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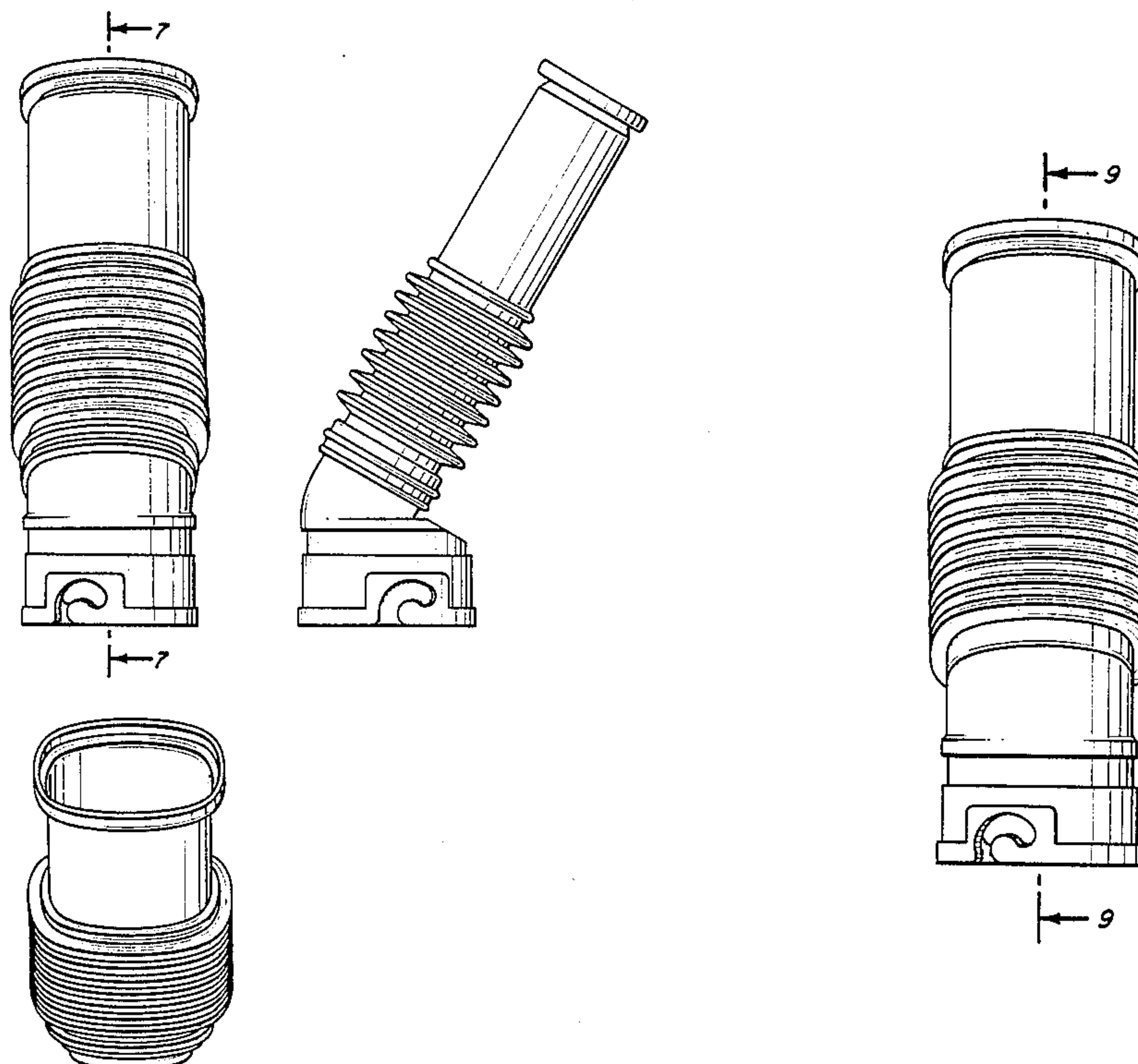

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vacuum cleaner hose coupling showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 9—9 in FIG. 8.



