DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the fishing lure with line and hook shown in phantom lines for environmental purpose;

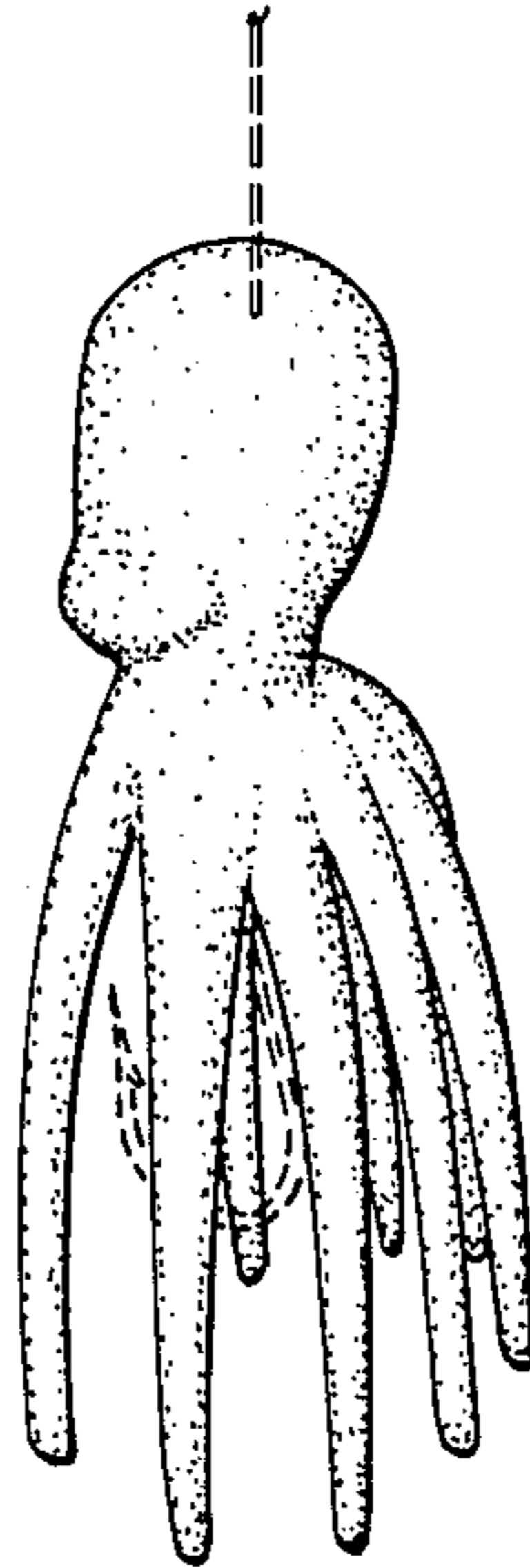
