DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of an ultraviolet light for fingernail treatment showing my new design.

FIG. 6 is bottom plan view thereof.

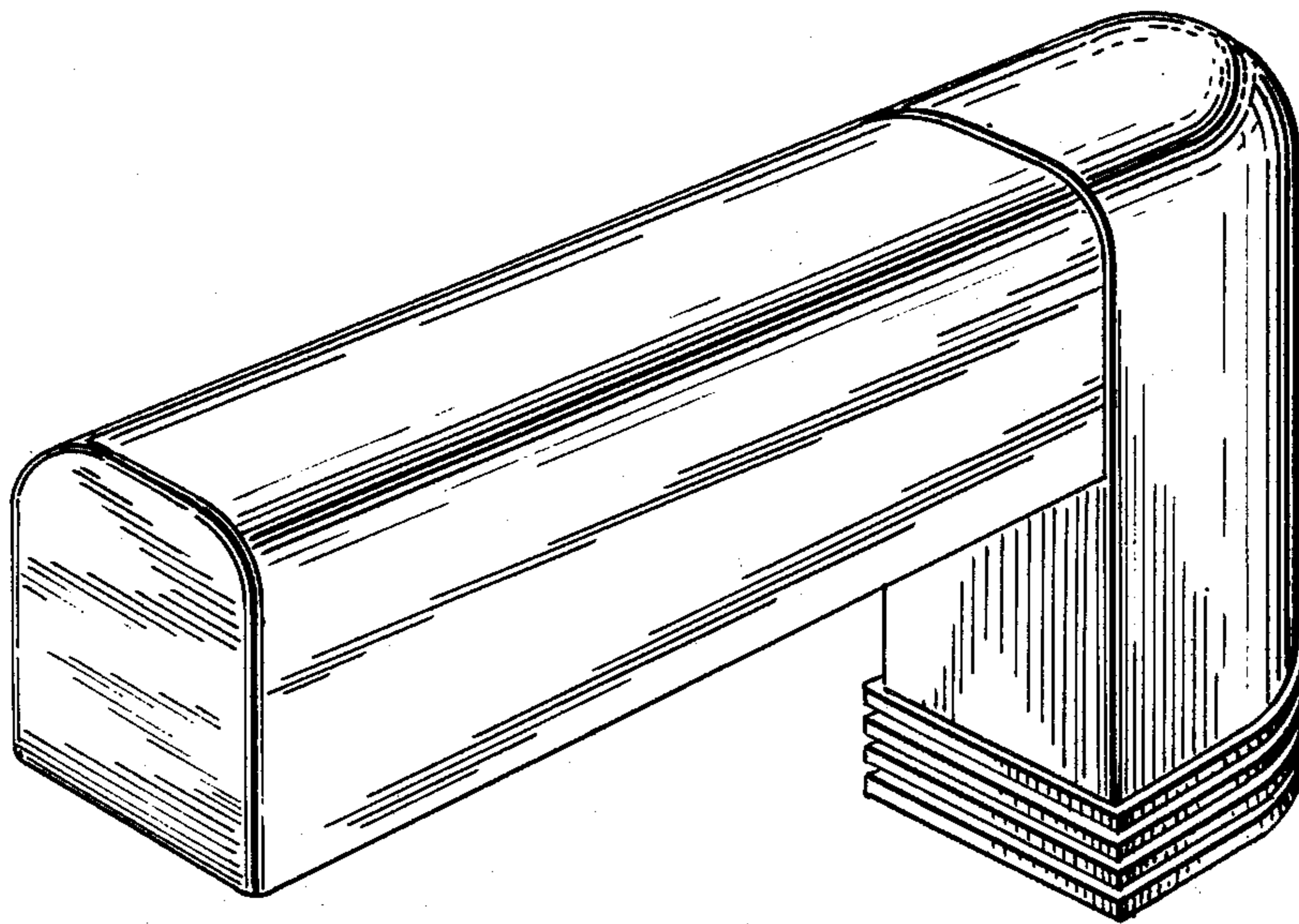
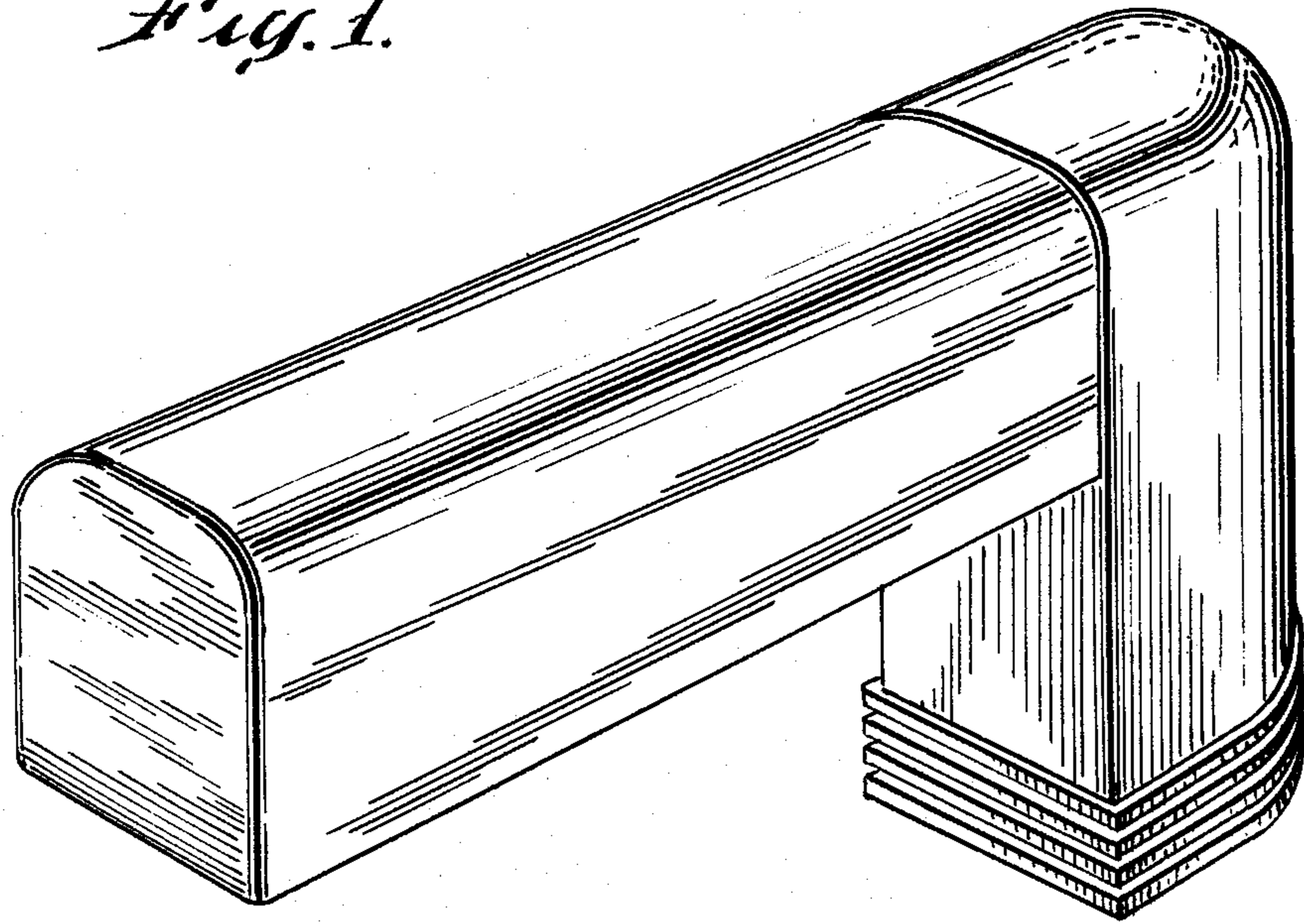