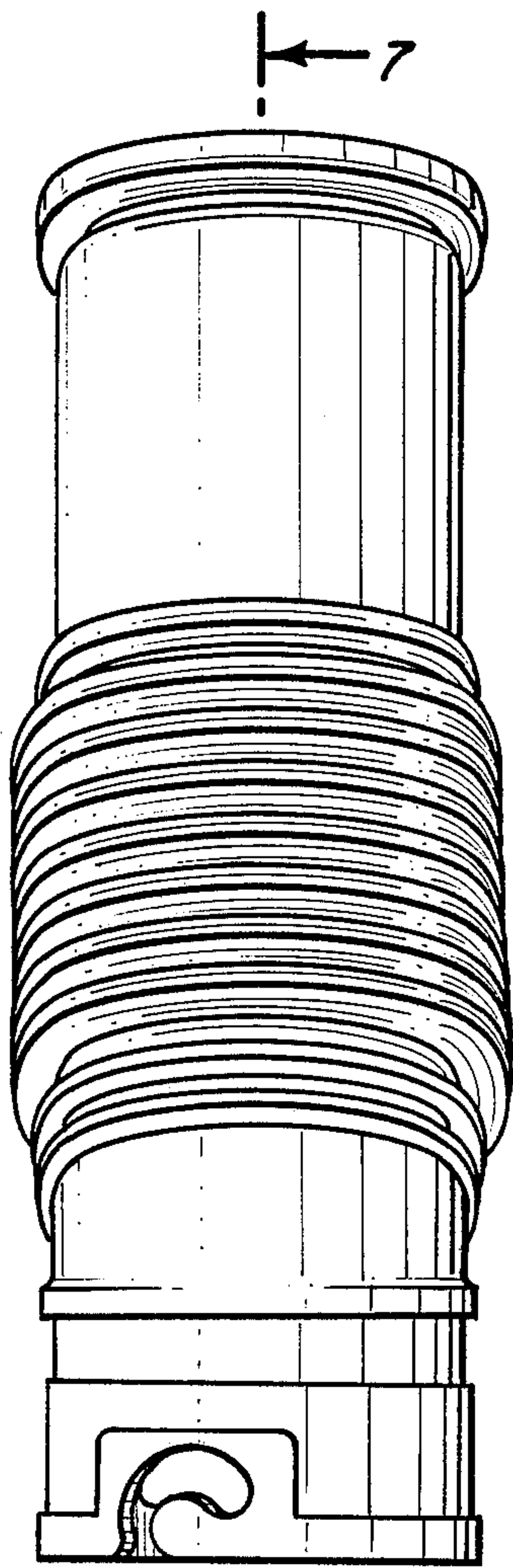

