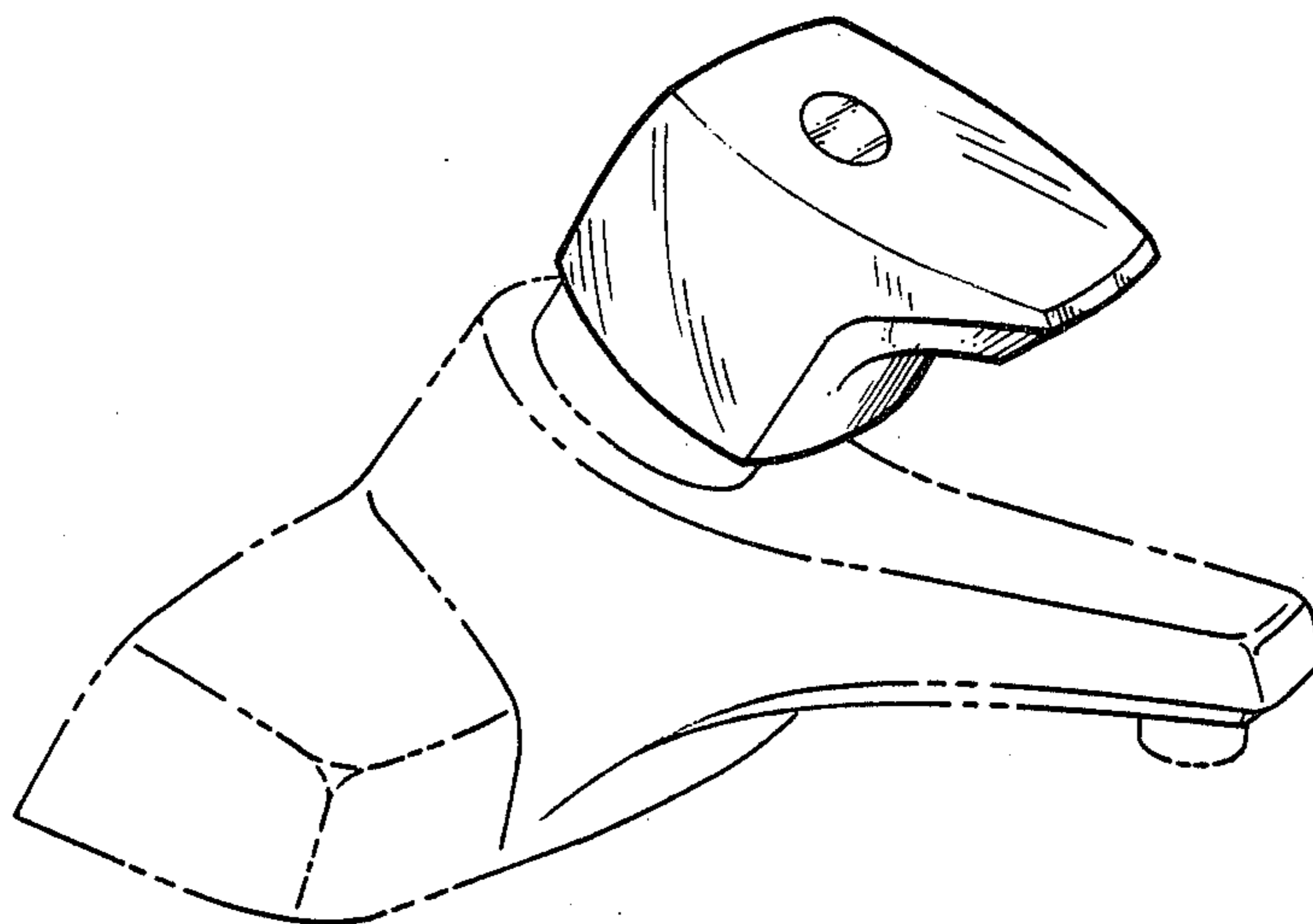

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a faucet handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a faucet handle showing my new design; FIG. 2 is another perspective view taken from the top, front and left side thereof; FIG. 3 is a perspective view taken from the top, rear and left side thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken line representation of a faucet in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.



