The ornamental design for a power unit for powered paint applicator or the like, as shown.

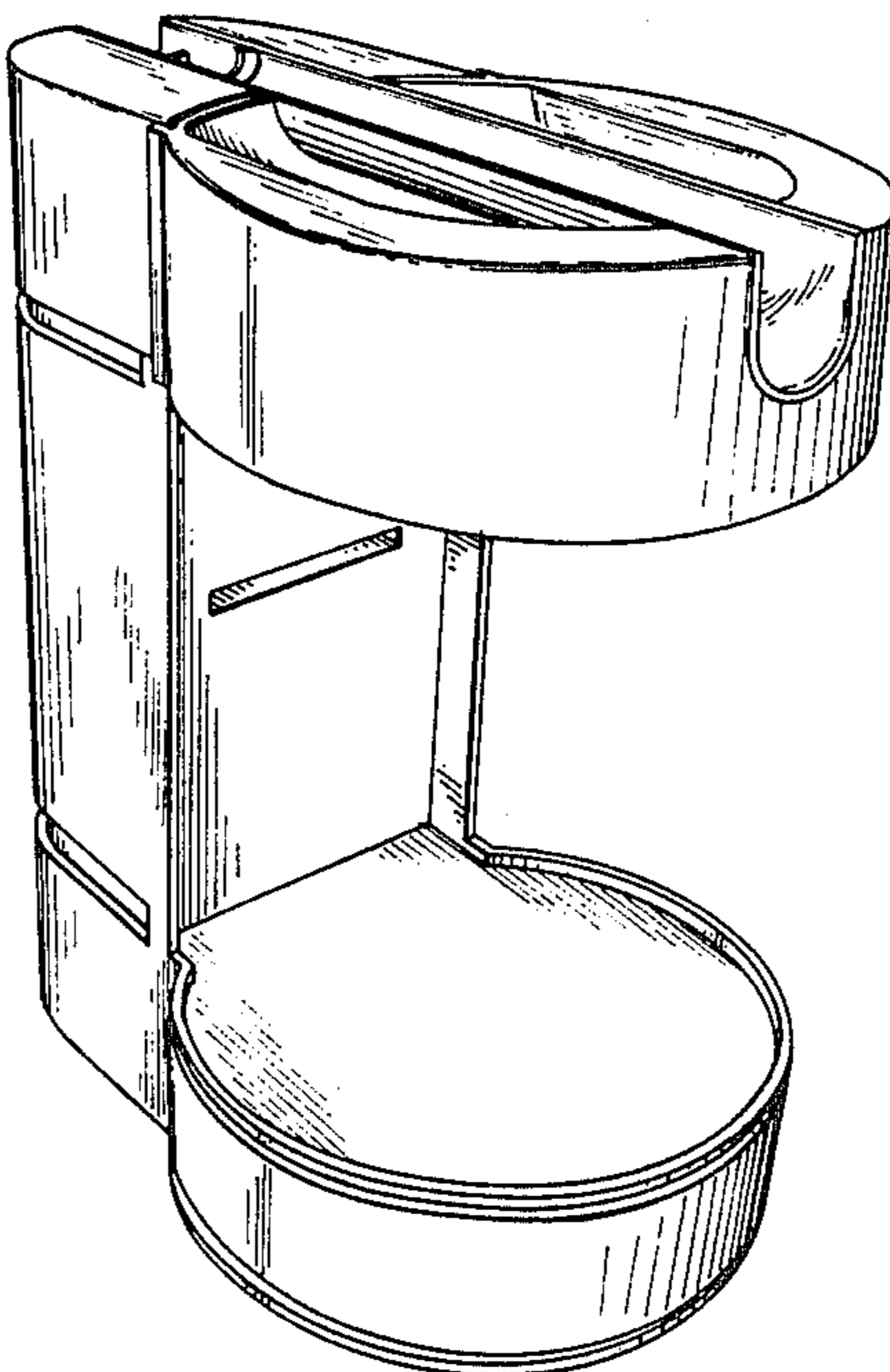