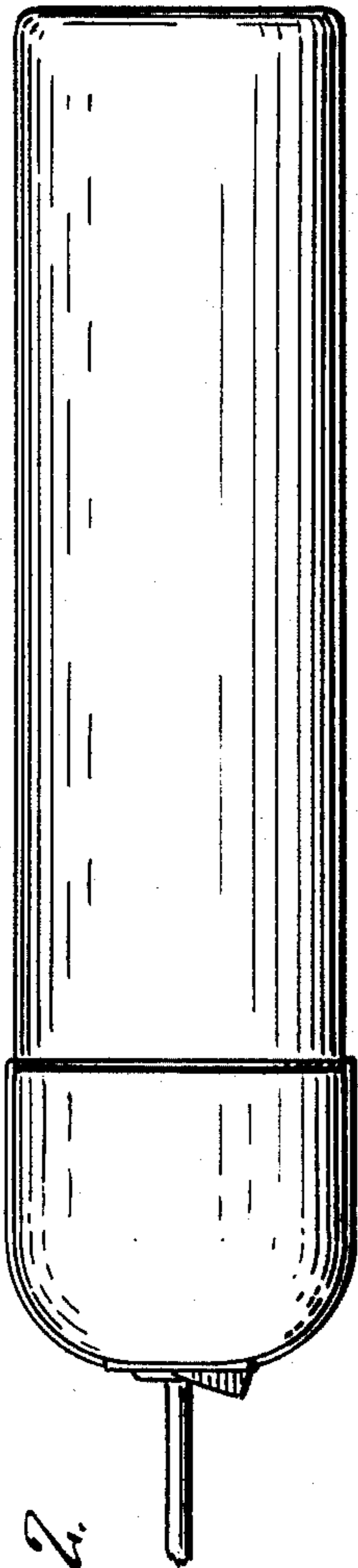

