The showing of a cap in broken lines in all views is for illustrative purposes only.

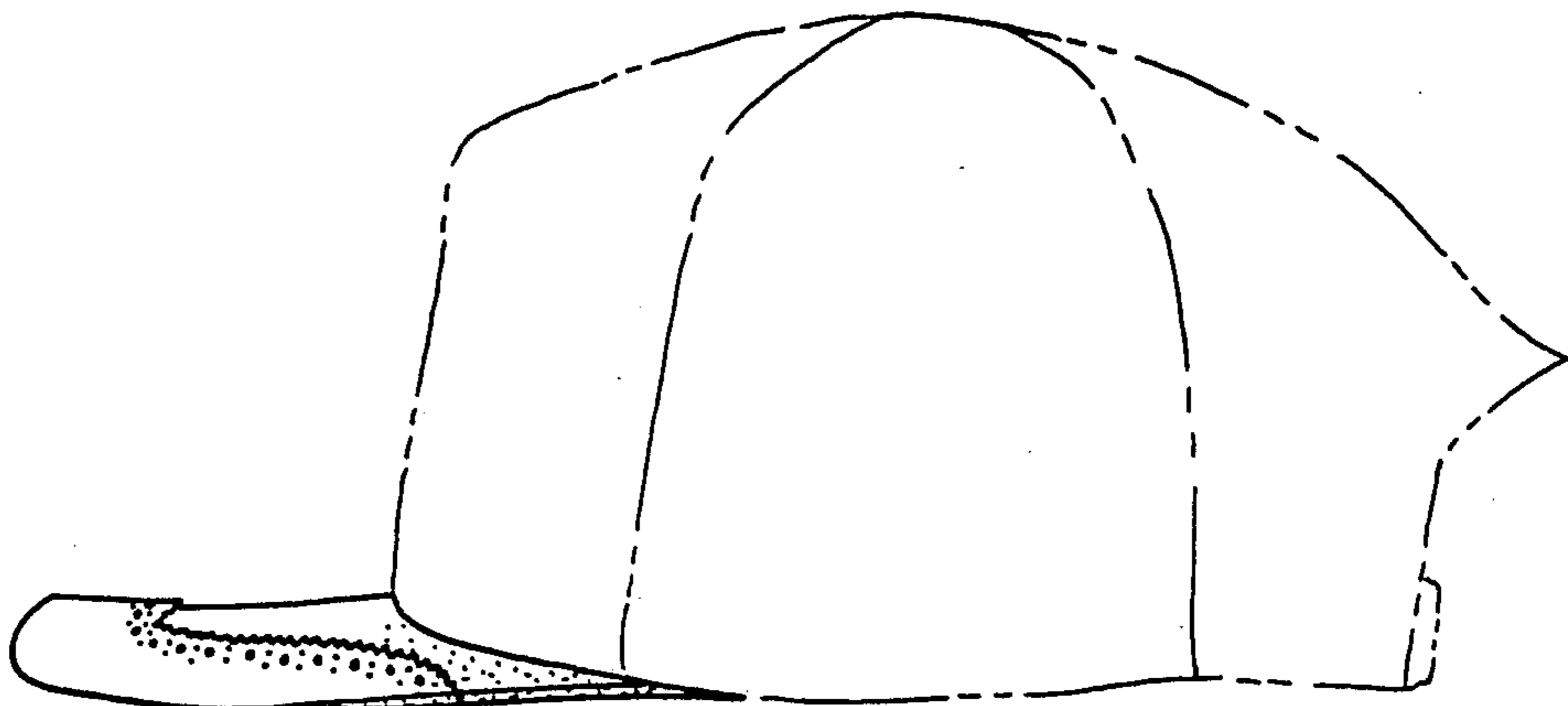