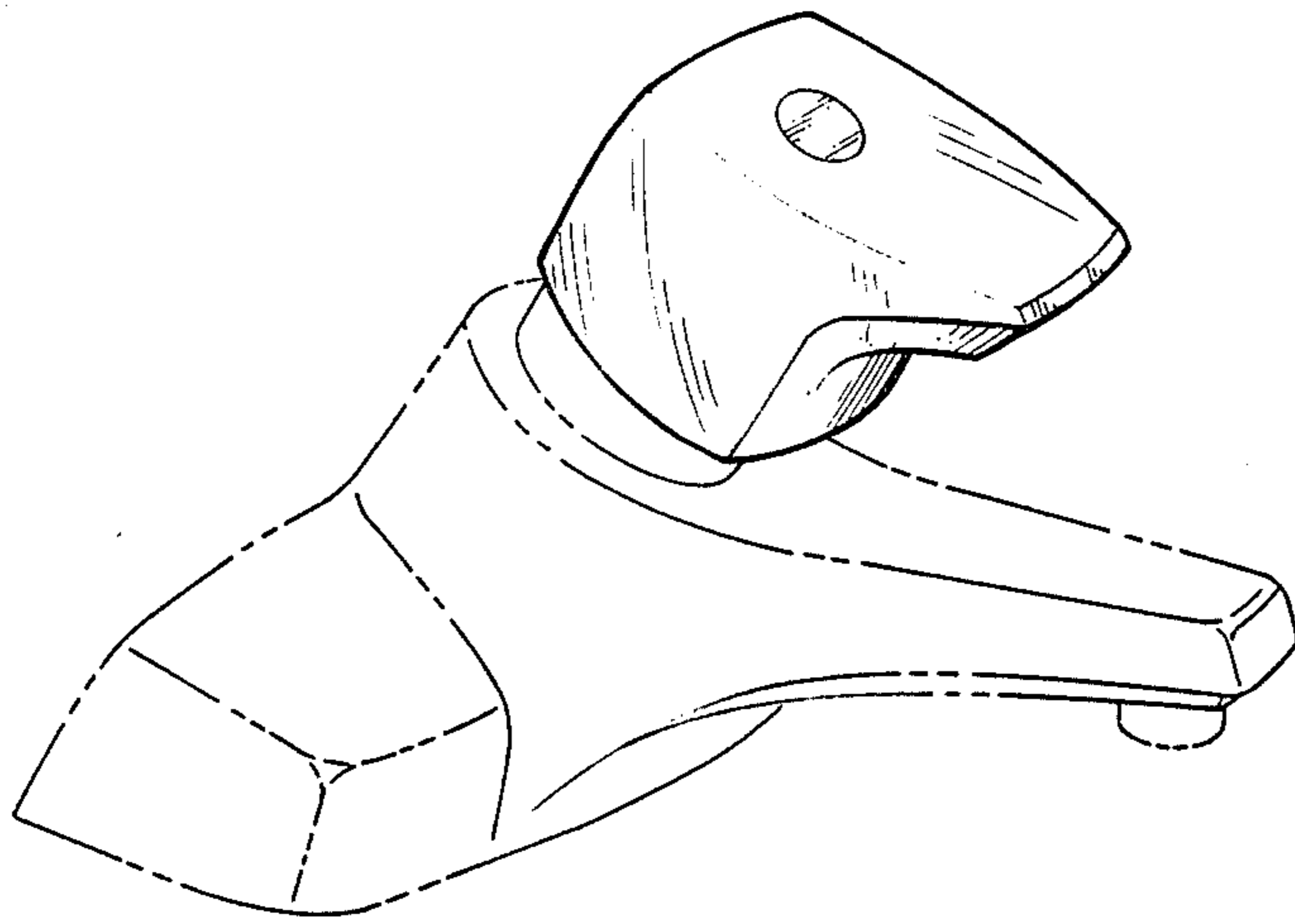

