The ornamental design for a foldable workstation, as shown.

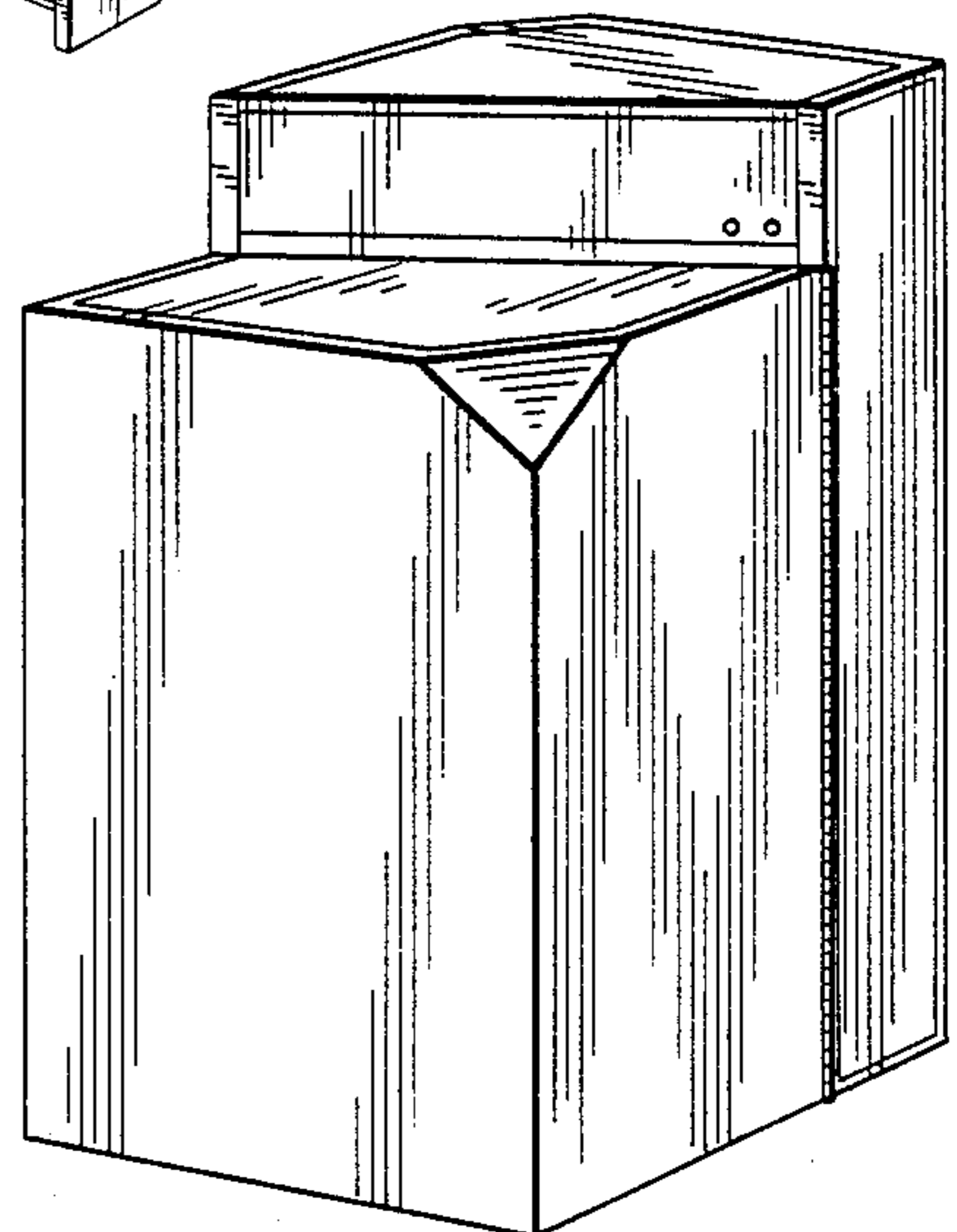