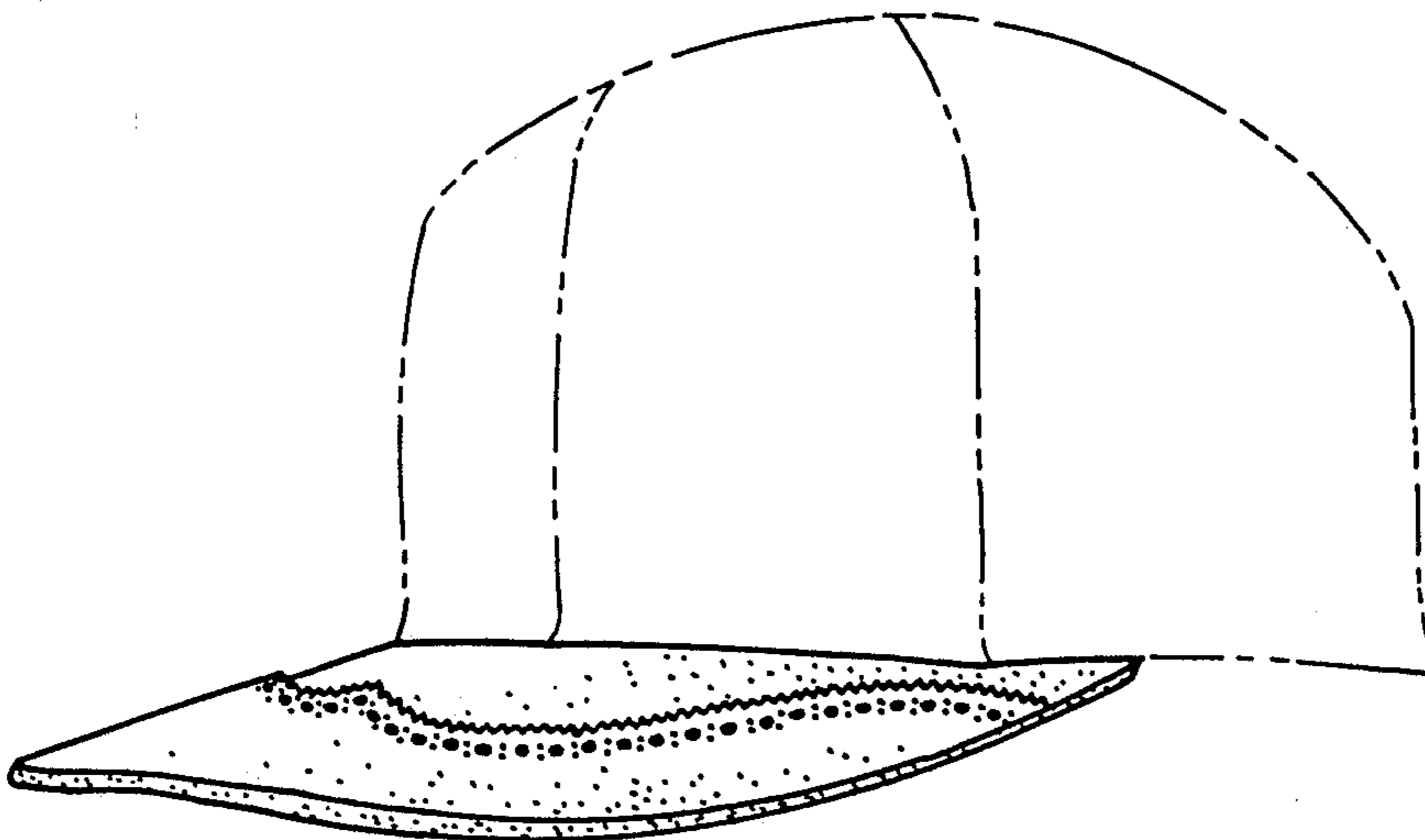

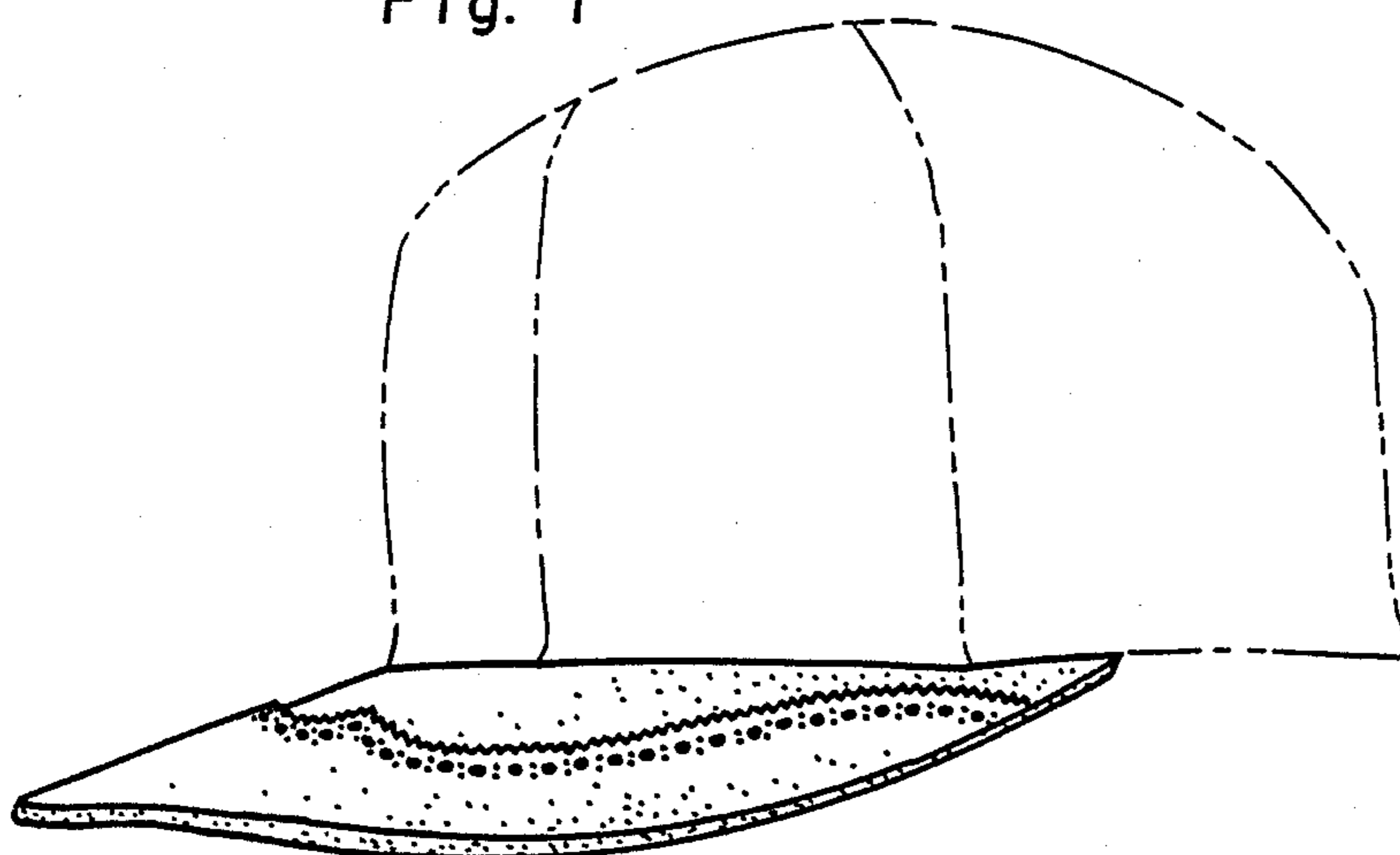