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



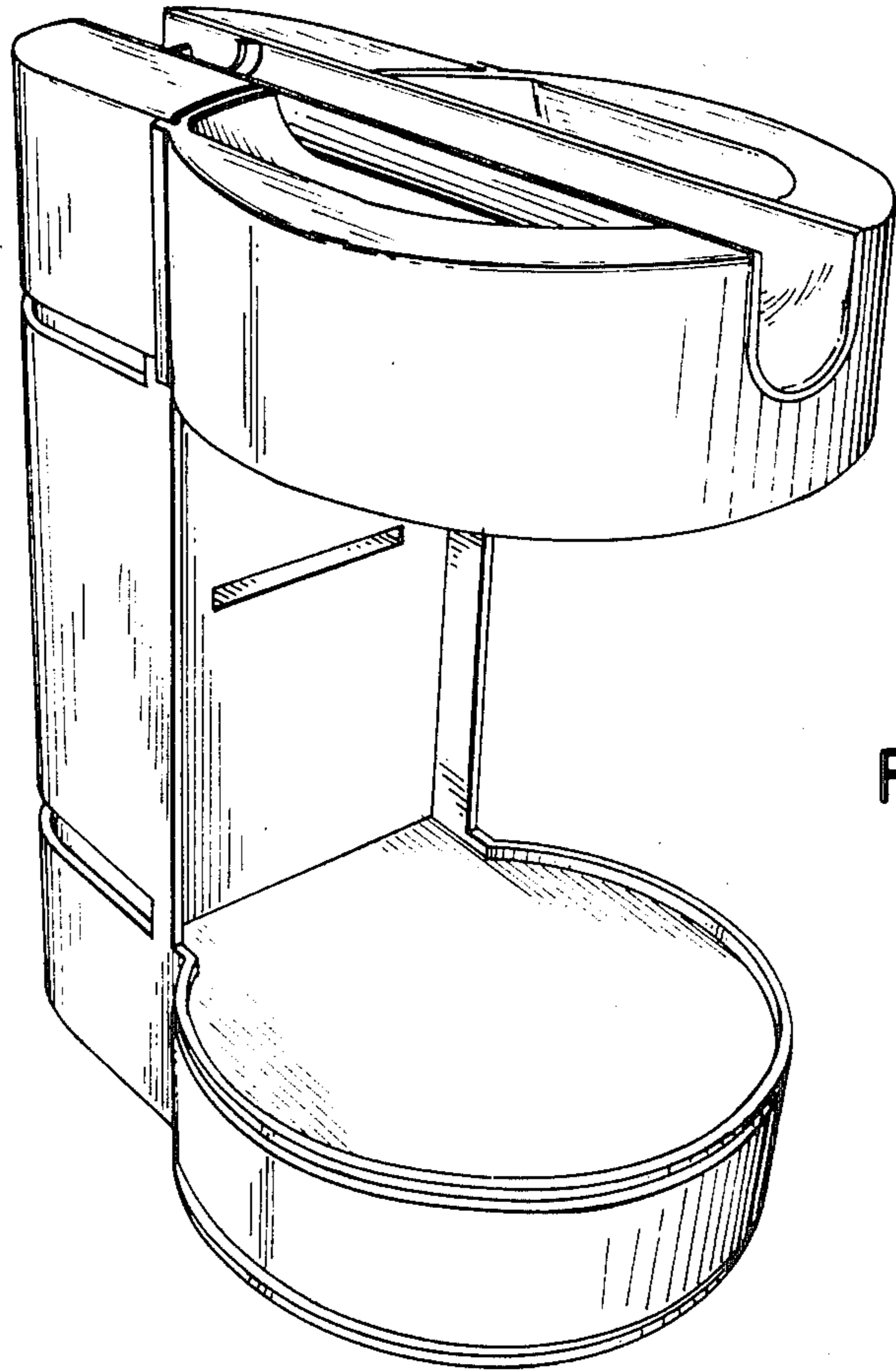