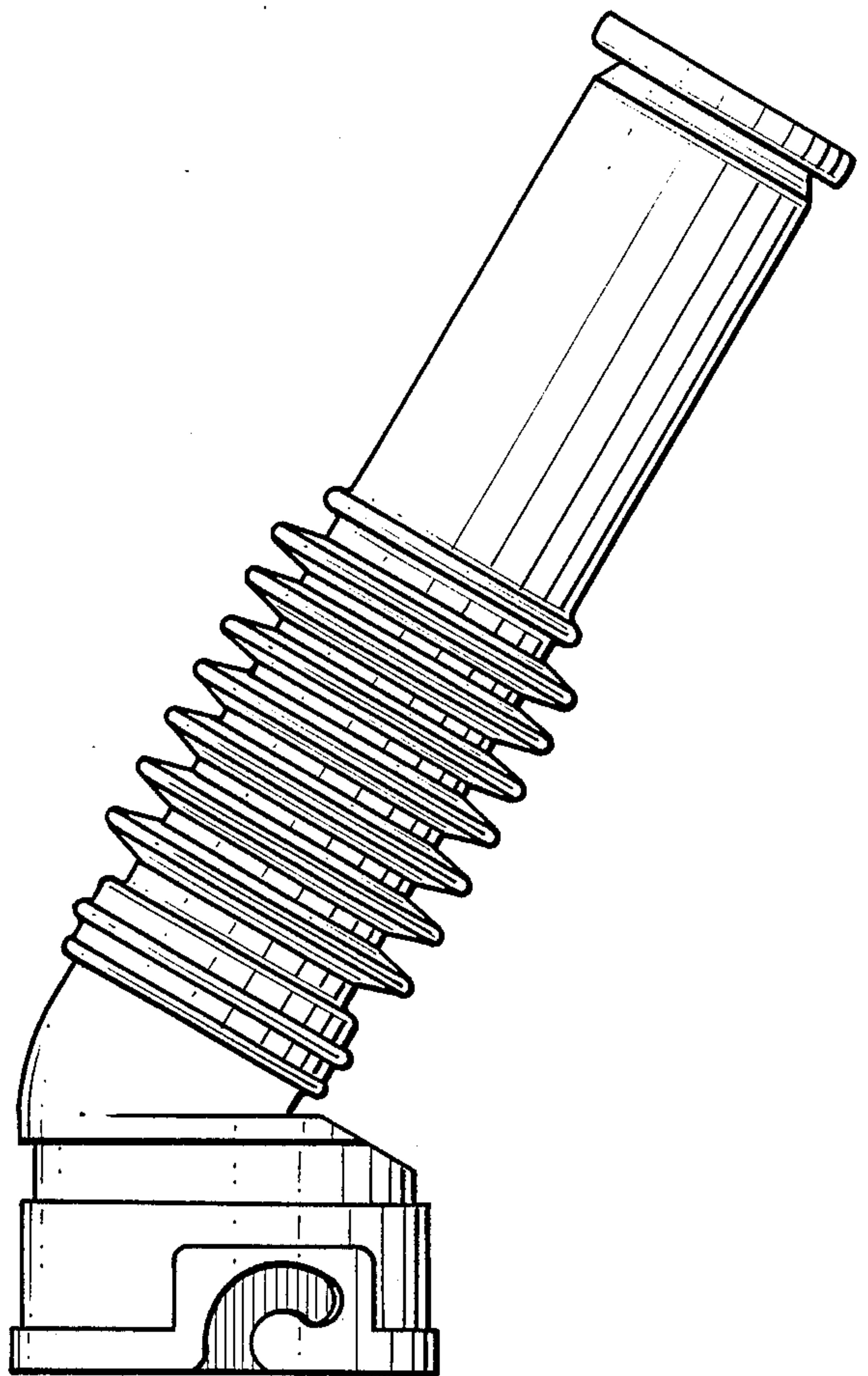

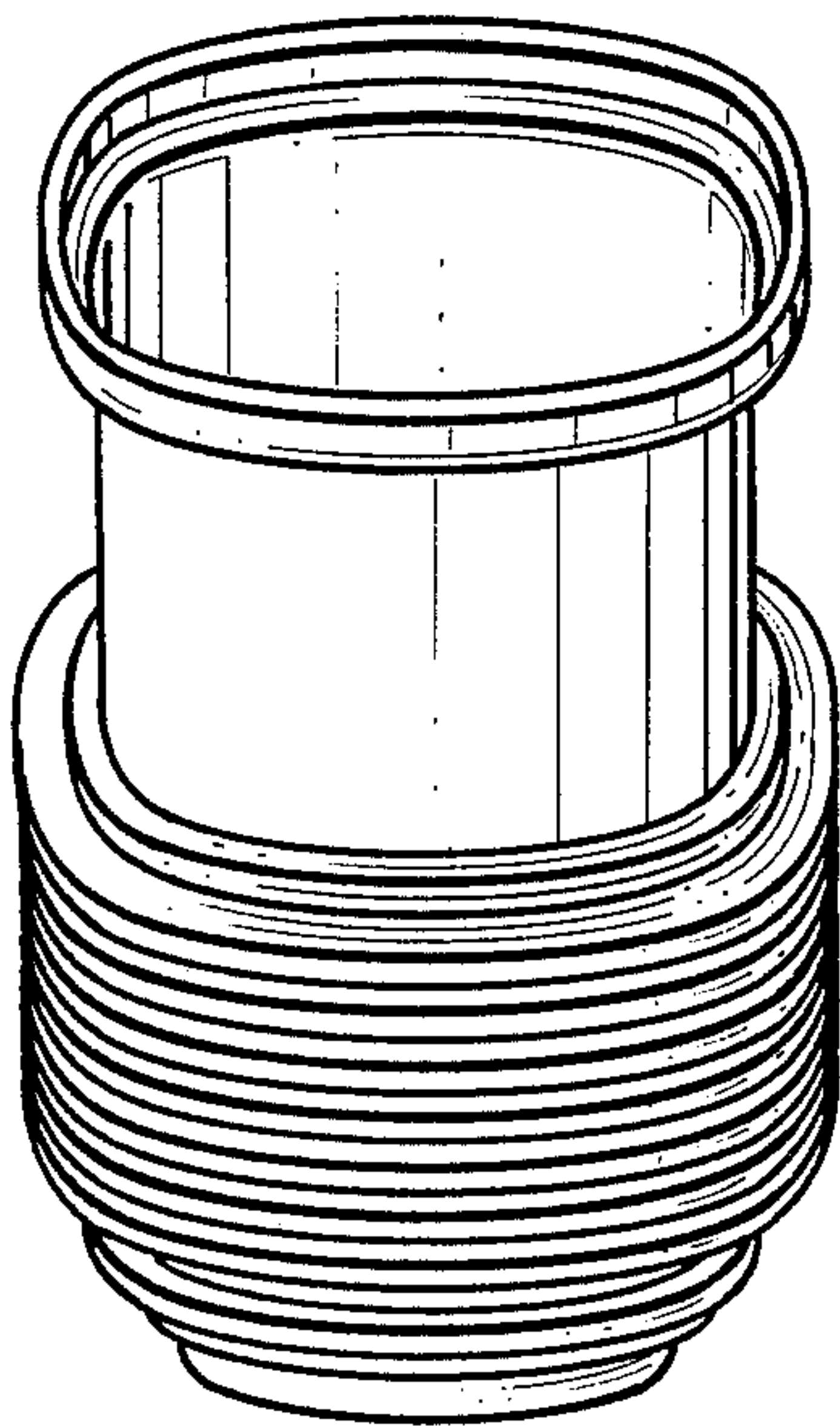