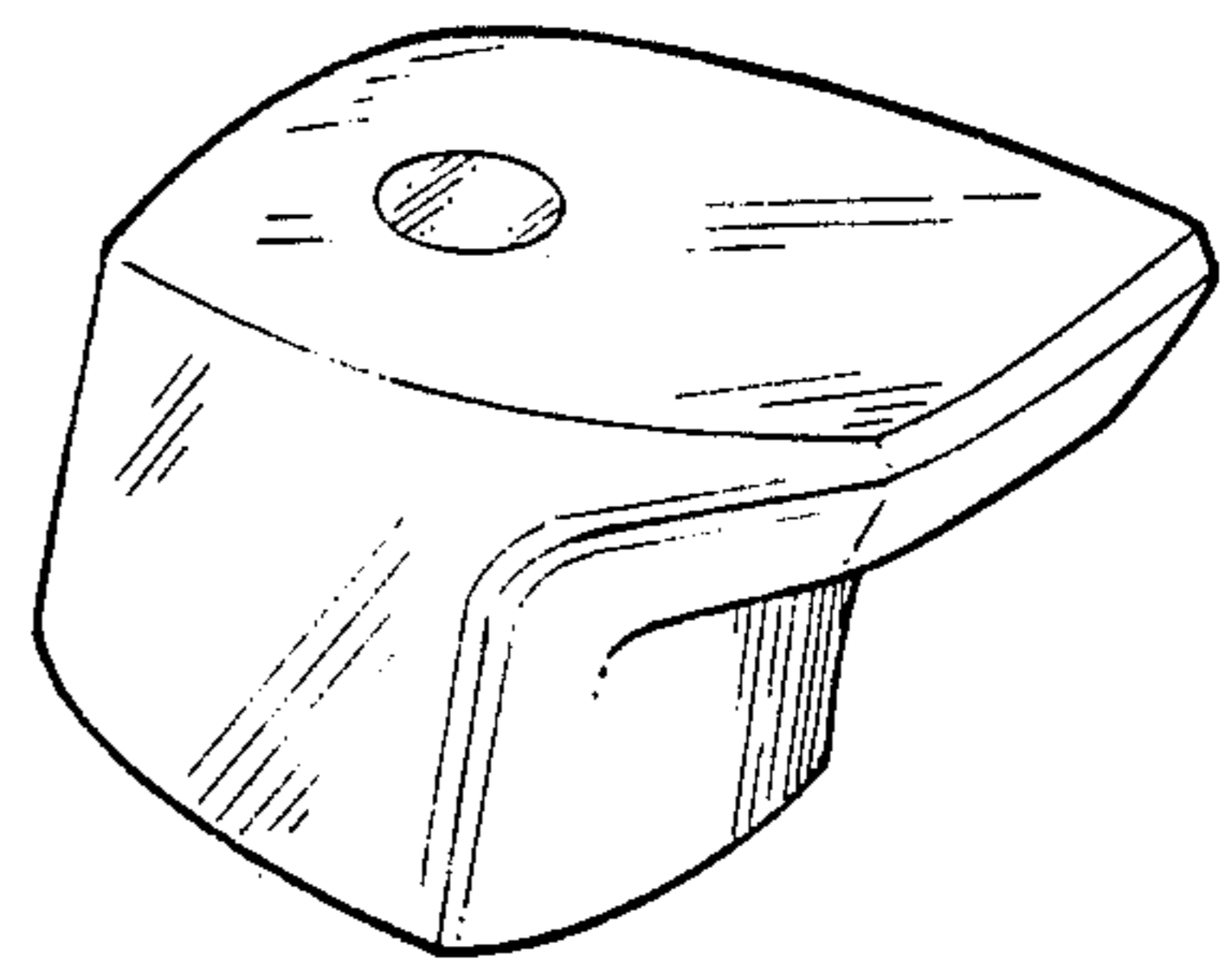