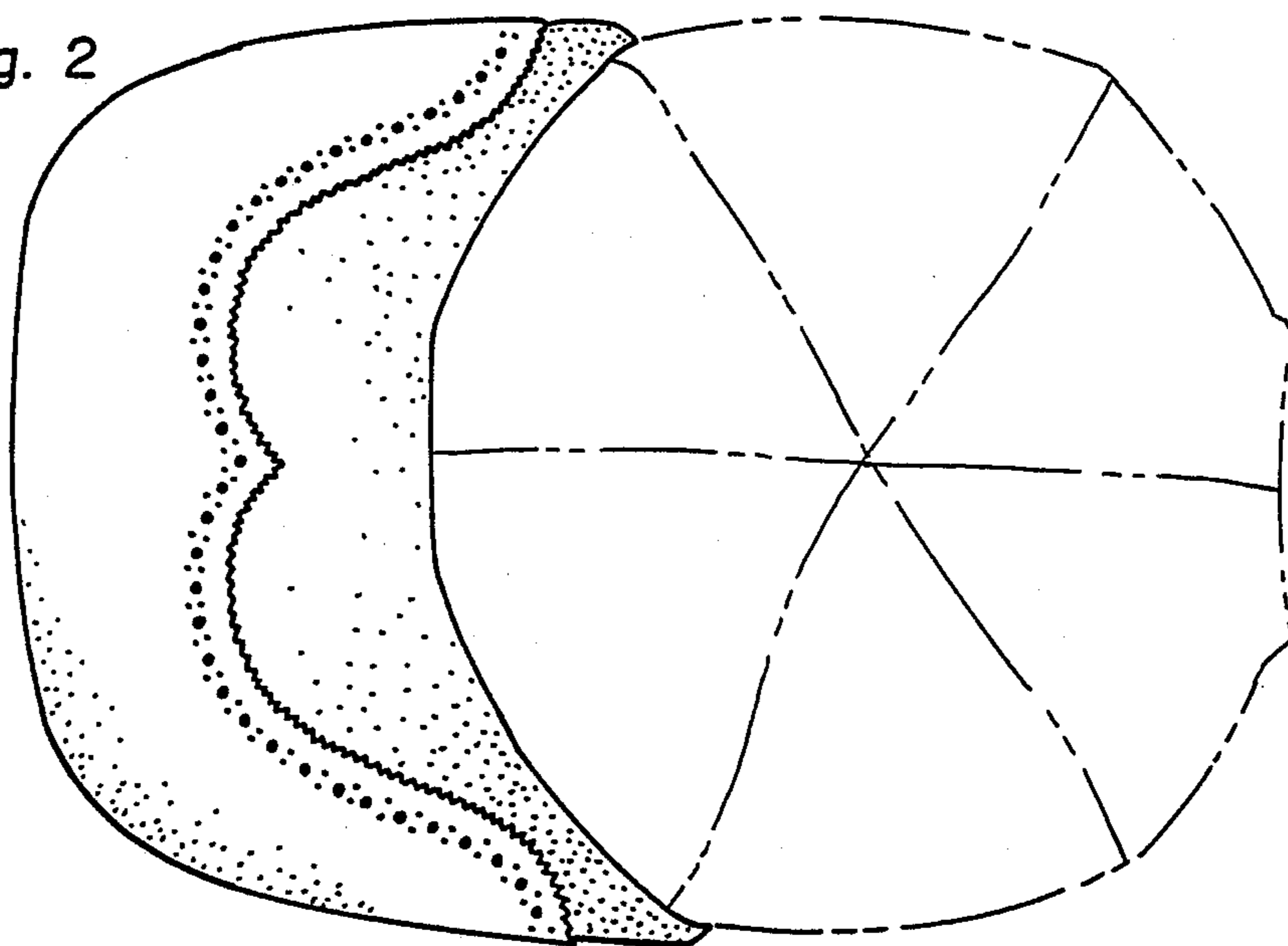