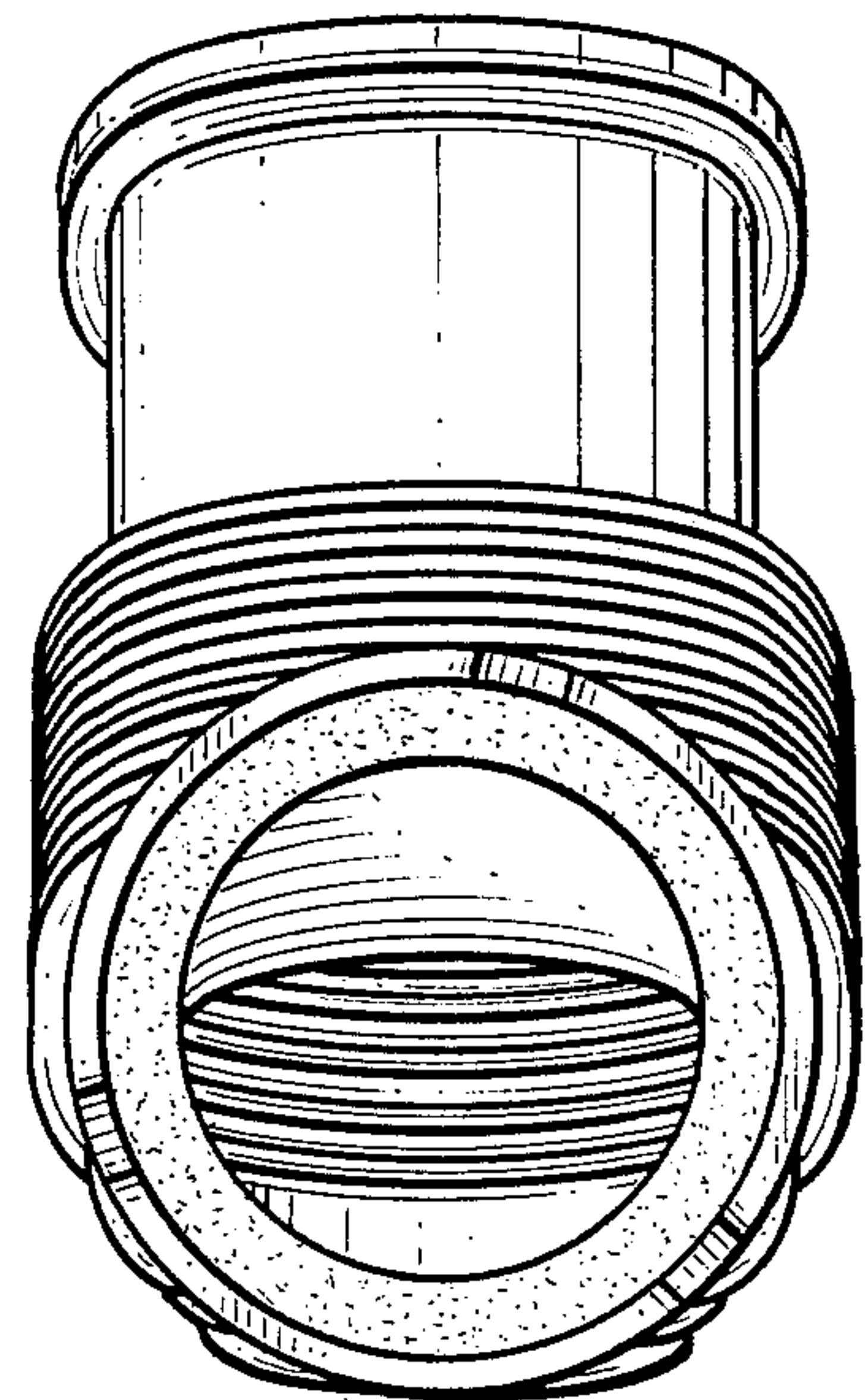

