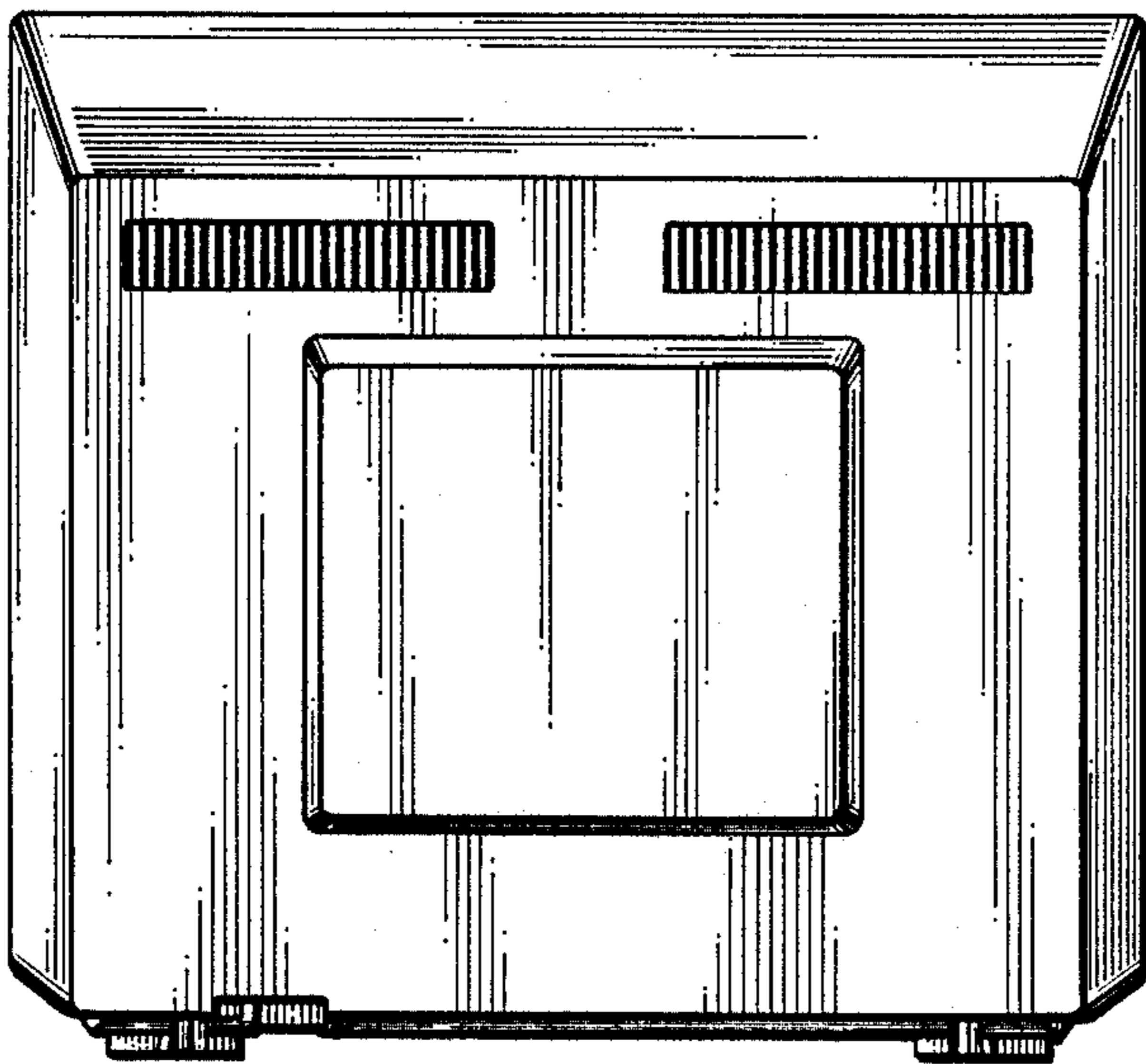