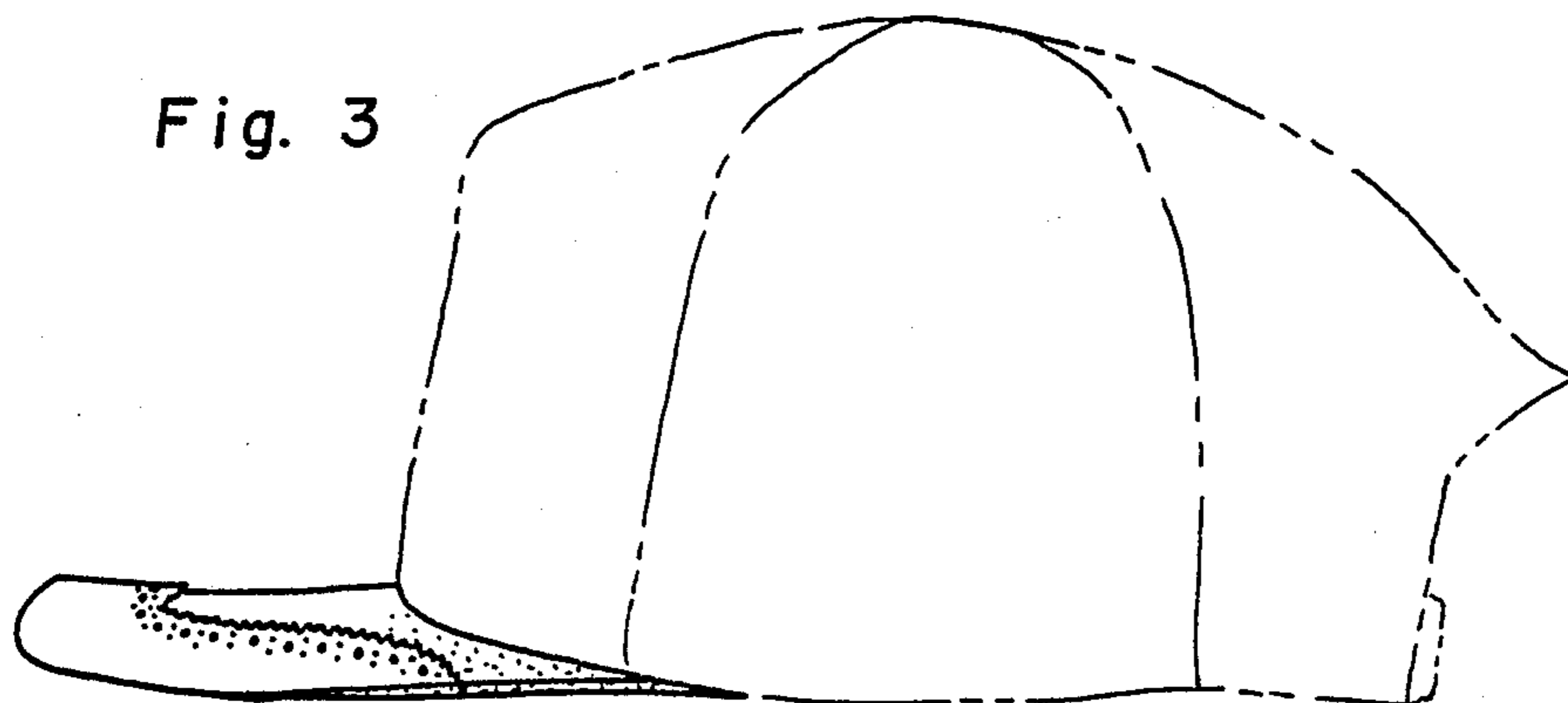

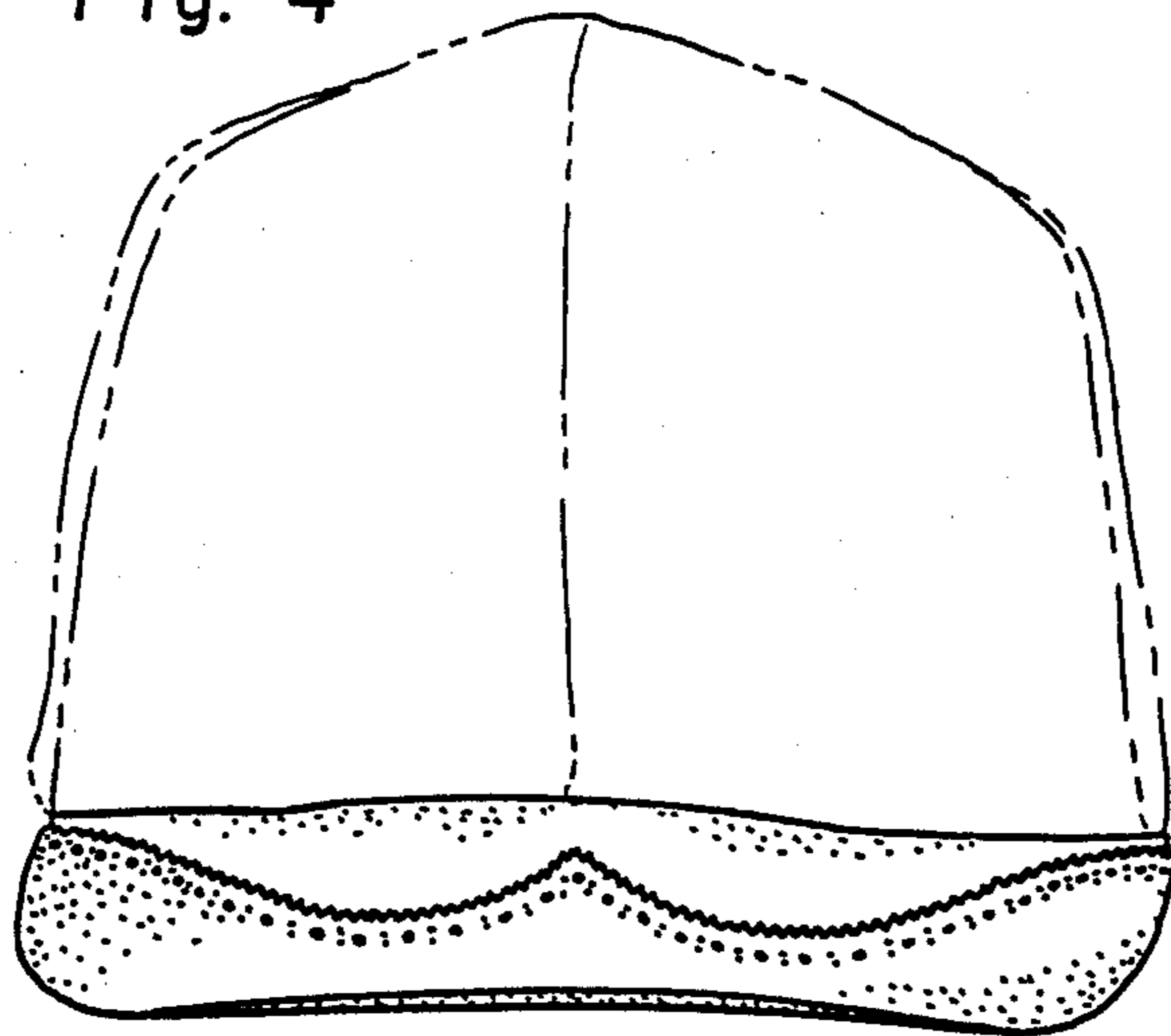