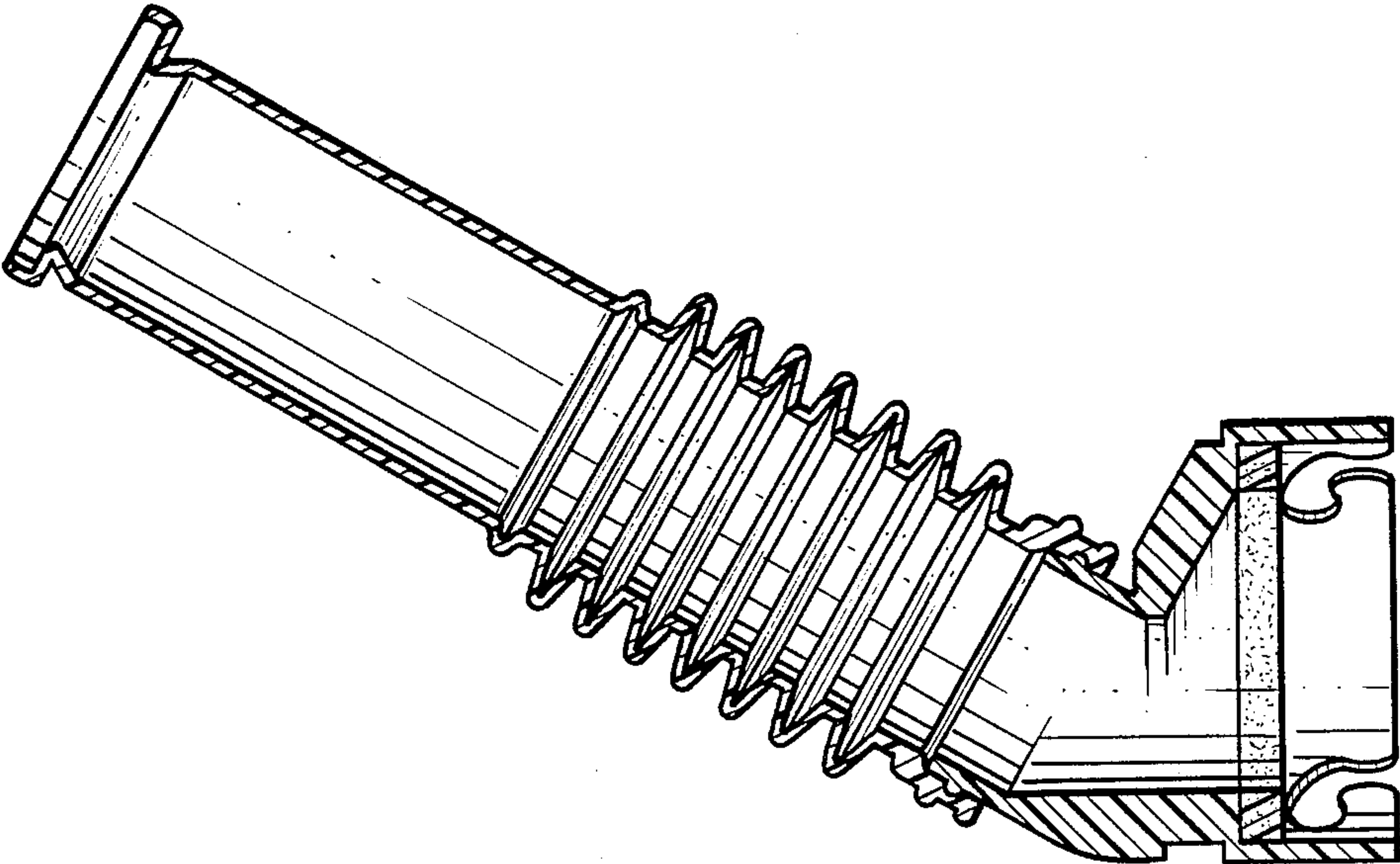