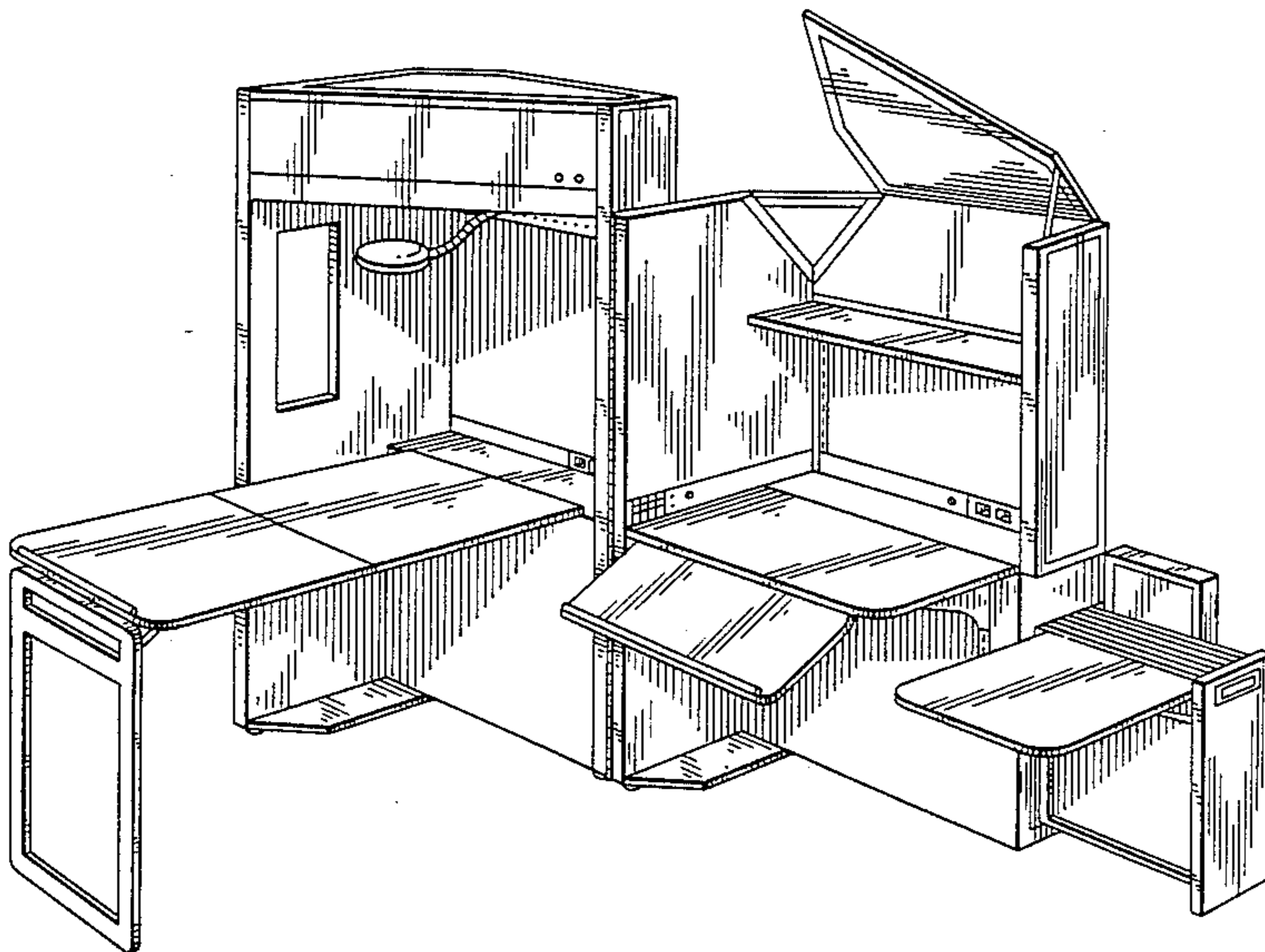
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.