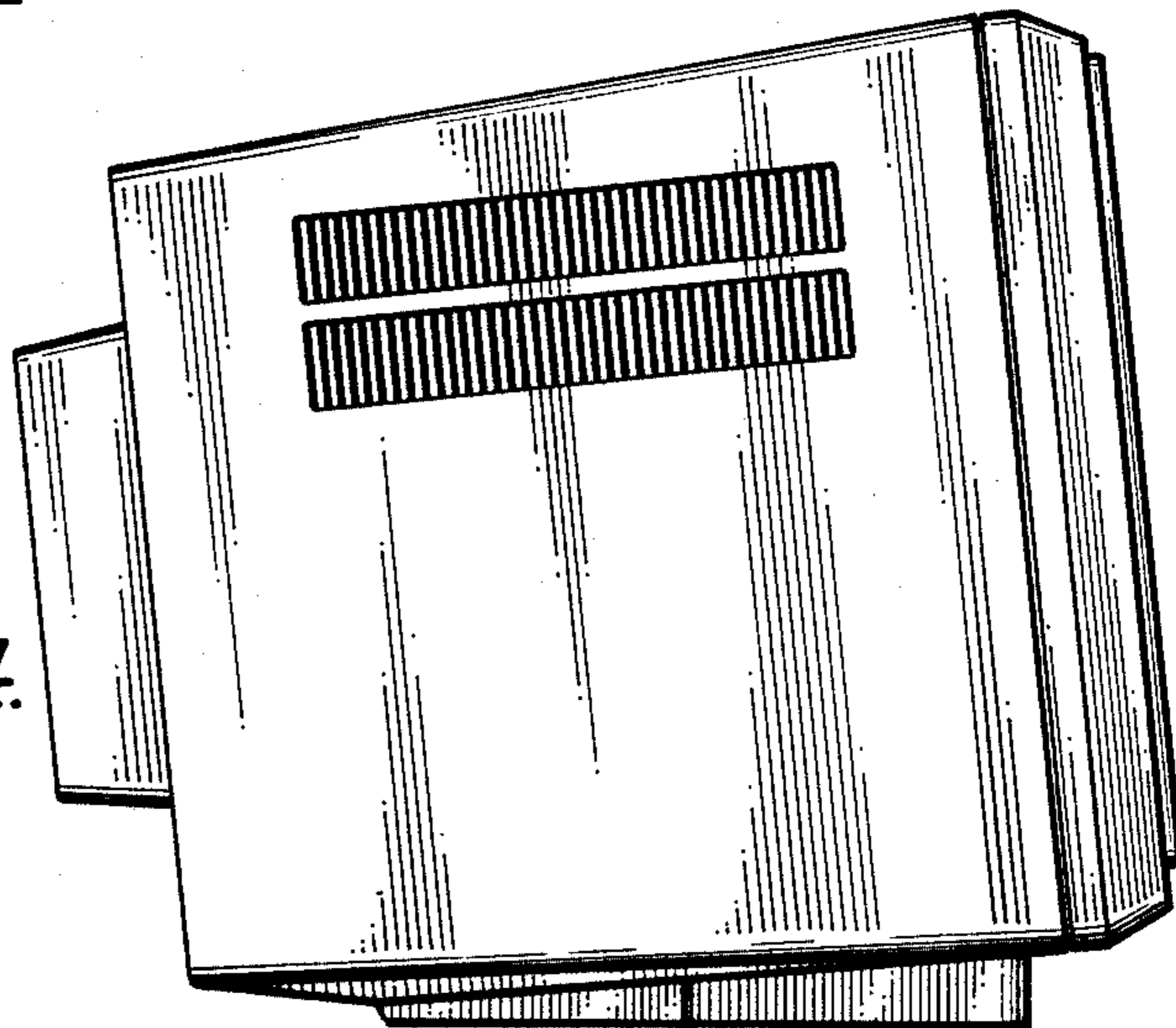