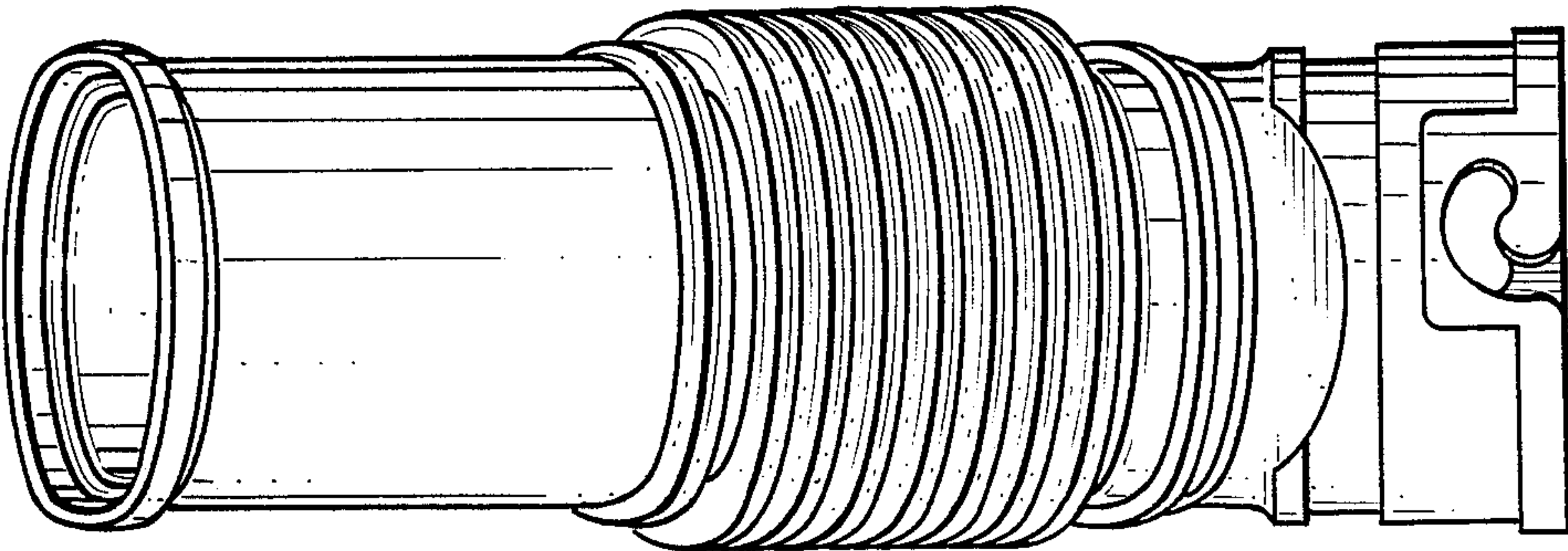

