DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a charger base for
a battery operated electric knife showing my new de-
sign;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-
side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

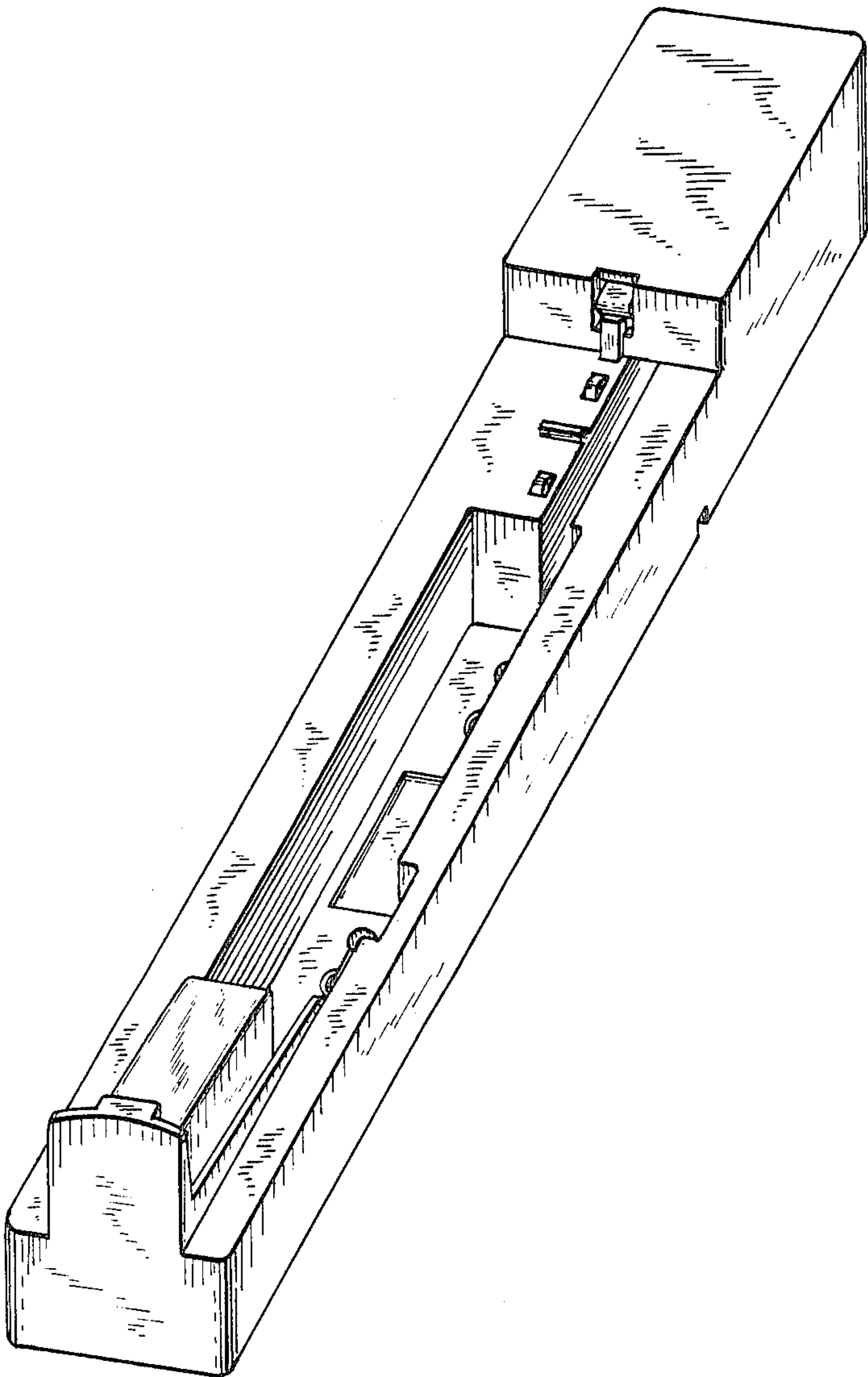

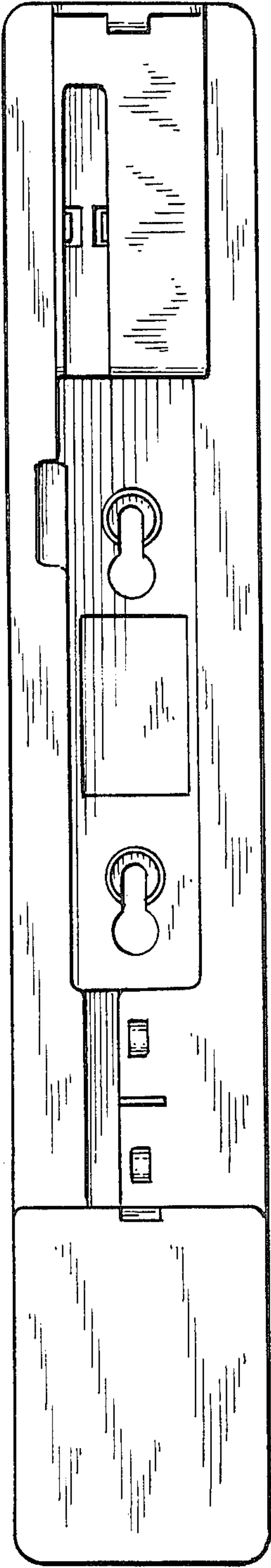

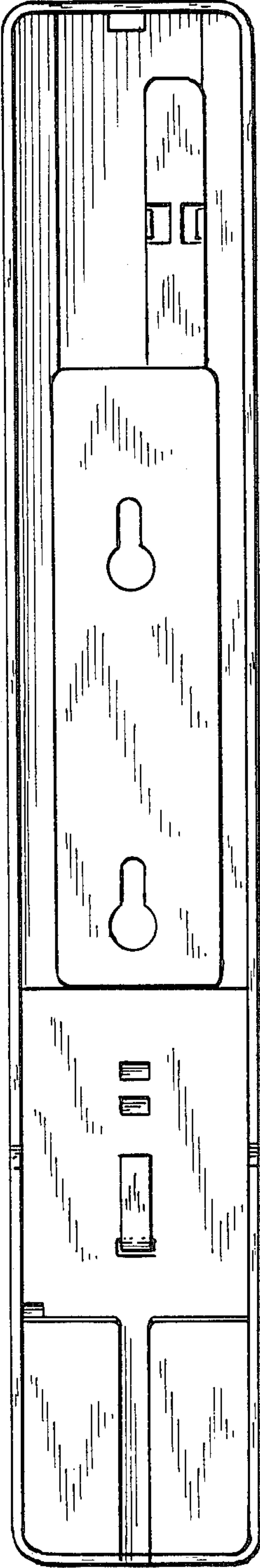

