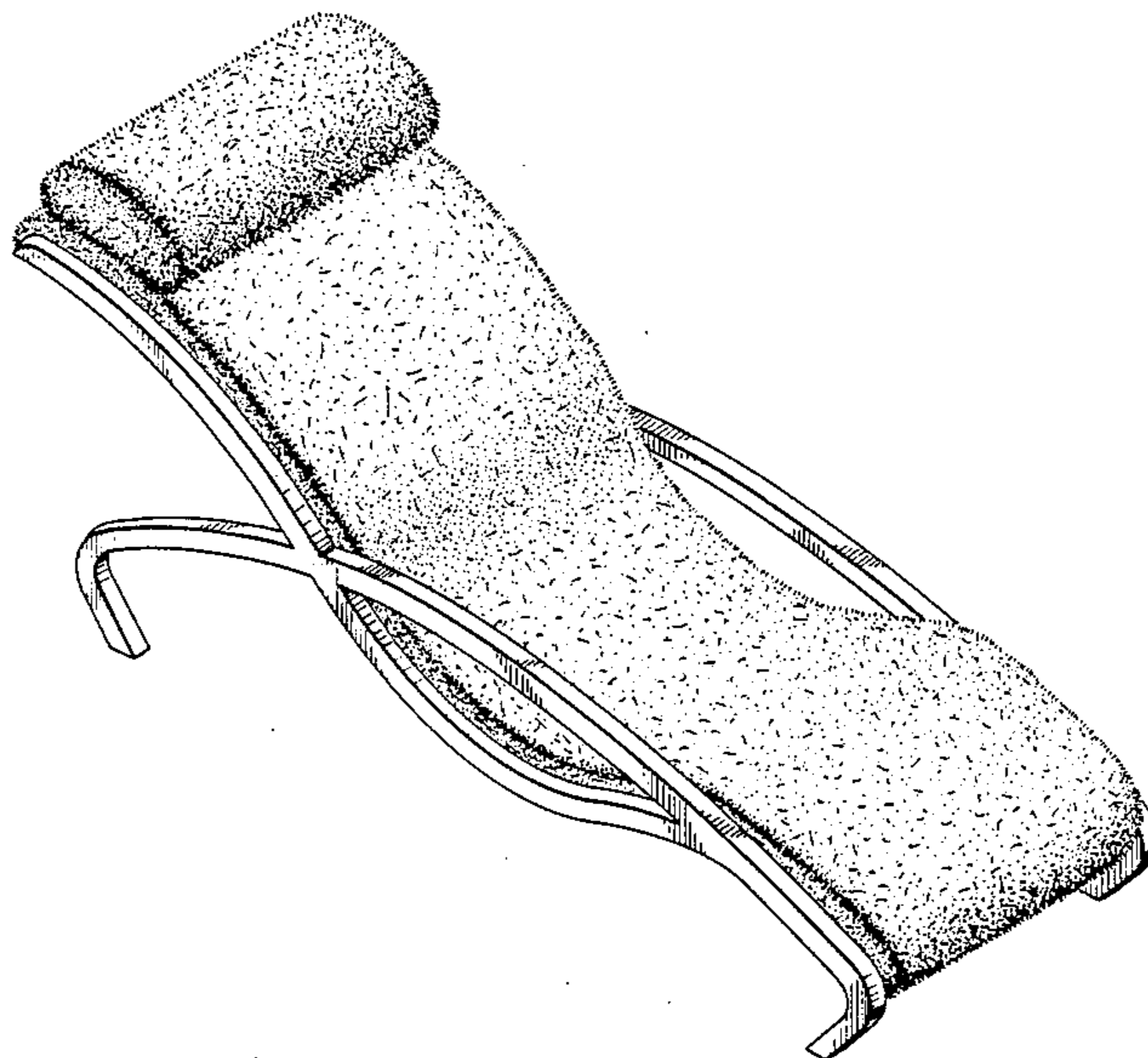

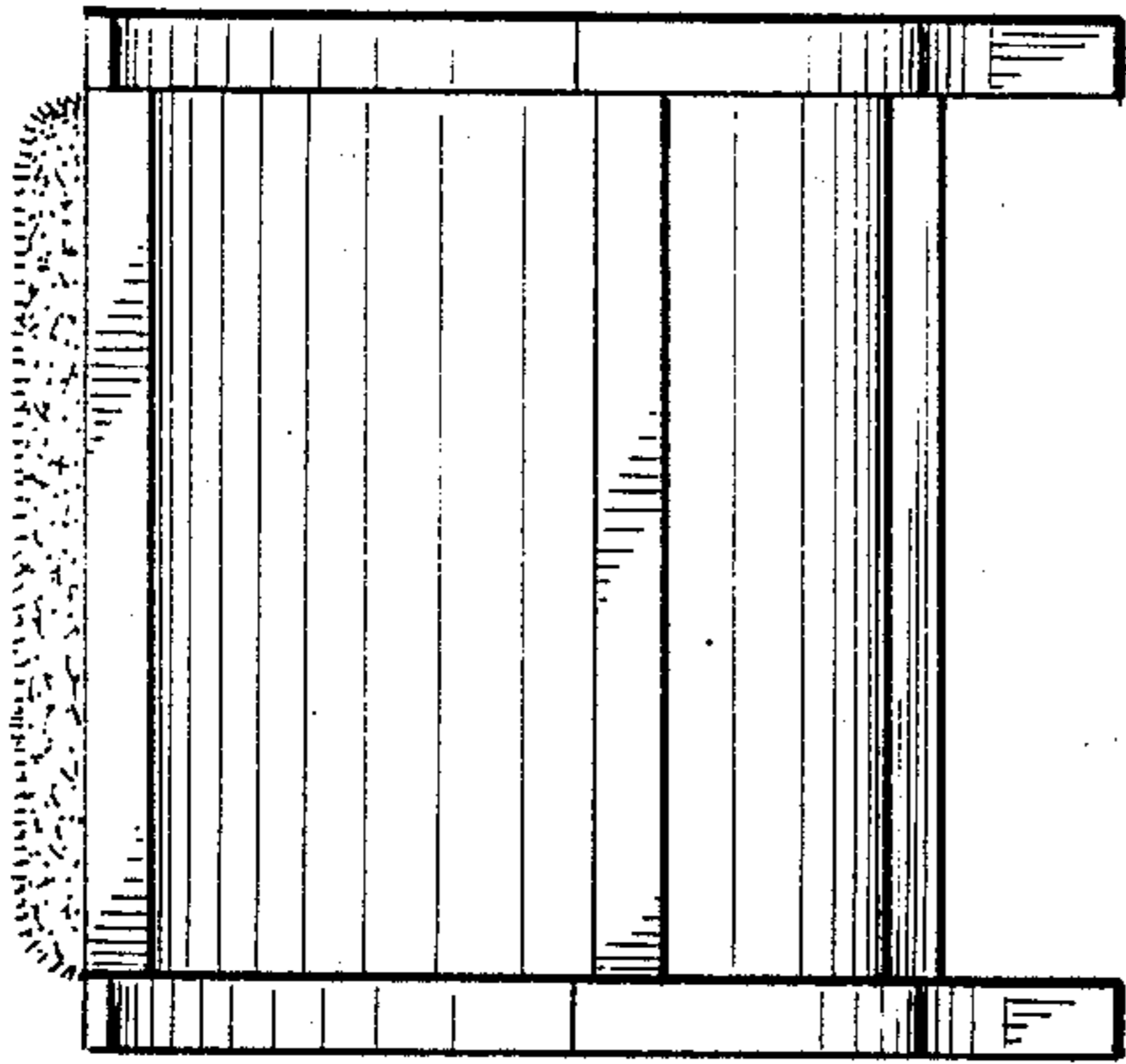
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chaise longue, as shown and described.