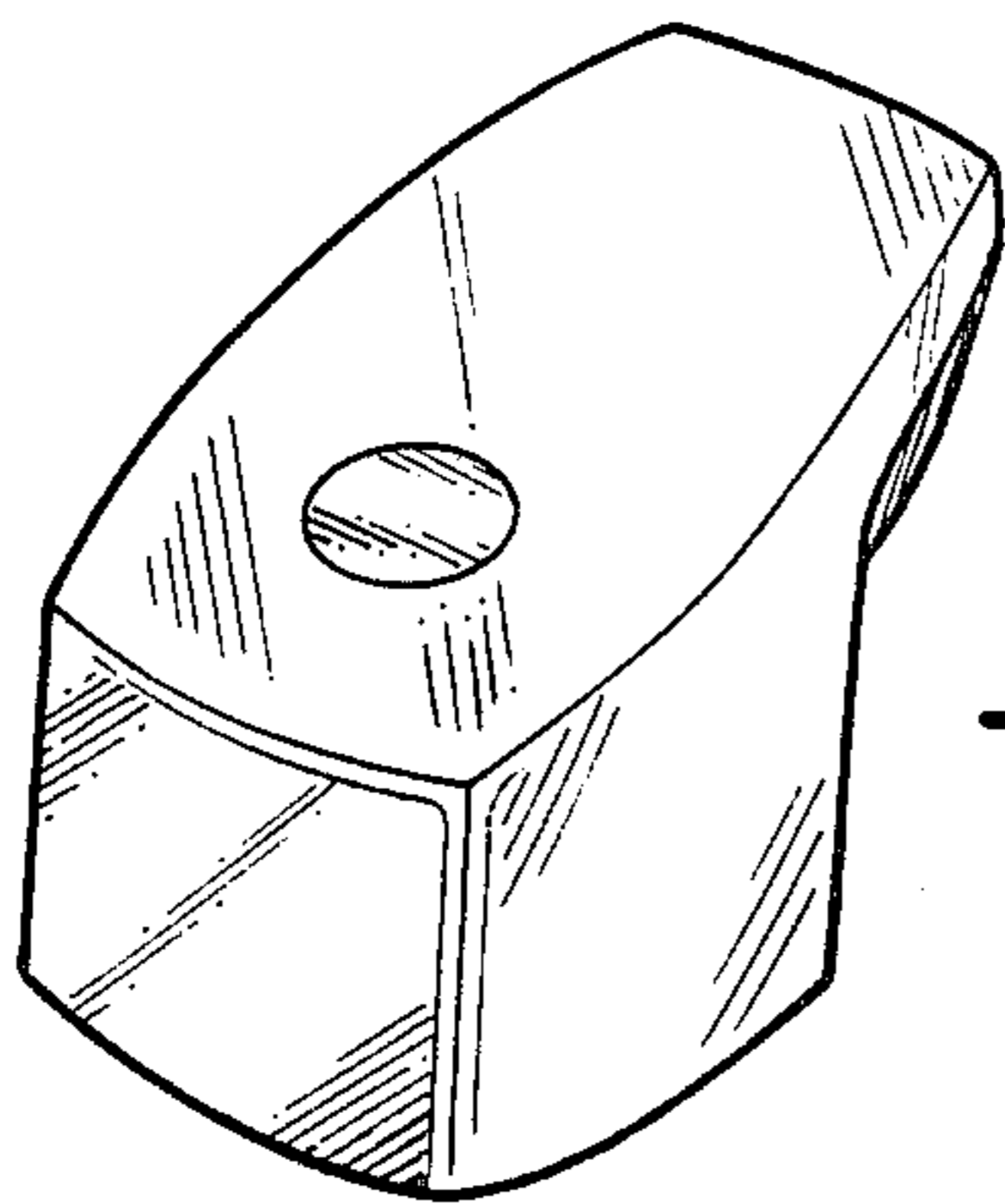