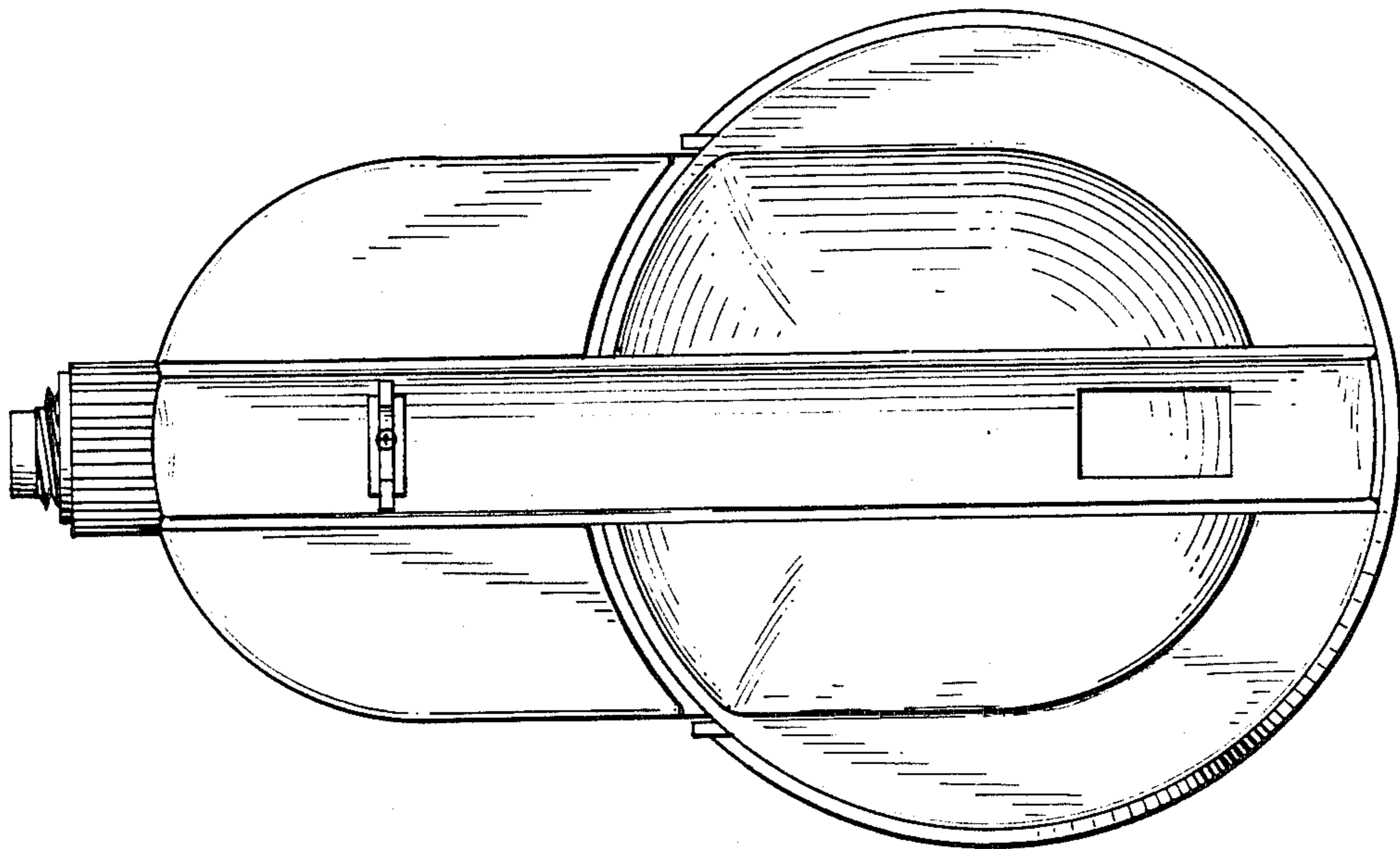