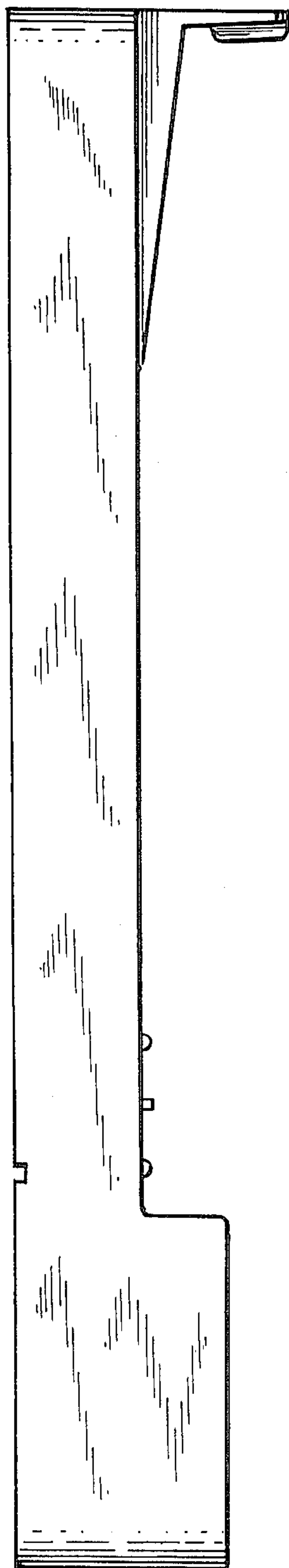

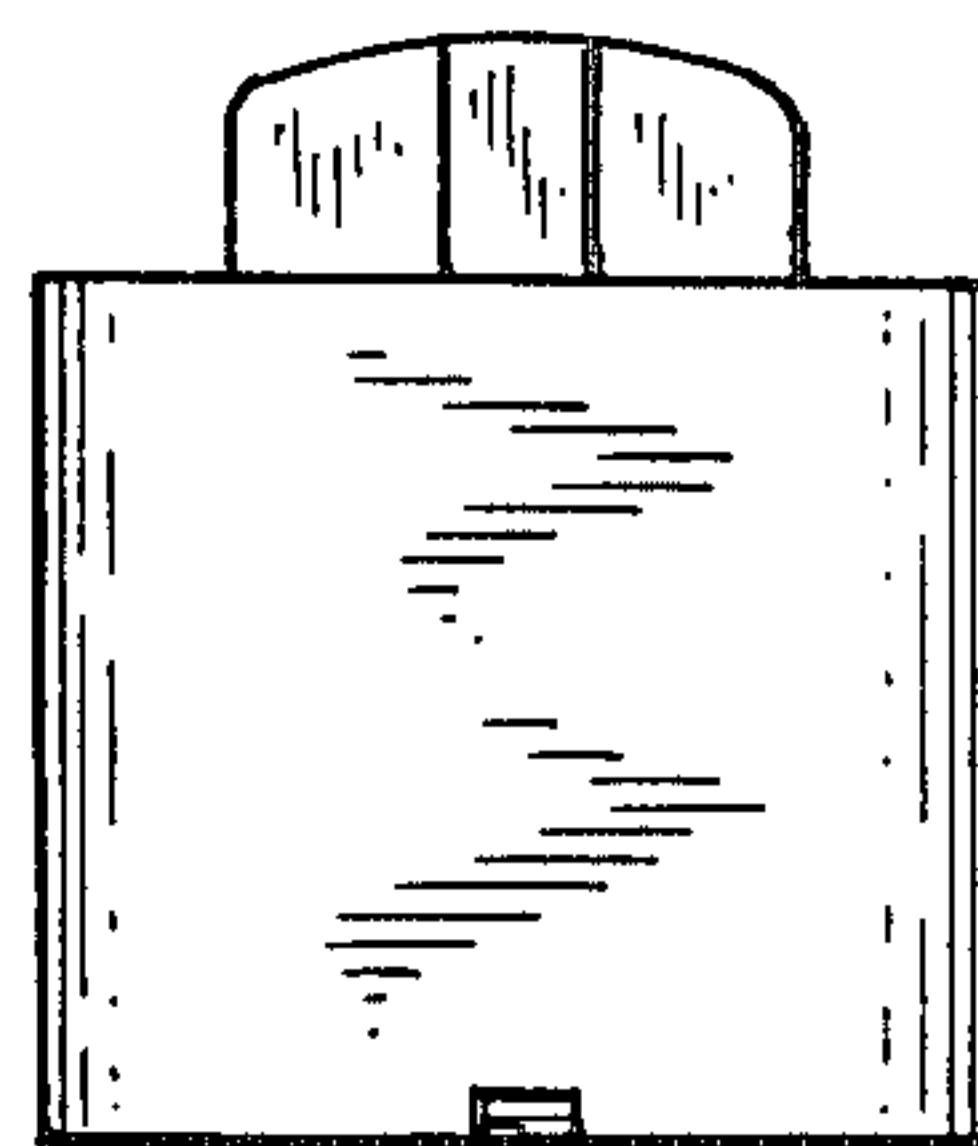

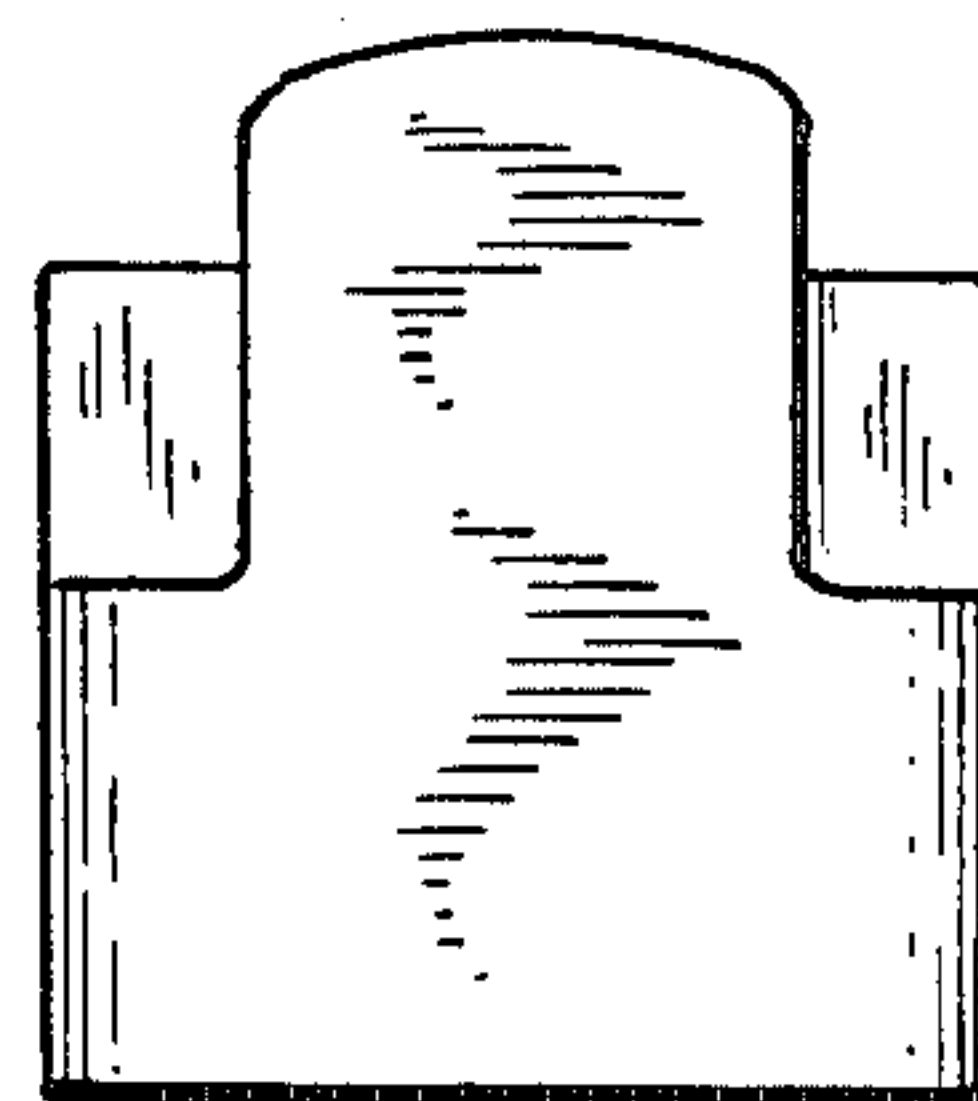