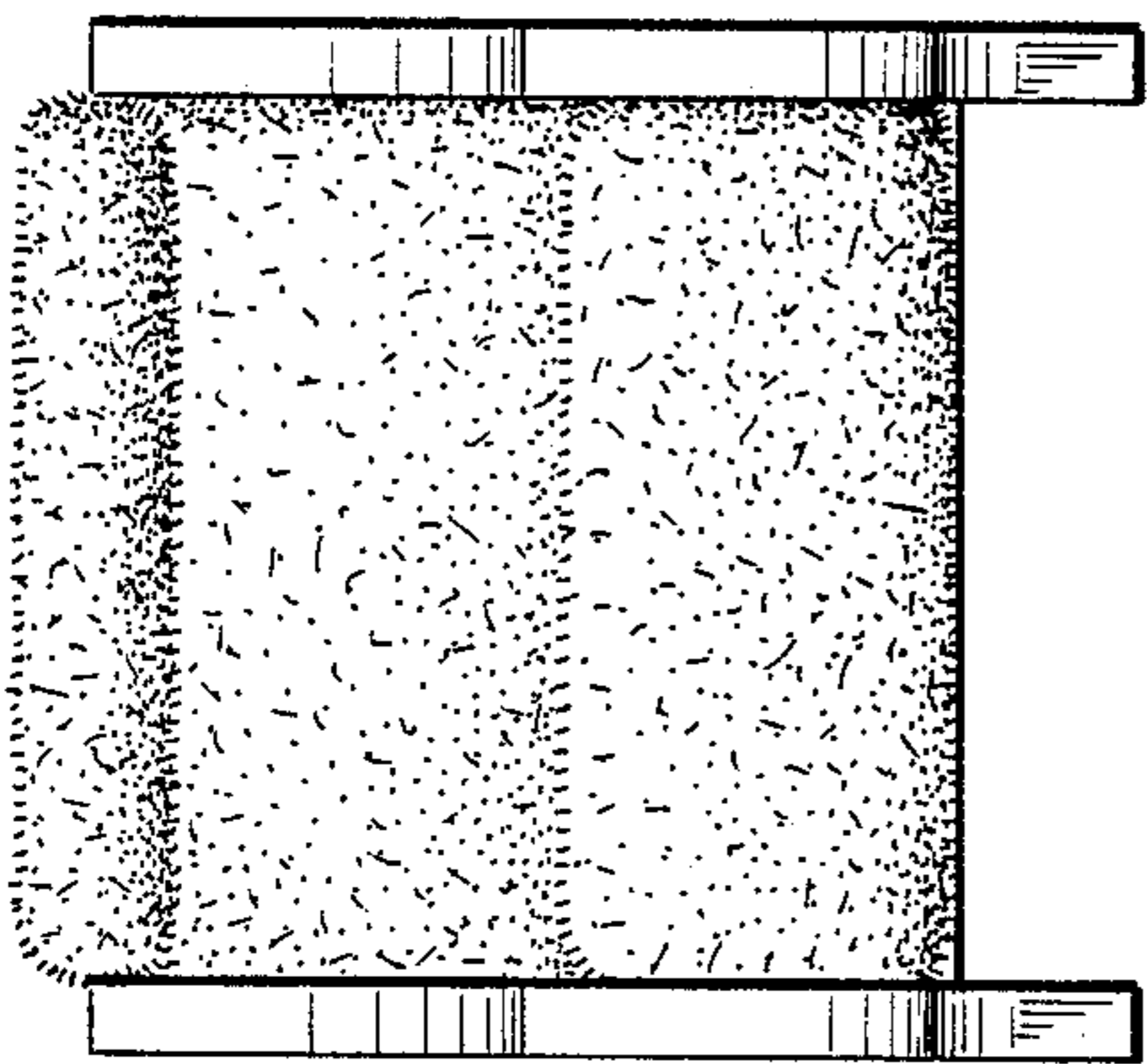
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chaise