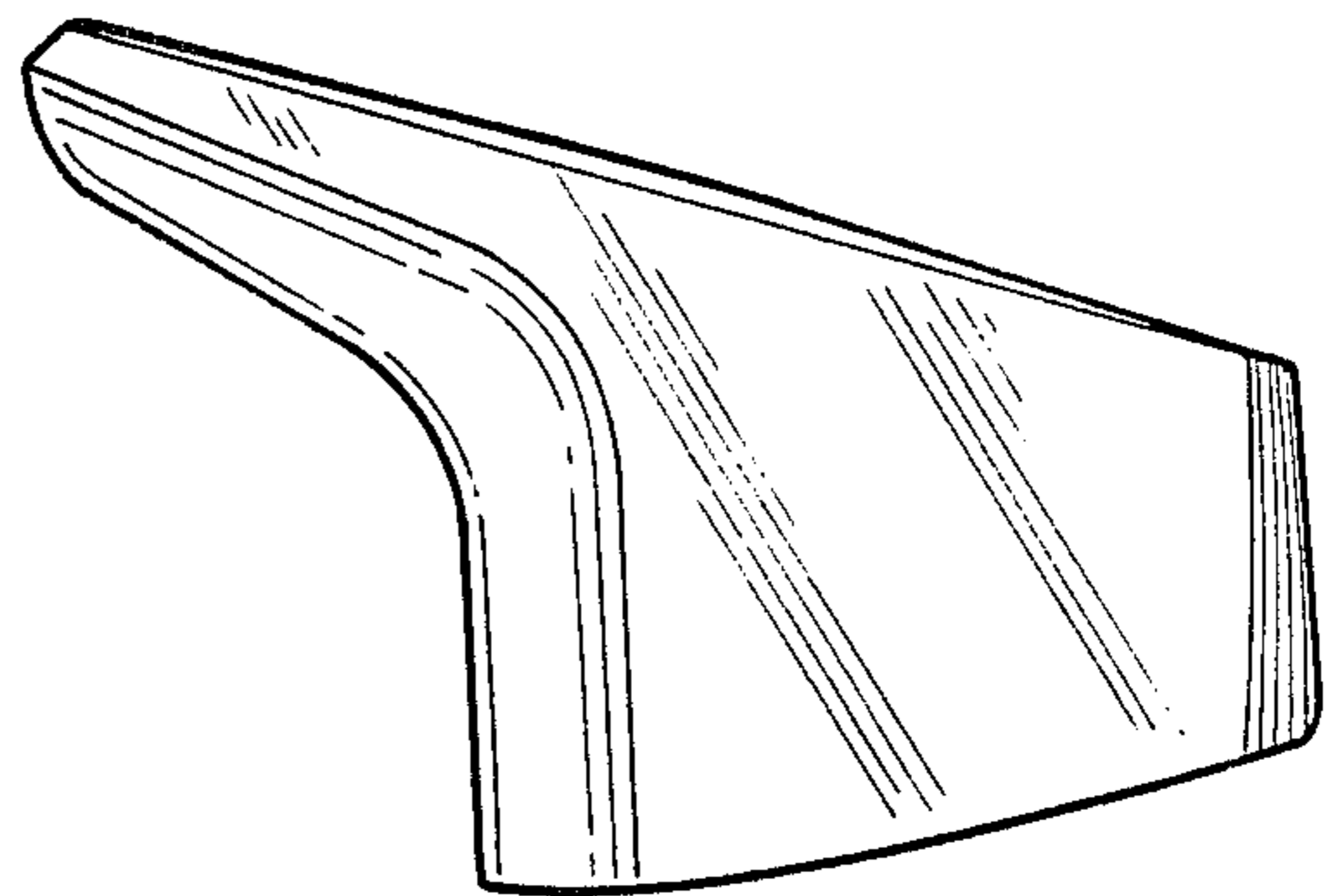

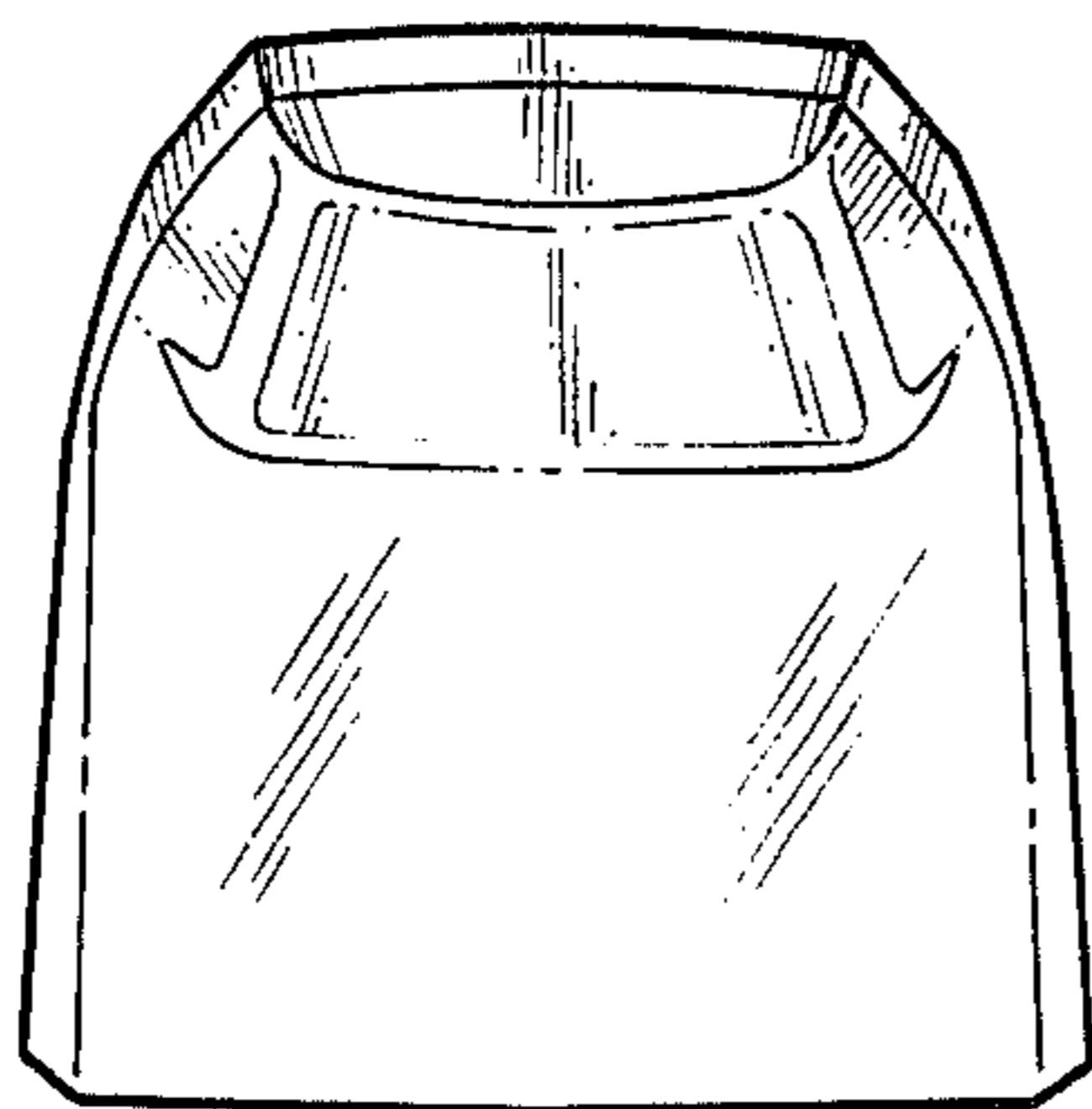