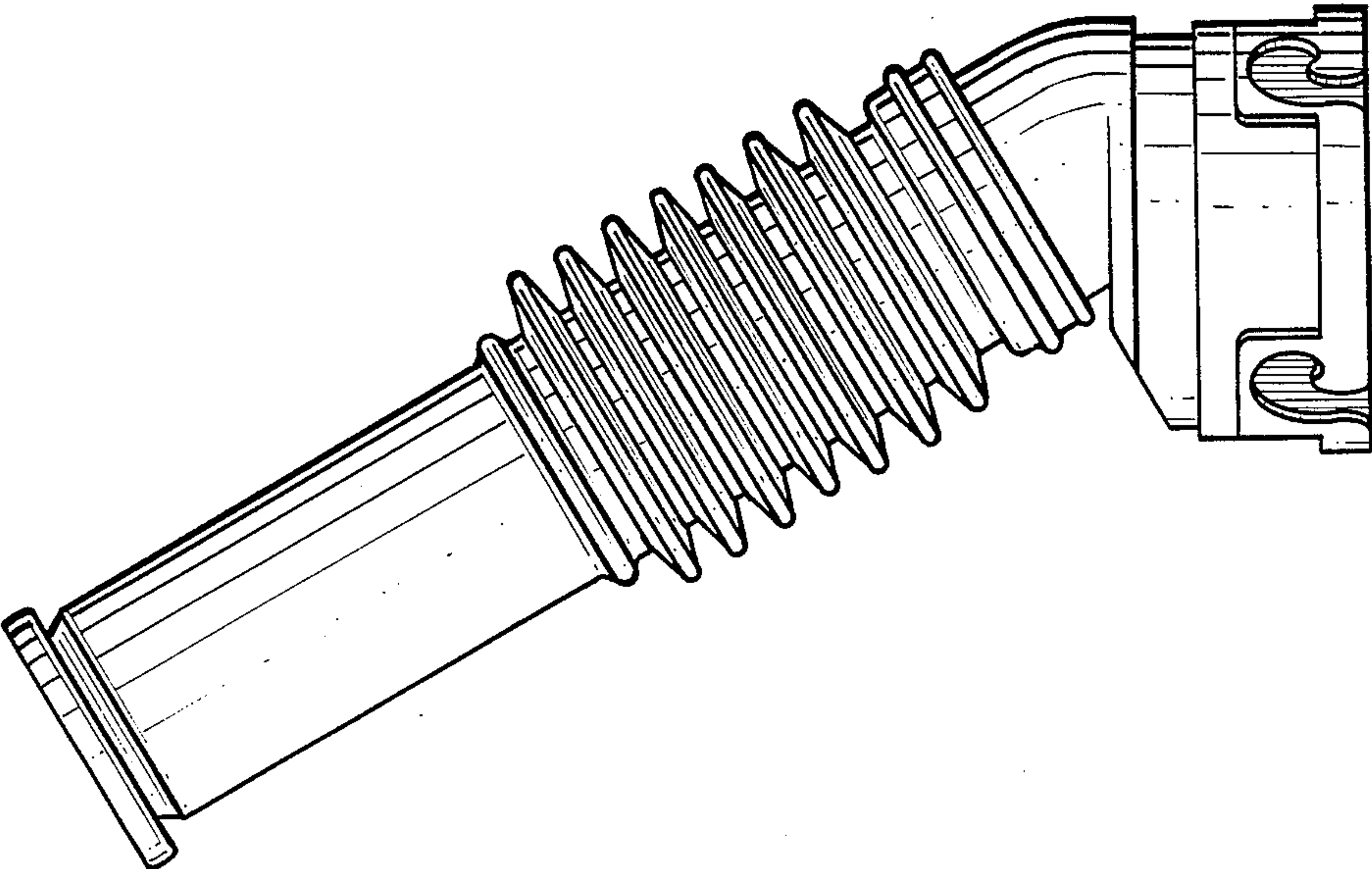

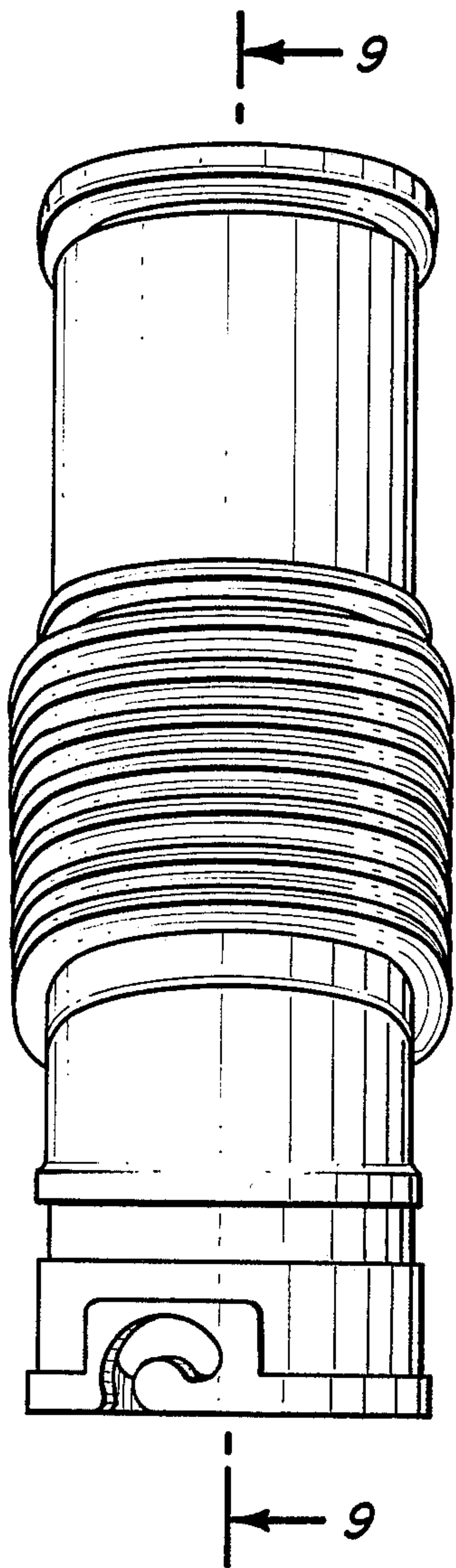