longue, showing my design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

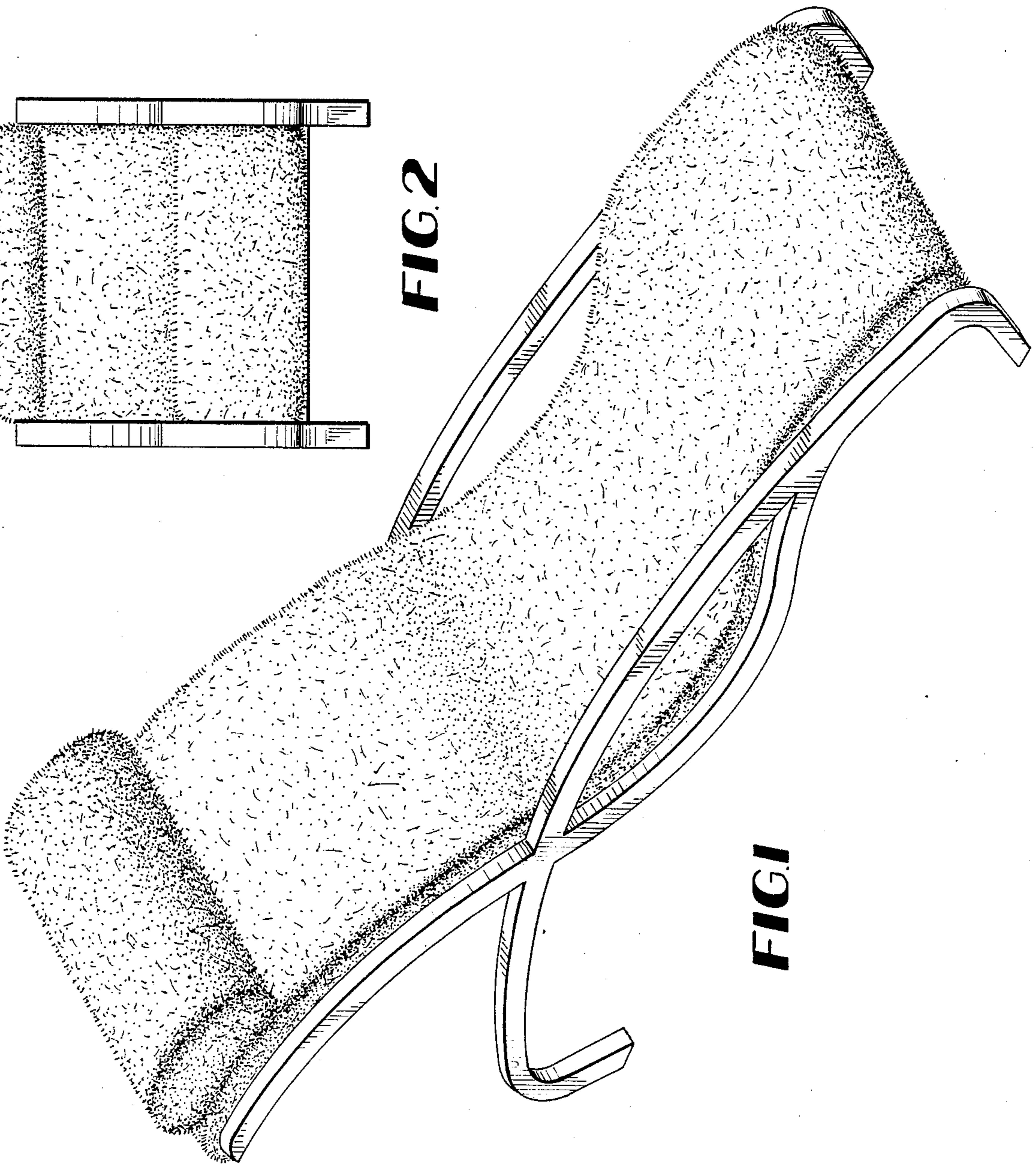