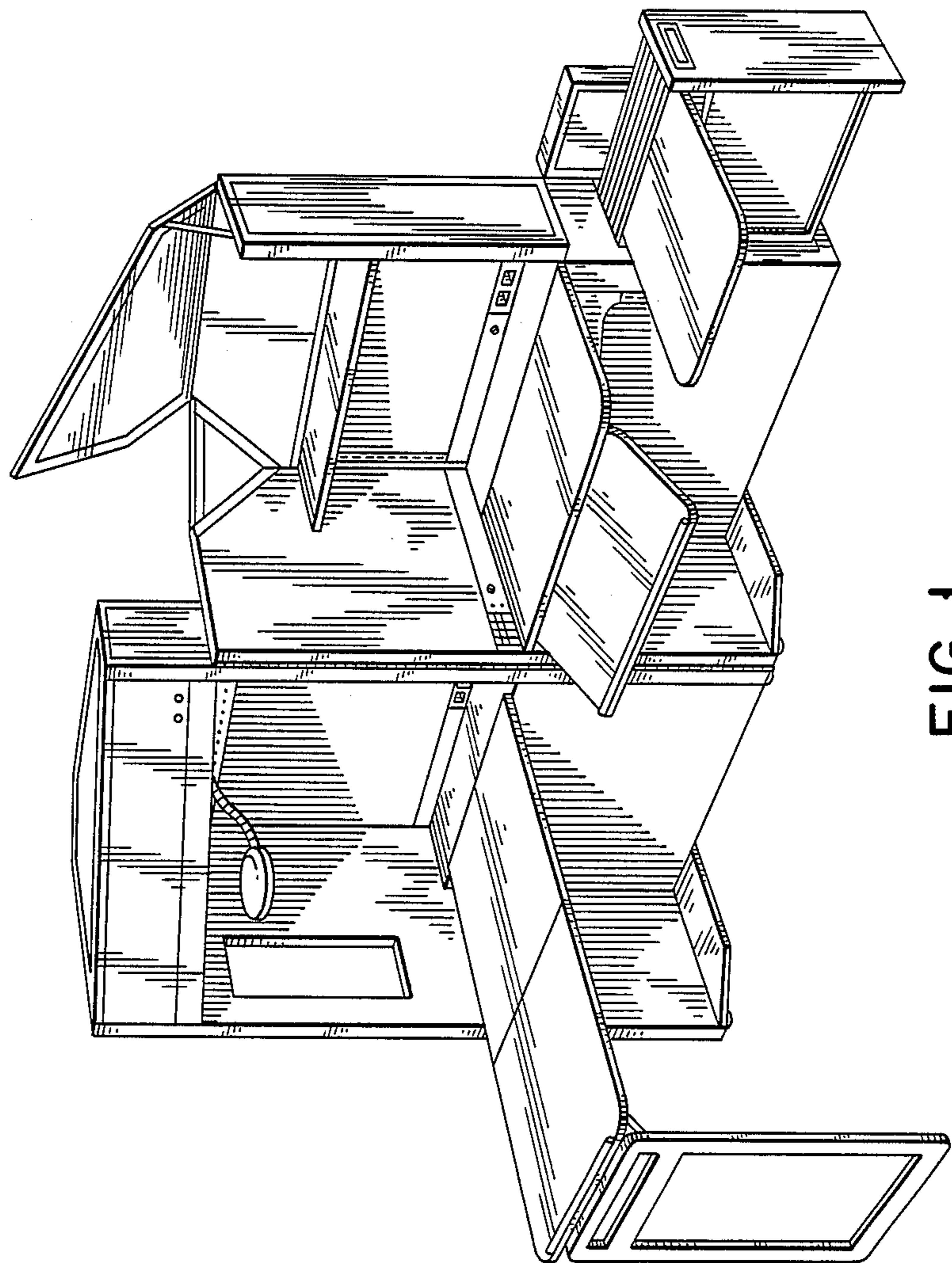