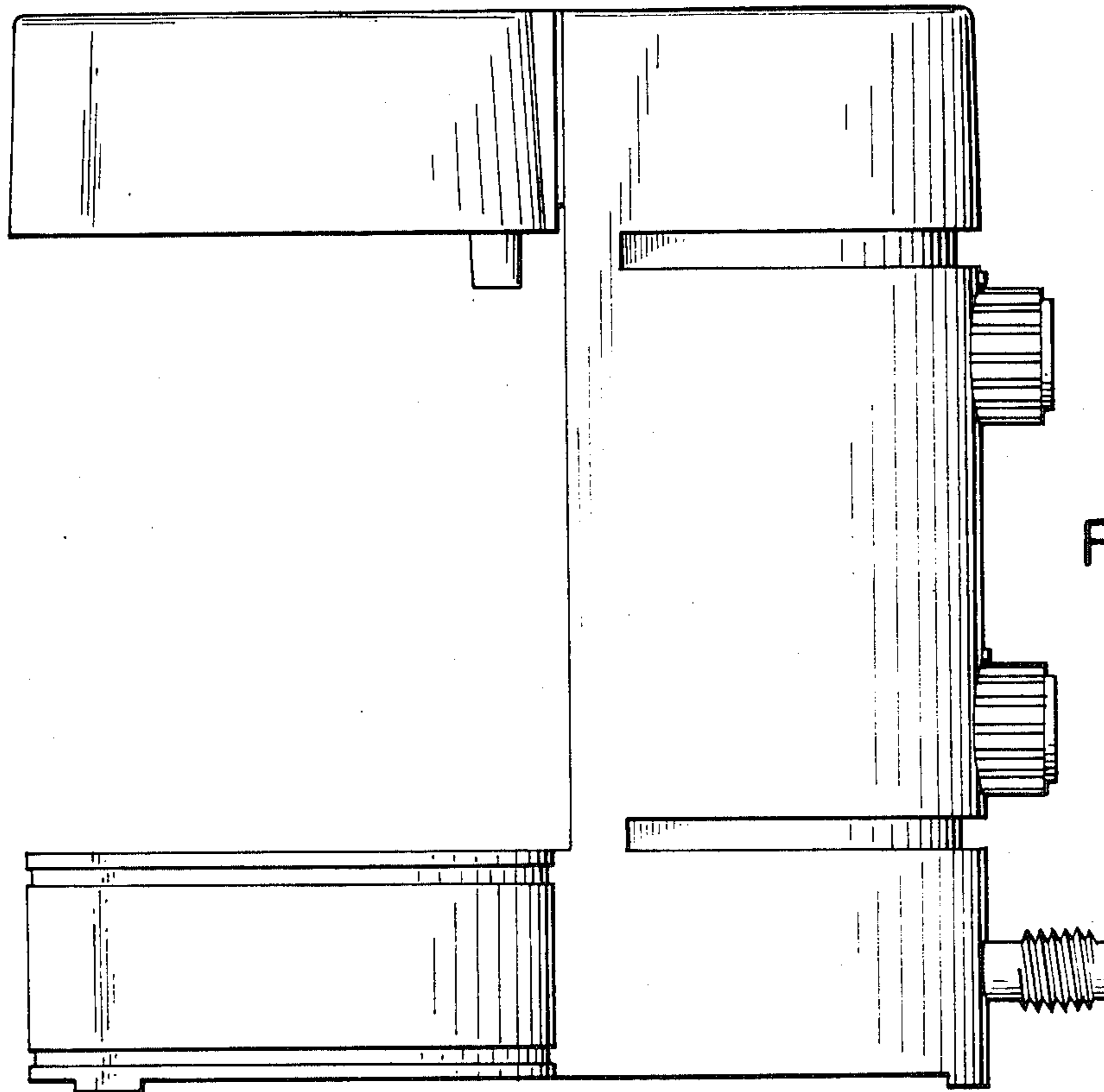

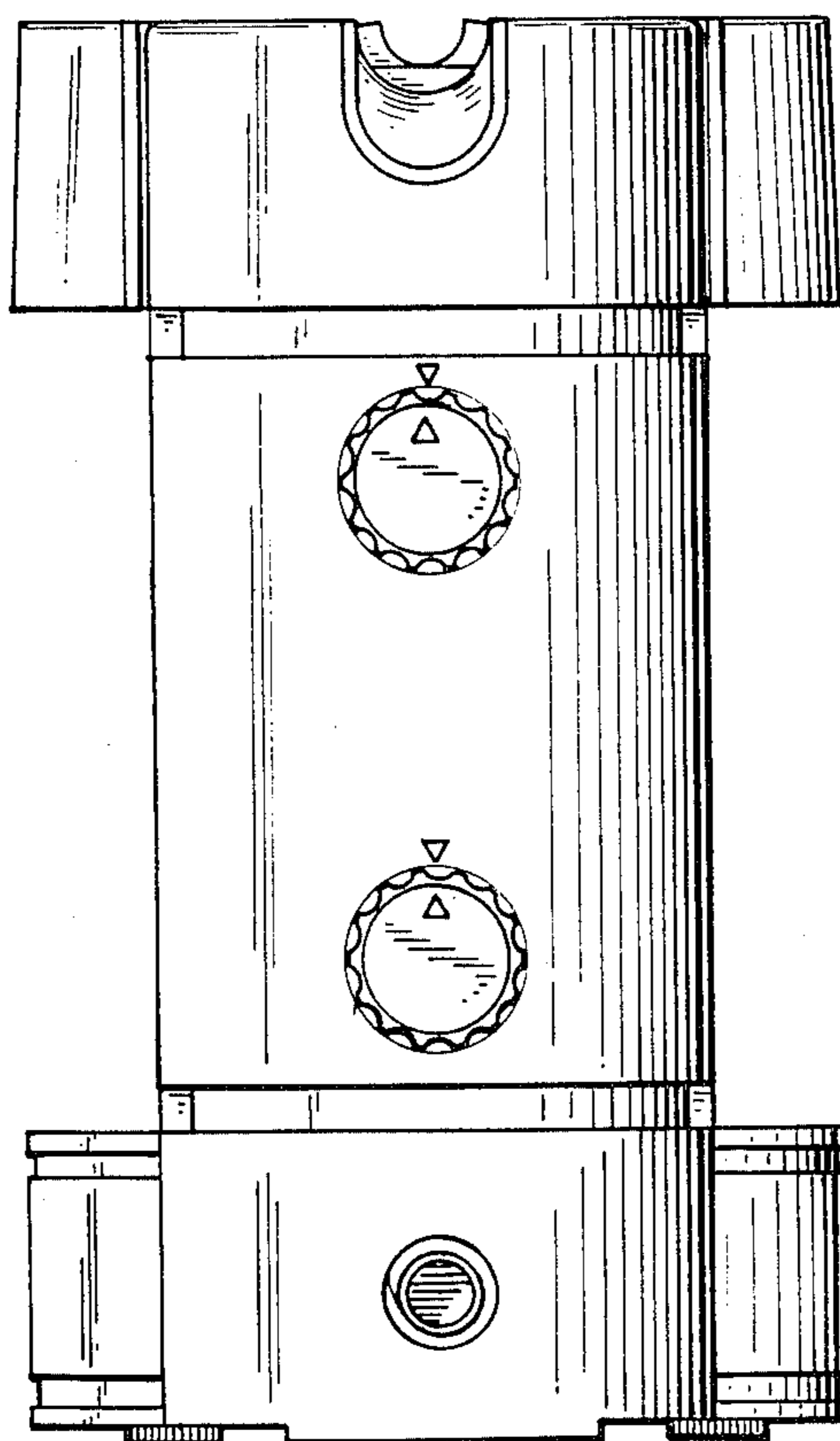