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the fishing lure.



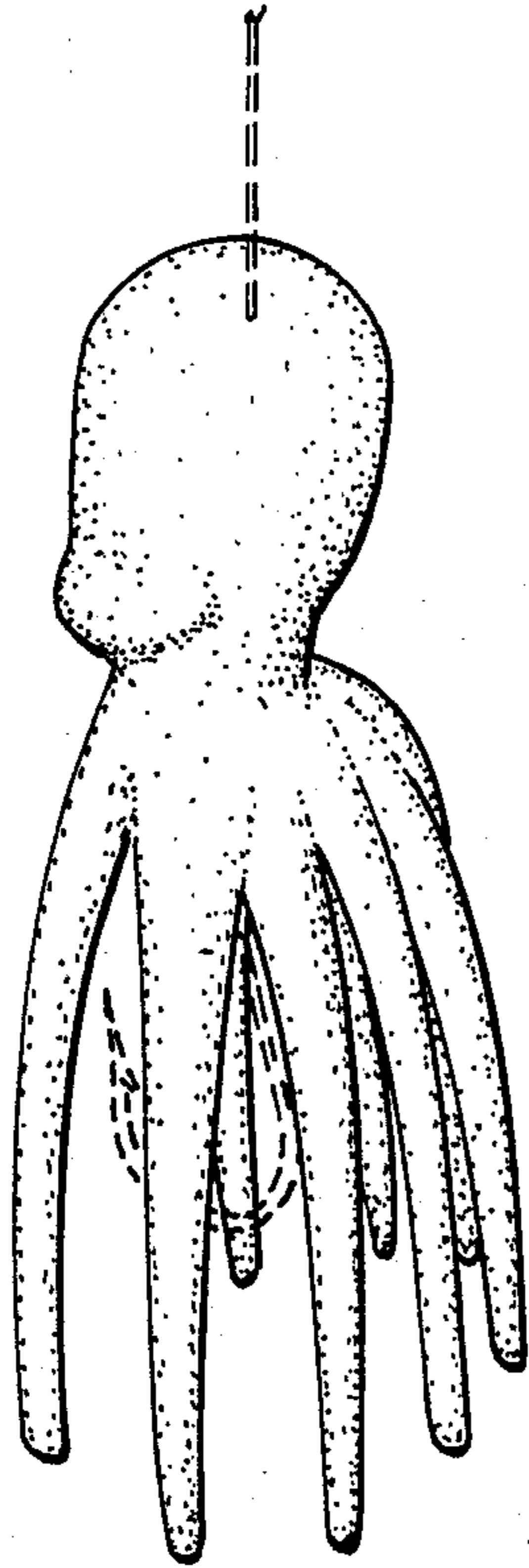

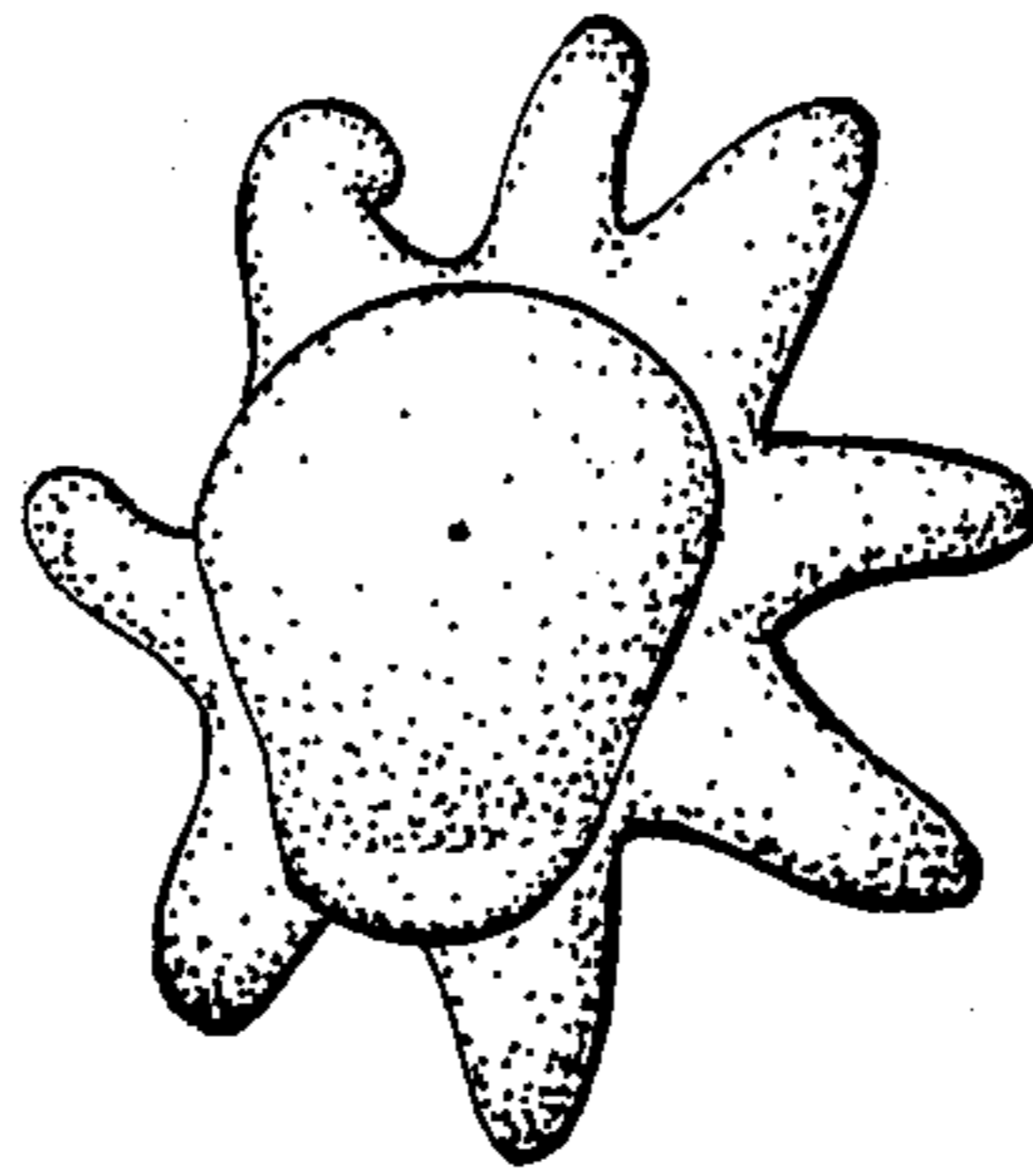