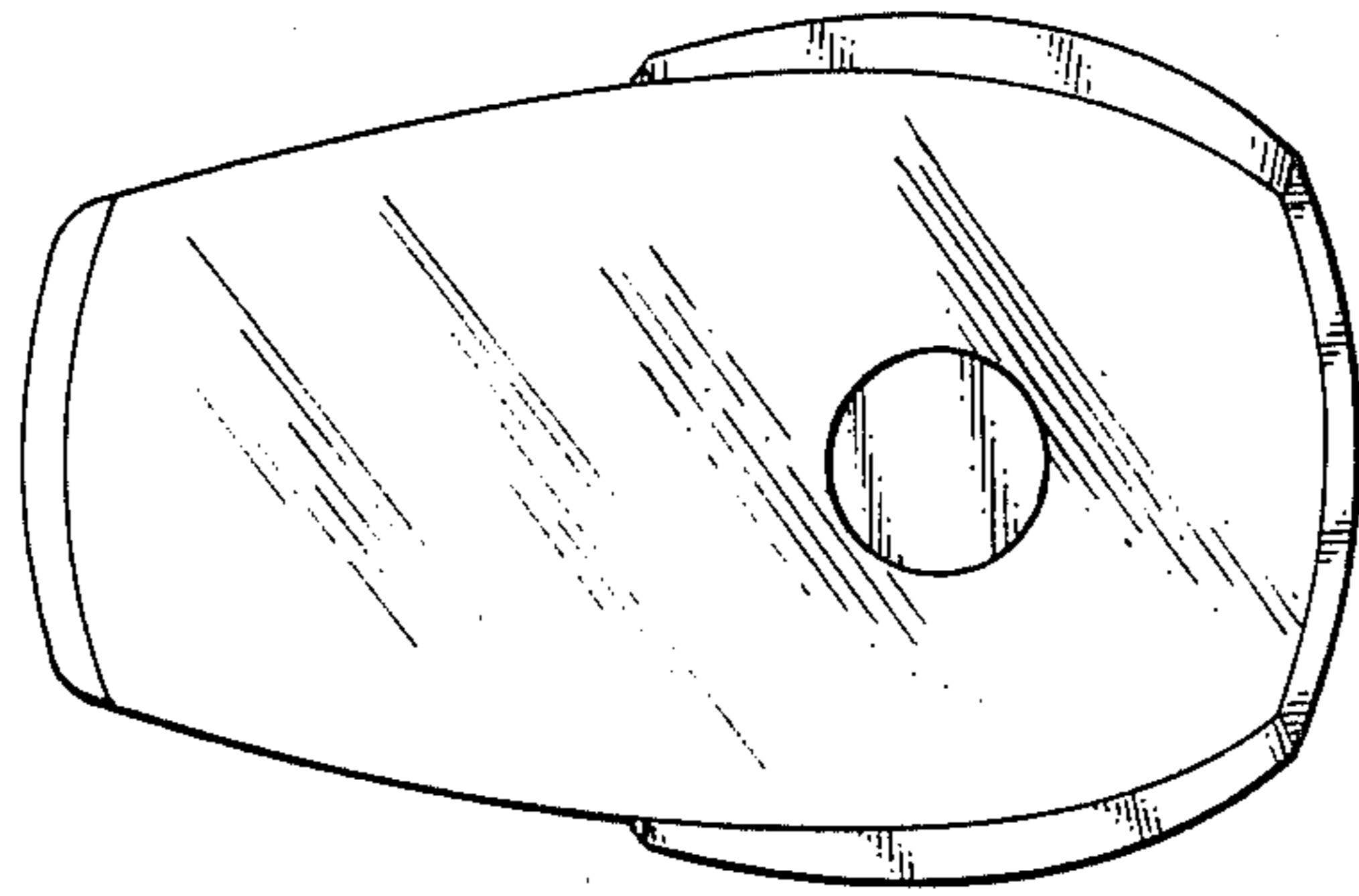