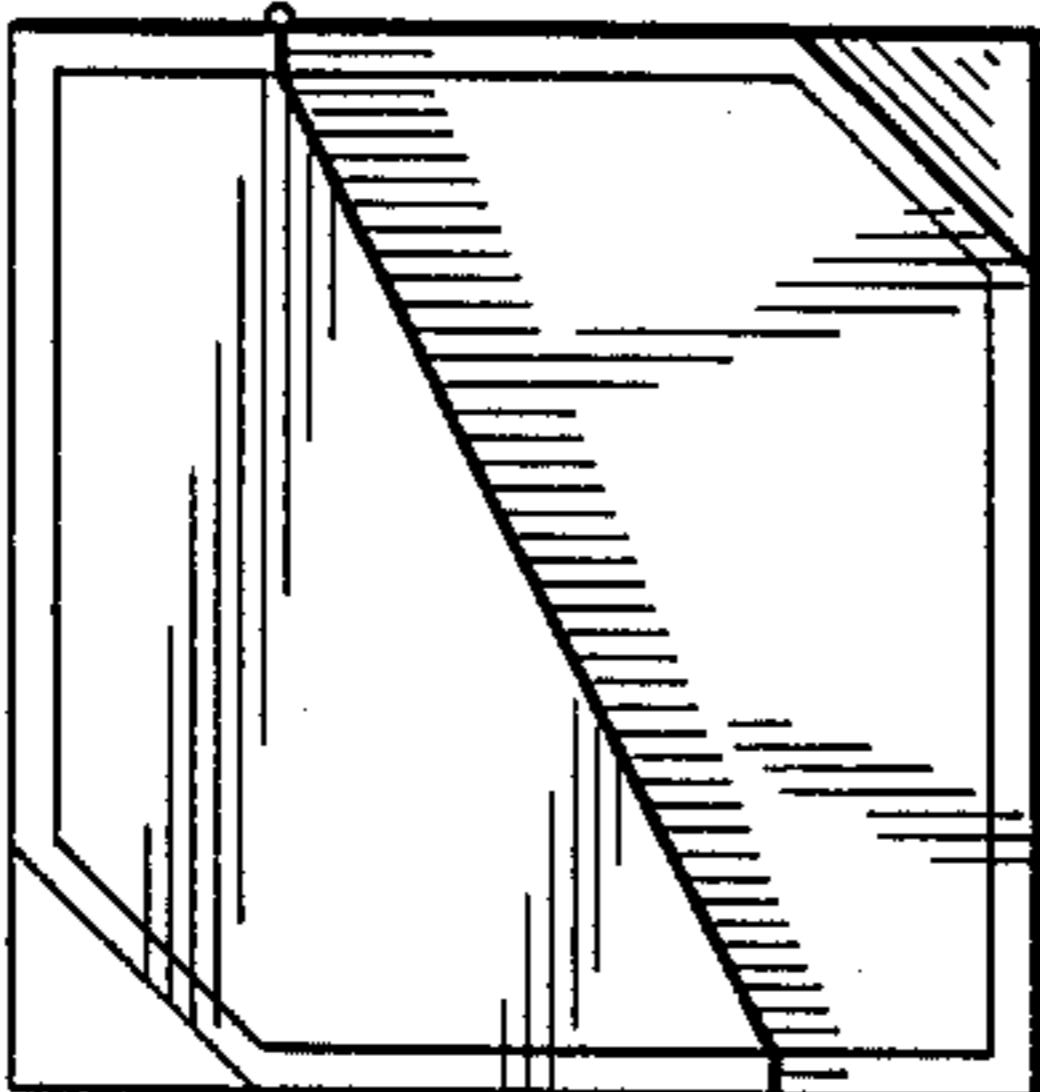