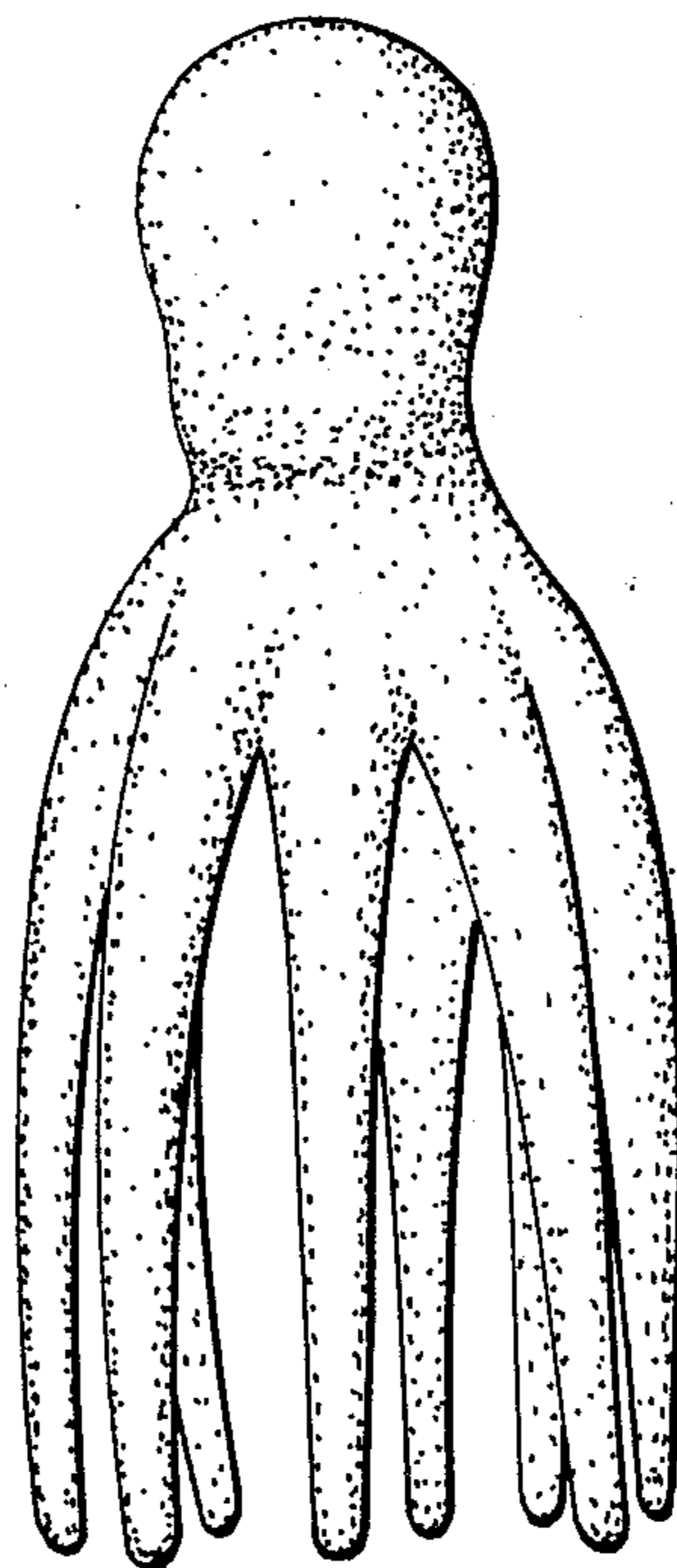

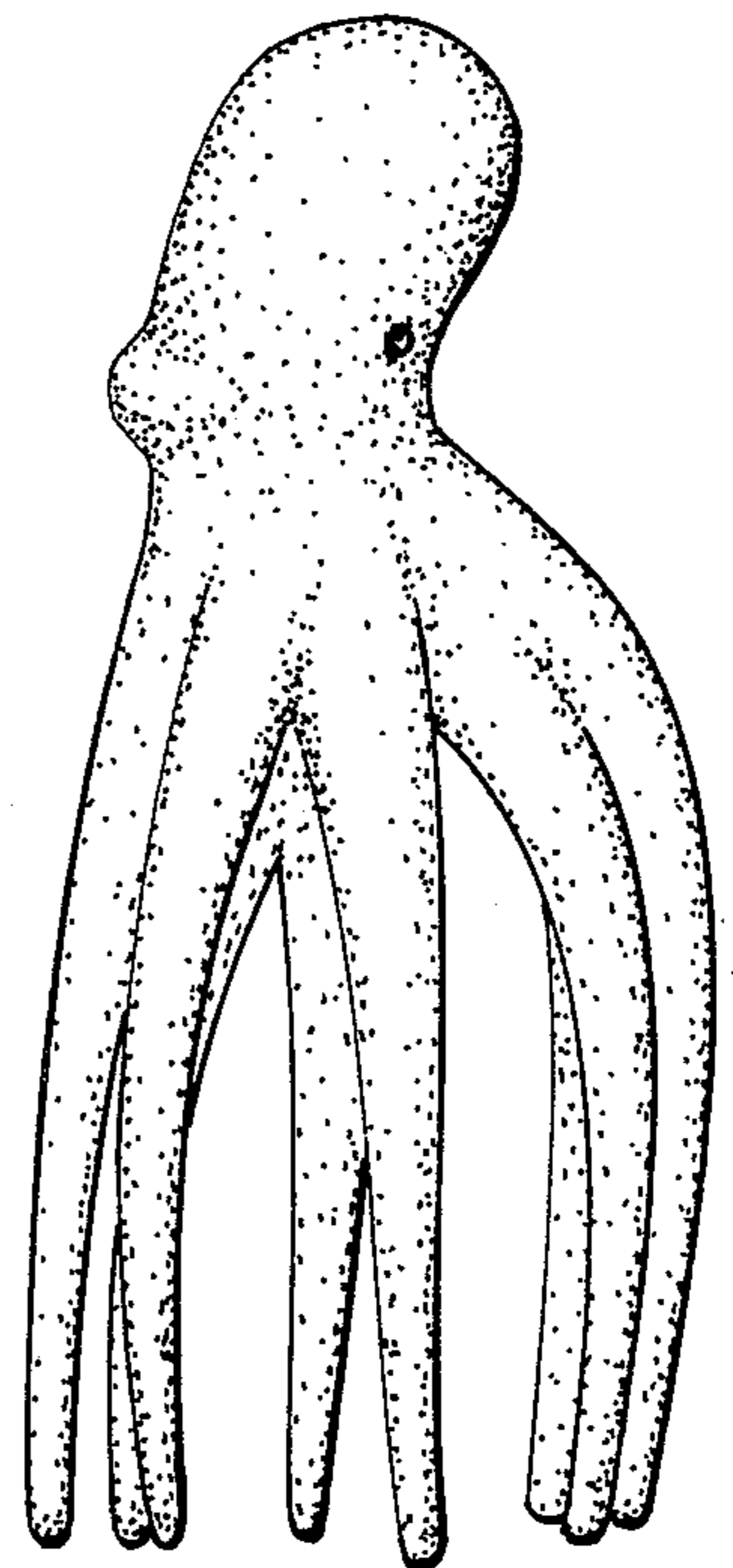