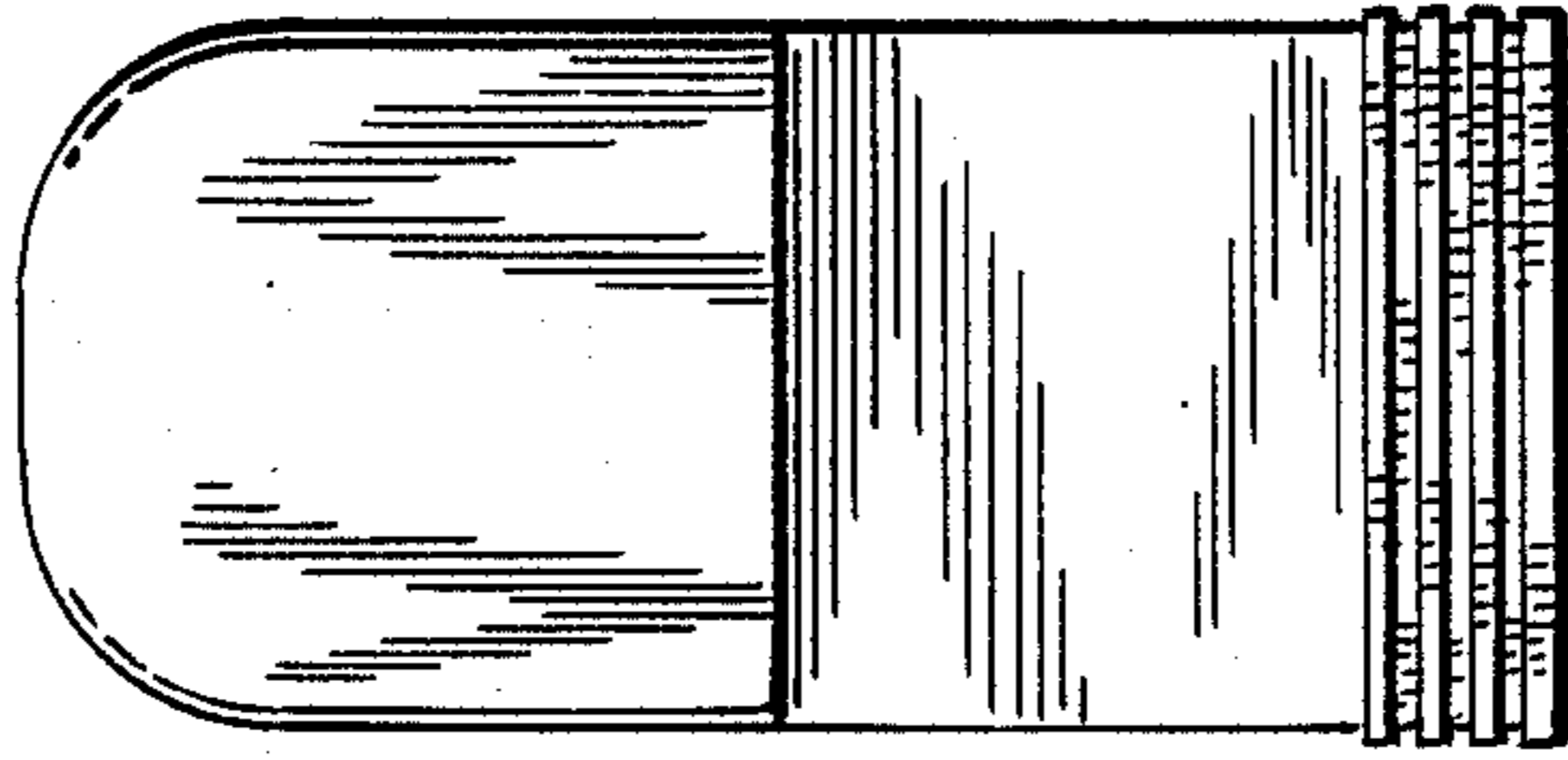

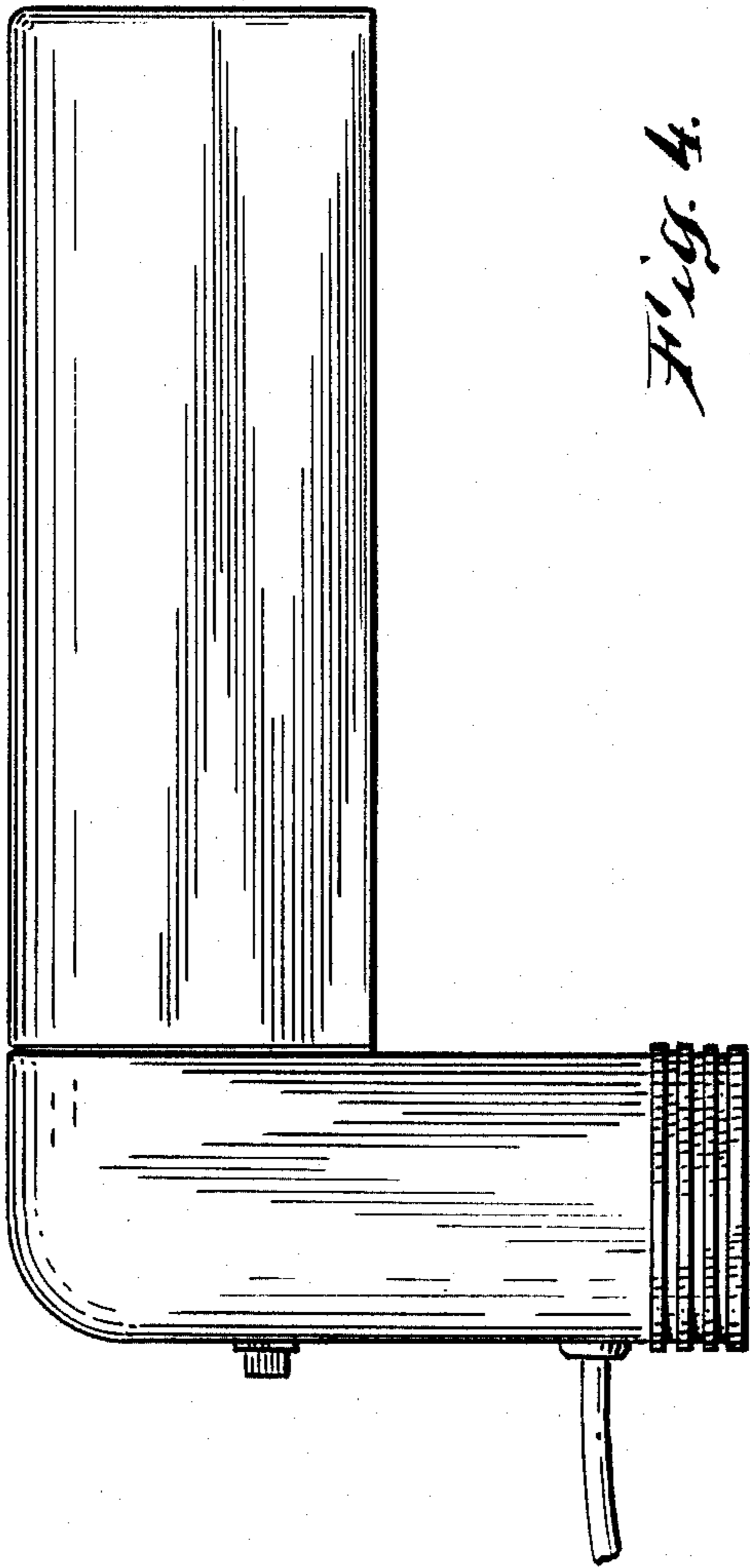