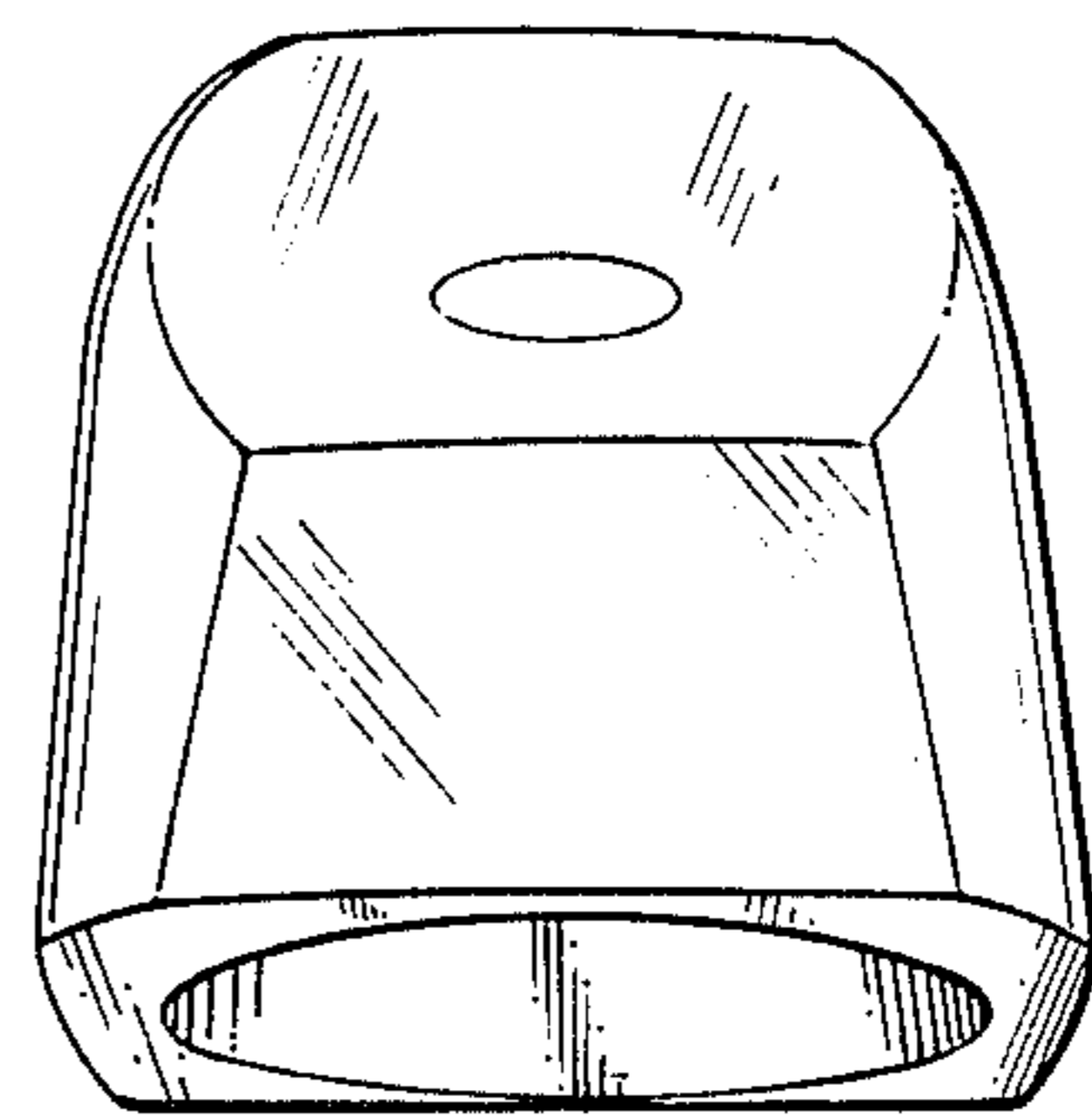