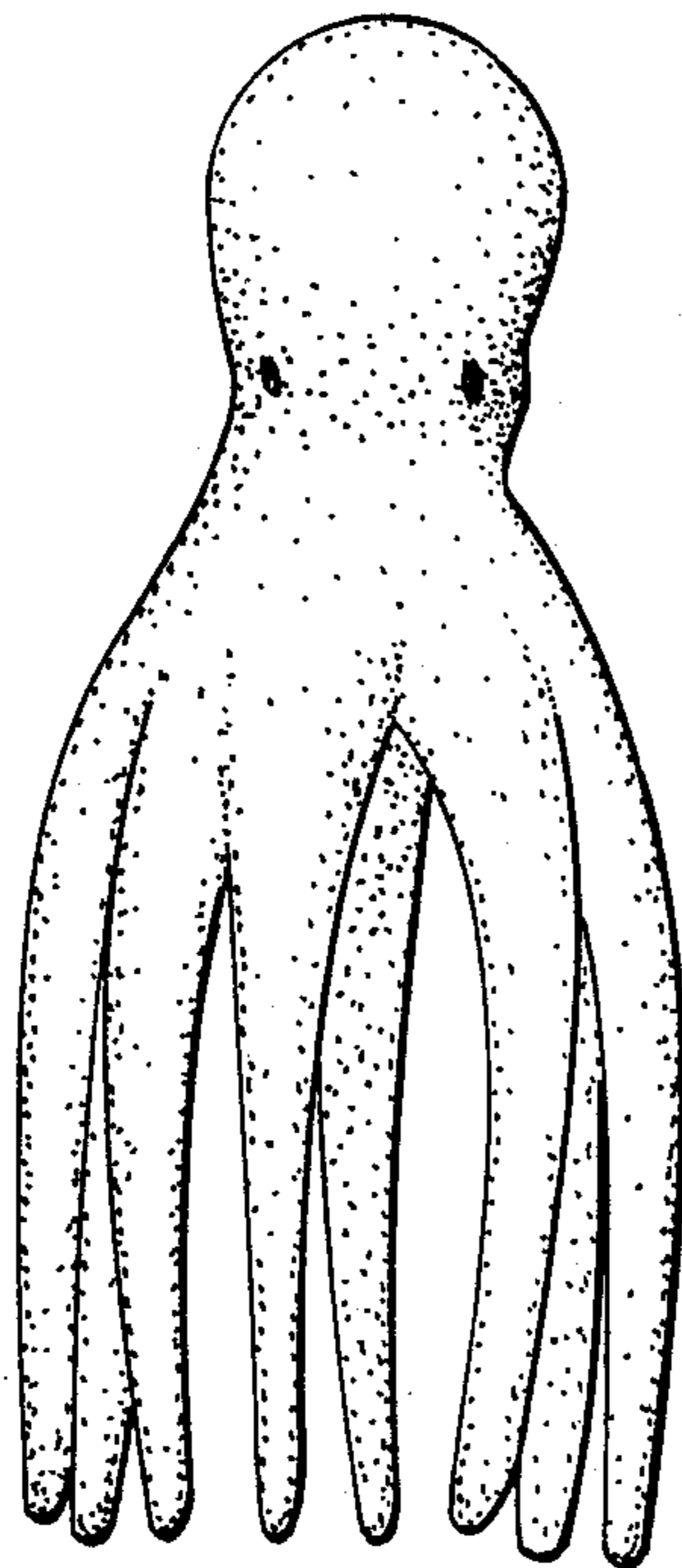

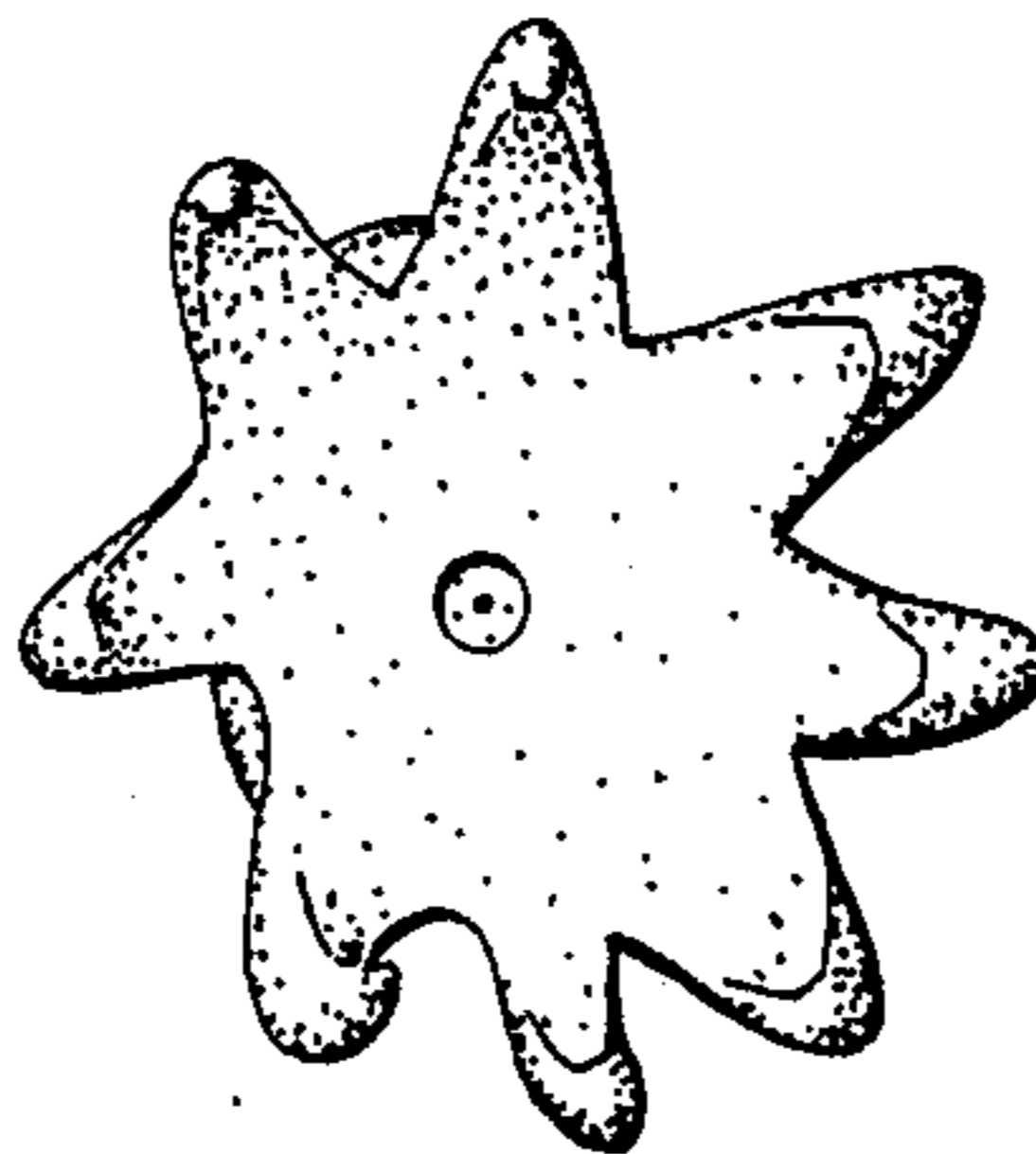