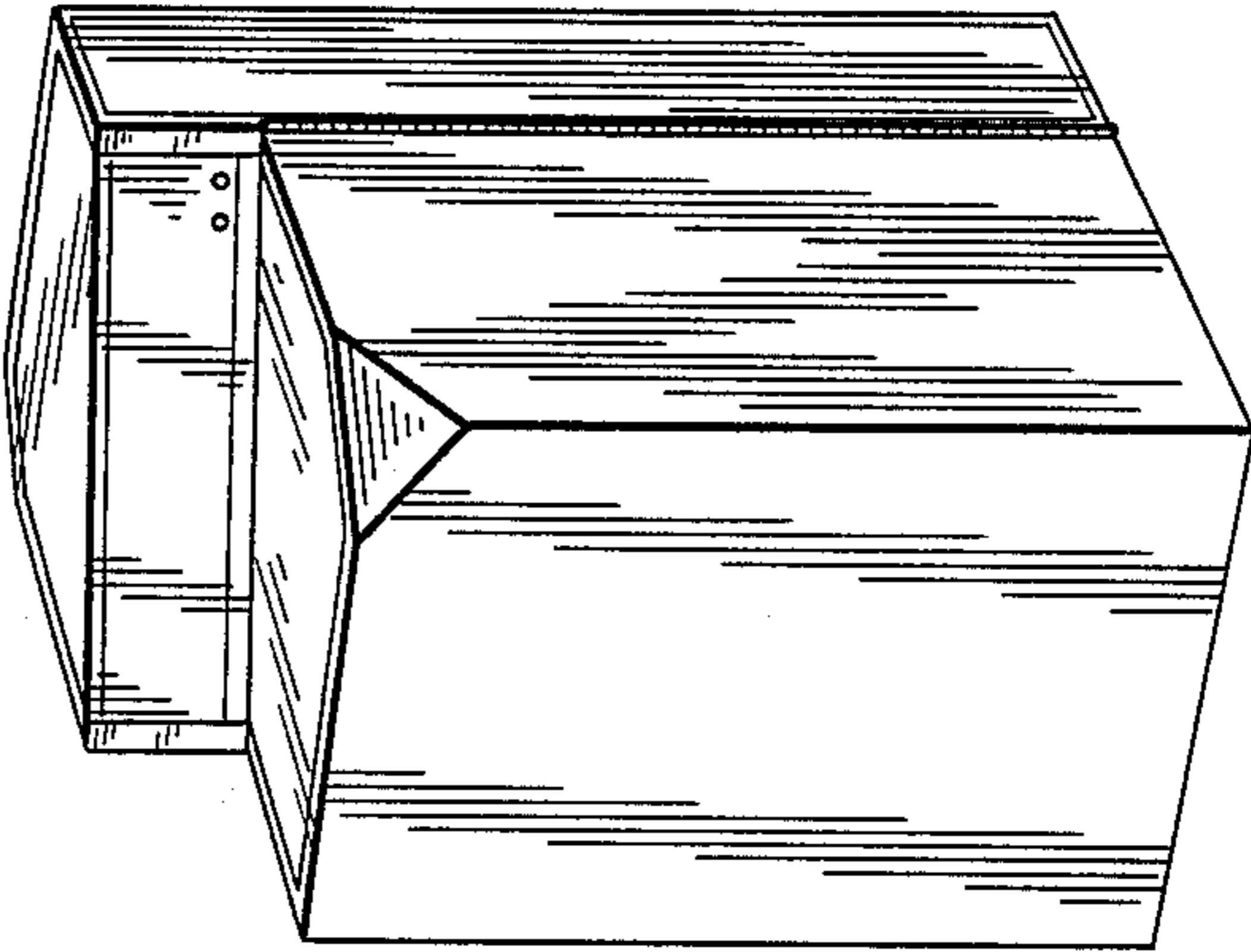

