FIG. 4 is a vertical cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1.

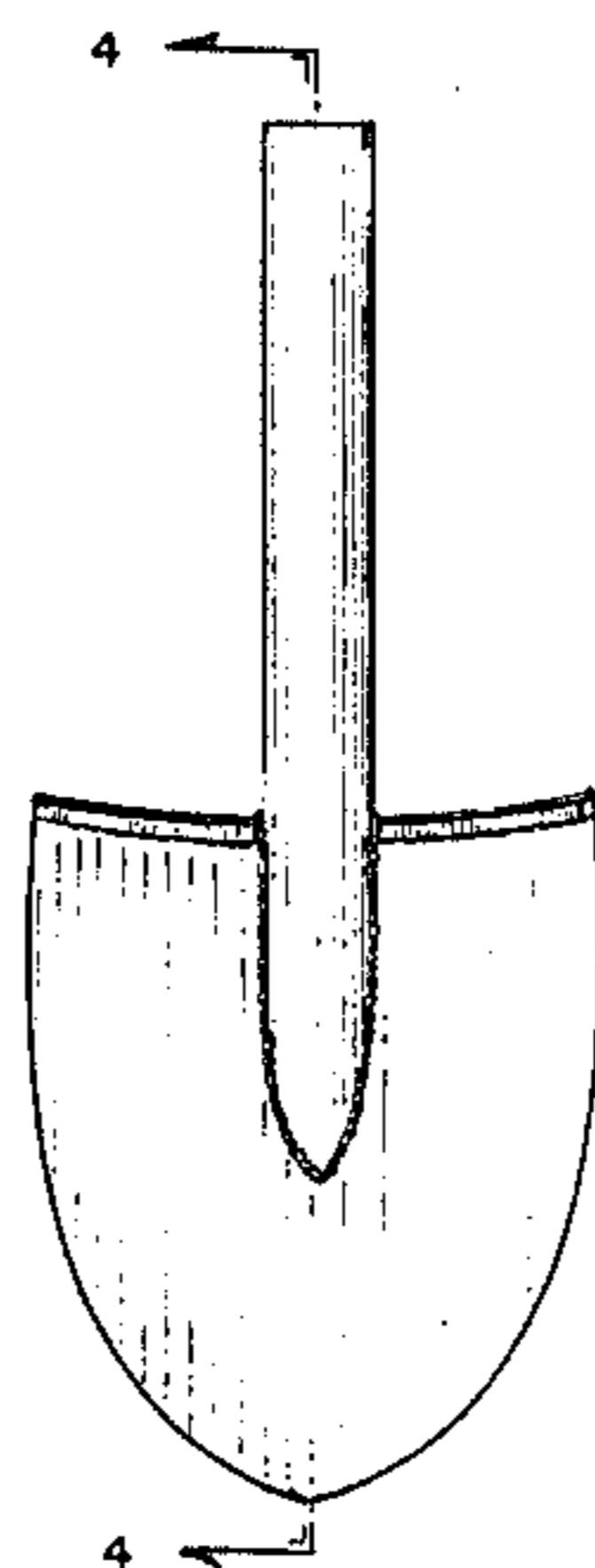

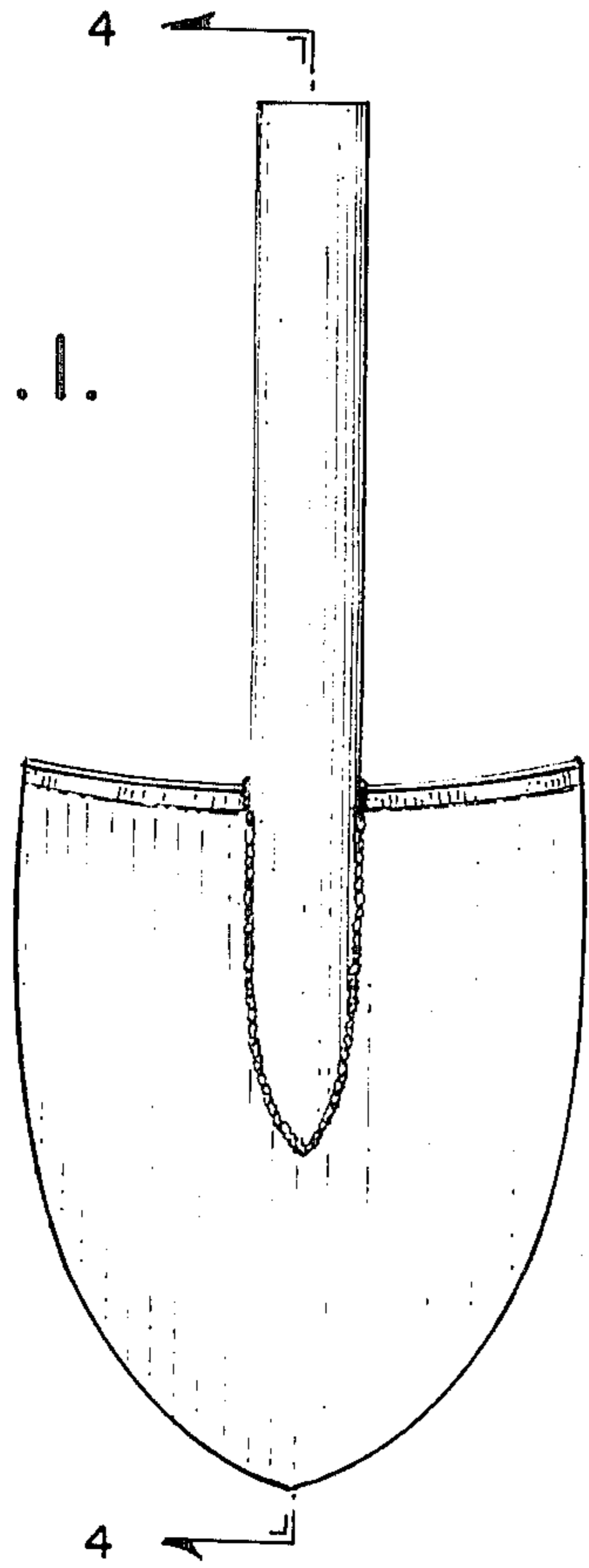