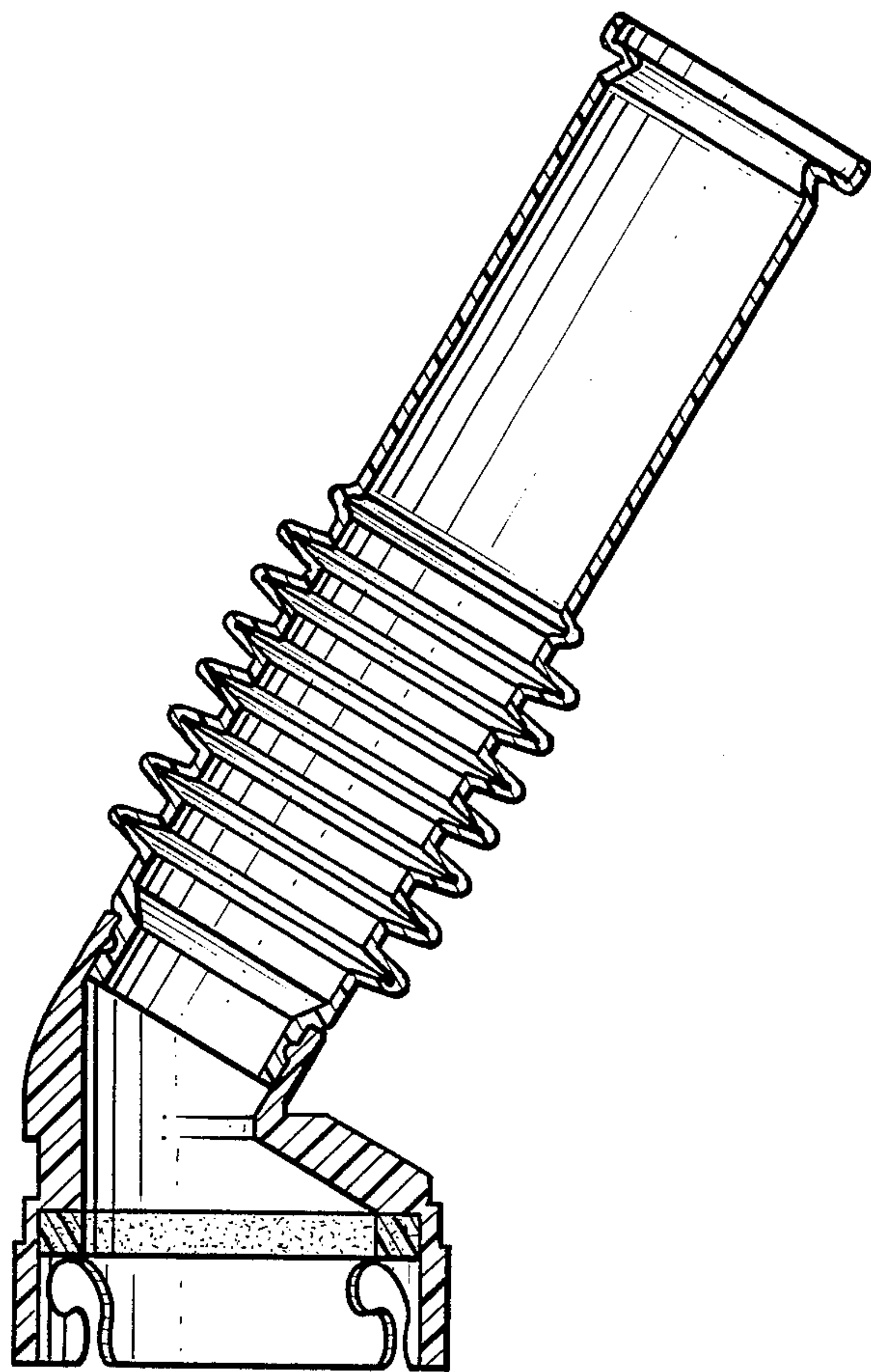