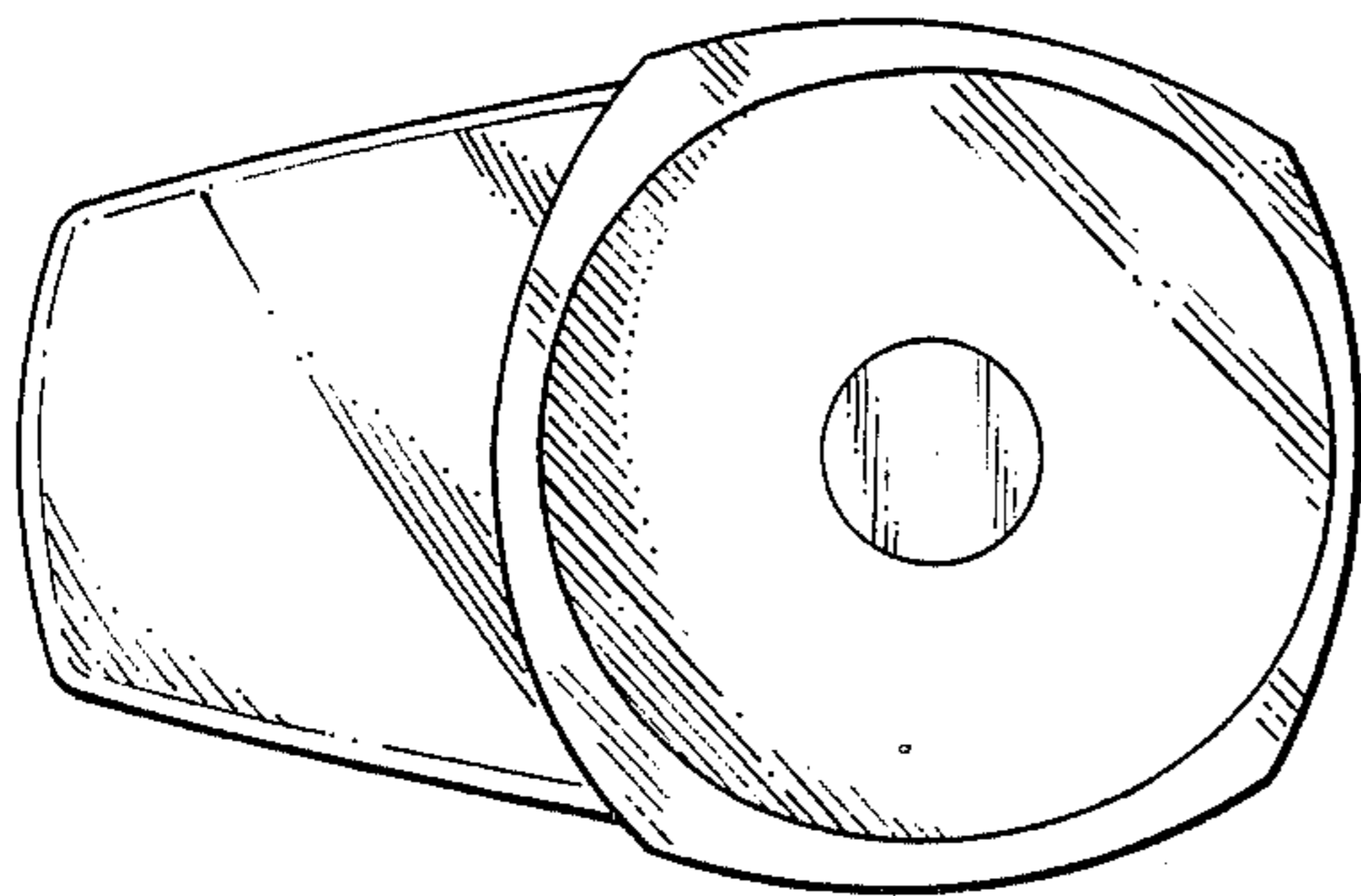