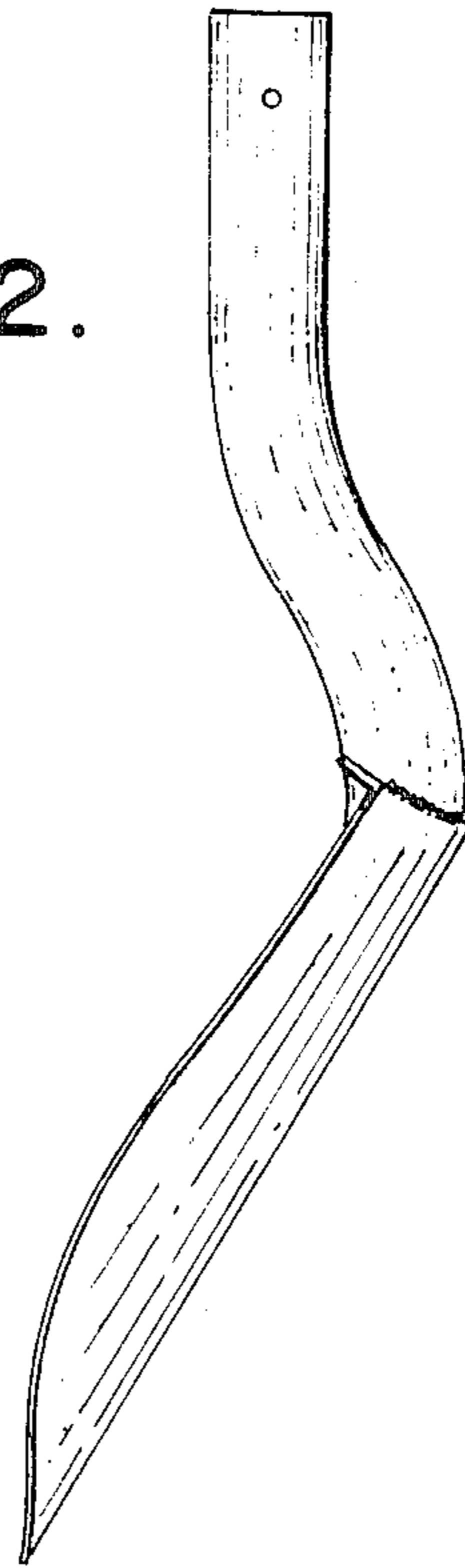

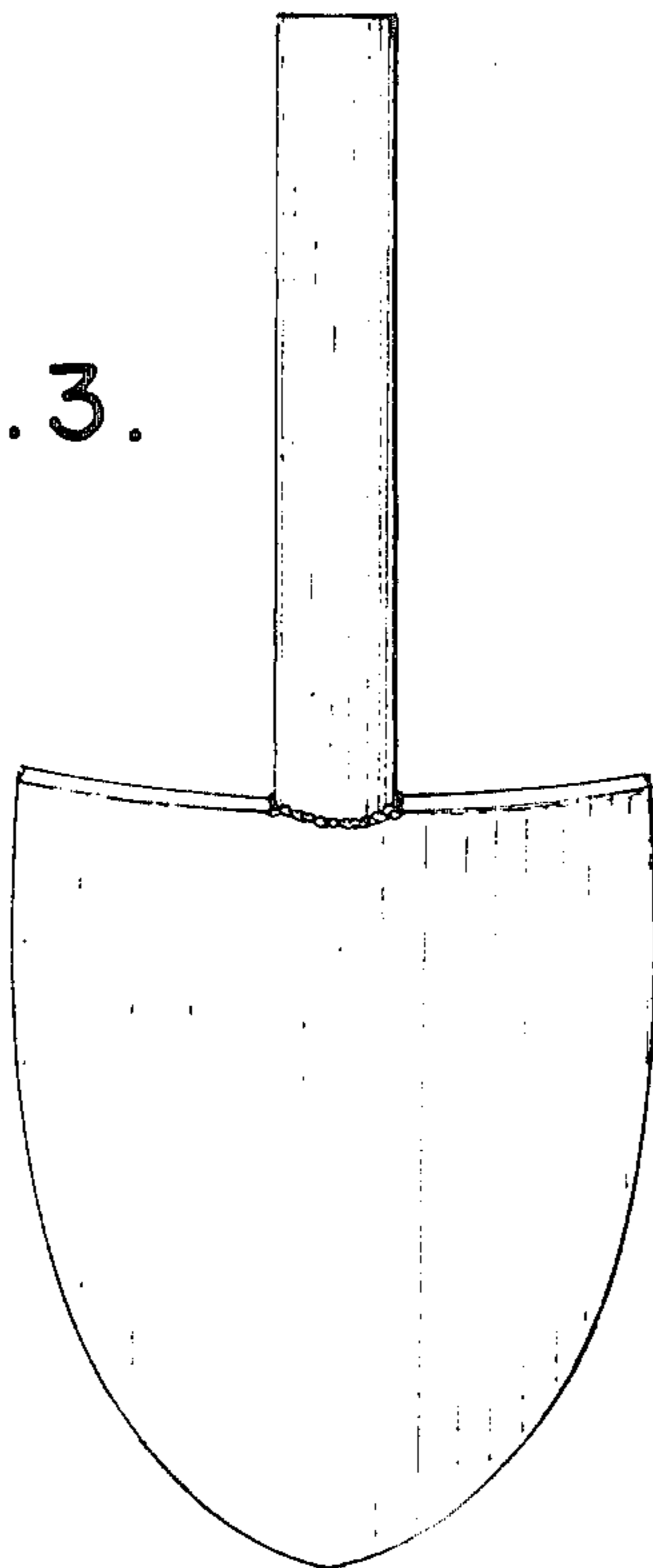