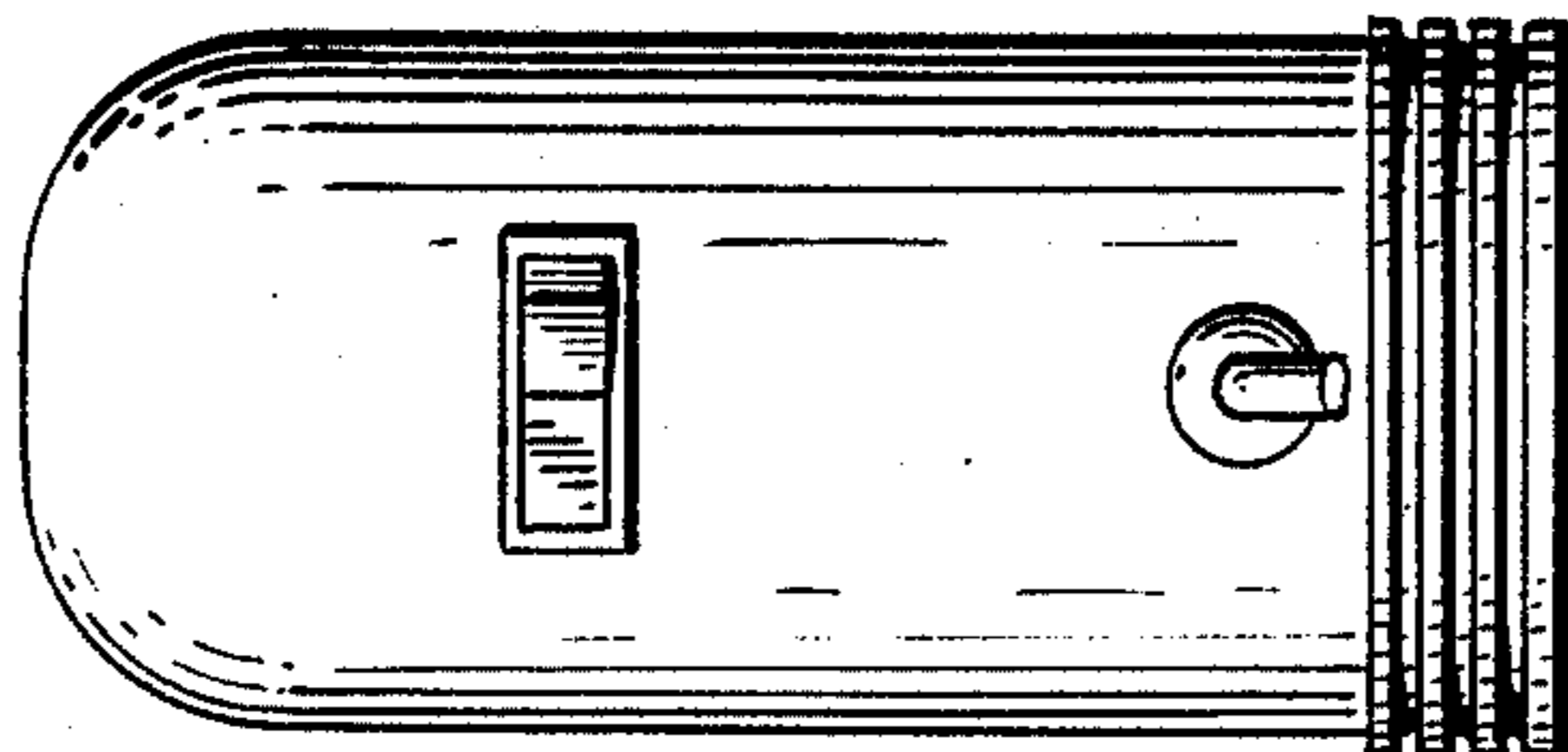

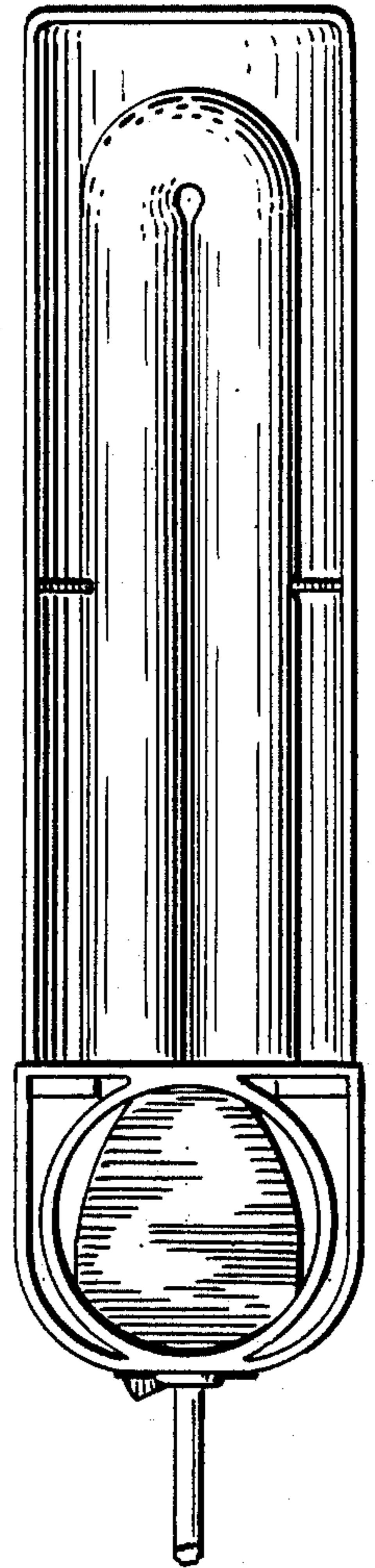