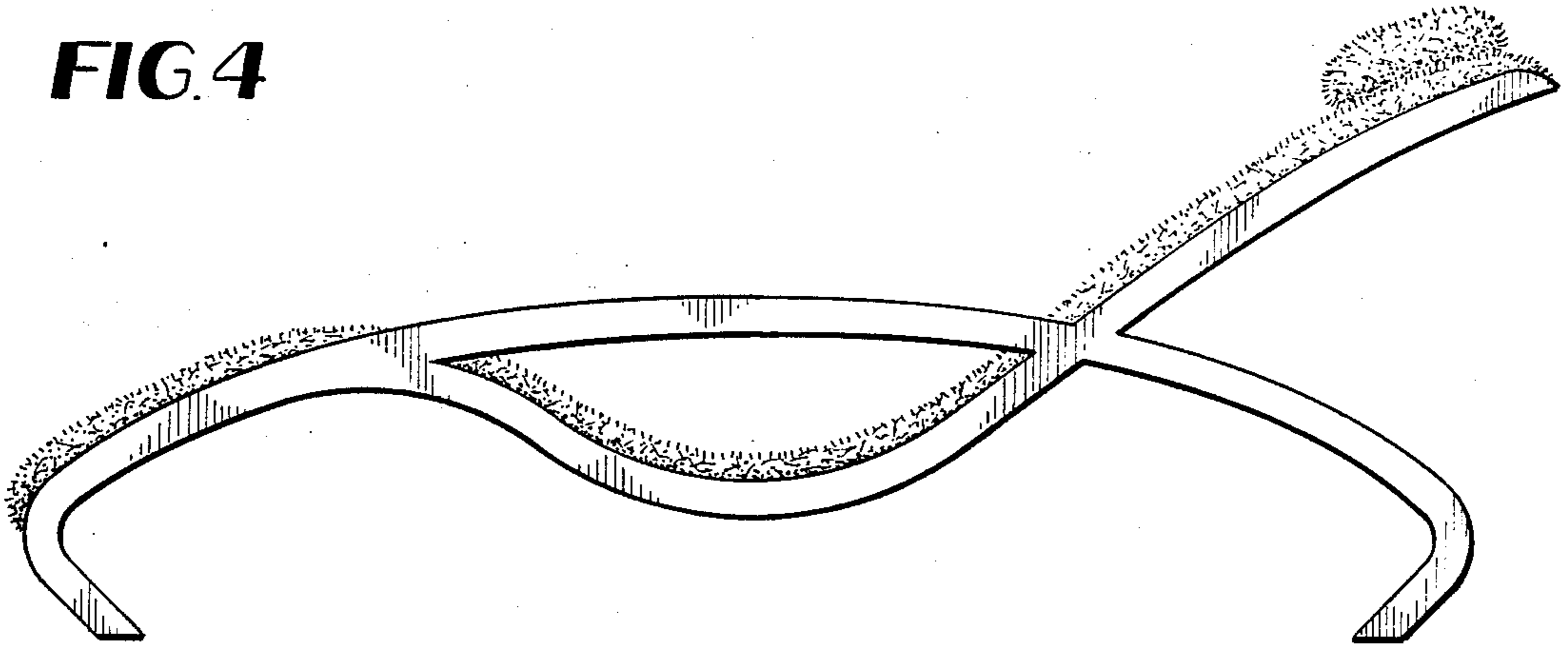

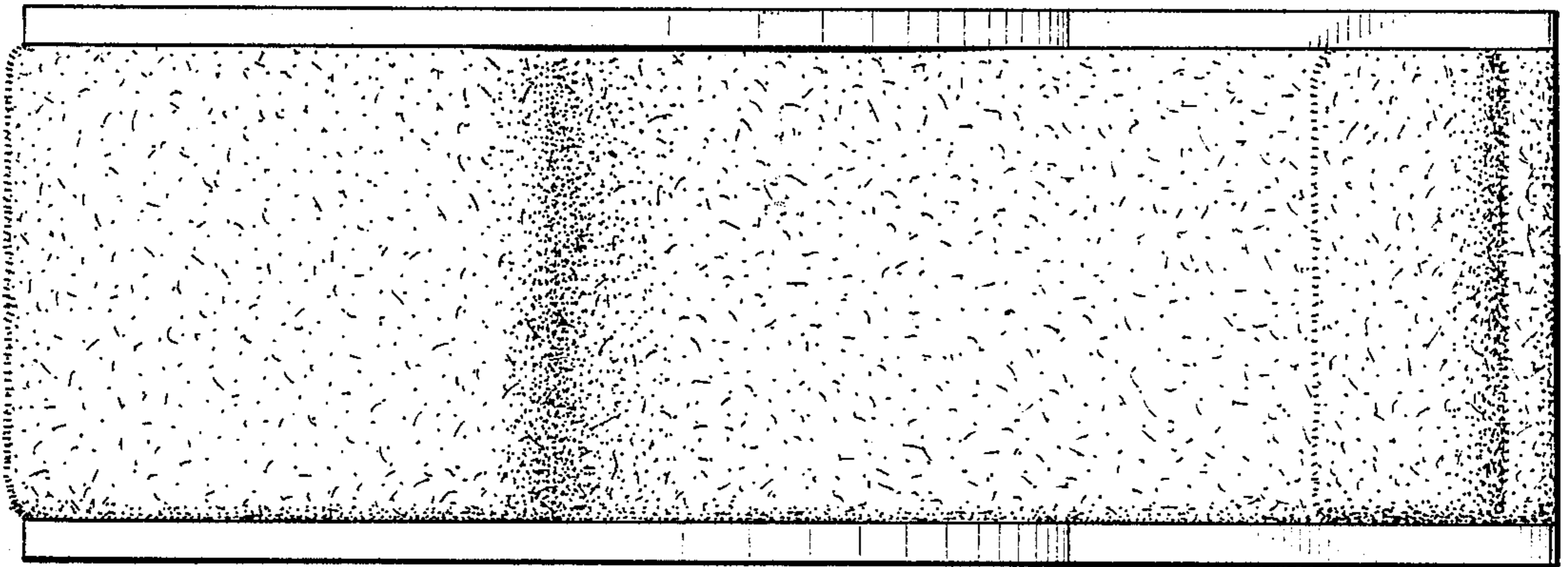