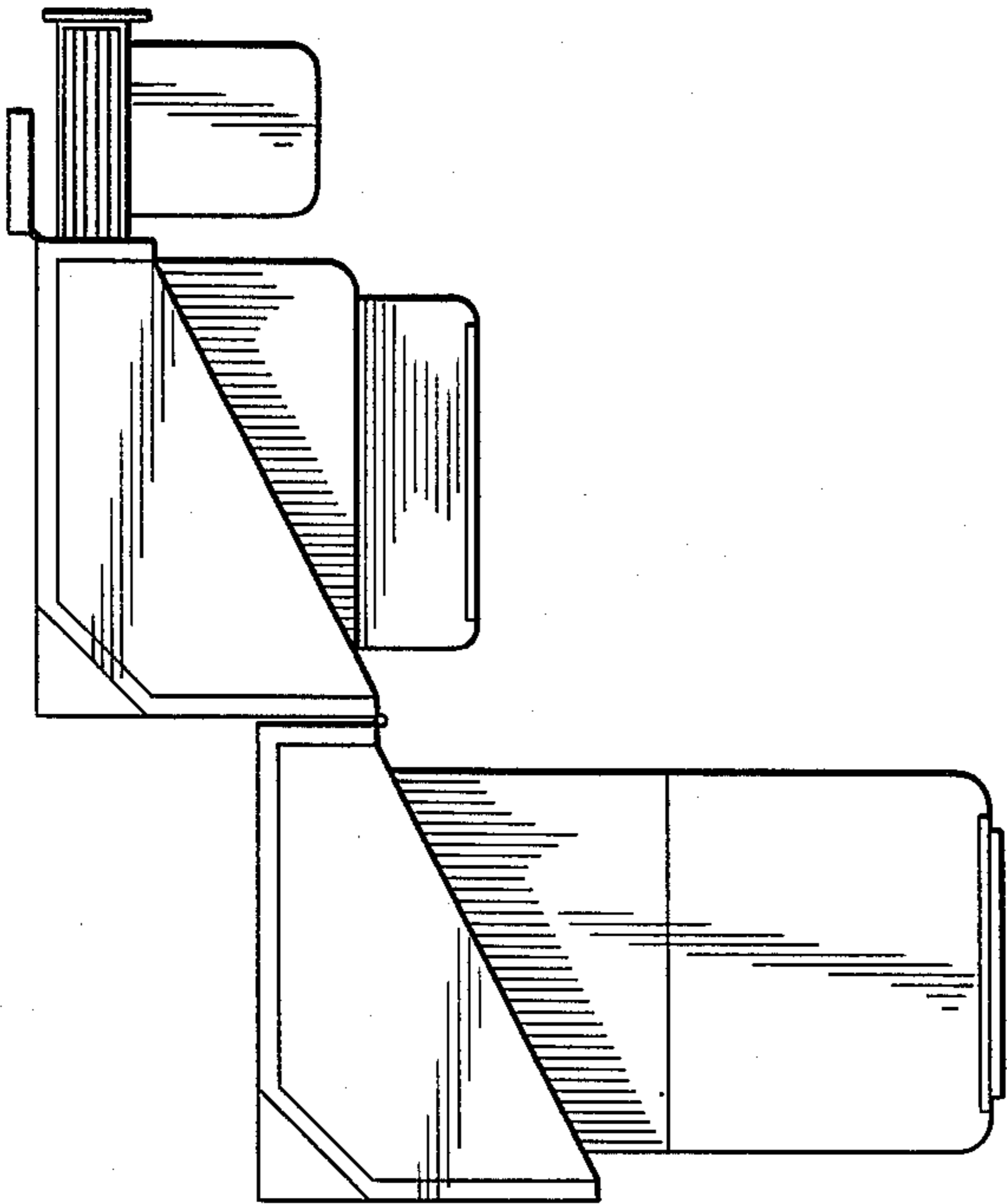