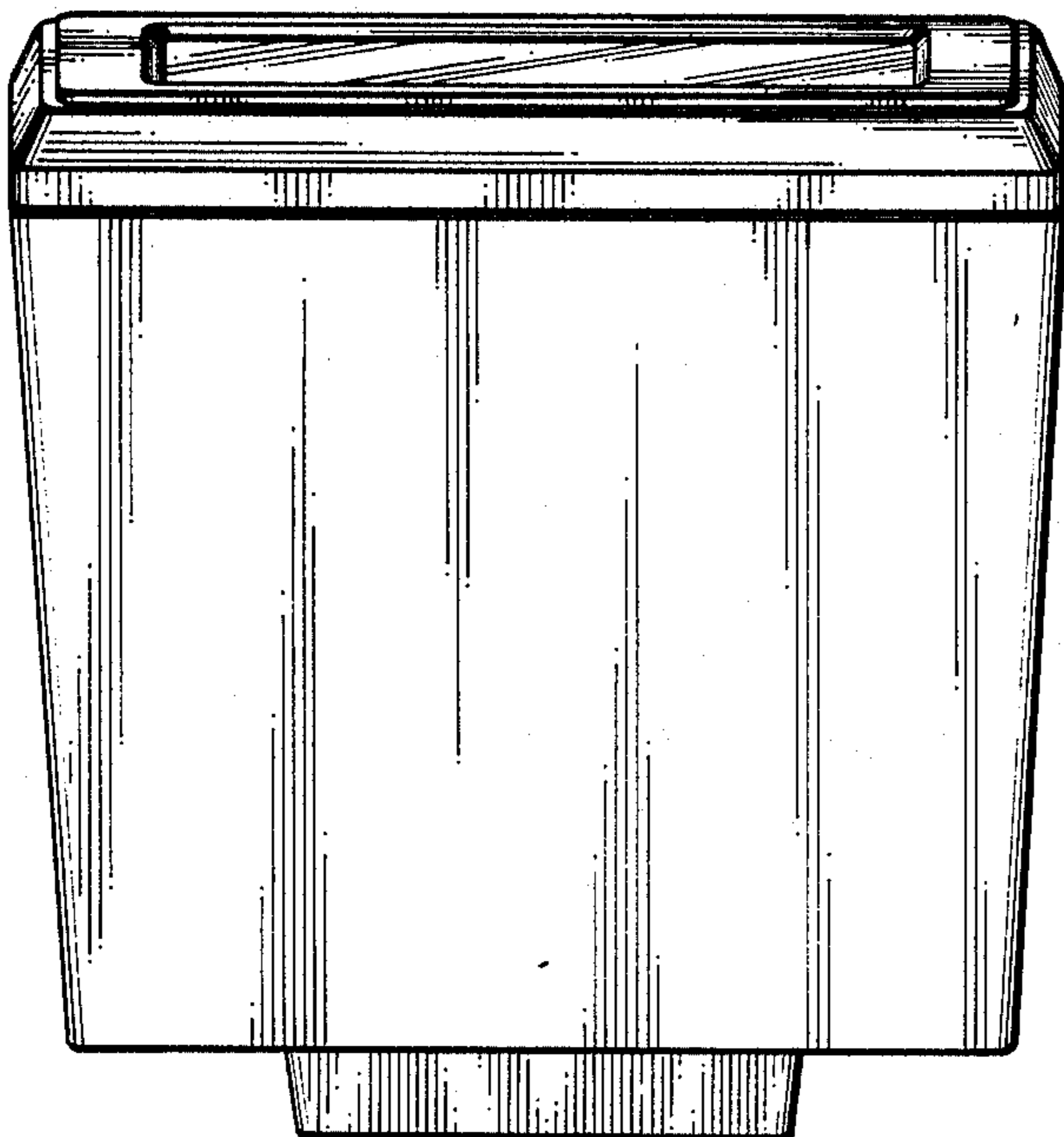
